**DESCRIPTION**

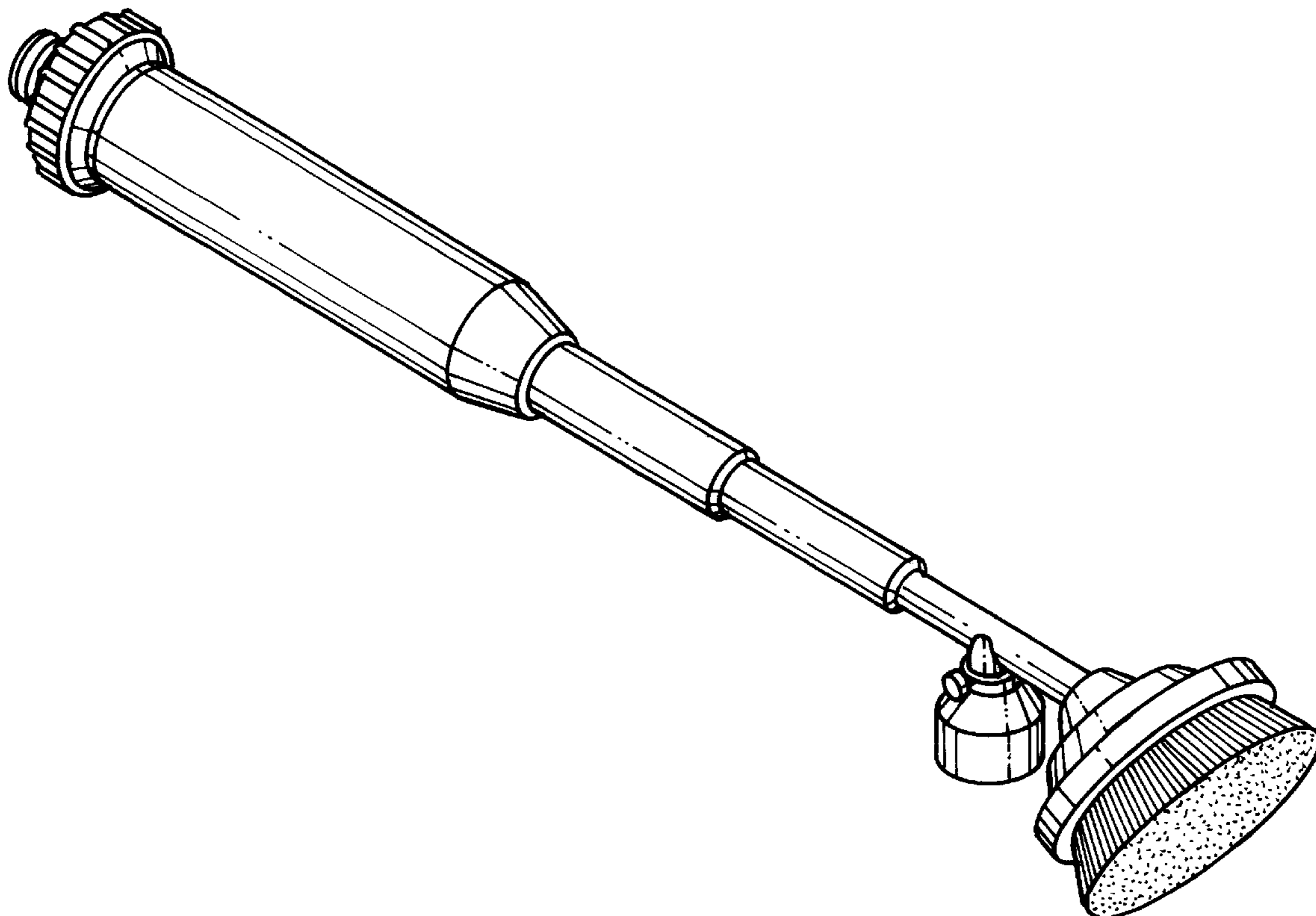

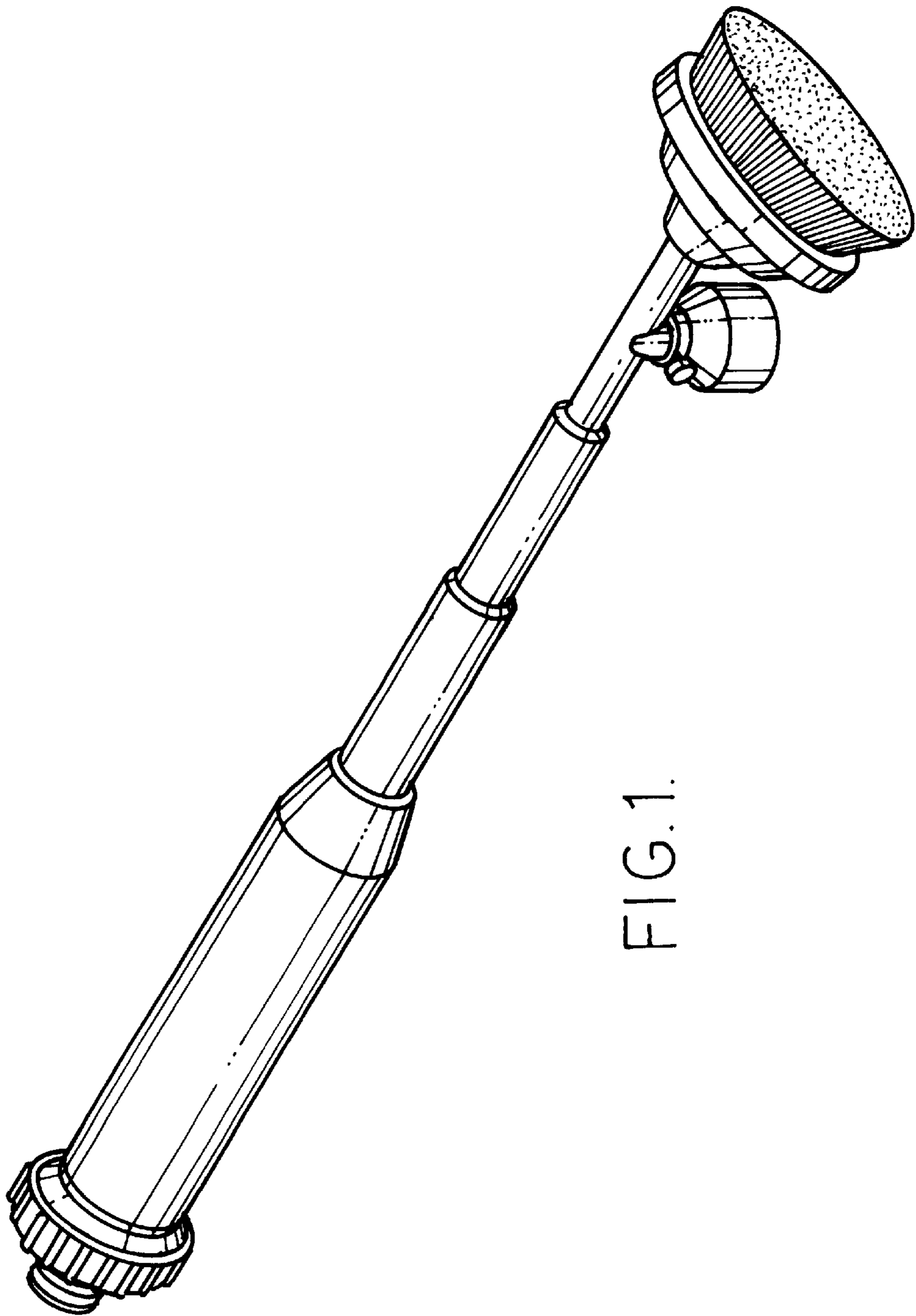

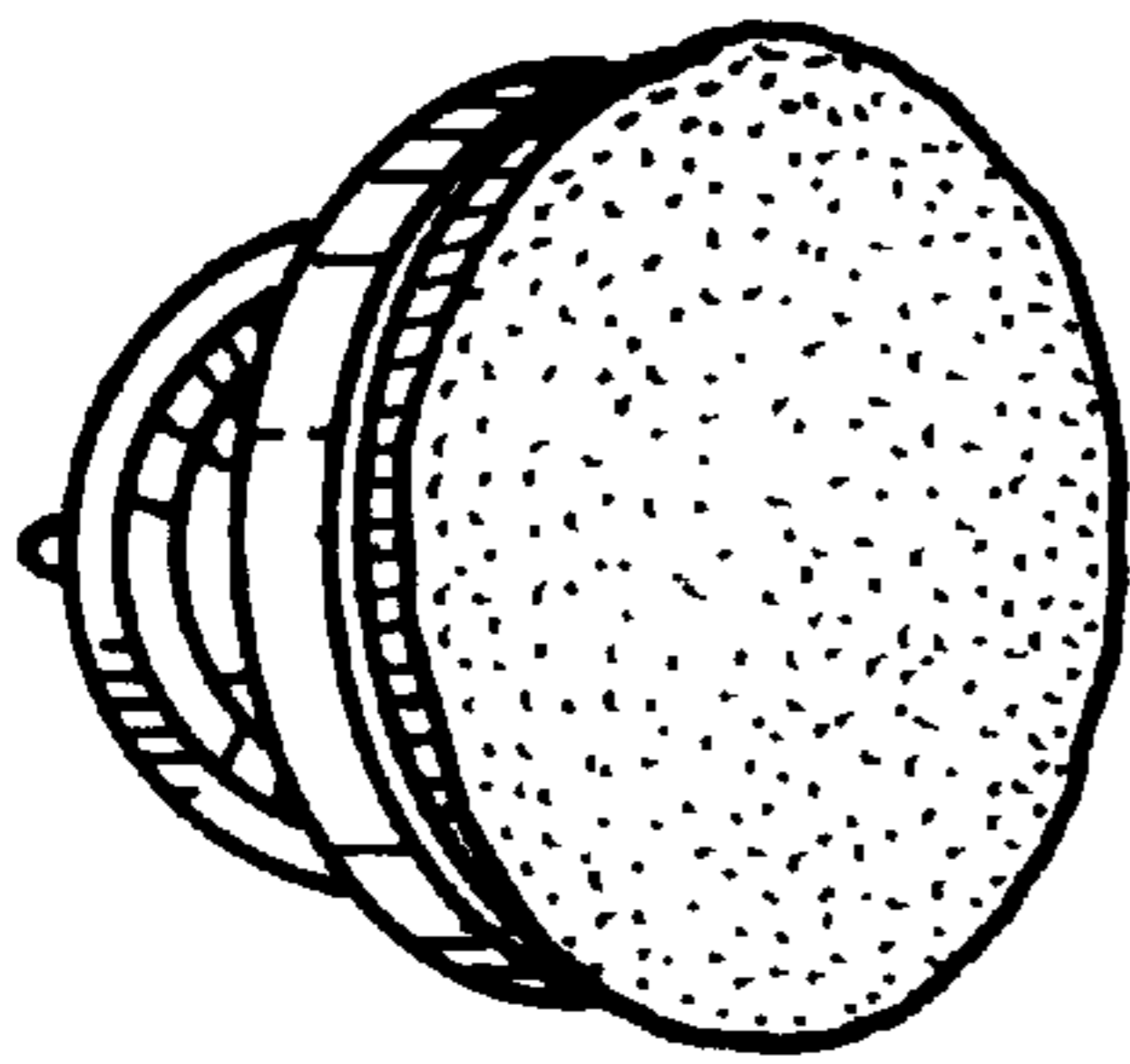

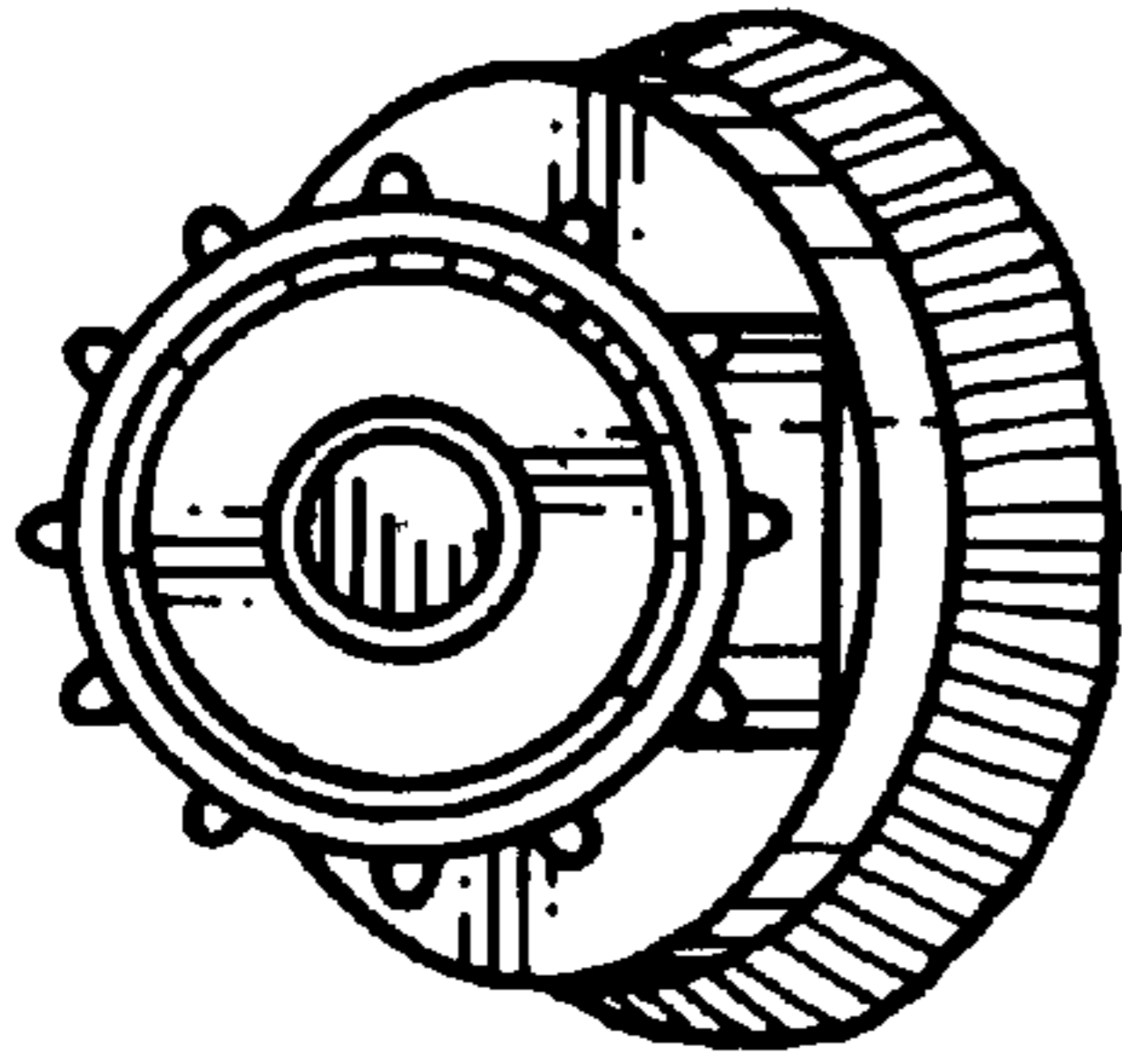

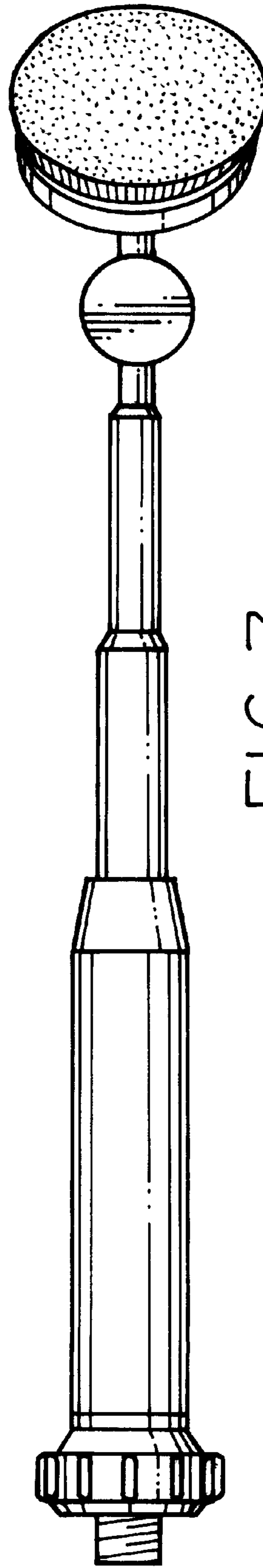
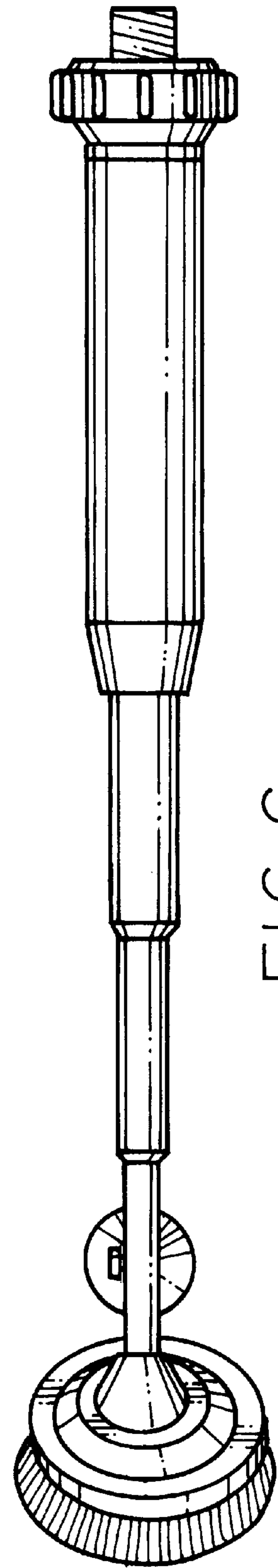
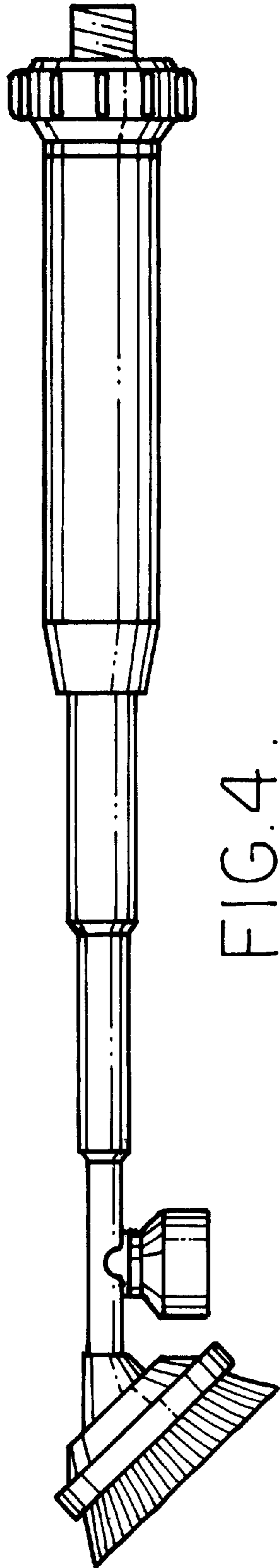

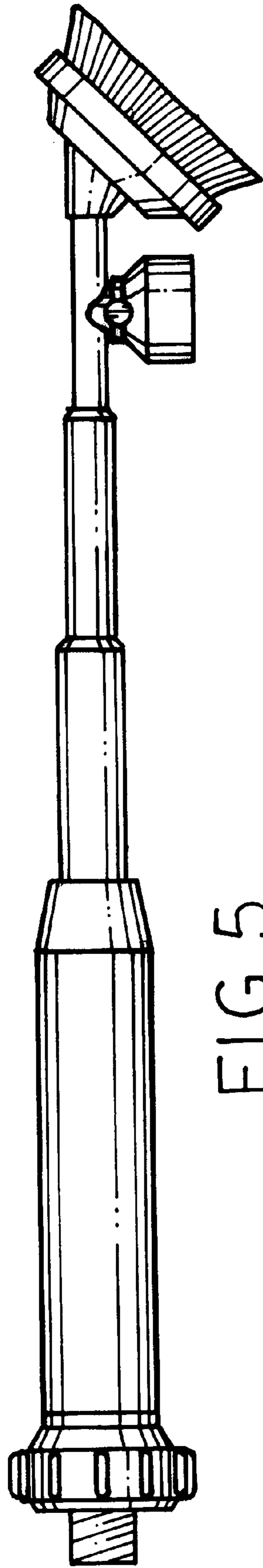
