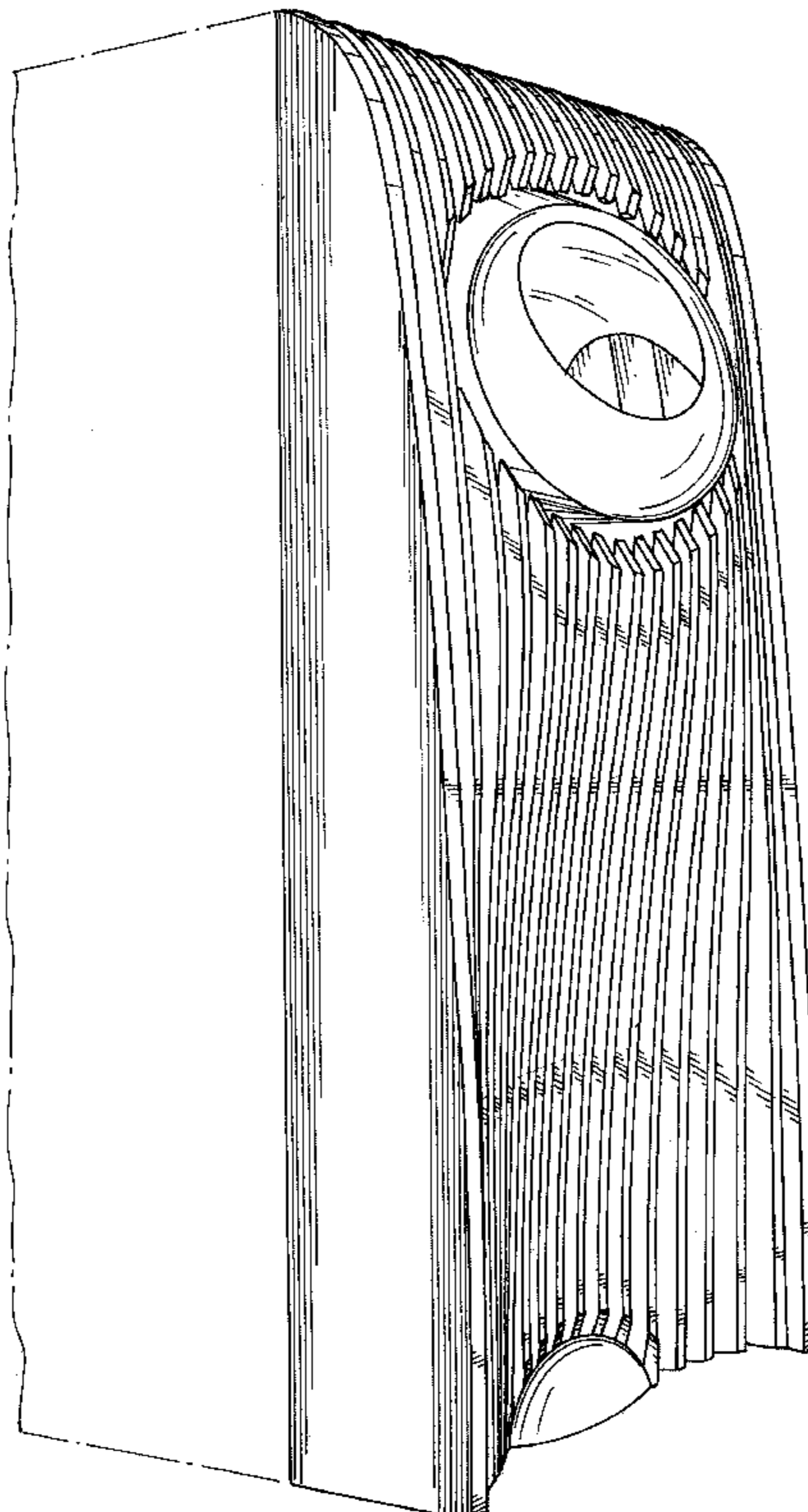
(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a tower unit bezel, as shown and described.

**DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 1 is a front and left-side perspective view of a tower unit bezel showing a first embodiment of our new design; FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof; FIG. 3 is a left-side elevational view thereof; FIG. 4 is a right-side elevational view thereof; FIG. 5 is a top plan view thereof; FIG. 6 is a bottom view thereof; and, FIG. 7 is a front elevational view of a second embodiment of our new design, the left and right-side elevational views are similar to FIGS. 3 and 4 respectively, and the top plan and bottom views are similar to FIGS. 5 and 6 respectively. The broken line showing the portion of the rear cabinet in FIGS. 1 and 3-6 is for illustrative purposes only and forms no part of the claimed design.

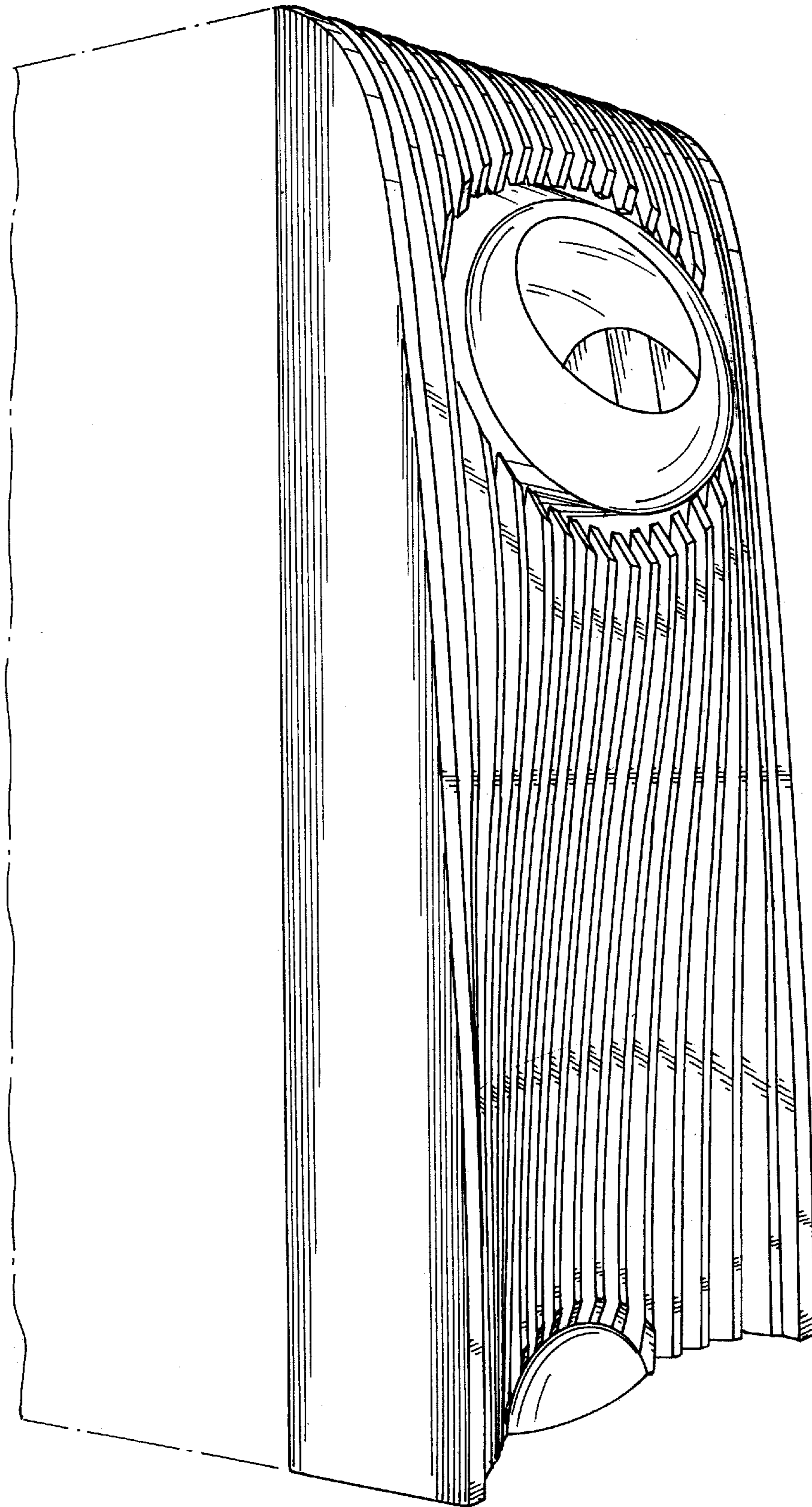
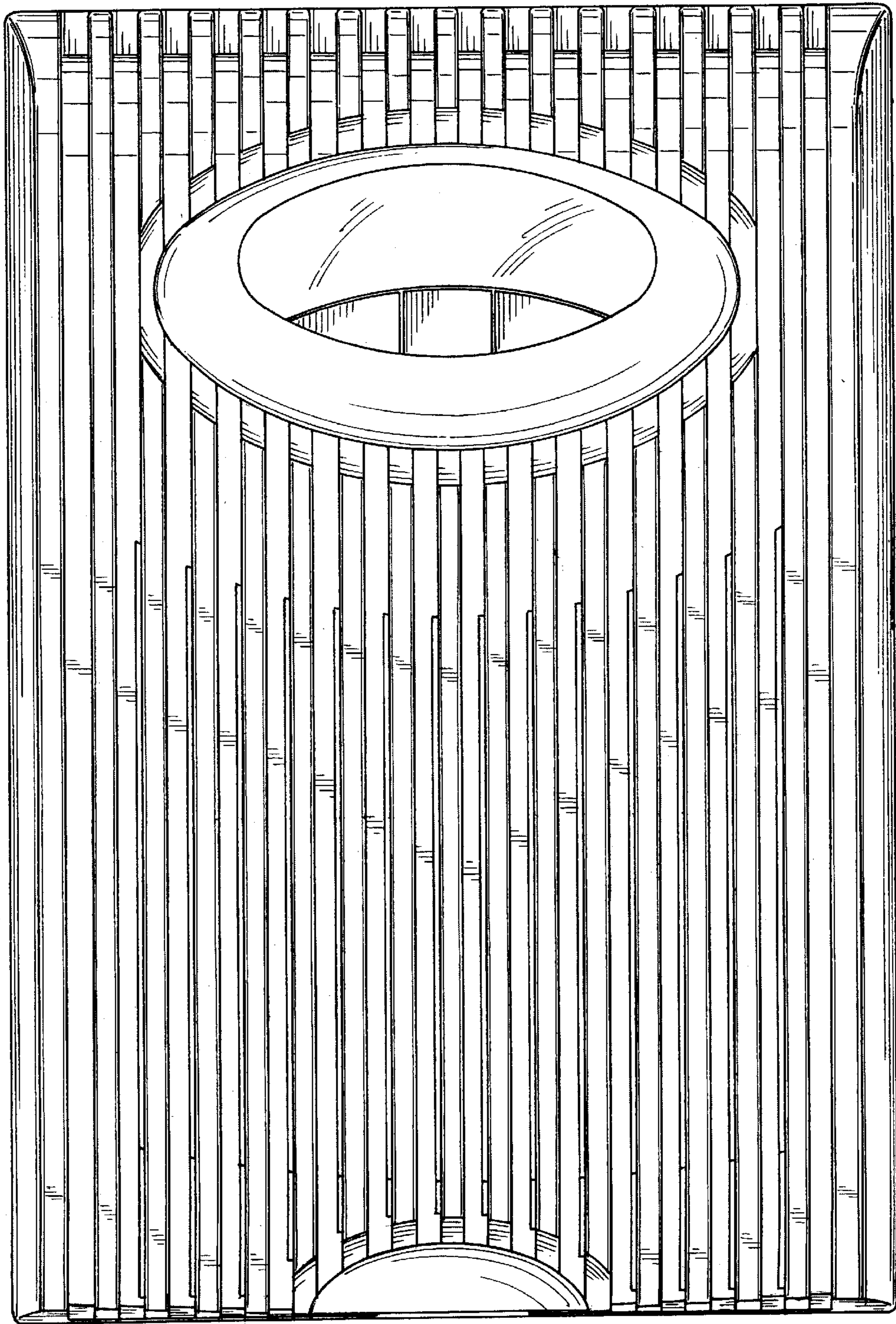
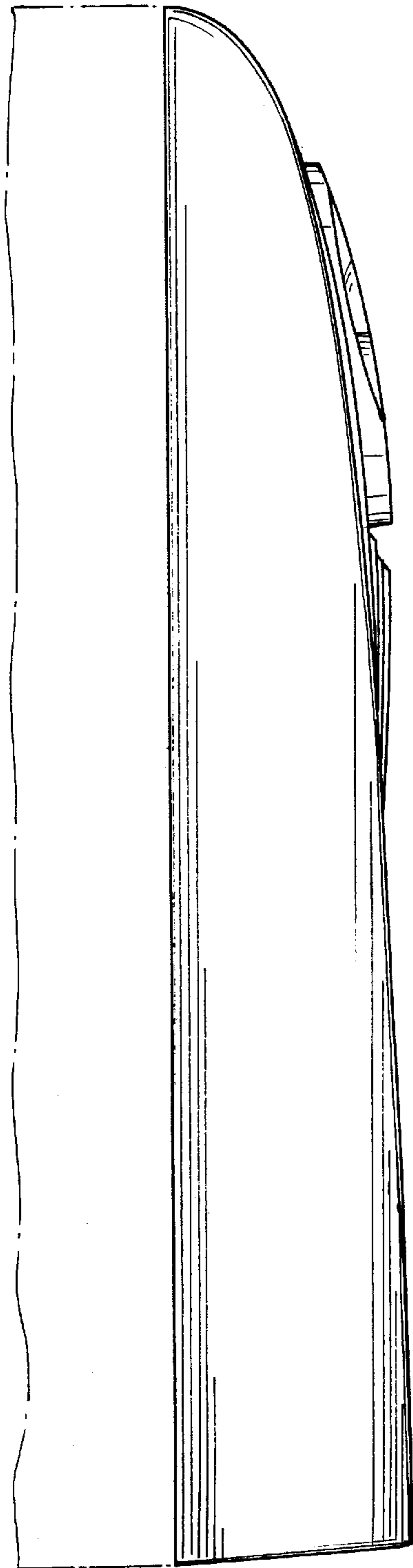

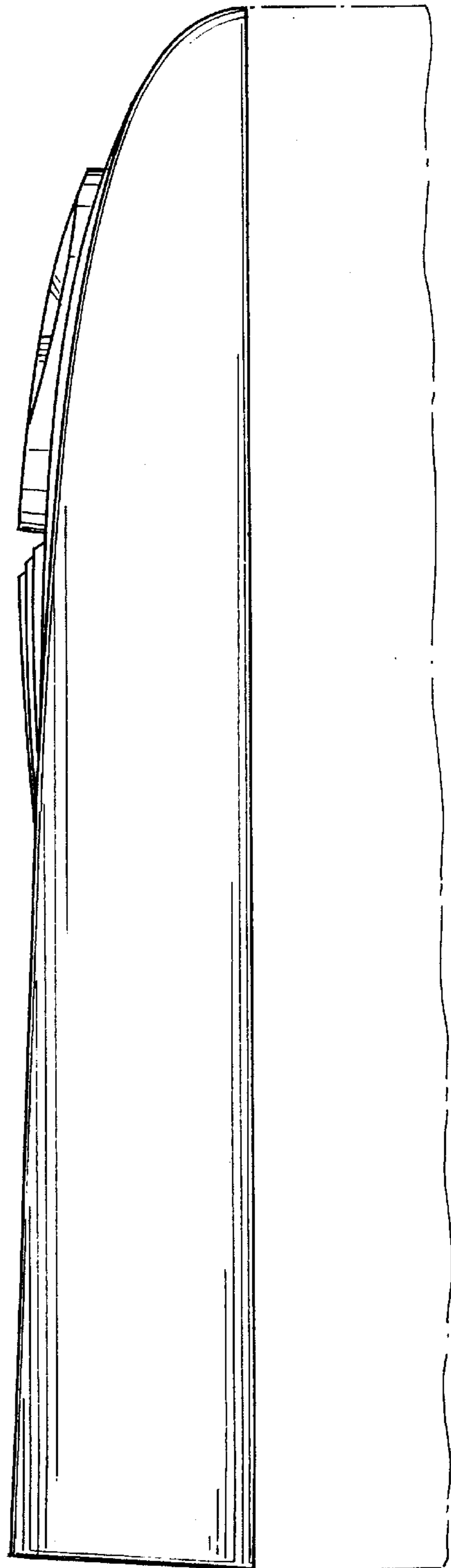

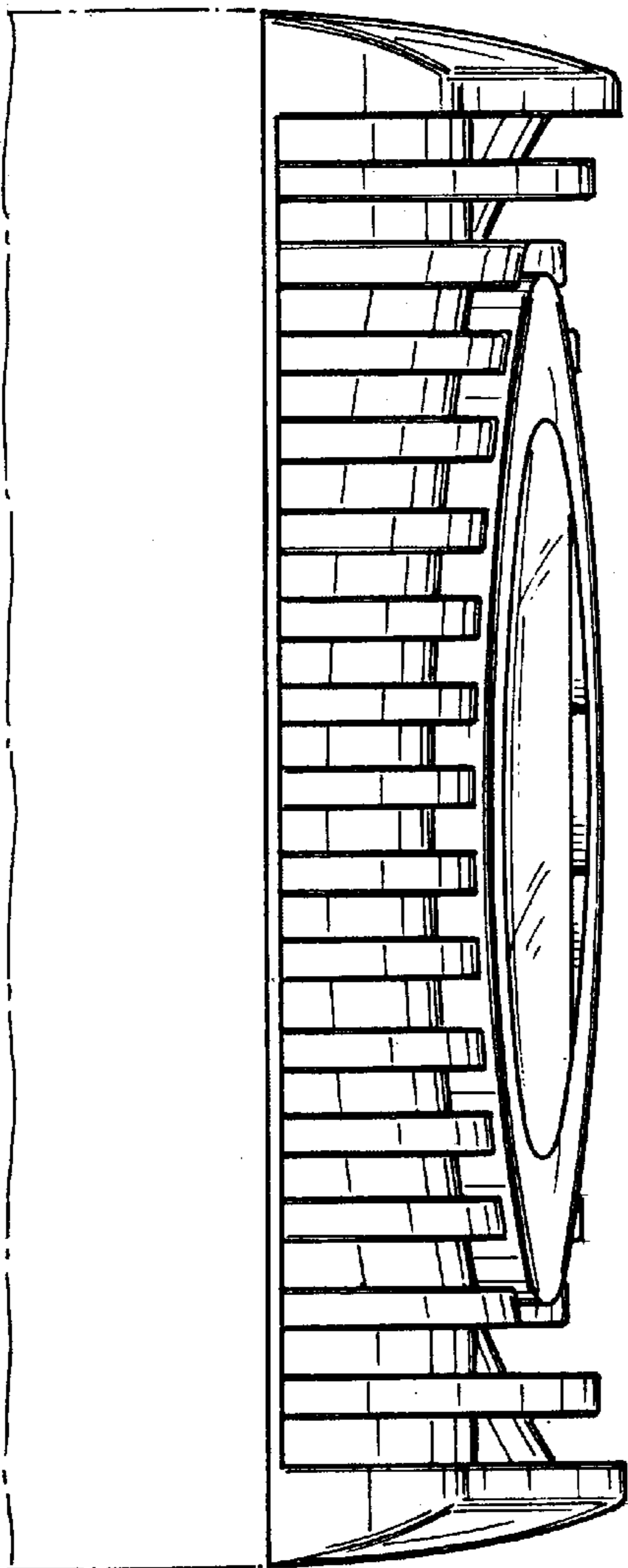

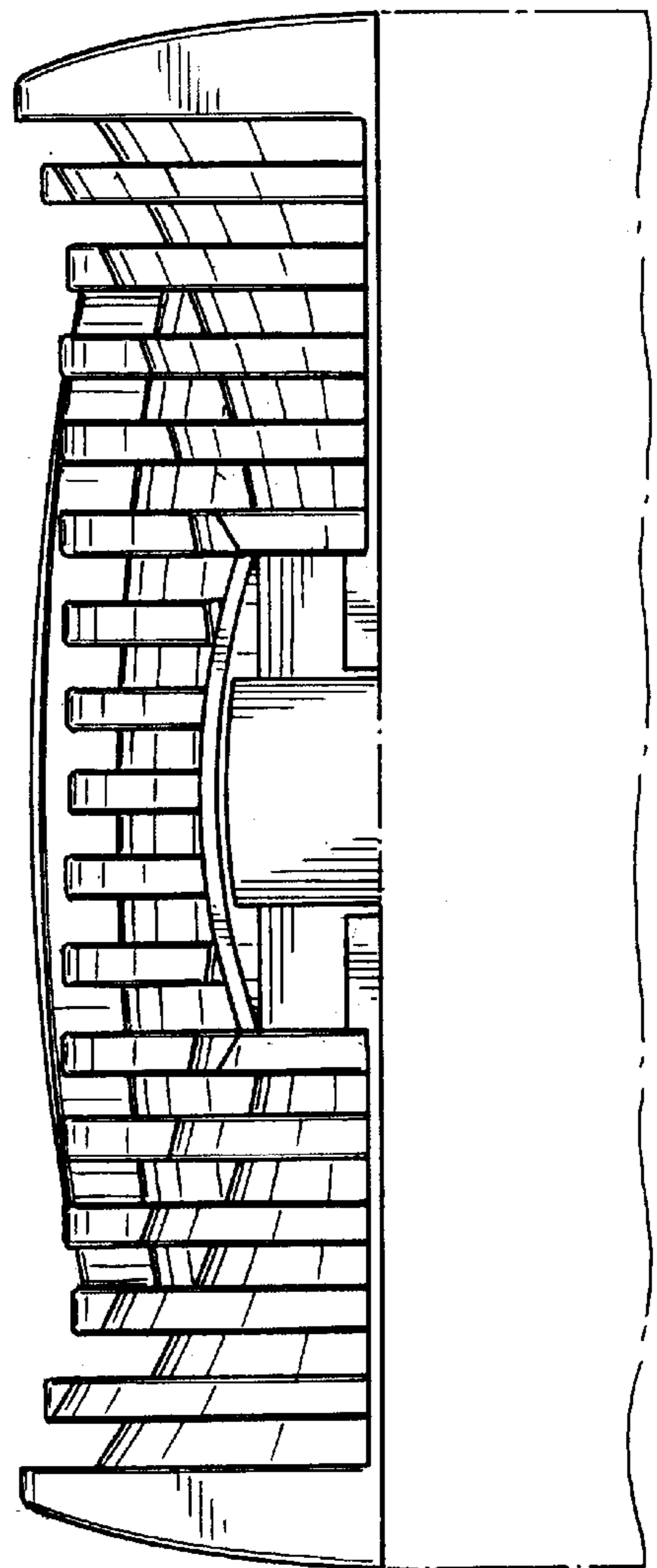
