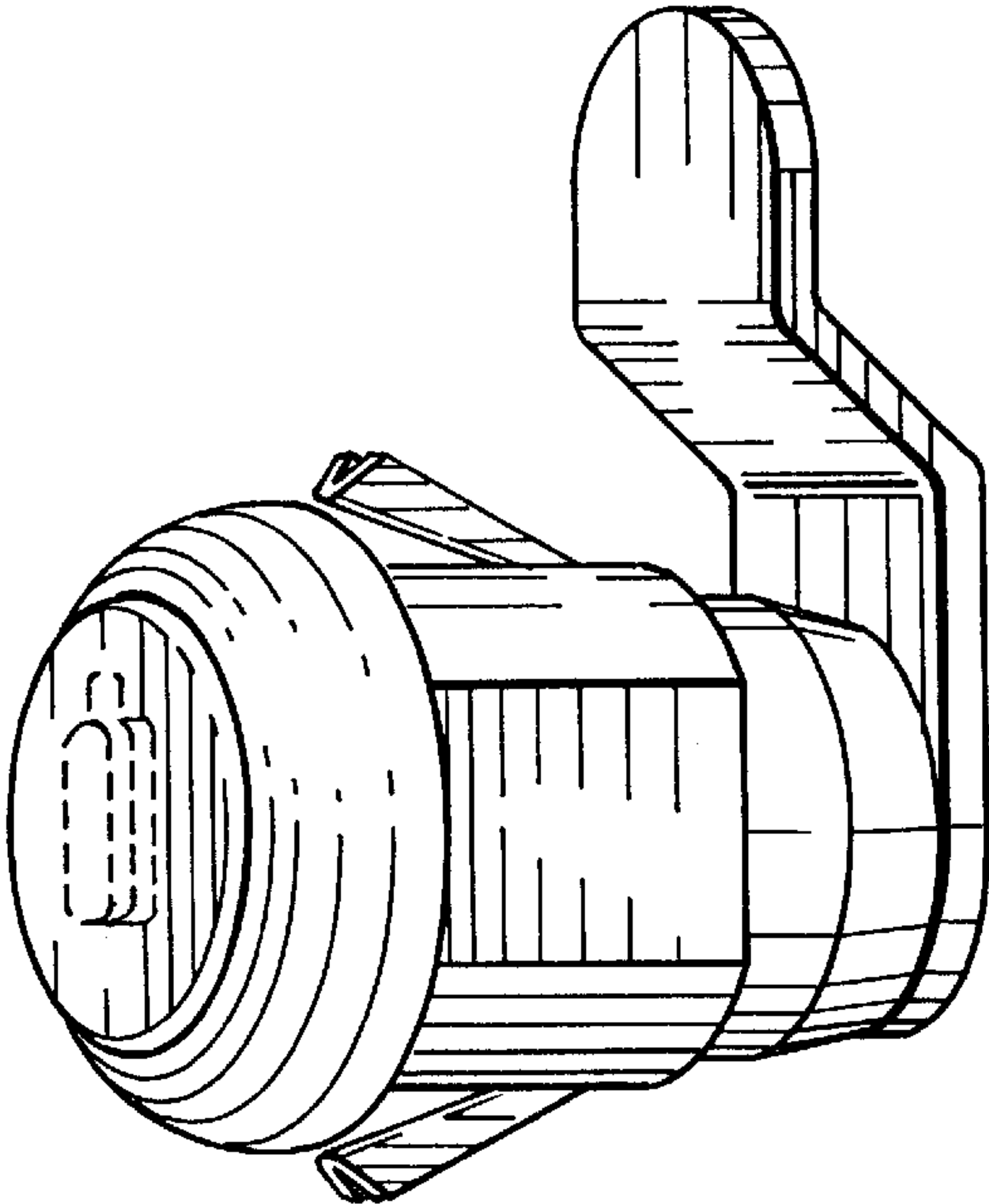
CLAIM

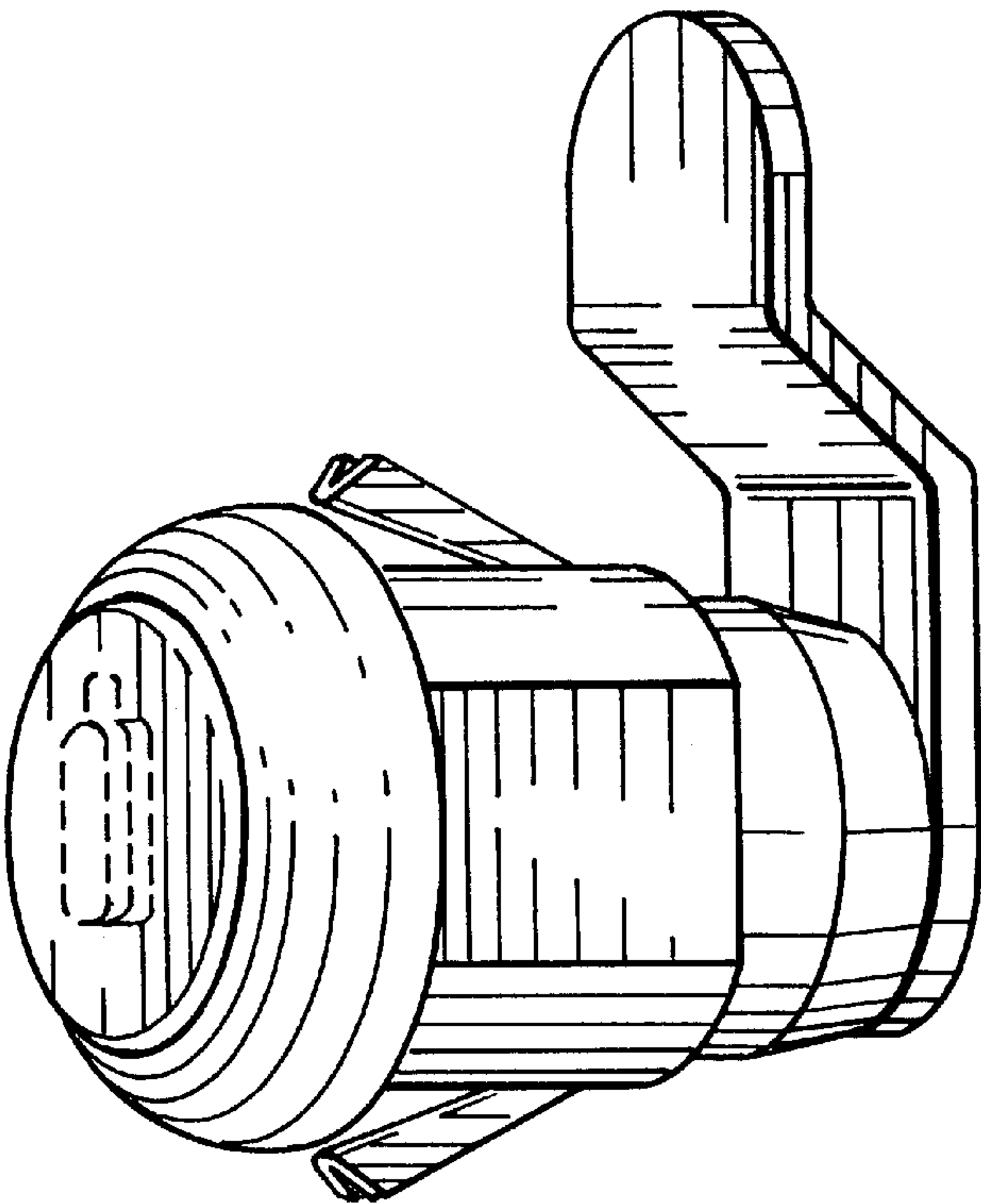

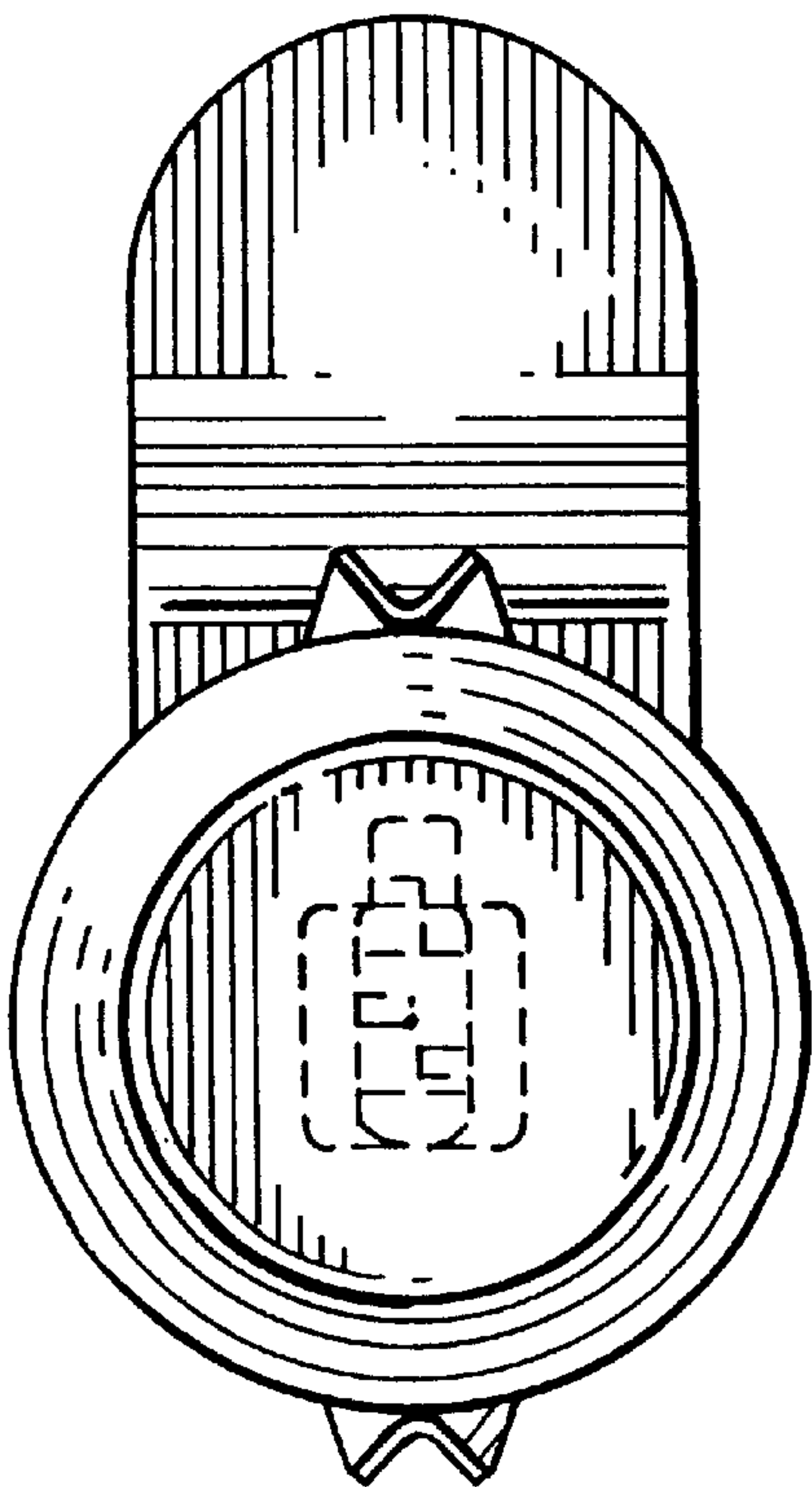

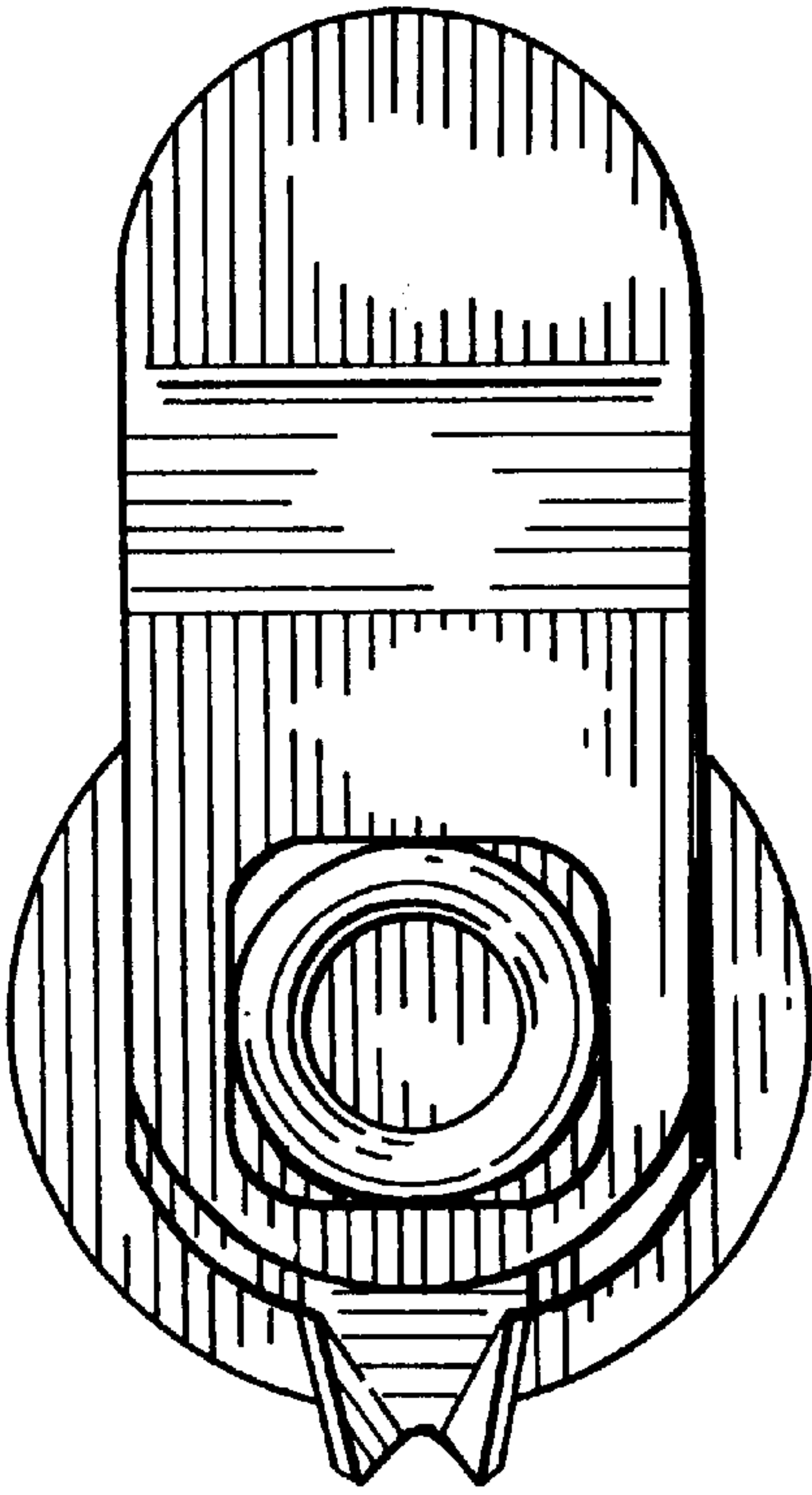

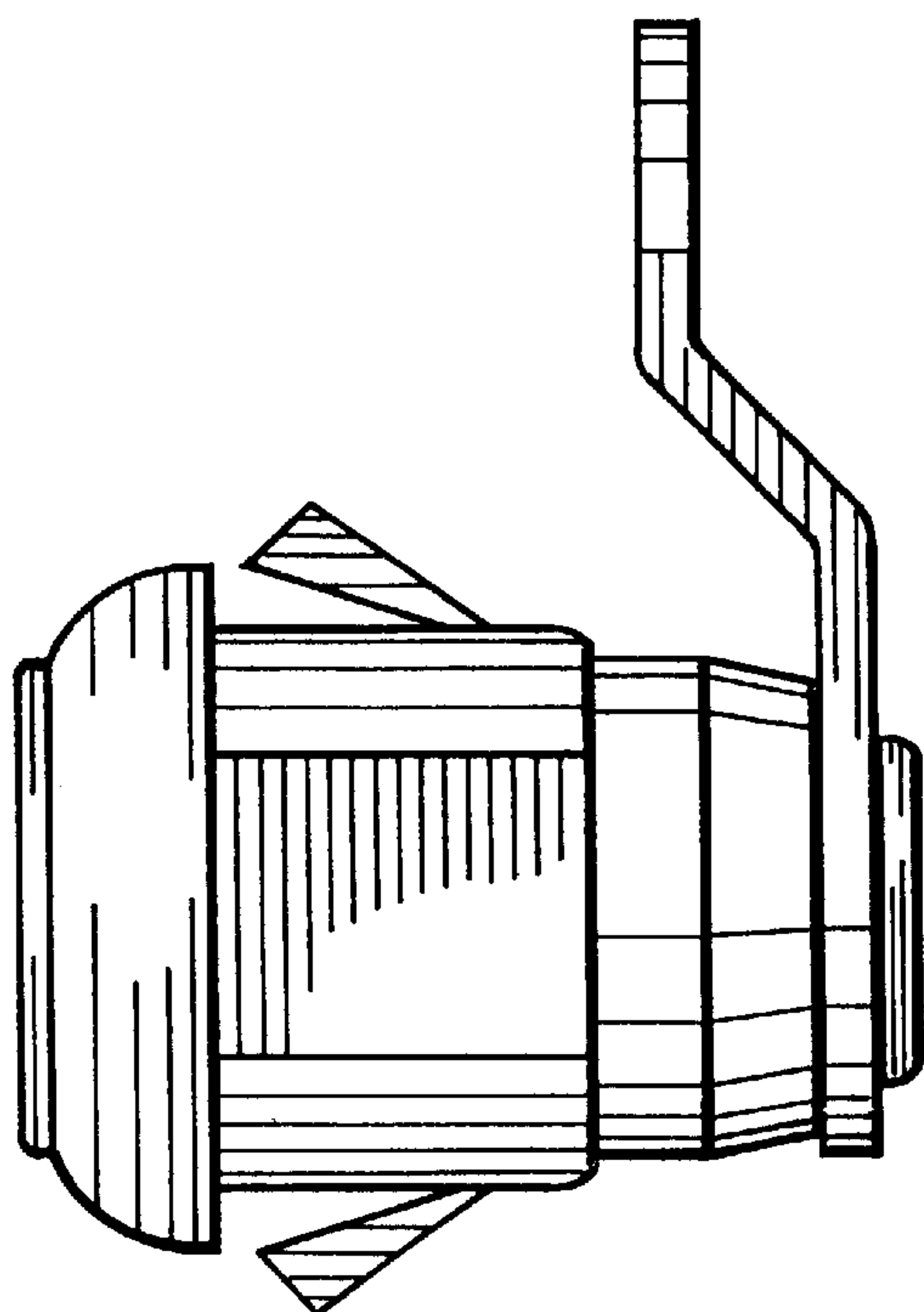

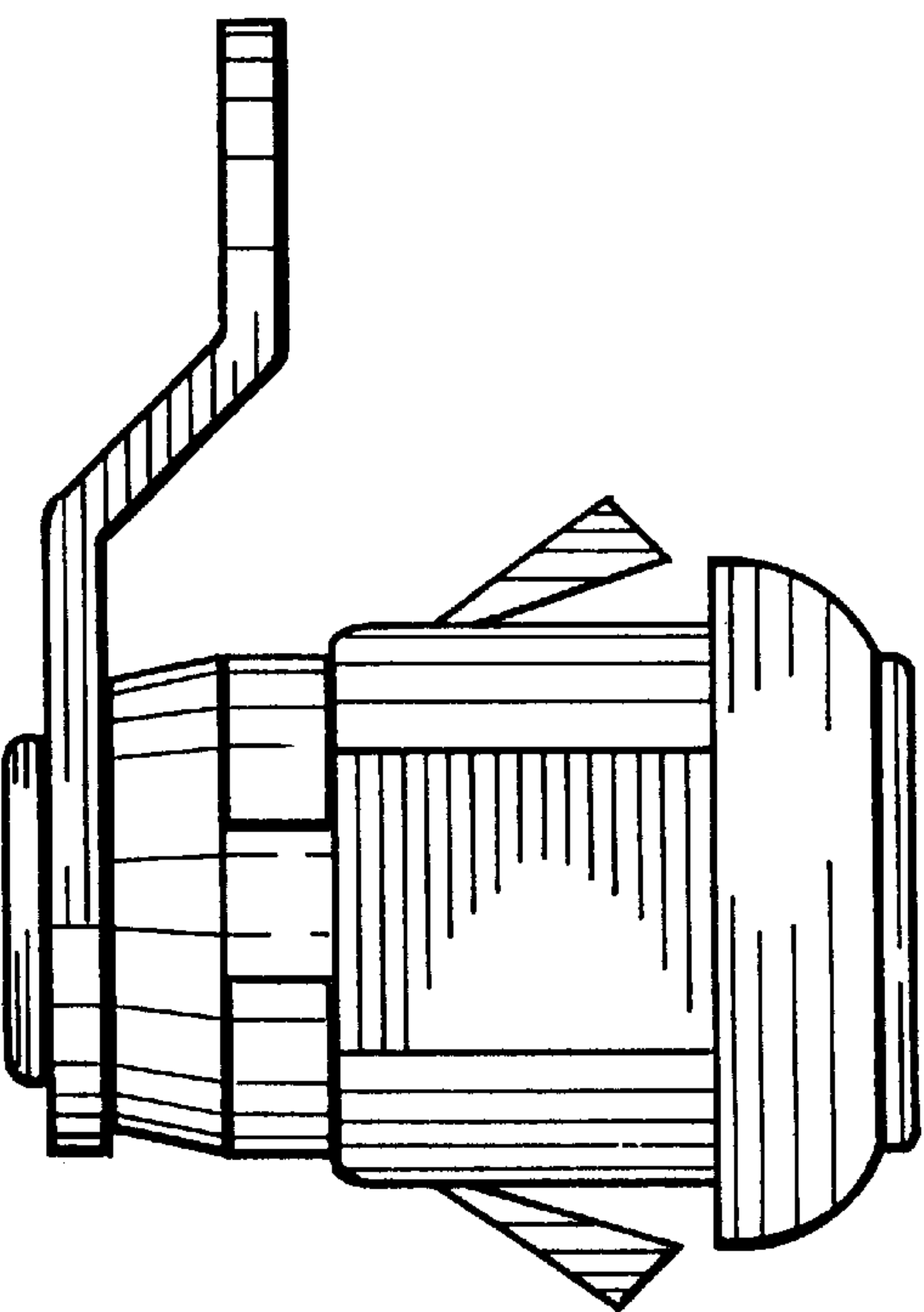

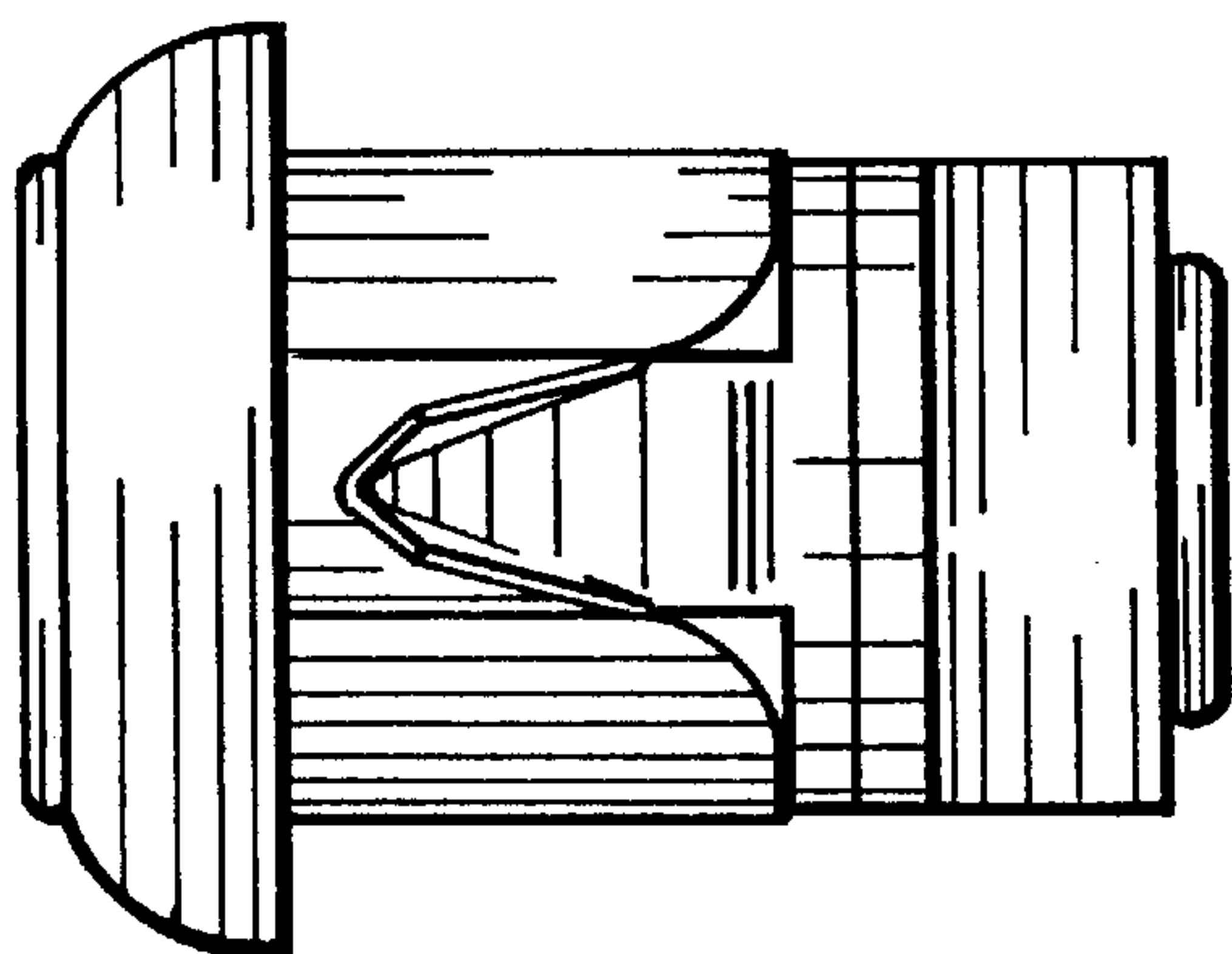

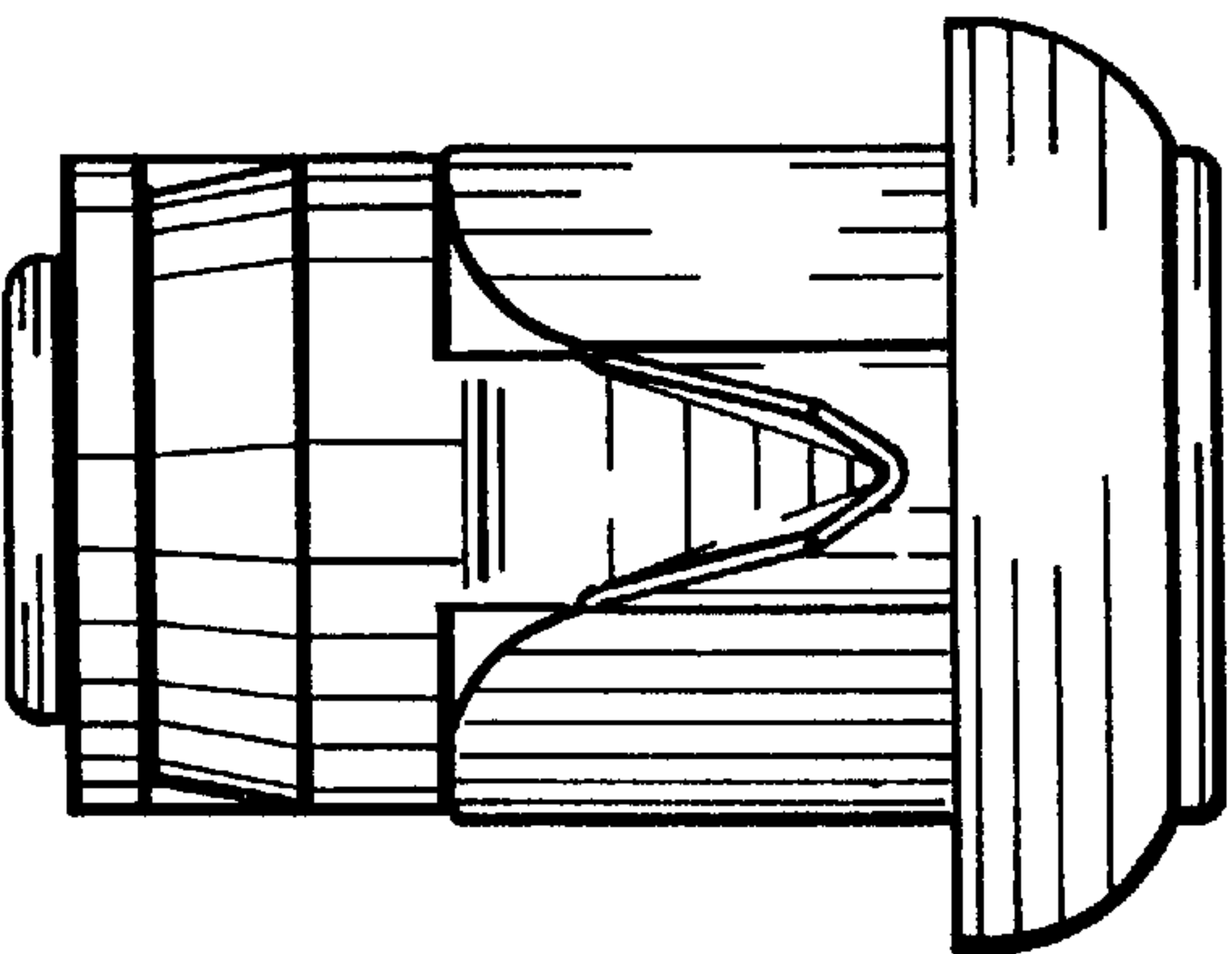
