FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a mirror according to an embodiment of the invention.

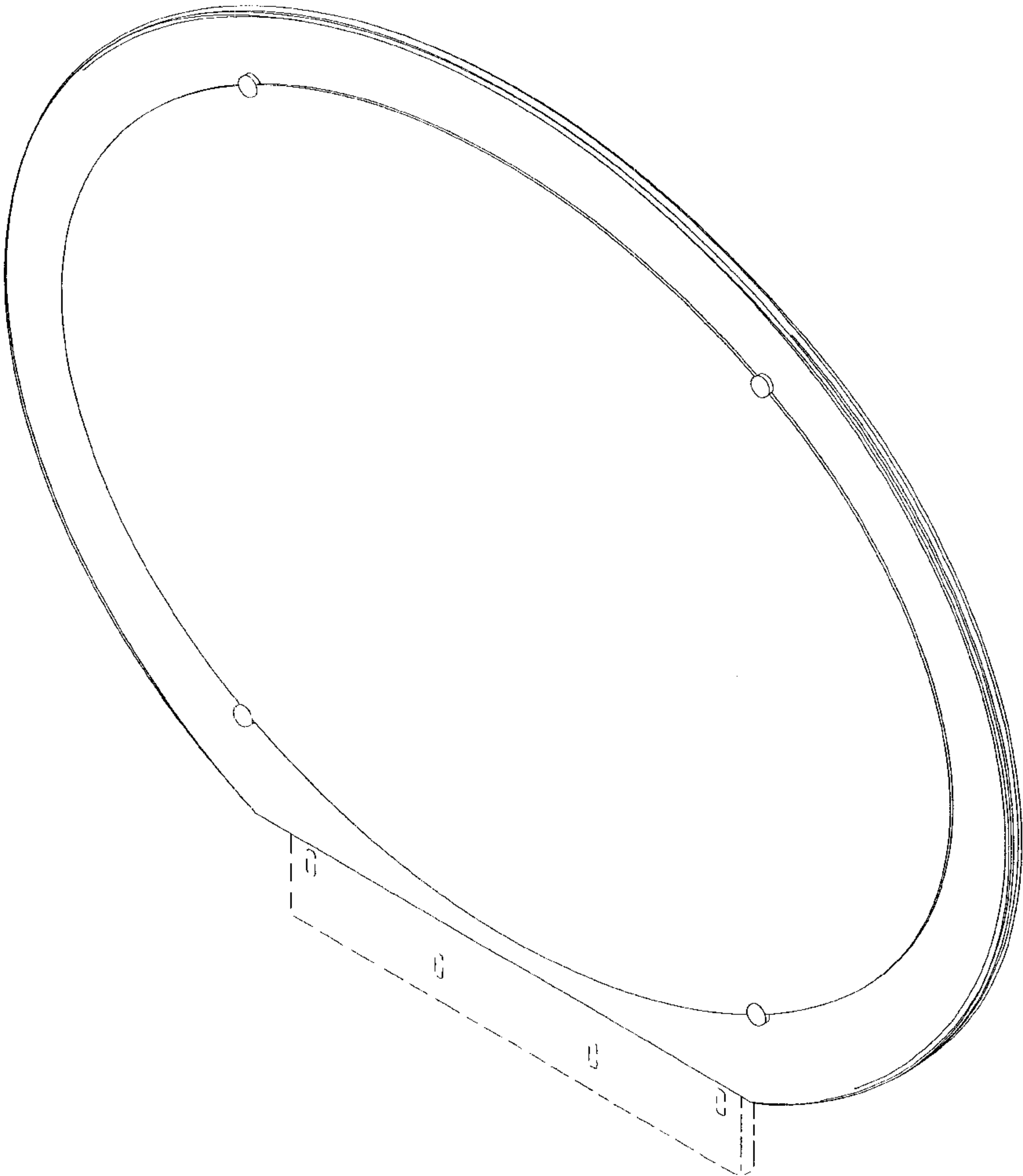
FIG. 2 is a front elevational view;

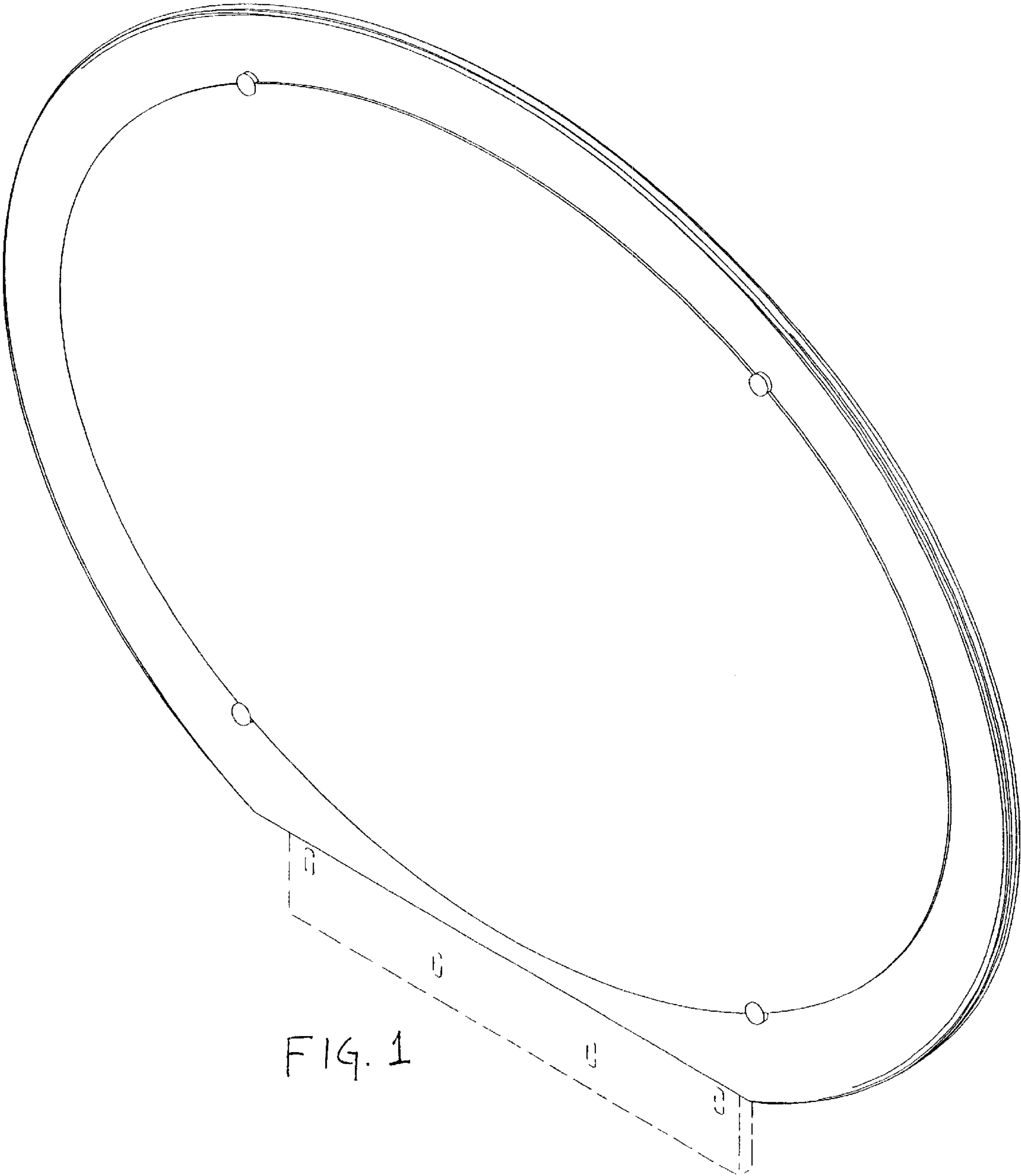
FIG. 3 is a side elevational view; and,

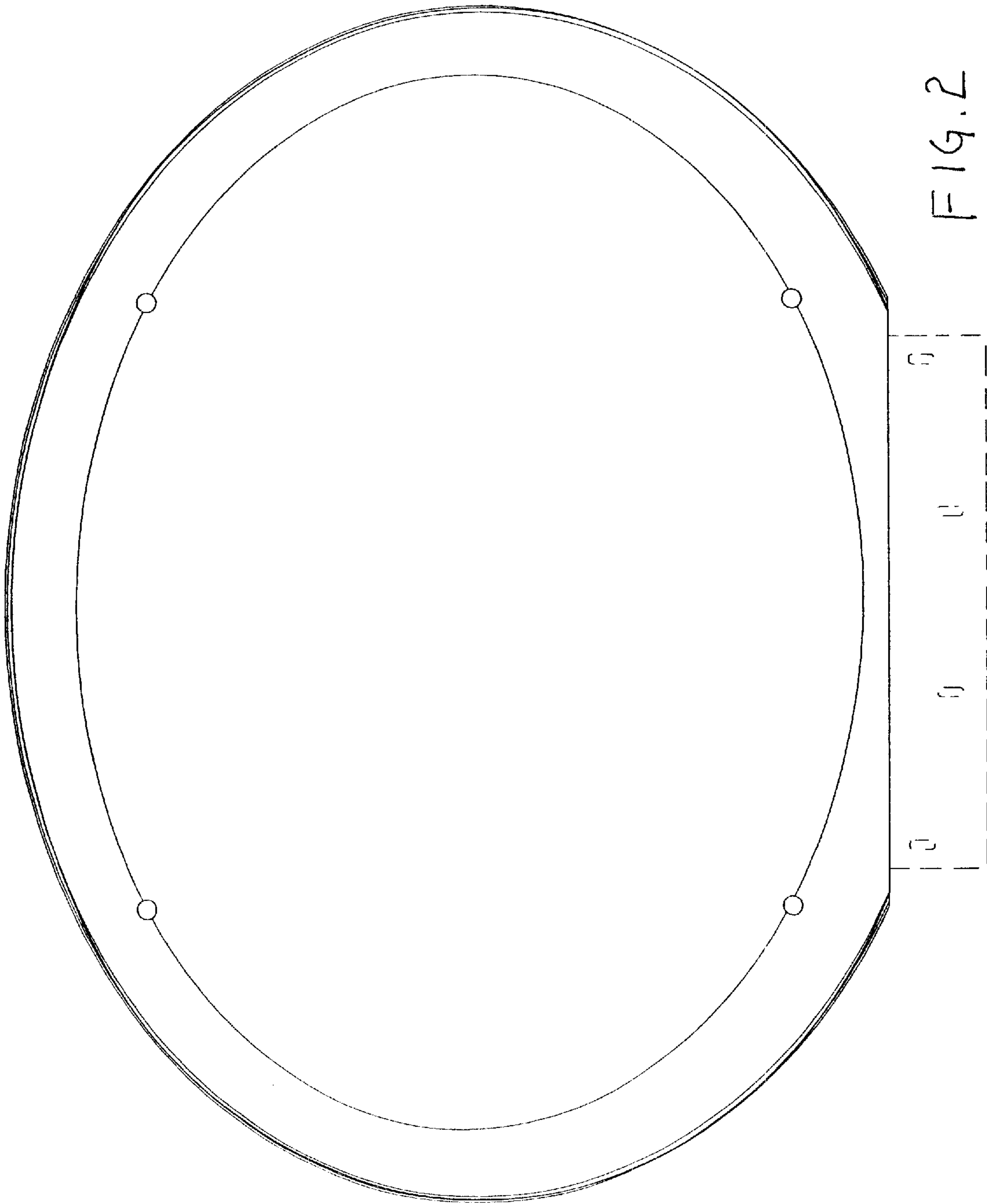
FIG. 4 is a top plan view.

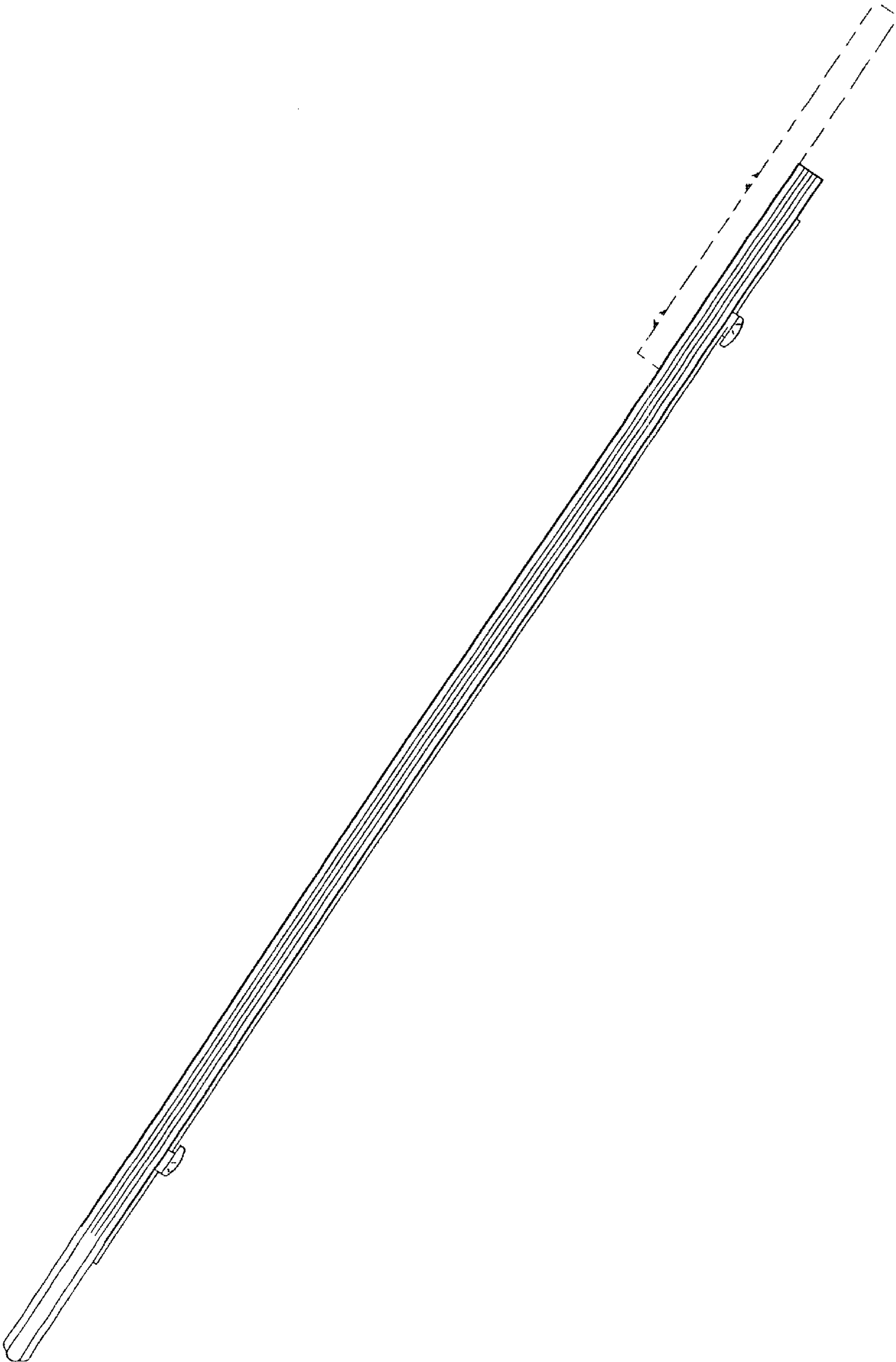

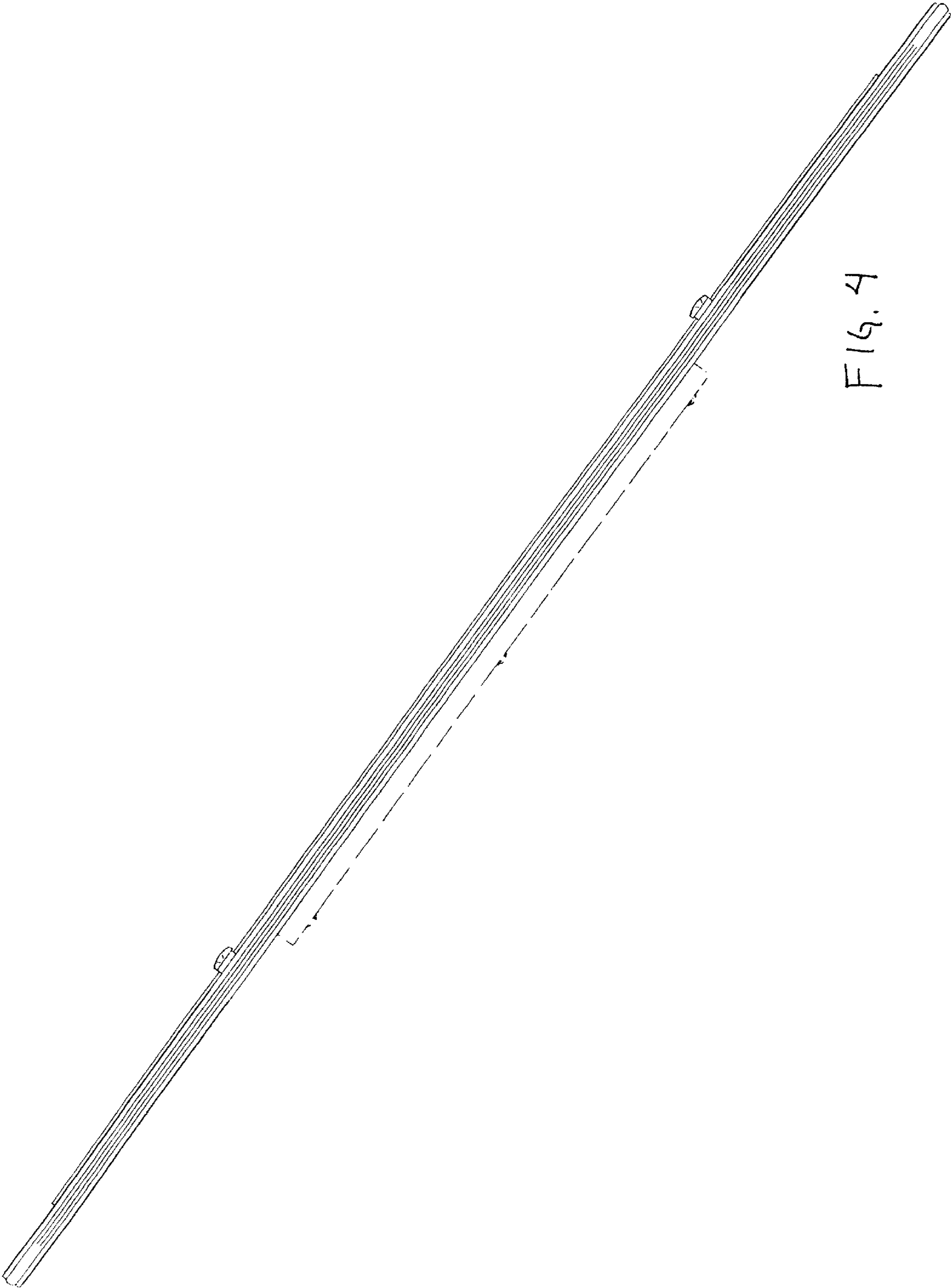
