The ornamental design for a hernia brief, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of a preferred embodiment of a hernia brief embodying the invention; and, FIG. 2 is a side elevation of the hernia brief of FIG. 1 shown on the body of a wearer depicted in broken lines. The broken lines shown on the hernia brief in the drawings are understood to represent stitching. The broken line showing of a human torso is for illustrative purposes only and forms no part of the claimed design.

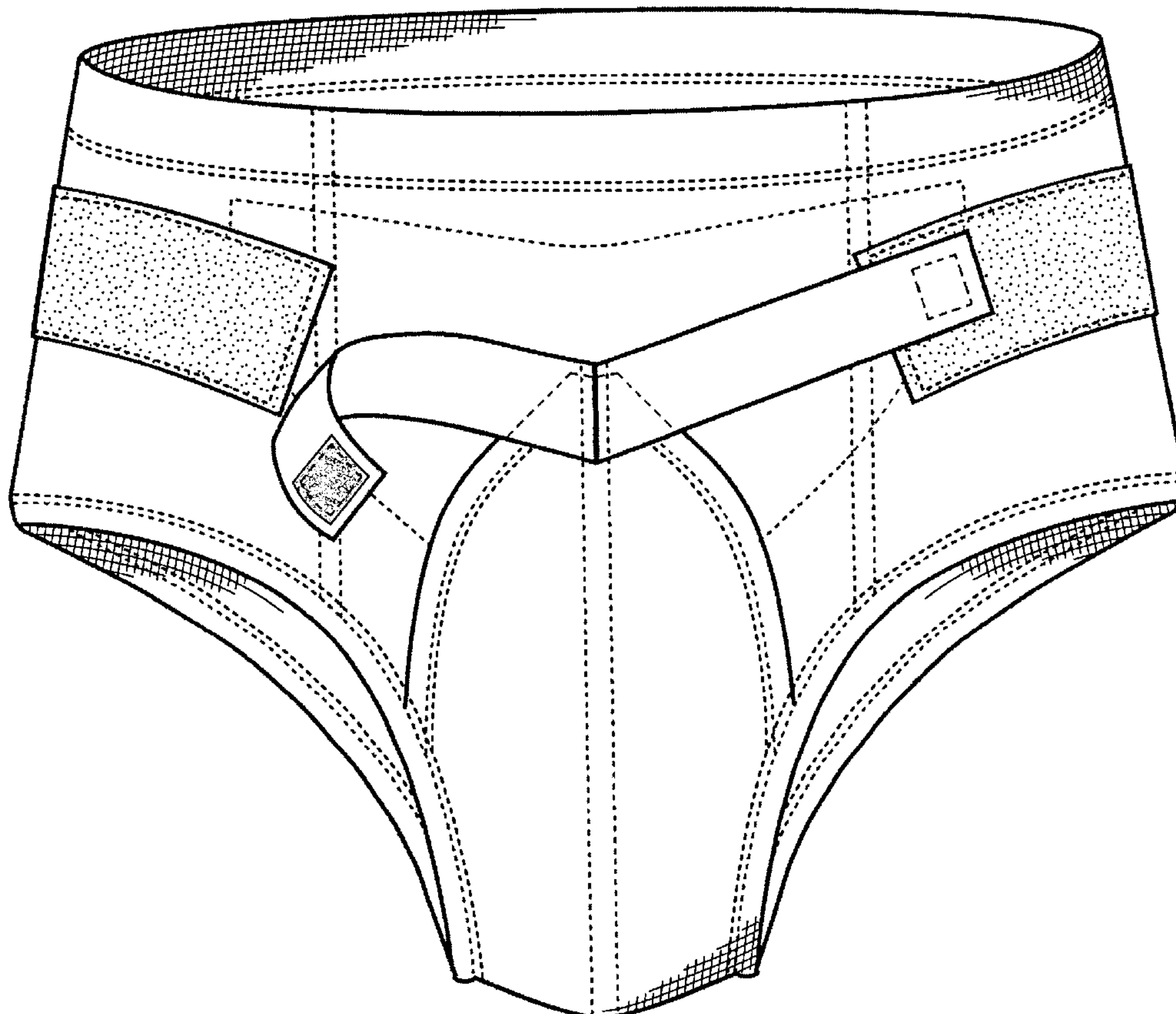

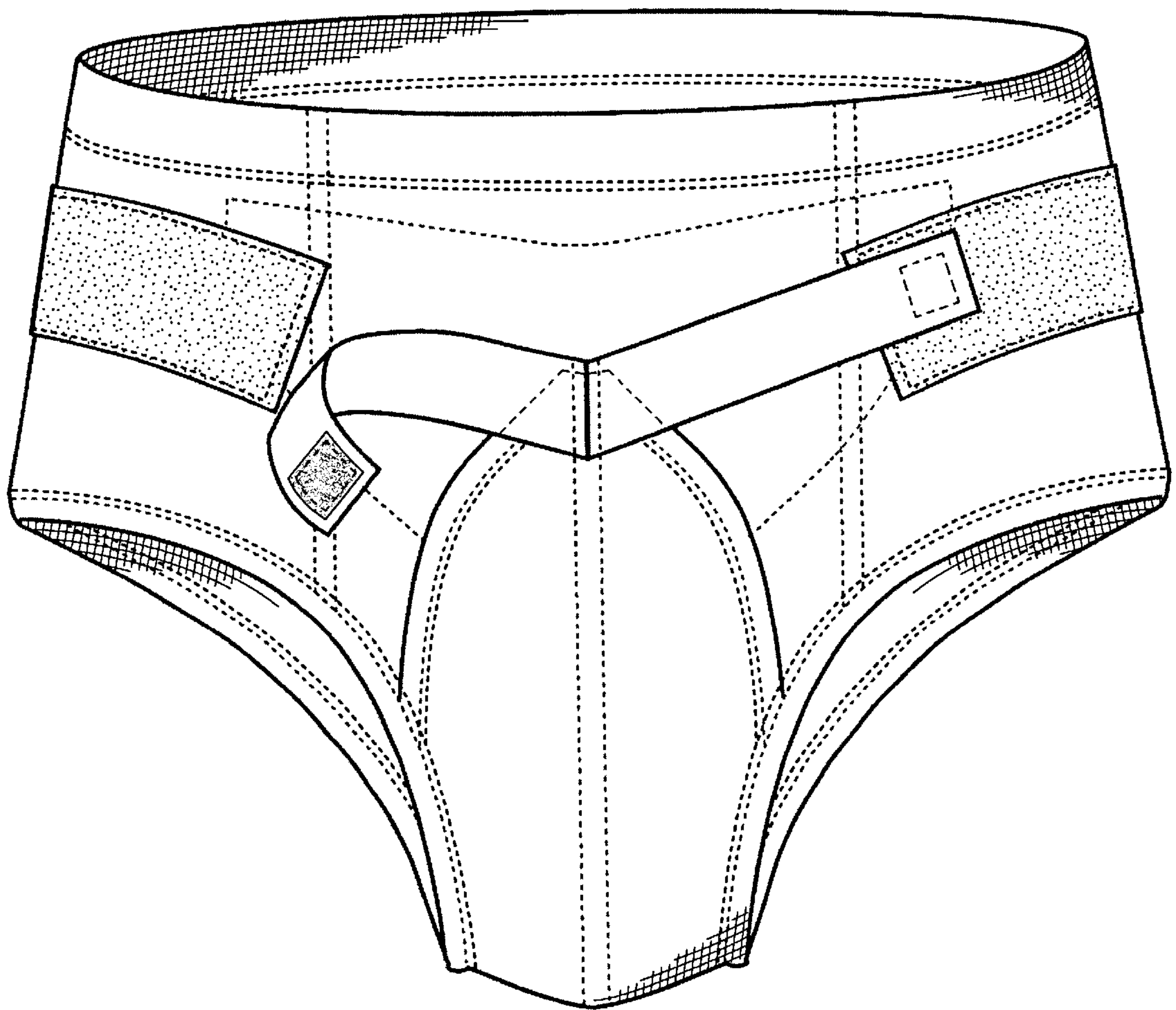
