FIG. 2 is a rear view of the TV/VCR stand.

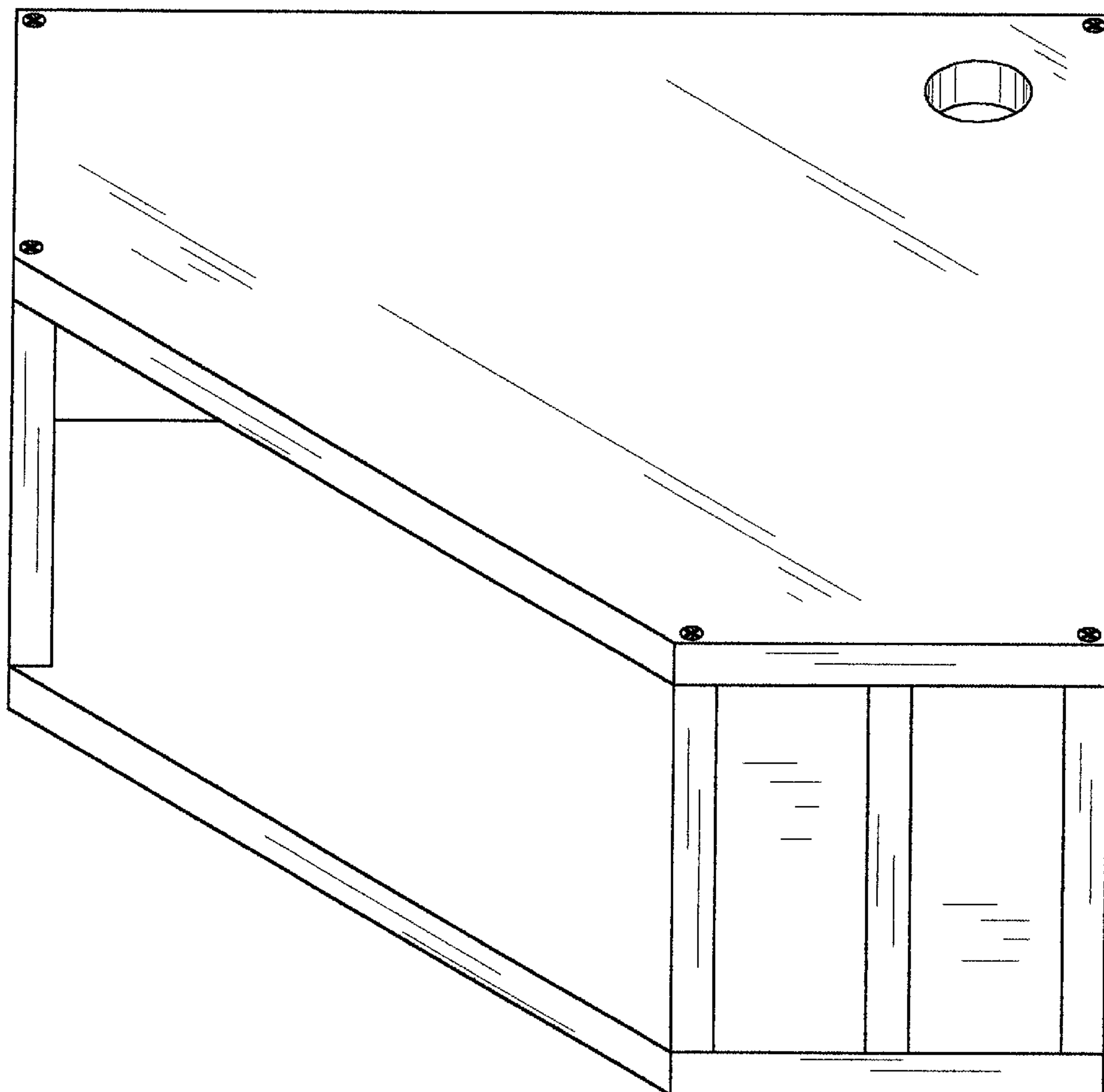
FIG. 3 is a side view of the TV/VCR stand.

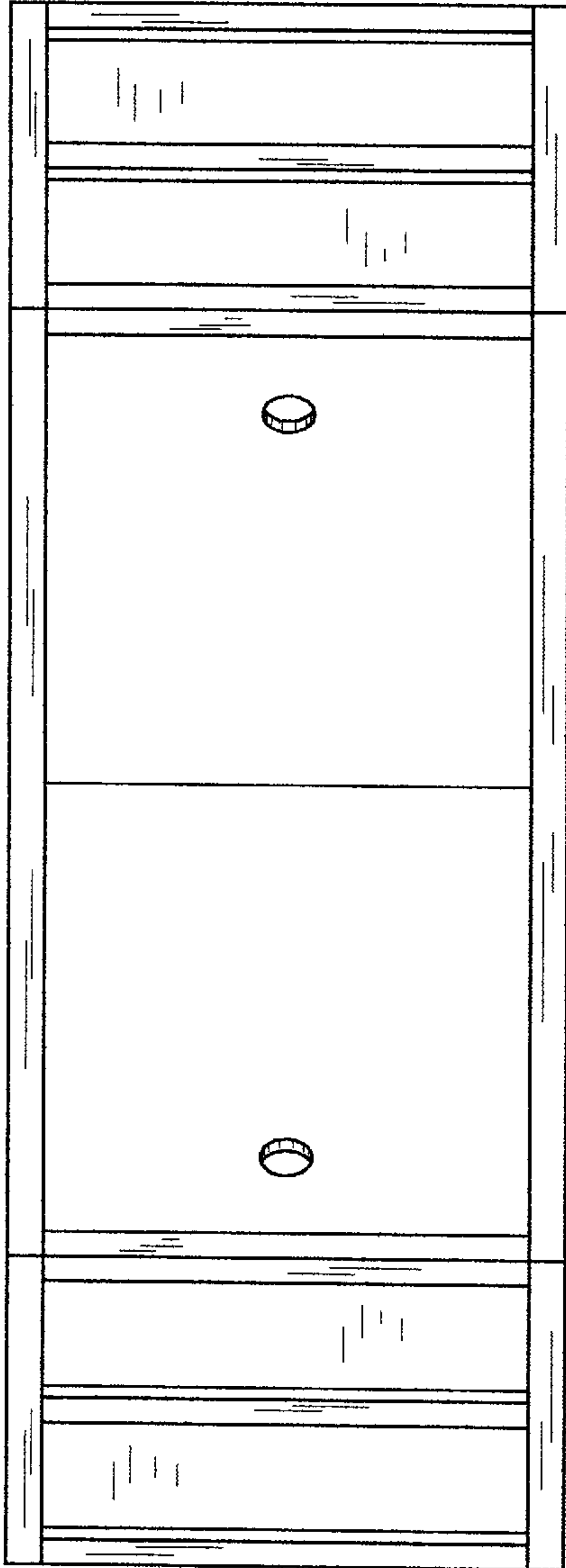

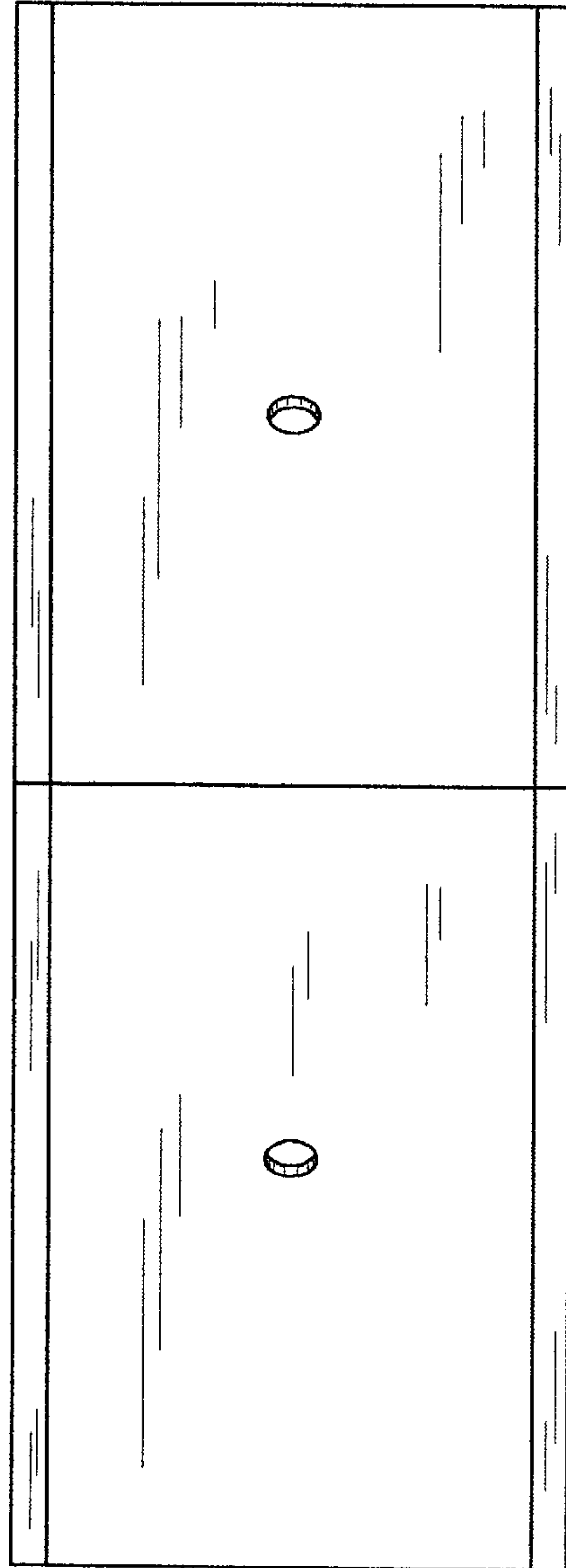

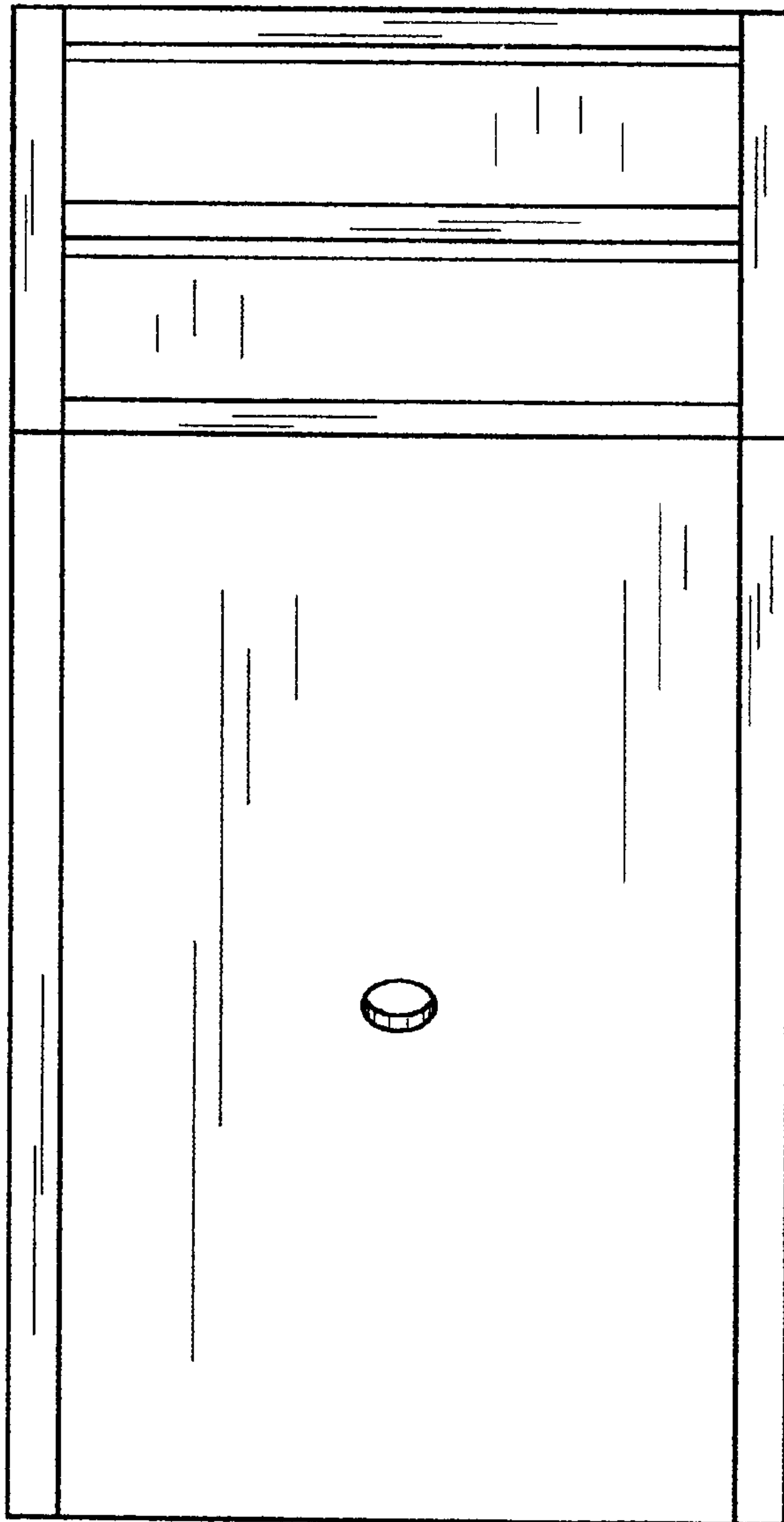

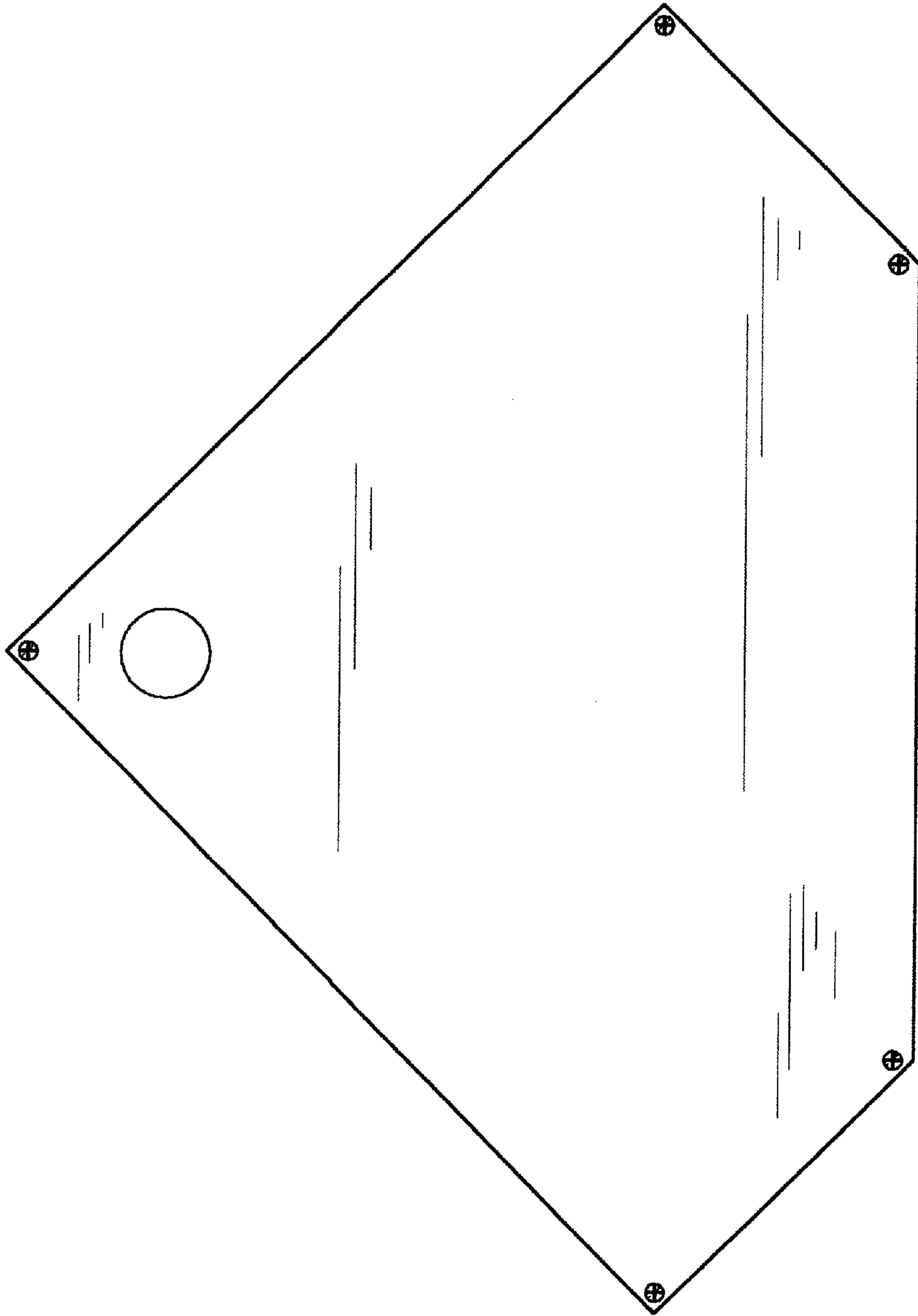

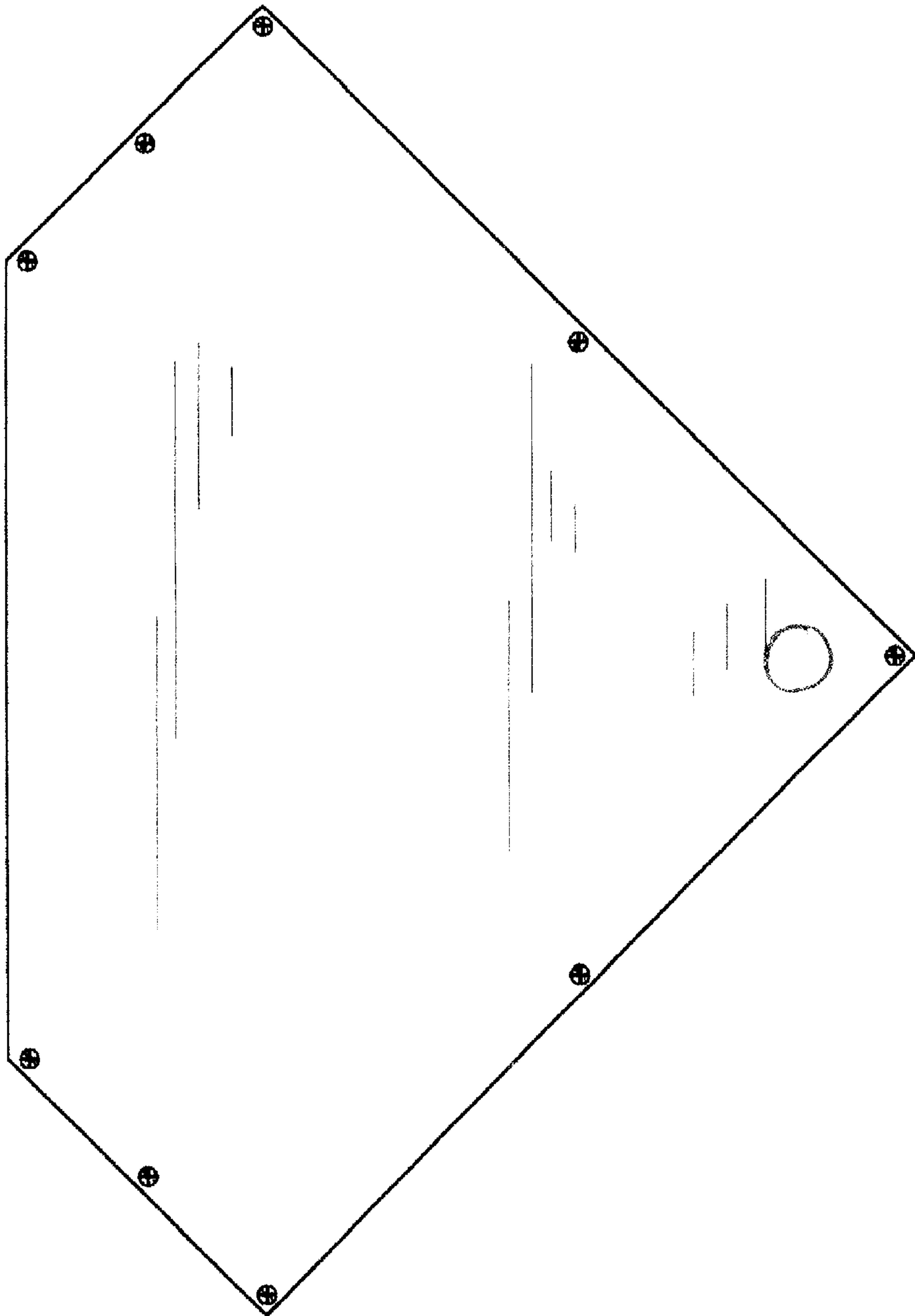

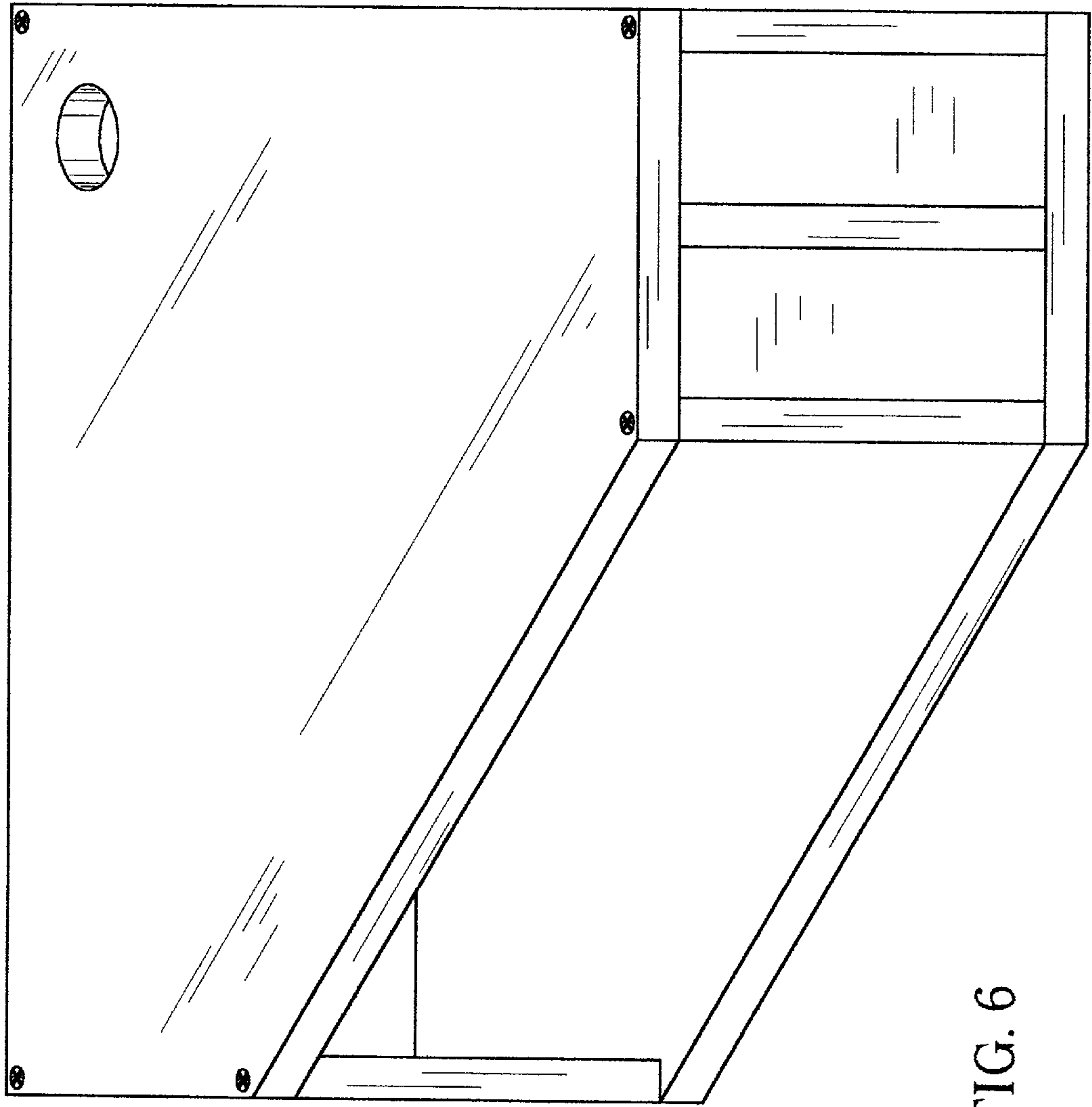
