(57) **CLAIM**

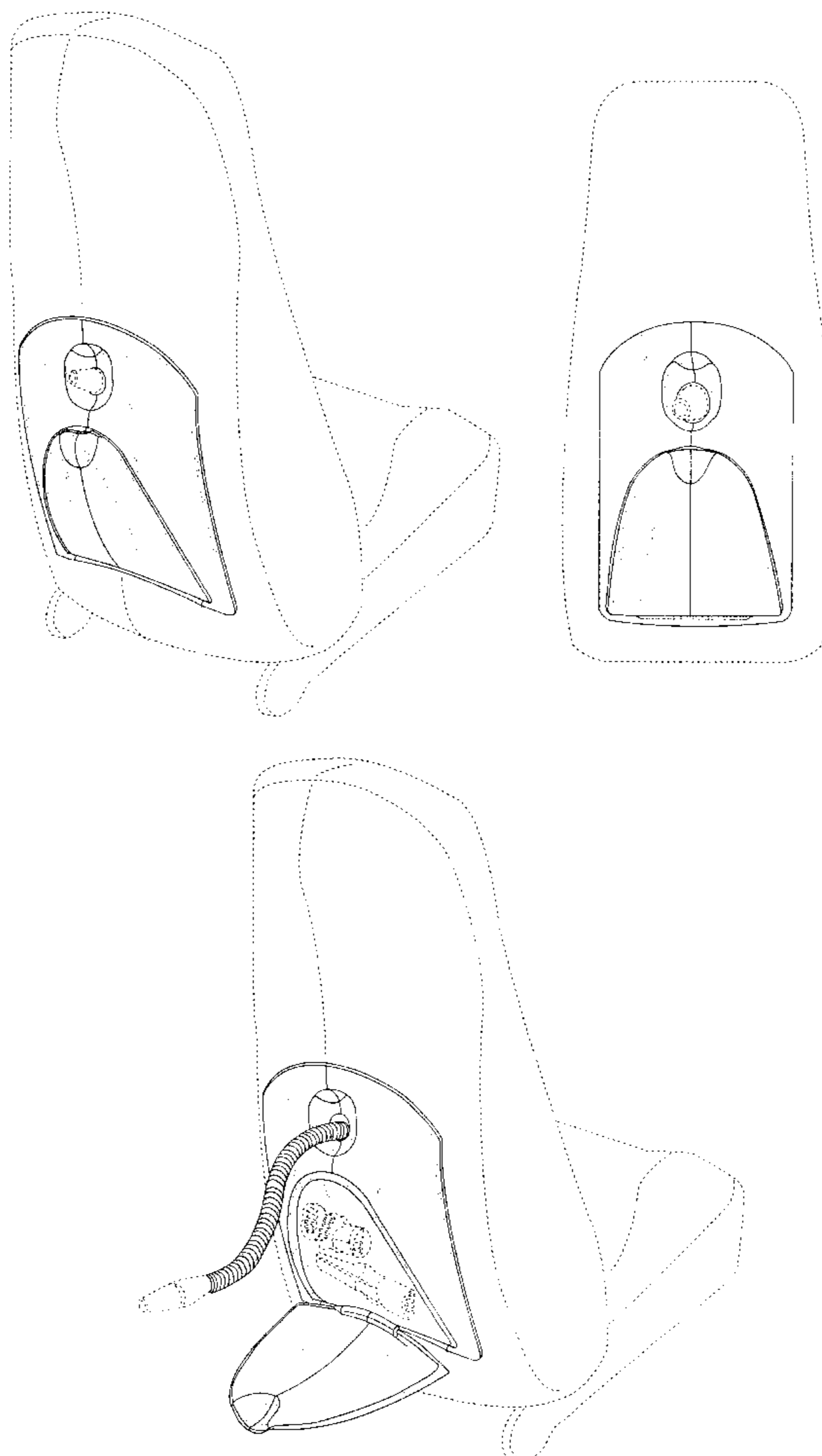
The ornamental appearance of a seat-mounted vacuum console, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of a seat mounted vacuum console showing our new design; FIG. 2 is a front elevational thereof; FIG. 3 is a left side elevational view thereof, the right side elevational view being a mirror image thereof; and, FIG. 4 is a perspective view thereof, with a hose in an extended position.

The broken lines are for illustrative purposes only and form no part of the claimed design.

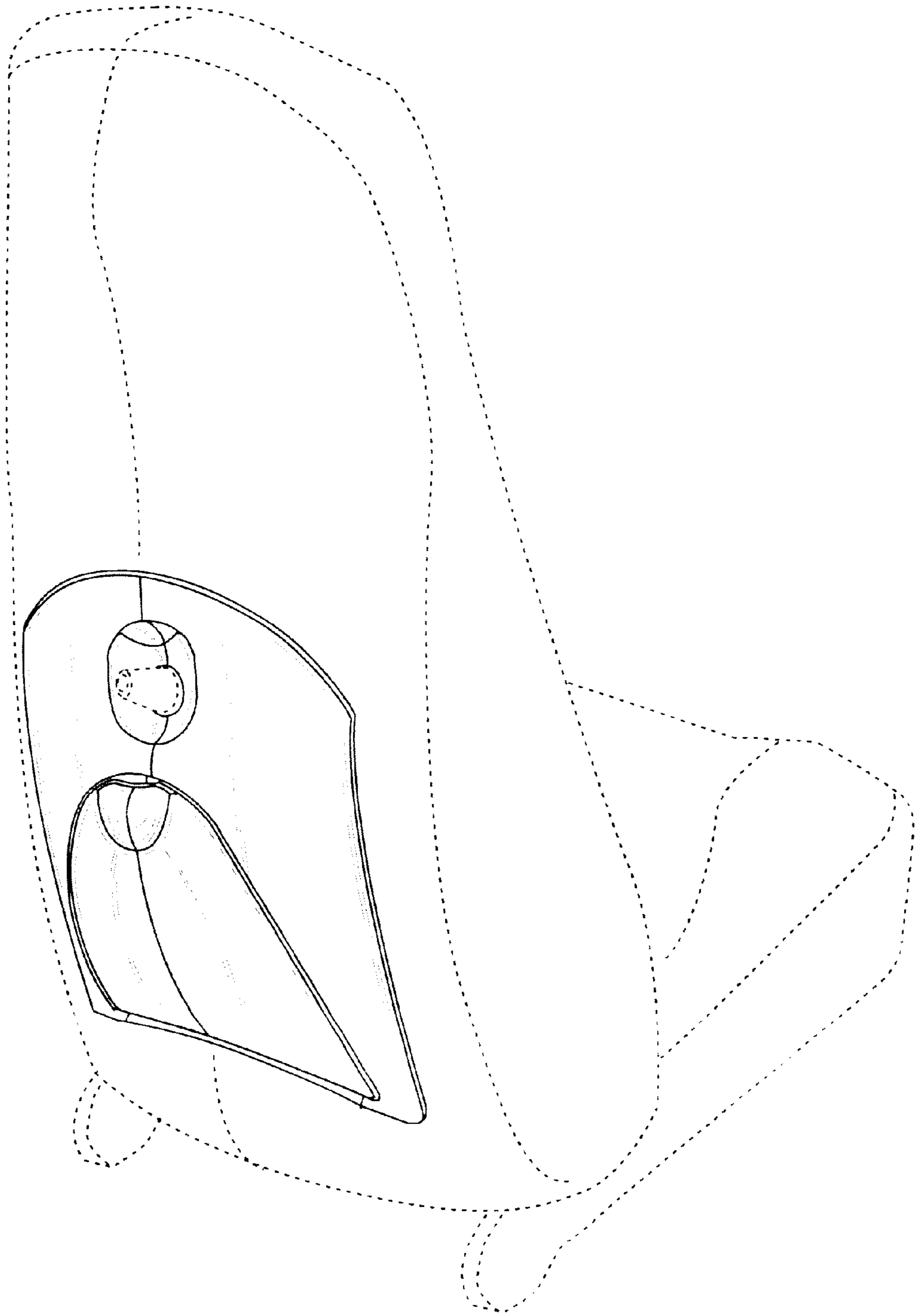

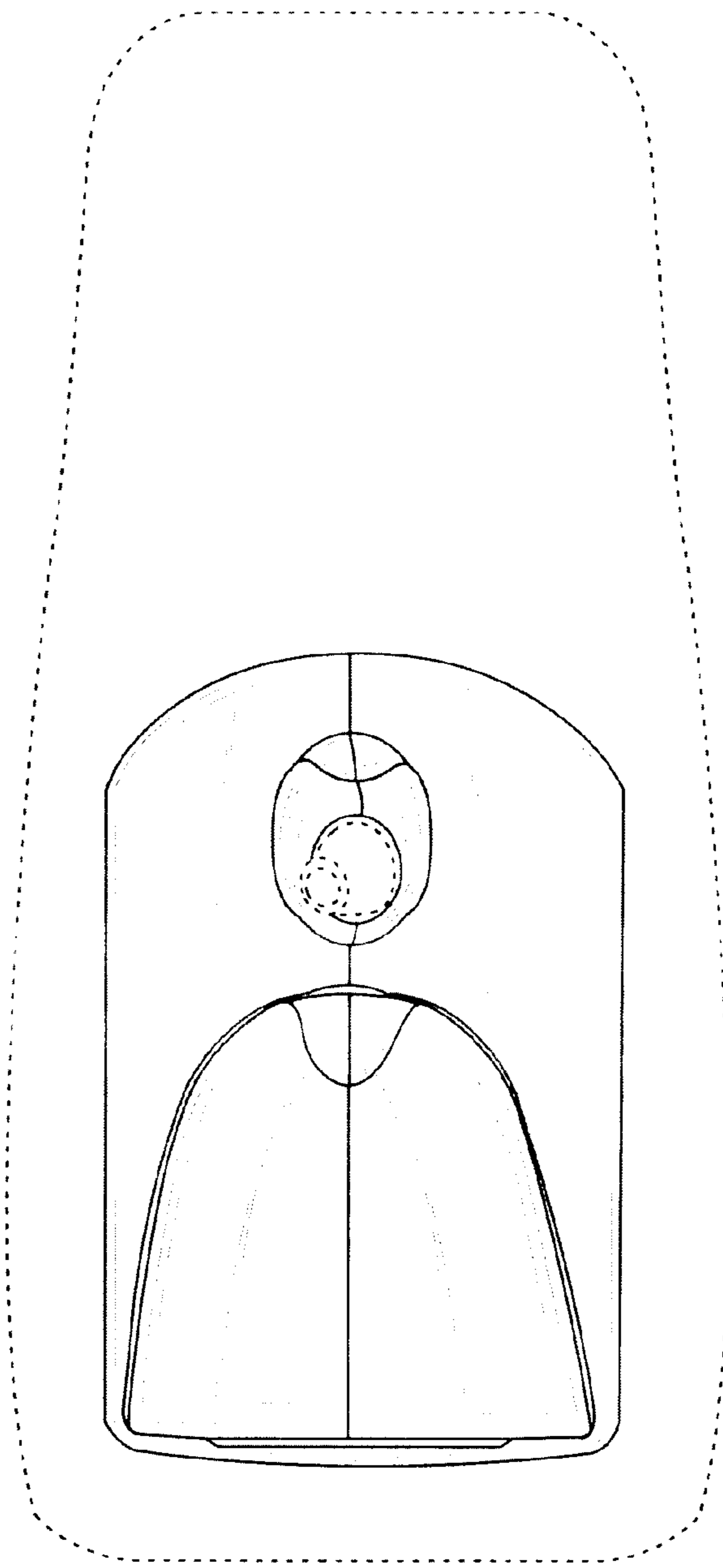

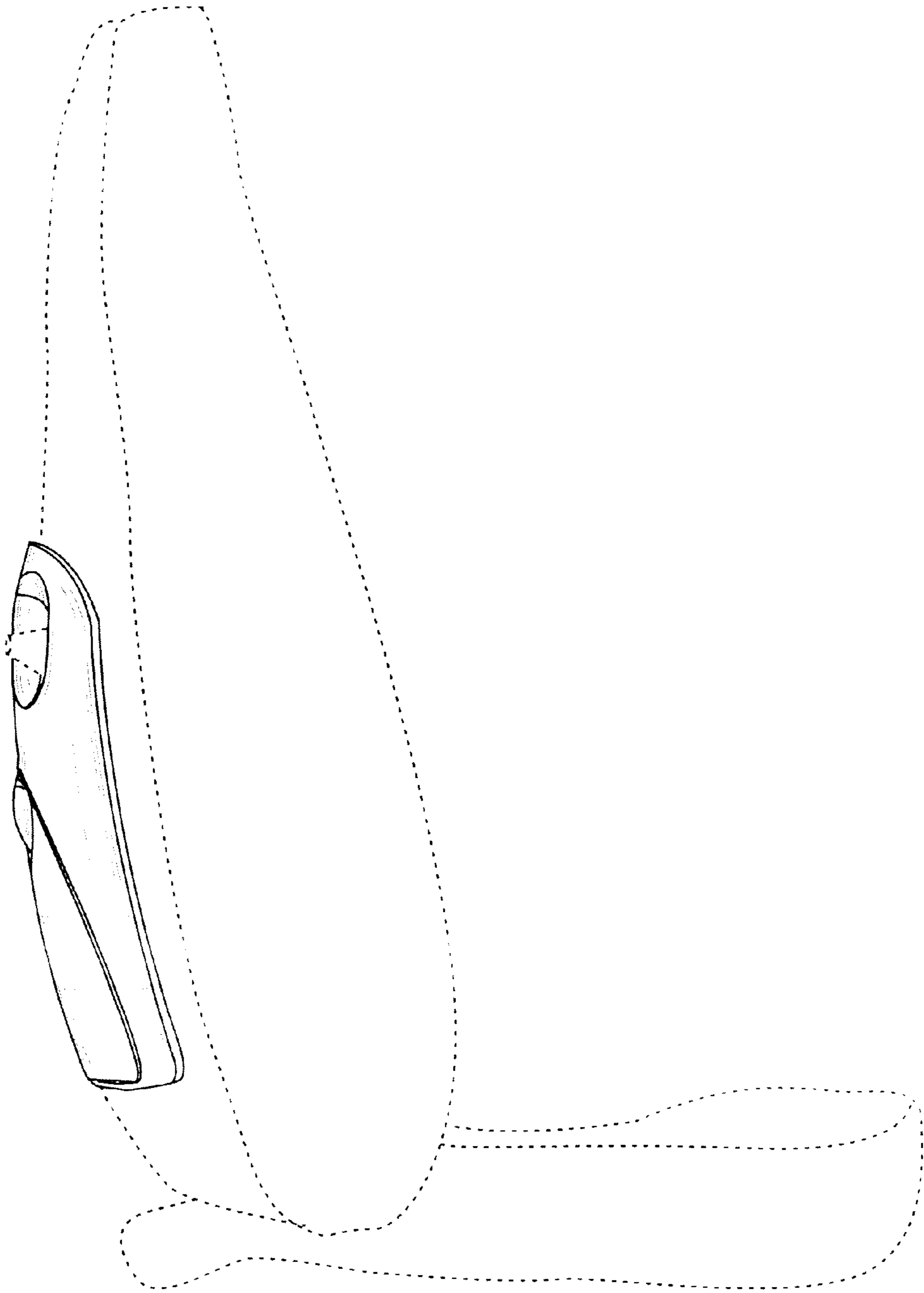

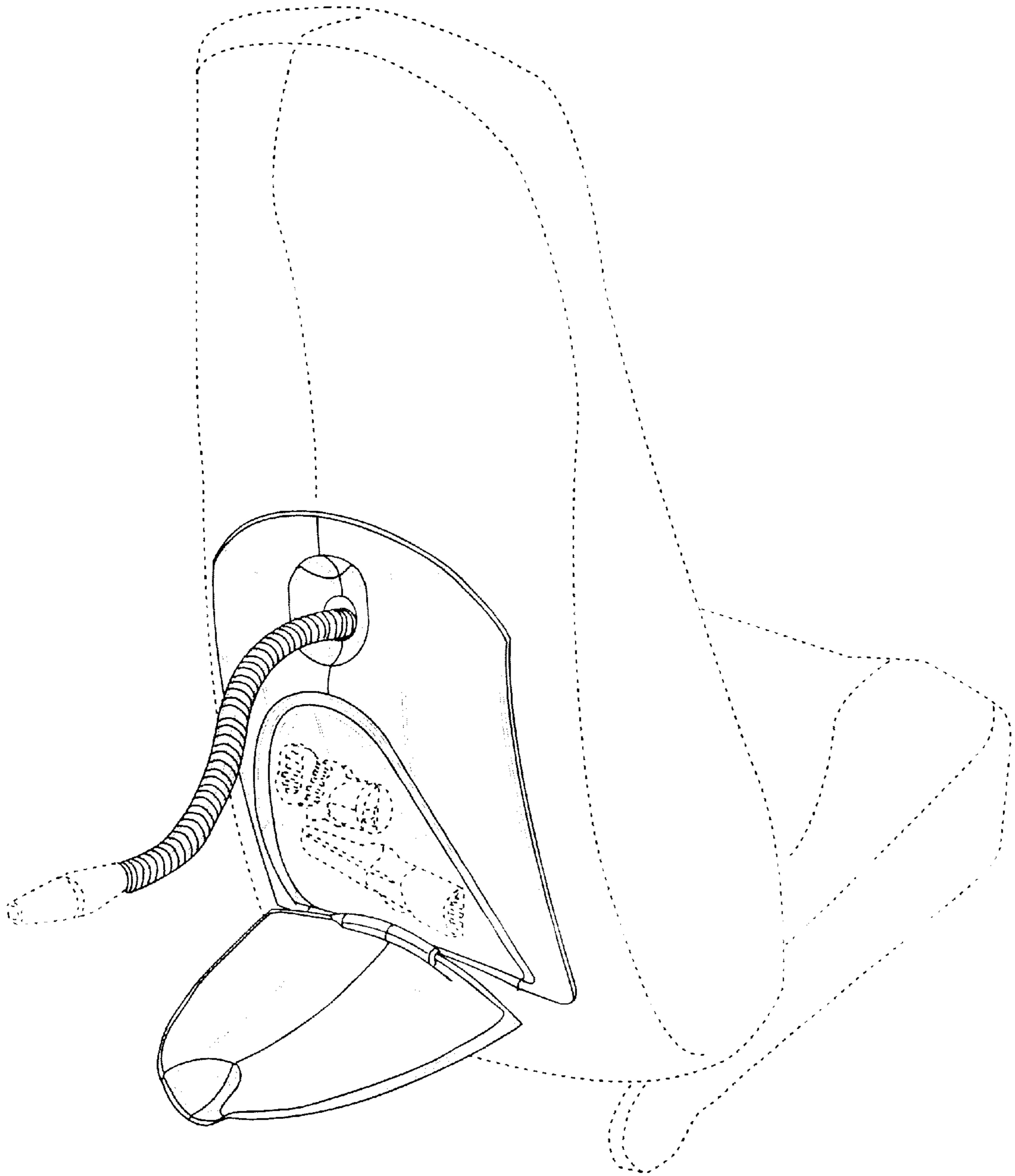
