(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design of a coin bank, substantially as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

Applicant hereby refers to her previously submitted disclosure document 488511, filed Feb. 12, 2001 and incorporated herein by references.

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a coin bank embodying the design of the present invention;

FIG. 2 is a front side elevational view of the coin bank illustrated in FIG. 1;

FIG. 3 is a back side elevational view of the coin bank illustrated in FIG. 1;

FIG. 4 is a left side elevational view of the coin bank illustrated in FIG. 1;

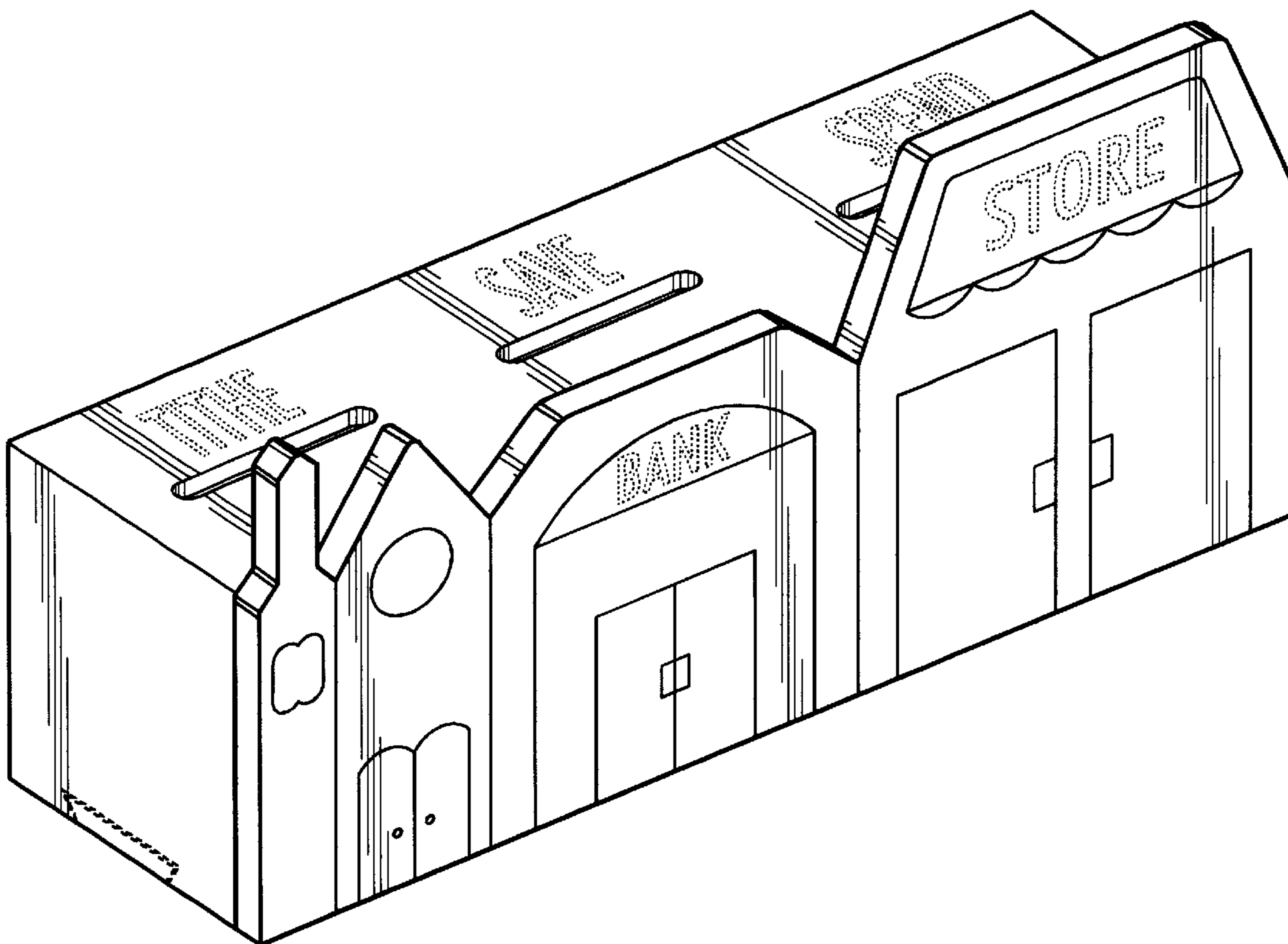
FIG. 5 is a right side elevational view of the coin bank illustrated in FIG. 1;

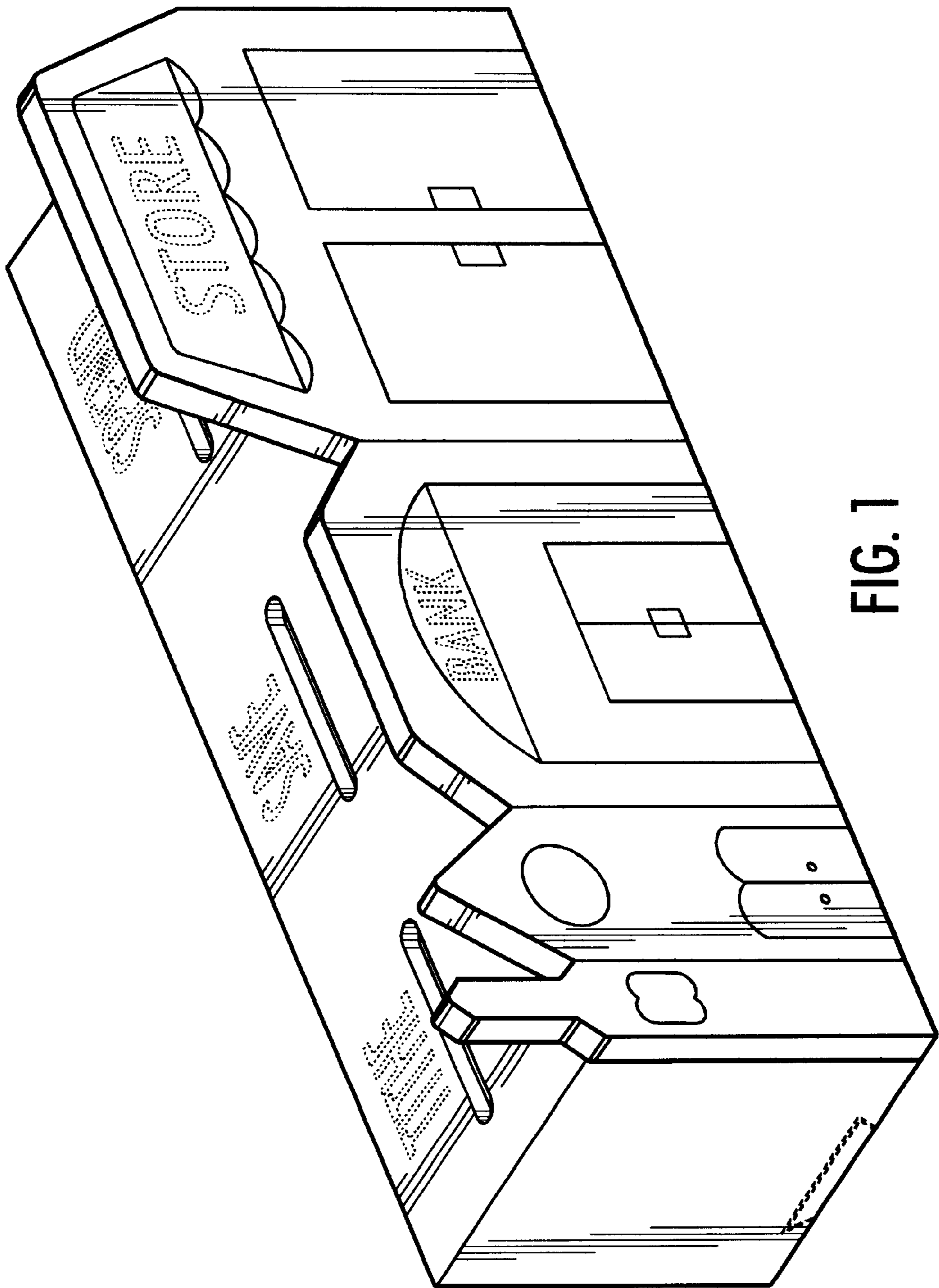

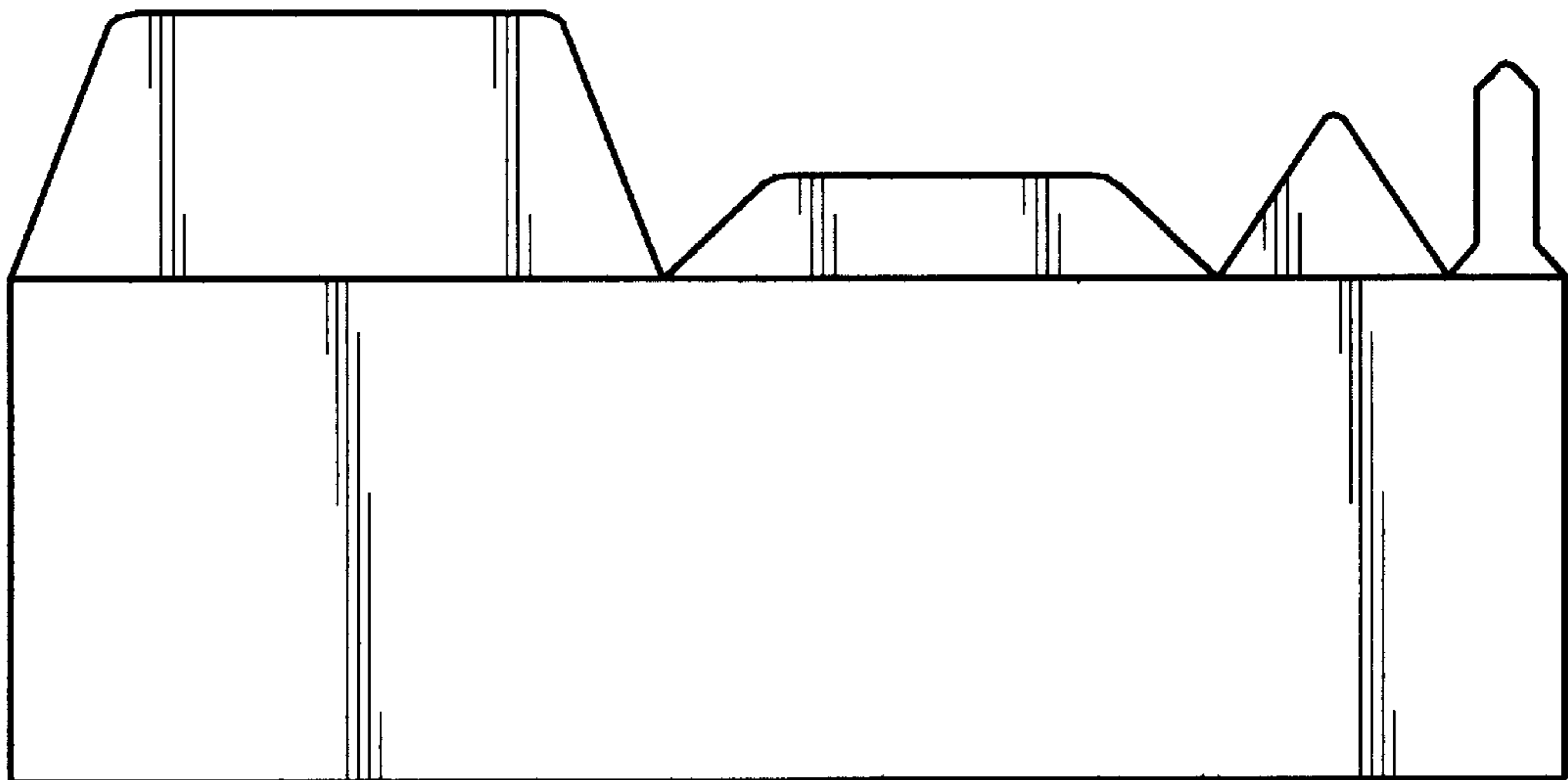

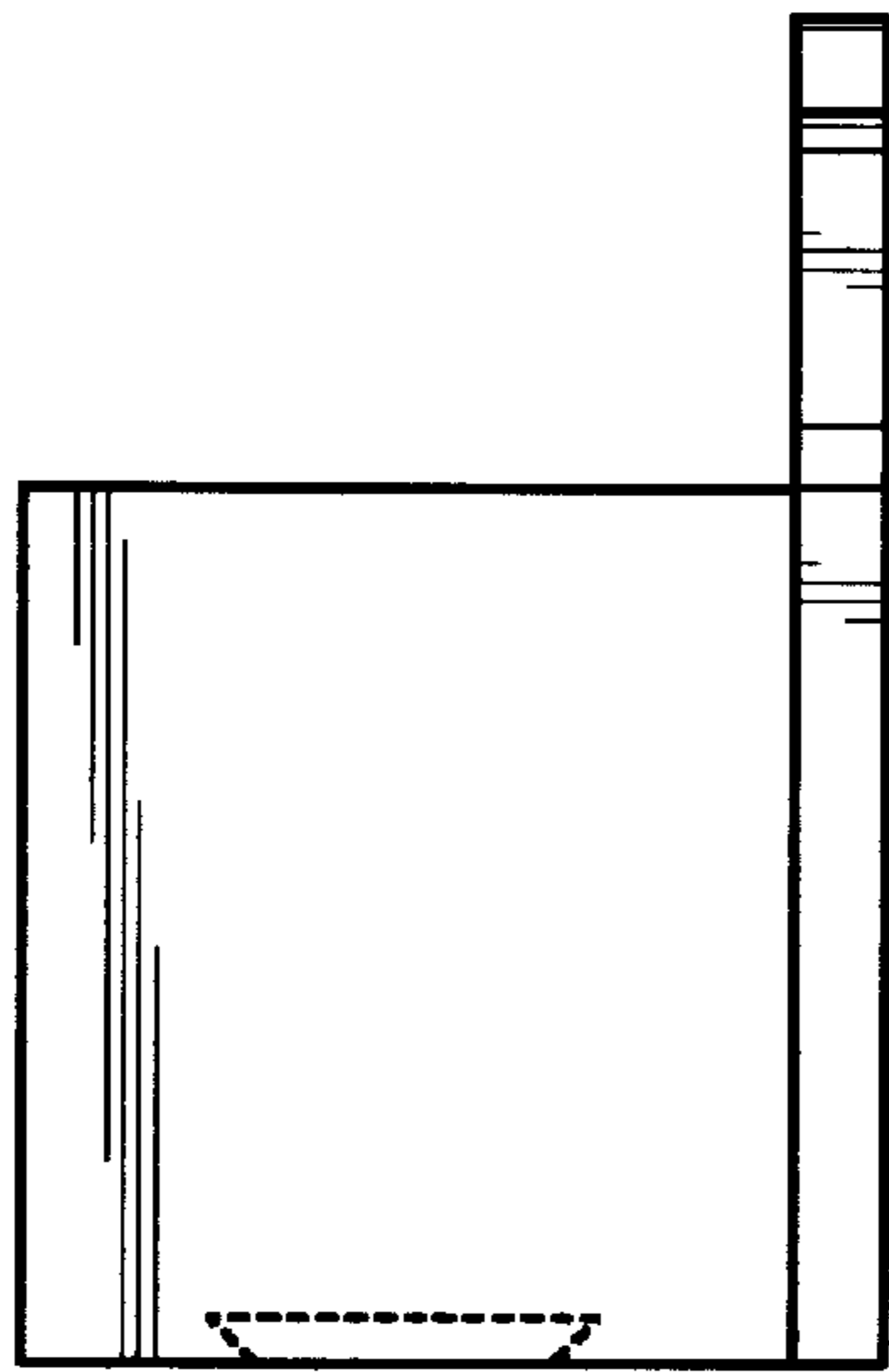

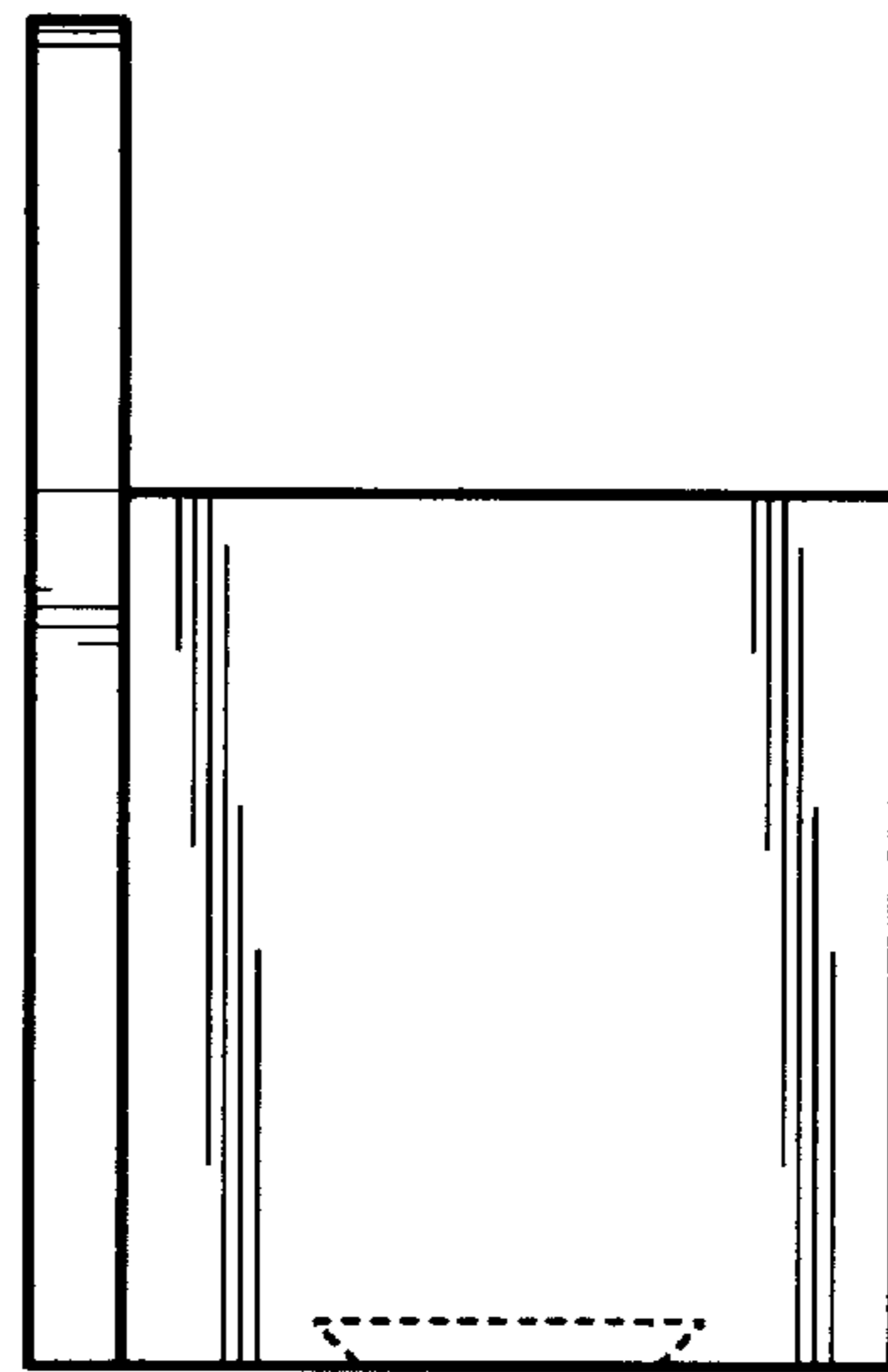

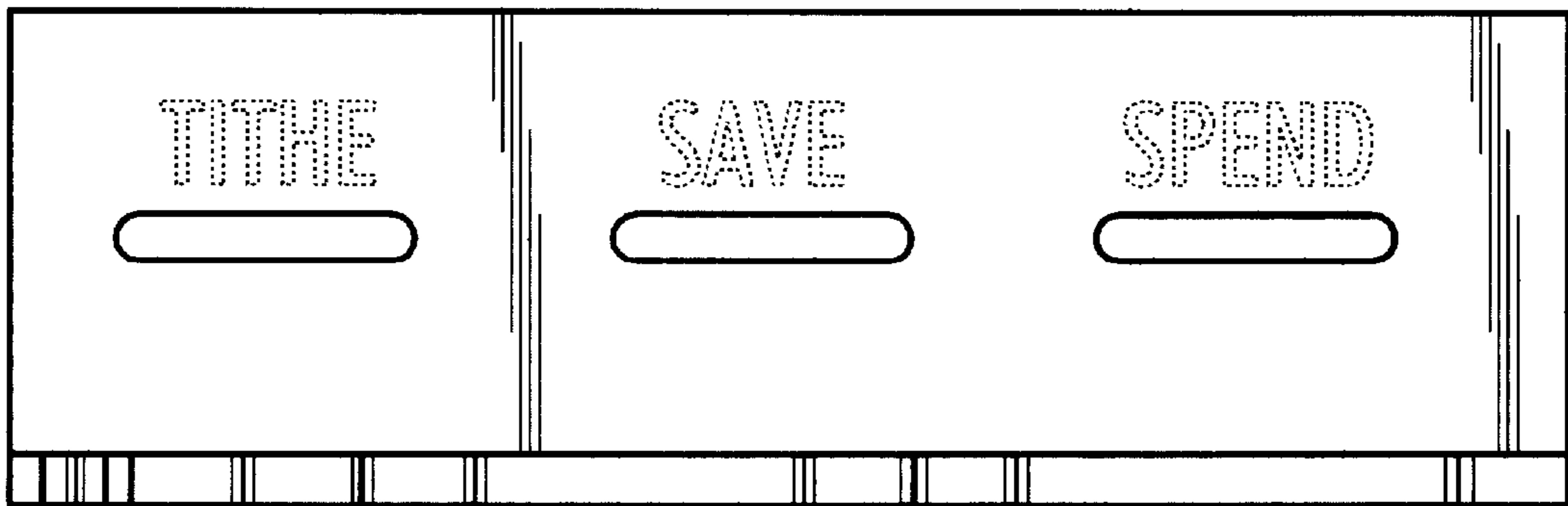

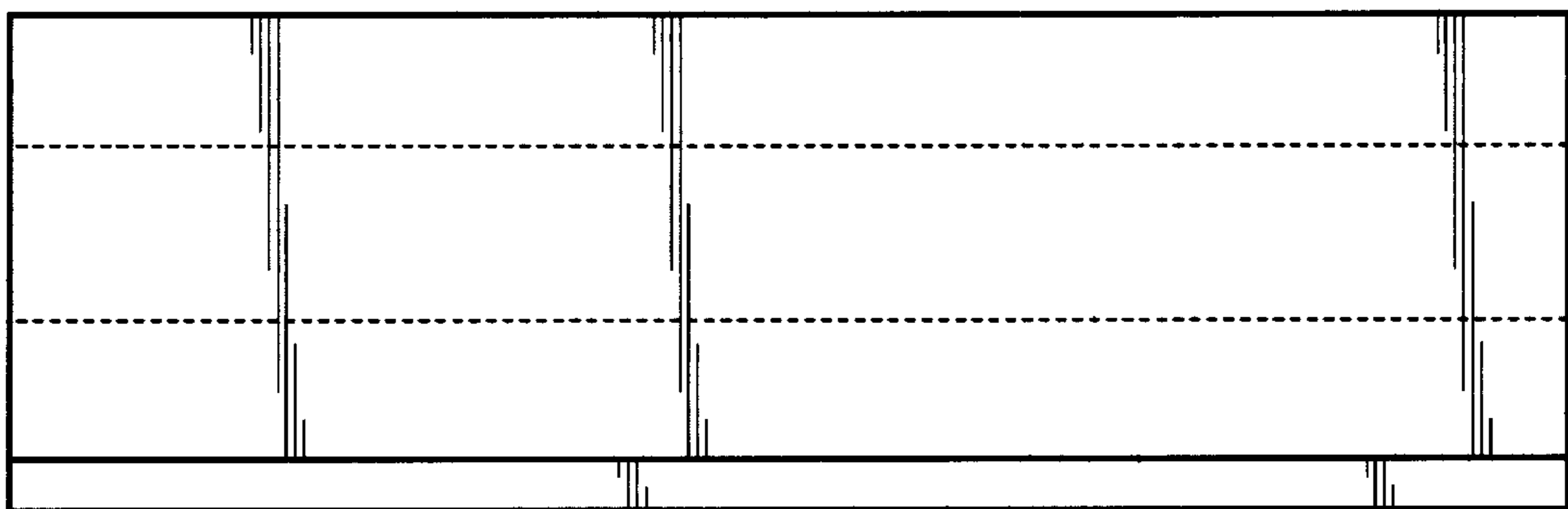
