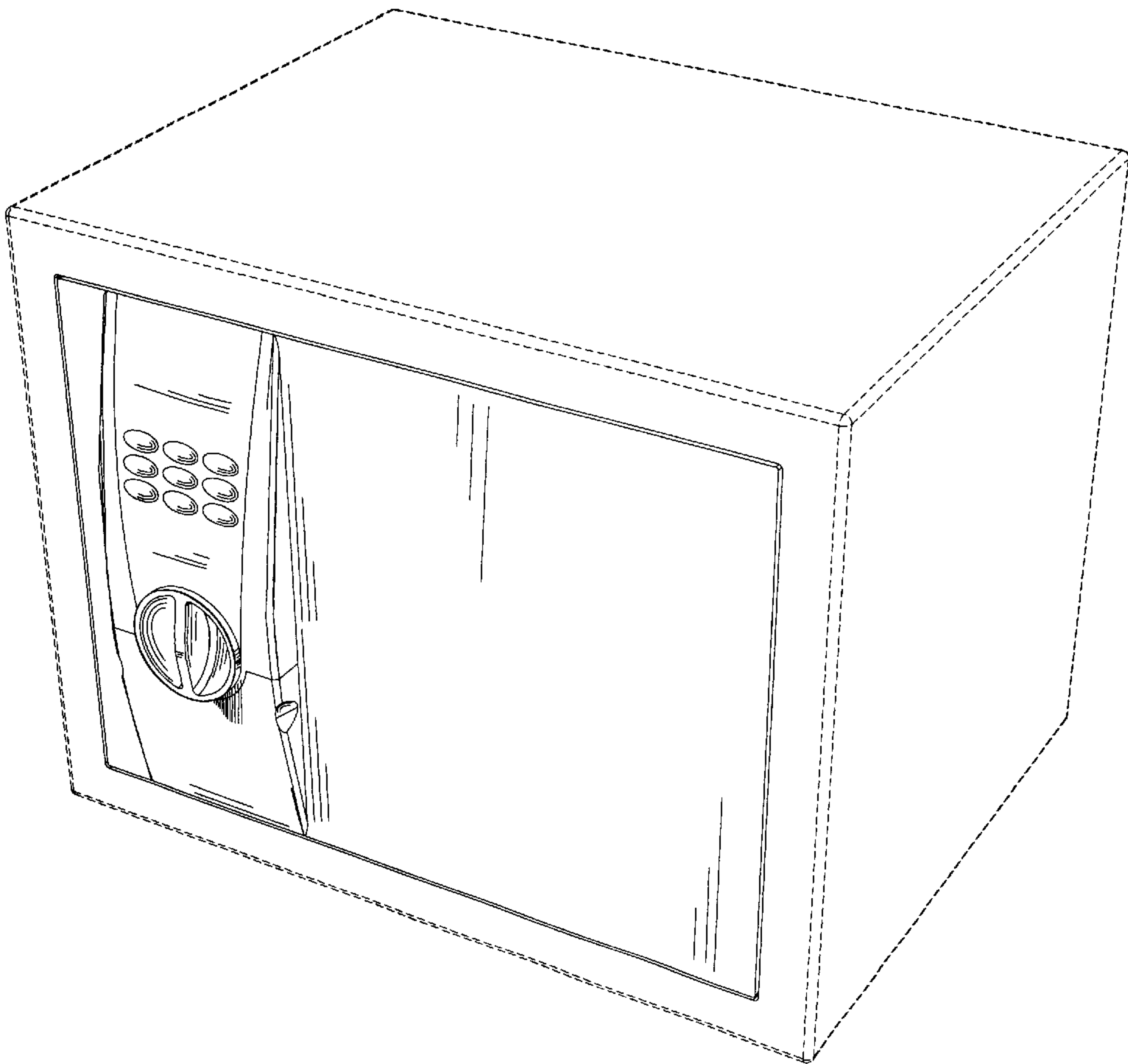
The ornamental design for a door for security safes and gun cabinets, as shown and described.

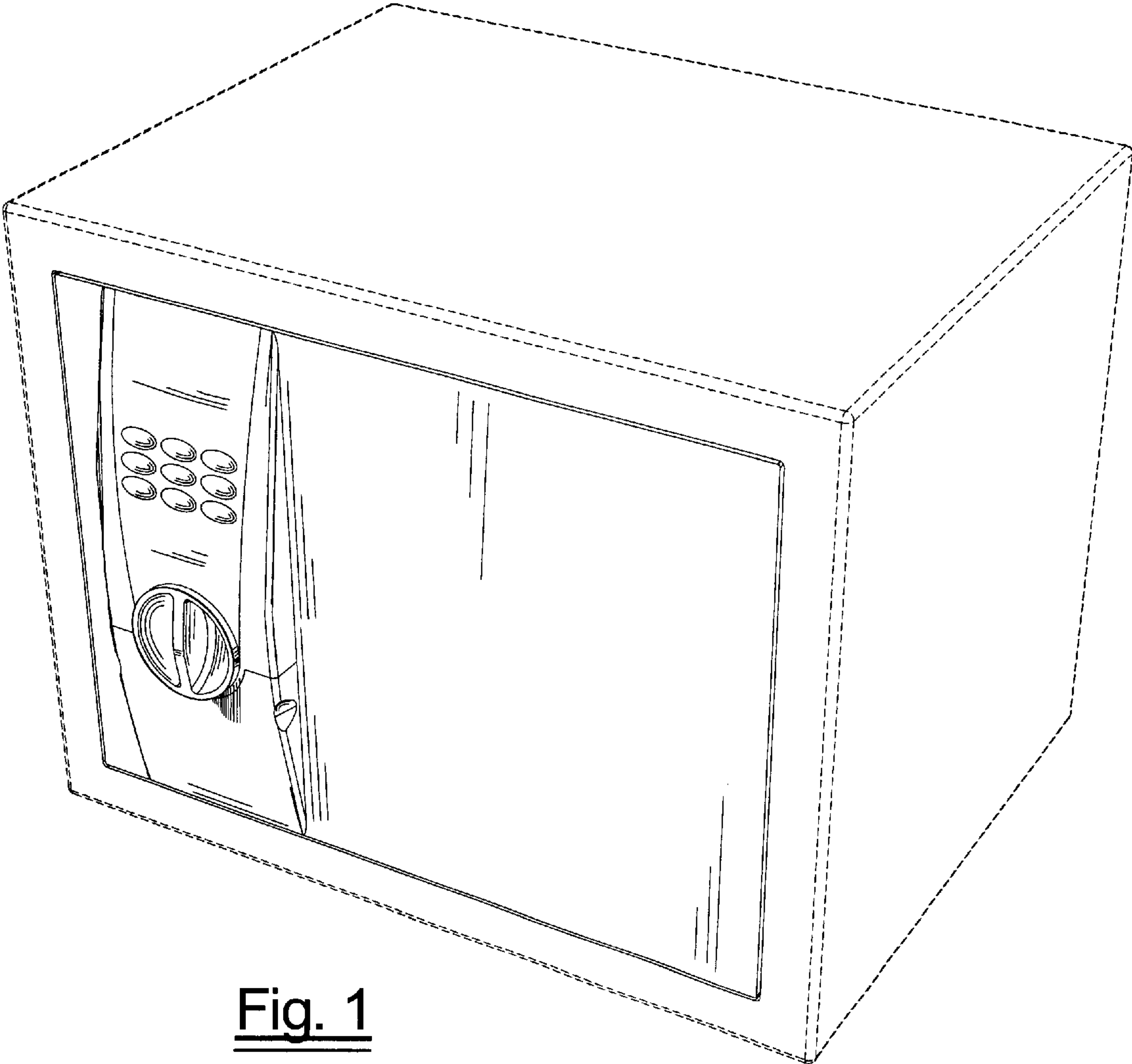

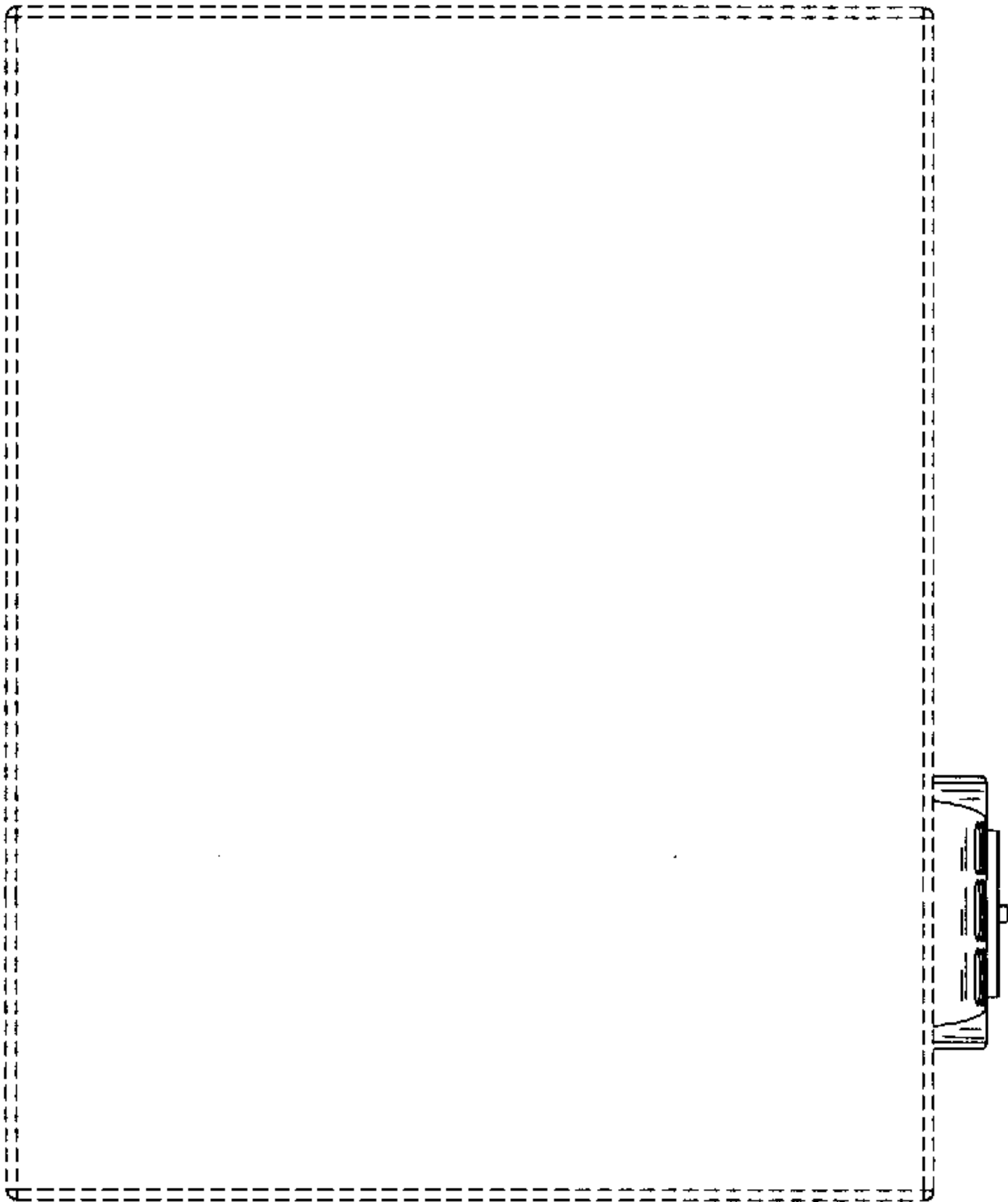

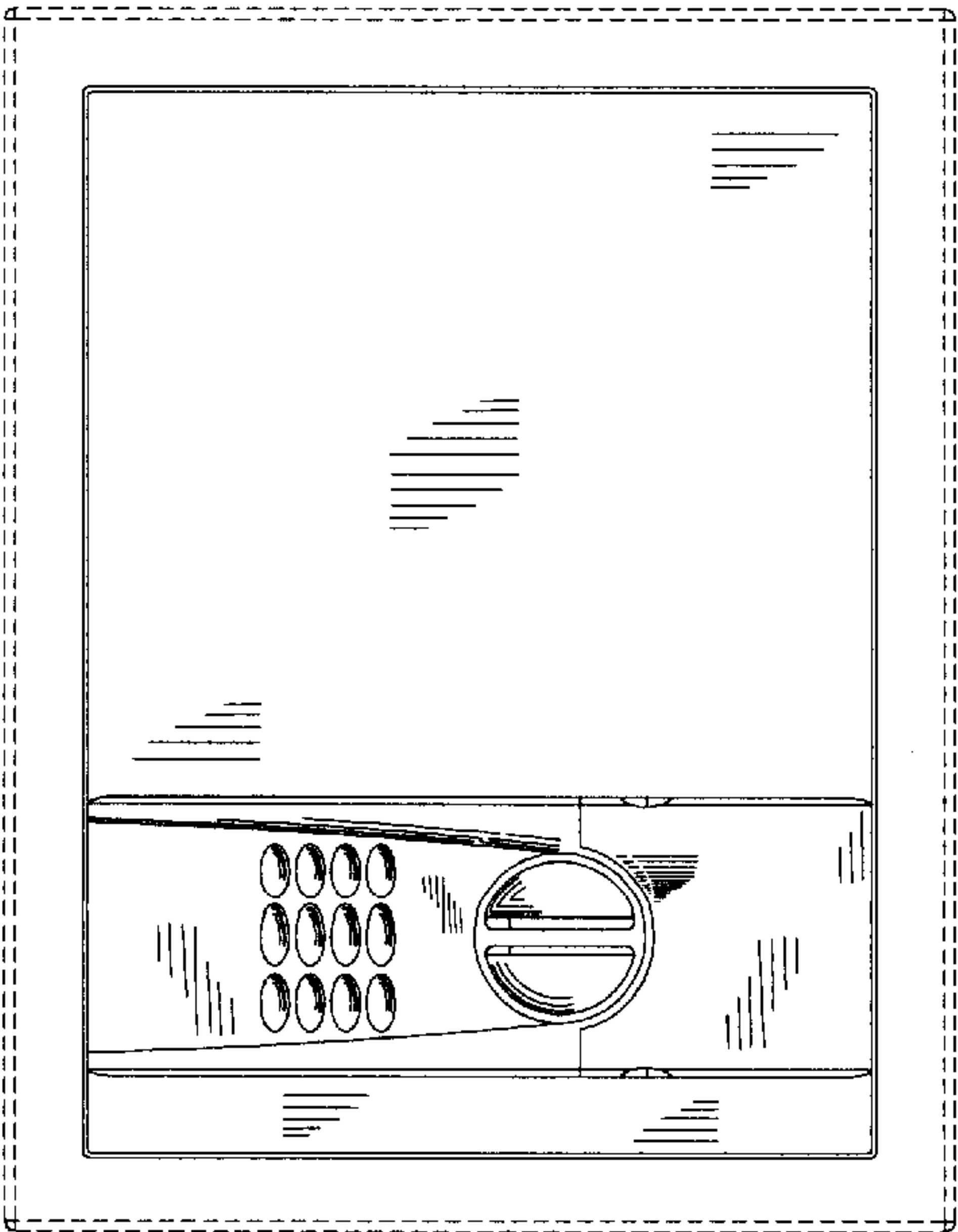
