FIG. 1 is a perspective view of my new design for a poker chip holder;

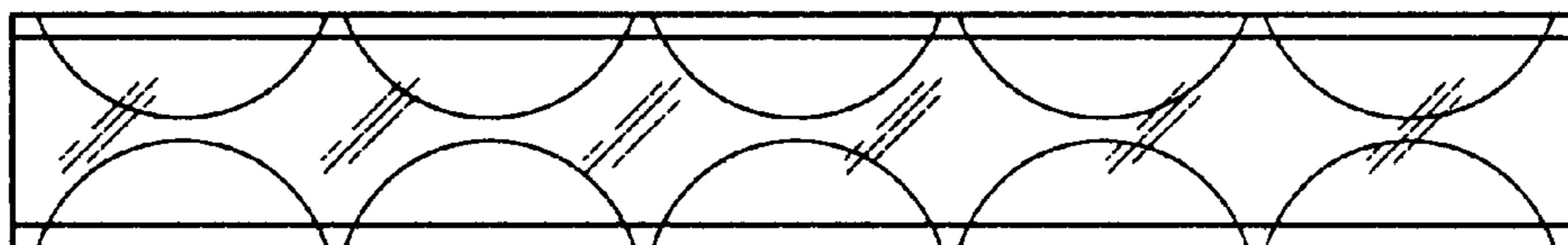
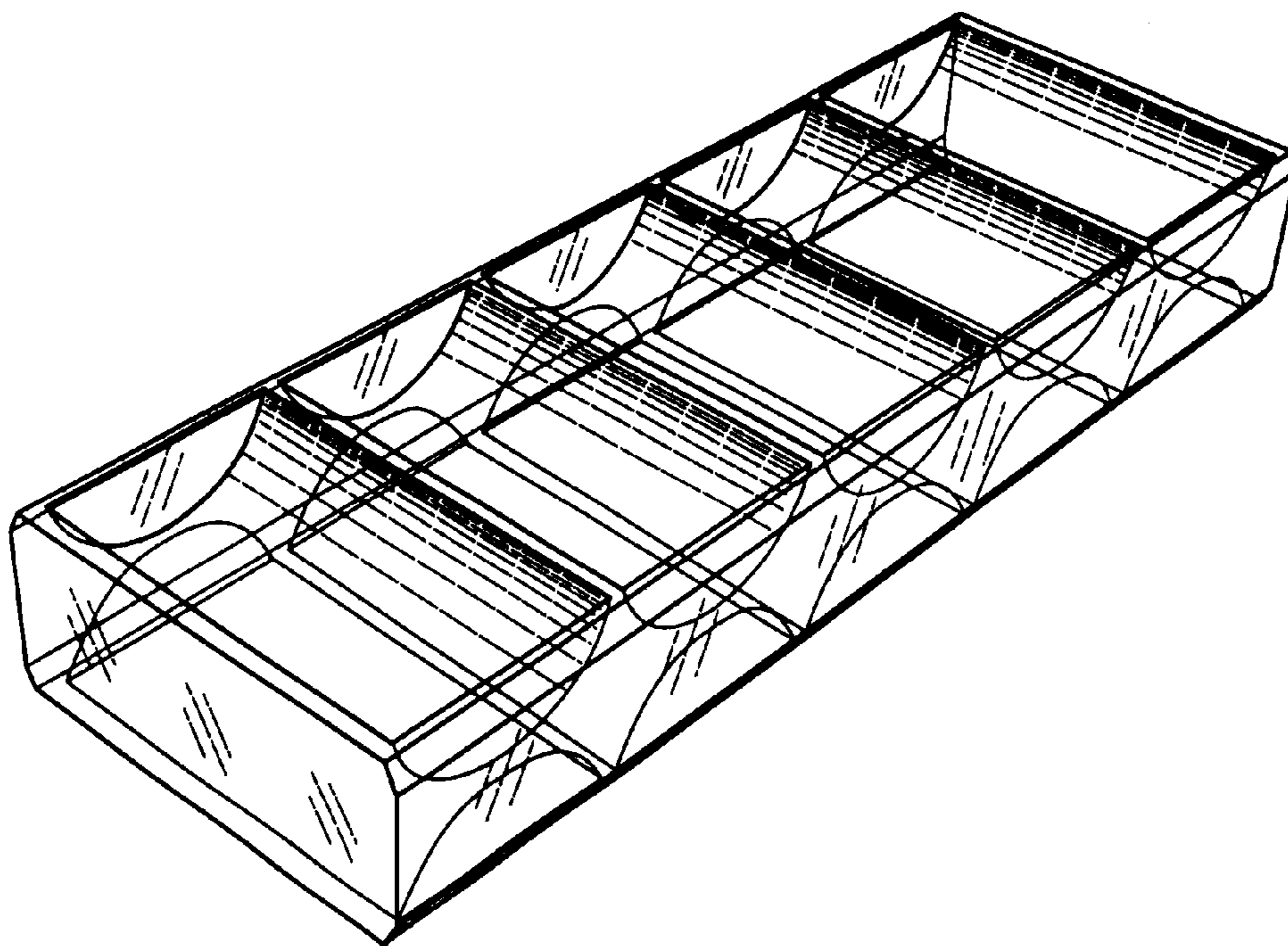
FIG. 2 is an elevational view of the front or back of the claimed invention;

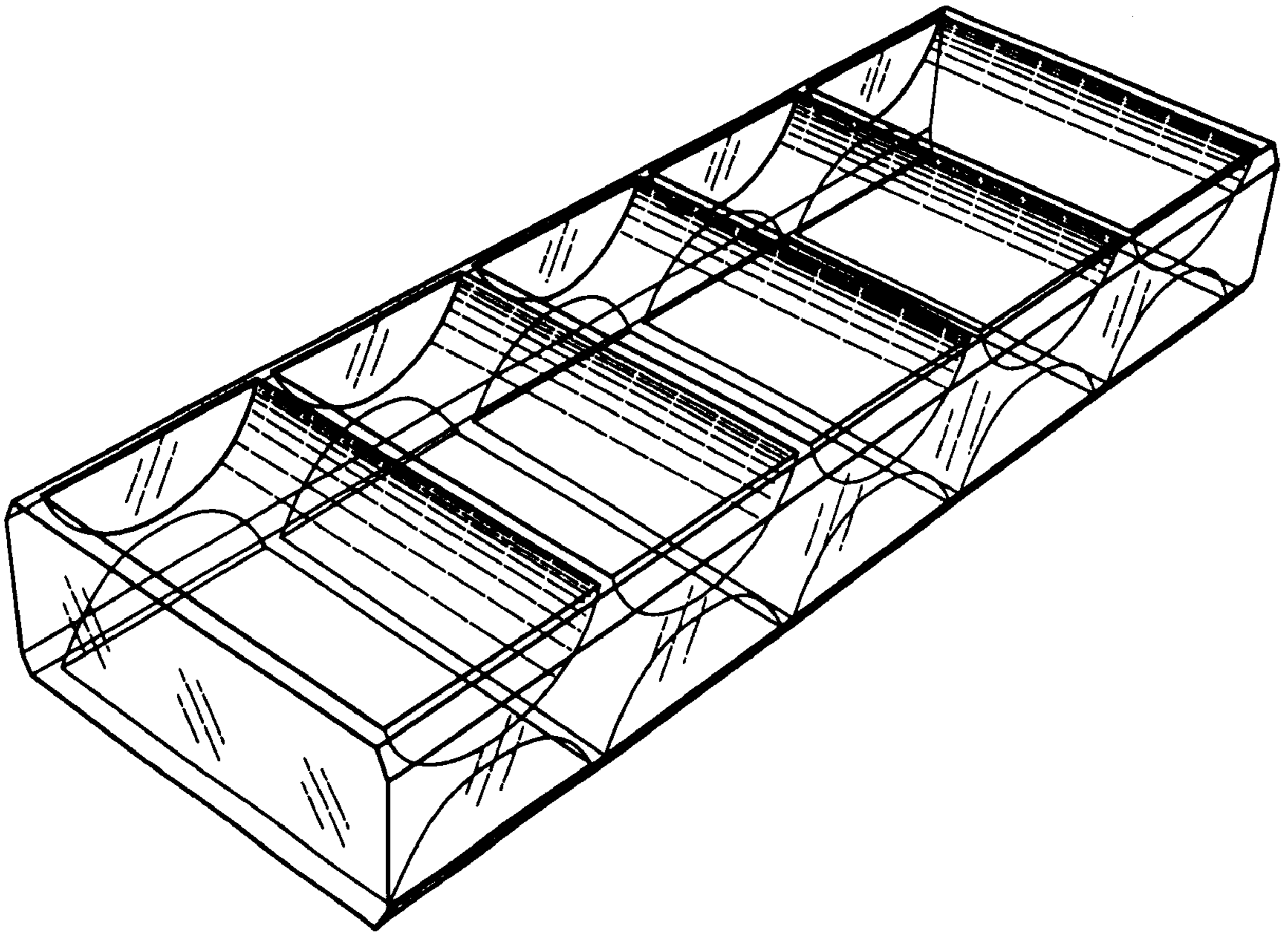

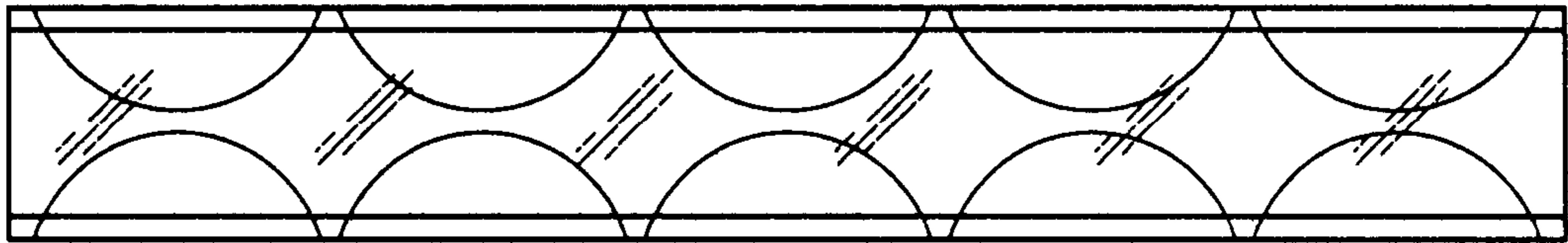

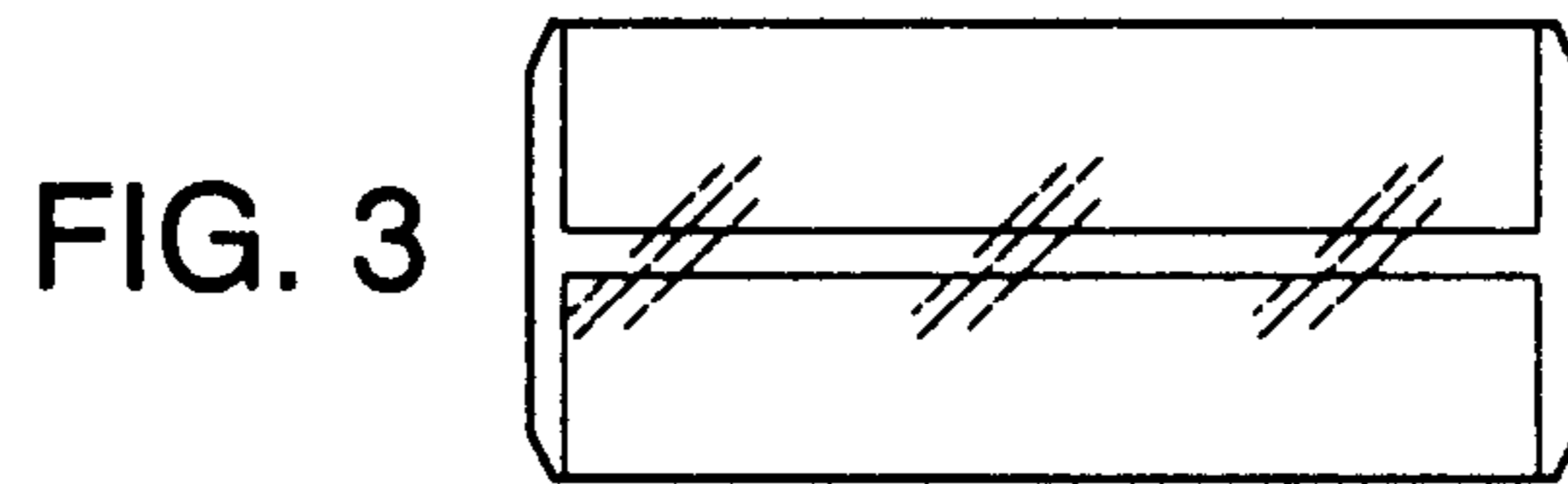

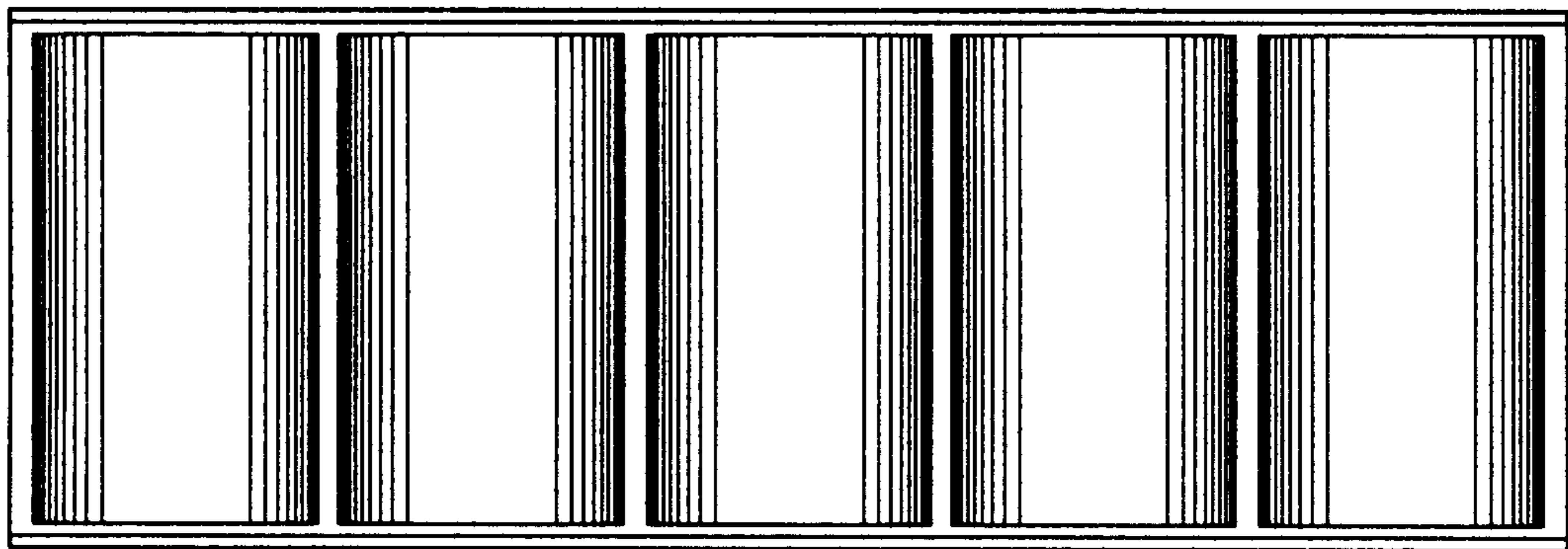

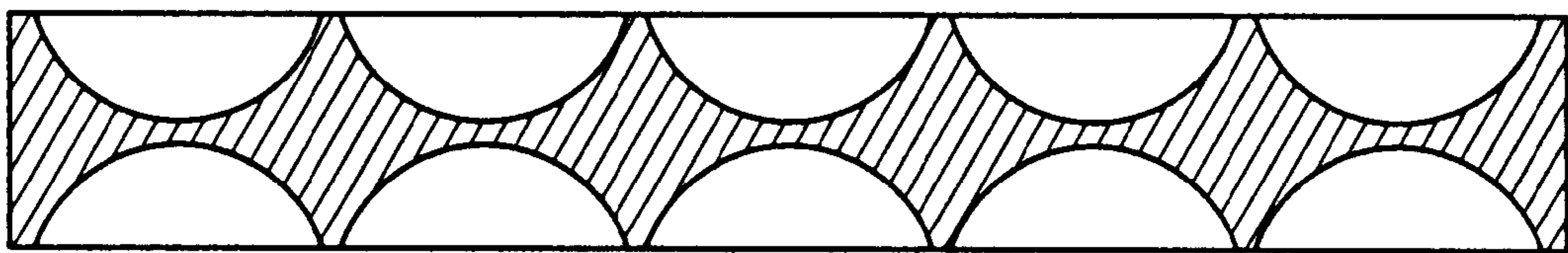
