FIG. 4 is a right-side elevational view thereof.

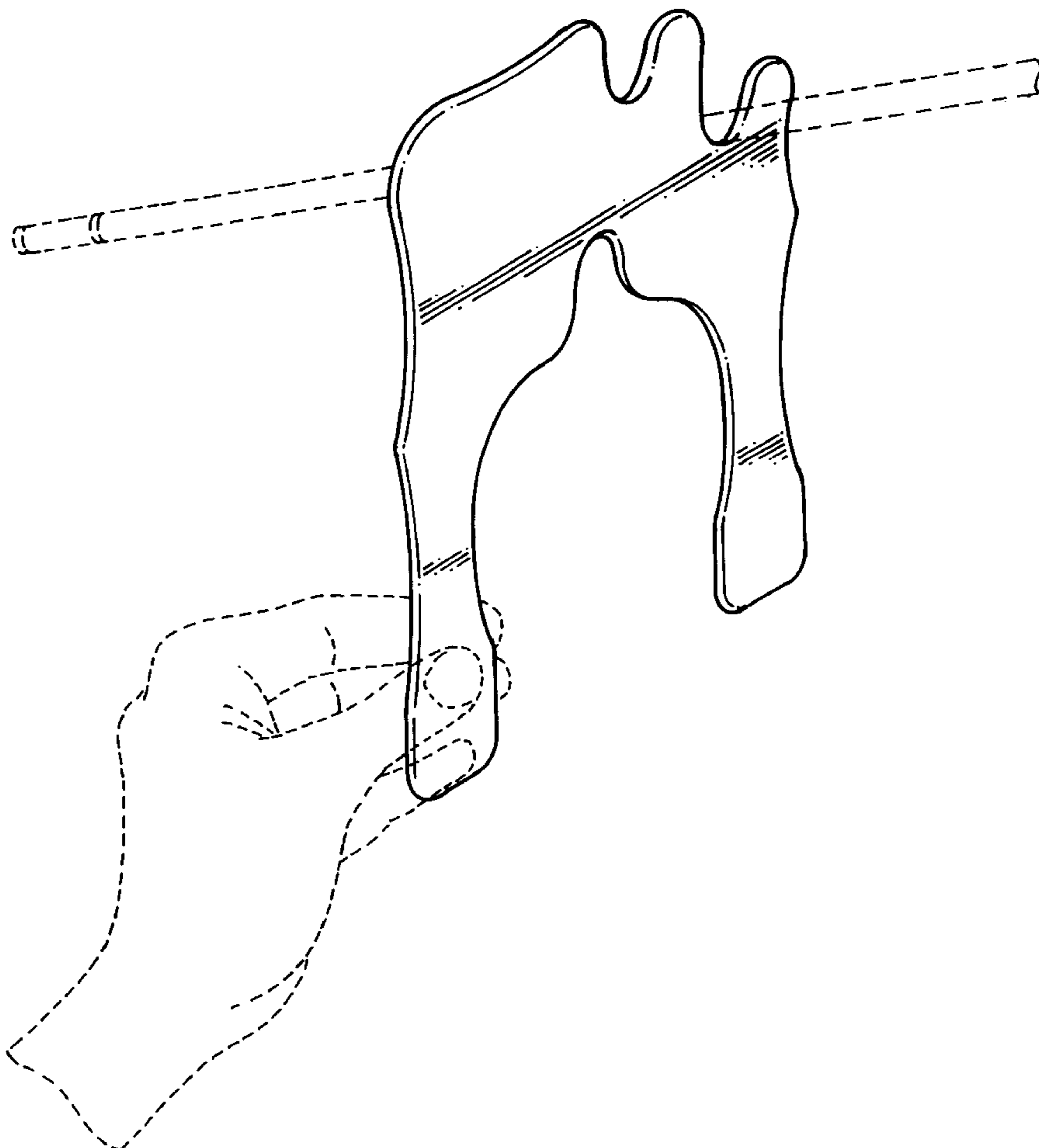
FIG. 5 is a left-side elevational view thereof.

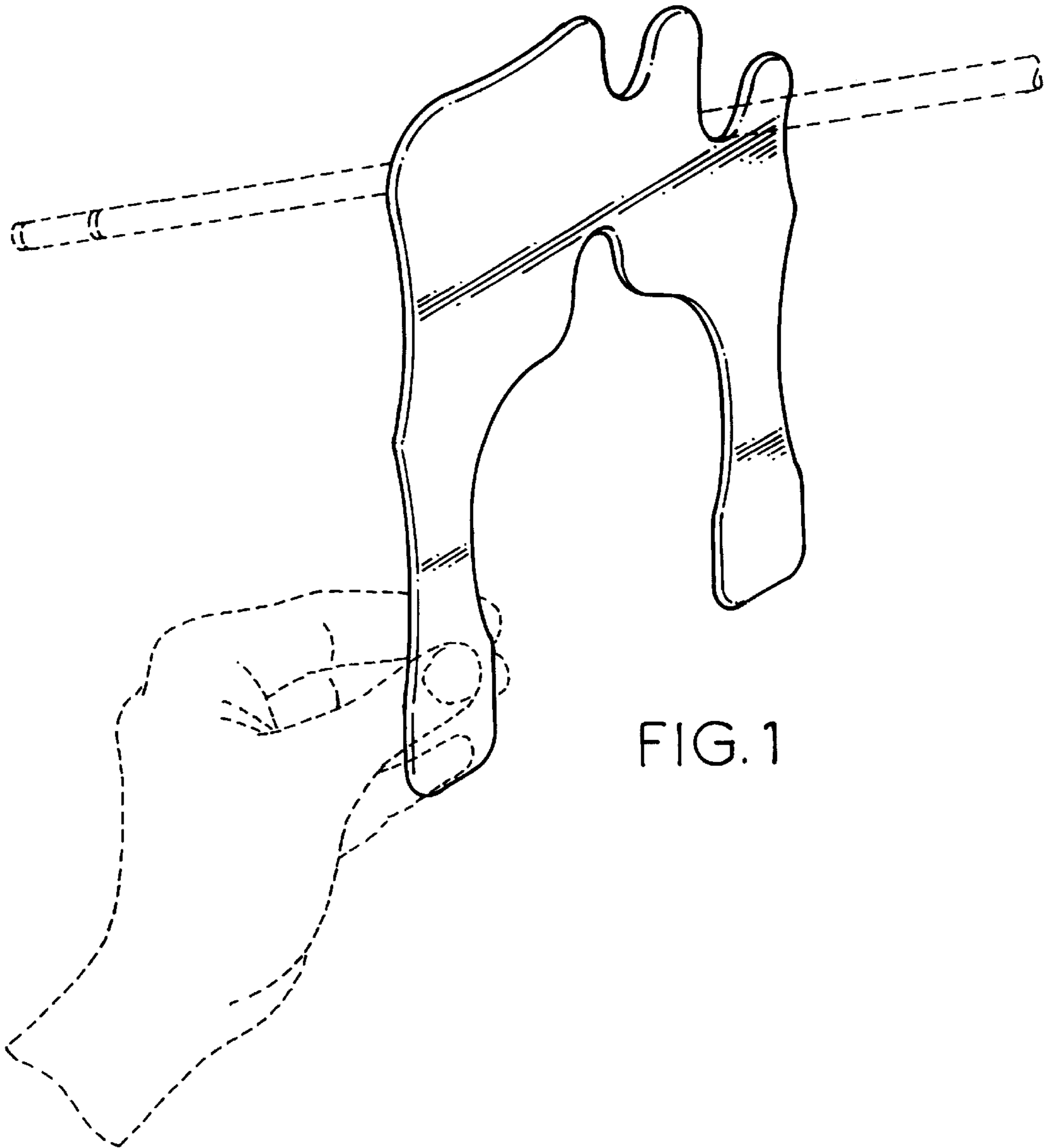

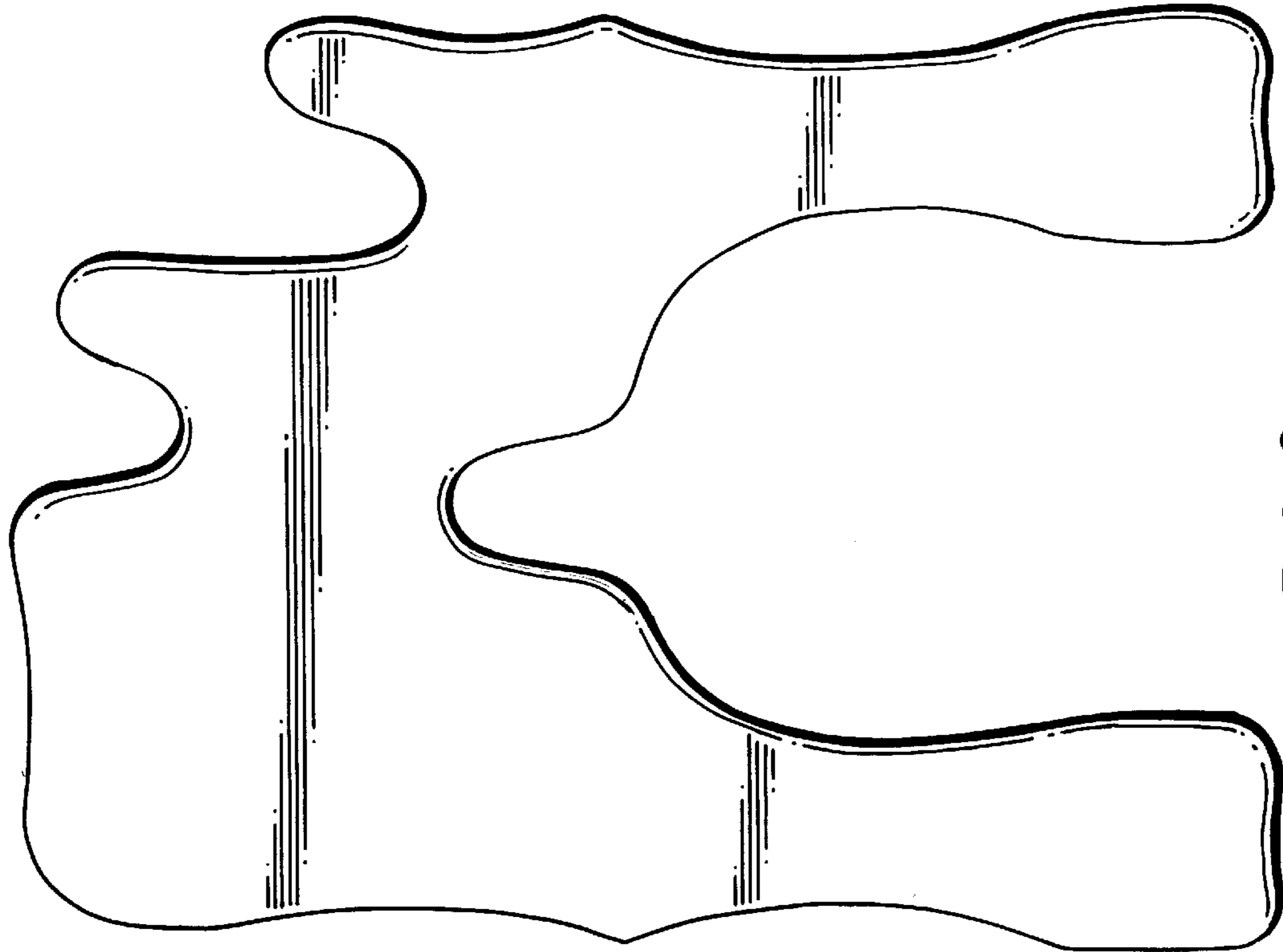

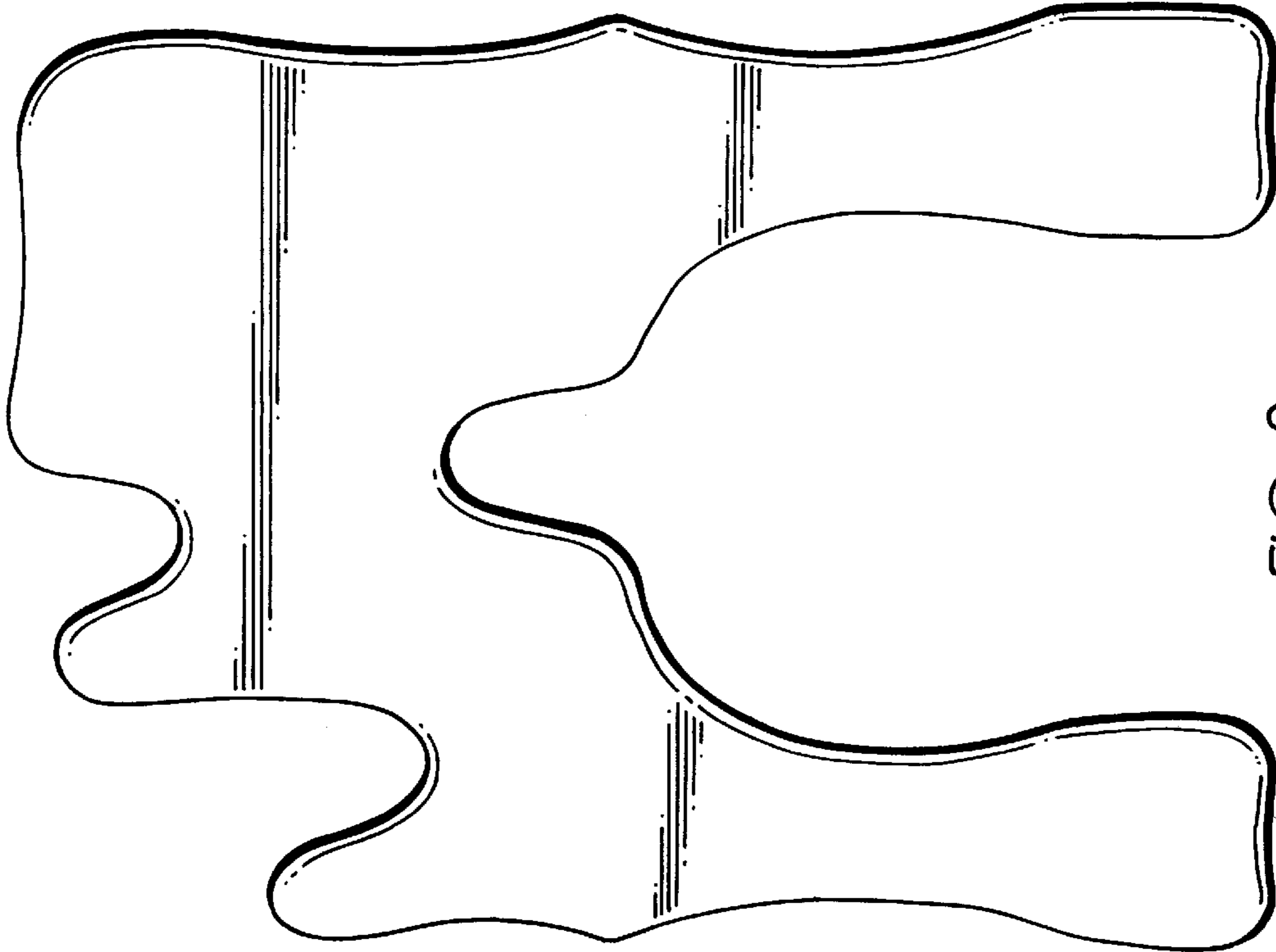
