The ornamental design for an icon for a portion of an electronic display, as shown and described.


**DESCRIPTION**


FIG. 1 is a front view of an icon for a portion of an electronic display; and,

FIG. 2 is a front view of a second embodiment thereof.


The broken line drawing of a portion of an electronic display is for illustrative purposes only and forms no part of the claimed design.
