(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a camcorder storage case, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of a camcorder storage case showing my new design with the front flap and pocket in an open position; the broken lines representing environment and forming no part of the claimed design;

FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof, shown in a closed position;

FIG. 3 is a rear elevational view of FIG. 2;

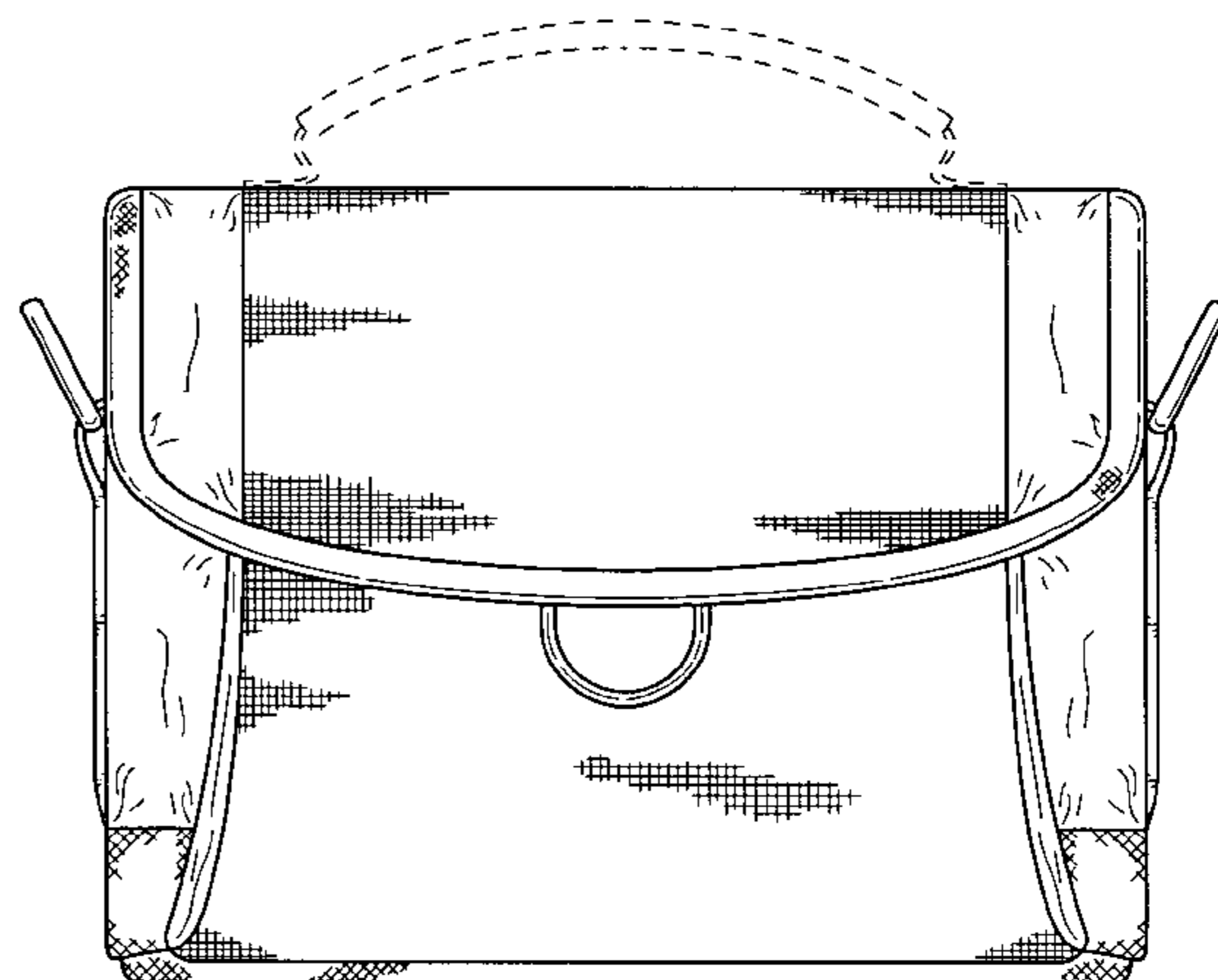
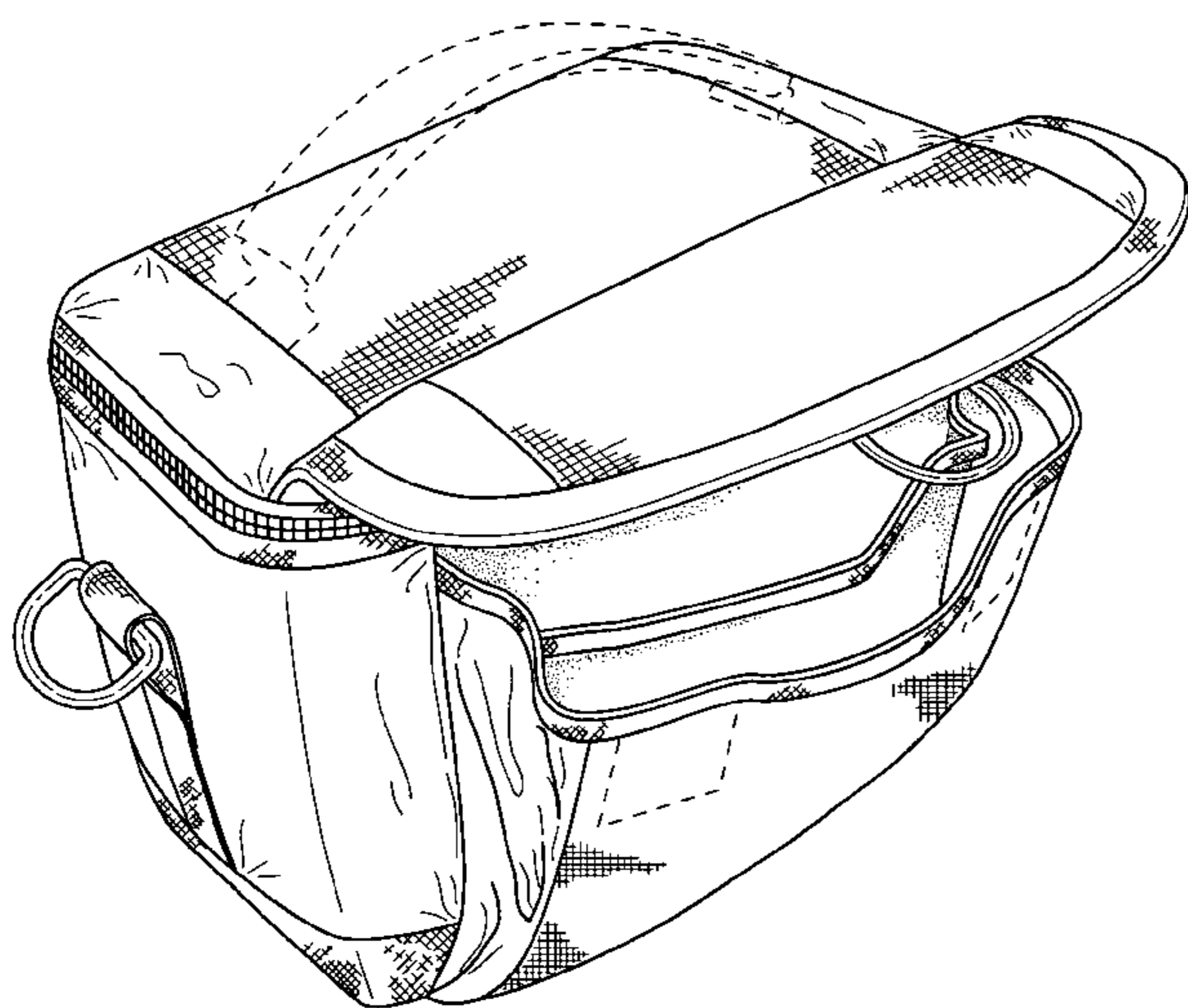
FIG. 4 is a right side elevational view of FIG. 2;

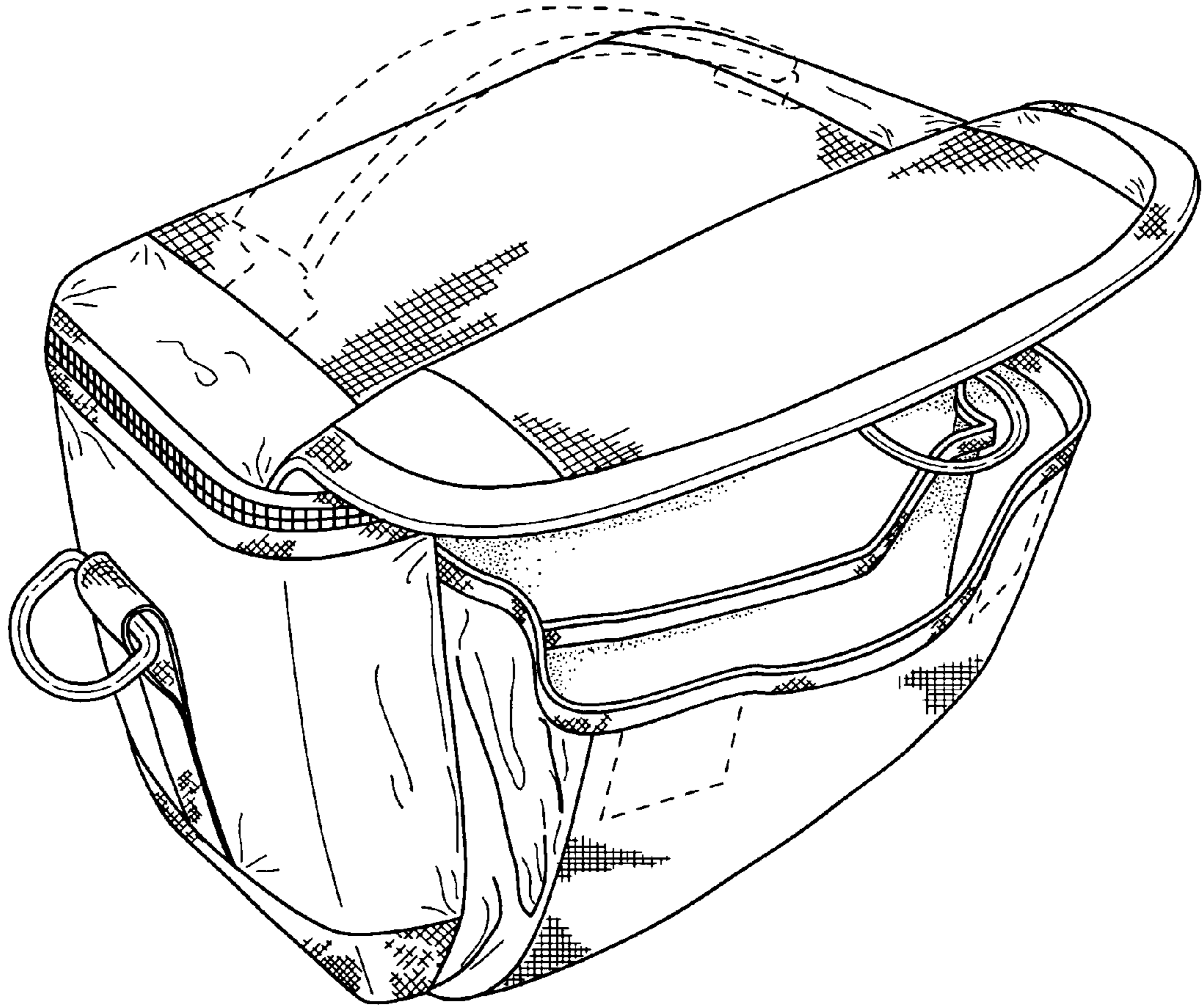

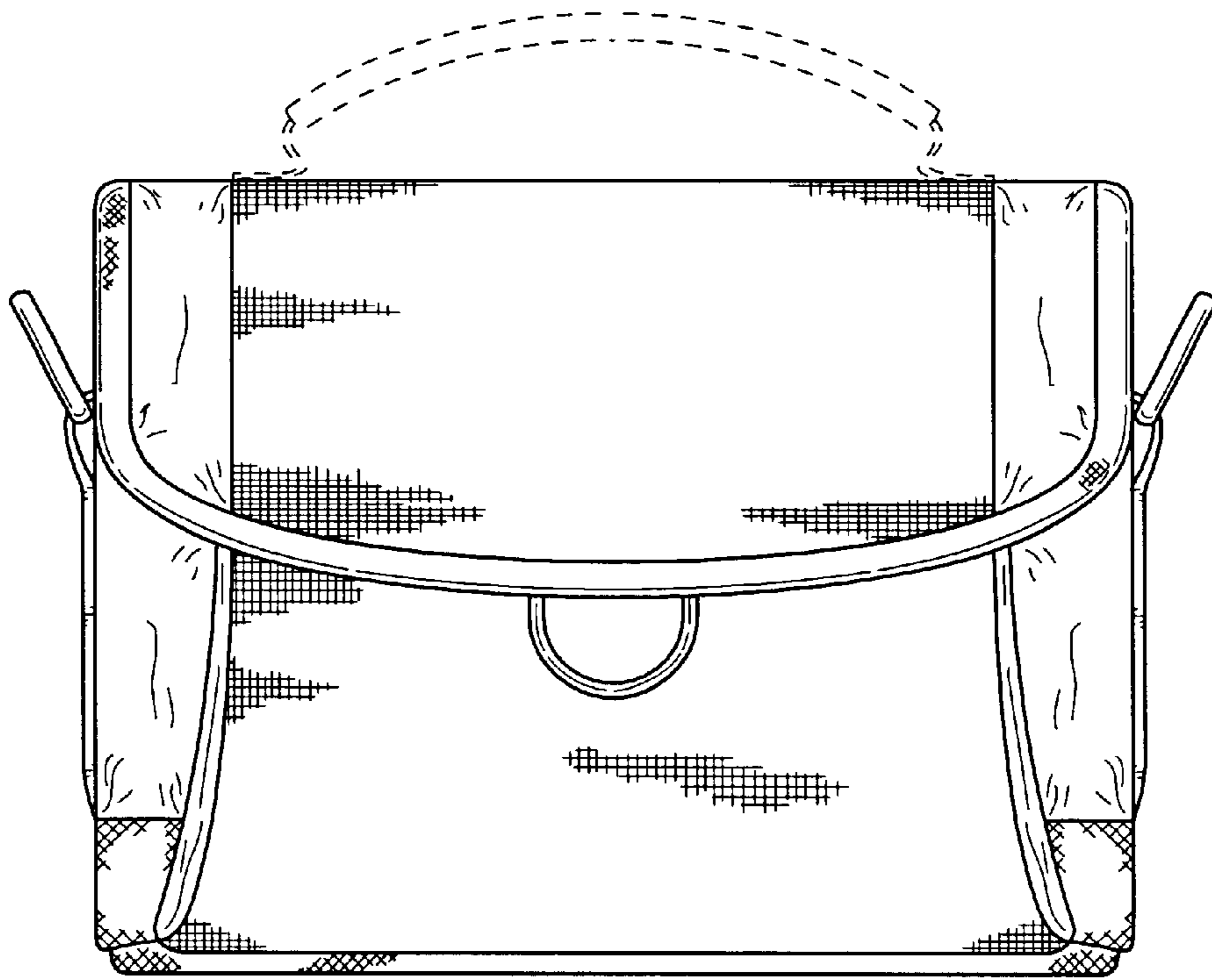

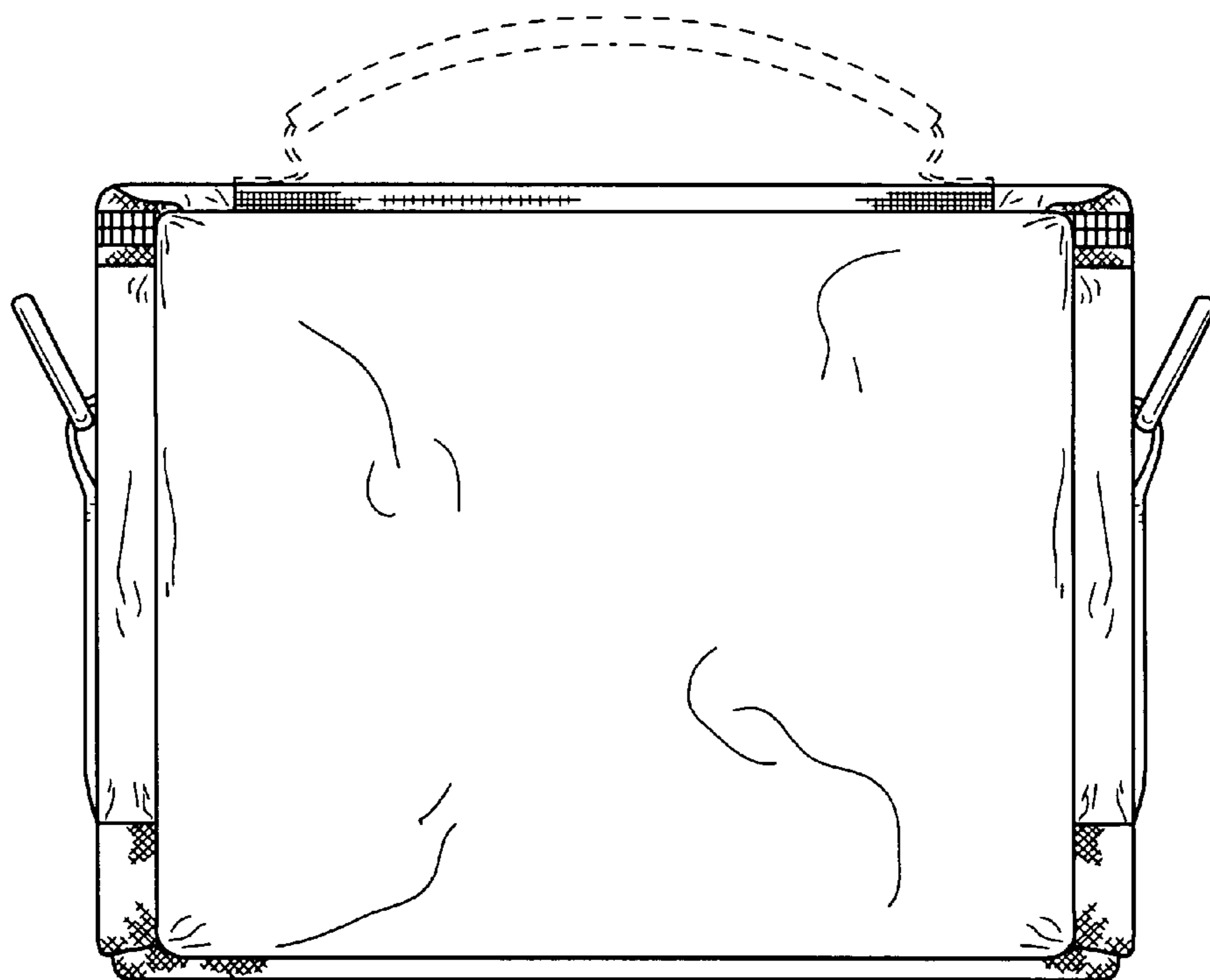

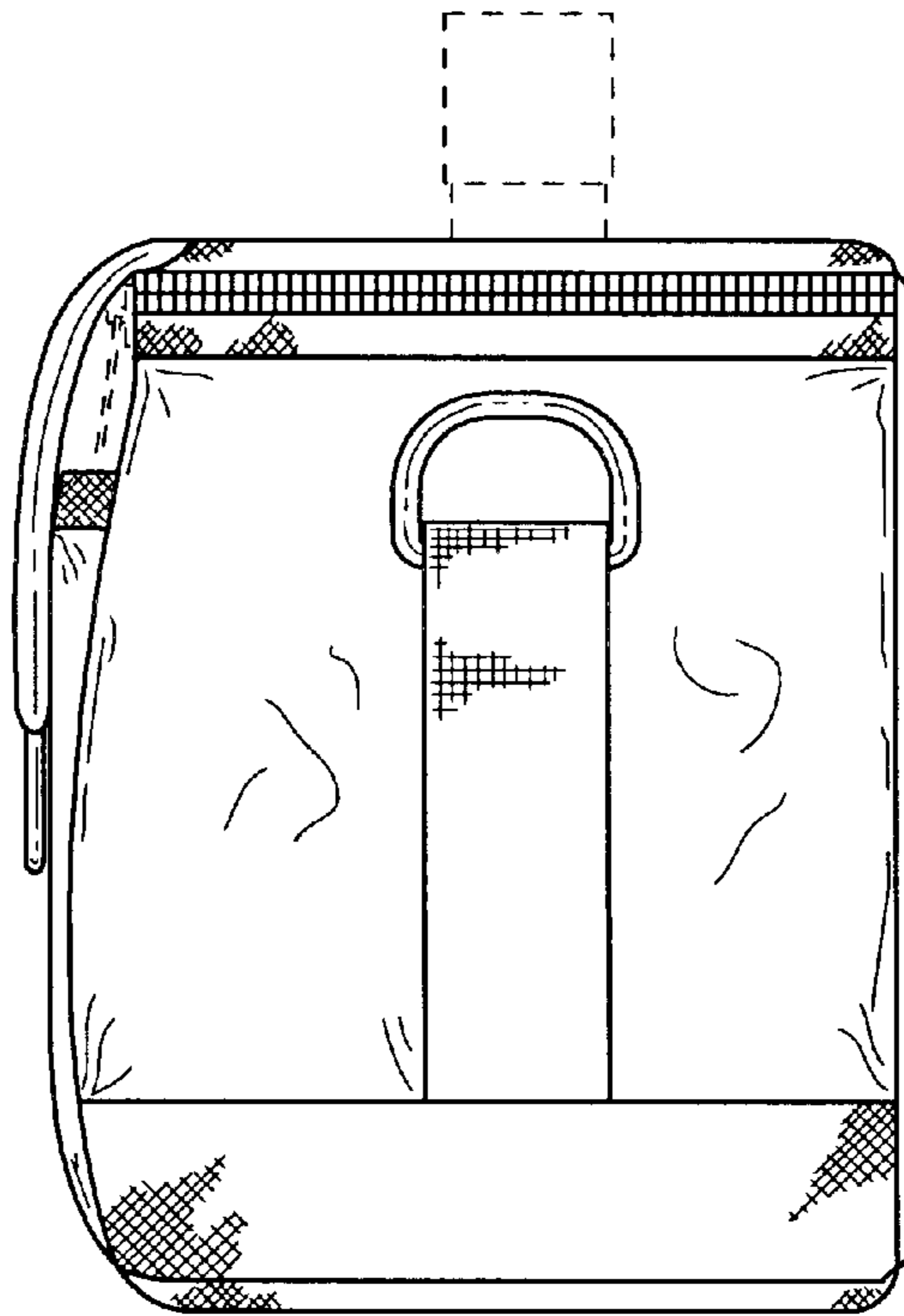

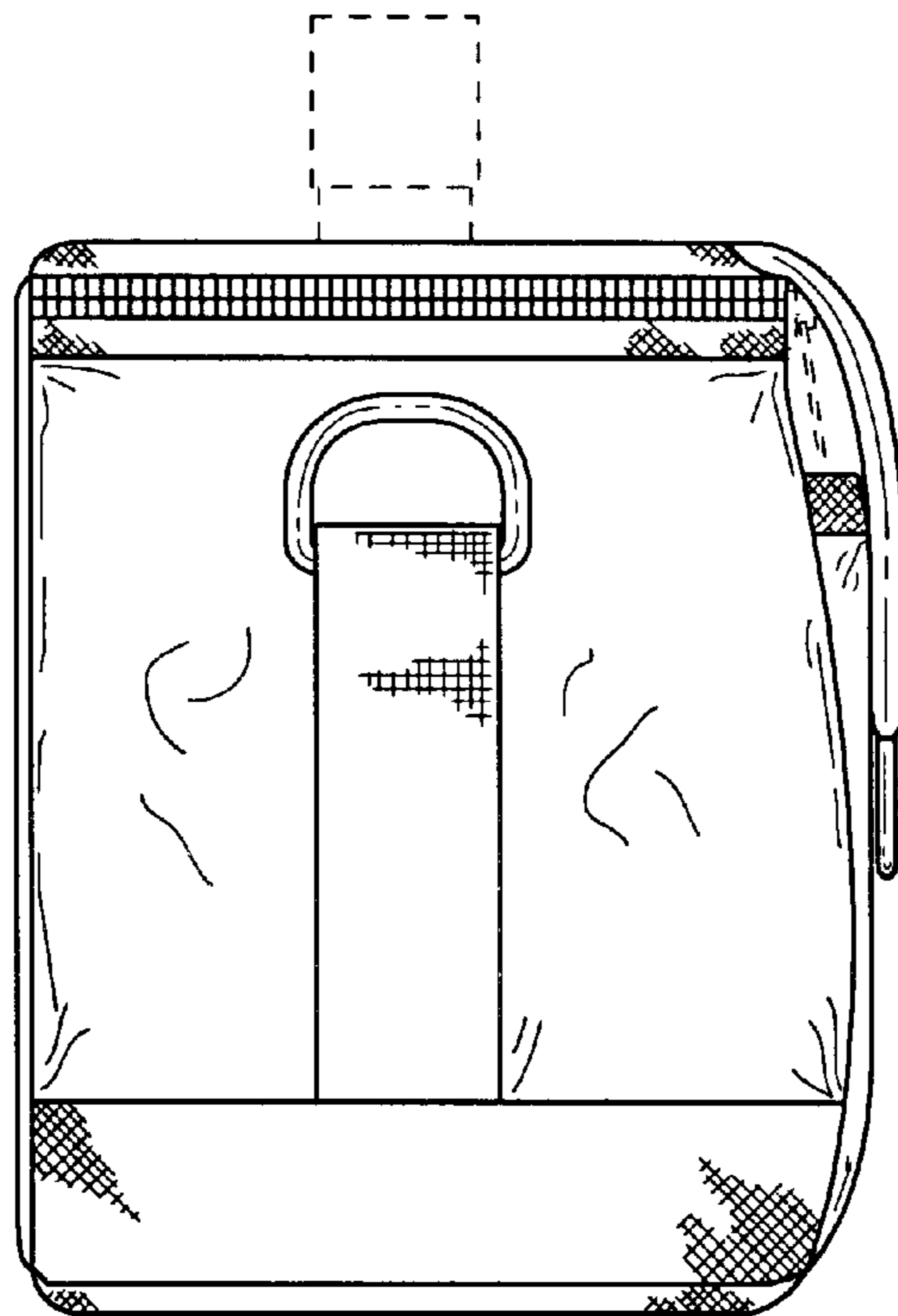

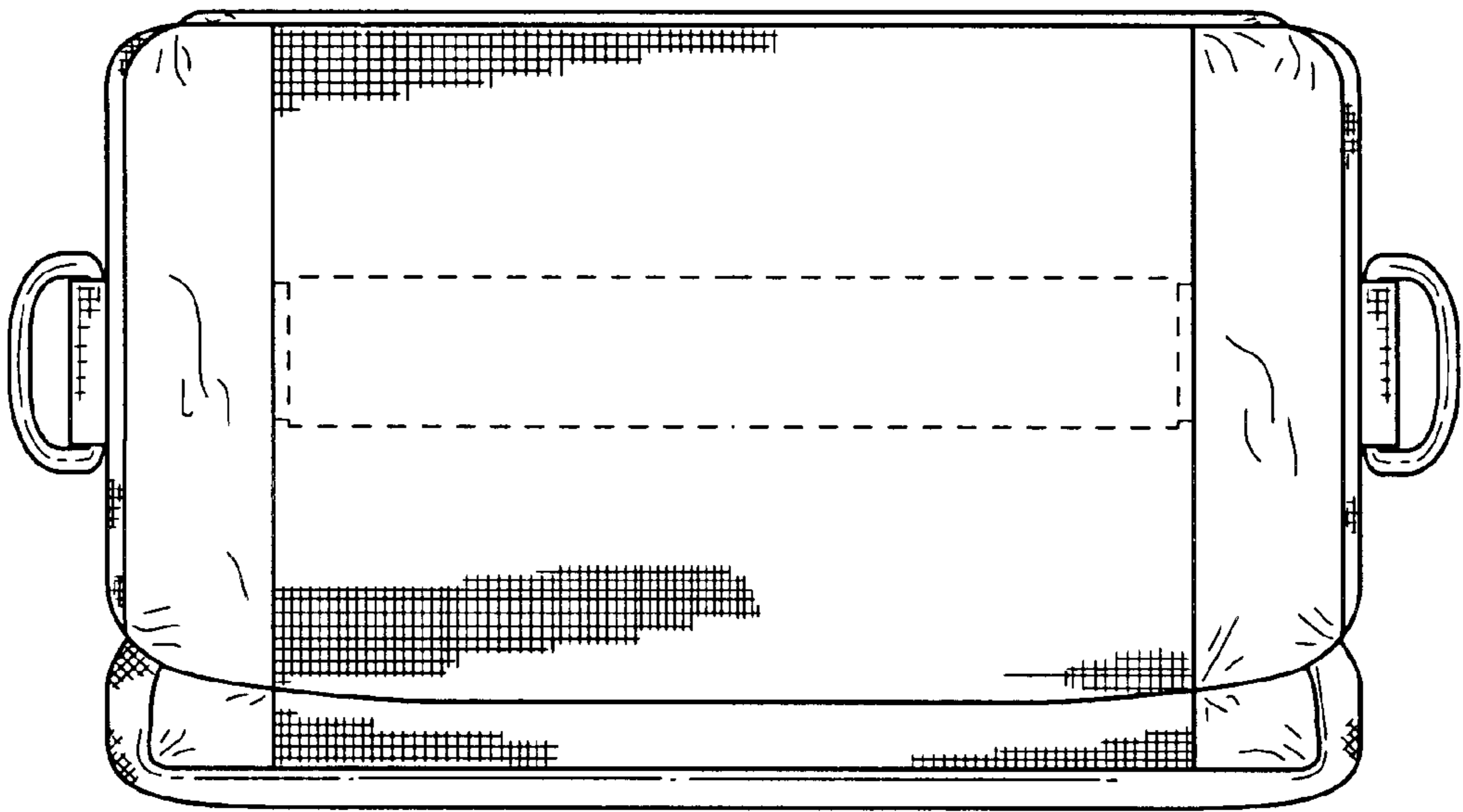

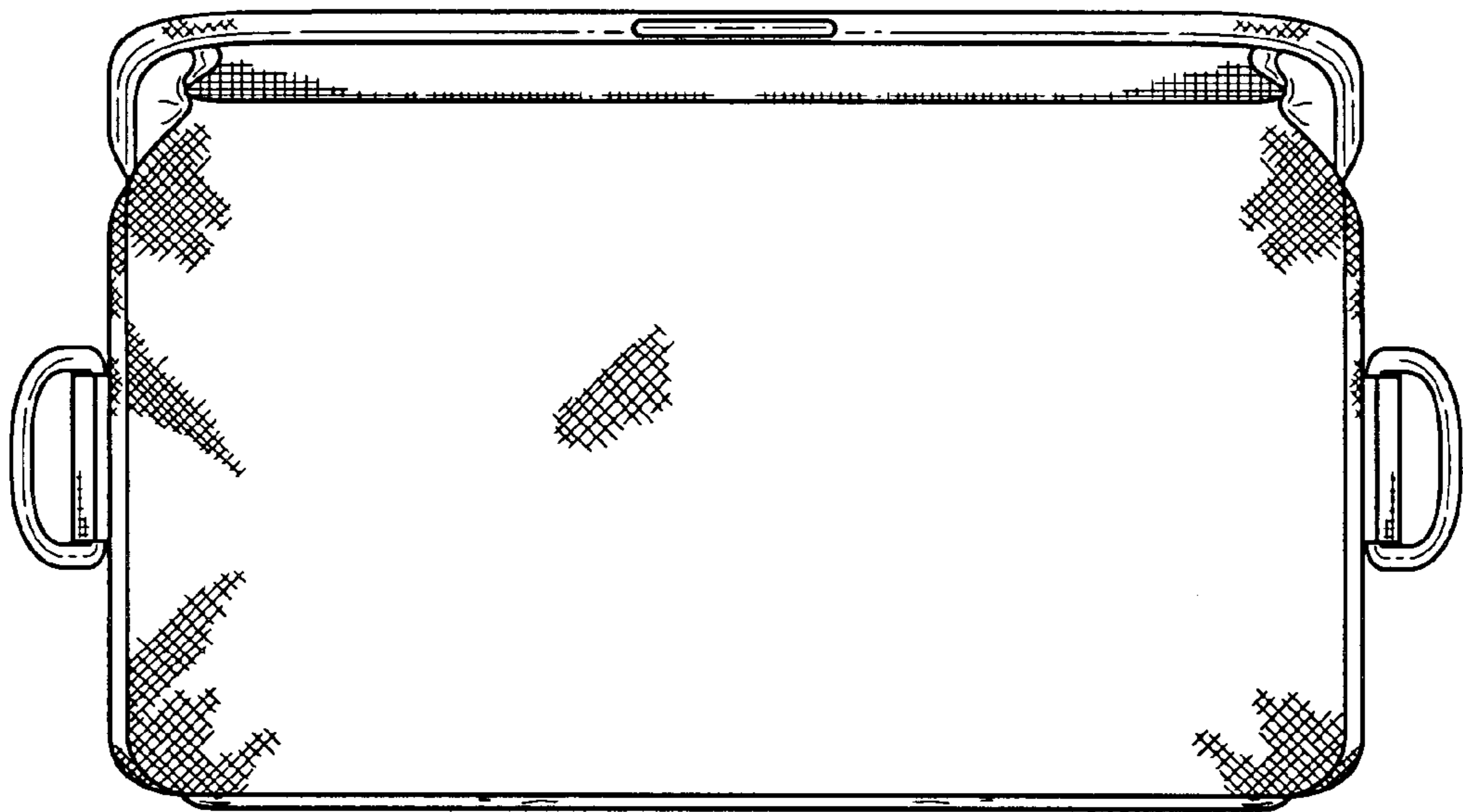
