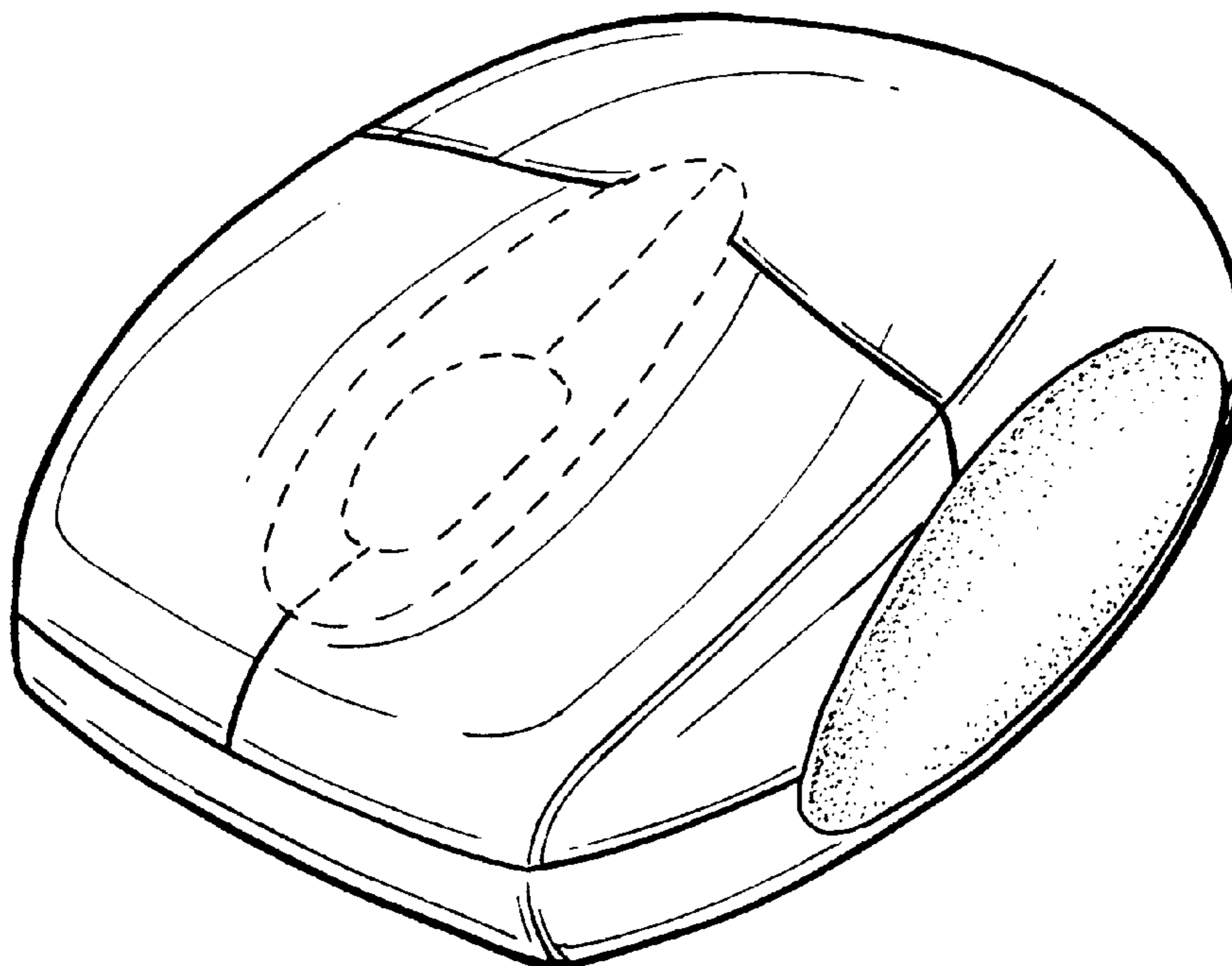
FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of a portion of an

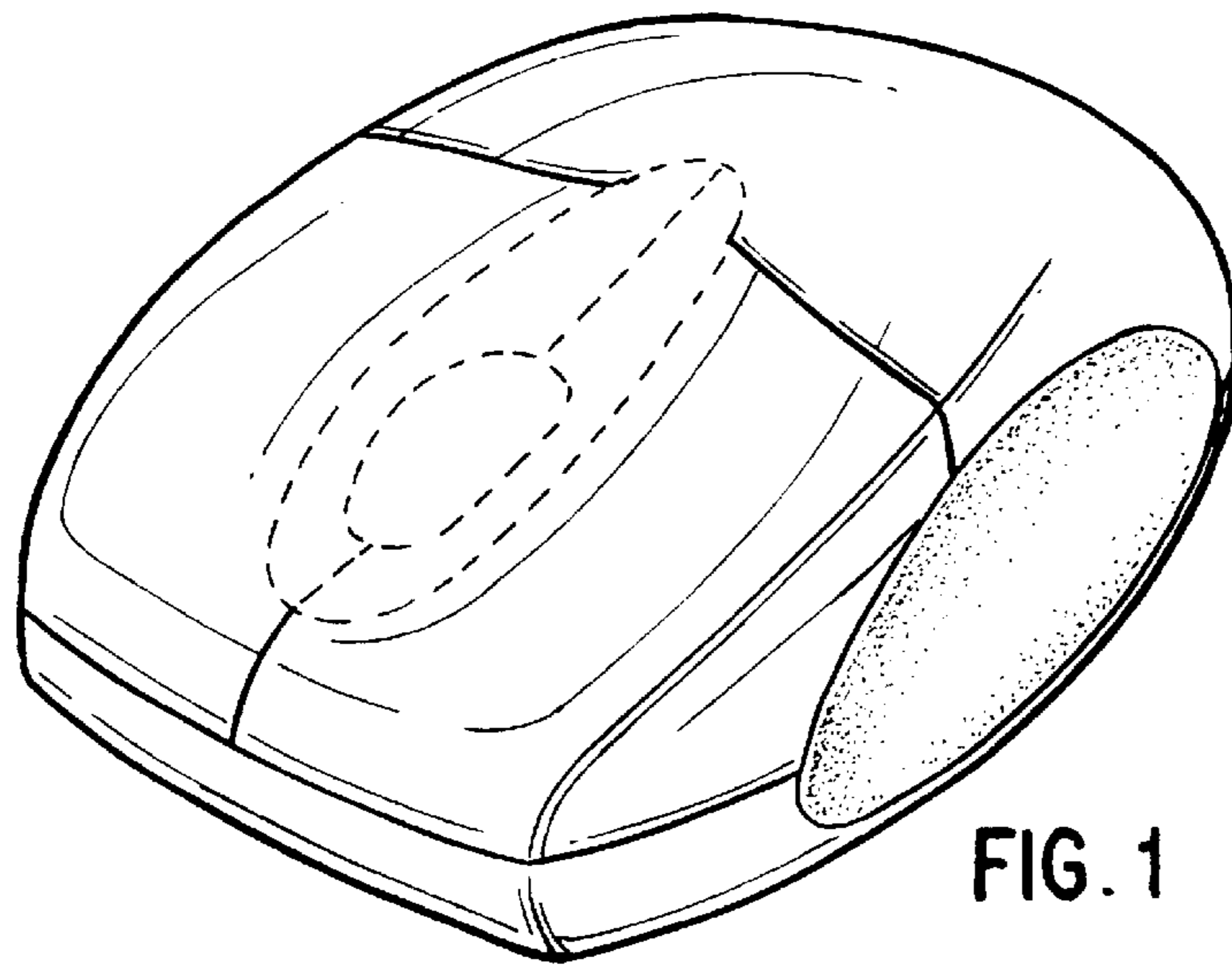

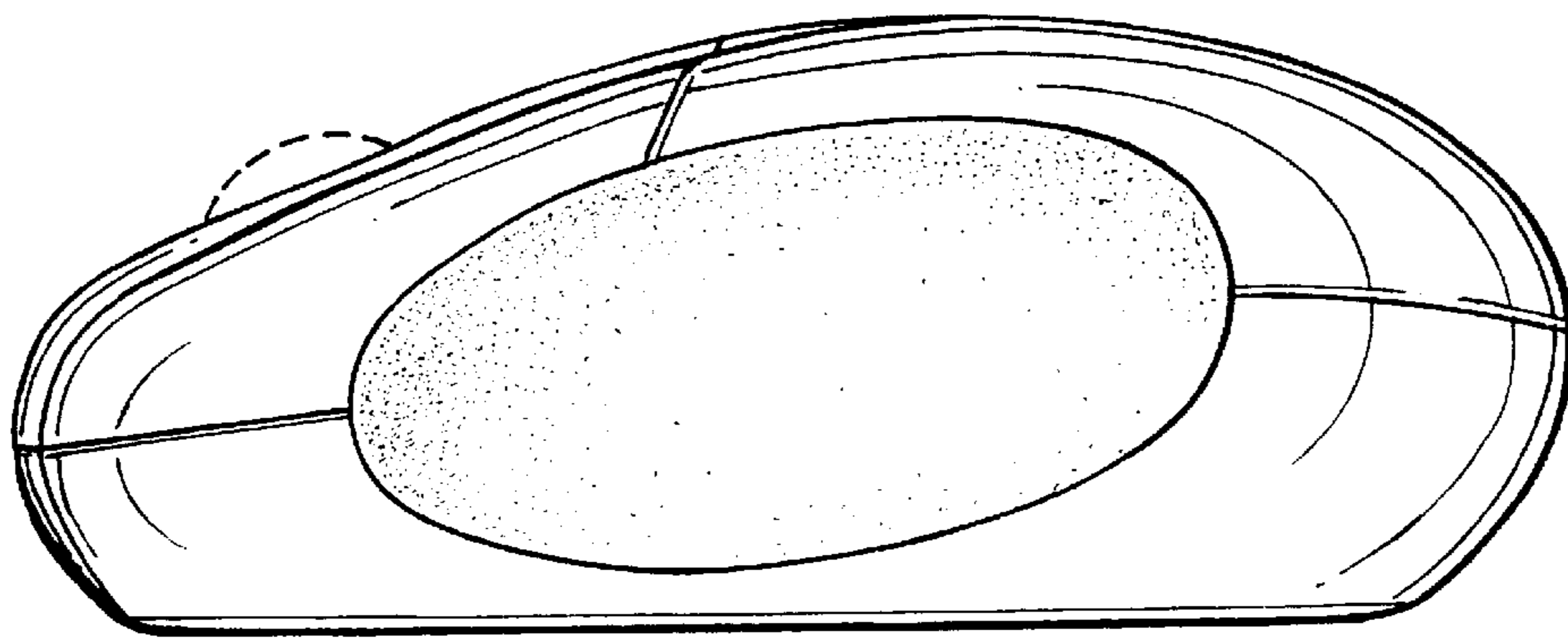

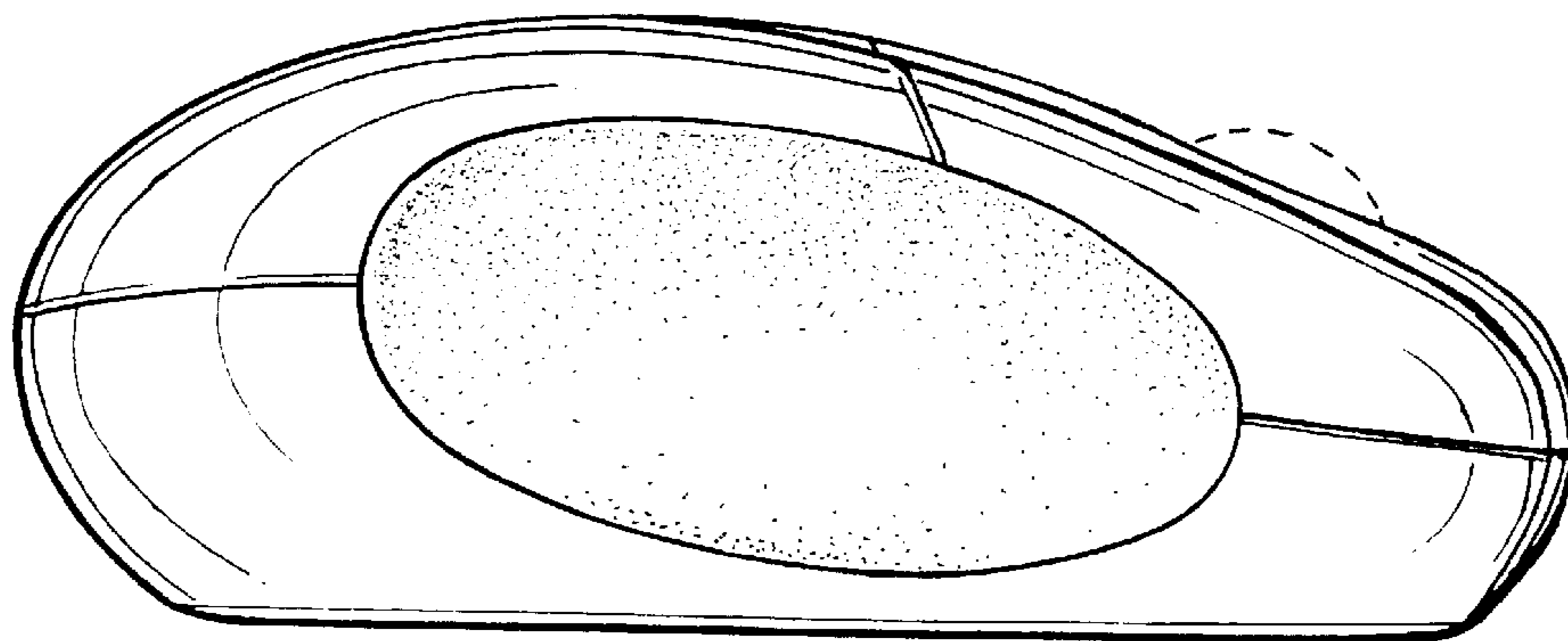

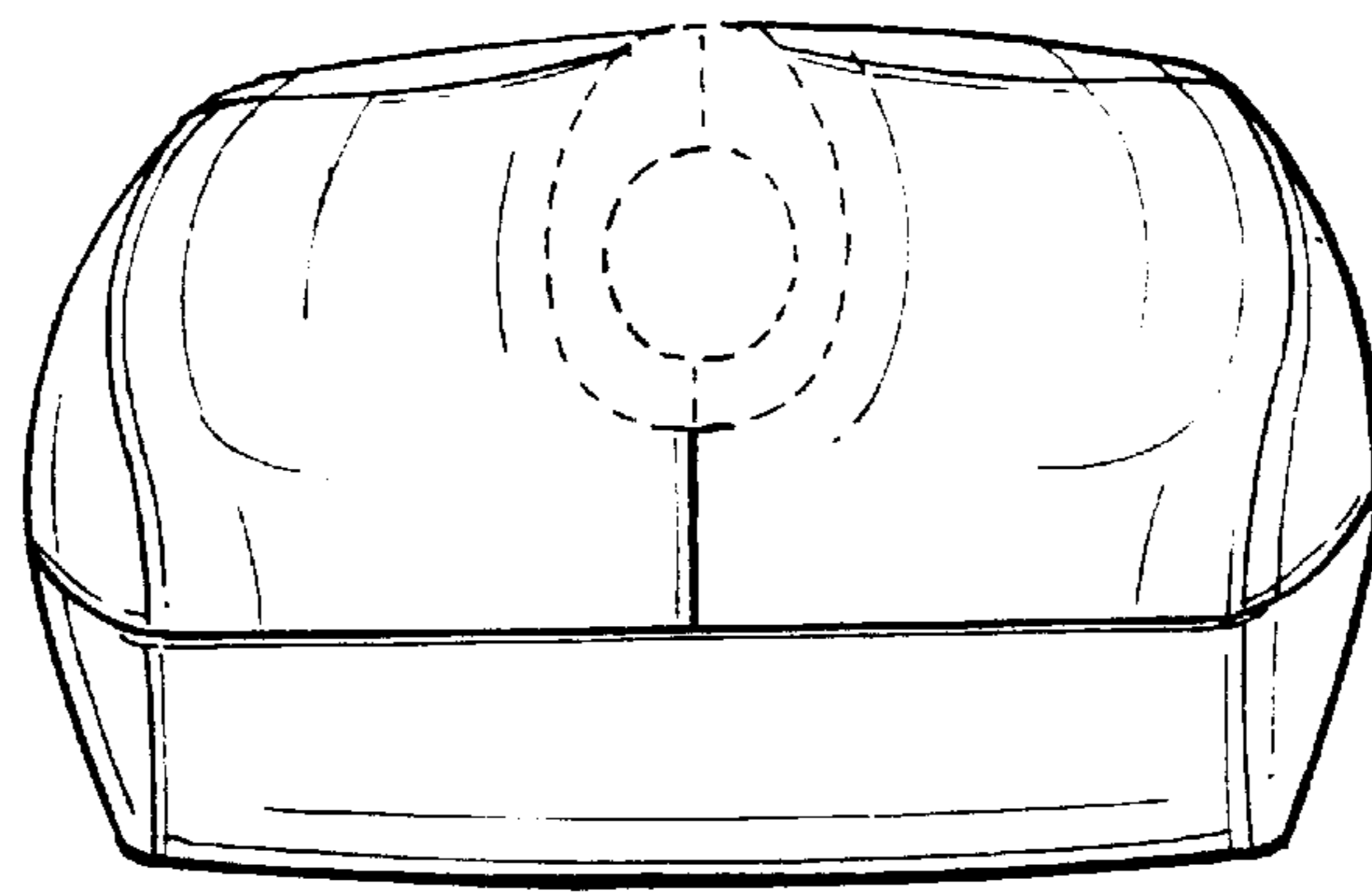

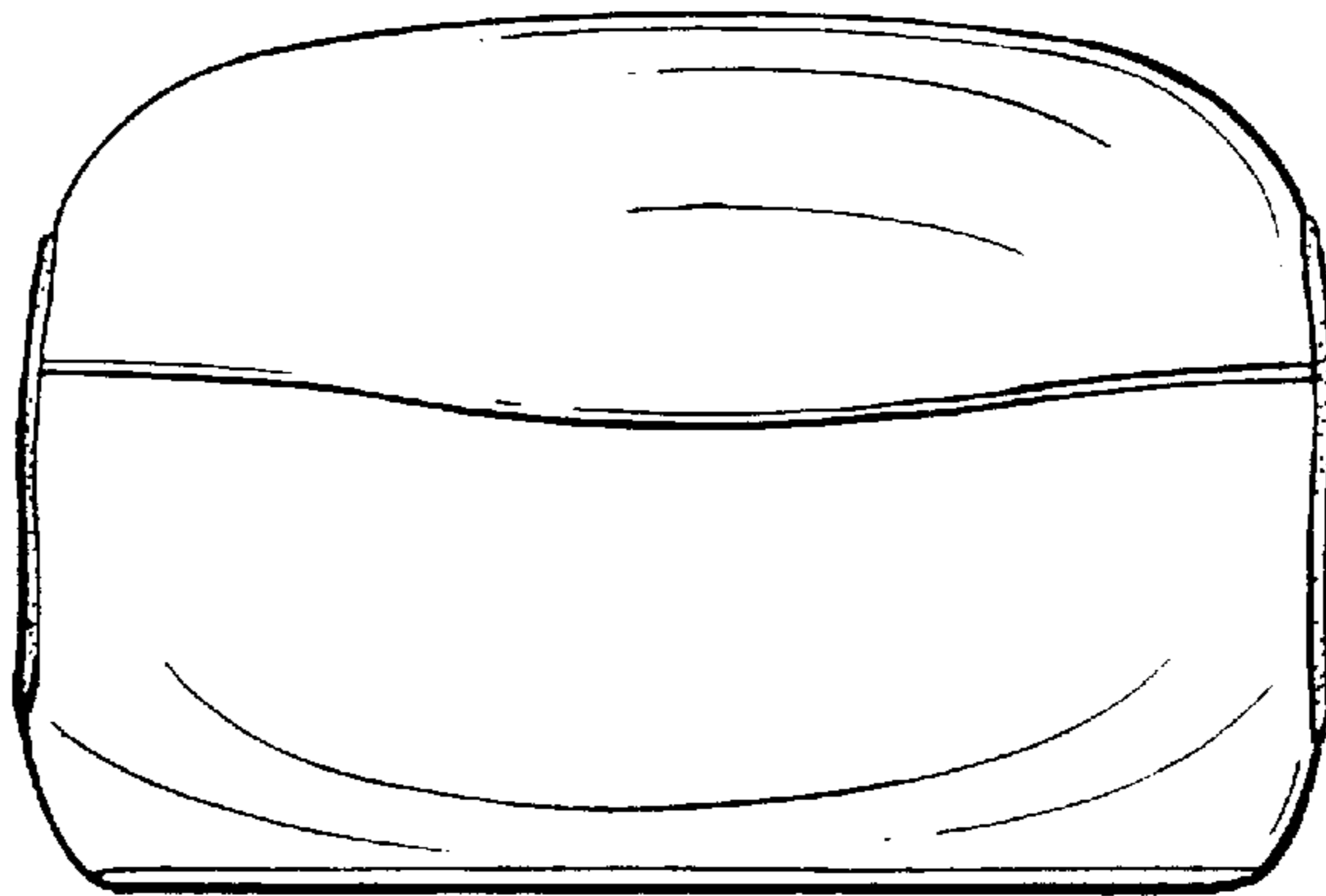

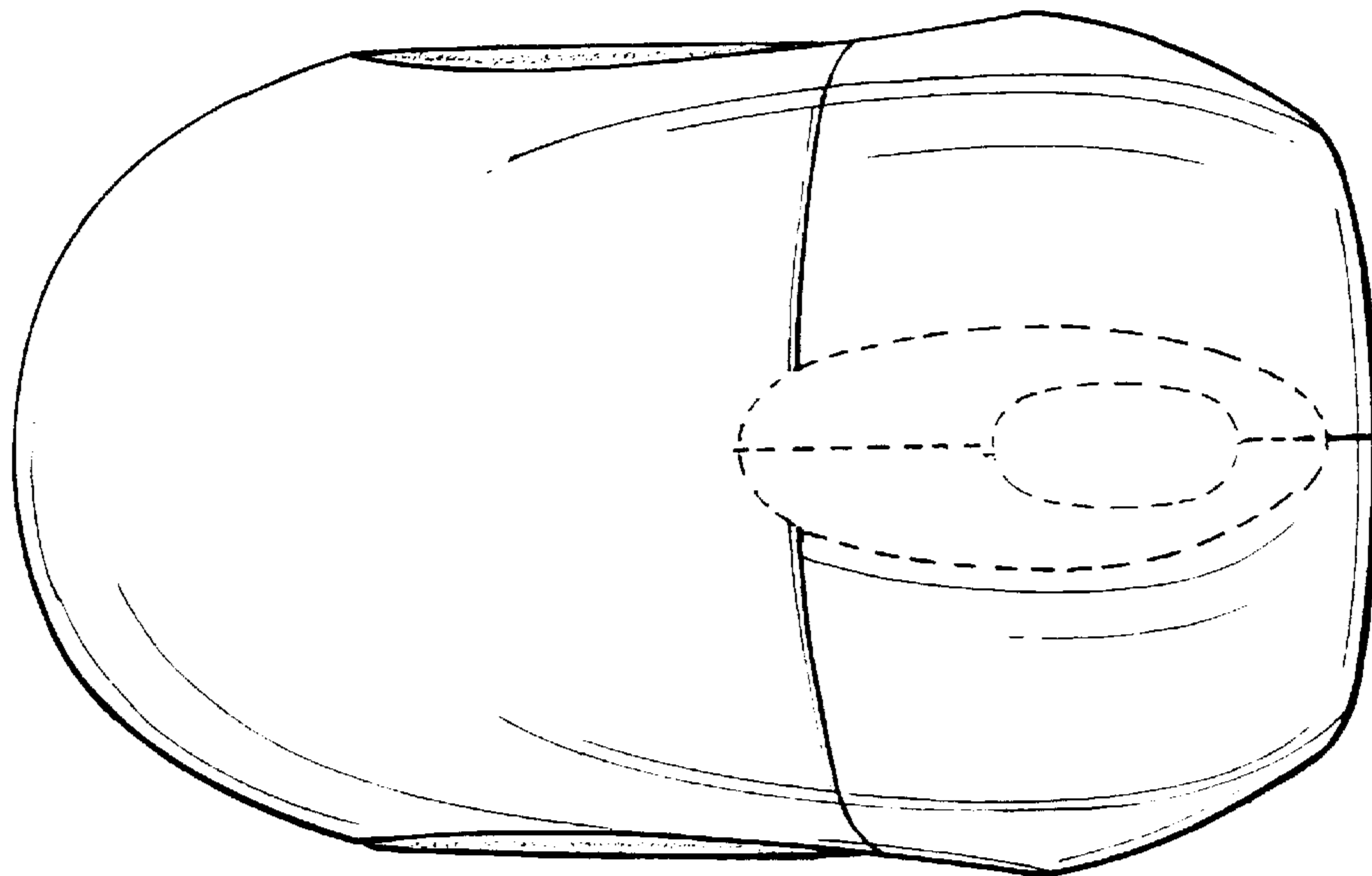
