FIG. 1 is a perspective view of the oblong dish showing my new design;

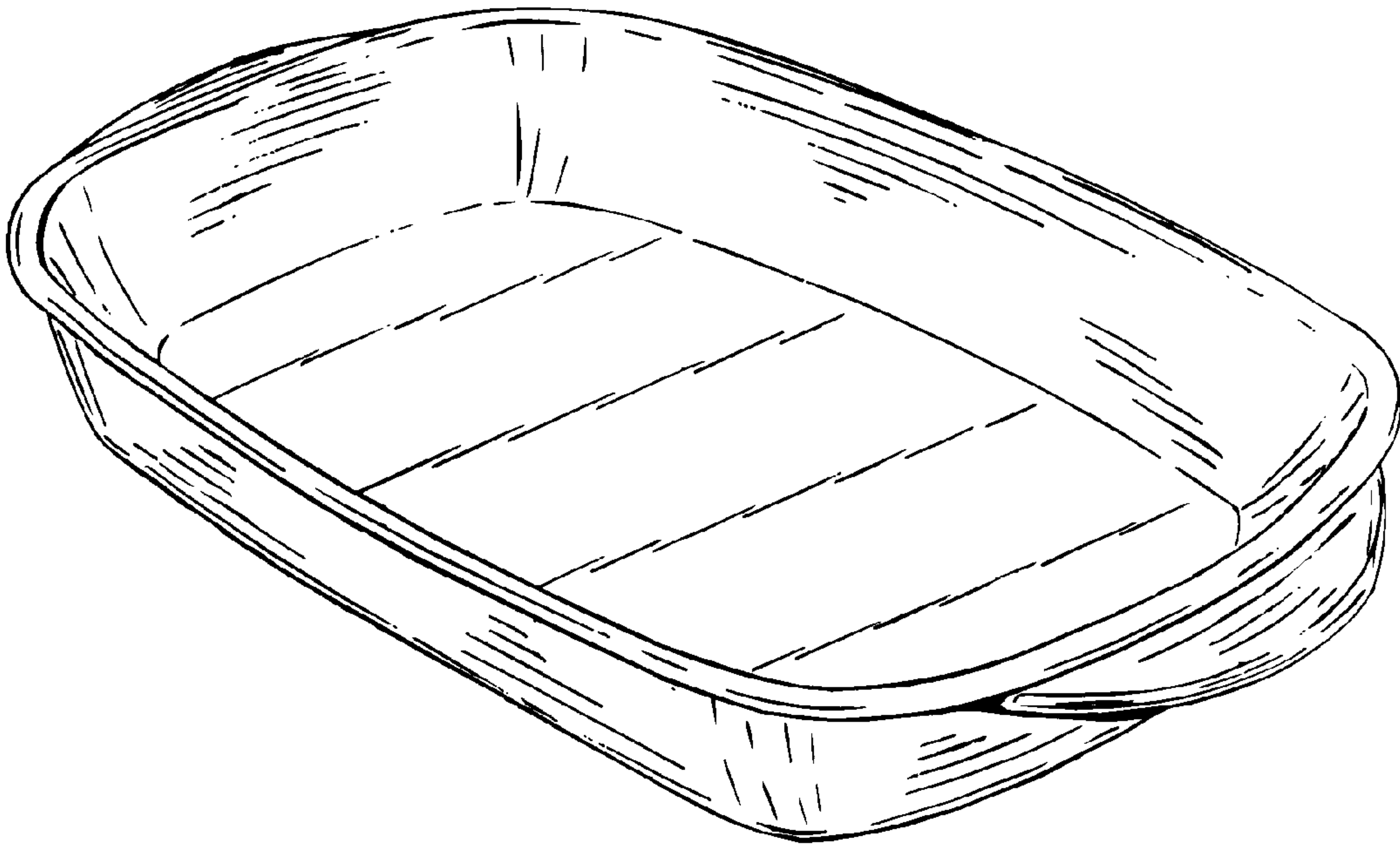
FIG. 2 is a side elevational view of one side of the oblong dish, the other side being substantially identical;

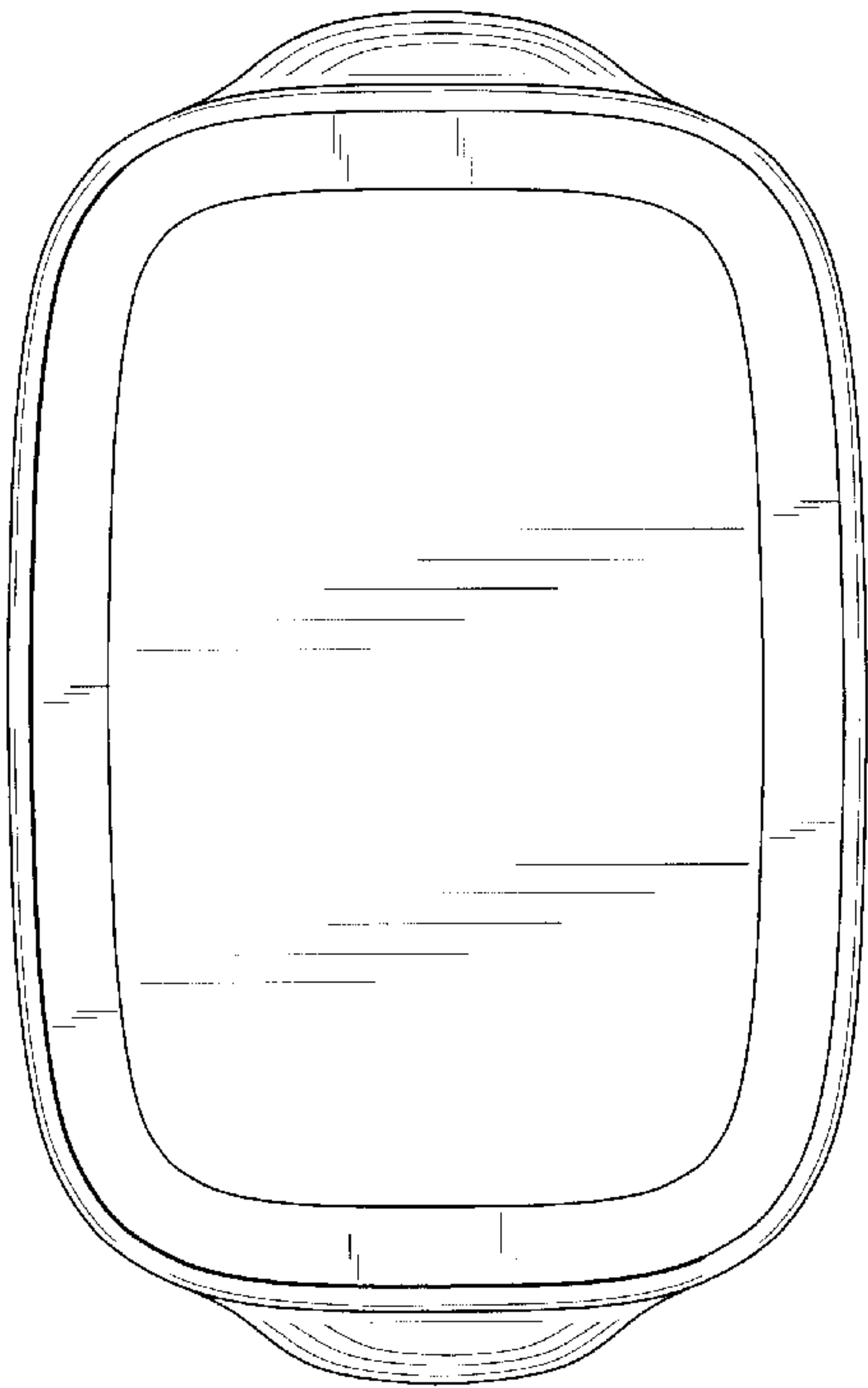

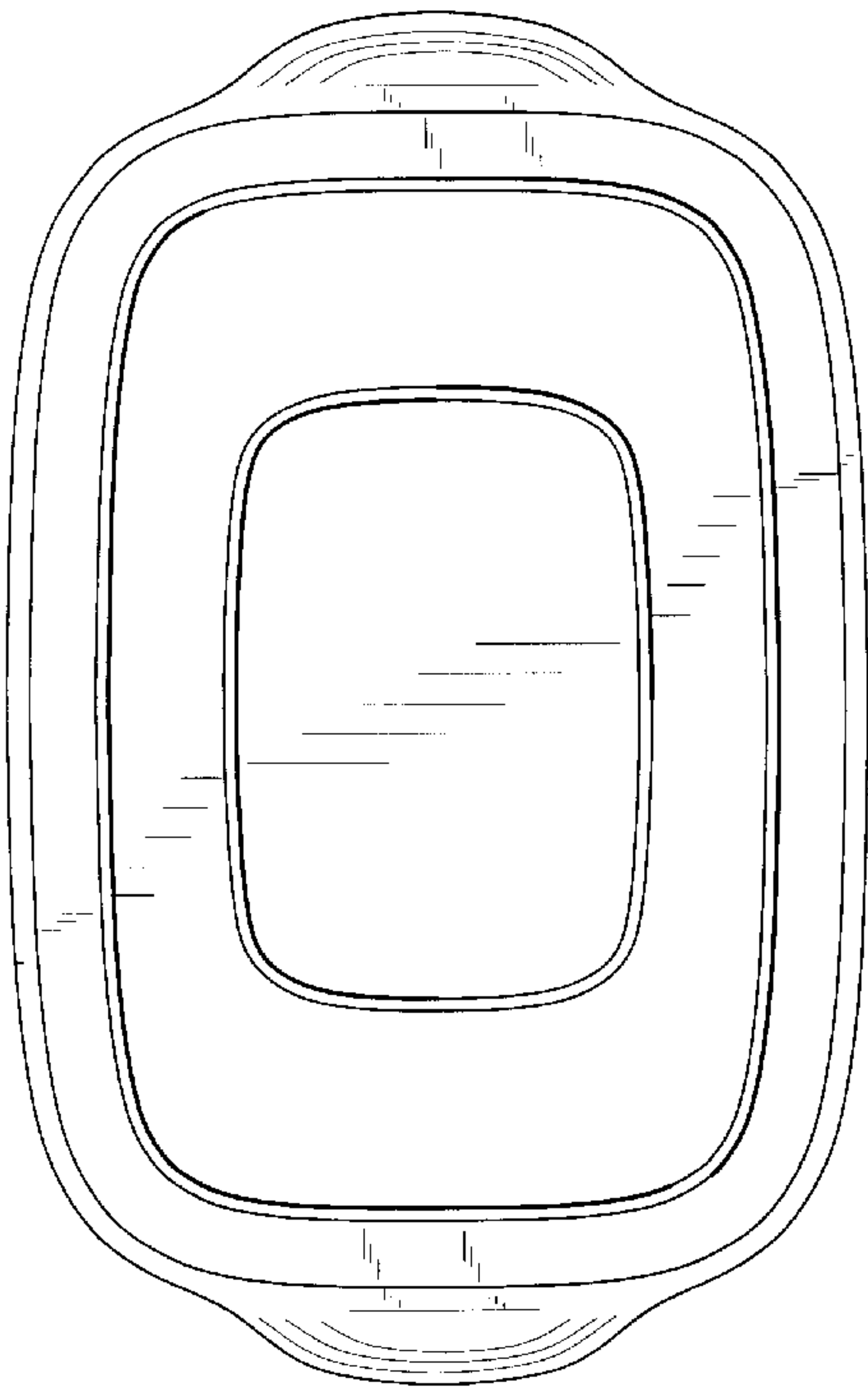

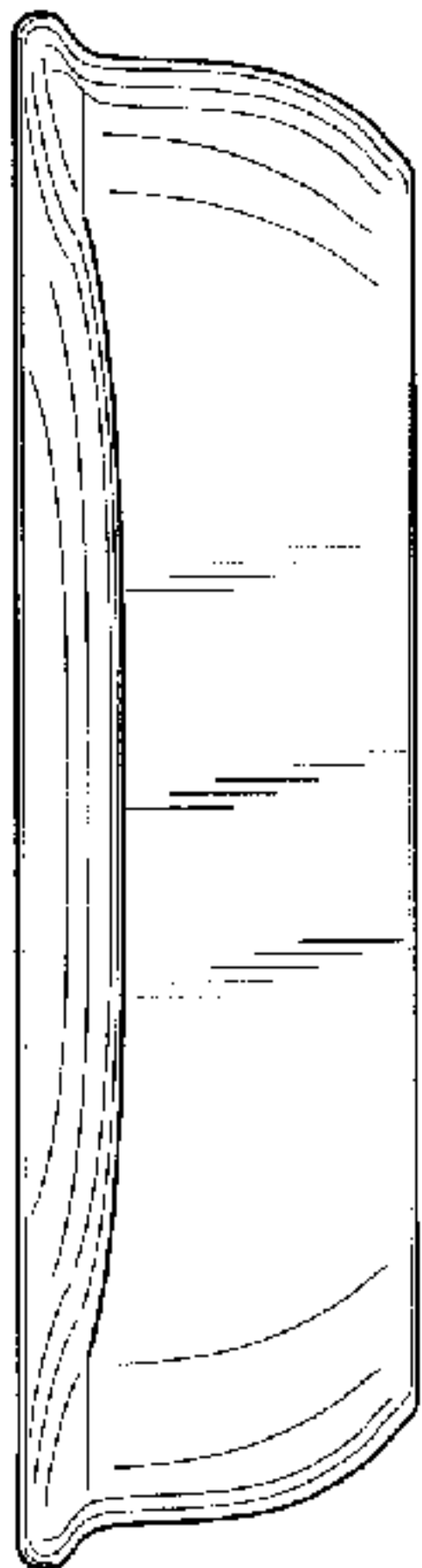

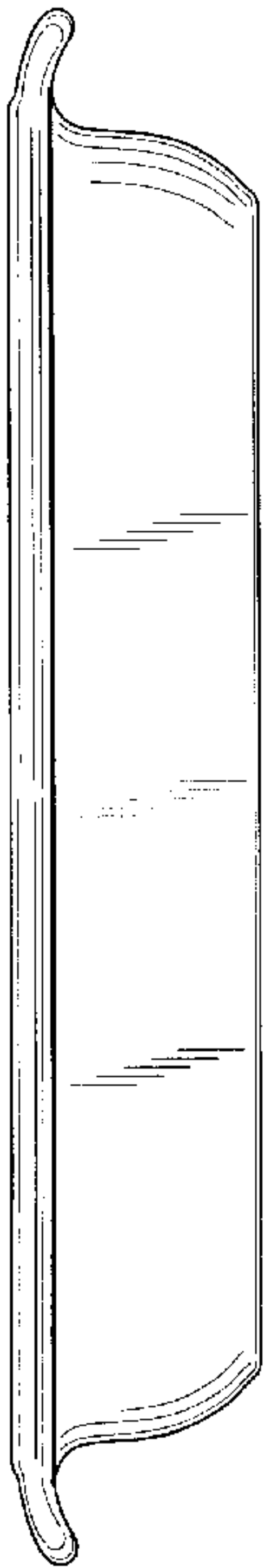

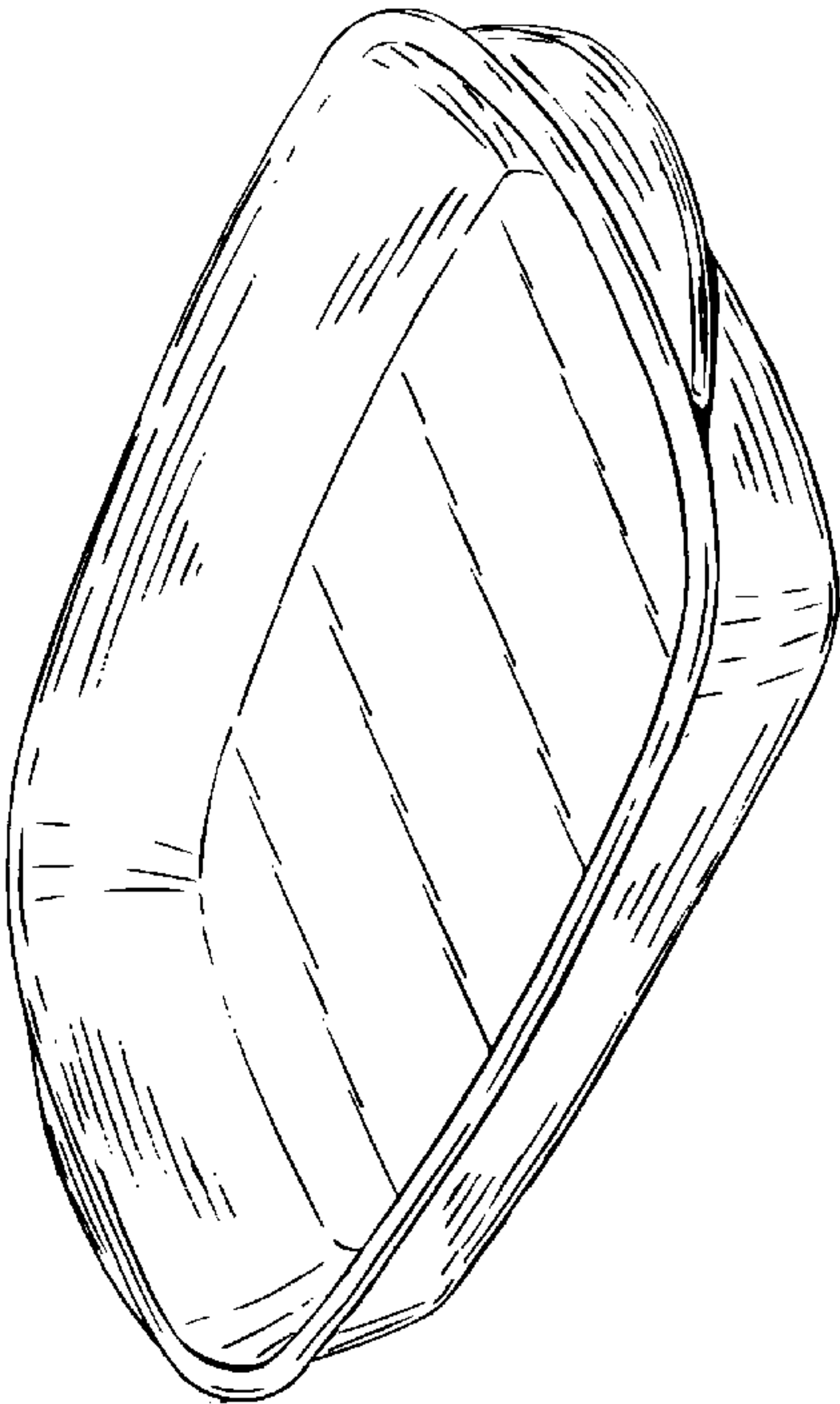
