FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof;

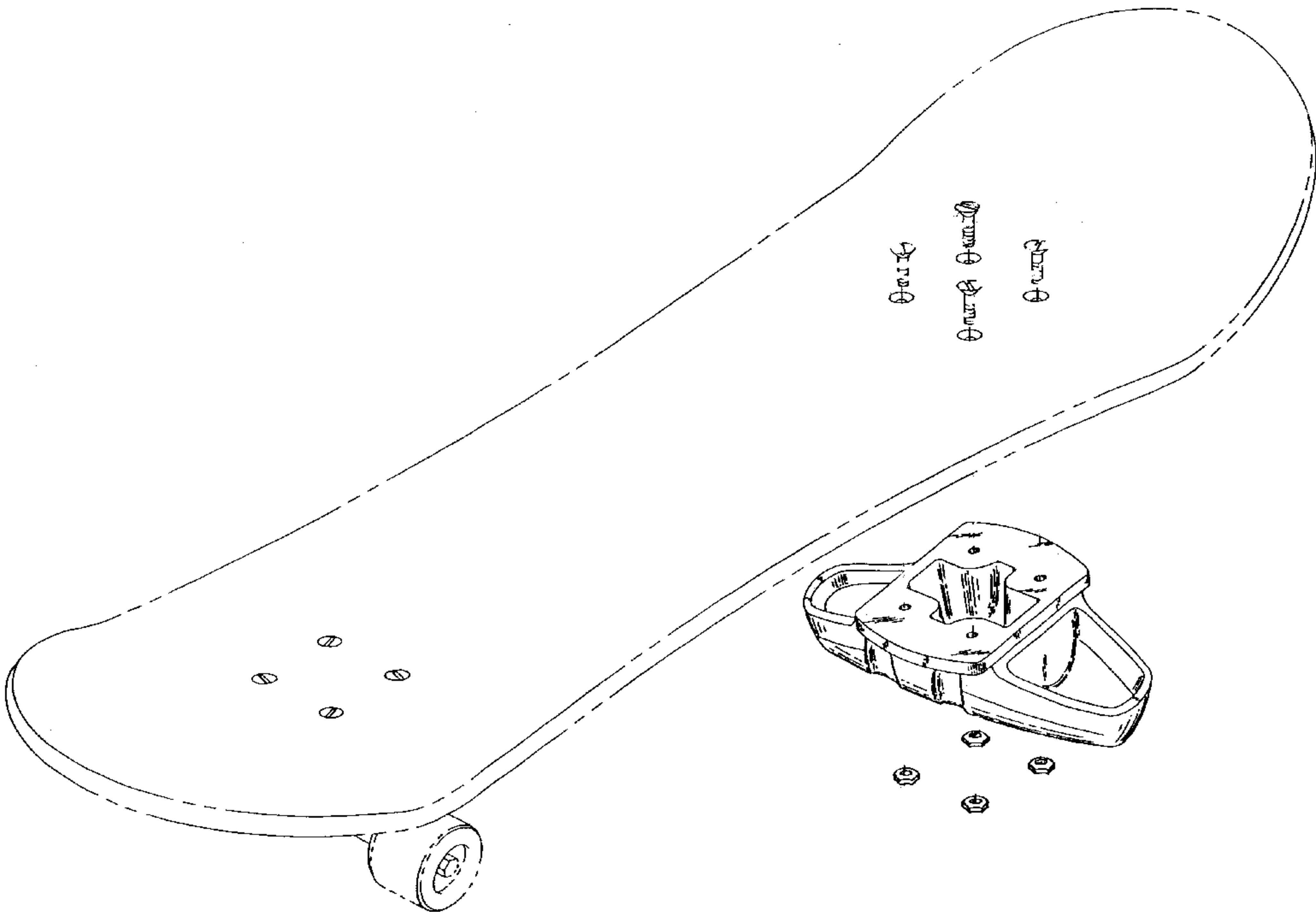
FIG. 3 is a front elevational view thereof, the rear elevation being a mirror image;

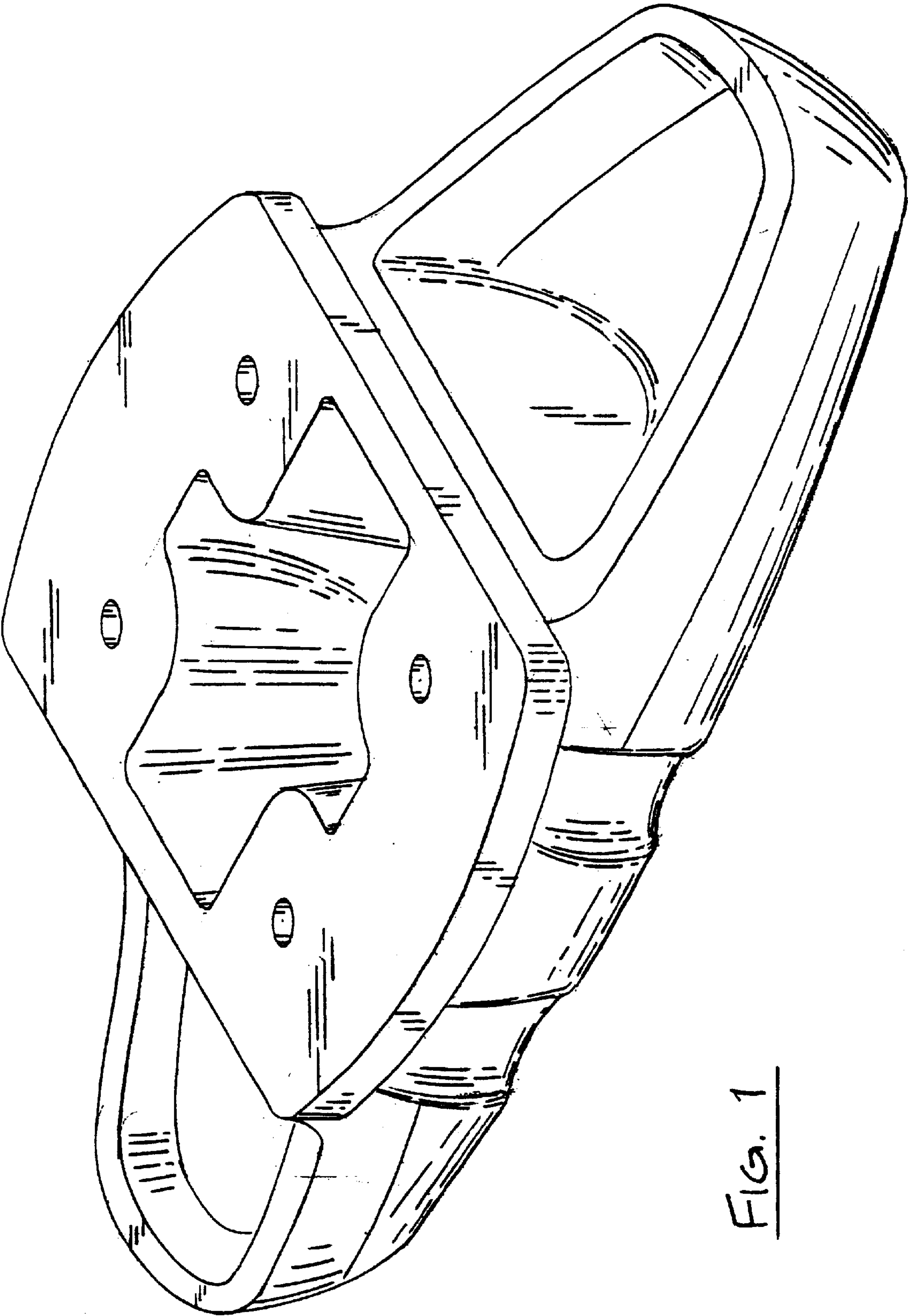

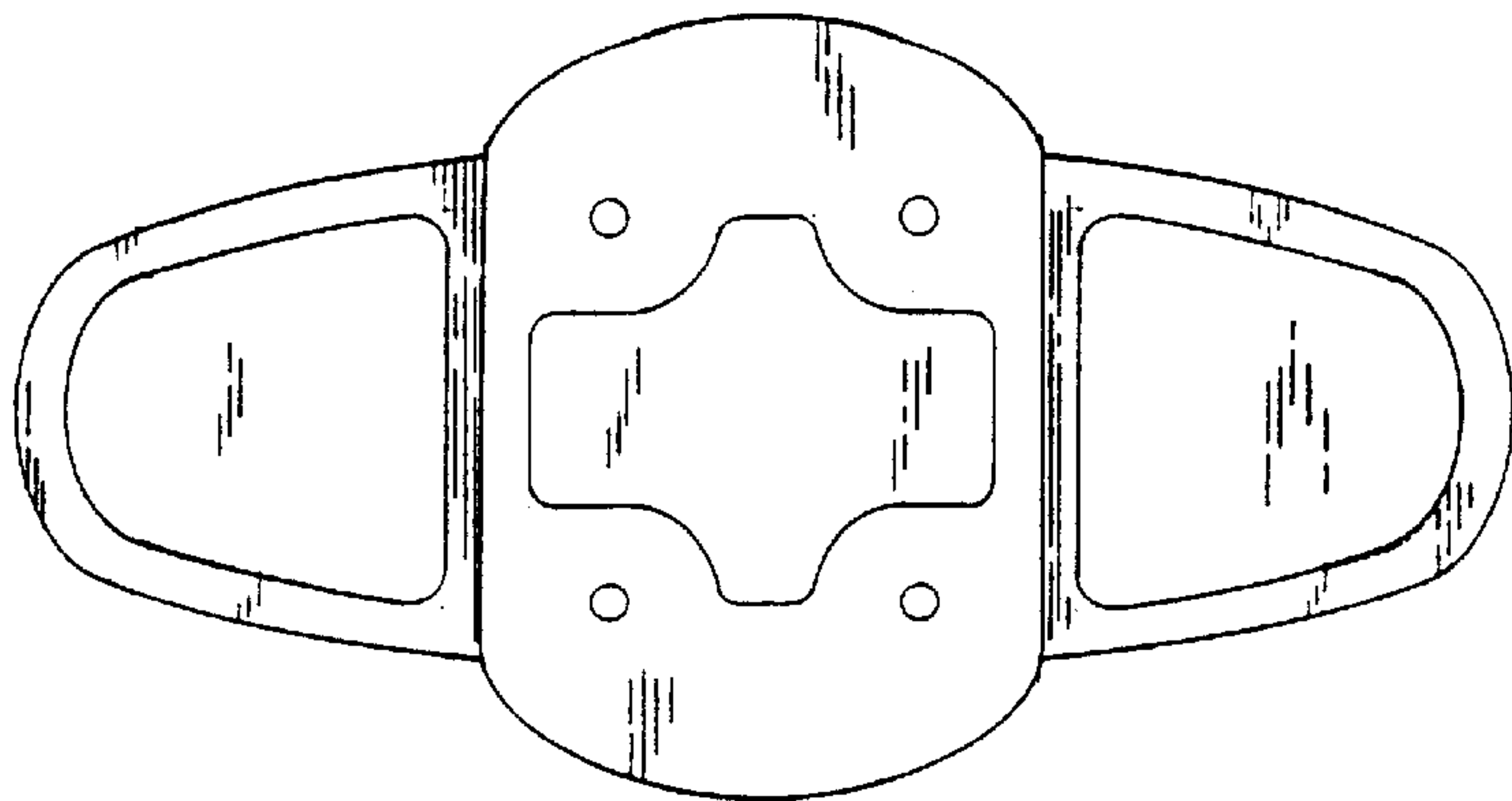

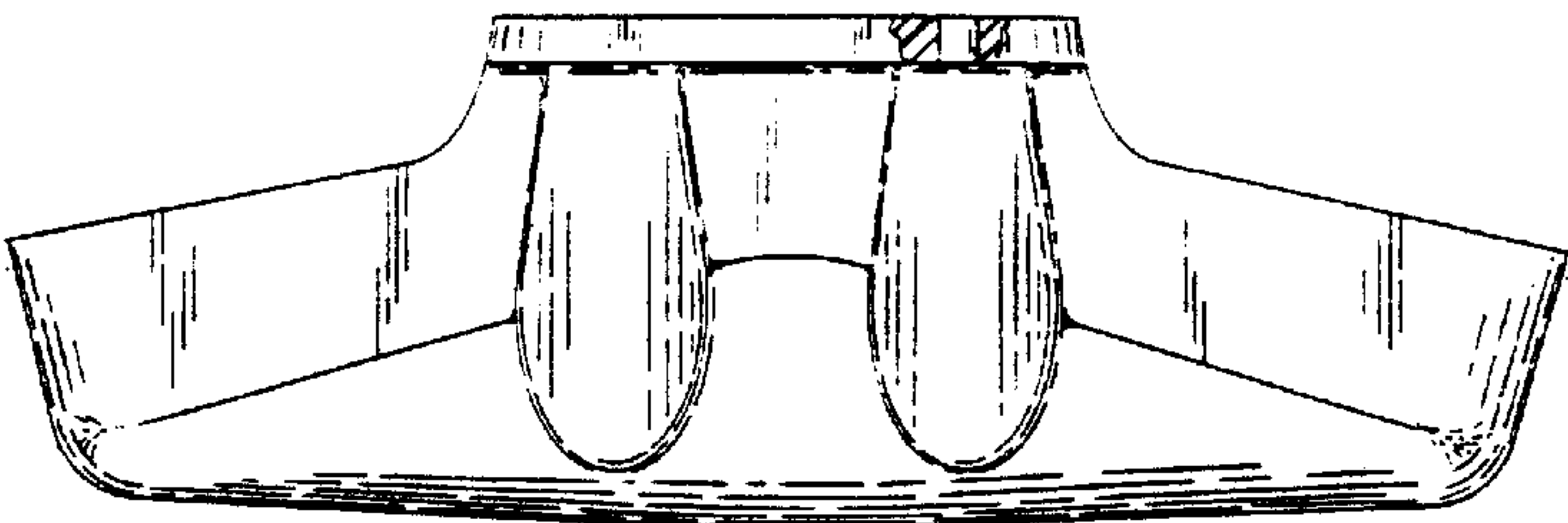

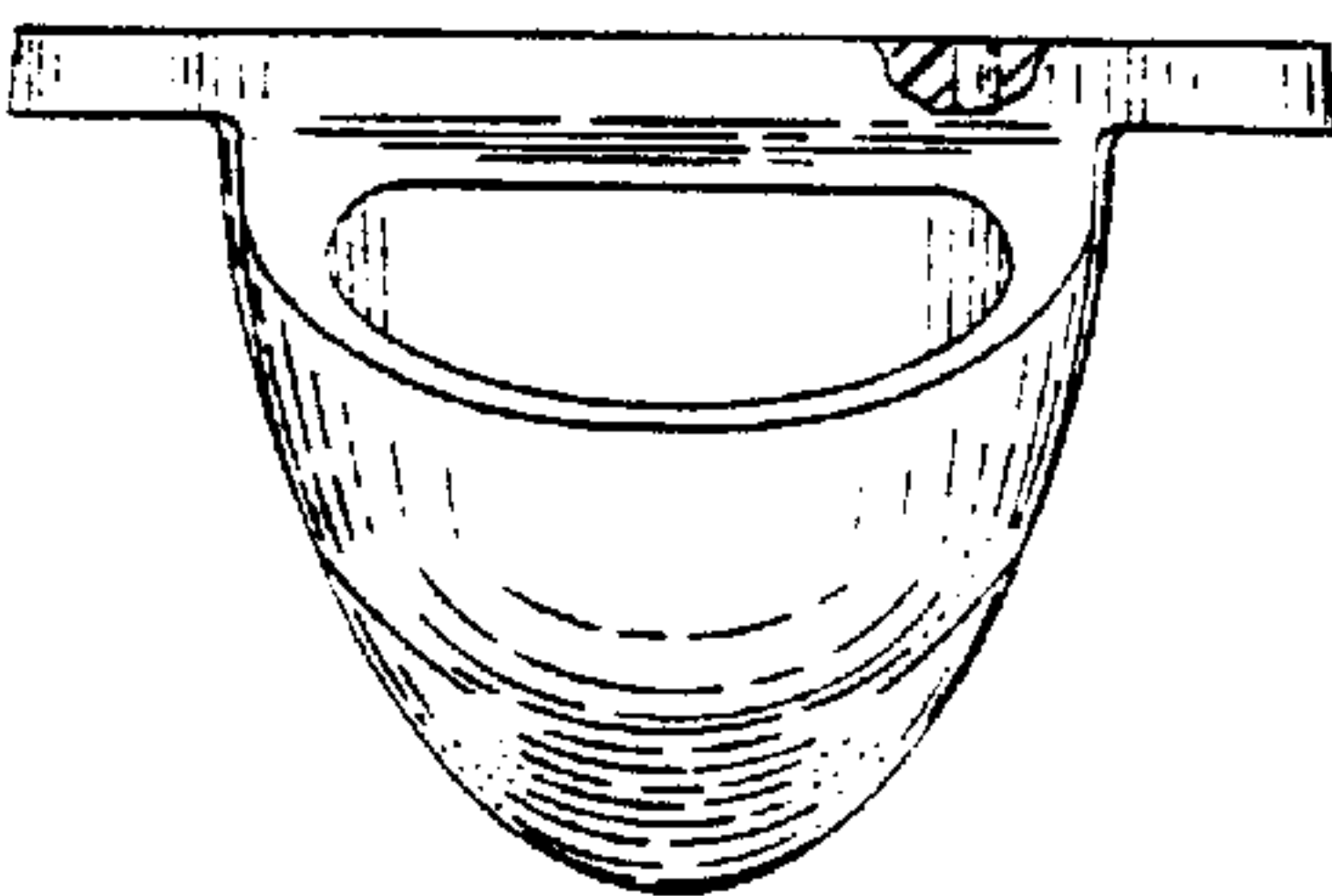

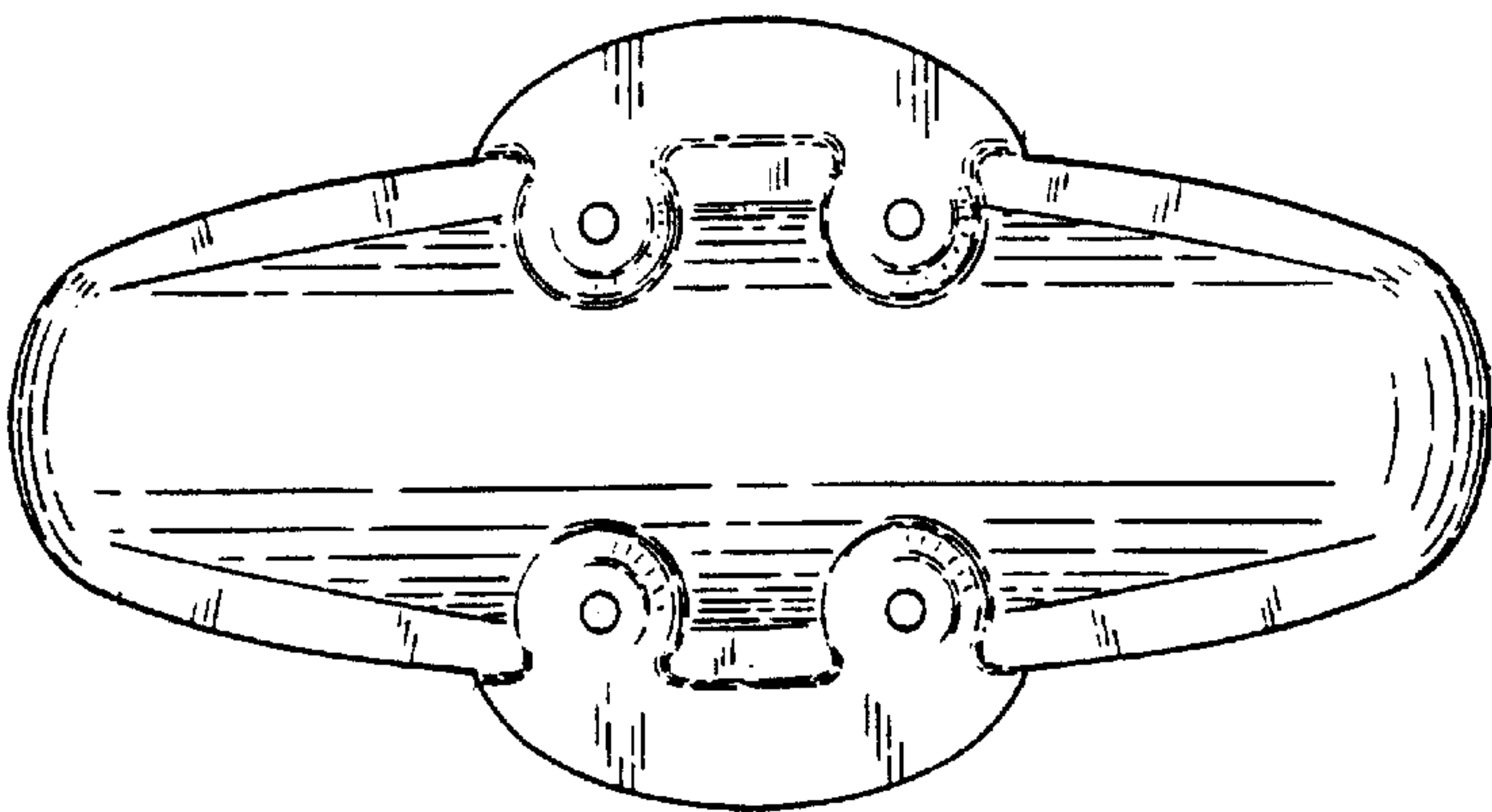

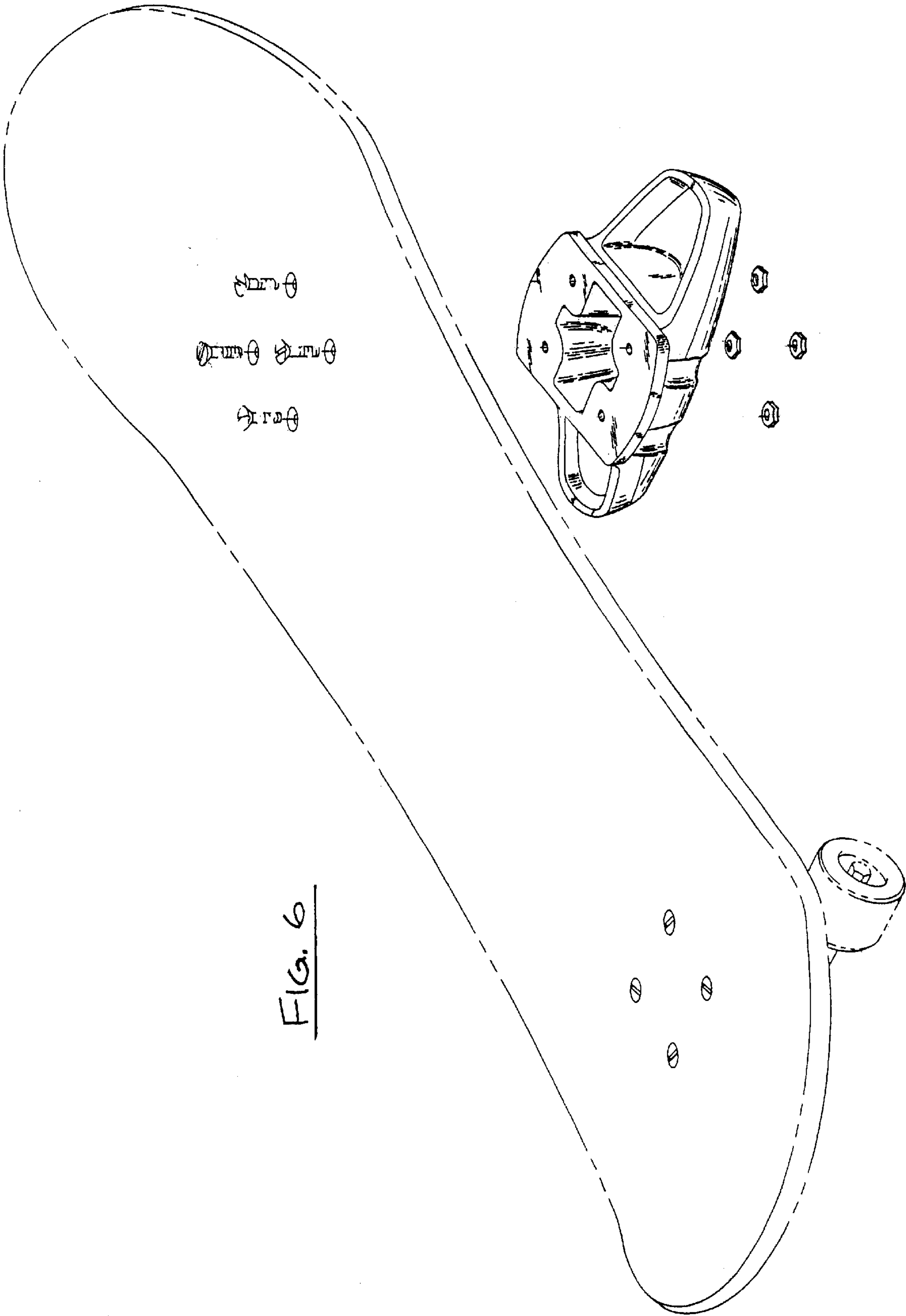
