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FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a holder for elongated articles, such as pens and pencils, for attachment to a wall, such as a cubicle wall, embodying our new design;

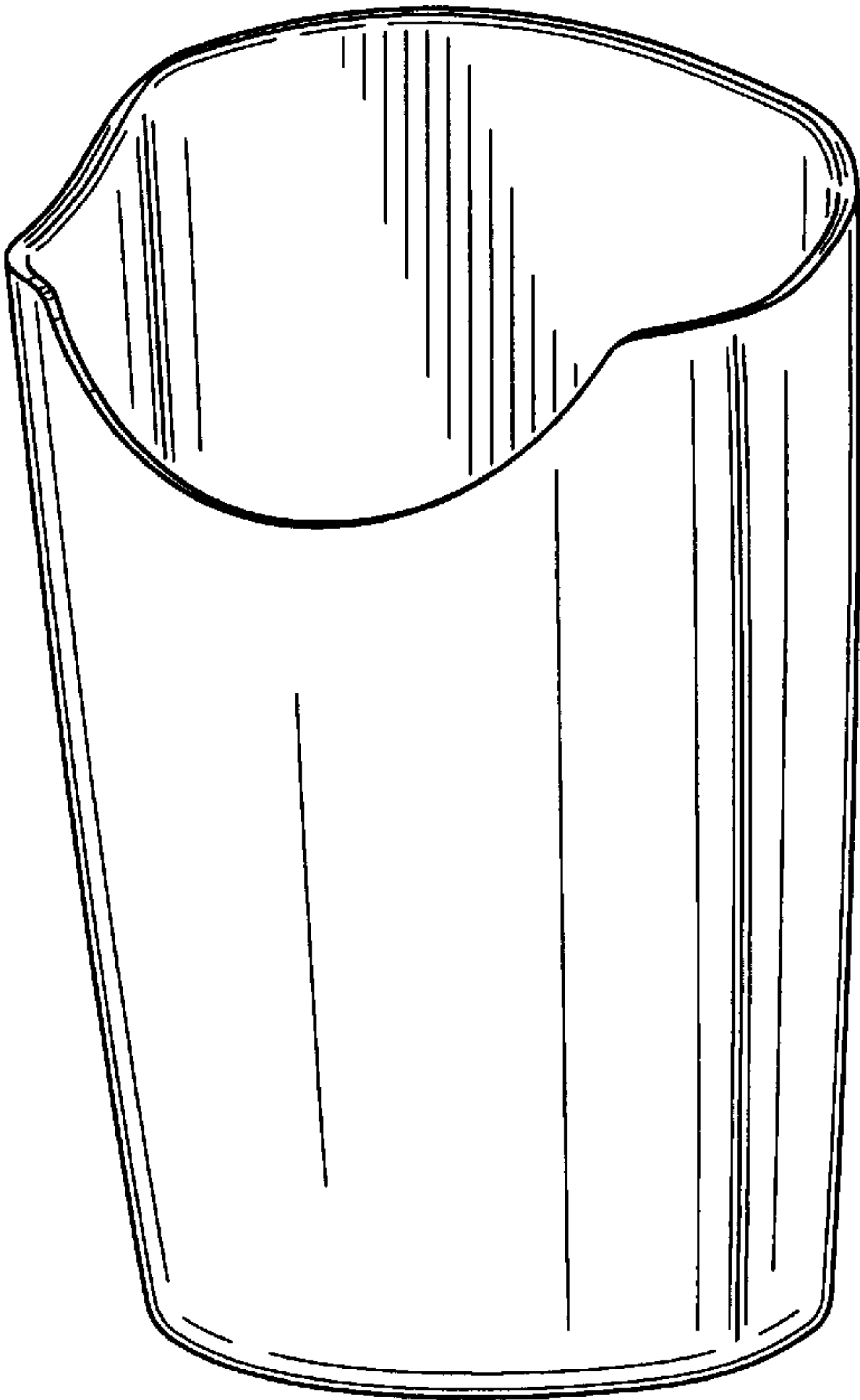
FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof;

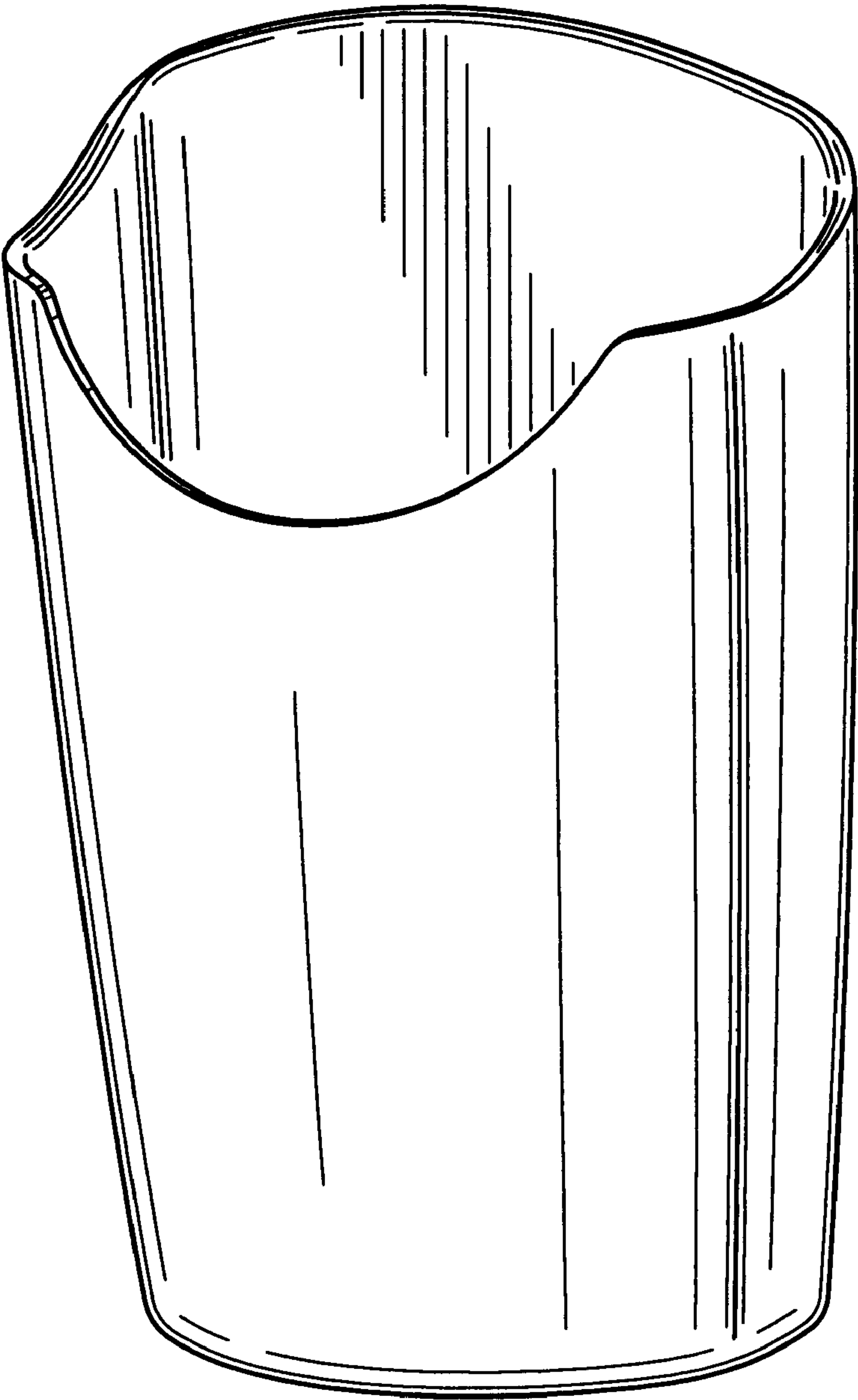

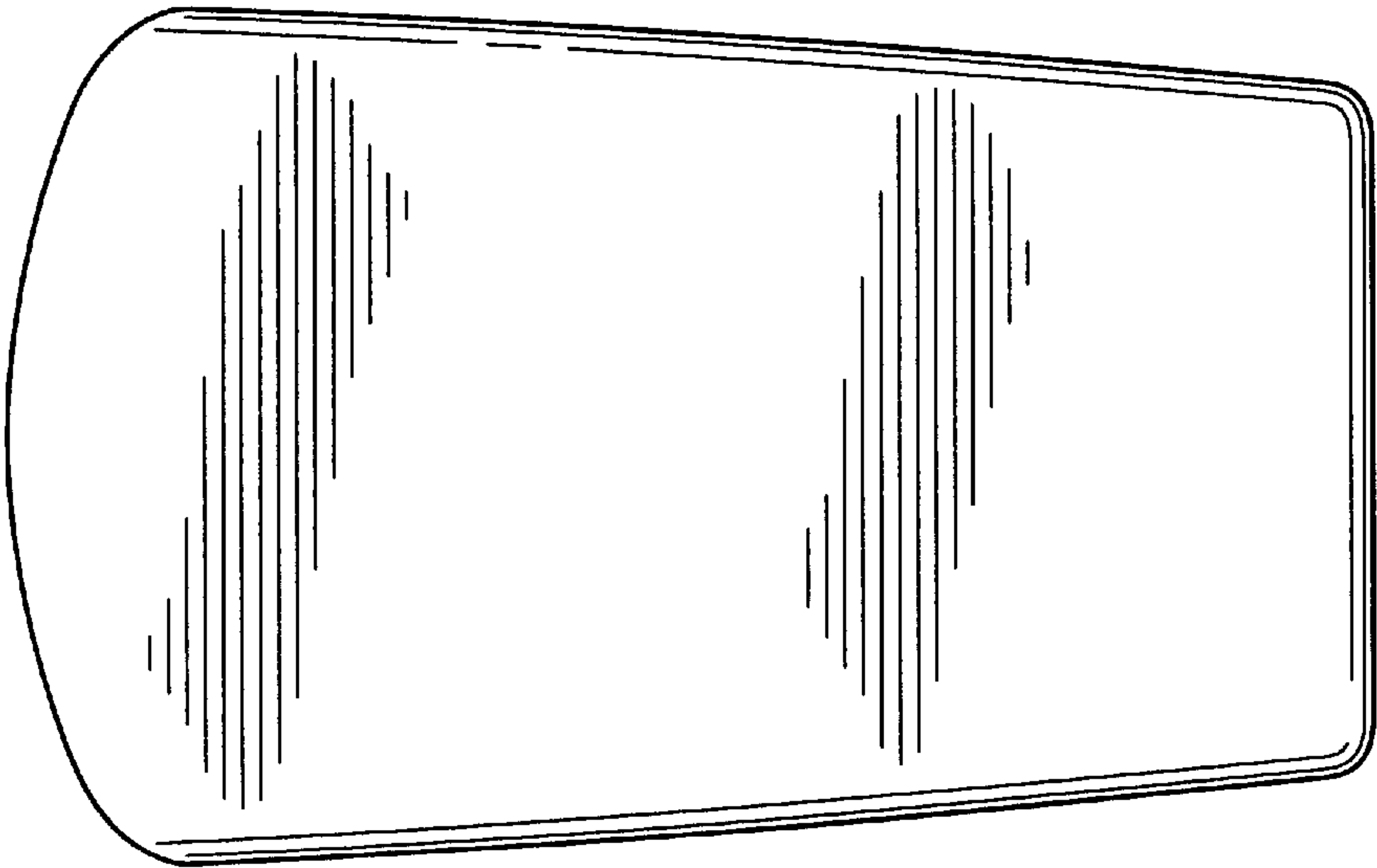

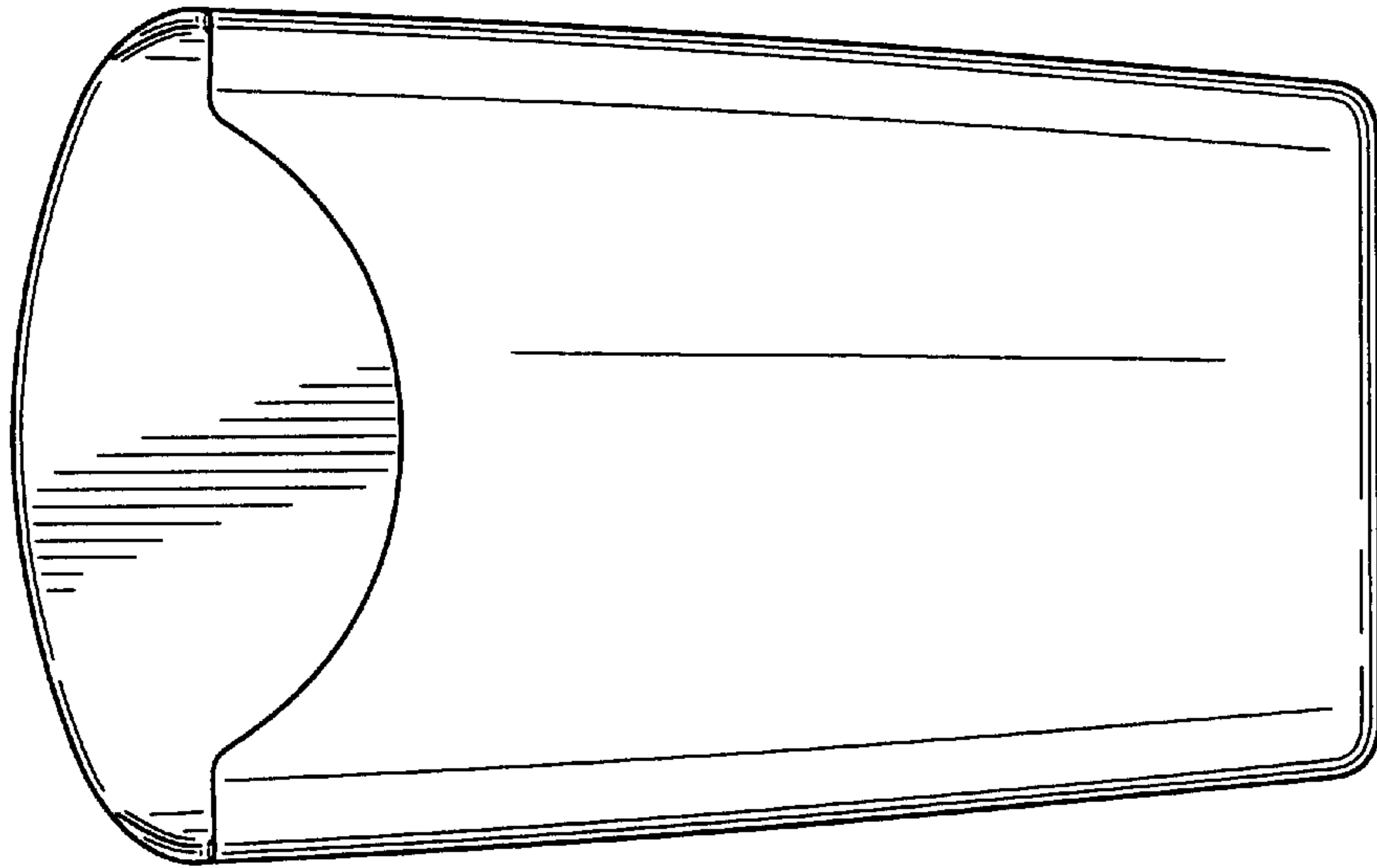

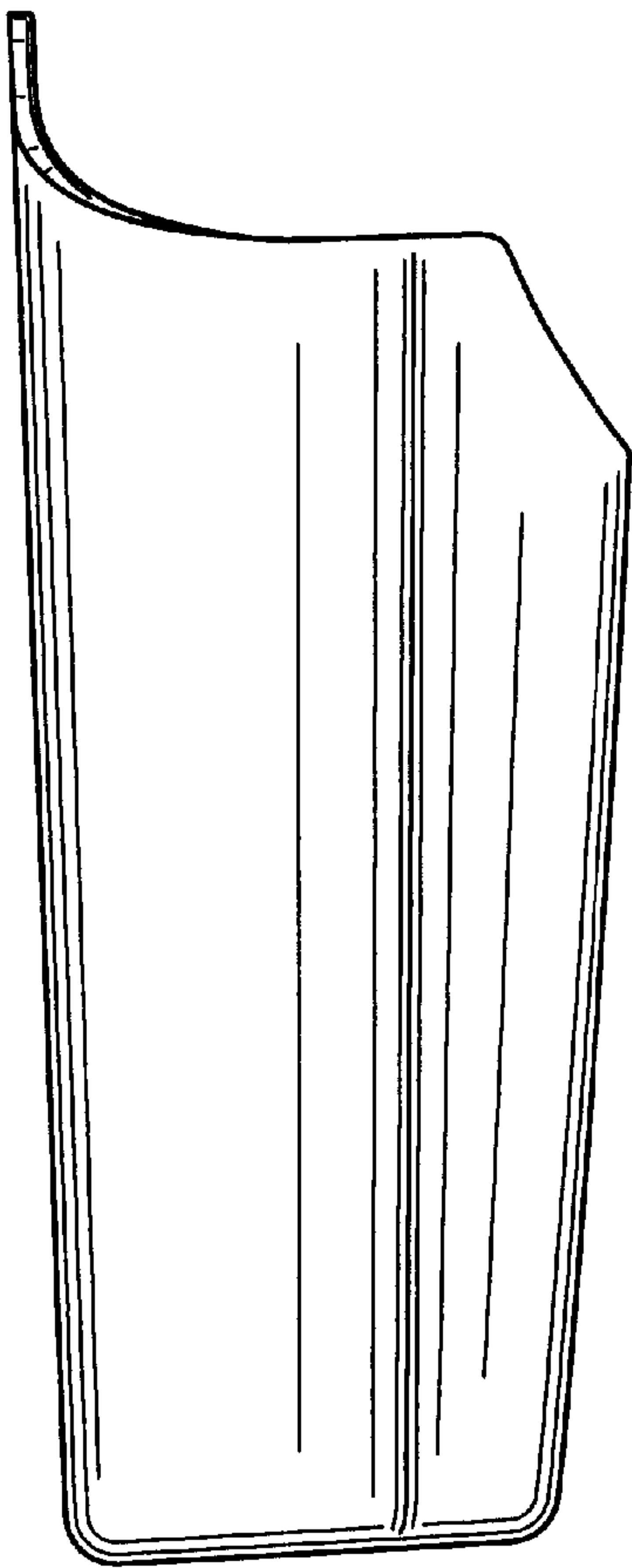

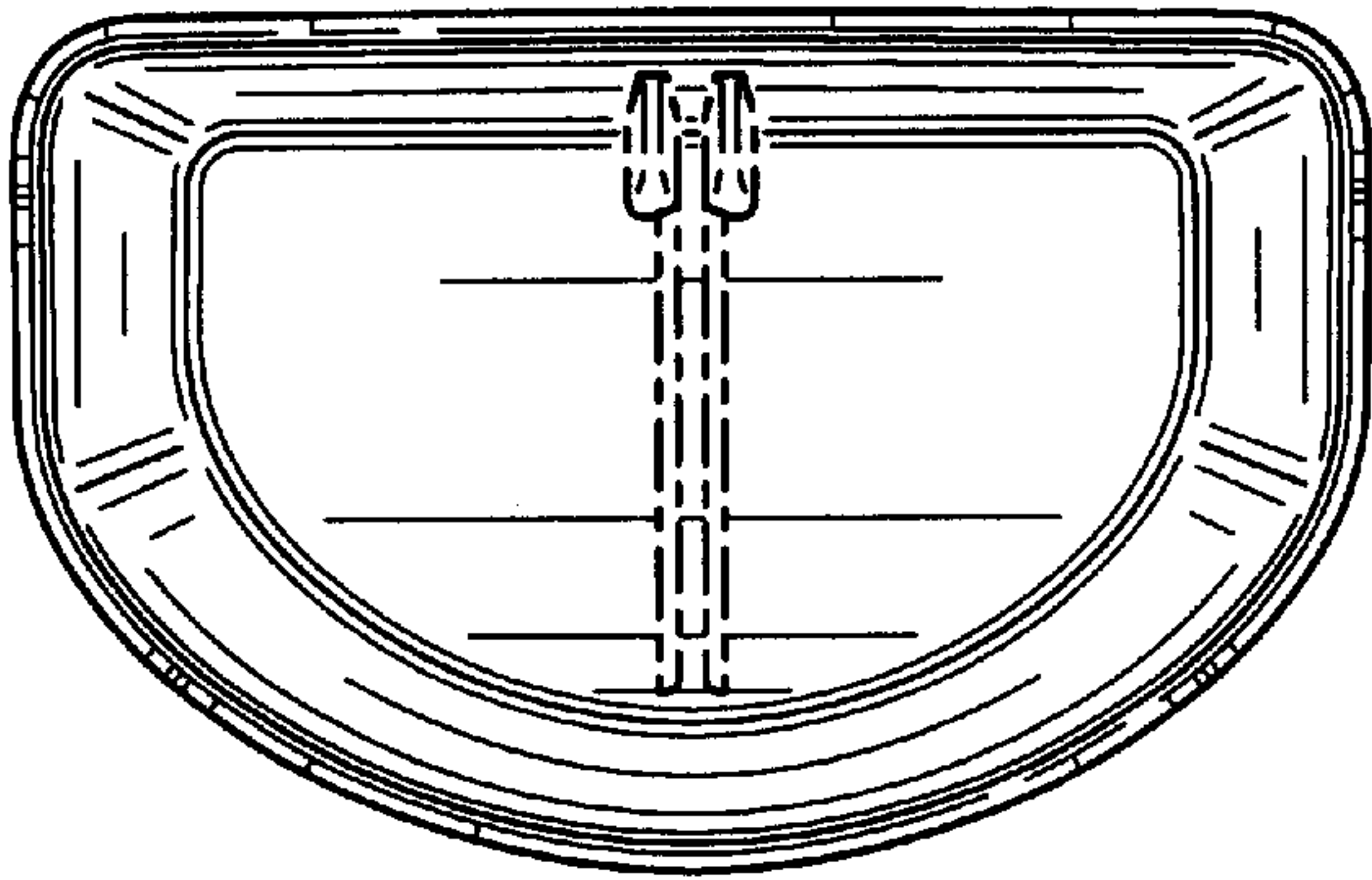
