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(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a body of a surgical microscope, as shown and described.

The body includes the main objective lens system of the surgical microscope and carries an optical magnification system. The body includes actuating elements for adjusting optical components. The body further includes mounting elements for mounting the body on a stand and has connecting elements for connecting additional equipment.

FIG. 1 is a perspective front view of a body of a surgical microscope of my new design according to a first embodiment thereof;

FIG. 2 is a perspective side view of said body of FIG. 1;

FIG. 3 is a perspective bottom view of said body of FIG. 1;

FIG. 4 is a perspective rear view of said body of FIG. 1;

FIG. 5 is a perspective front view of a body of a surgical microscope of my new design according to a second embodiment thereof;

FIG. 6 is a perspective side view of said body of FIG. 5;

FIG. 7 is a perspective bottom view of said body of FIG. 5;

FIG. 8 is a perspective rear view of said body of FIG. 5;

FIG. 9 is a perspective front view of a body of a surgical microscope of my new design according to a third embodiment thereof;

FIG. 10 is a perspective side view of said body of FIG. 9;

FIG. 11 is a perspective bottom view of said body of FIG. 9;

FIG. 12 is an upper view of said body of FIG. 9;

FIG. 13 is a perspective front view of a body of a surgical microscope of my new design according to a fourth embodiment thereof;

FIG. 14 is a side view of said body of FIG. 13;

FIG. 15 is a bottom view of said body of FIG. 13; and,

FIG. 16 is an upper view of said body of FIG. 13.

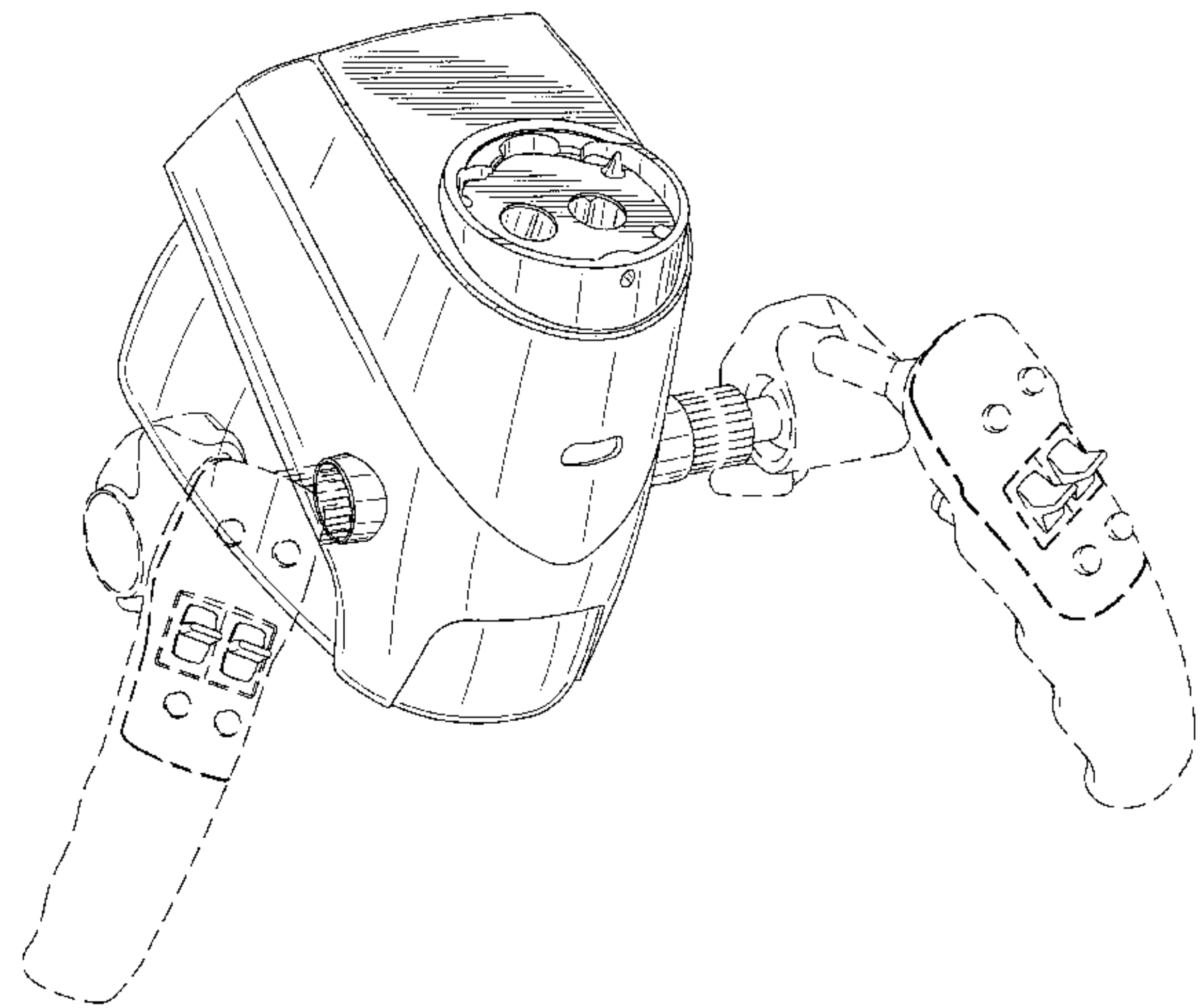
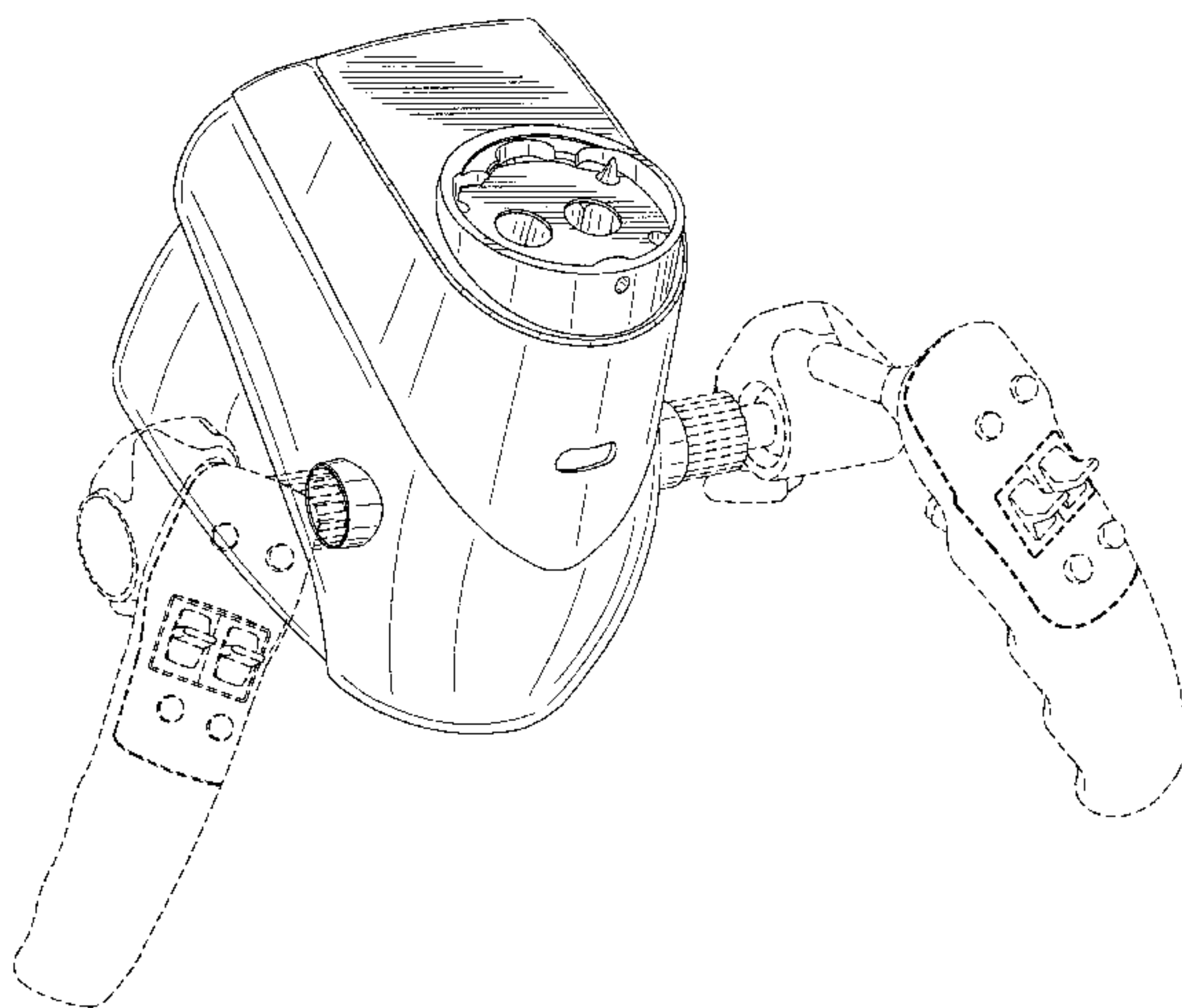

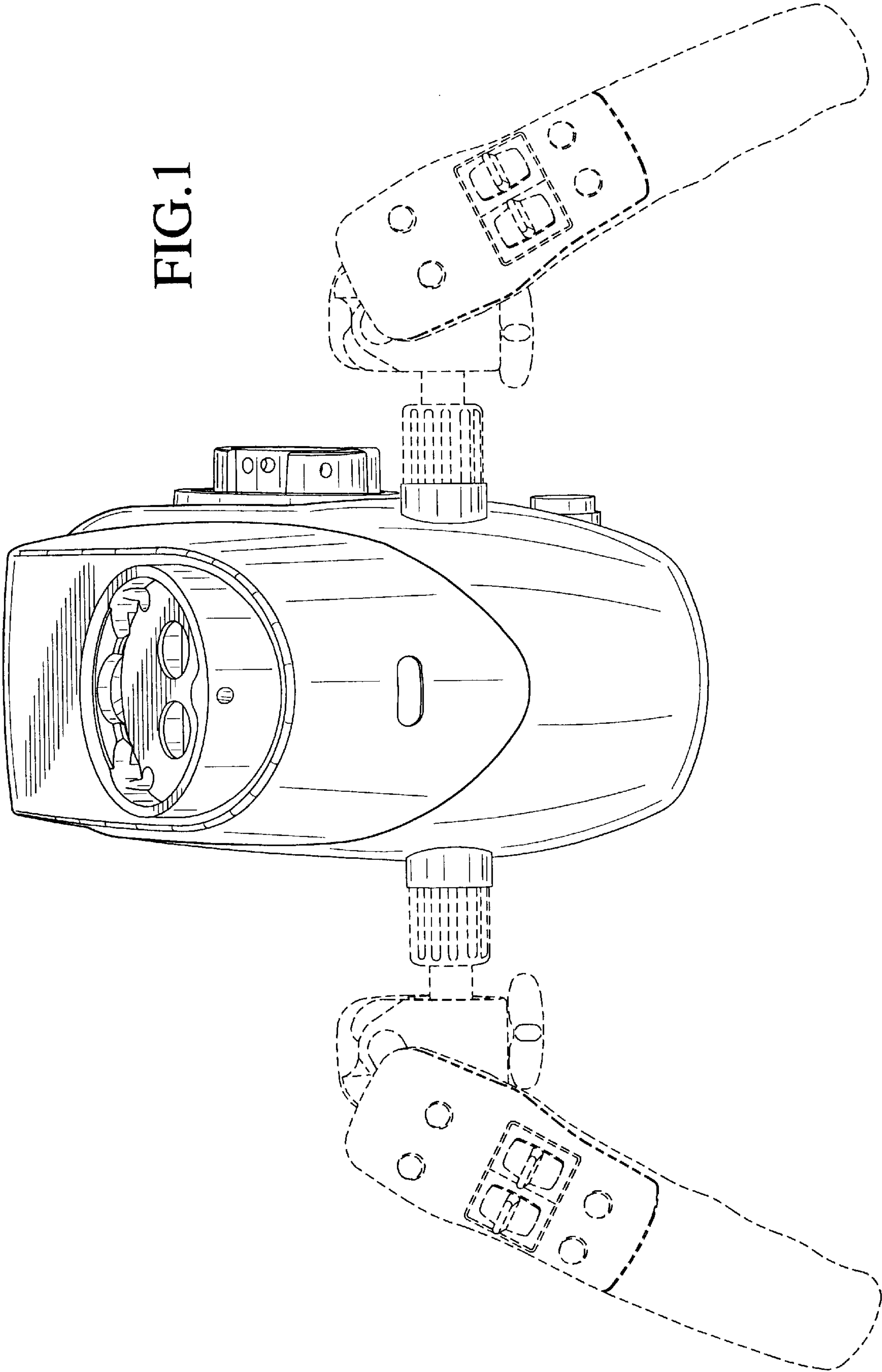

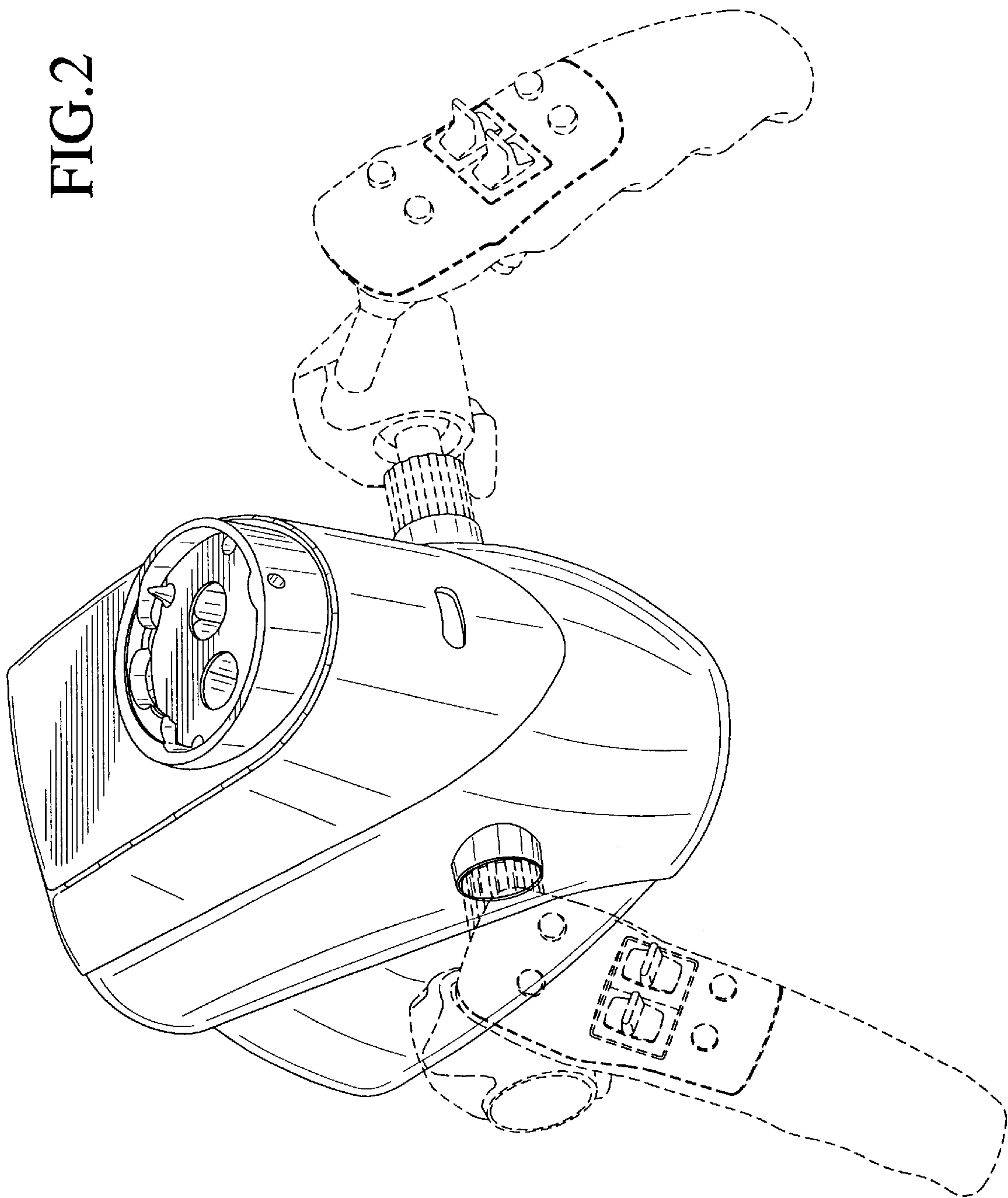

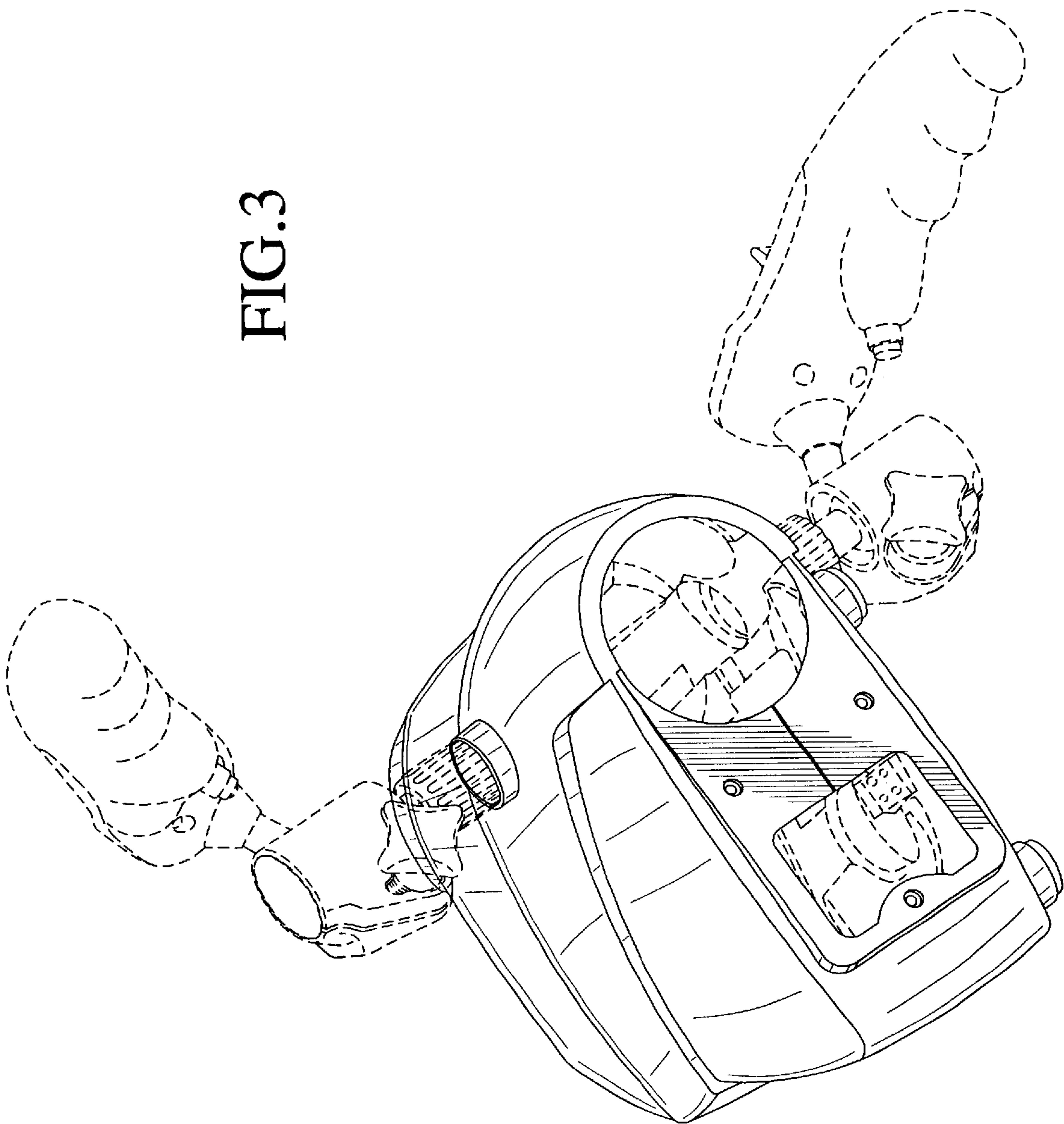

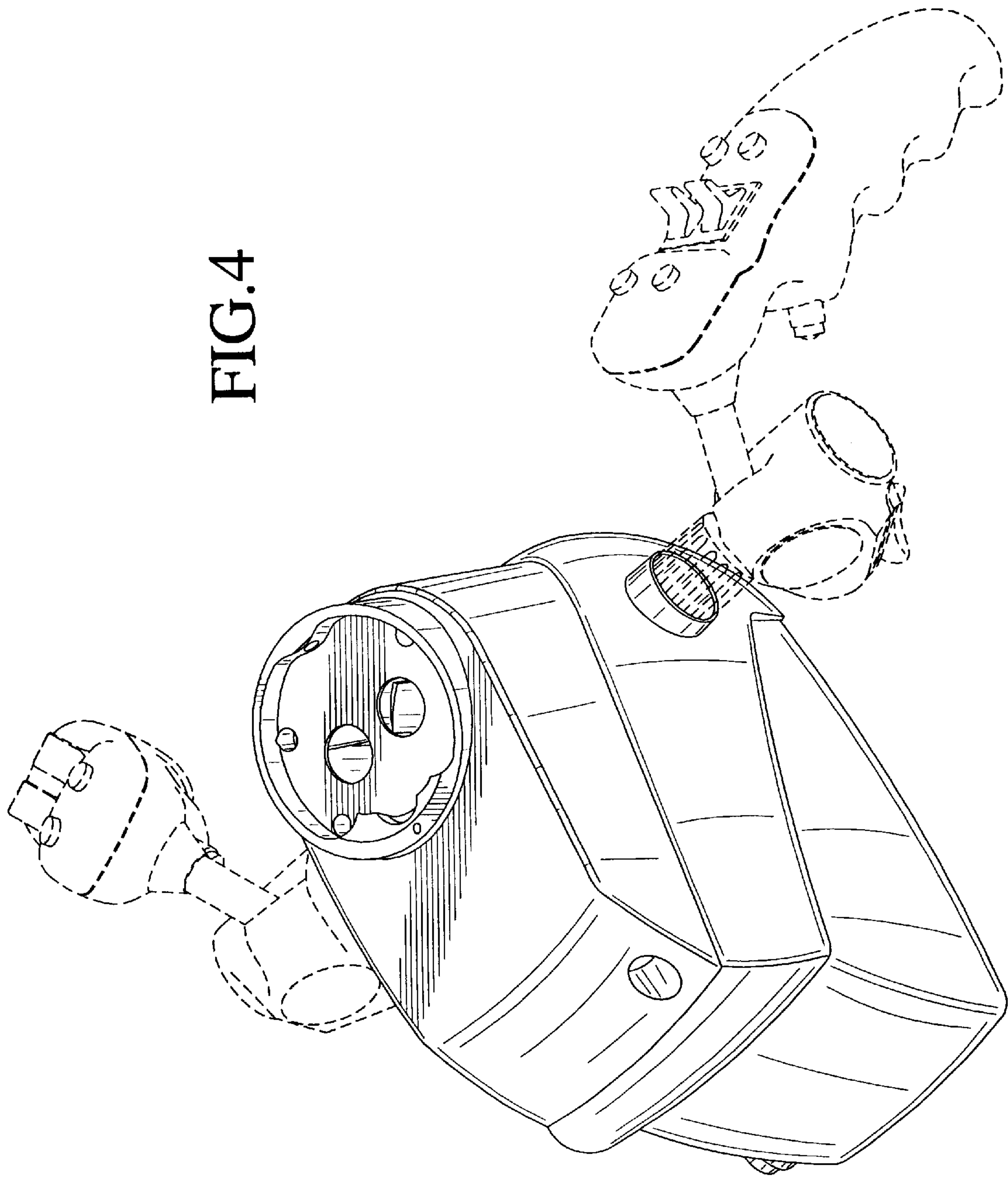

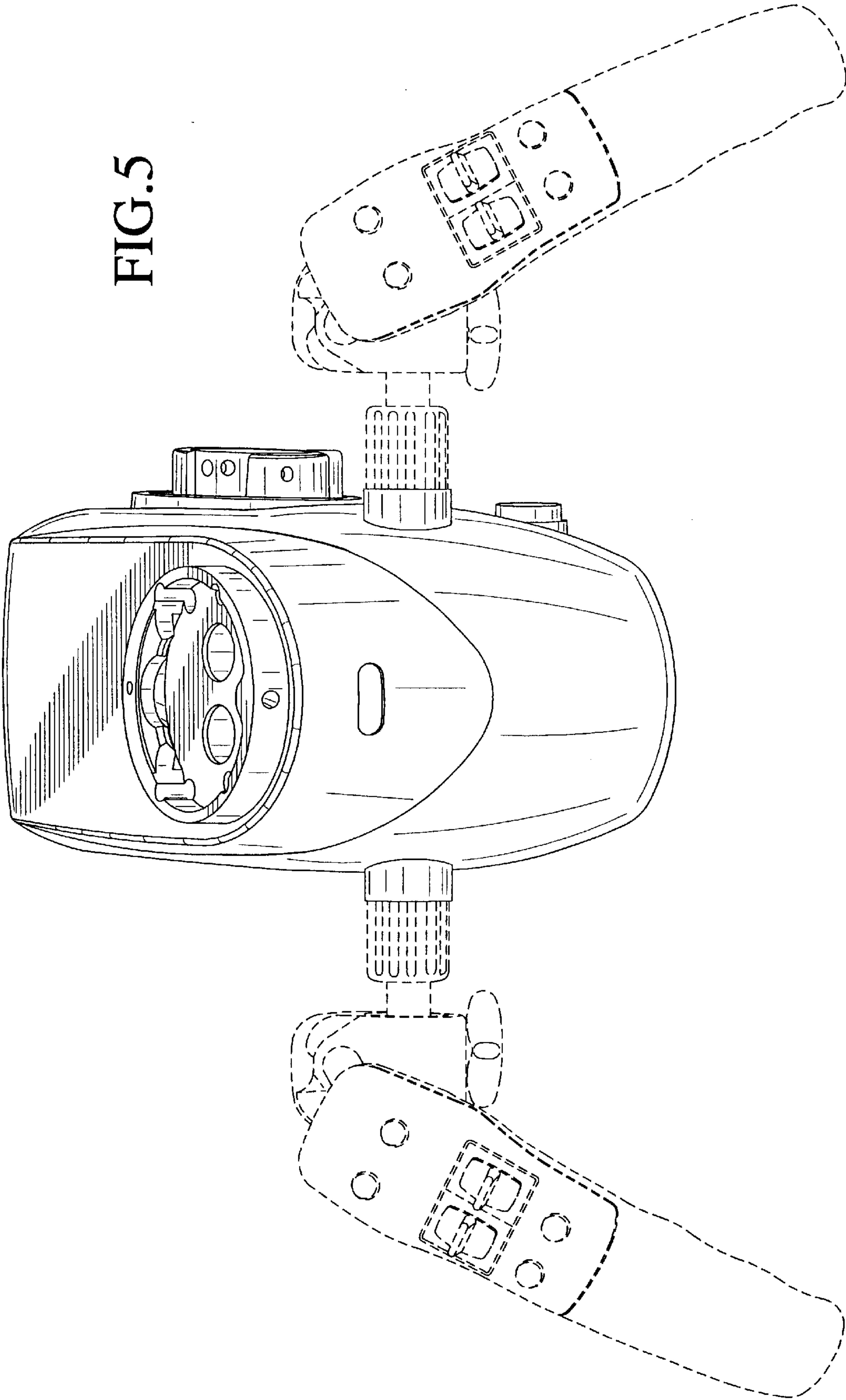

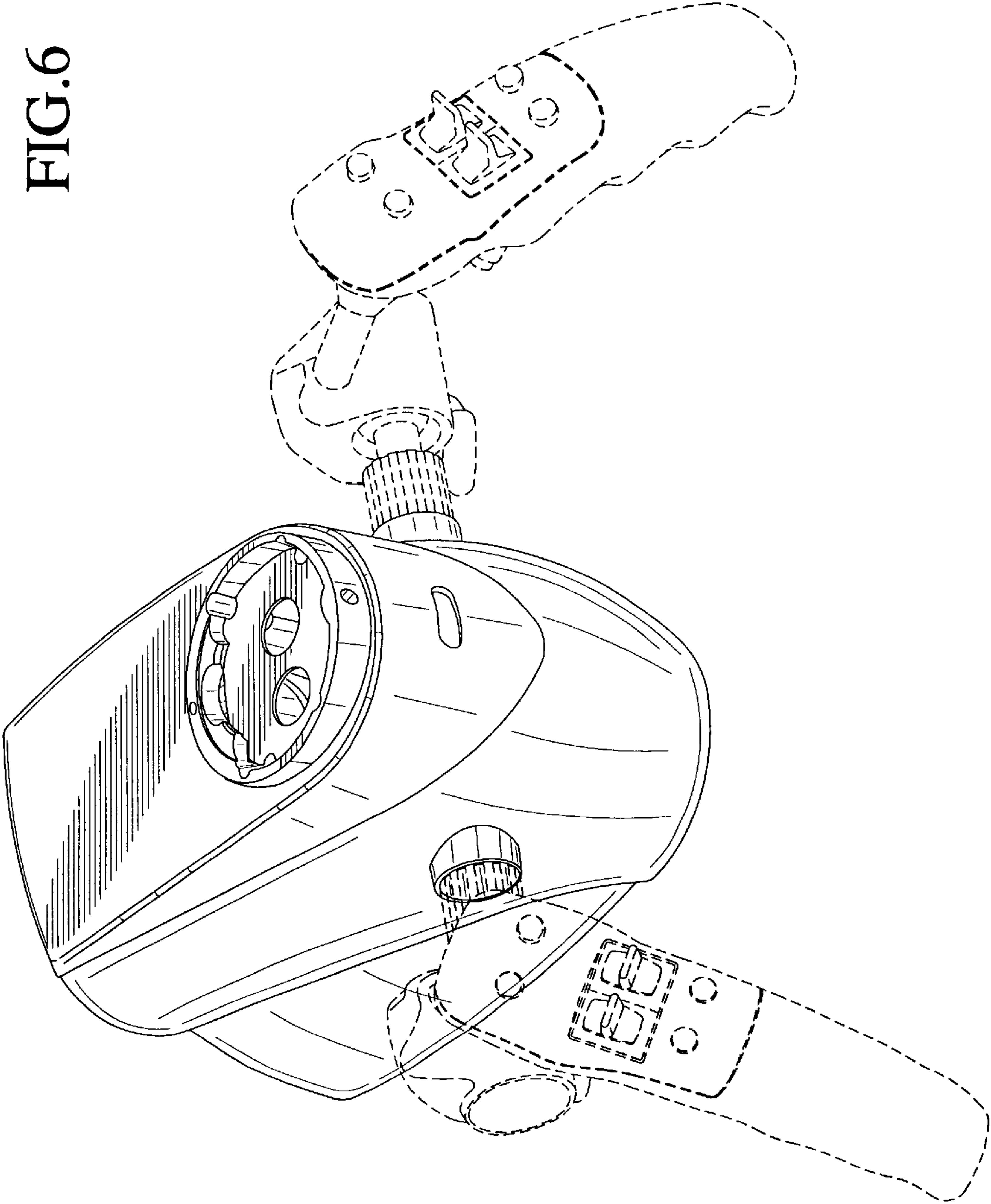

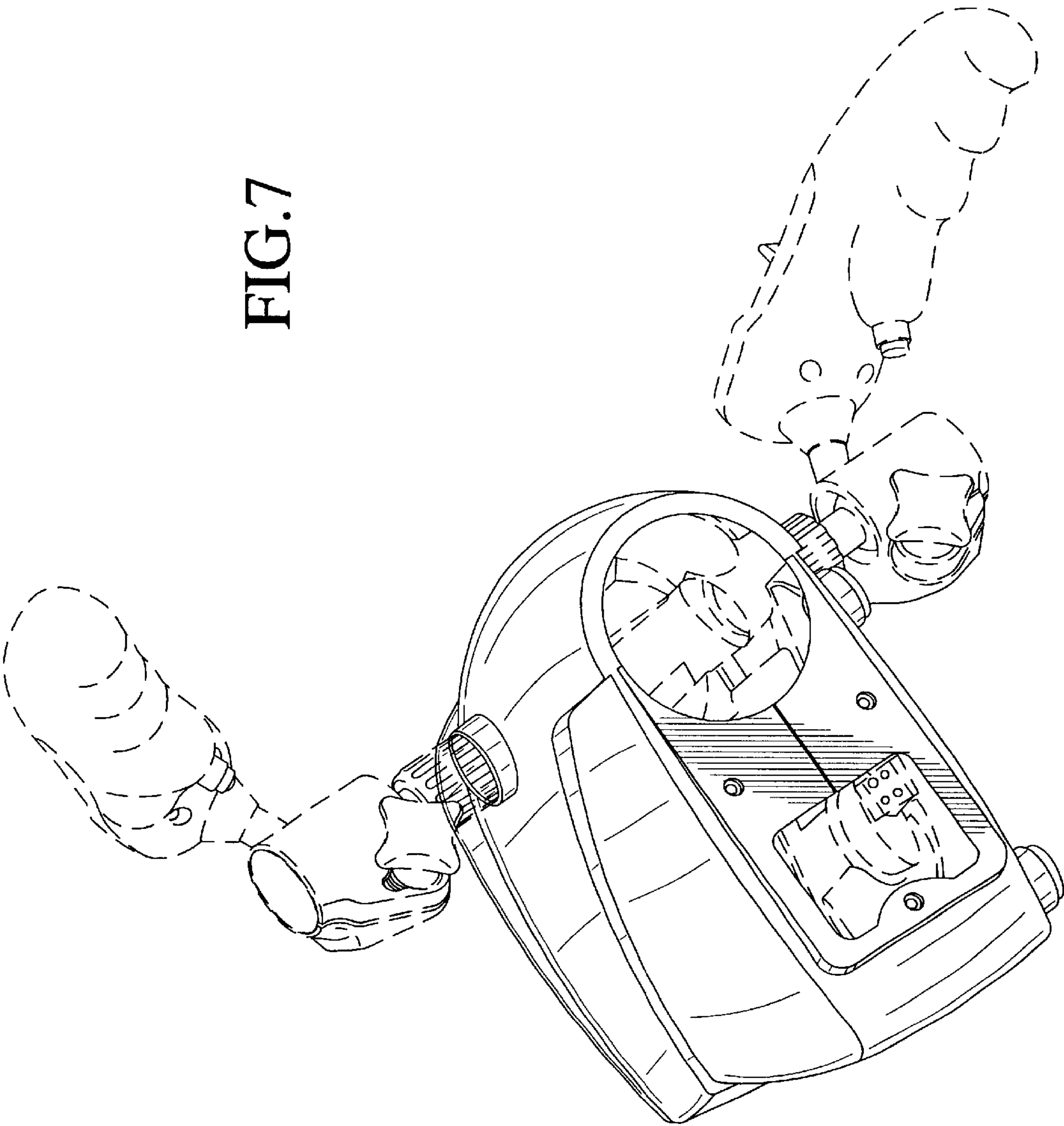

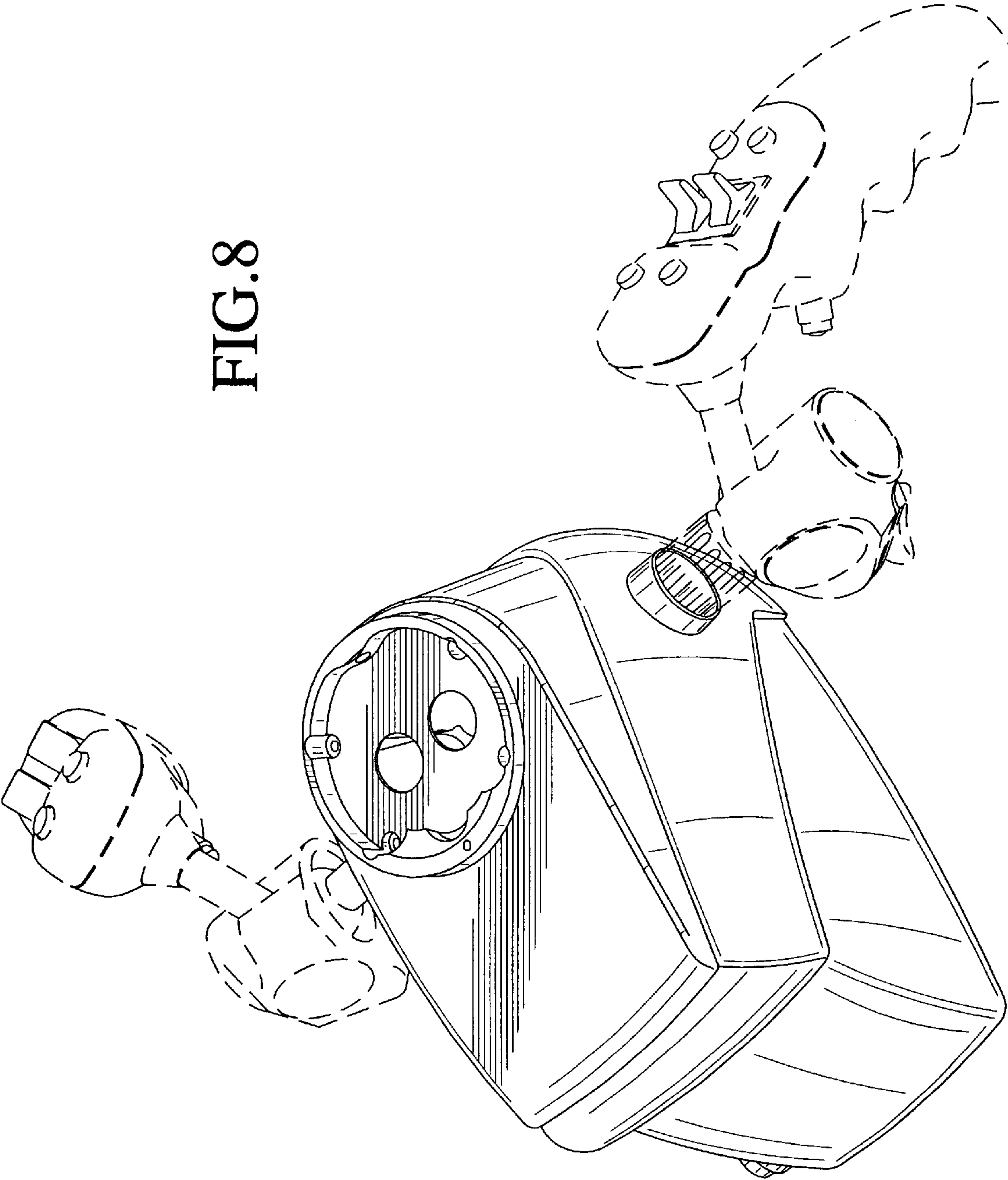

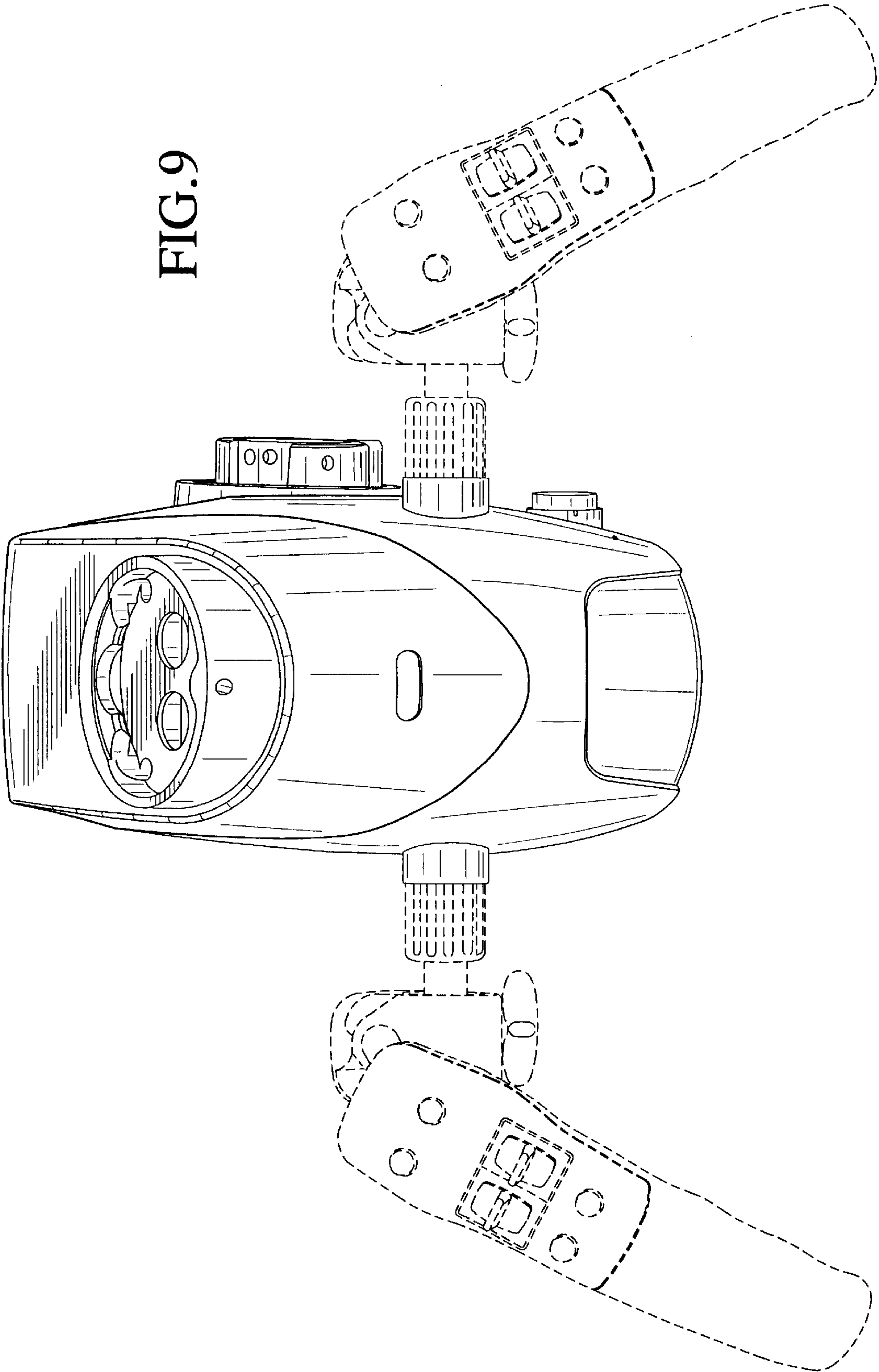

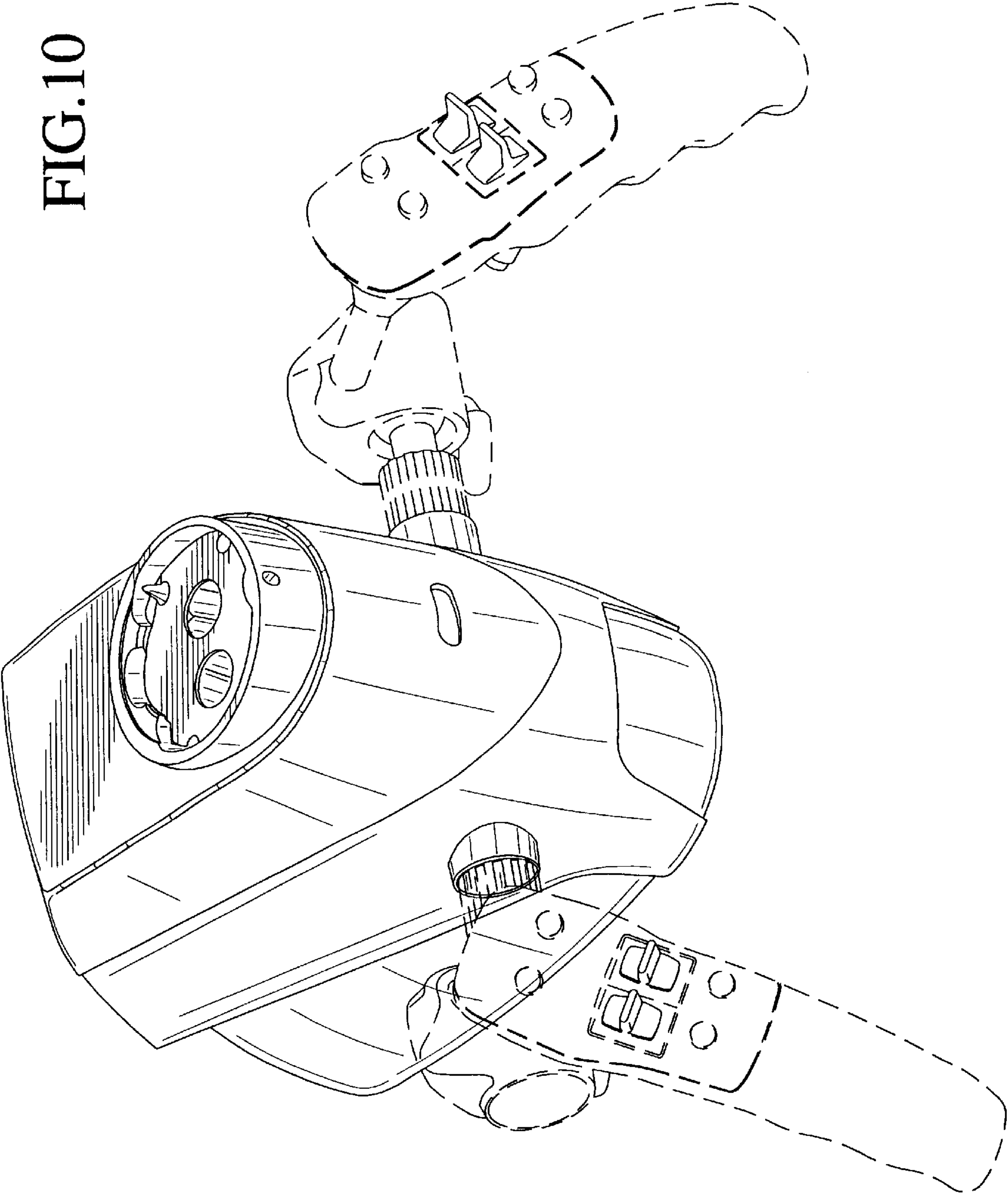

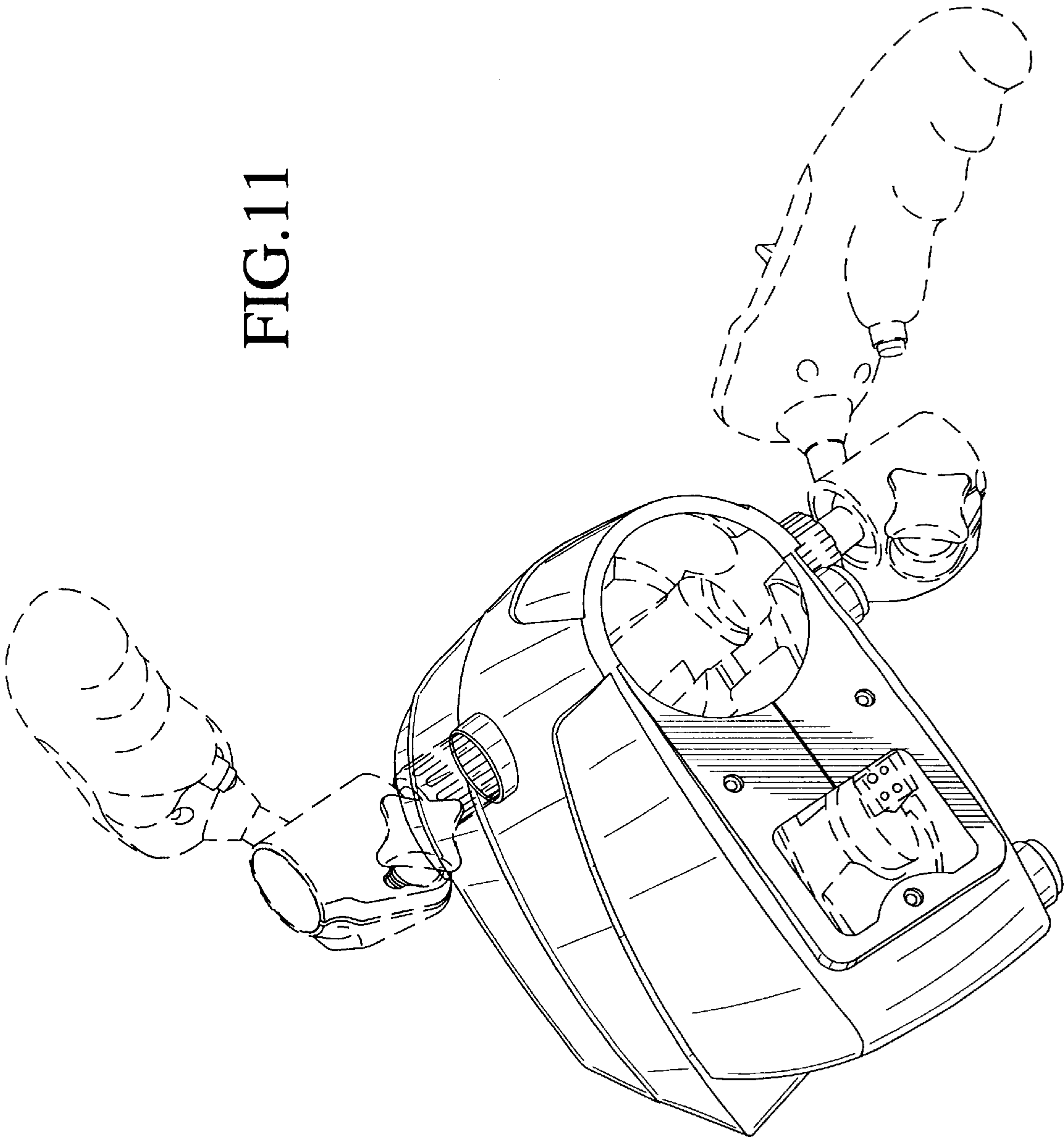

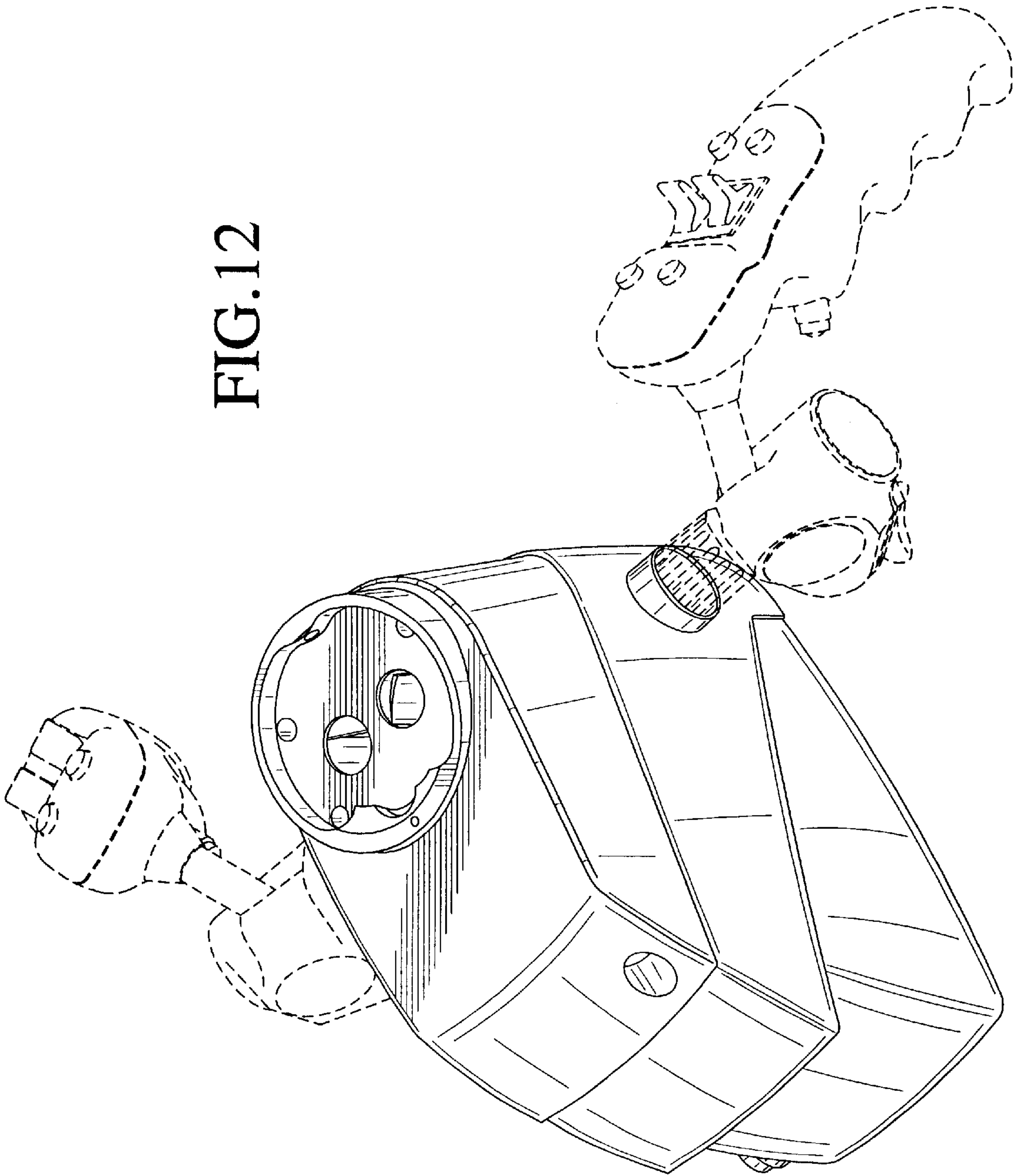

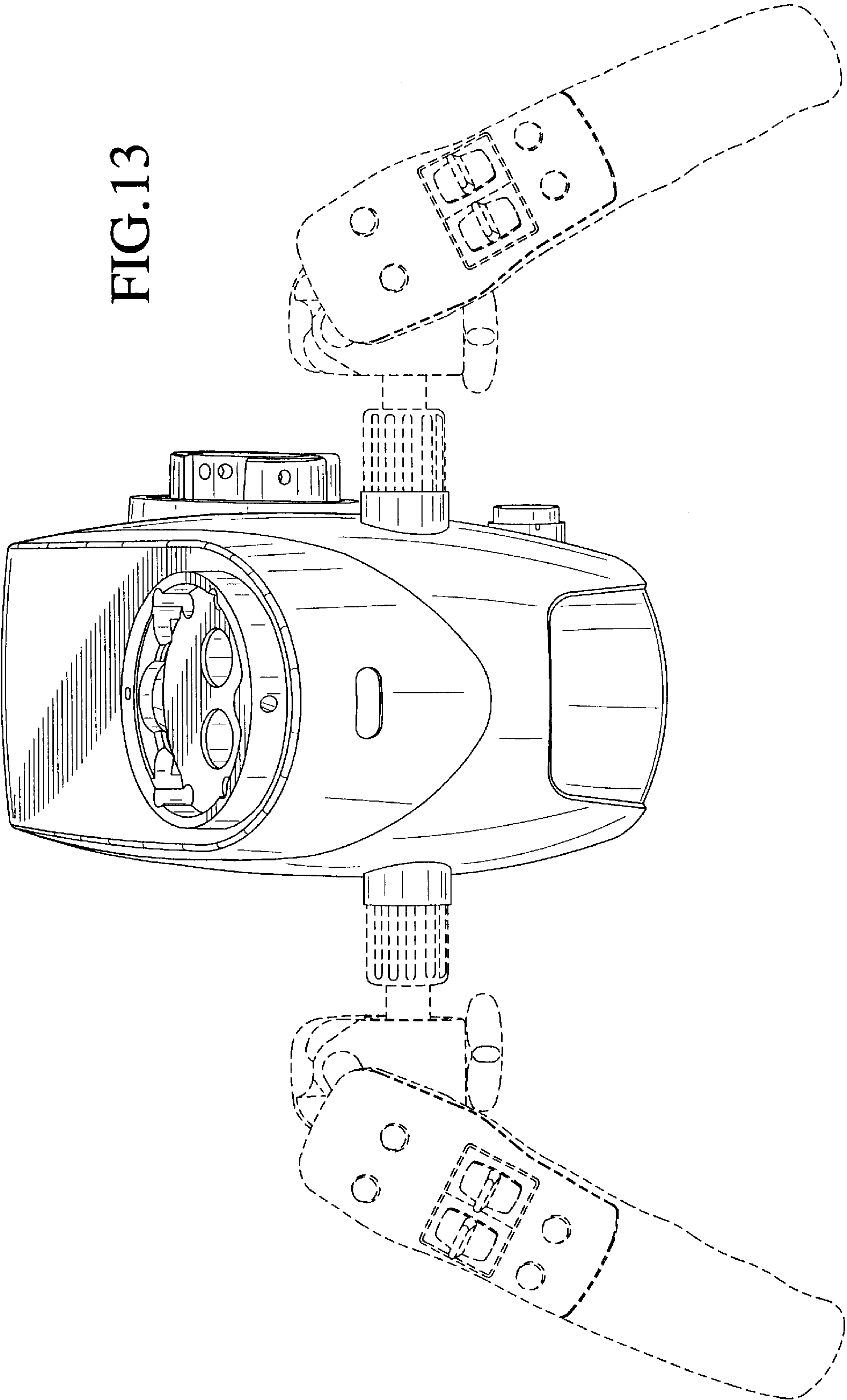

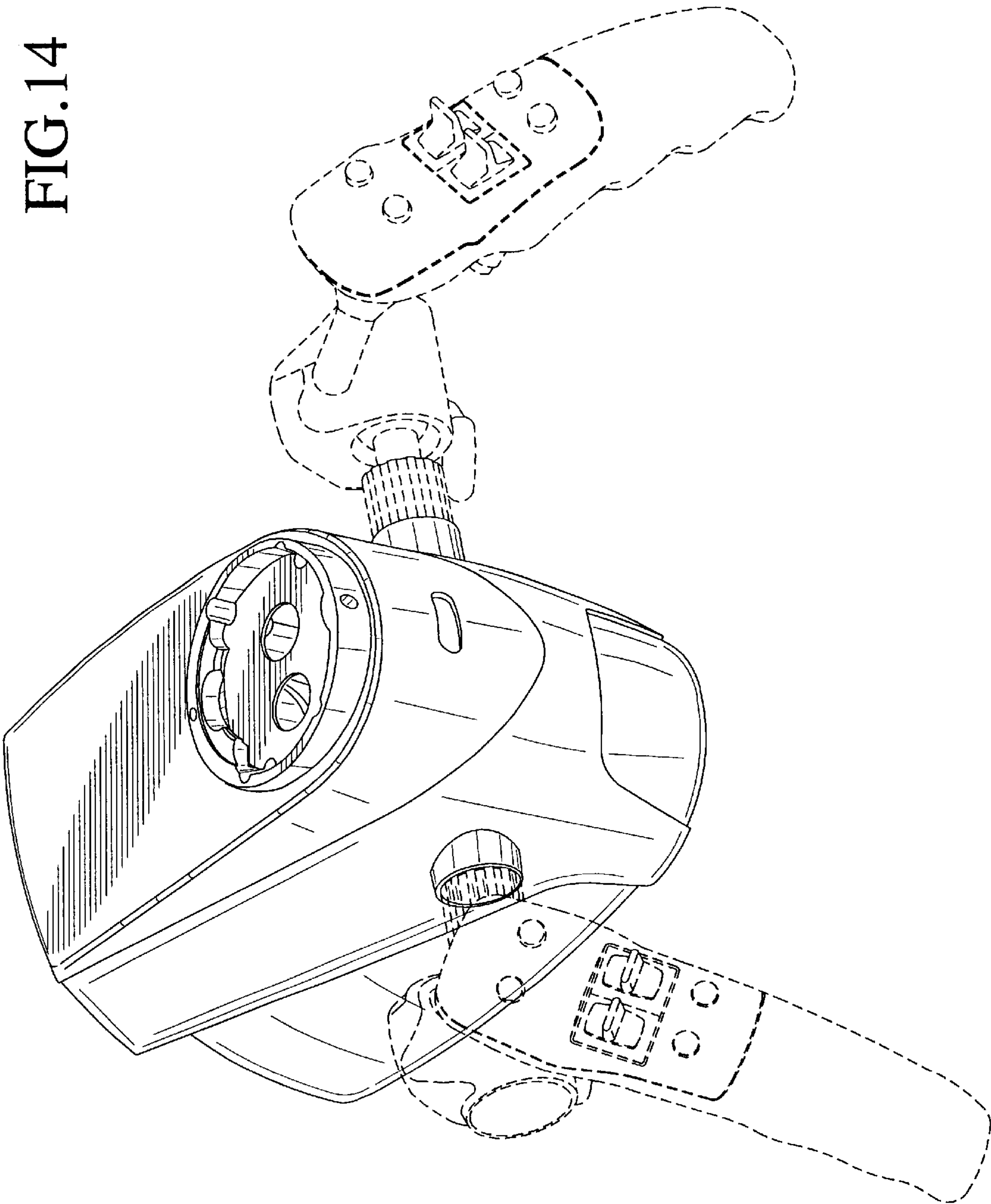

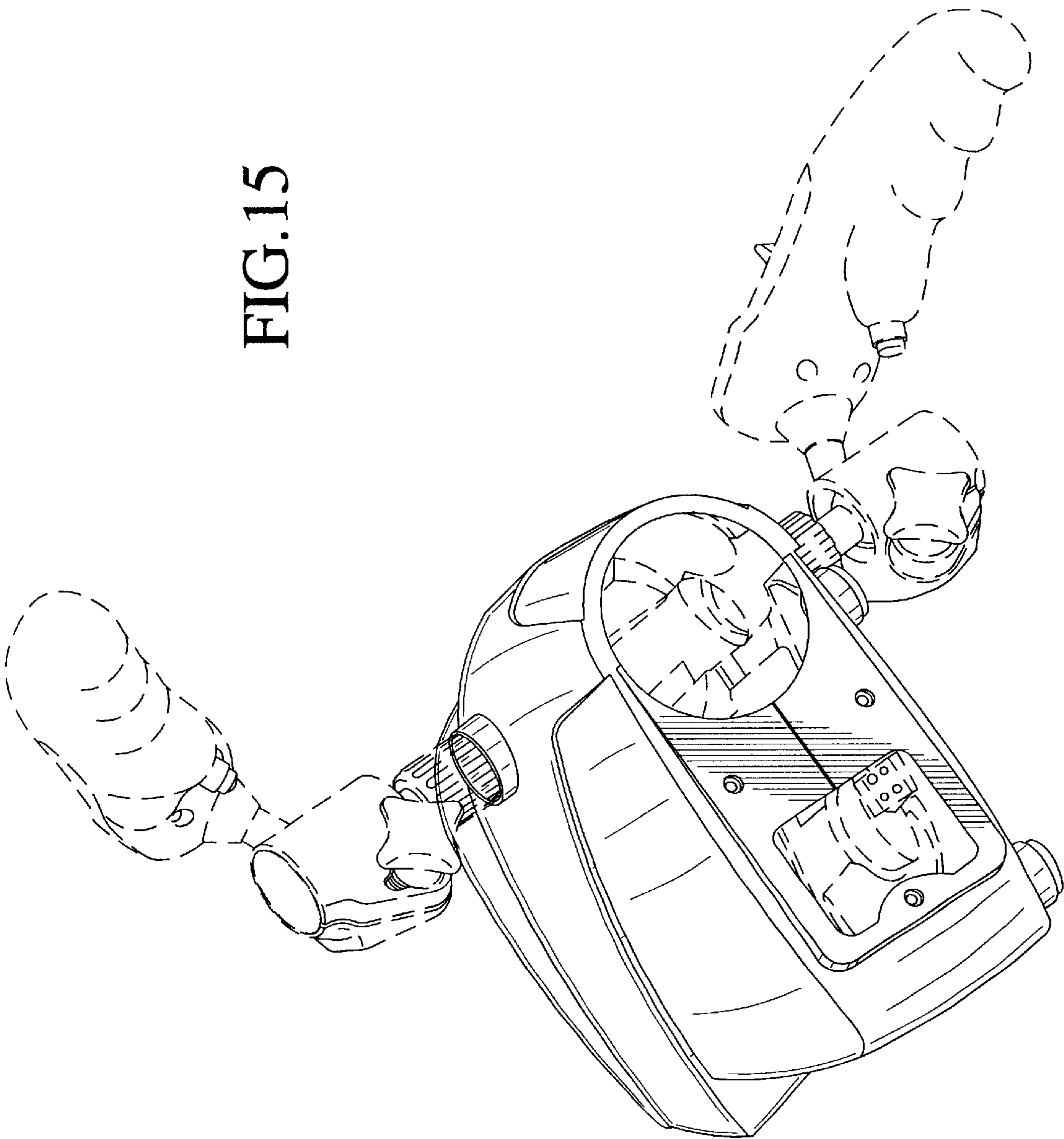
