DESCRIPTION

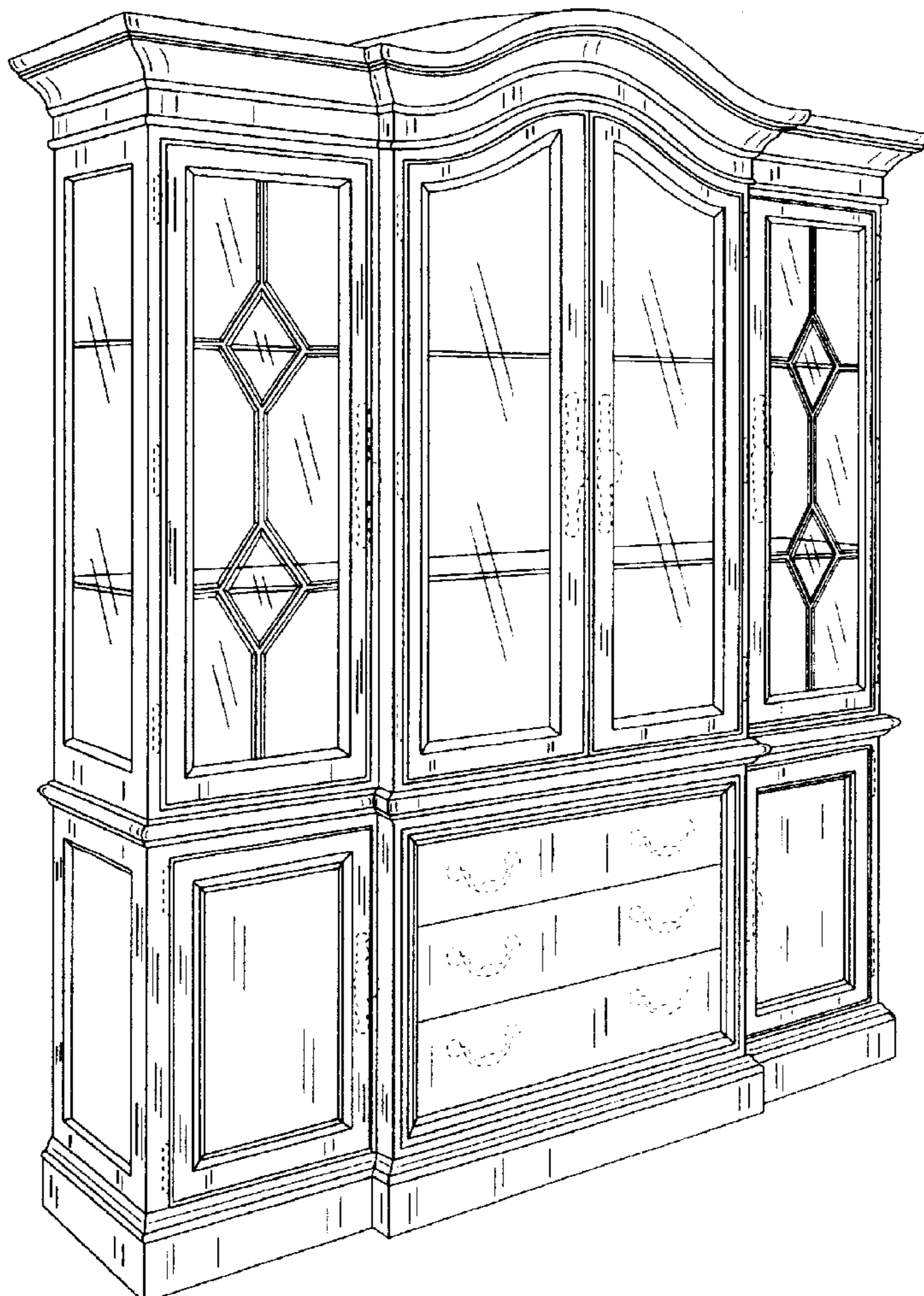
FIG. 1 is a left front perspective view of a display case showing the design of the present invention.

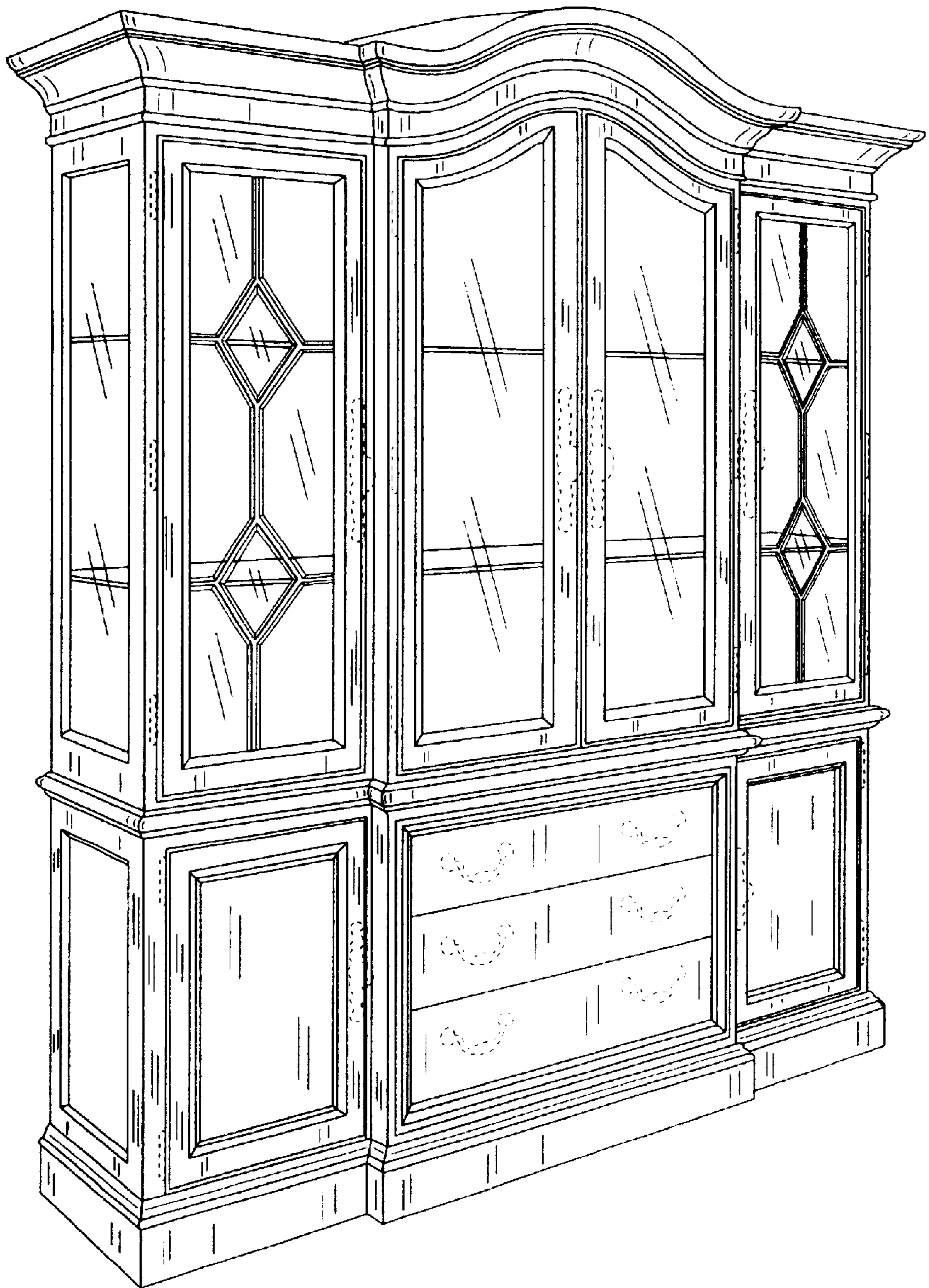

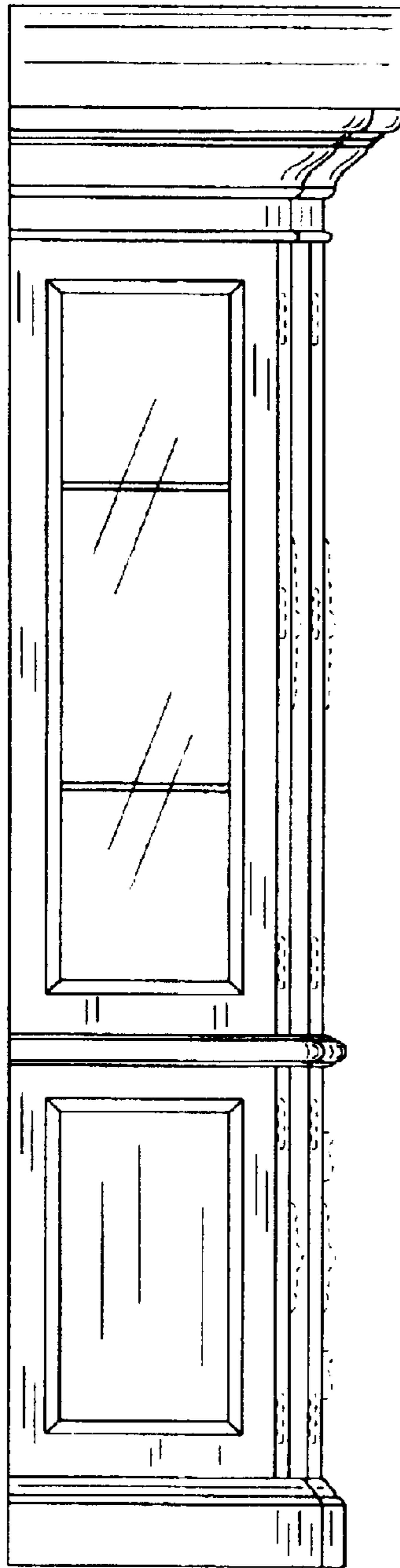

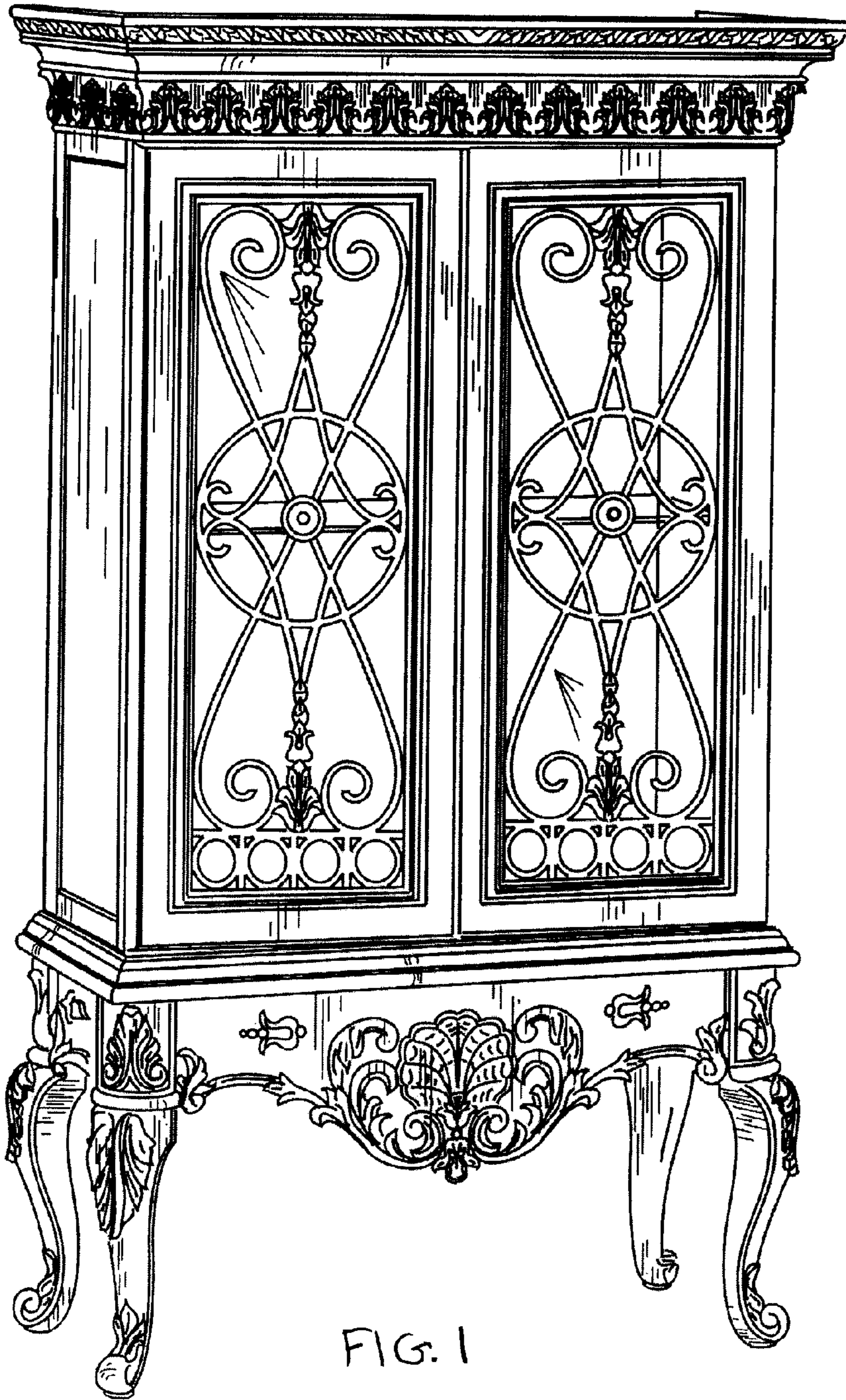

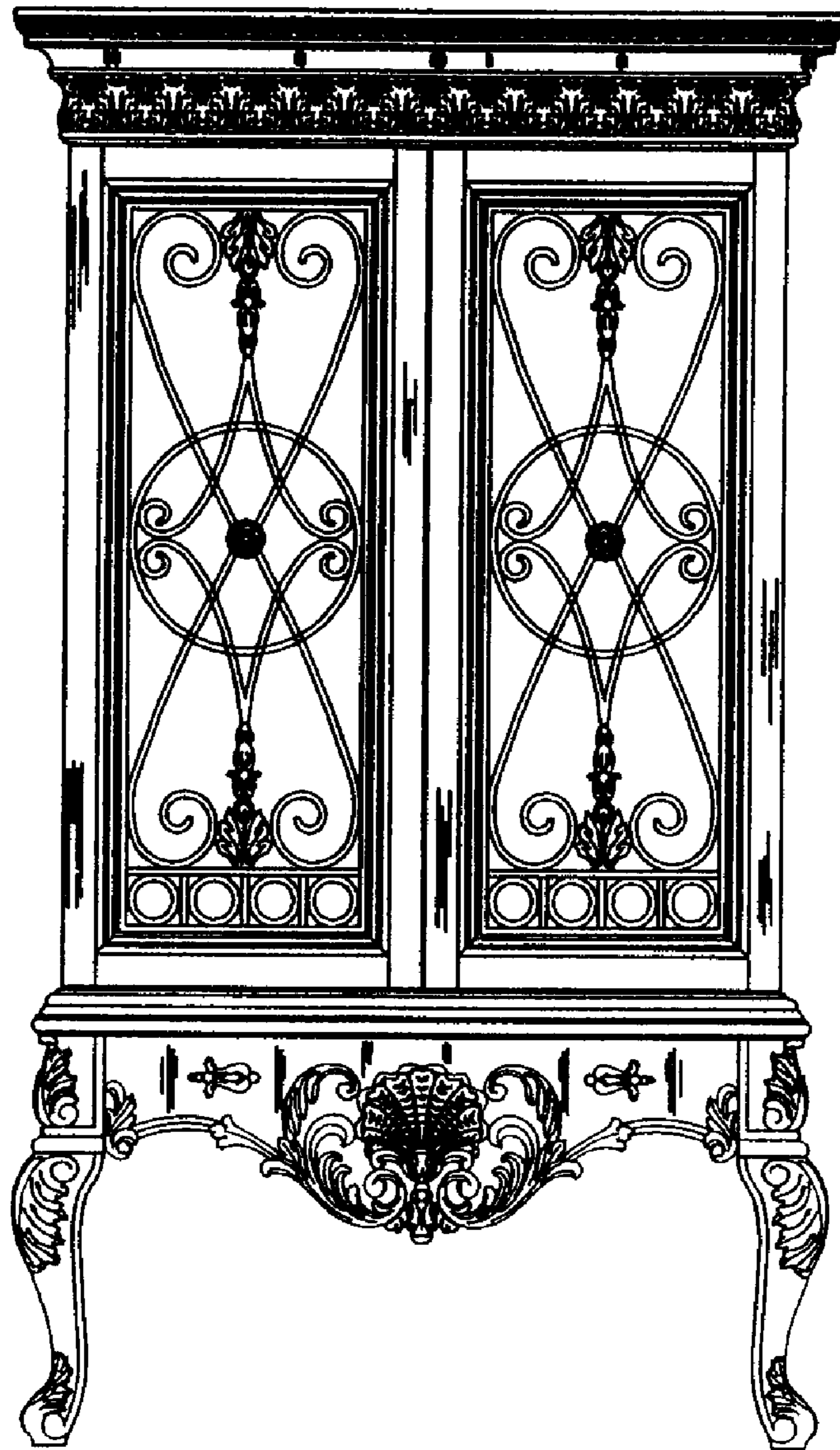

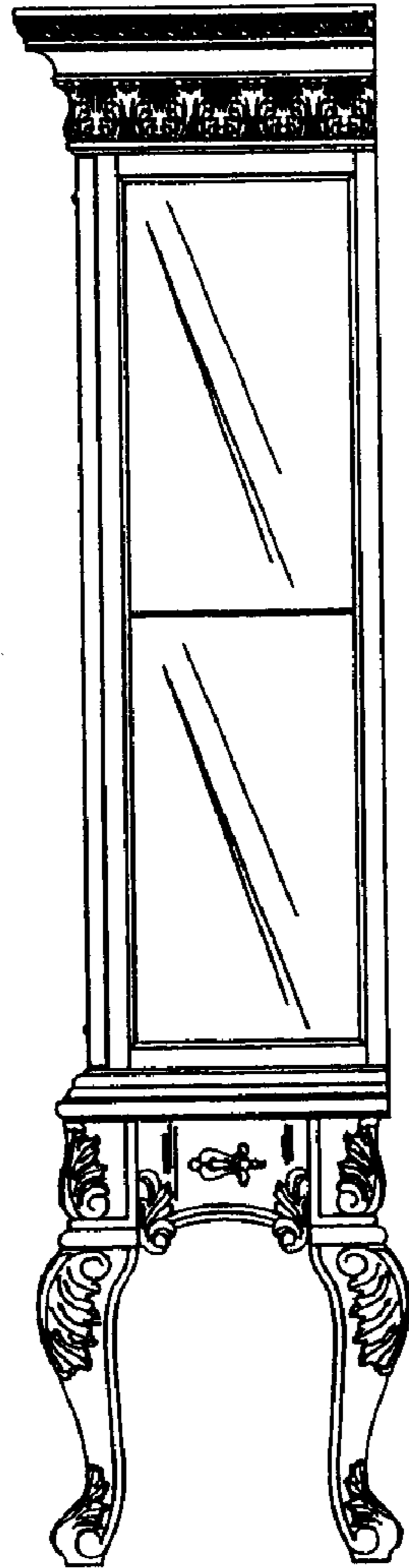
