DESCRIPTION

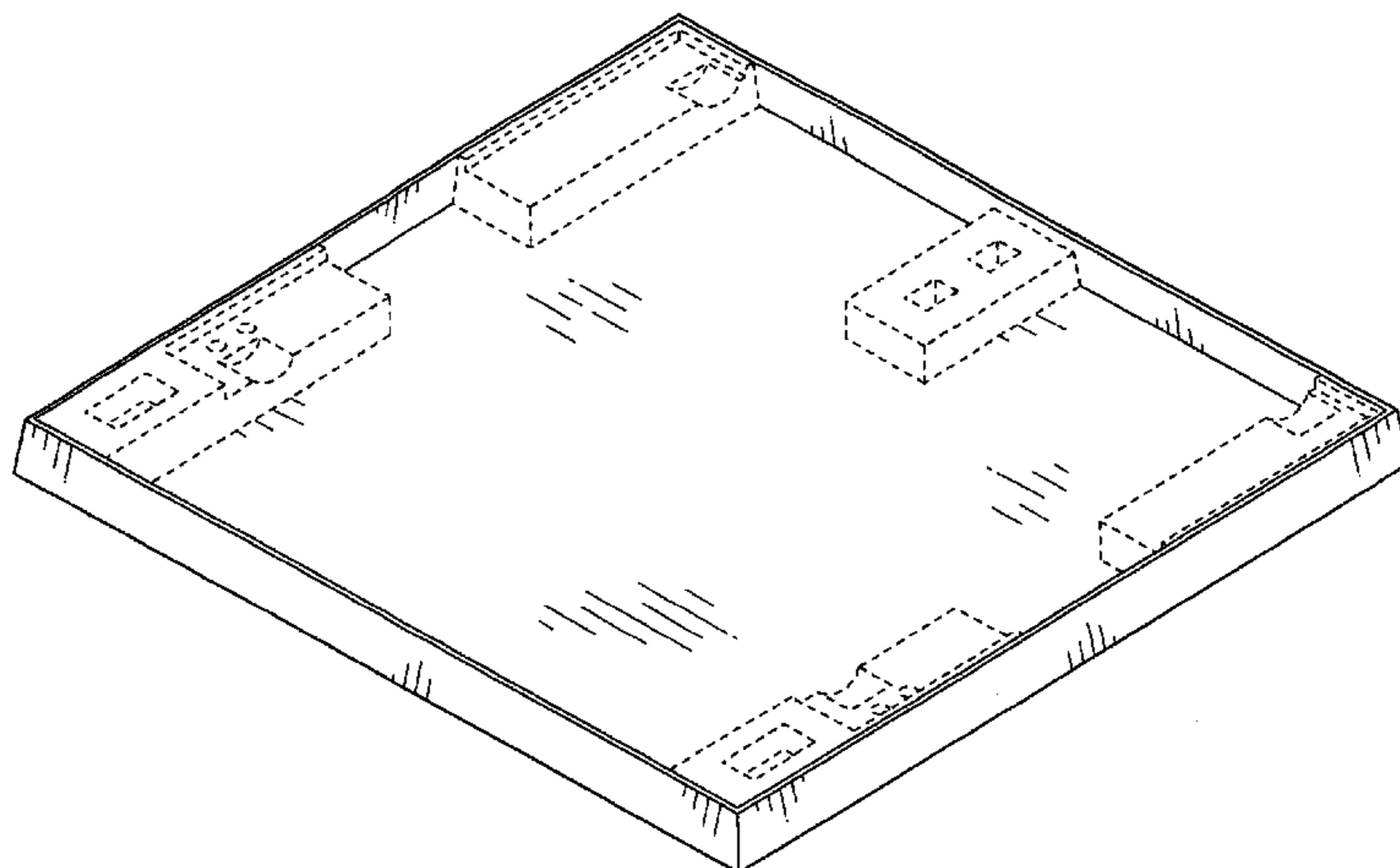
FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a shipping base pad in accordance with a first embodiment of the invention; FIG. 2 is a top view of the shipping base pad of FIG. 1; FIG. 3 is a front end view of the shipping base pad of FIG. 1; FIG. 4 is a bottom view of the shipping base pad of FIG. 1; FIG. 5 is a side end view of the shipping base pad of FIG. 1; FIG. 6 is a perspective view of a shipping base pad in accordance with a second embodiment of the invention; FIG. 7 is a top view of the shipping base pad of FIG. 6; FIG. 8 is a front end view of the shipping base pad of FIG. 6; FIG. 9 is a bottom view of the shipping base pad of FIG. 6; and, FIG. 10 is a side view of the shipping base pad of FIG. 6. 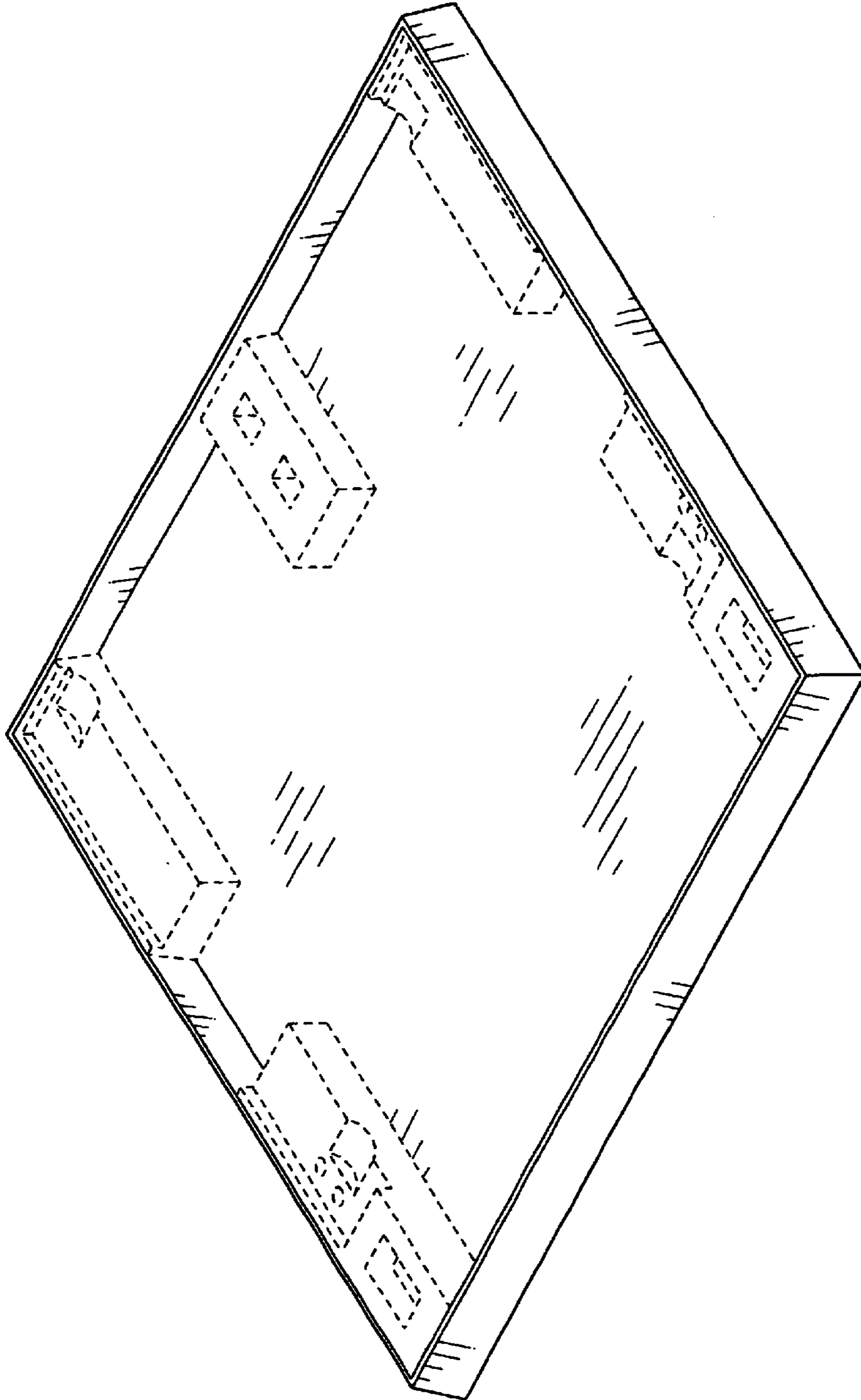

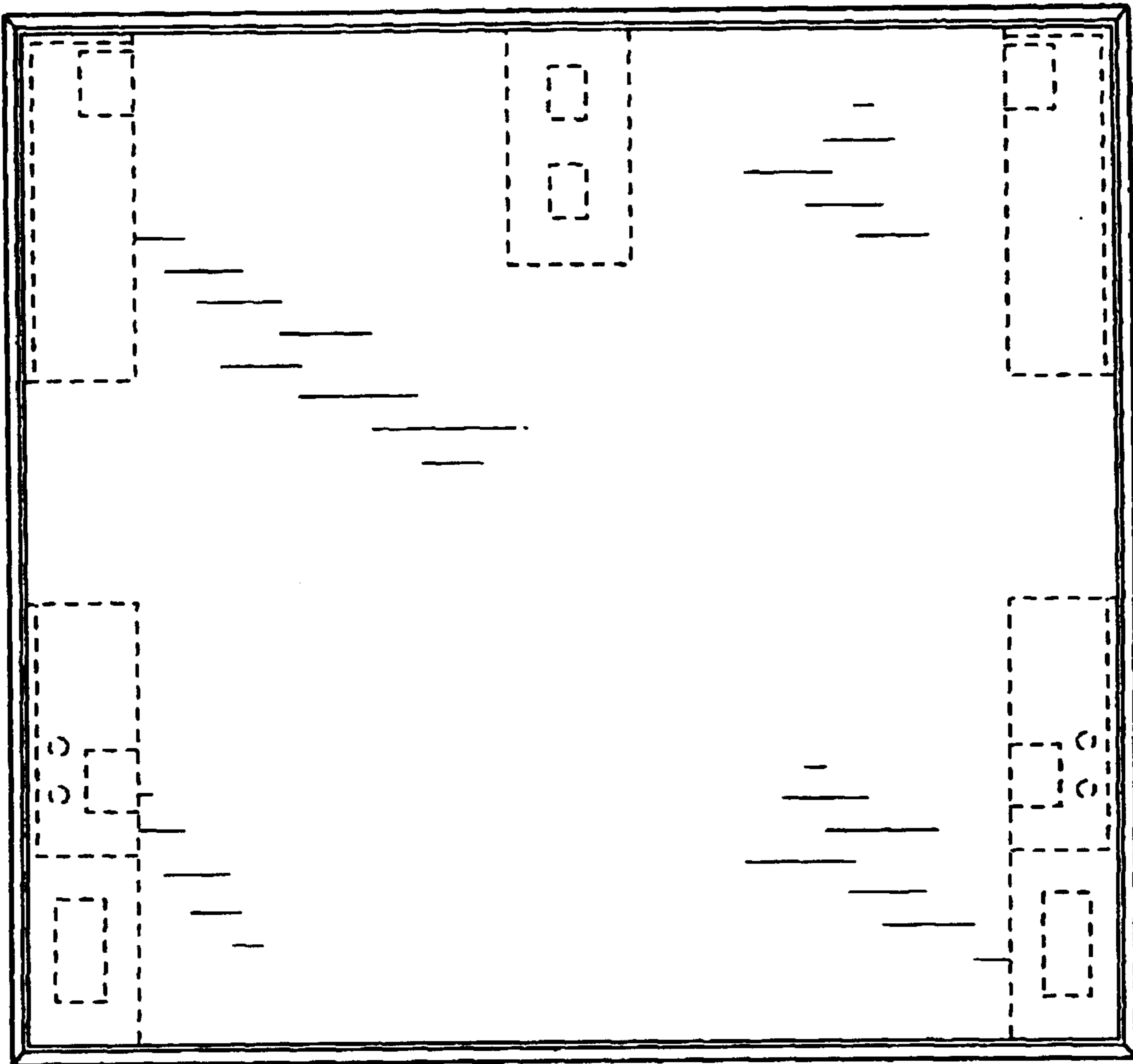

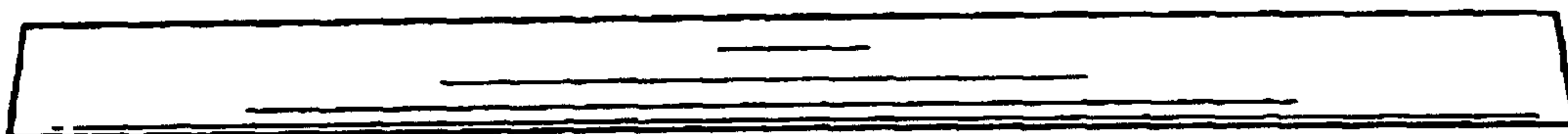

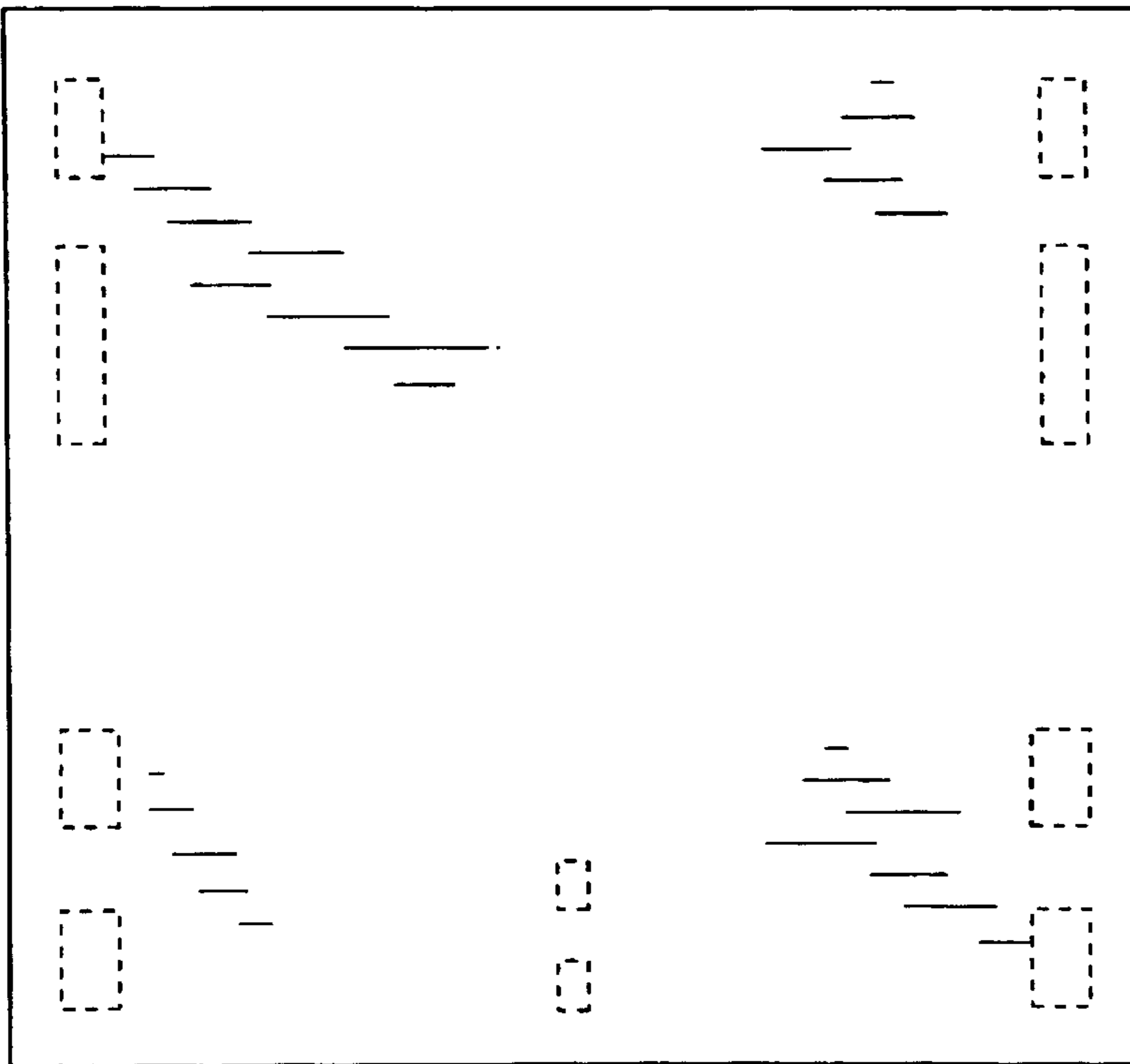

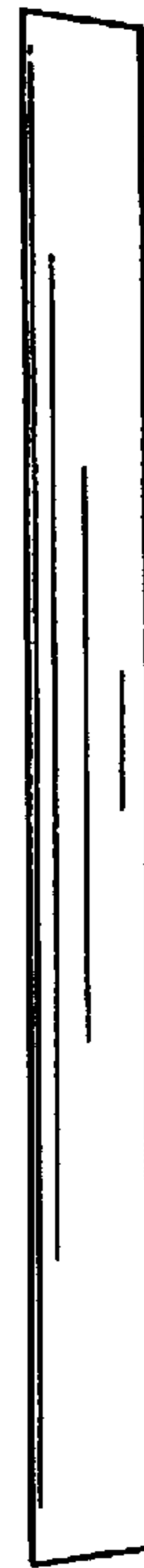

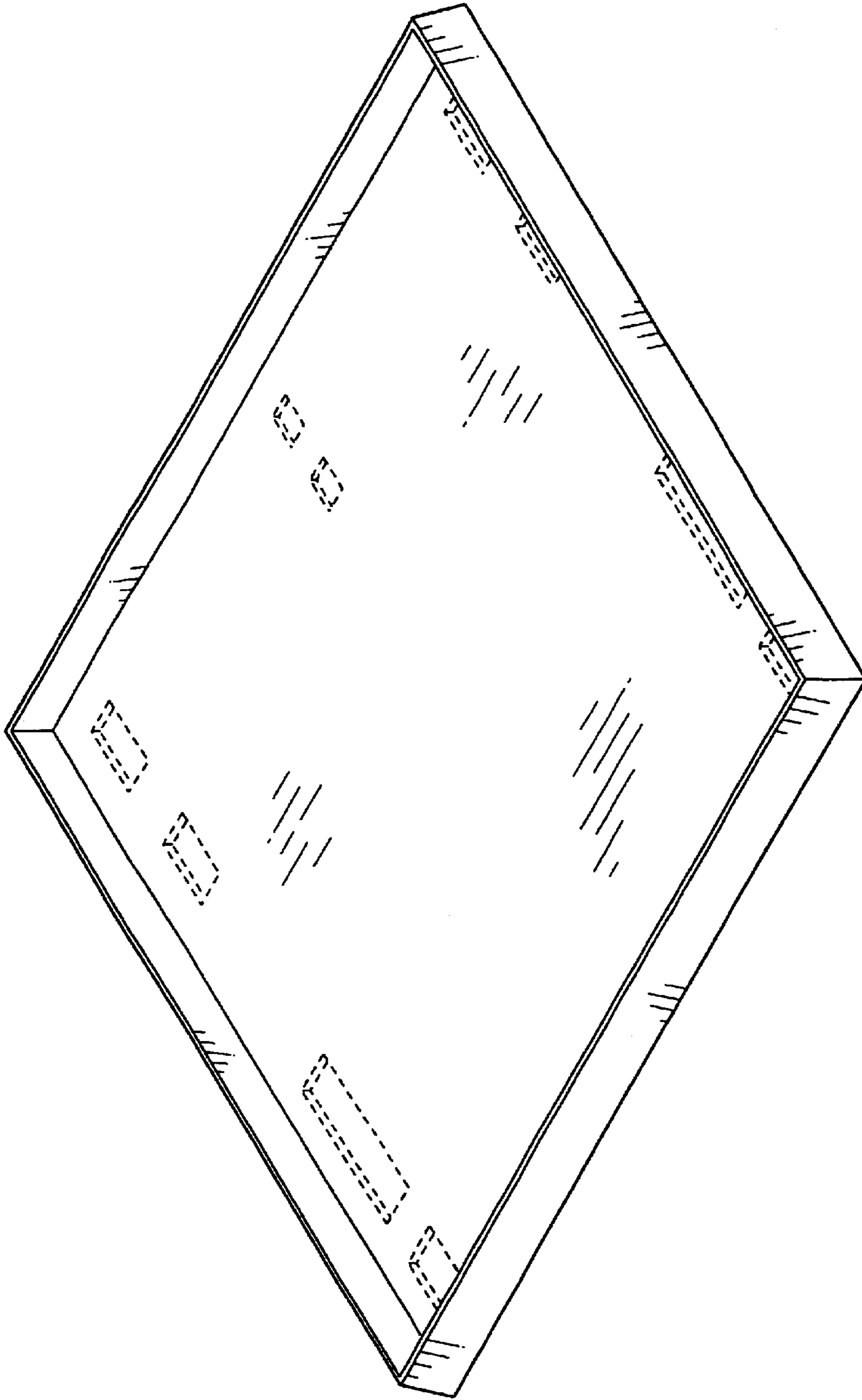

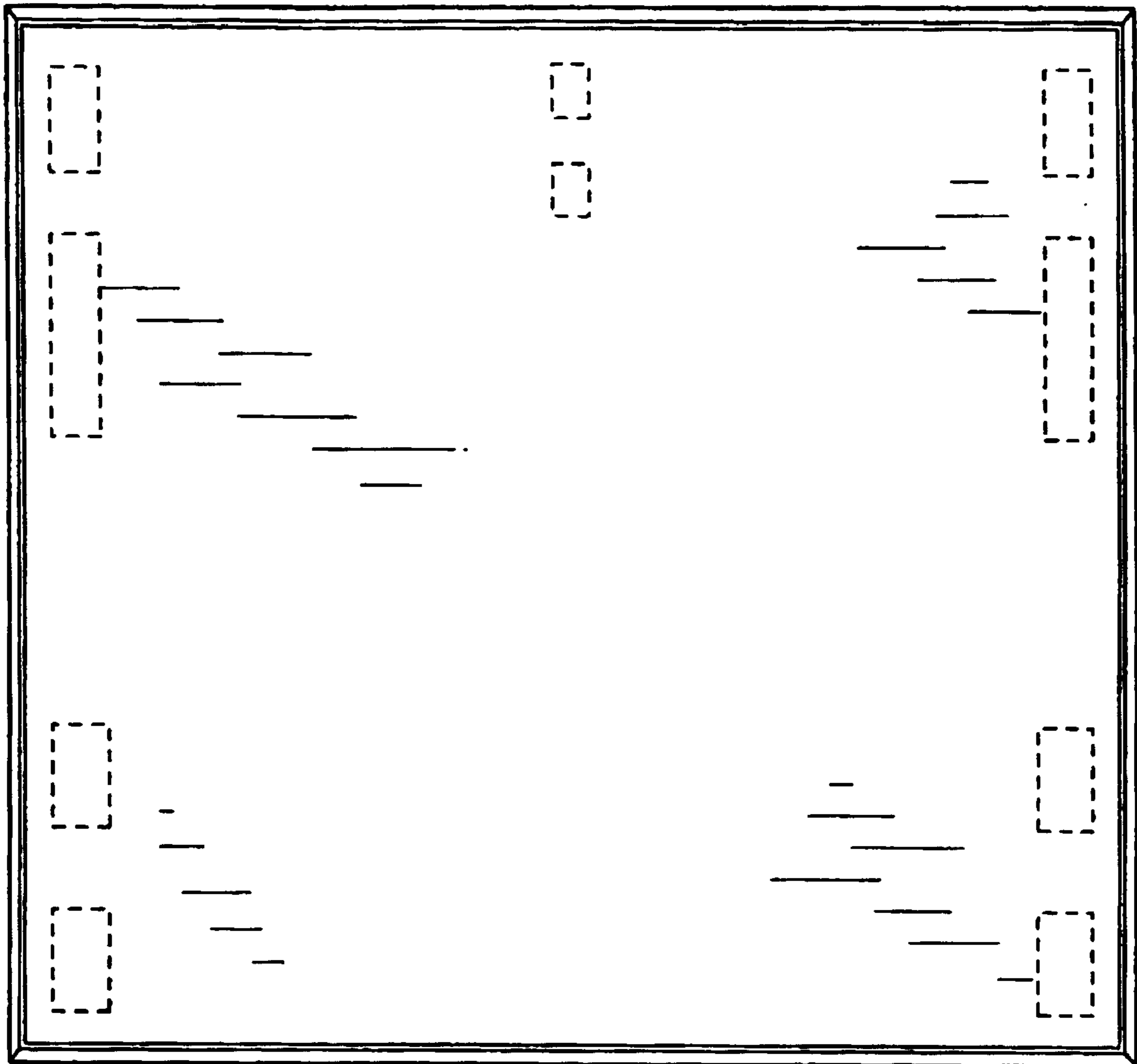

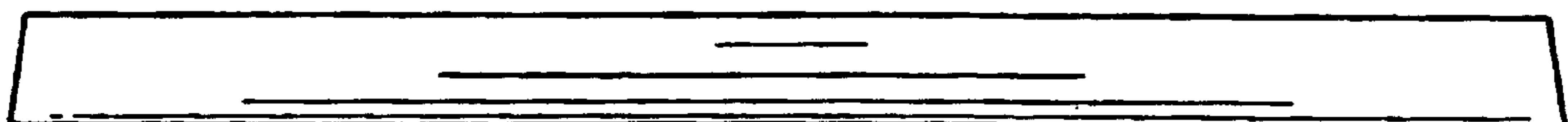

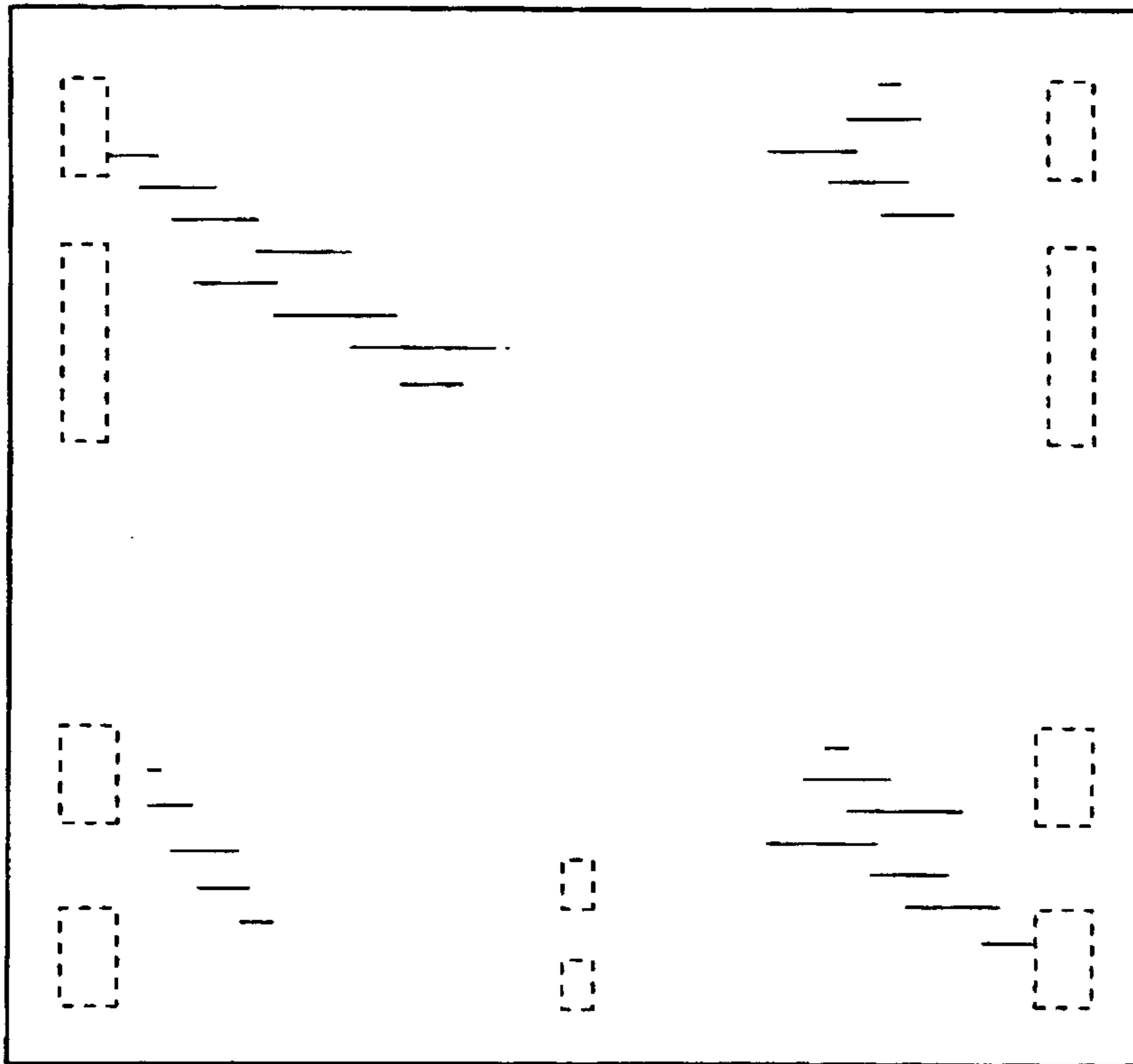
