#### (57)**CLAIM**

I claim the ornamental design for an article of jewelry, as shown and described.

## **DESCRIPTION**

A first embodiment of the invention is shown in FIGS. 1 through **6**.

FIG. 1 is a front view of an article of jewelry showing my new design.

FIG. 2 is a back view of the article of jewelry illustrated in FIG. 1, which also shows one location for an attachment means, for use of the article of jewelry as a pin or an earring, in dotted lines depicting environment and not part of the claimed design.

FIG. 3 is a left view of the article of jewelry illustrated in FIG. 1.

FIG. 4 is a right view of the article of jewelry illustrated in FIG. 1.

FIG. 5 is a top view of the article of jewelry illustrated in FIG. 1.

FIG. 6 is a bottom view of the jewelry illustrated in FIG. 1.

A second embodiment of the invention is shown in FIGS. 7 through 12.

FIG. 7 is a front view of an article of jewelry showing my new design.

FIG. 8 is a back view of the article of jewelry illustrated in FIG. 7, which also shows one location for an attachment means, for use of the article of jewelry as a pin or an earring, in dotted lines depicting environment and not part of the claimed design.


FIG. 9 is a left view of the article of jewelry illustrated in FIG. **7**.

FIG. 10 is a right view of the article of jewelry illustrated in FIG. 7.


FIG. 11 is a top view of the article of jewelry illustrated in FIG. **7**; and,


FIG. 12 is a bottom view of the article of jewelry illustrated in FIG. 7.



















