FIG. 3 is a front elevation view thereof.

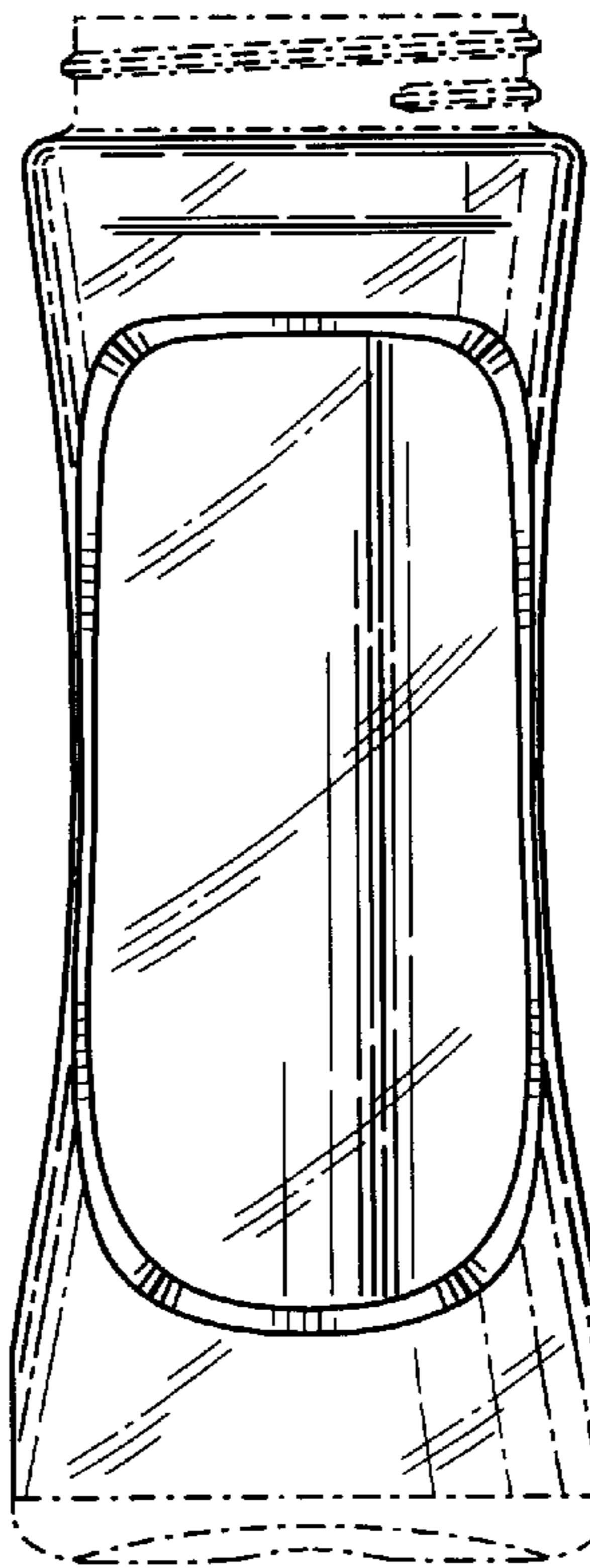
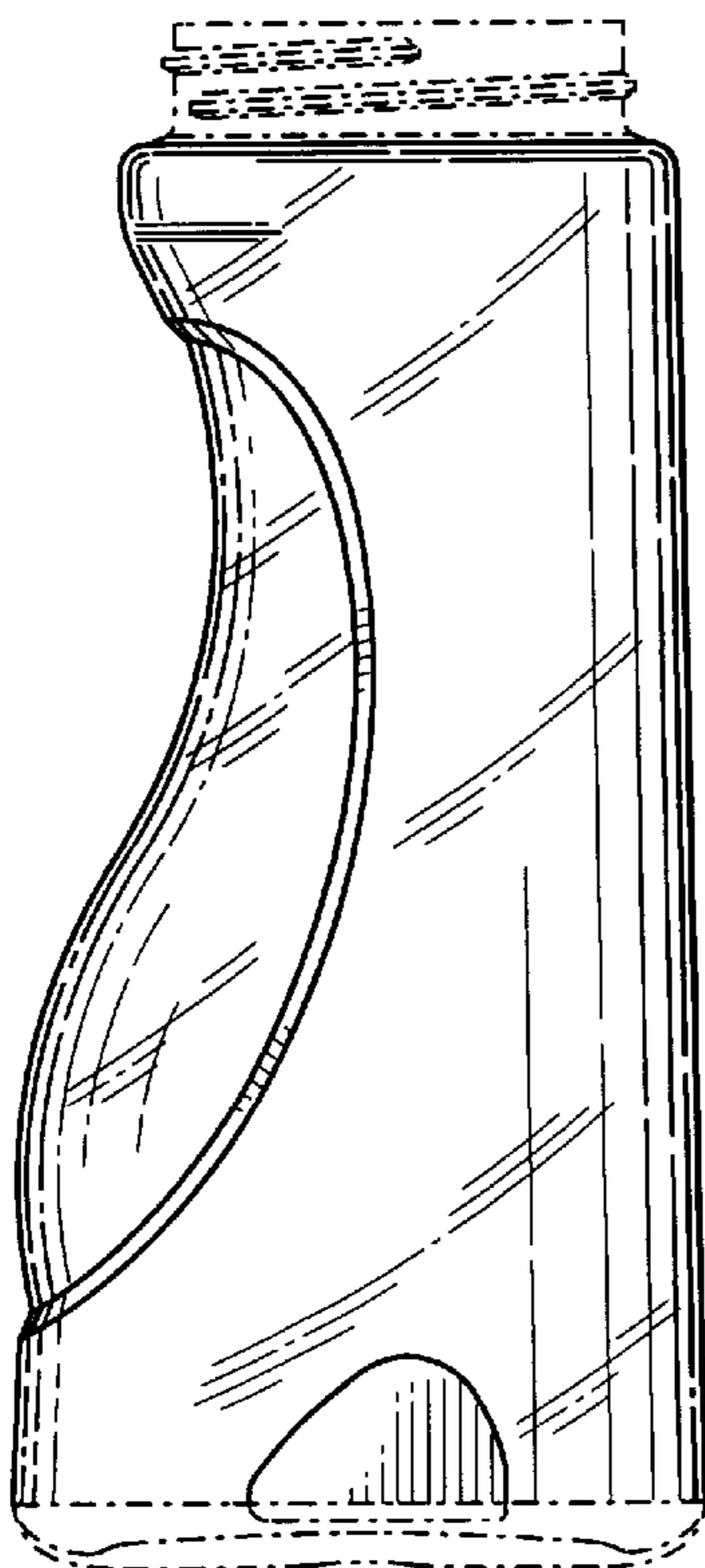
FIG. 4 is a back elevation view thereof.

FIG. 5 is a top plan view thereof; and,

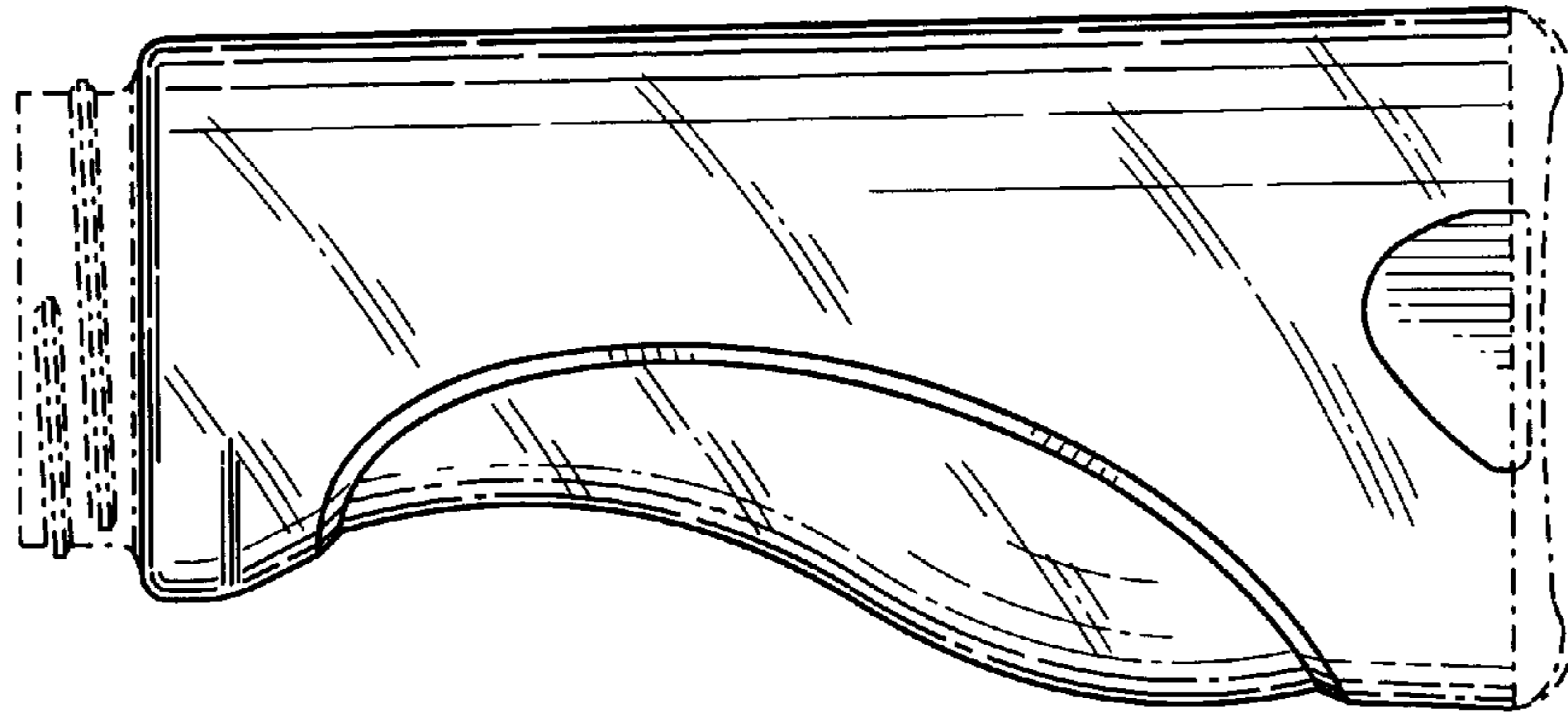
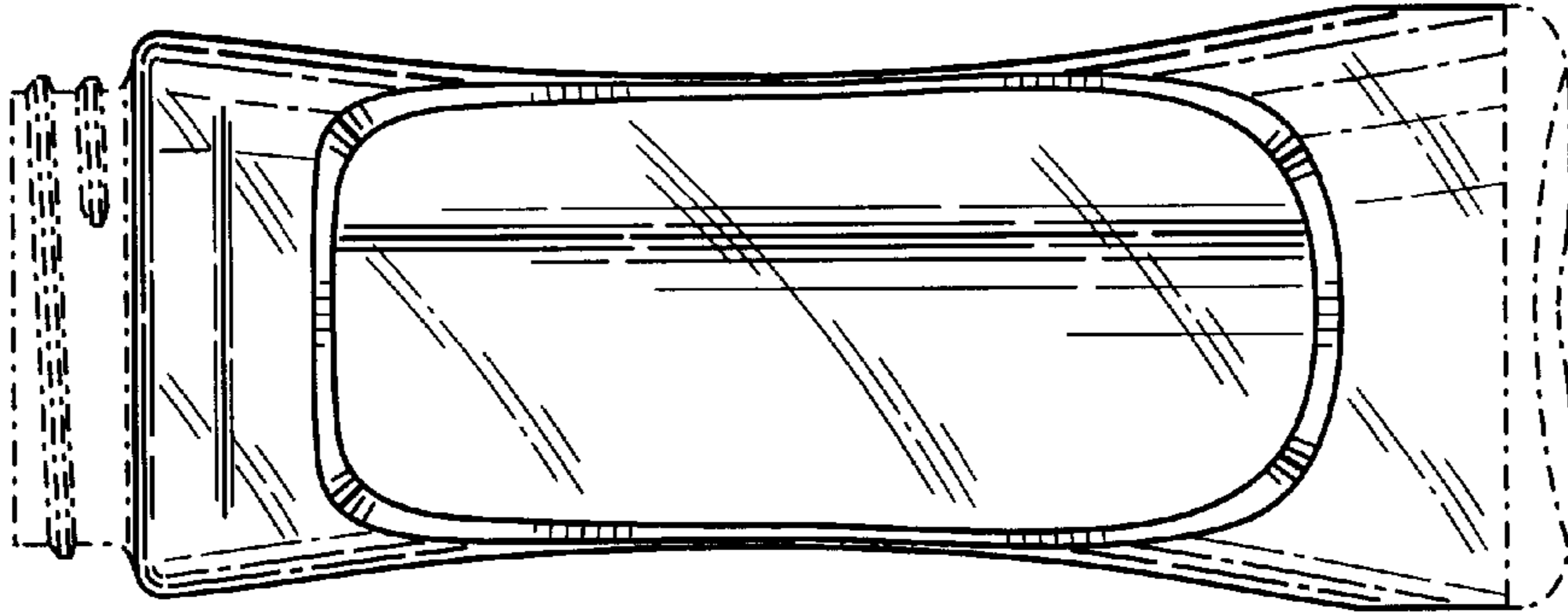
FIG. 6 is a bottom plan view thereof.

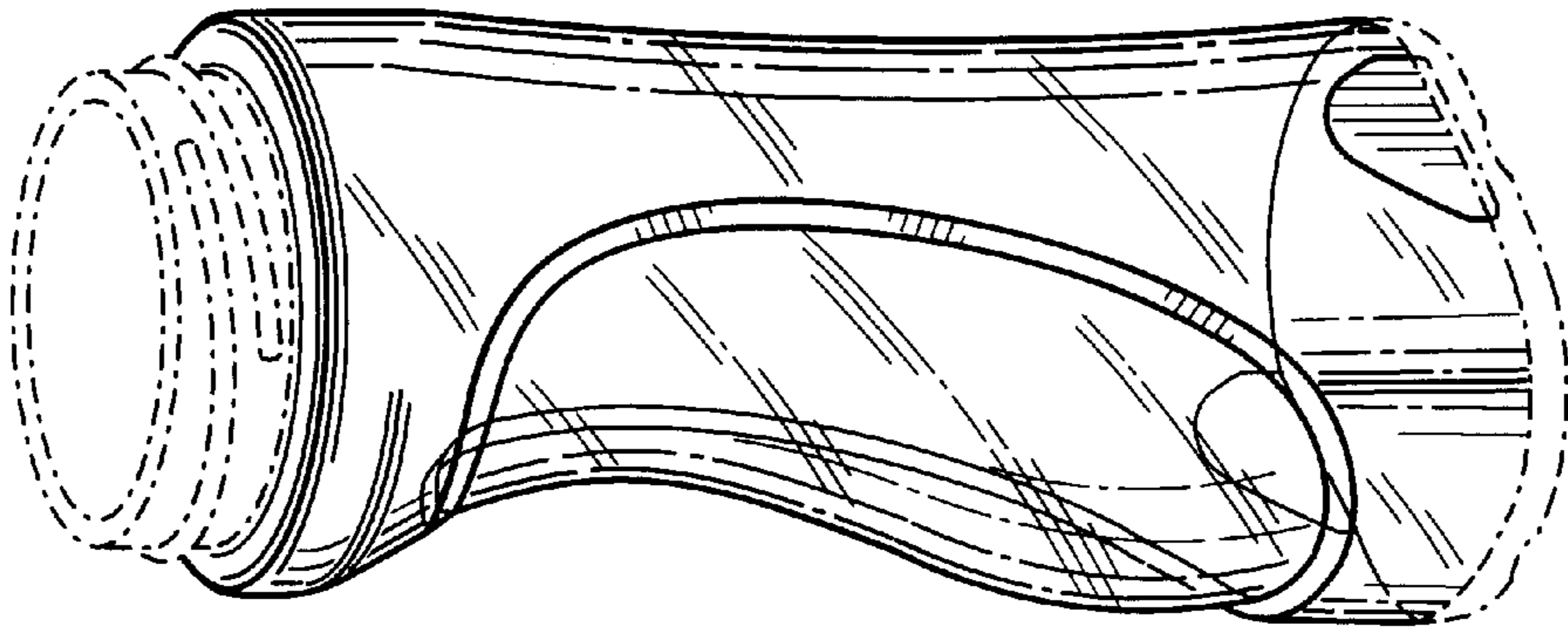

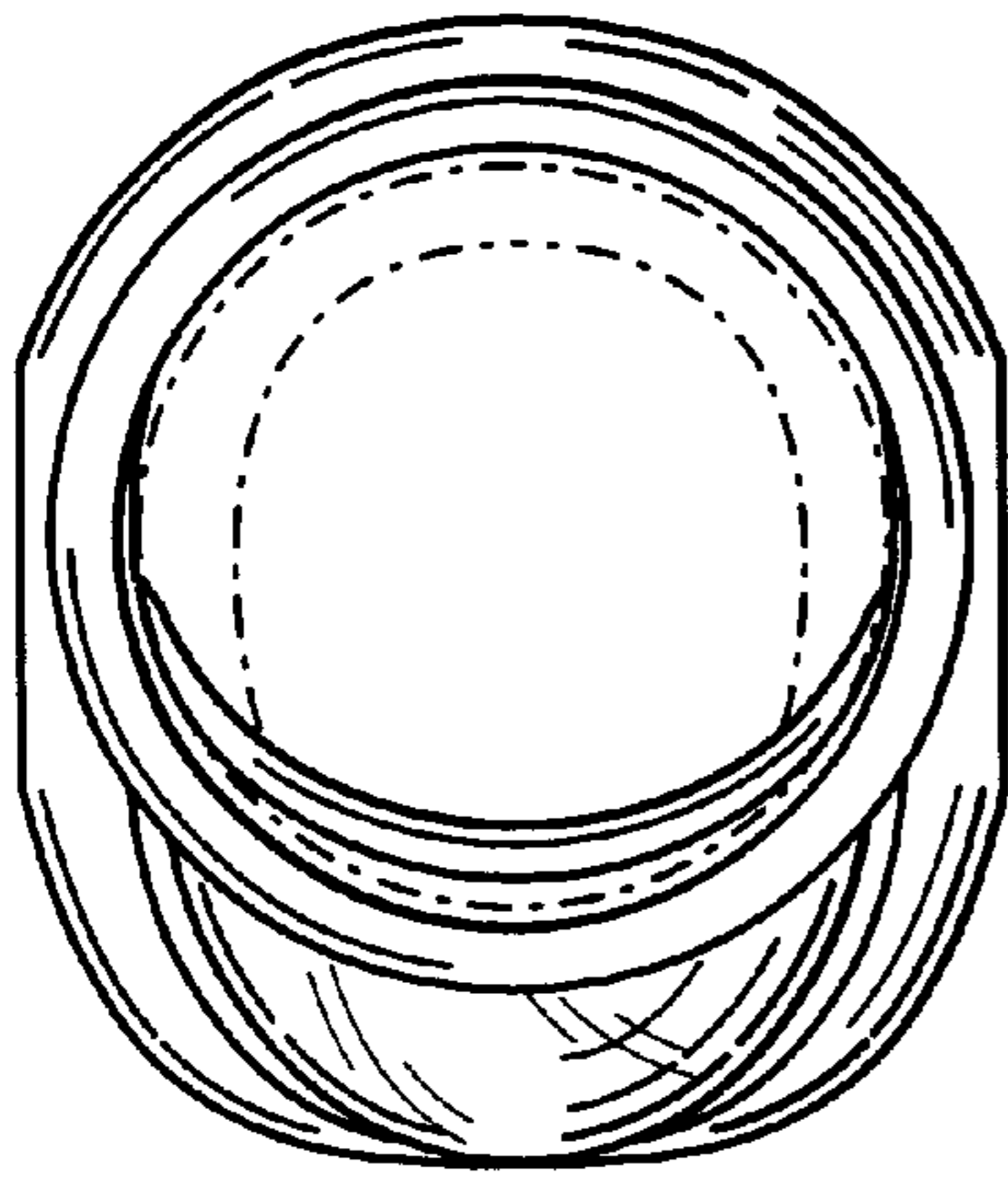

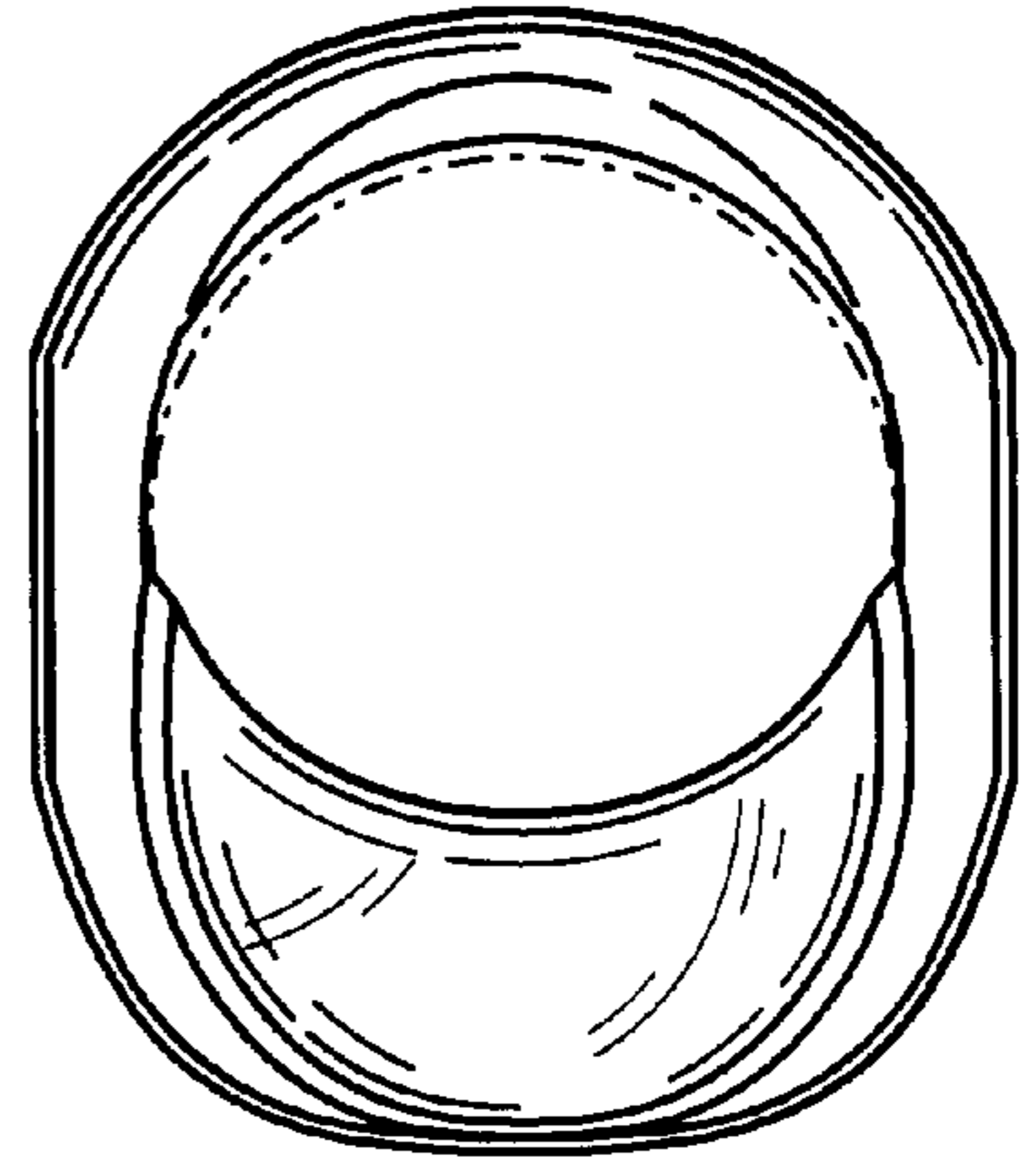

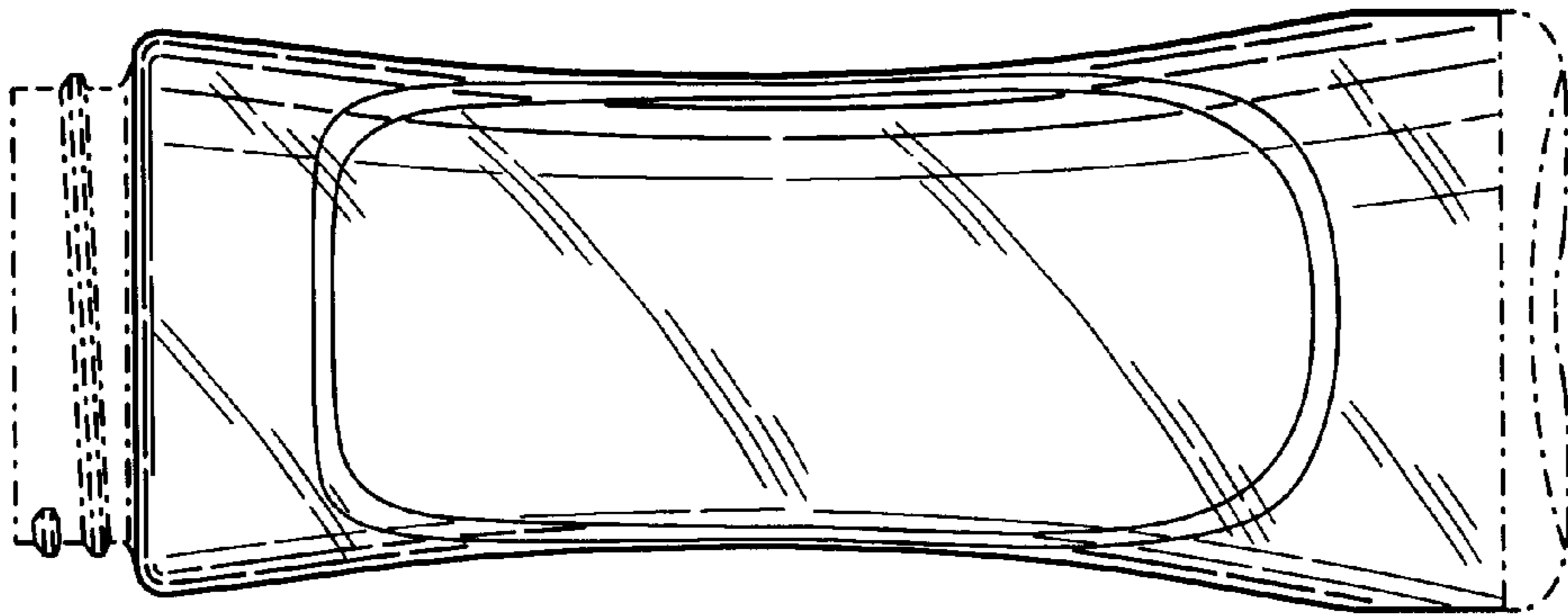
