The ornamental design for a roof for an automotive vehicle, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a roof for an automotive vehicle, showing the new design in a closed configuration; the opposite view of the roof is a symmetrically mirrored image of FIG. 1;

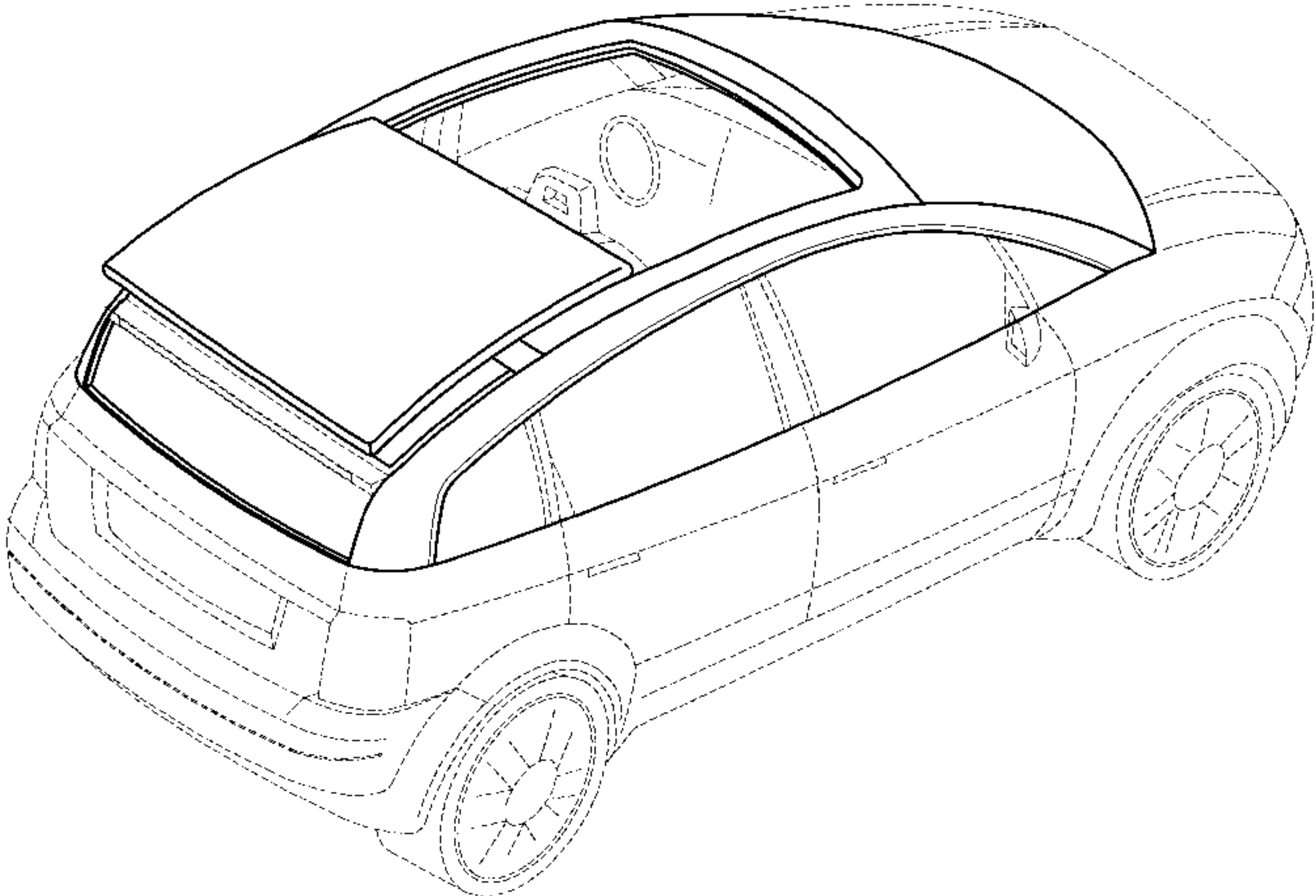
FIG. 2 is a top elevational view of the roof showing the new design in a closed configuration;

FIG. 3 is a rear elevational view of the roof showing the new design in a closed configuration;

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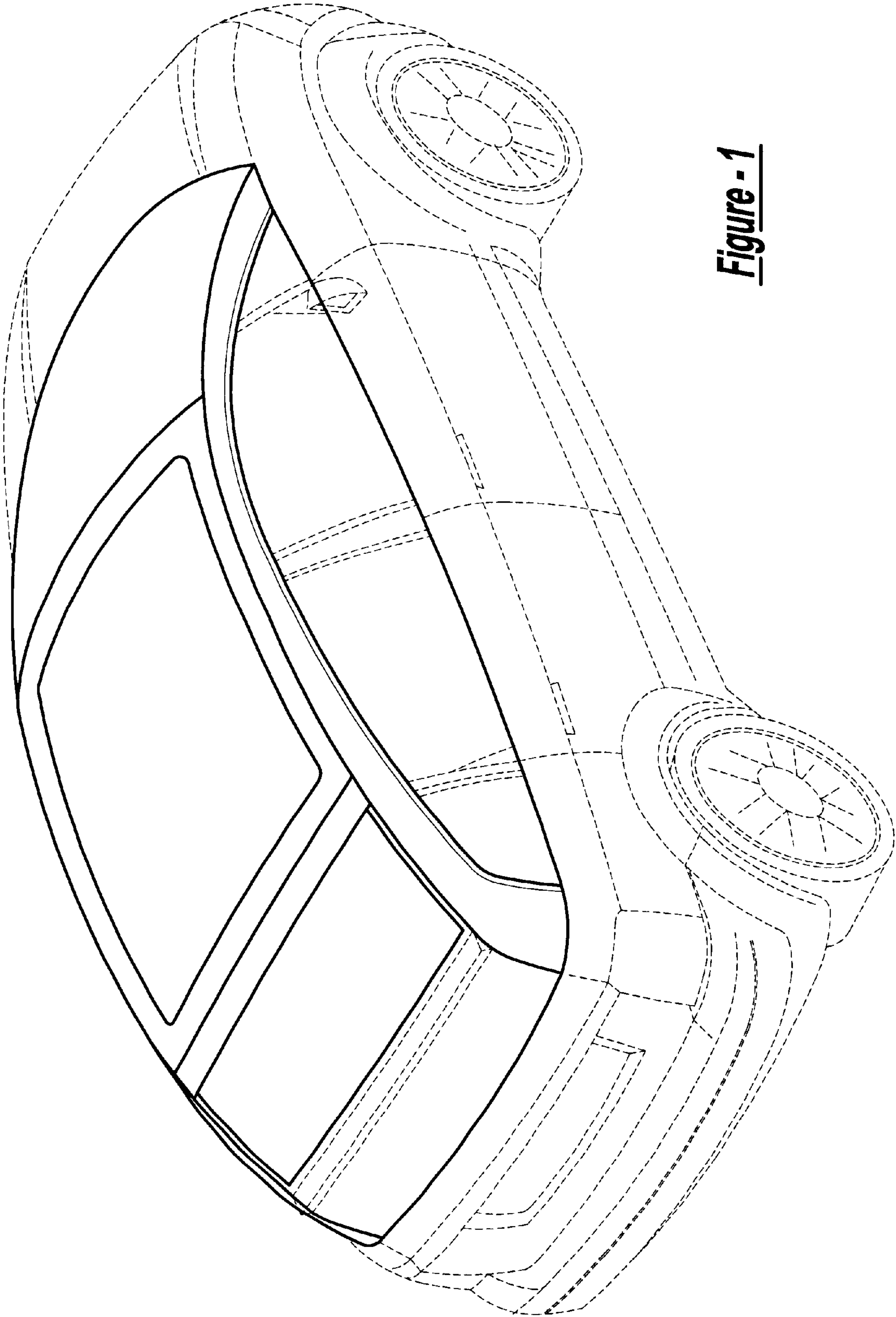

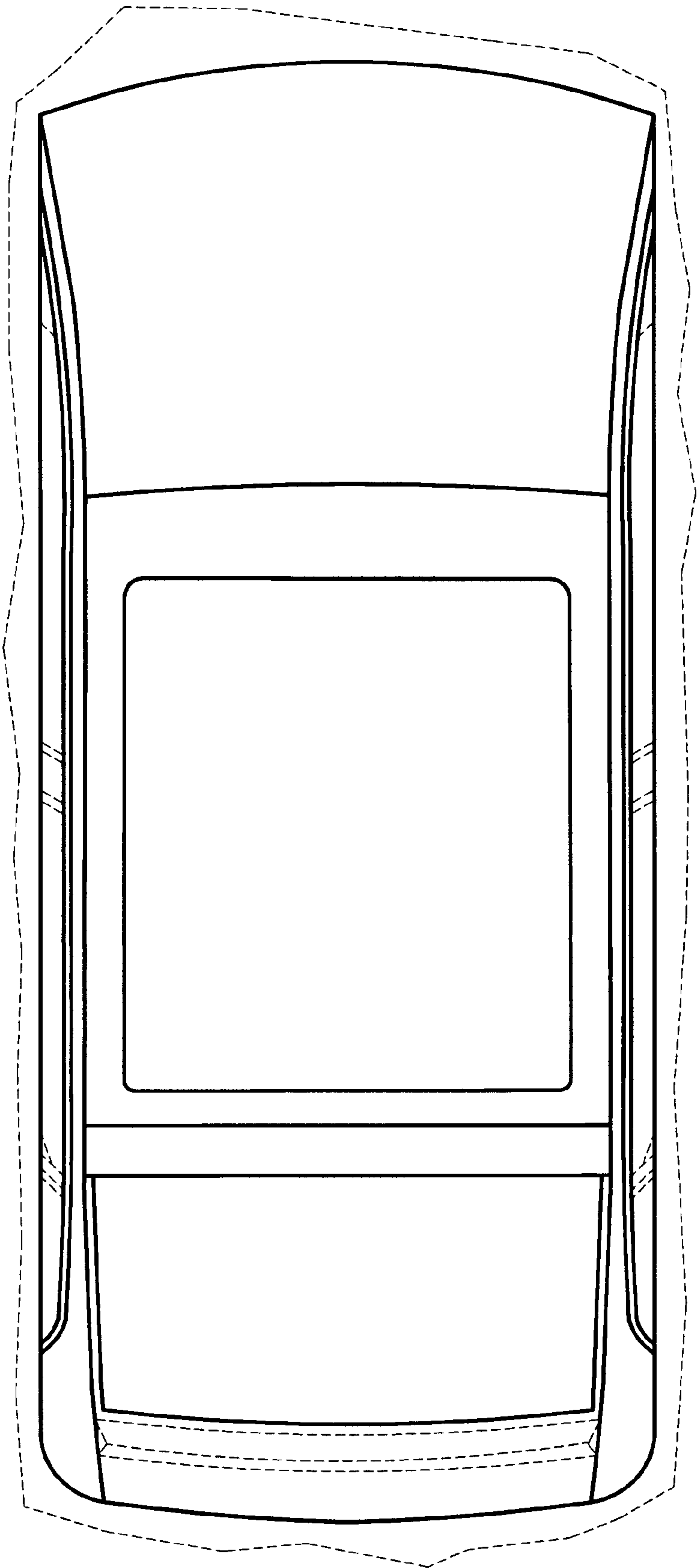

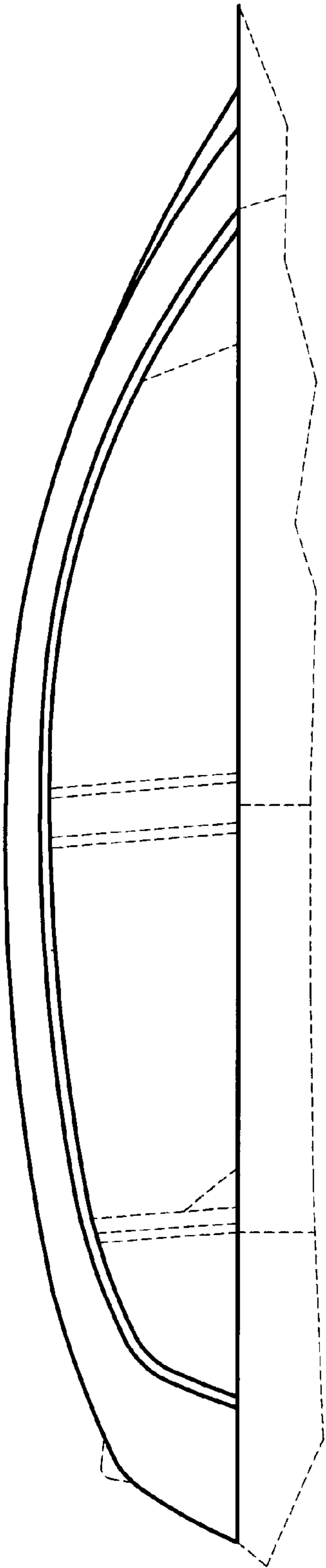

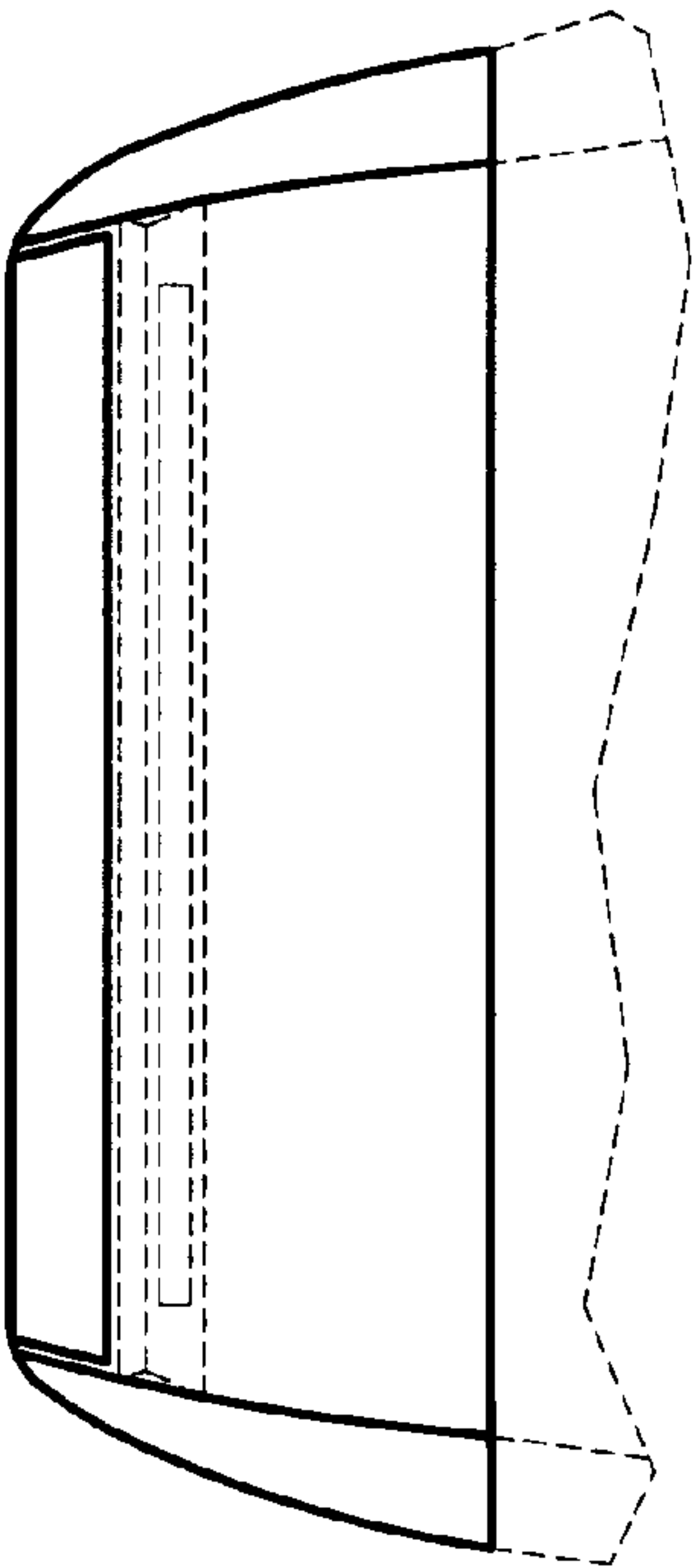

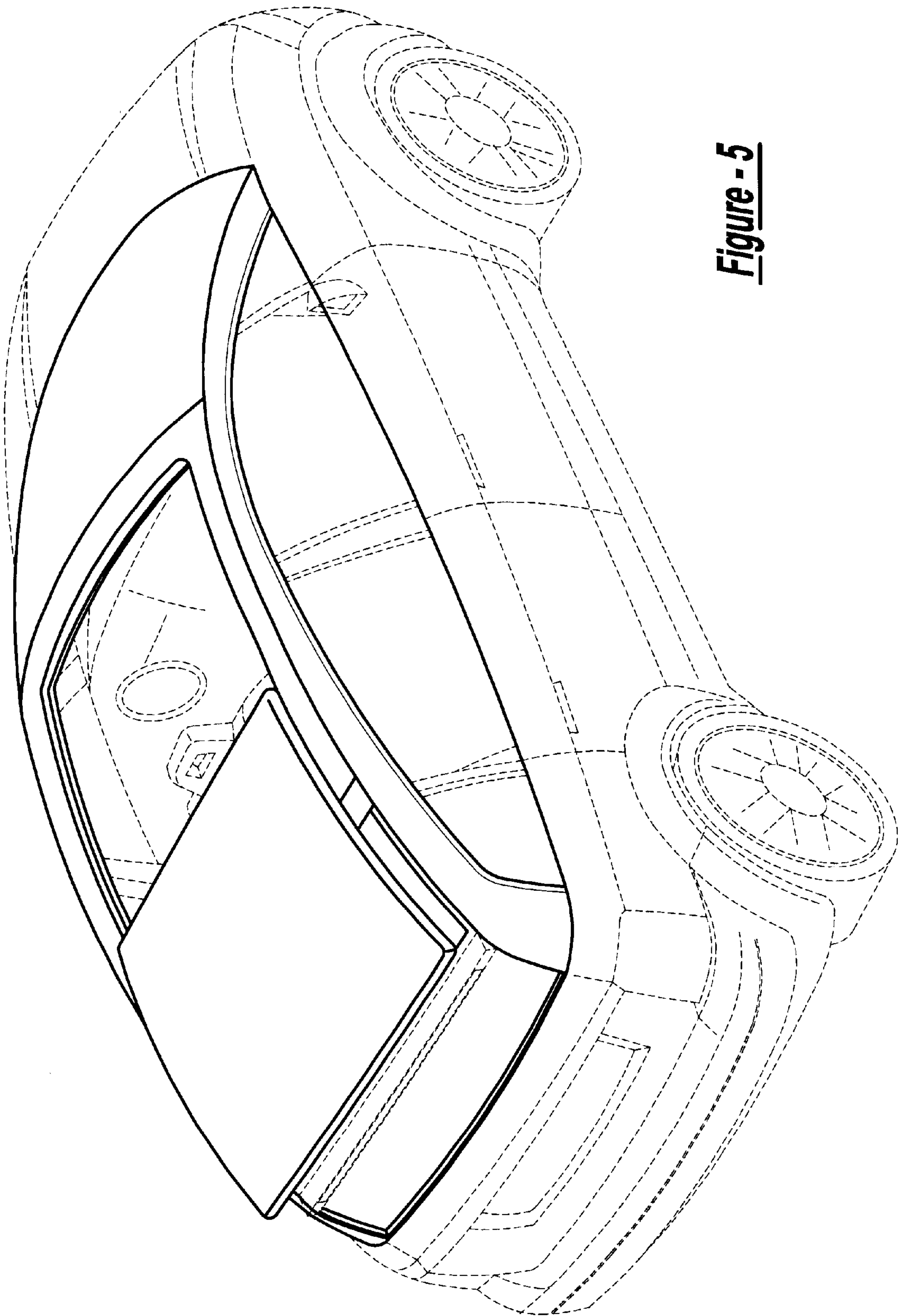


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
