DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a footwear sole embodying our new design;

FIG. 3 is a right side elevational view thereof;

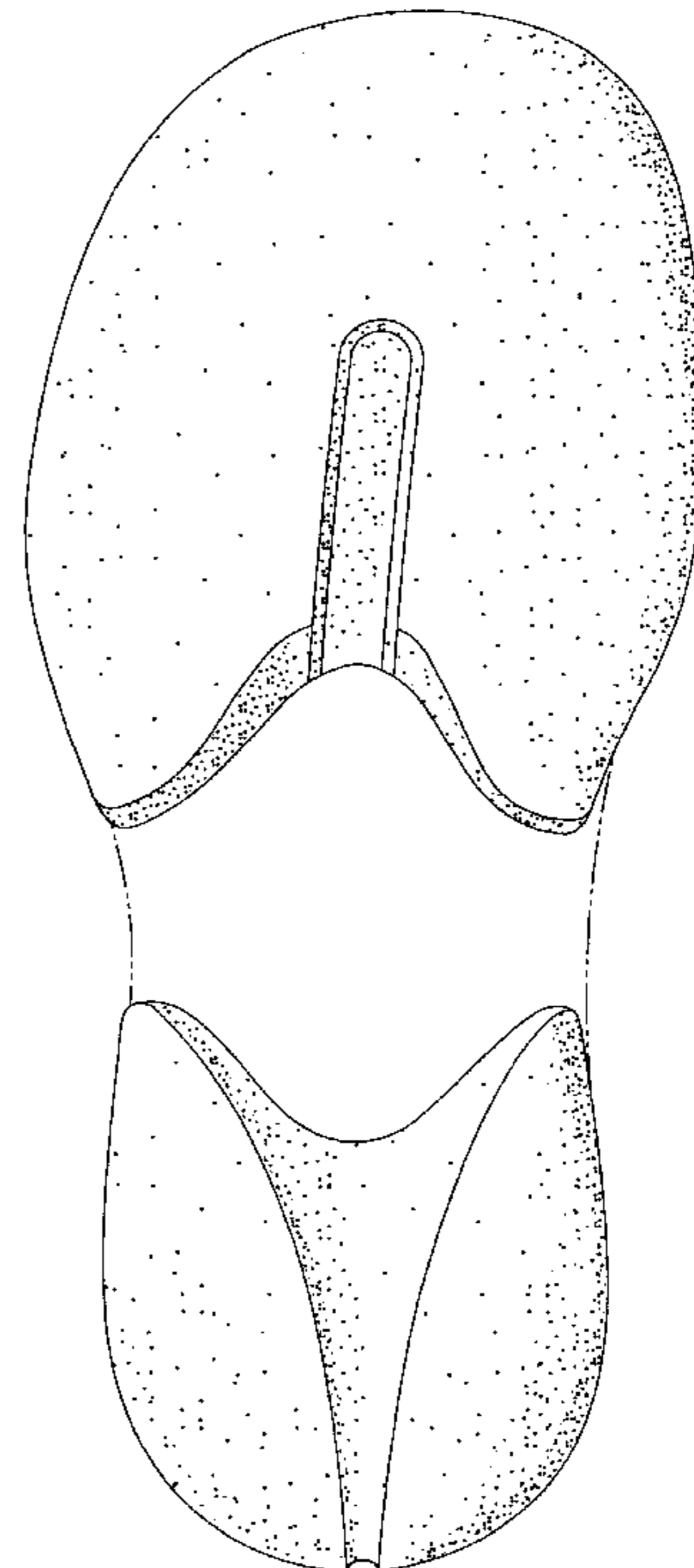
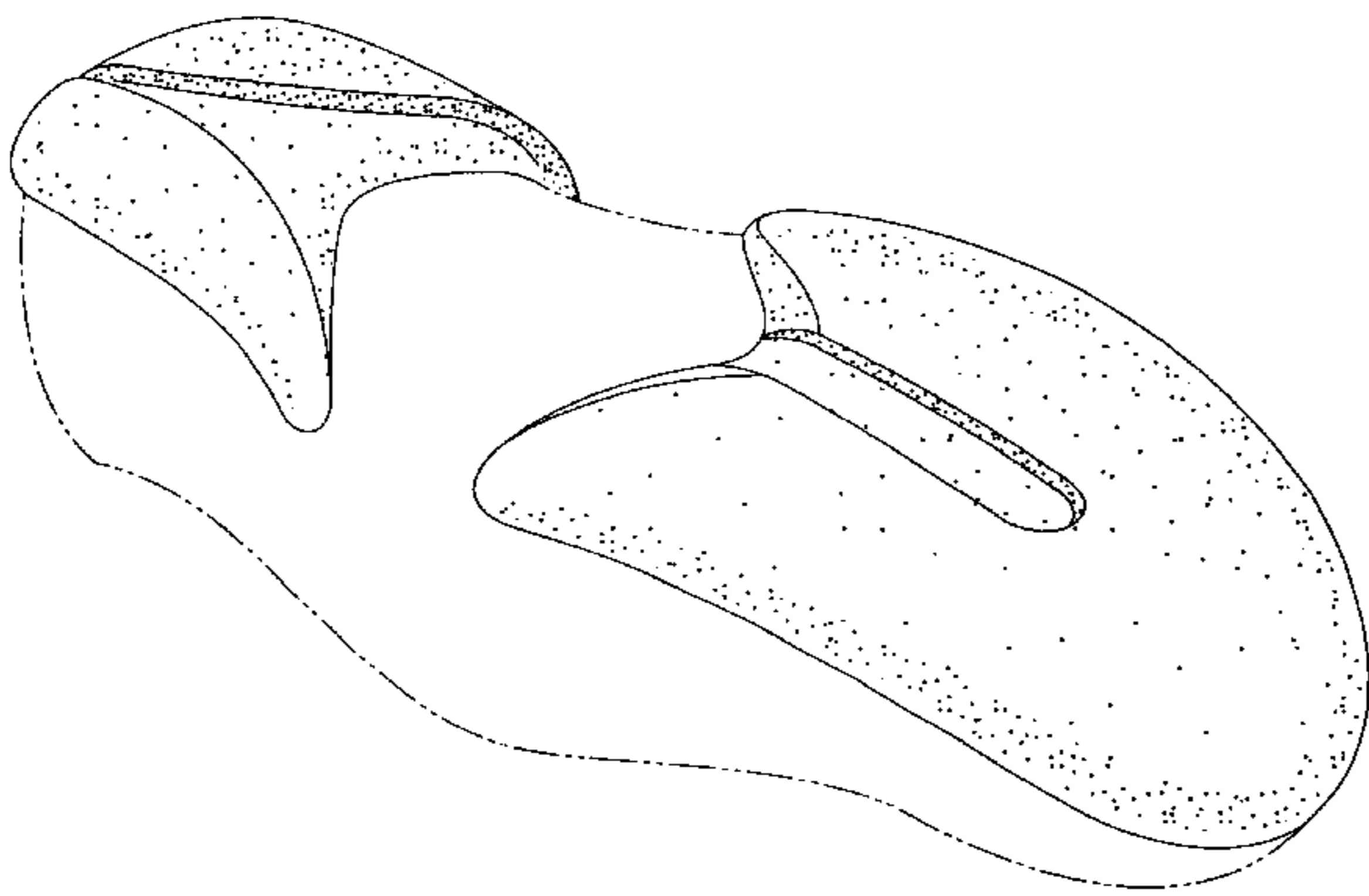
FIG. 4 is a left side elevational view thereof;

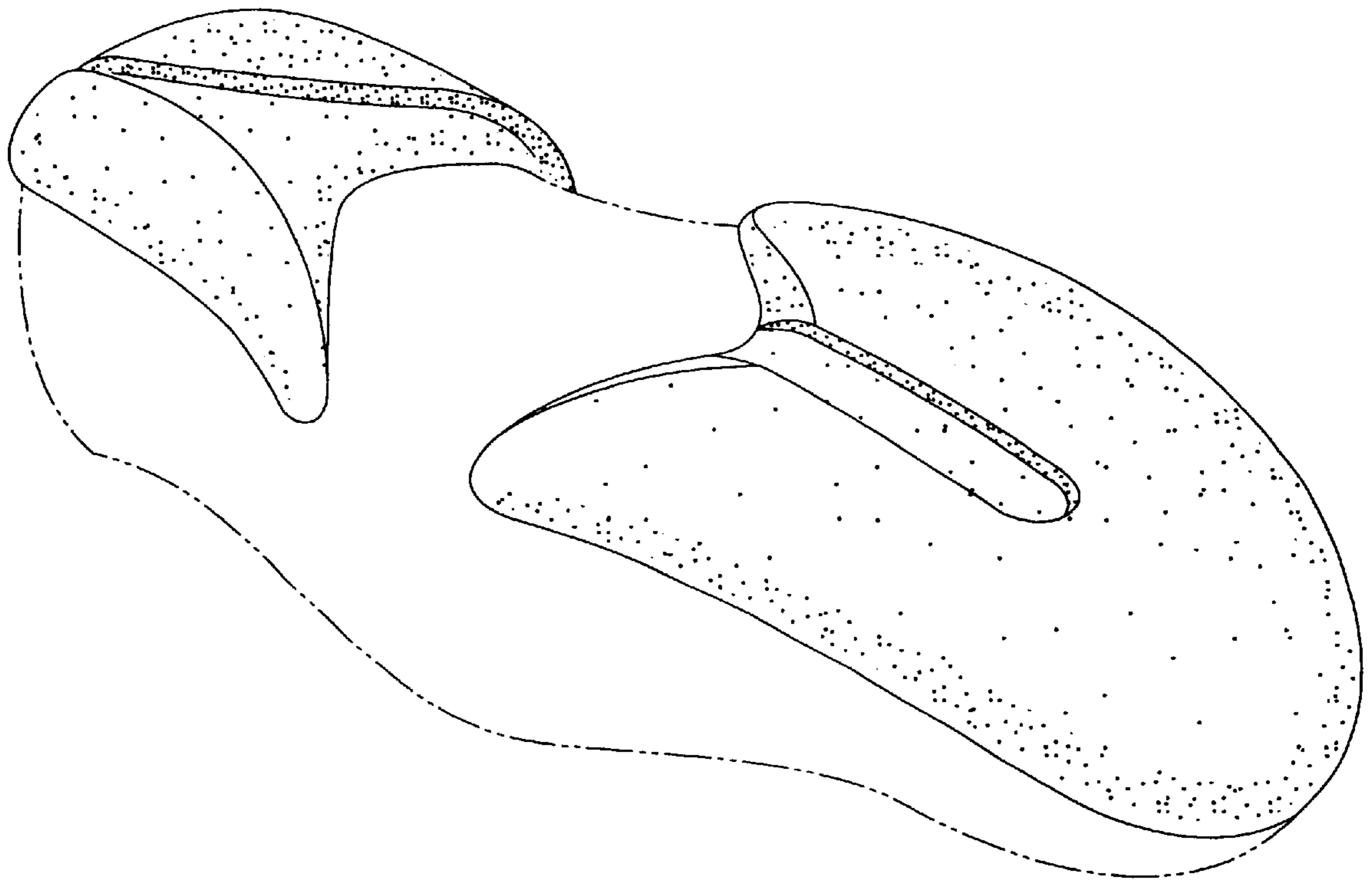

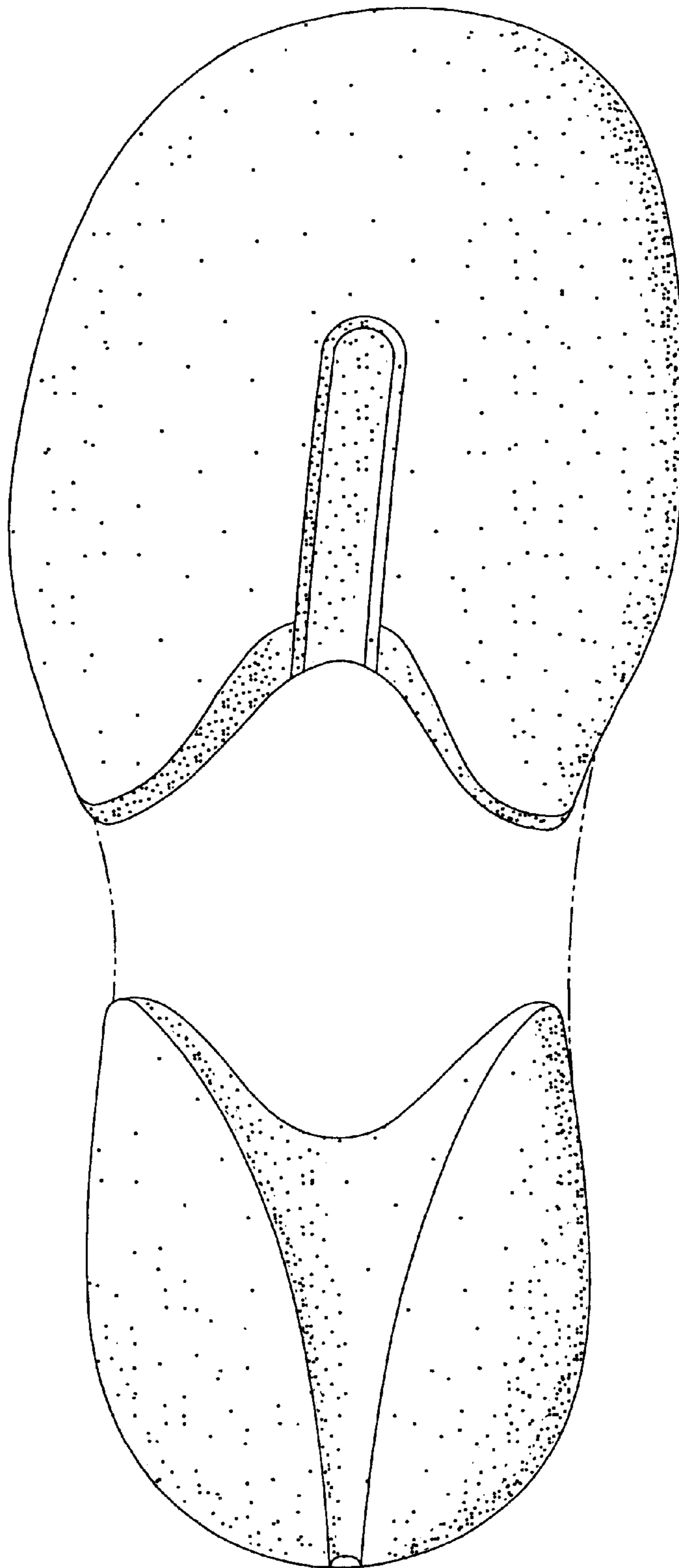

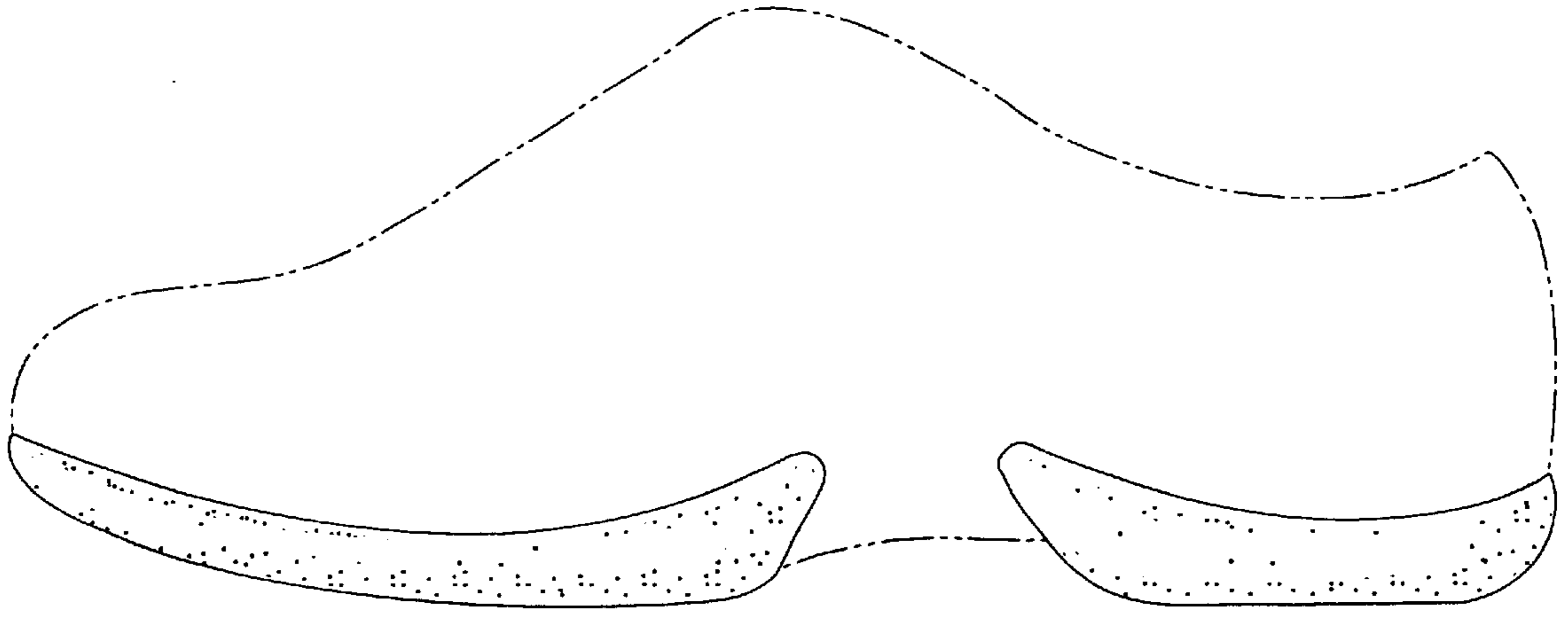

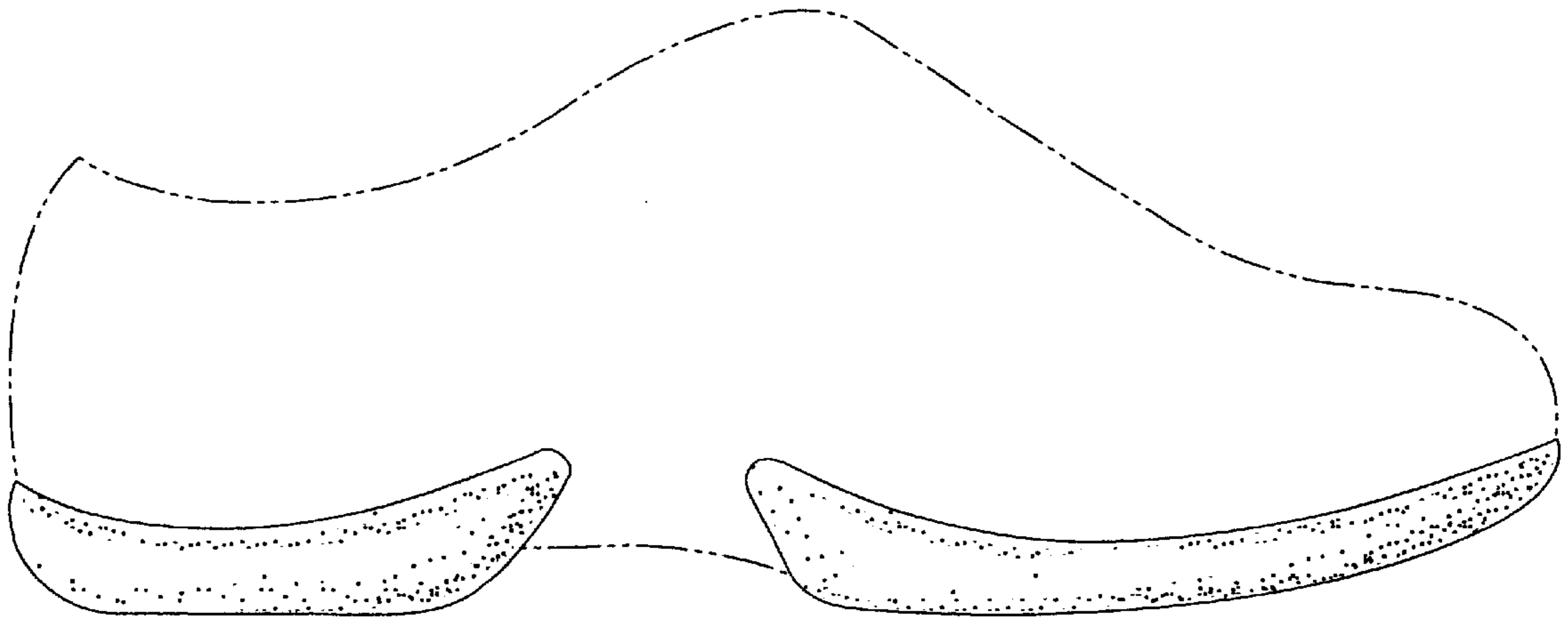

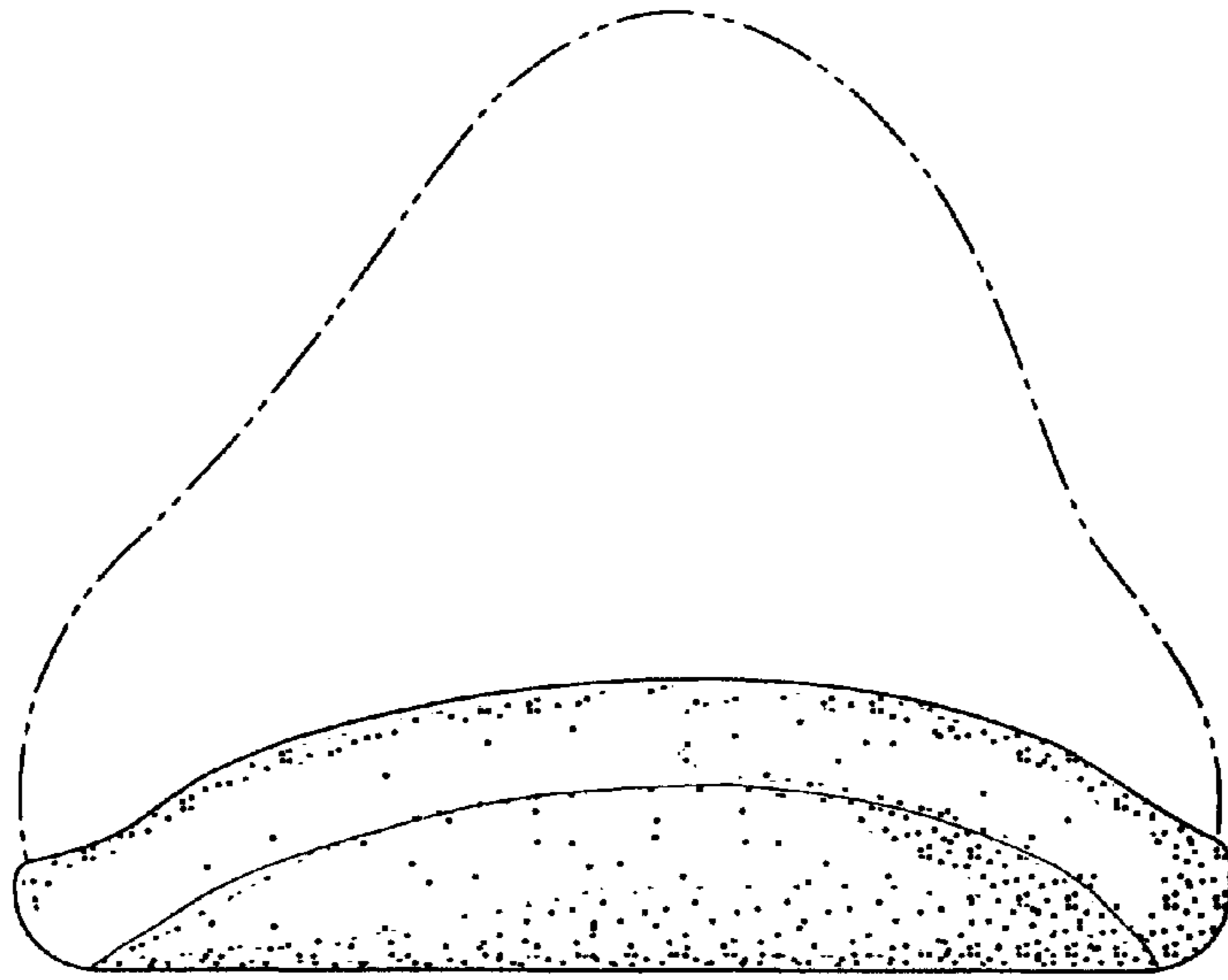

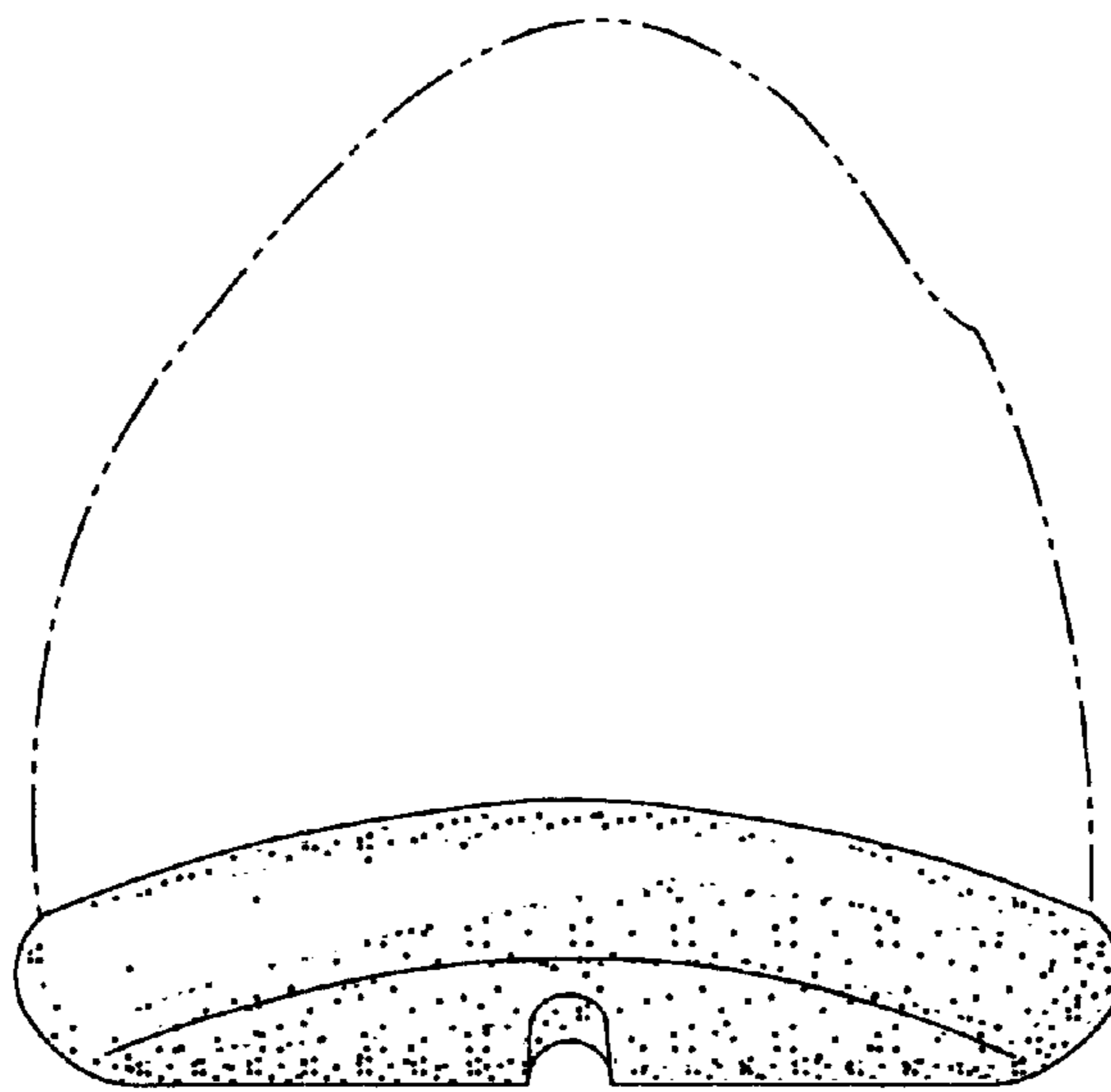
