CLAIM (57)

The ornamental design for a dresser drawer with pockets, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevation of my dresser drawer with pockets;

FIG. 2 is a side elevation as viewed from one side of my dresser drawer with pockets;

FIG. 3 is a side elevation of my dresser drawer with pockets as viewed from an opposite of the dresser drawer with pockets shown in FIG. 1;


FIG. 4 is a top plan view of my dresser drawer with pockets; FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view of my dresser drawer with pockets;


FIG. 6 is a rear view of my dresser drawer with pockets as shown in FIG. 1; and,









