(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a natural or artificial gemstone or ornamental object made of glass, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a bottom view of a natural or artificial gemstone or ornamental object made of glass according to a first embodiment of the present invention;

FIG. 2 is a point-down side view taken from the lower side of FIG. 1;

FIG. 3 is a point-up side view taken from the upper side of FIG. 1;

FIG. 4 is a top view of the first embodiment;

FIG. 5 is a side view taken from the right side of FIG. 4;

FIG. 6 is a side view taken from the left side of FIG. 4;

FIG. 7 is a bottom view of a natural or artificial gemstone or ornamental object made of glass according to a second embodiment of the present invention;

FIG. 8 is a point-down side view taken from the lower side of FIG. 7;

FIG. 9 is a point-up side view taken from the upper side of FIG. 7;

FIG. 10 is a top view of the second embodiment;

FIG. 11 is a side view taken from the right side of FIG. 10; and,

FIG. 12 is a side view taken from the left side of FIG. 10.
























