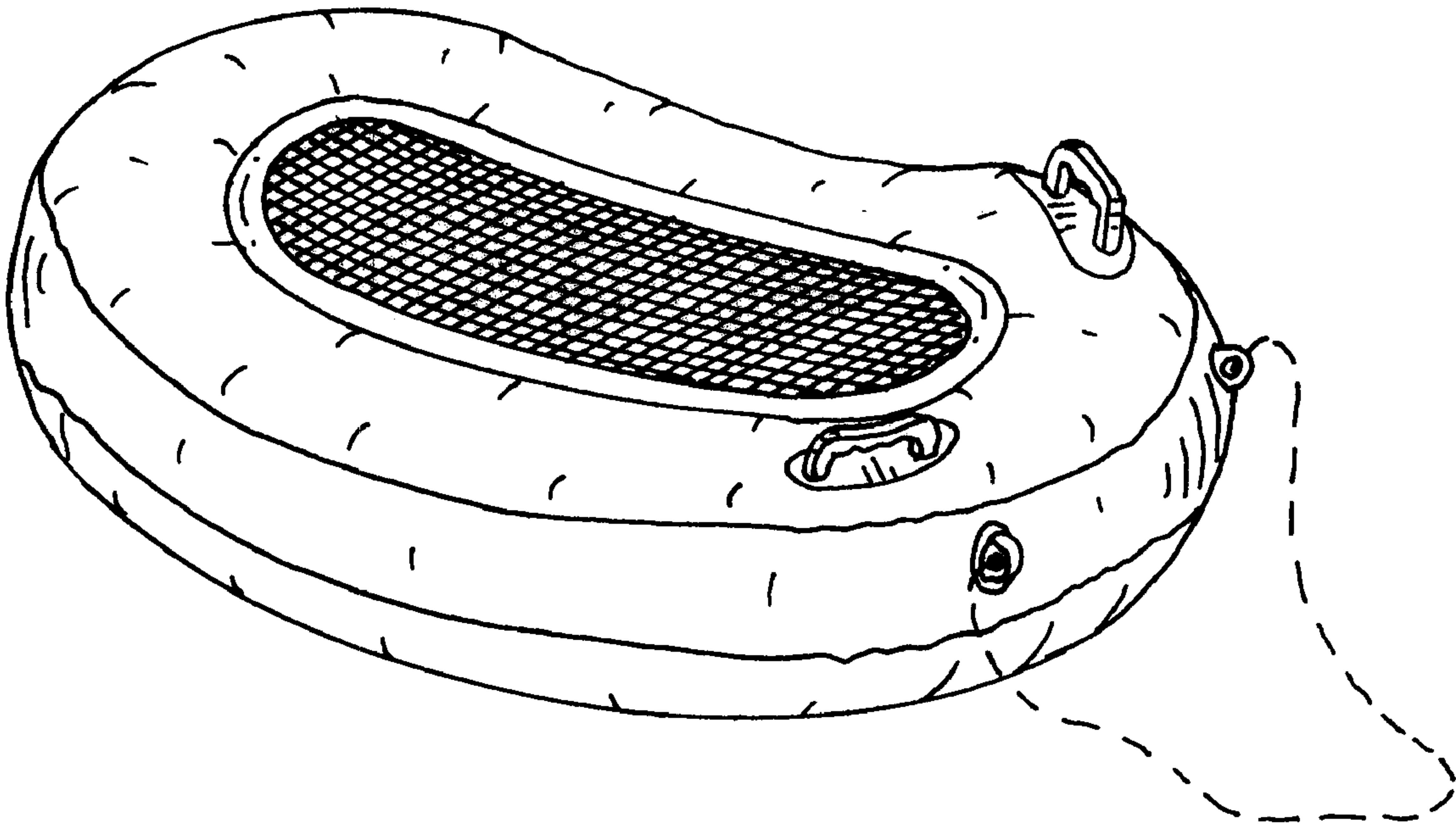
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(57) **CLAIM**

DESCRIPTION
FIG. 1 is a perspective view of the inflatable snow tube showing my new design;
FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof;
FIG. 3 is a bottom plan view thereof;
FIG. 4 is a right side elevational view, the left side view being a mirror image thereof;
FIG. 5 is a front elevational view thereof; and,
FIG. 6 is a rear elevational view thereof.

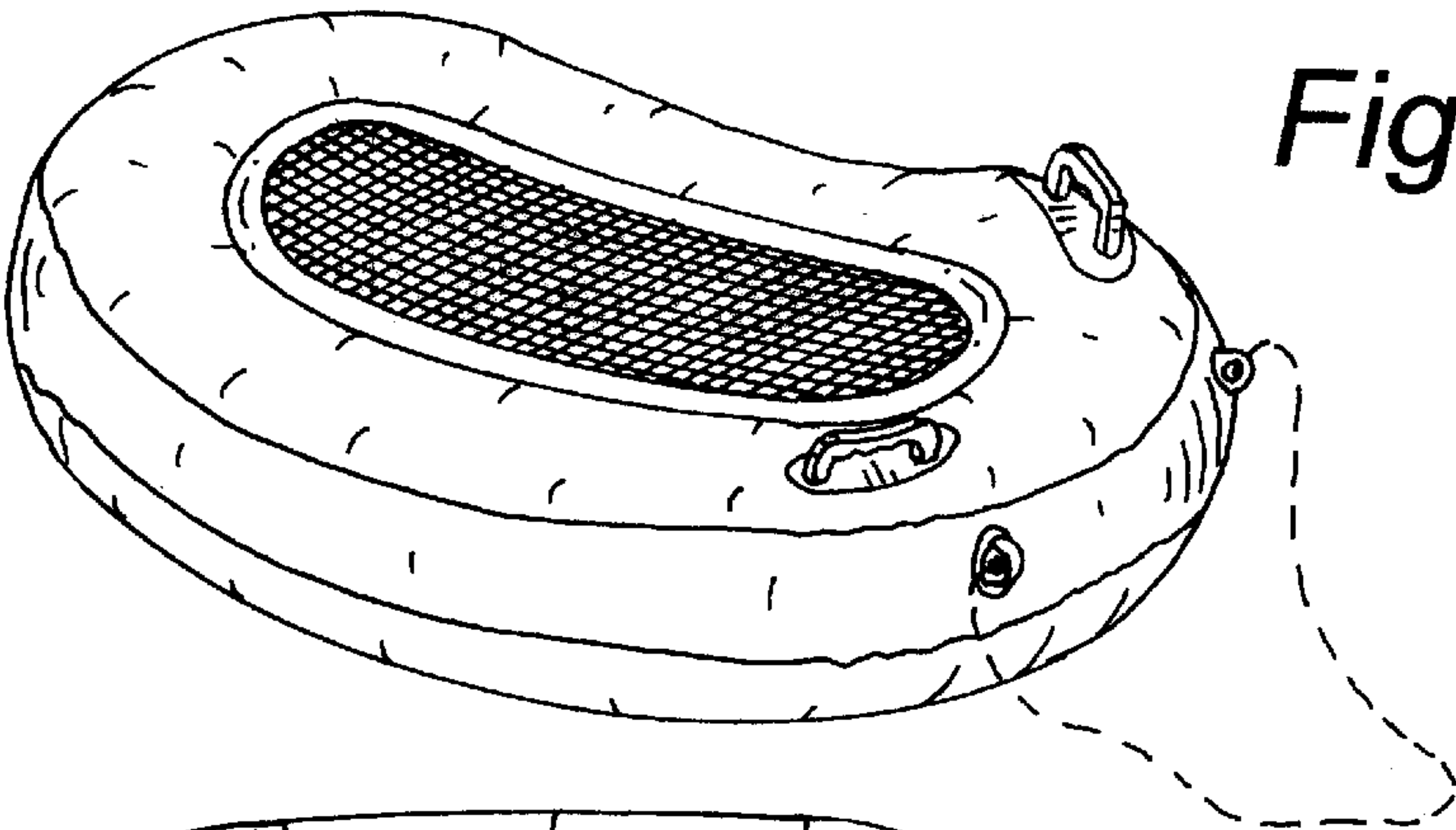

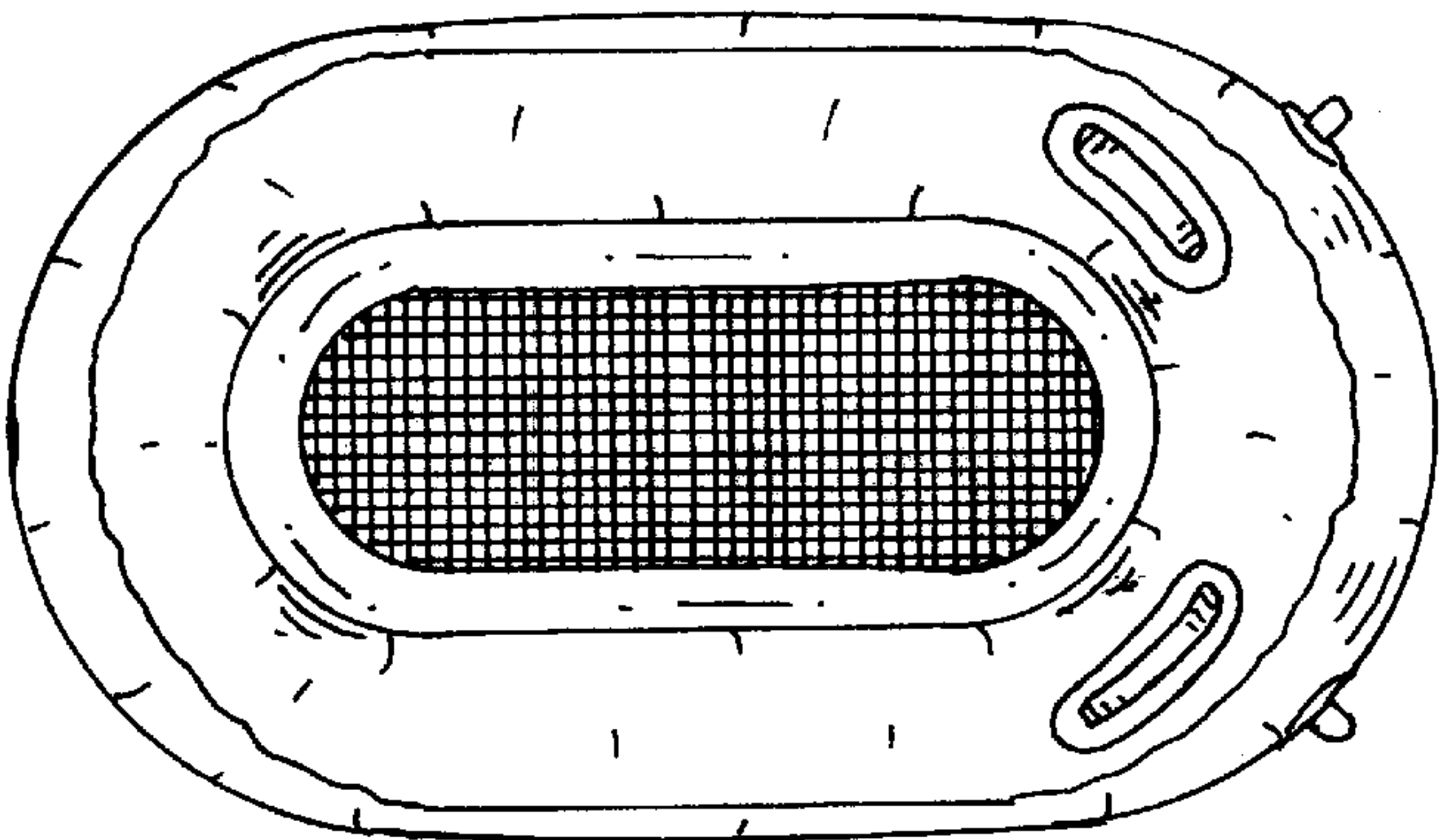

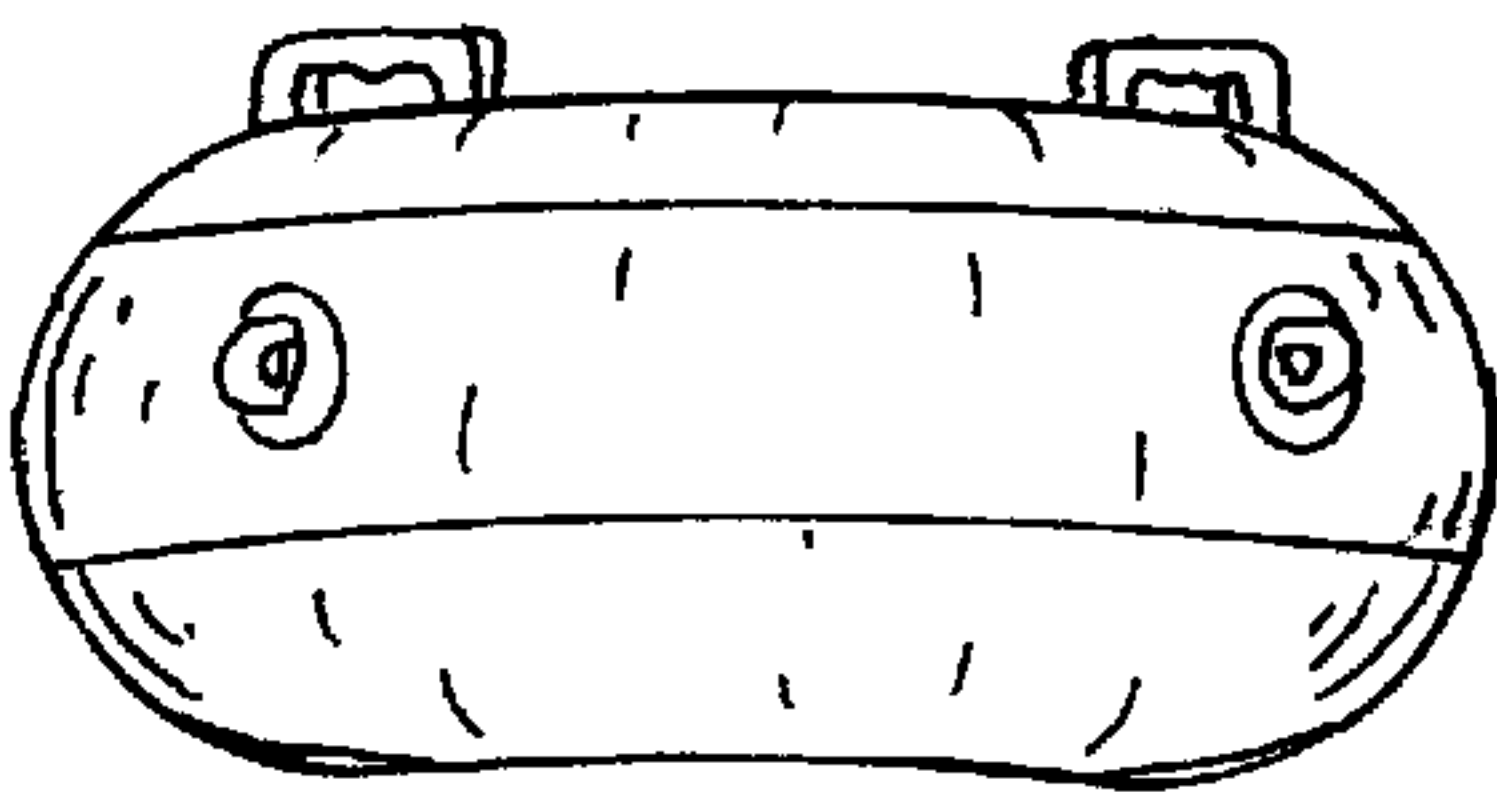

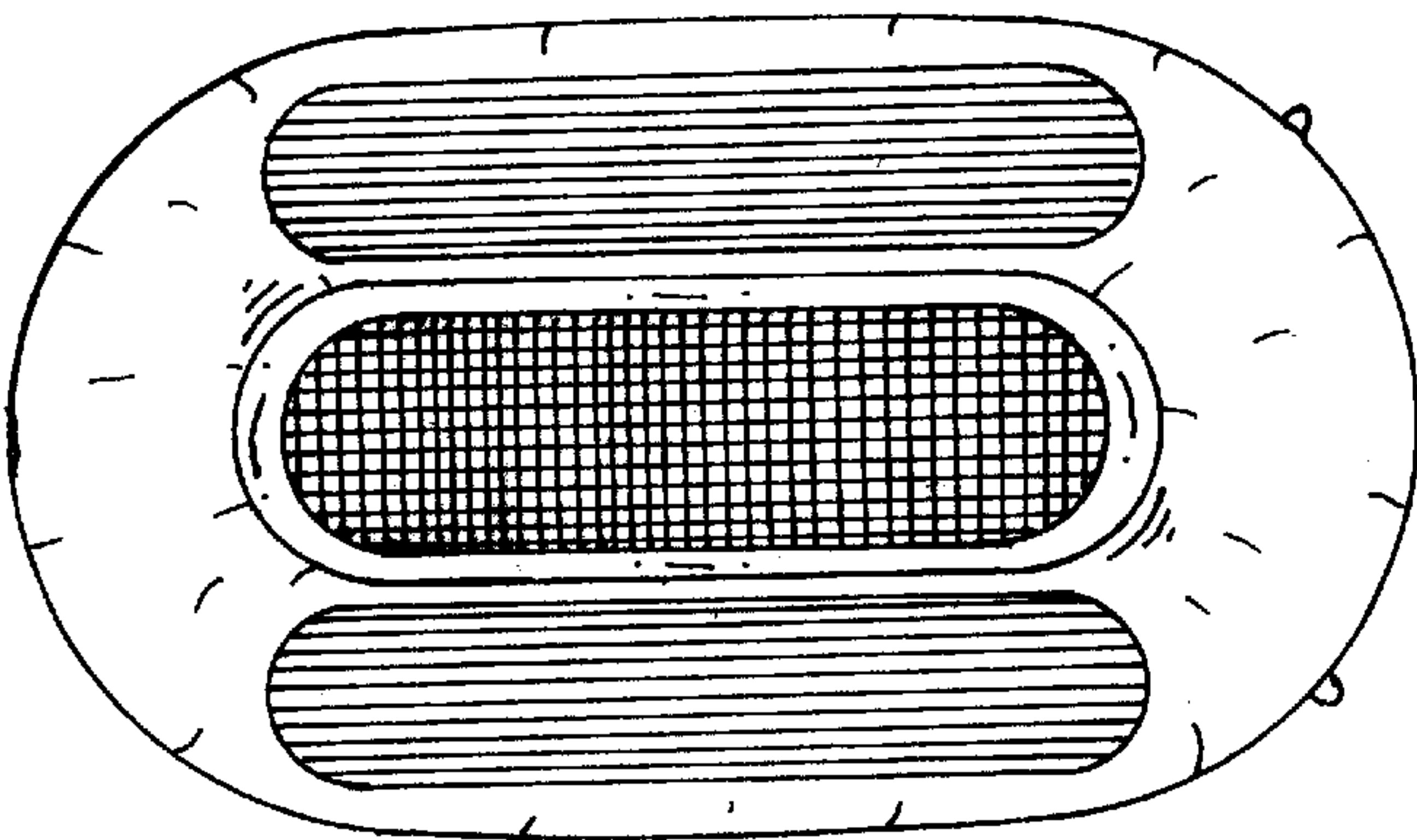

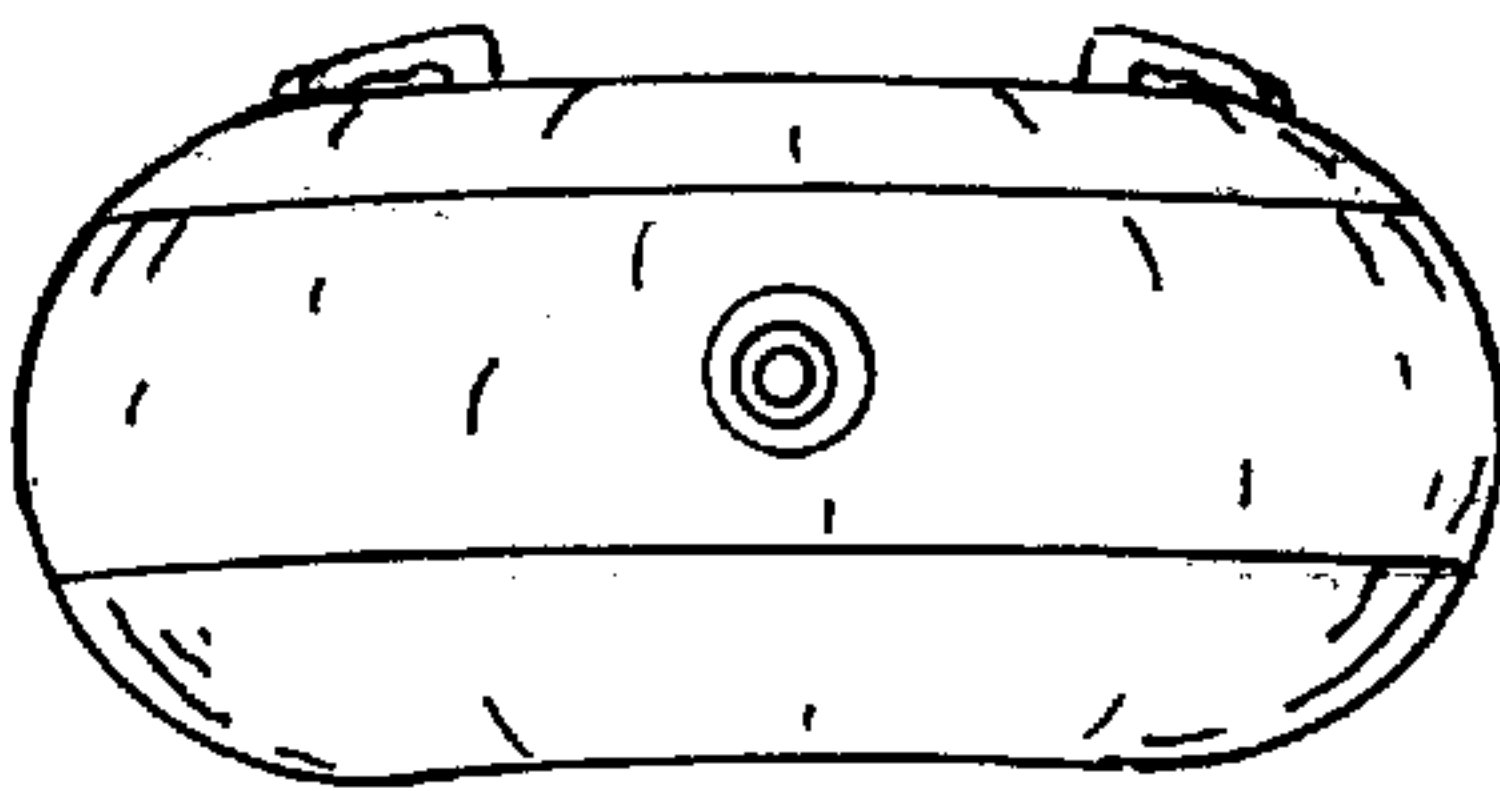

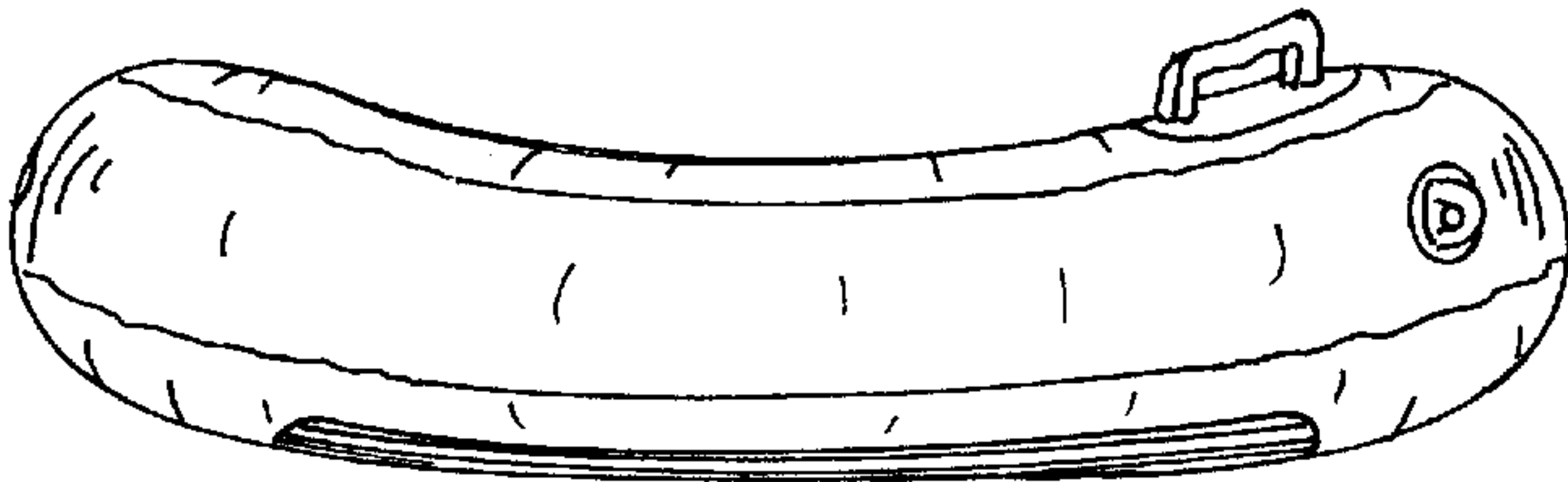
