FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of a mirror with drawer according to an embodiment of the invention.

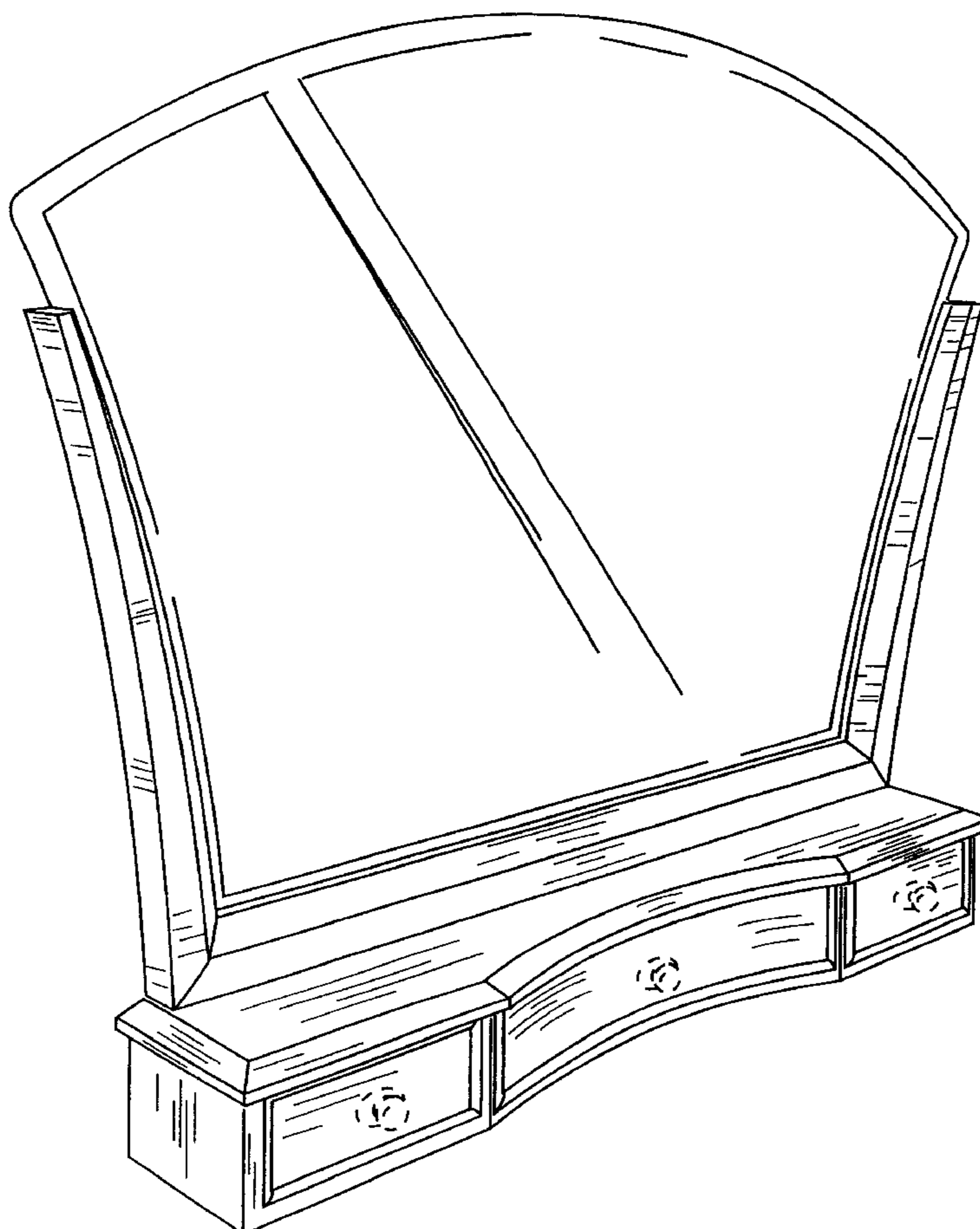
FIG. 2 is a front view of a mirror with drawer according to an embodiment of the invention.

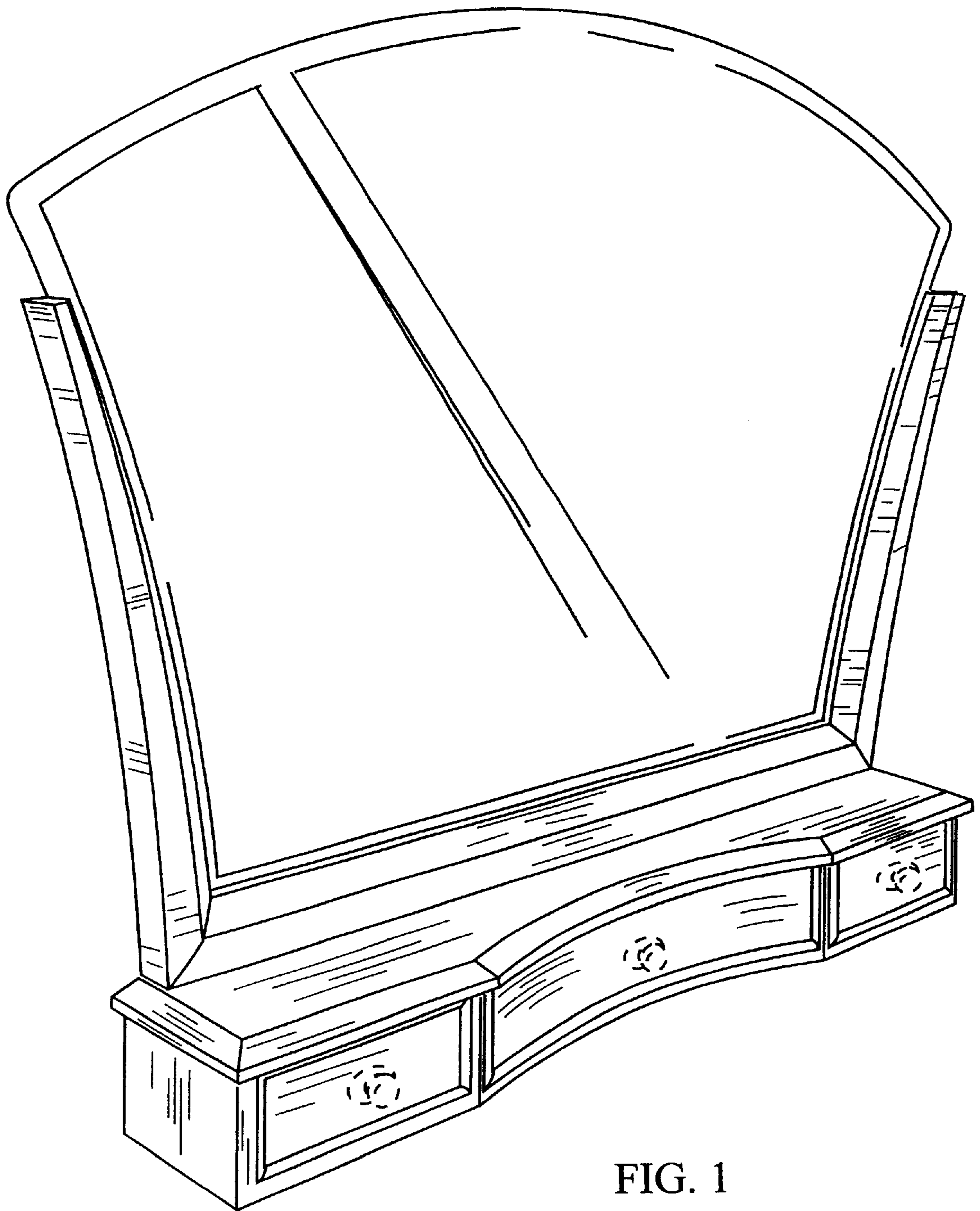

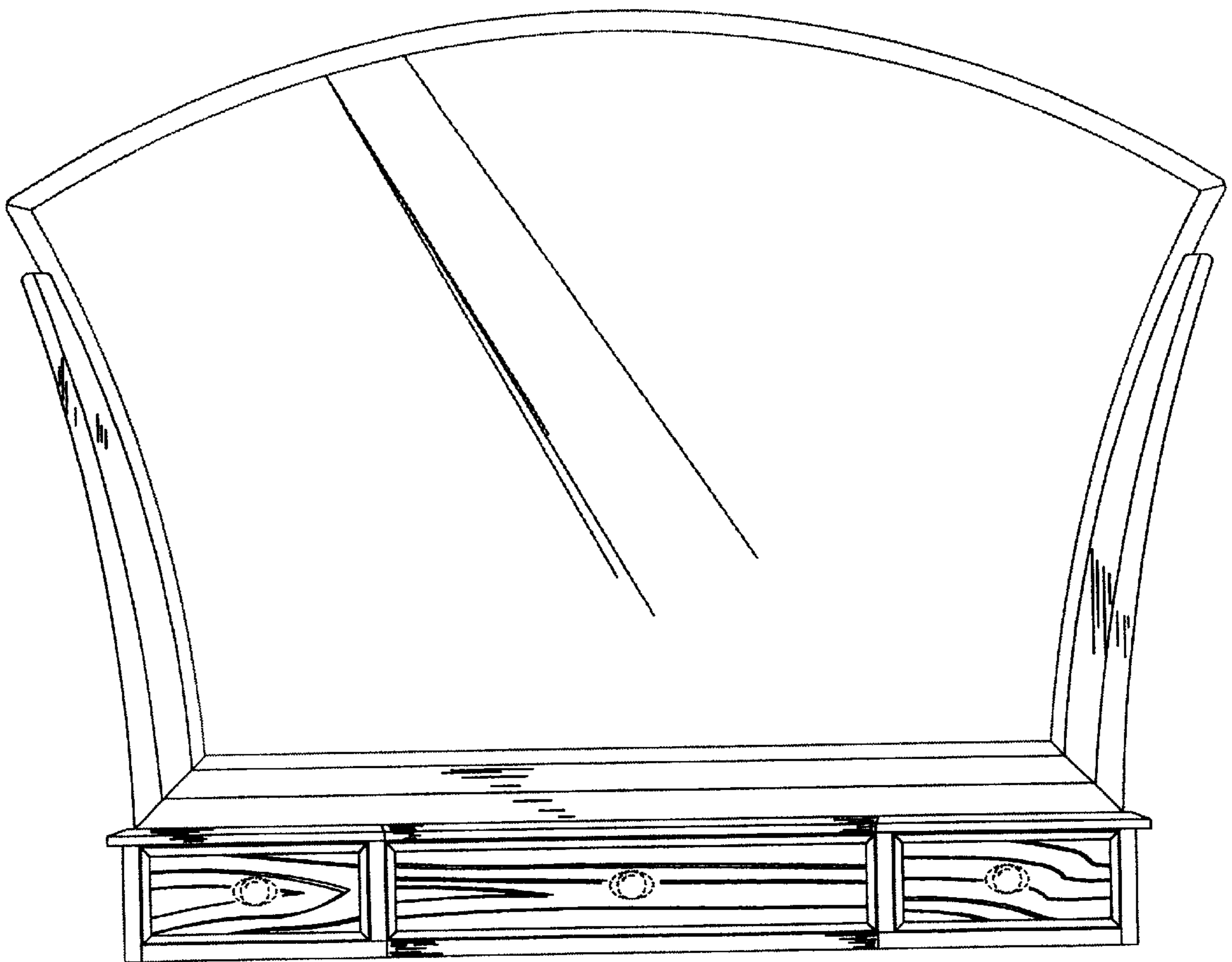

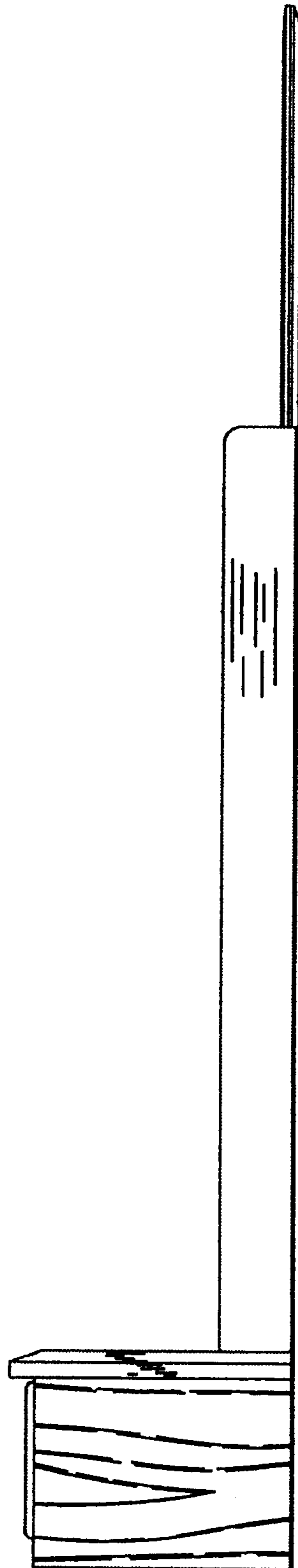
