FIG. 6 is a bottom view of my instant invention.

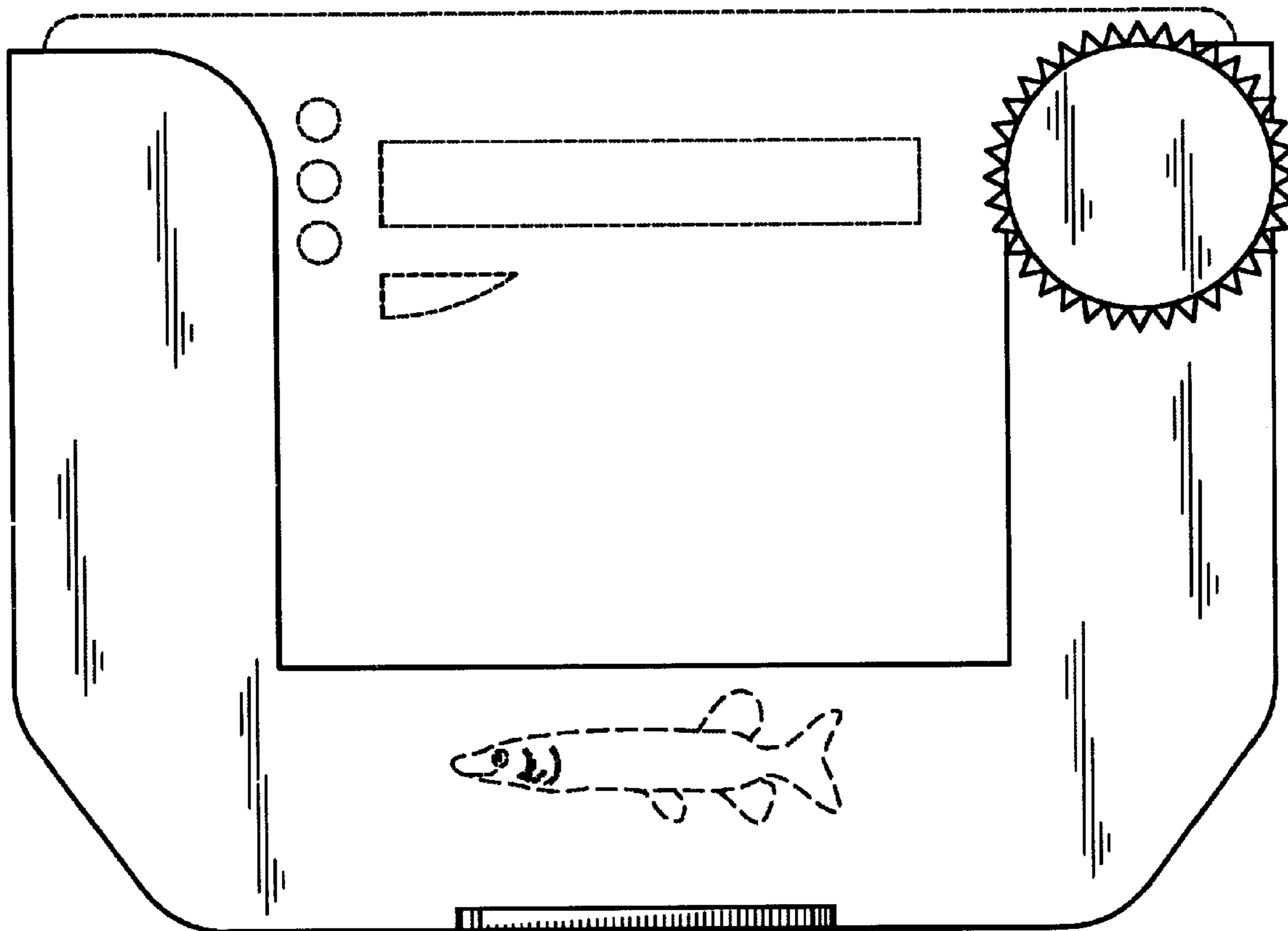

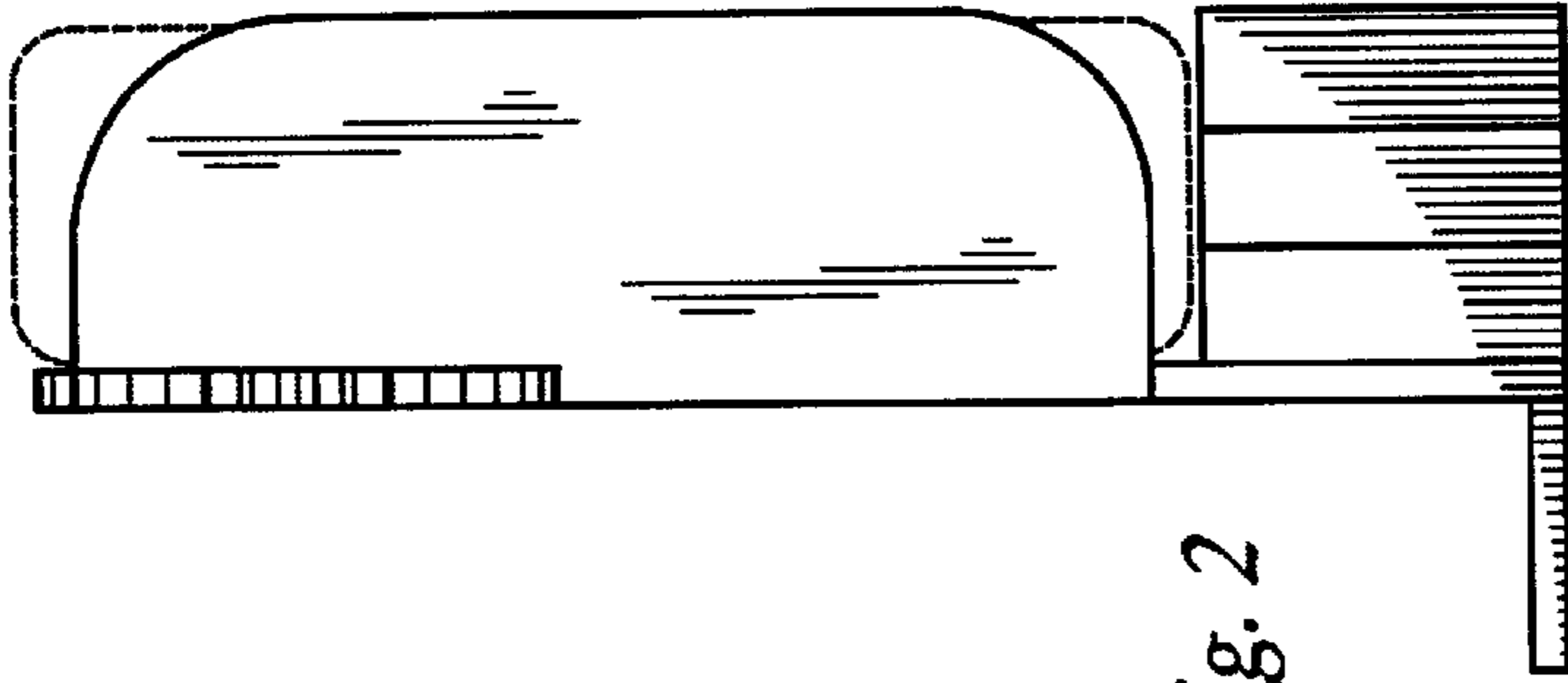

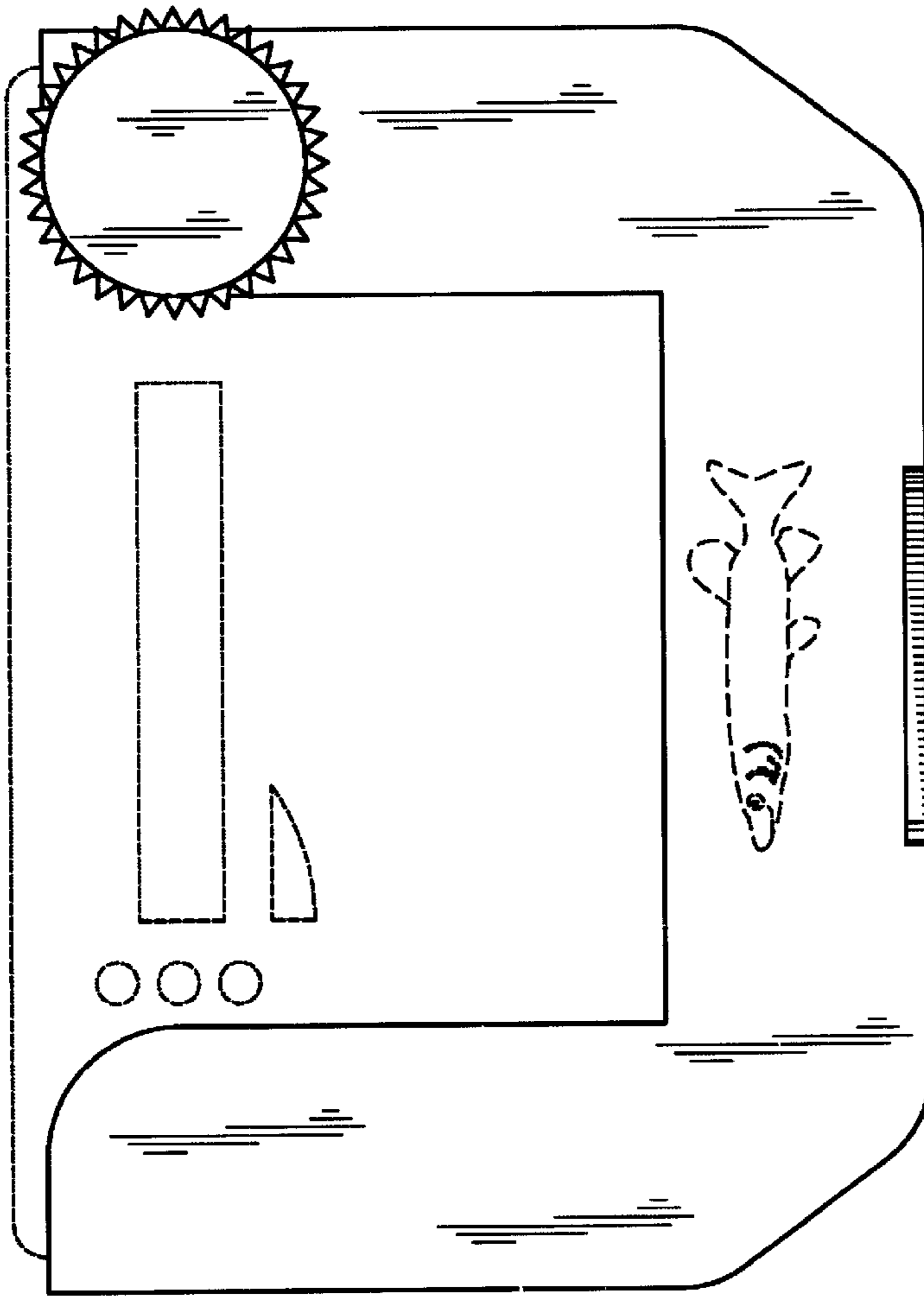

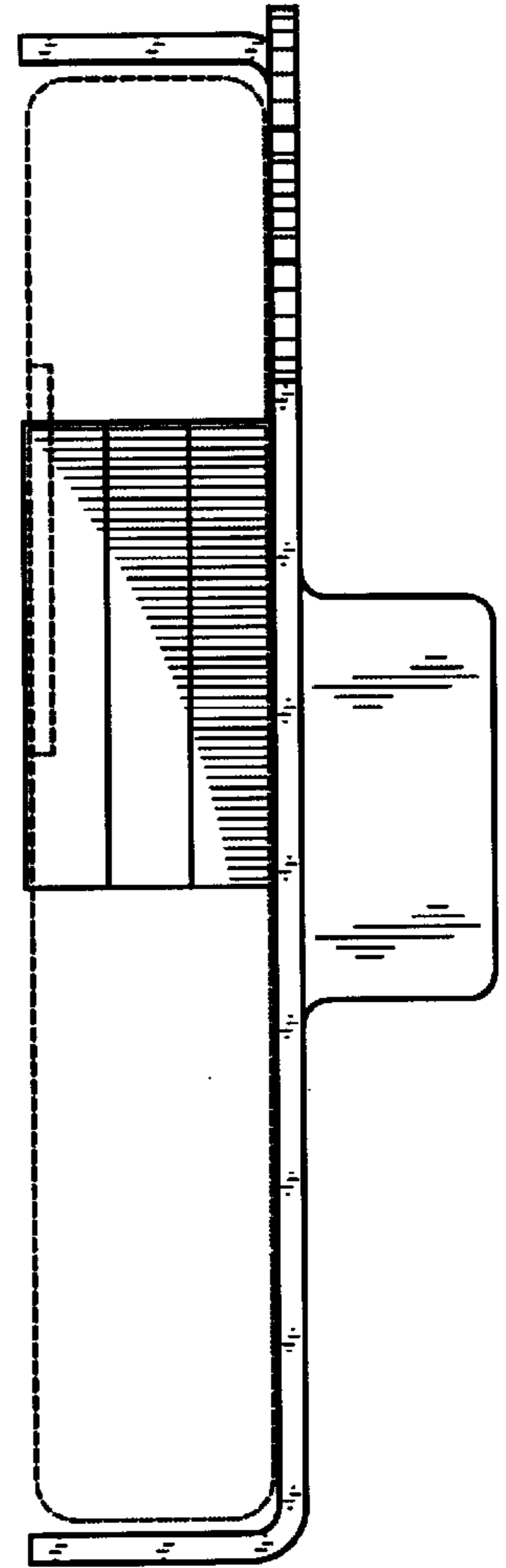

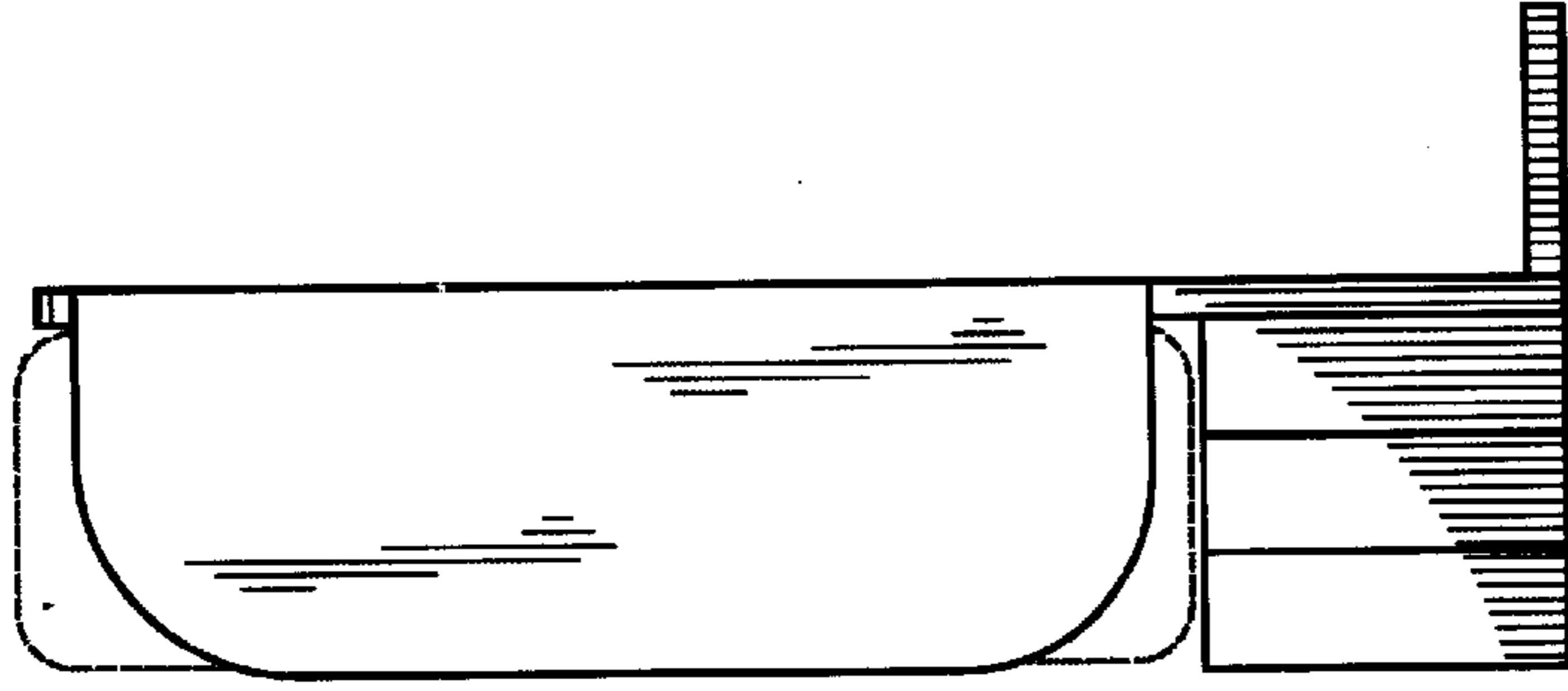

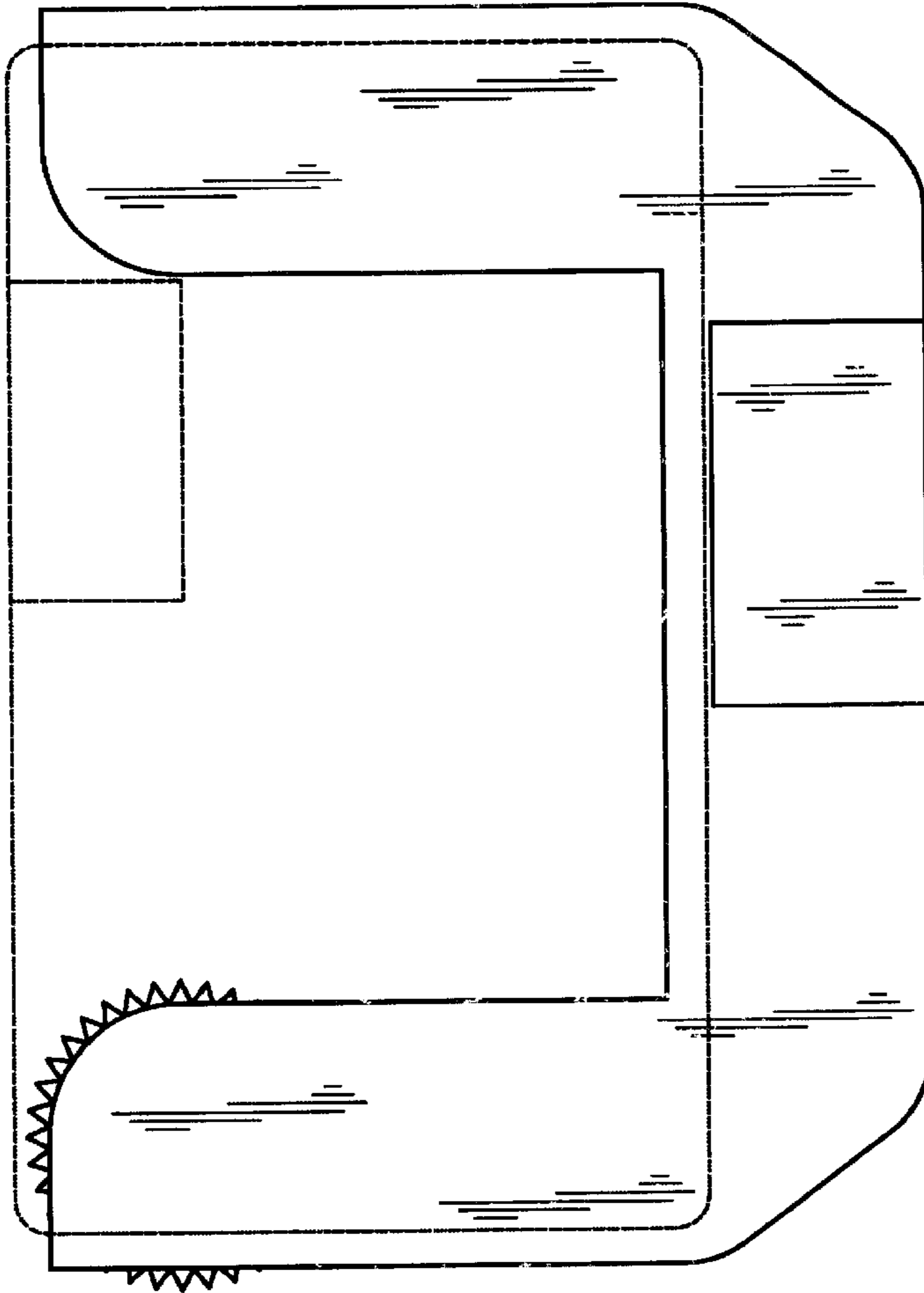

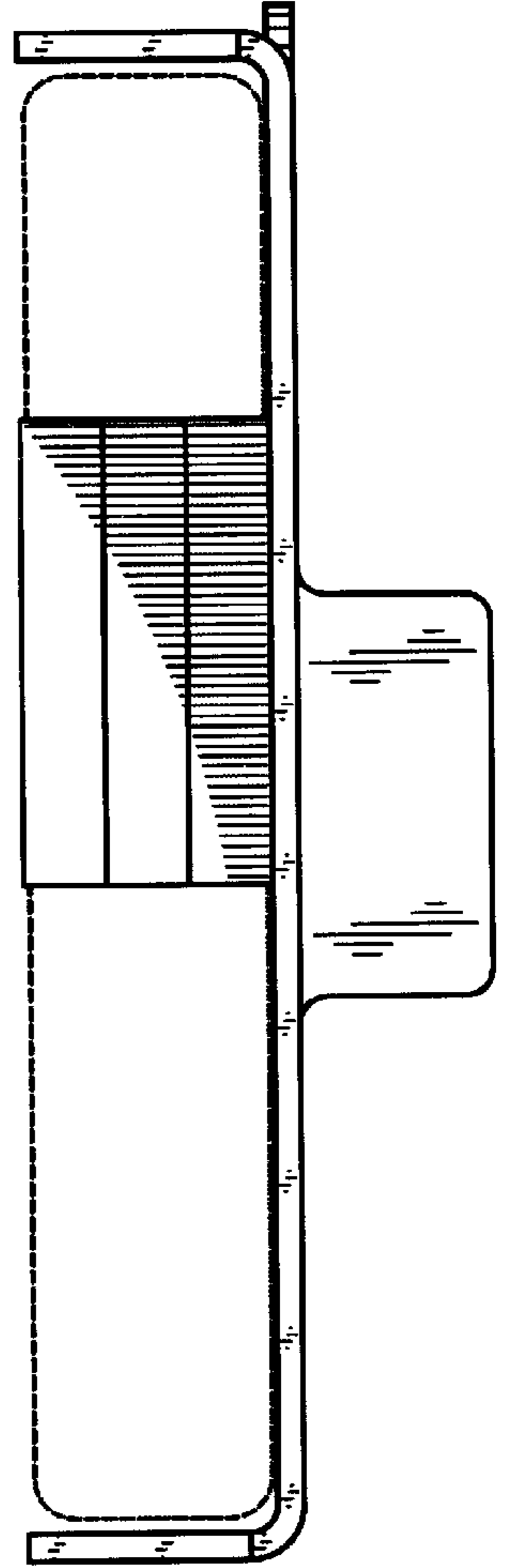
