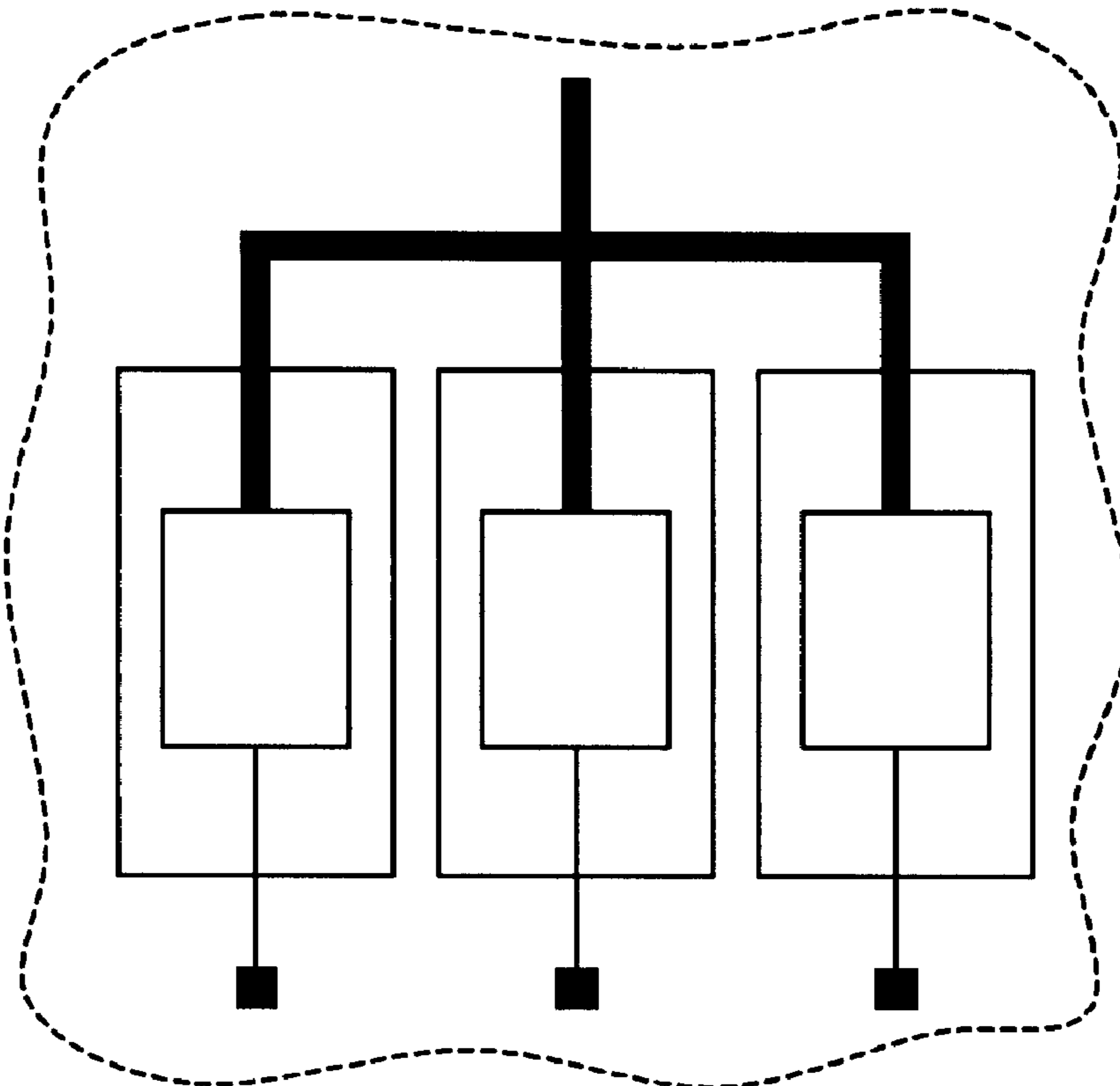

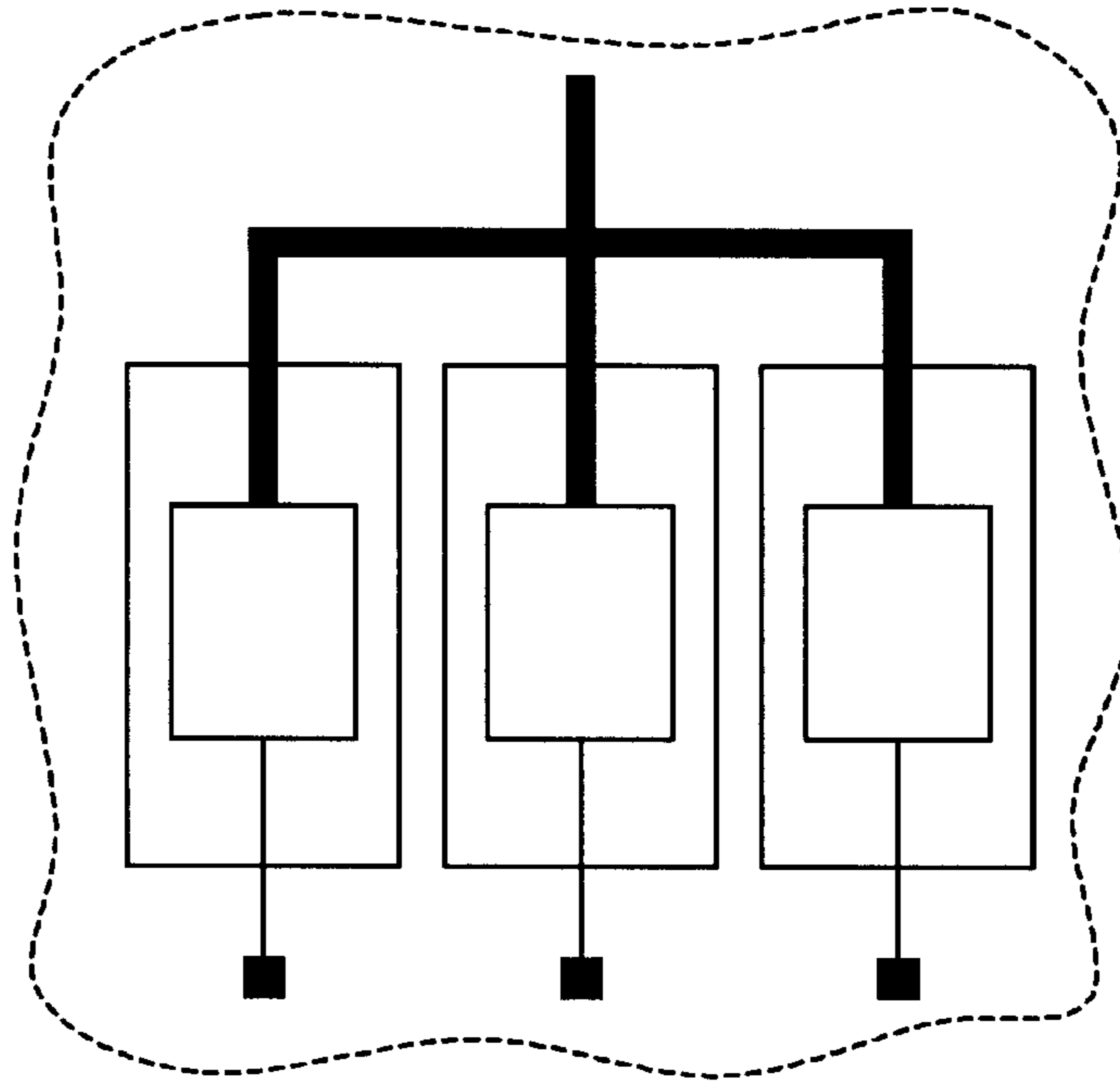
The ornamental design for an icon for a portion of a computer screen, as shown and described.

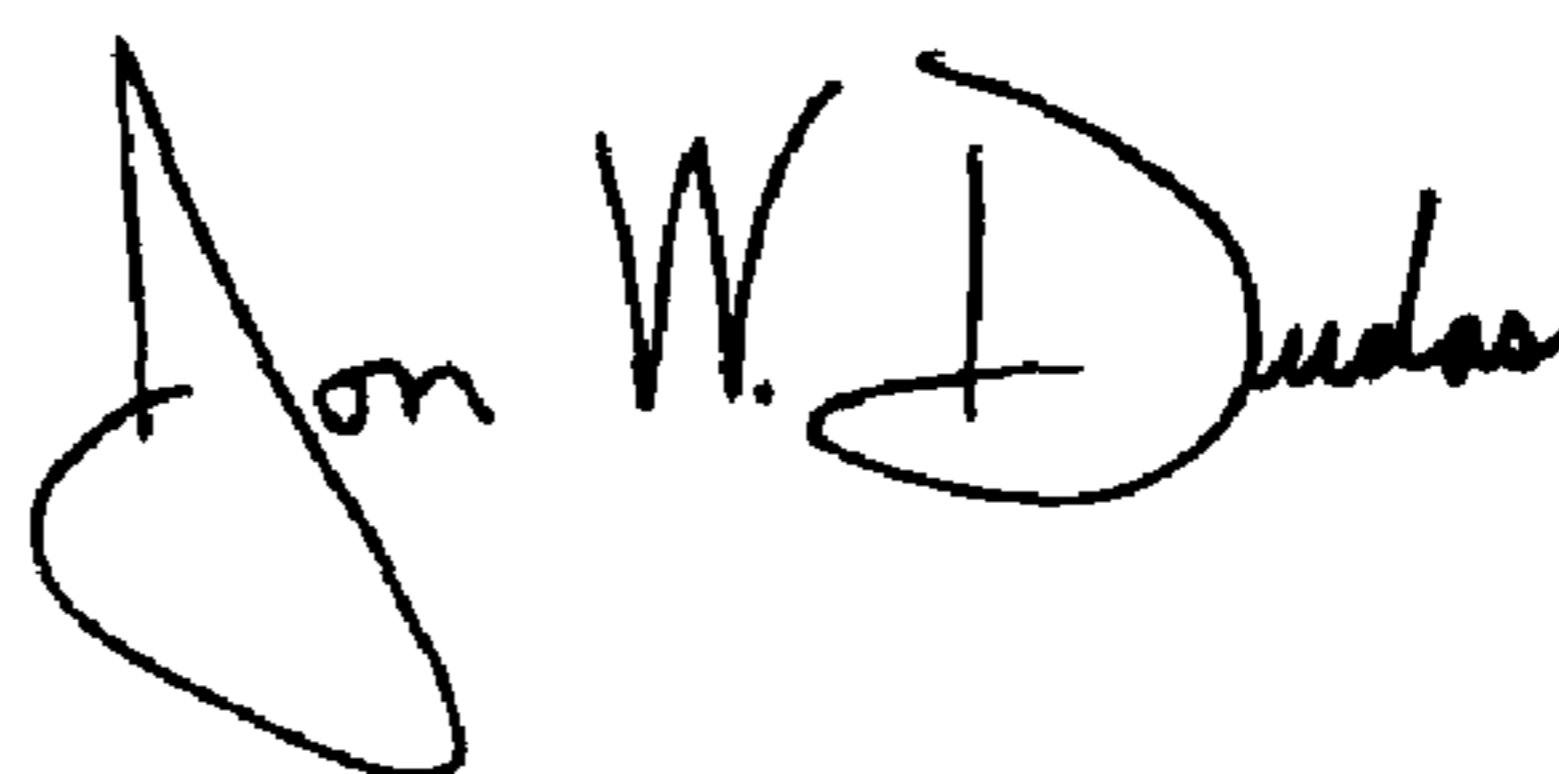
