FIG. 6 is a bottom view;

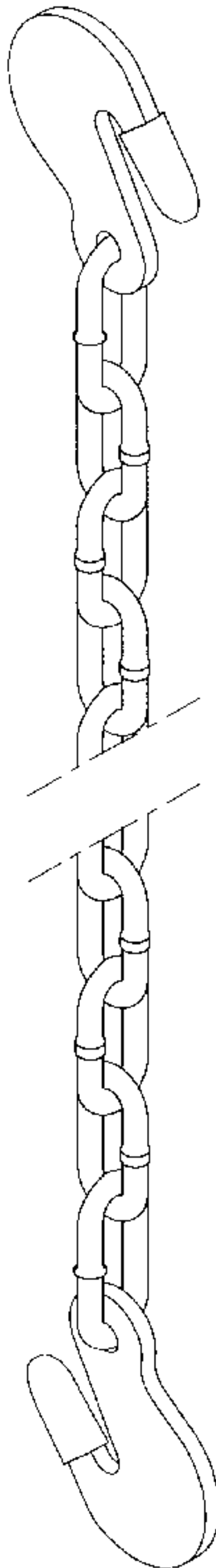
FIG. 7 is a perspective view; and,

The chain is shown broken-away in the enlarged views for convenience of illustration.

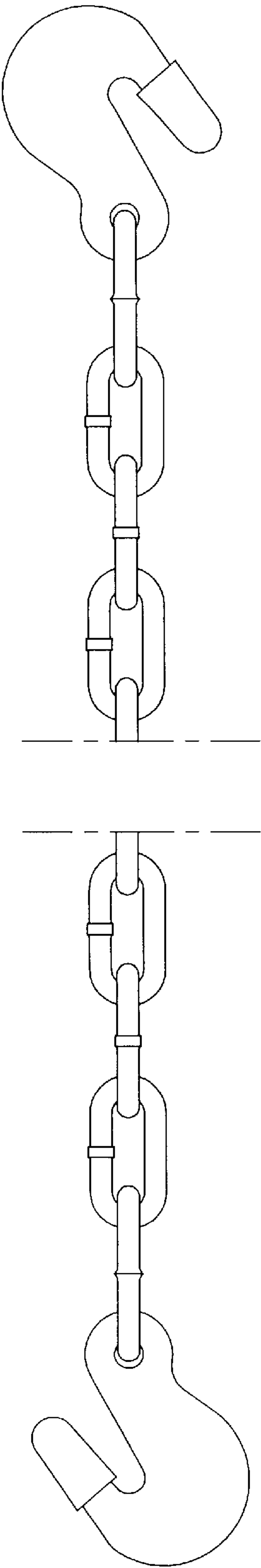

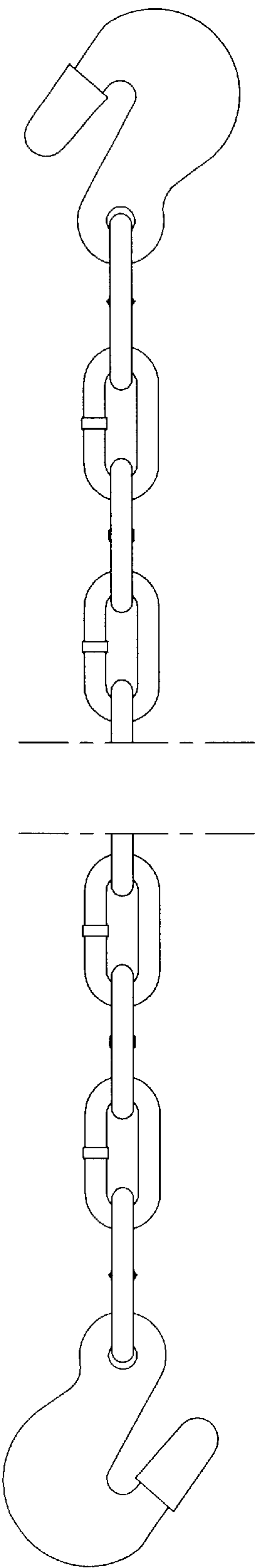
Front view

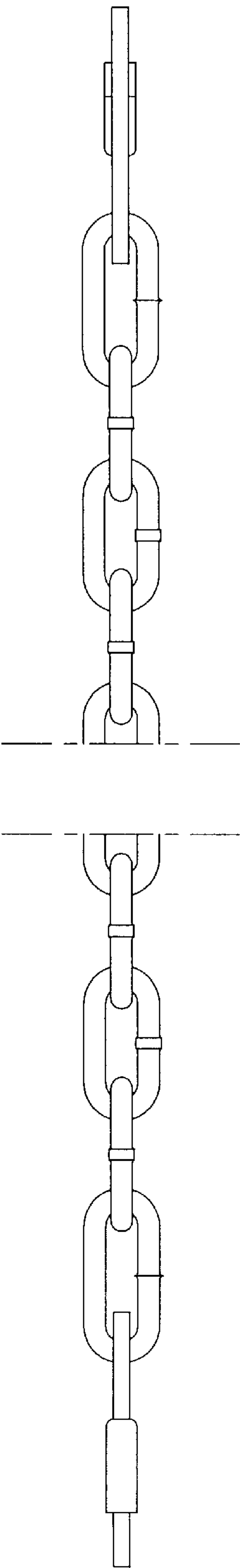
Back view

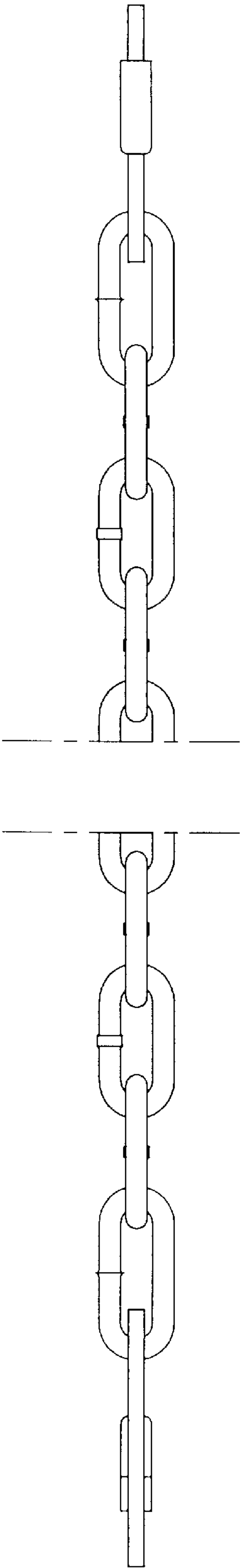
Left side view

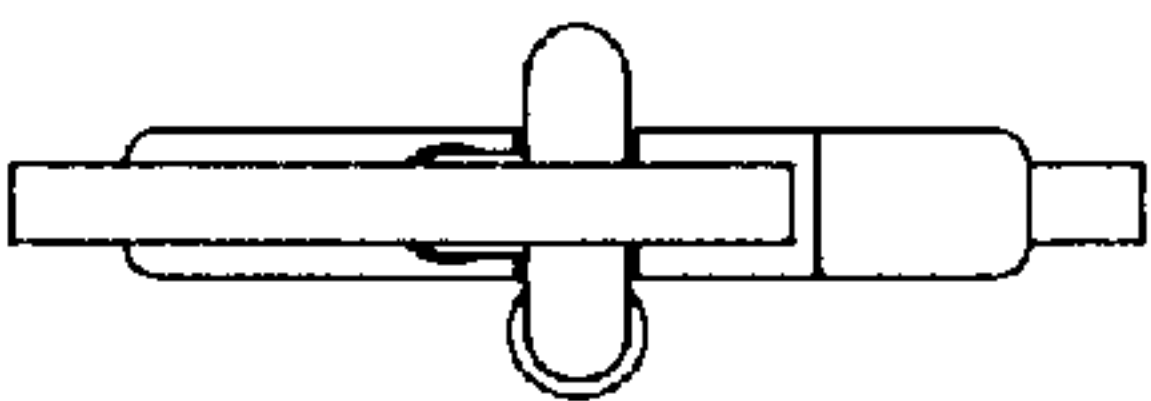
Right side view

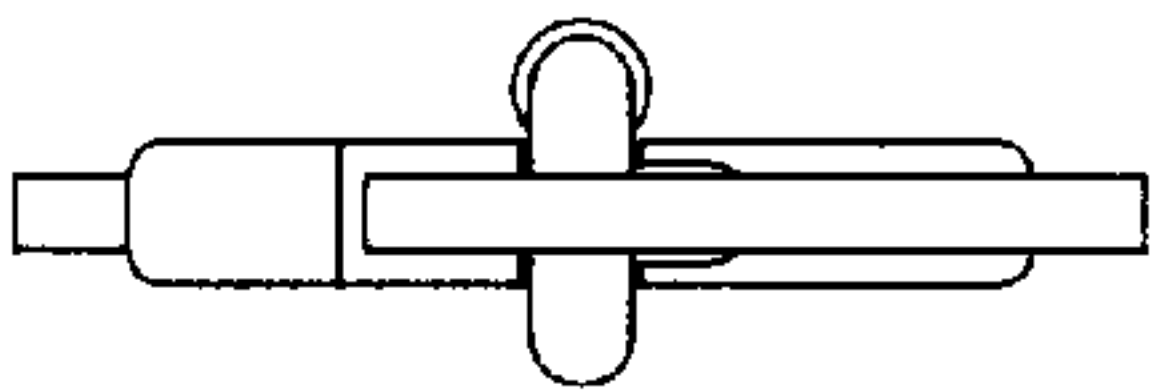
Plane view

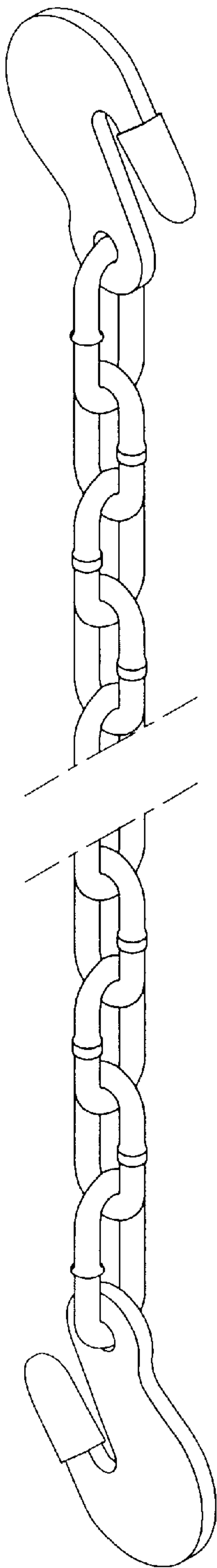
Bottom view
