(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a compact disc player case, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of a compact disc player case showing my new design in an open position, the broken lines depicting environment and forming no part of the claimed design;

FIG. 2 is a front elevational view of the invention illustrated in FIG. 1 in a closed position;

FIG. 3 is a rear elevational view of the invention illustrated in FIG. 1;

FIG. 4 is a rear elevational view of the invention illustrated in FIG. 1;

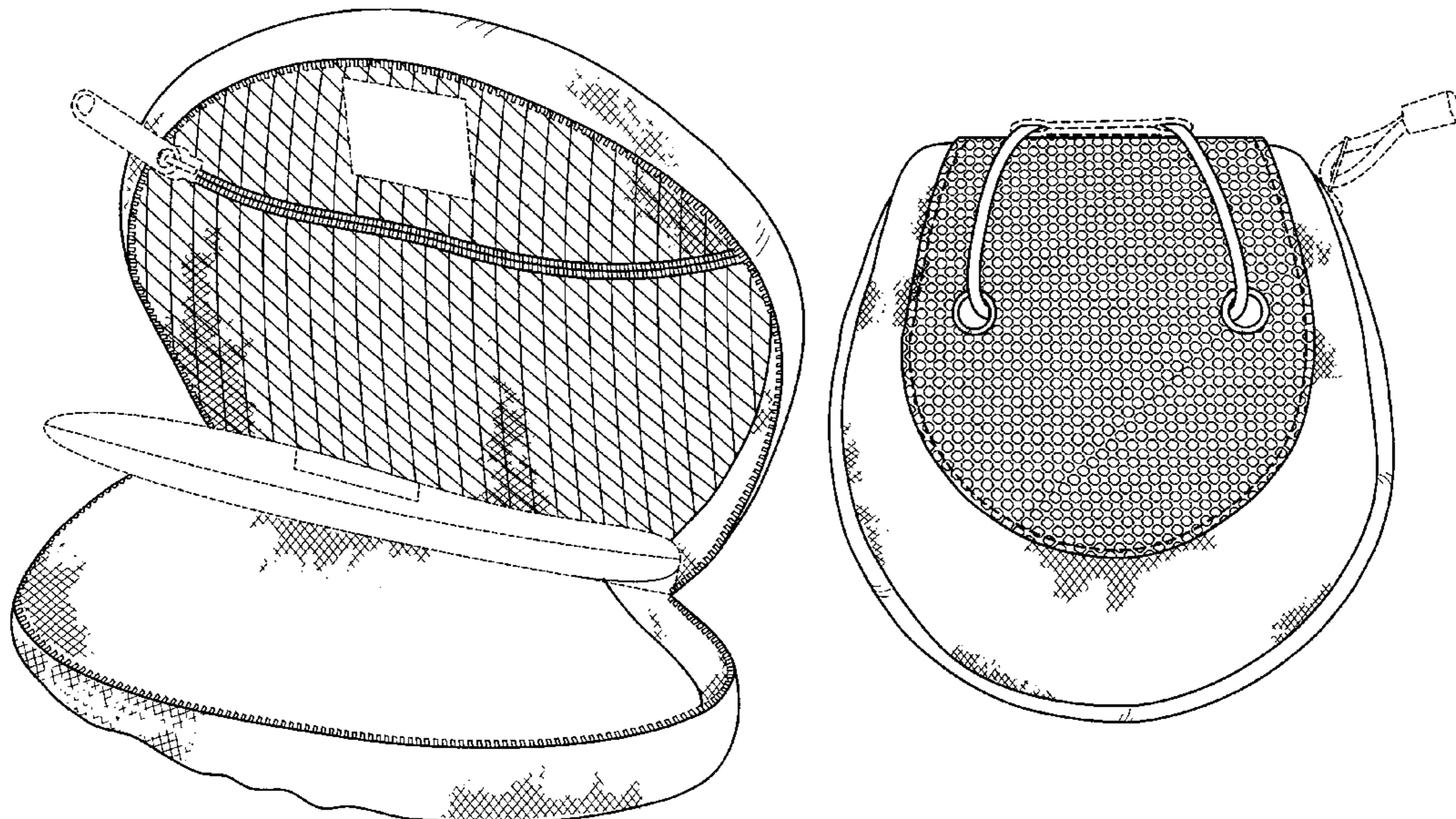
FIG. 5 is right elevational view of the invention illustrated in FIG. 1;

FIG. 6 is a top plan view of the invention illustrated in FIG. 1; and,

FIG. 7 is a bottom plan view of the invention illustrated in FIG. 1.

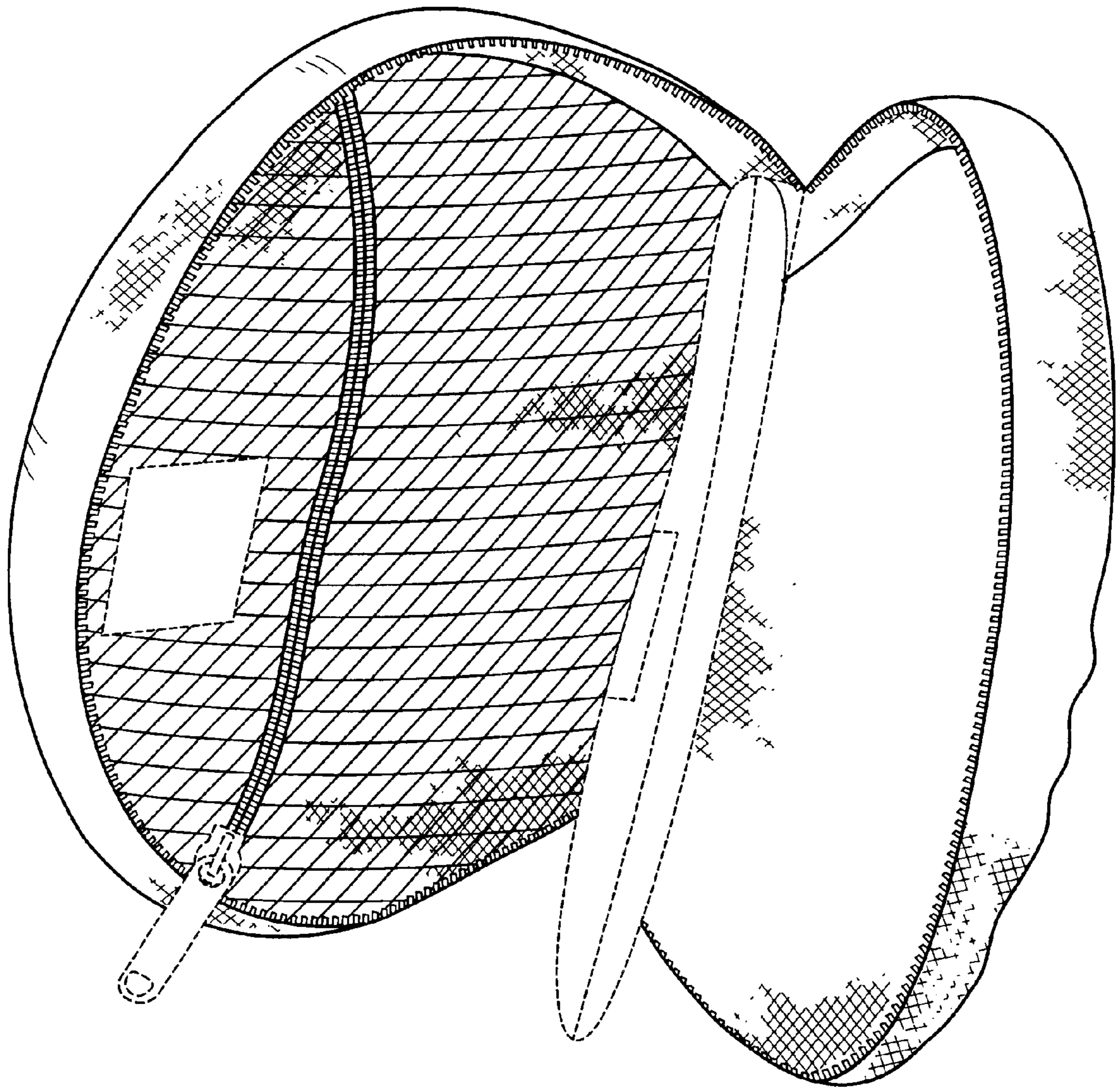

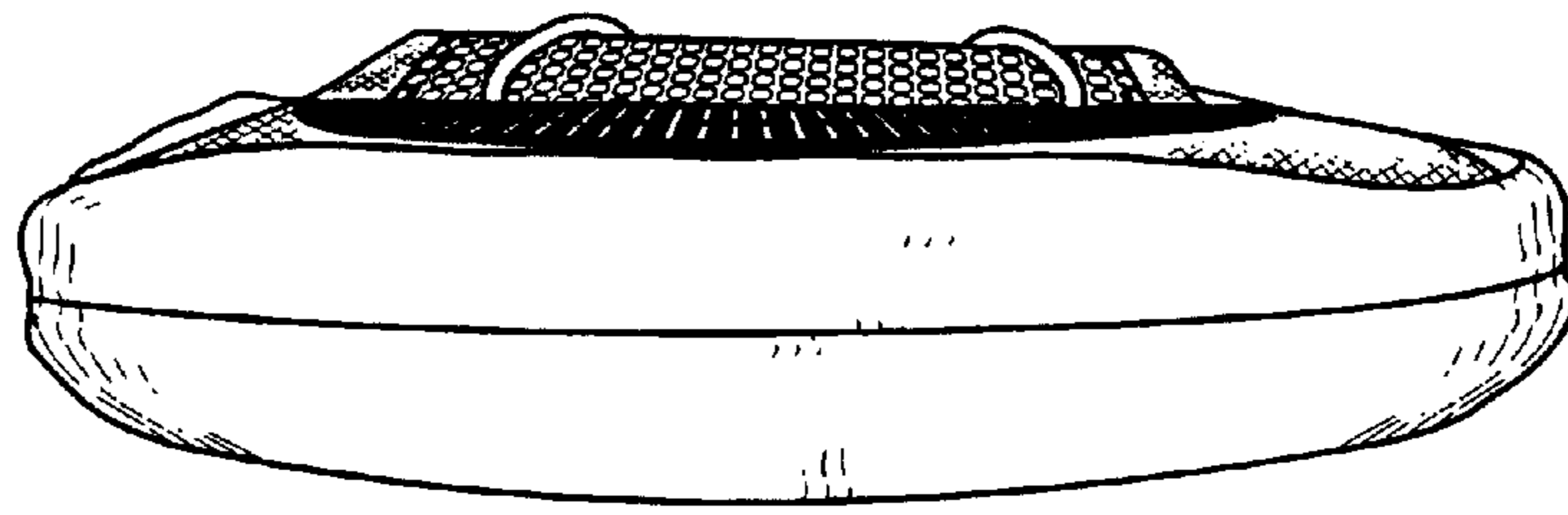

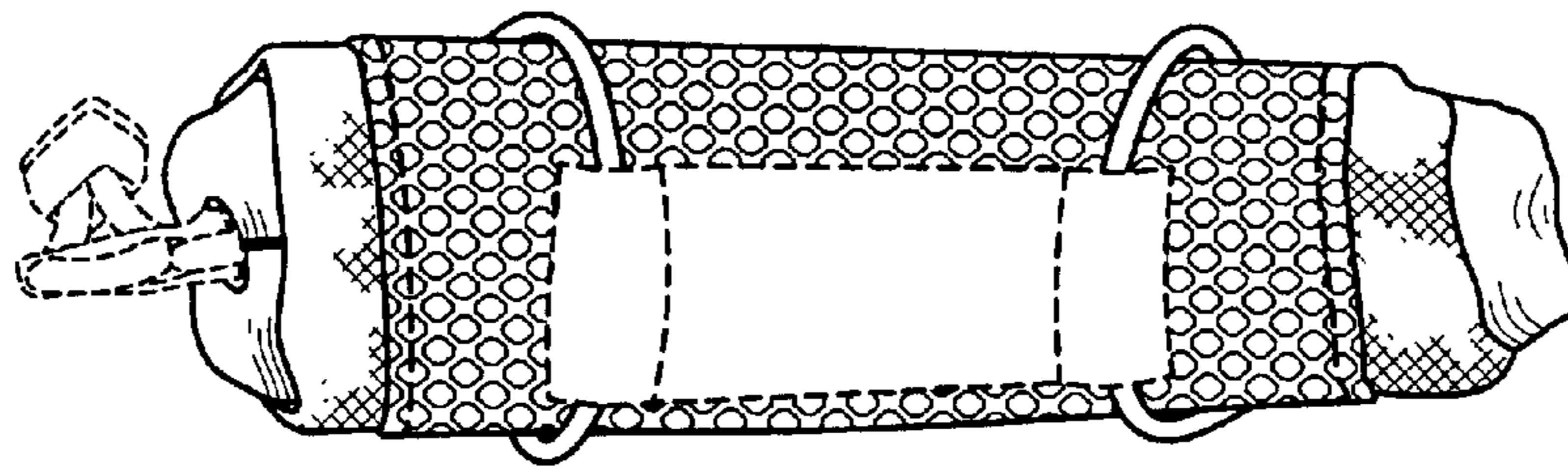

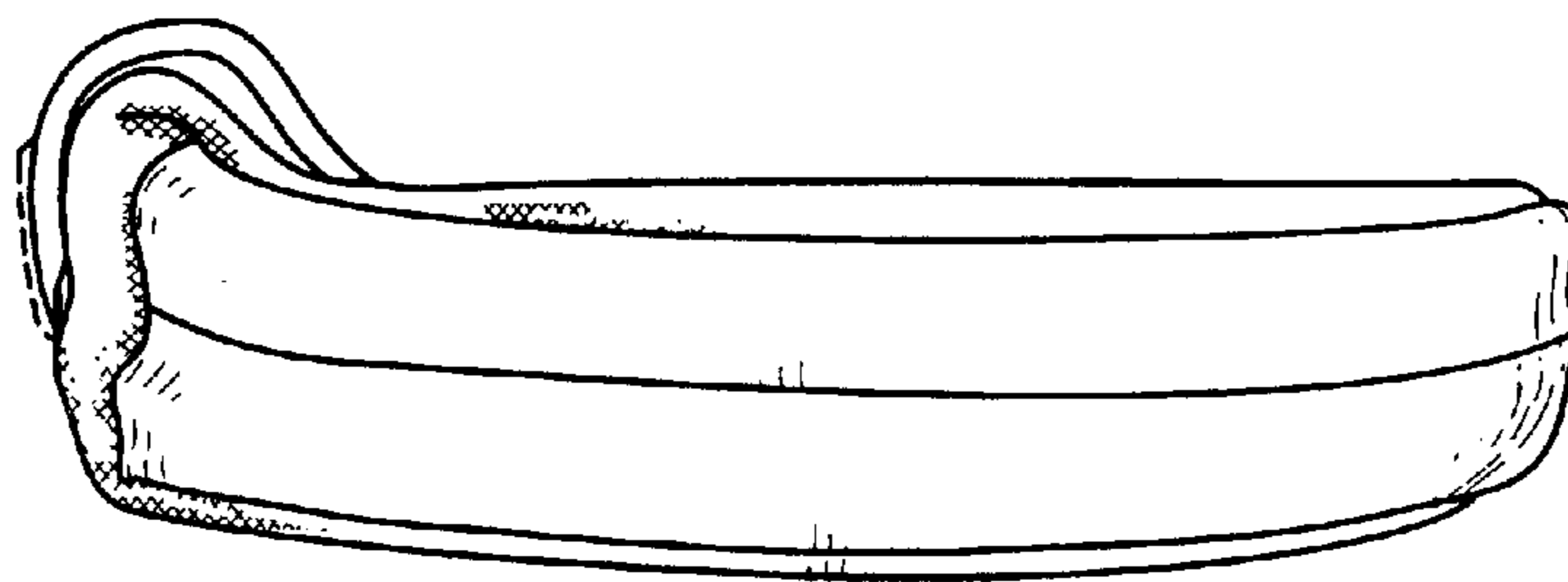

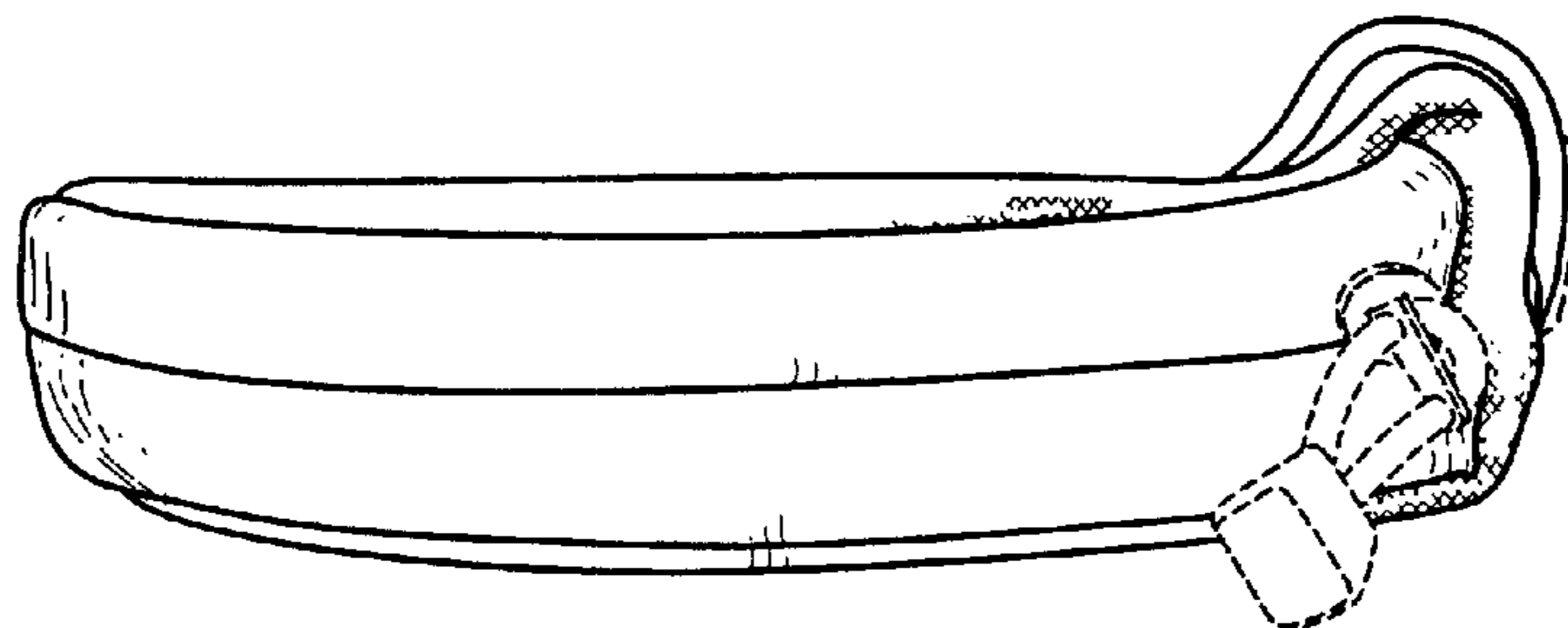

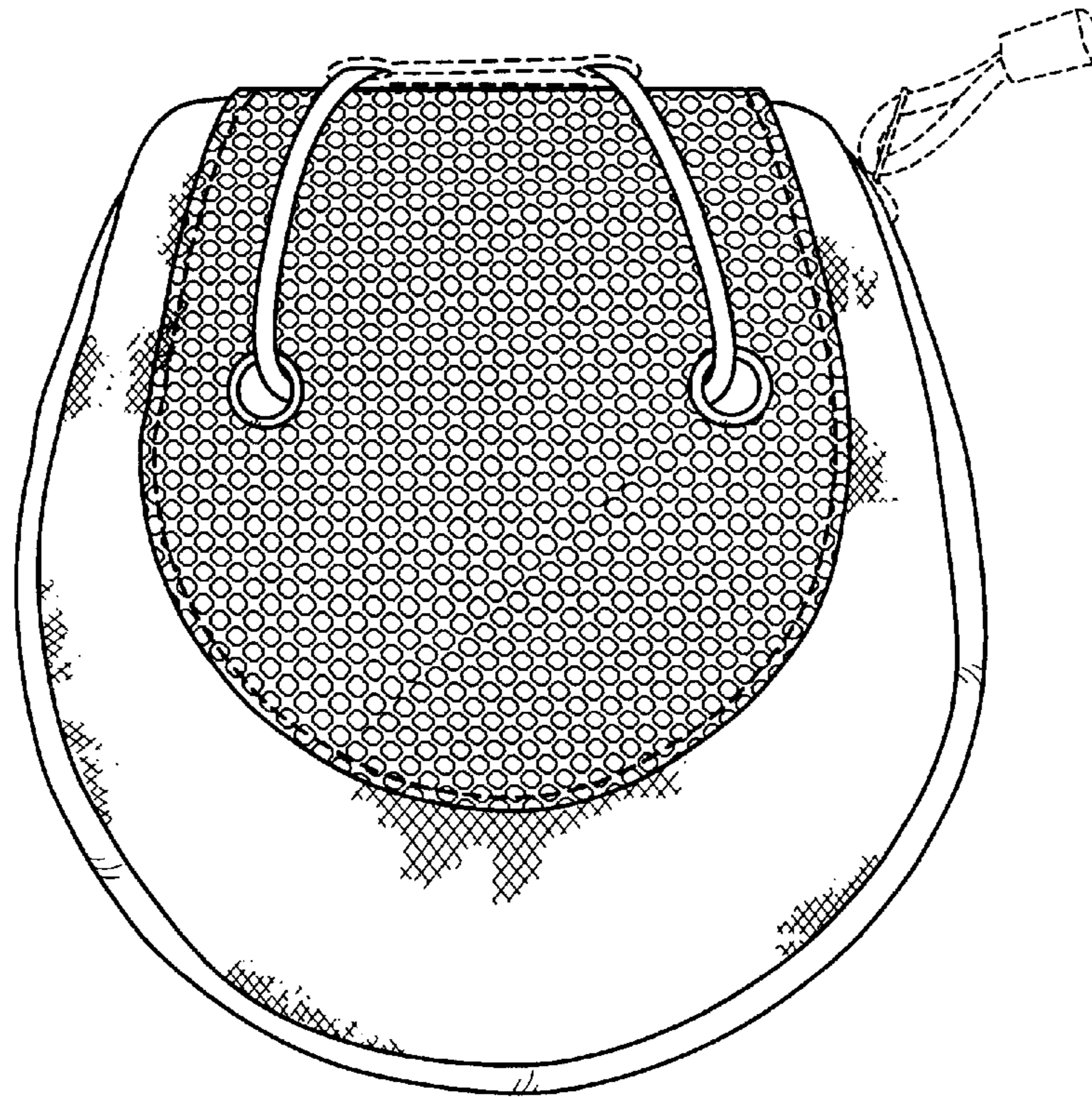

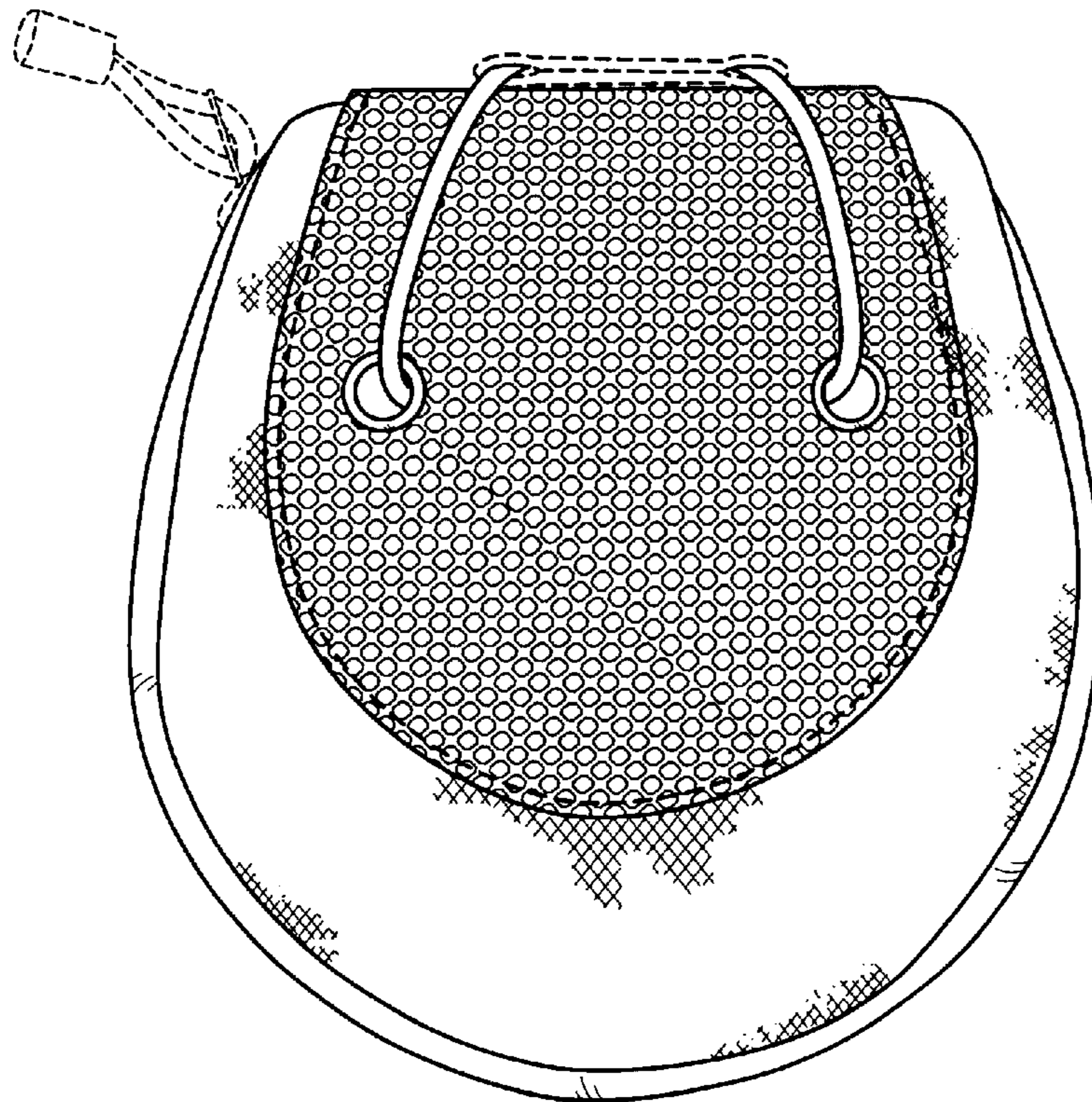
