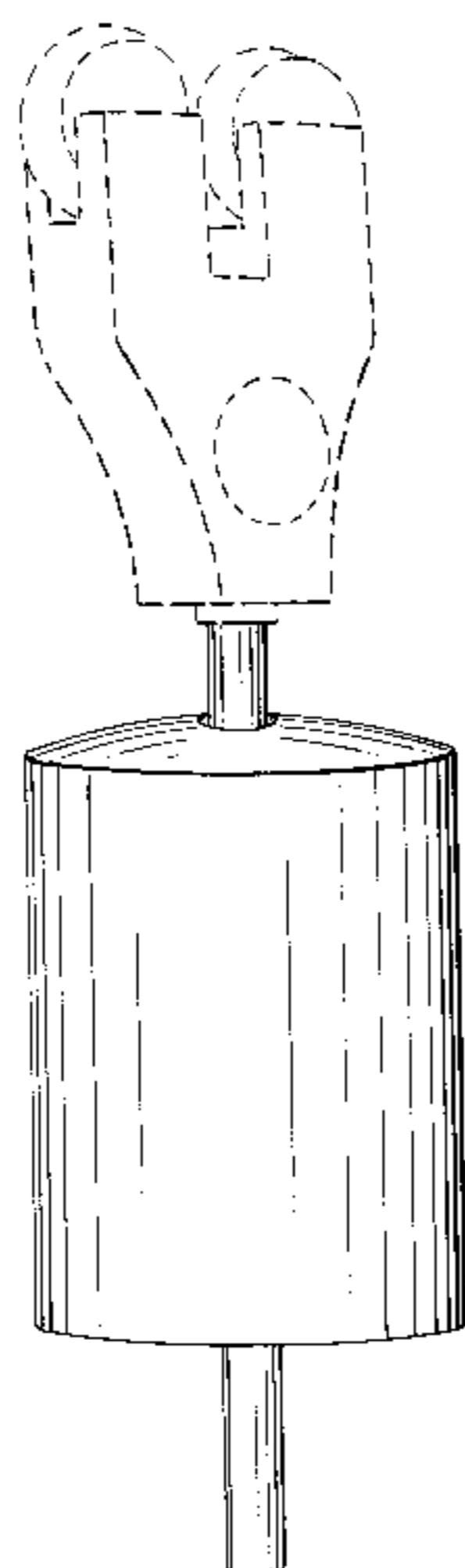
(57) **CLAIM**

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top, left, front perspective view of a sign showing our new design;
FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof;
FIG. 3 is a front elevation view thereof;
FIG. 4 is a left side elevation view thereof; and,
FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view thereof.
The subject matter shown in broken line represents unclaimed environmental structure which is shown for illustrative purposes and forms no part of the claimed design.

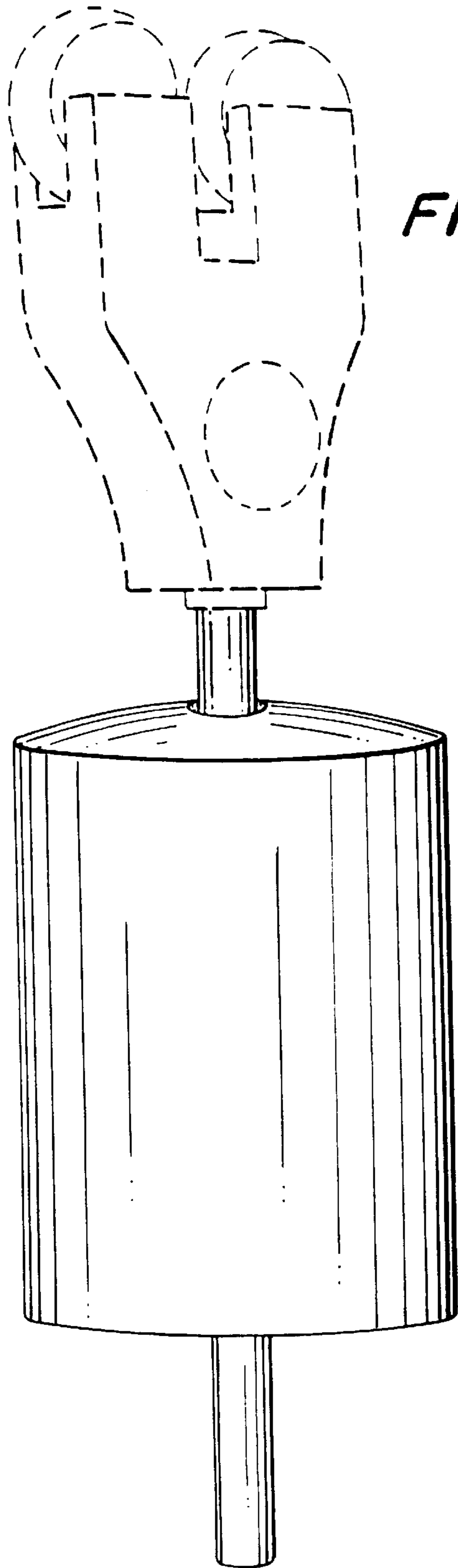
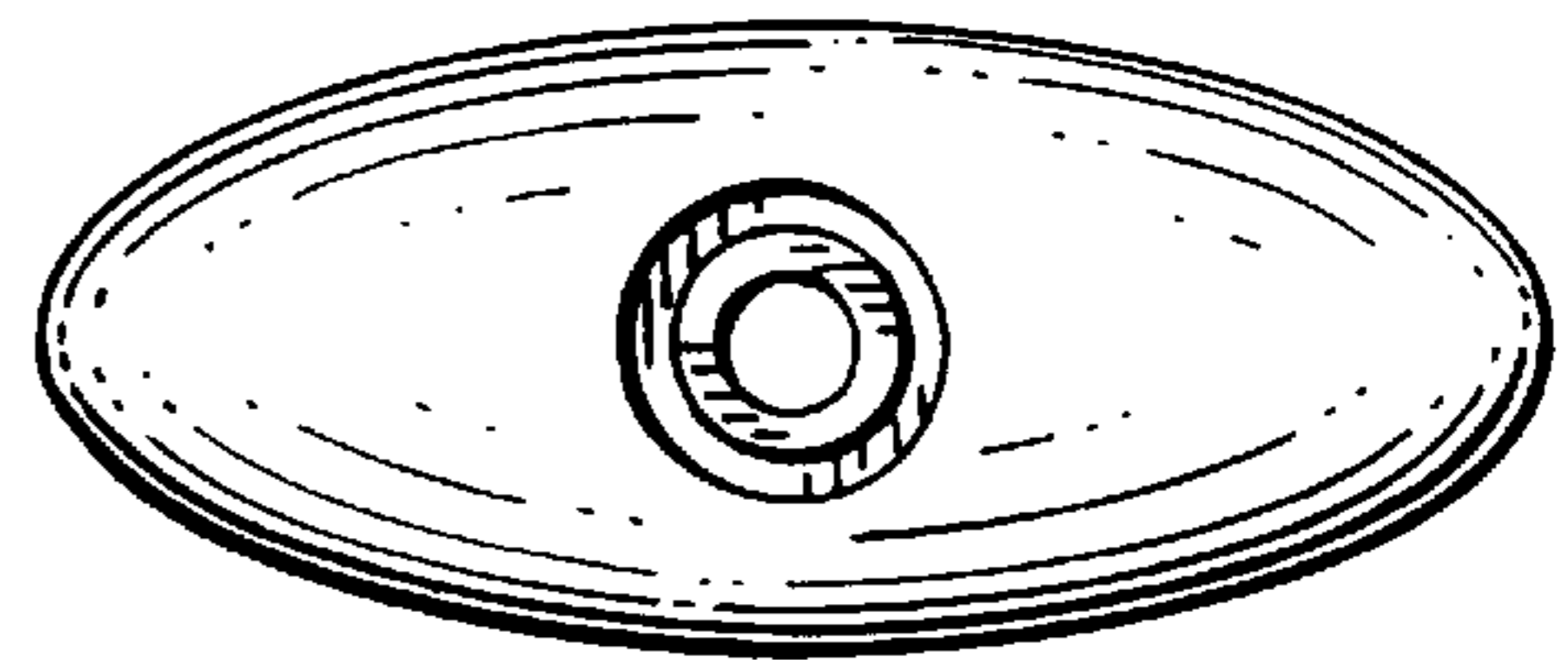

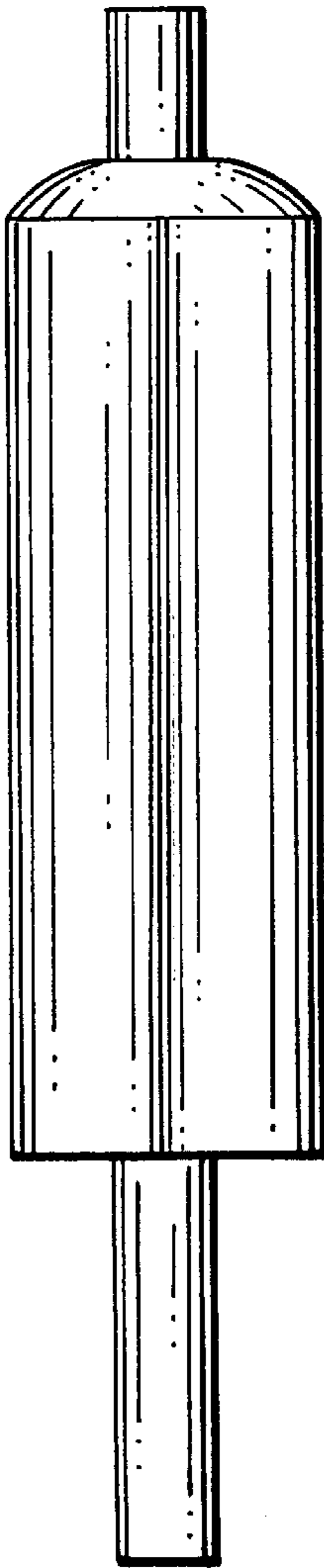

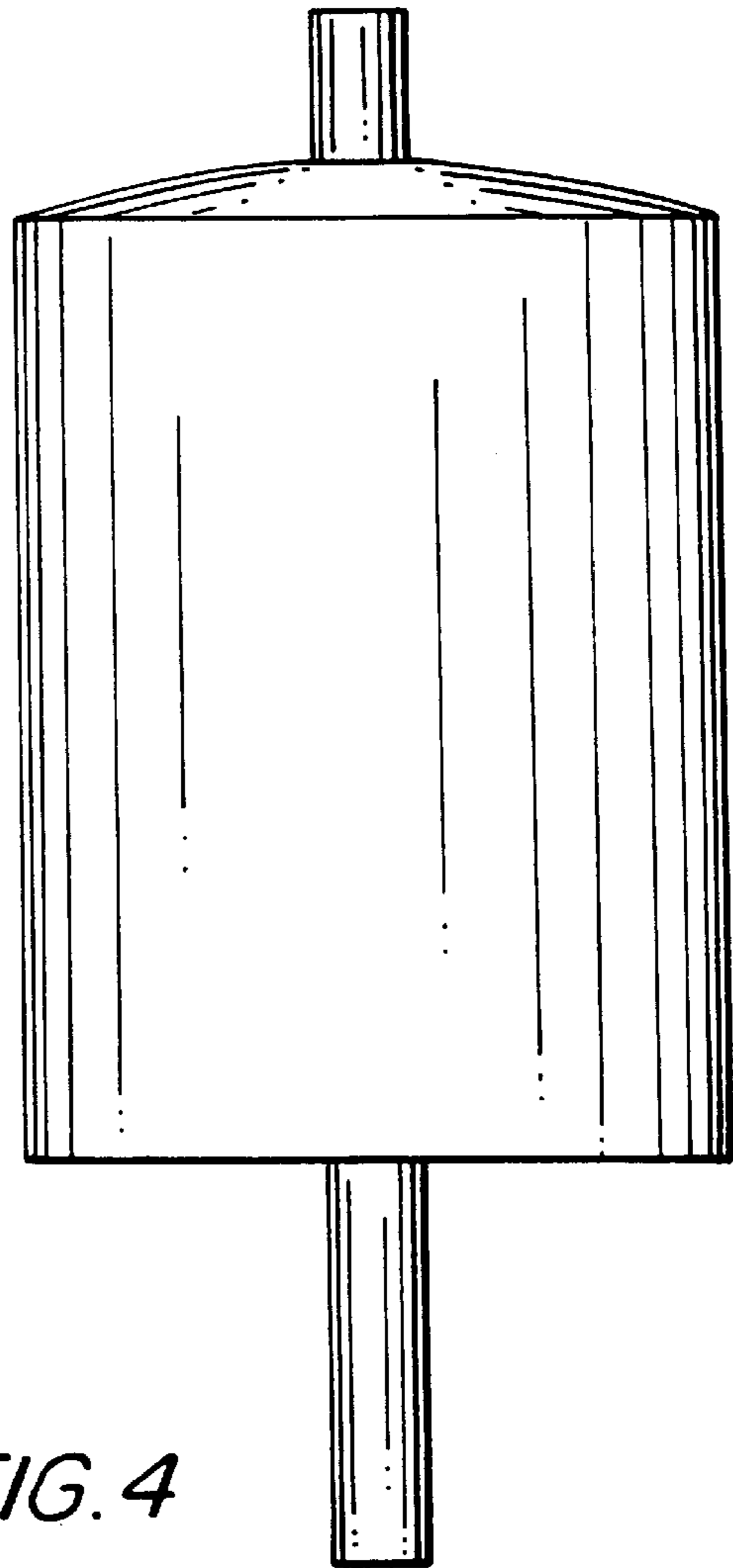
