FIG. 1 is a bottom perspective view of an insole for a left-foot, the insole for the right foot being a mirror image thereof;

FIG. 4 is a side view taken from the outside;

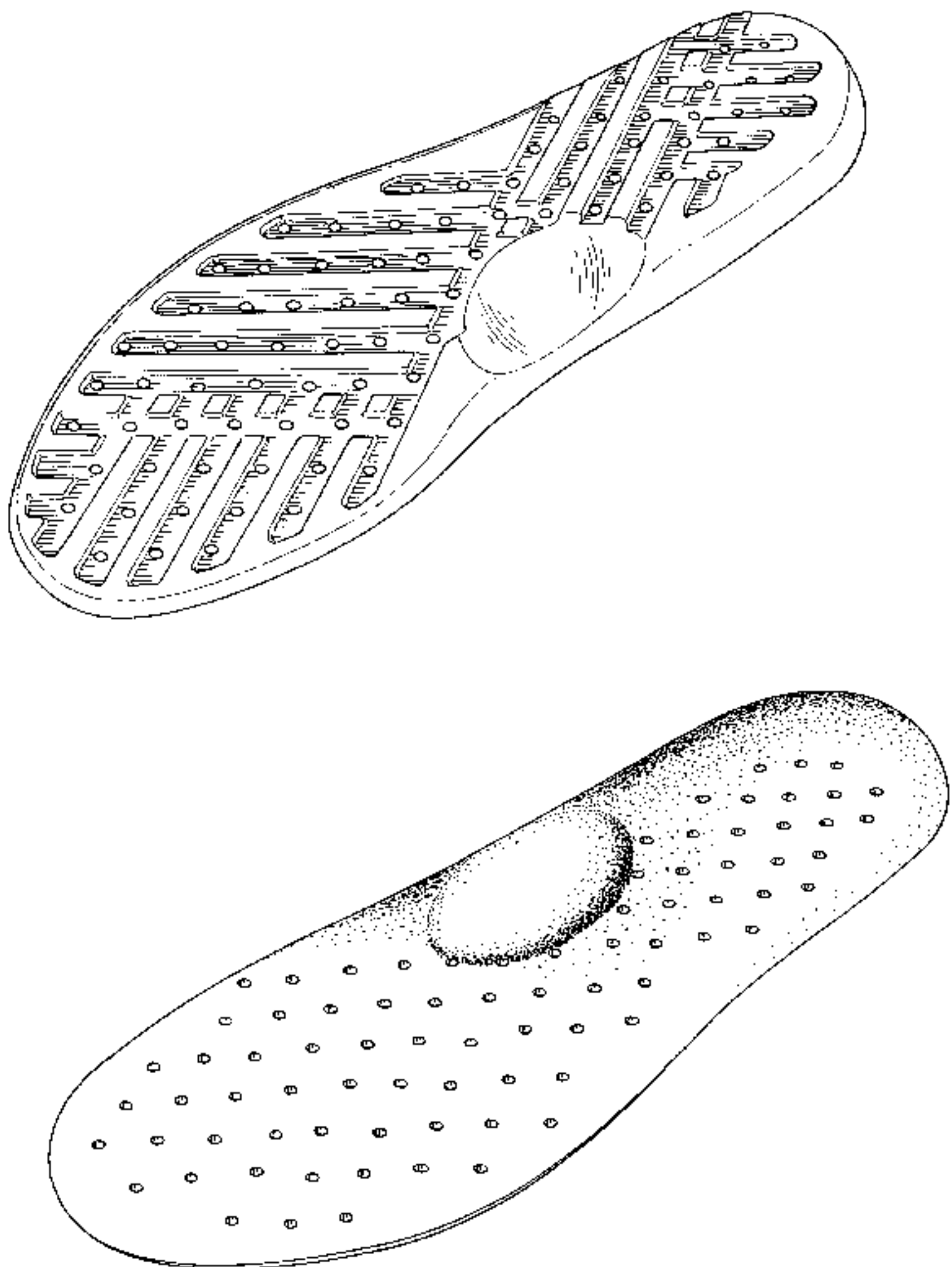
FIG. 5 is a front view;

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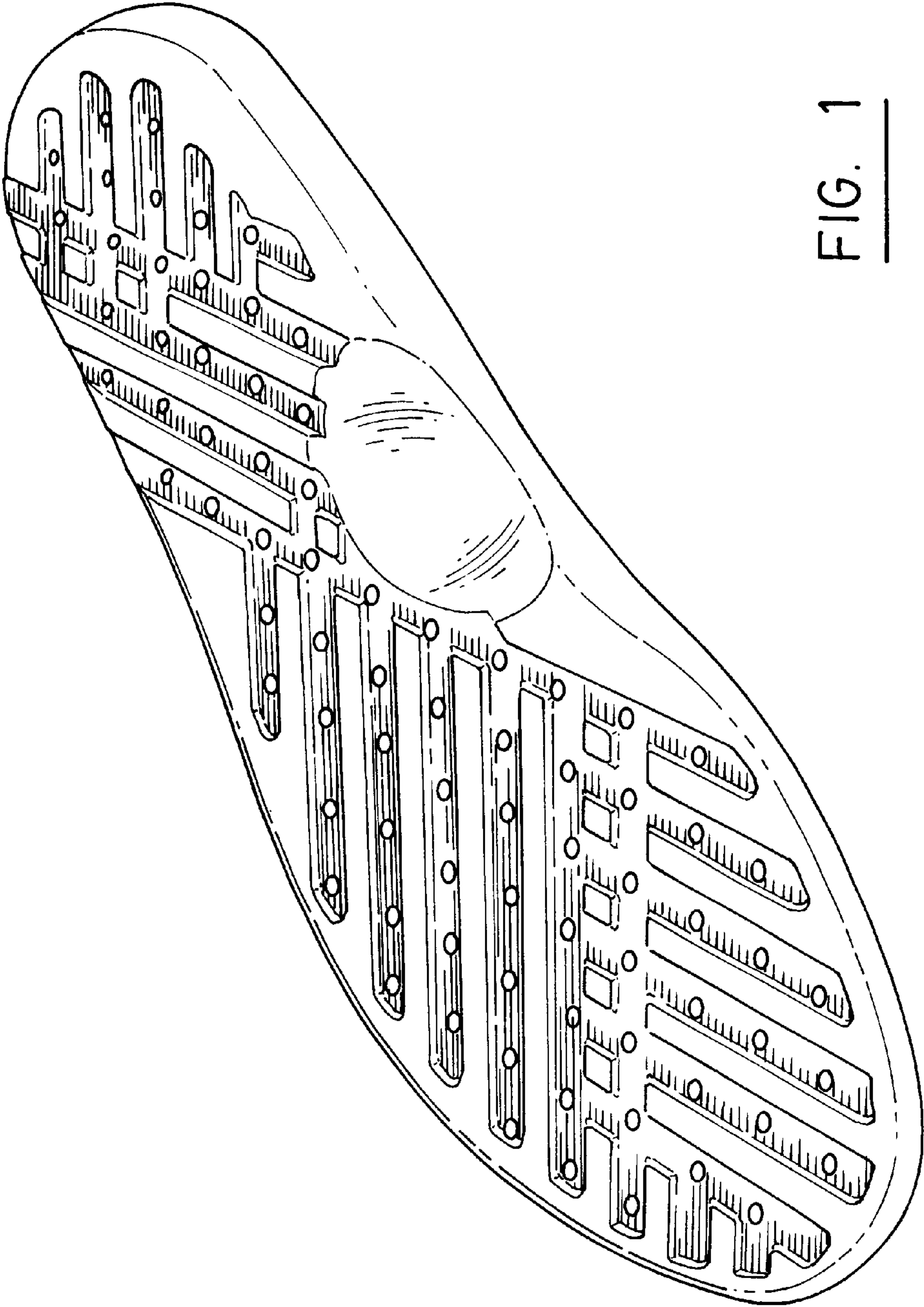

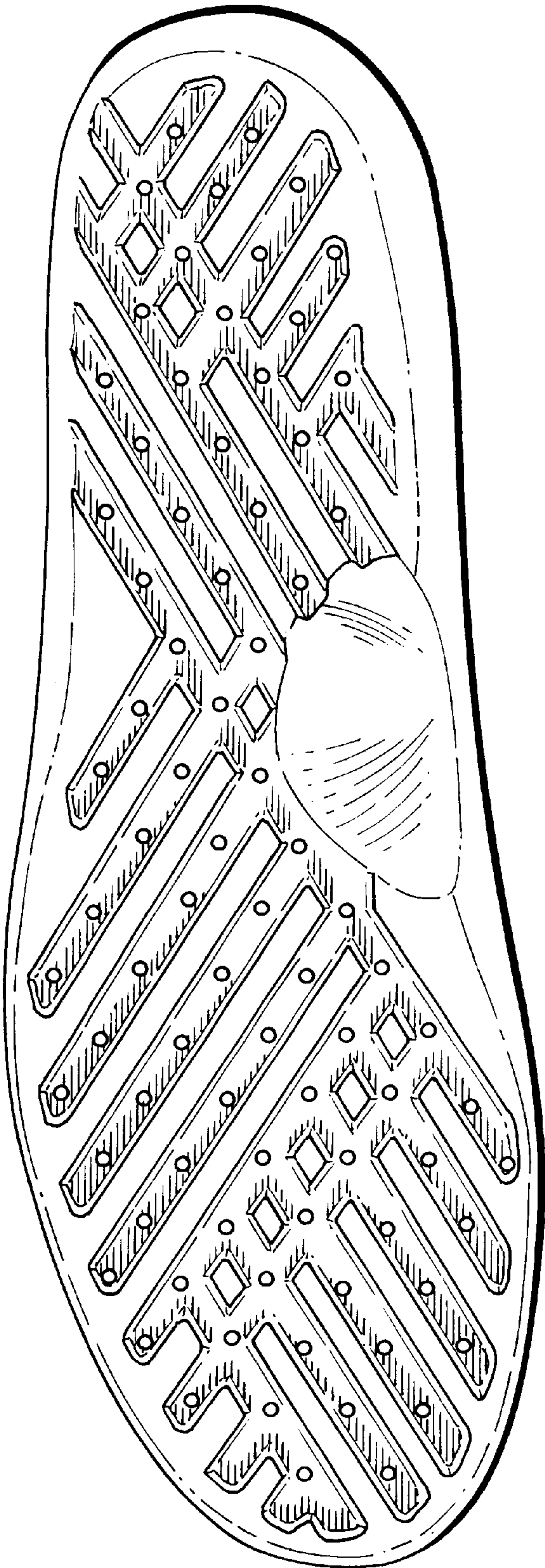

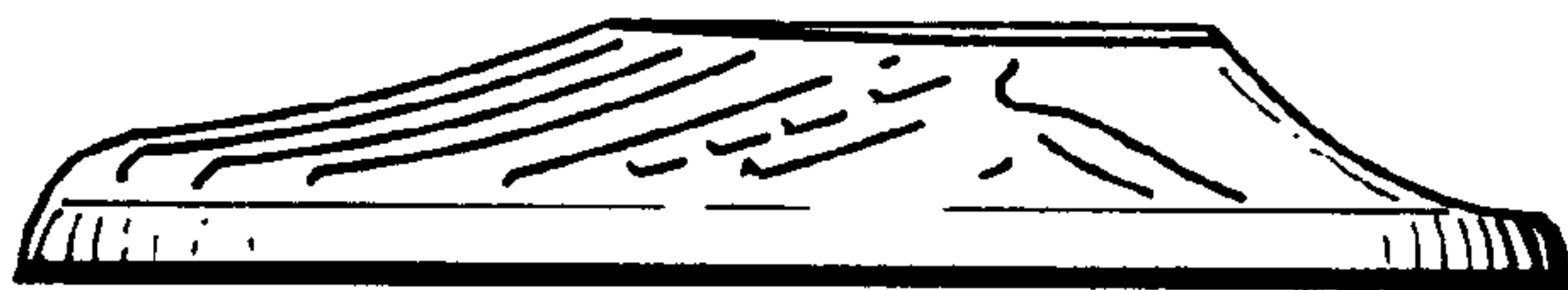

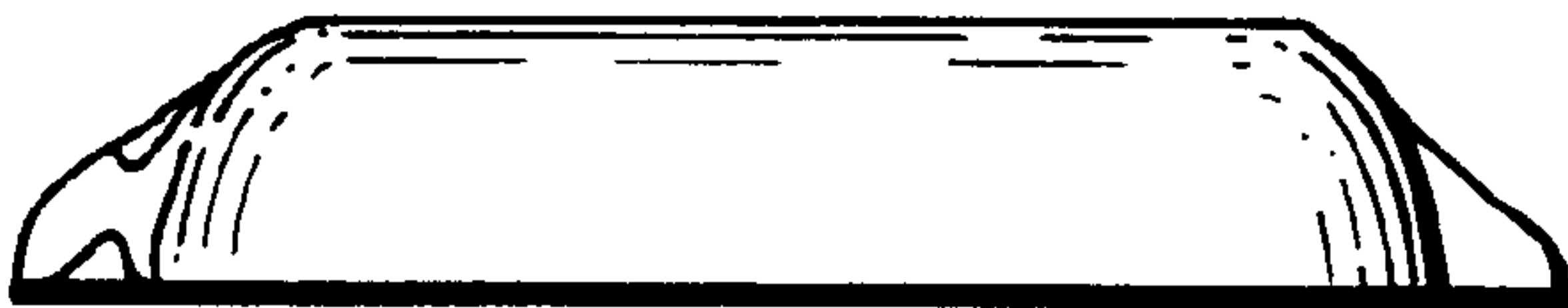

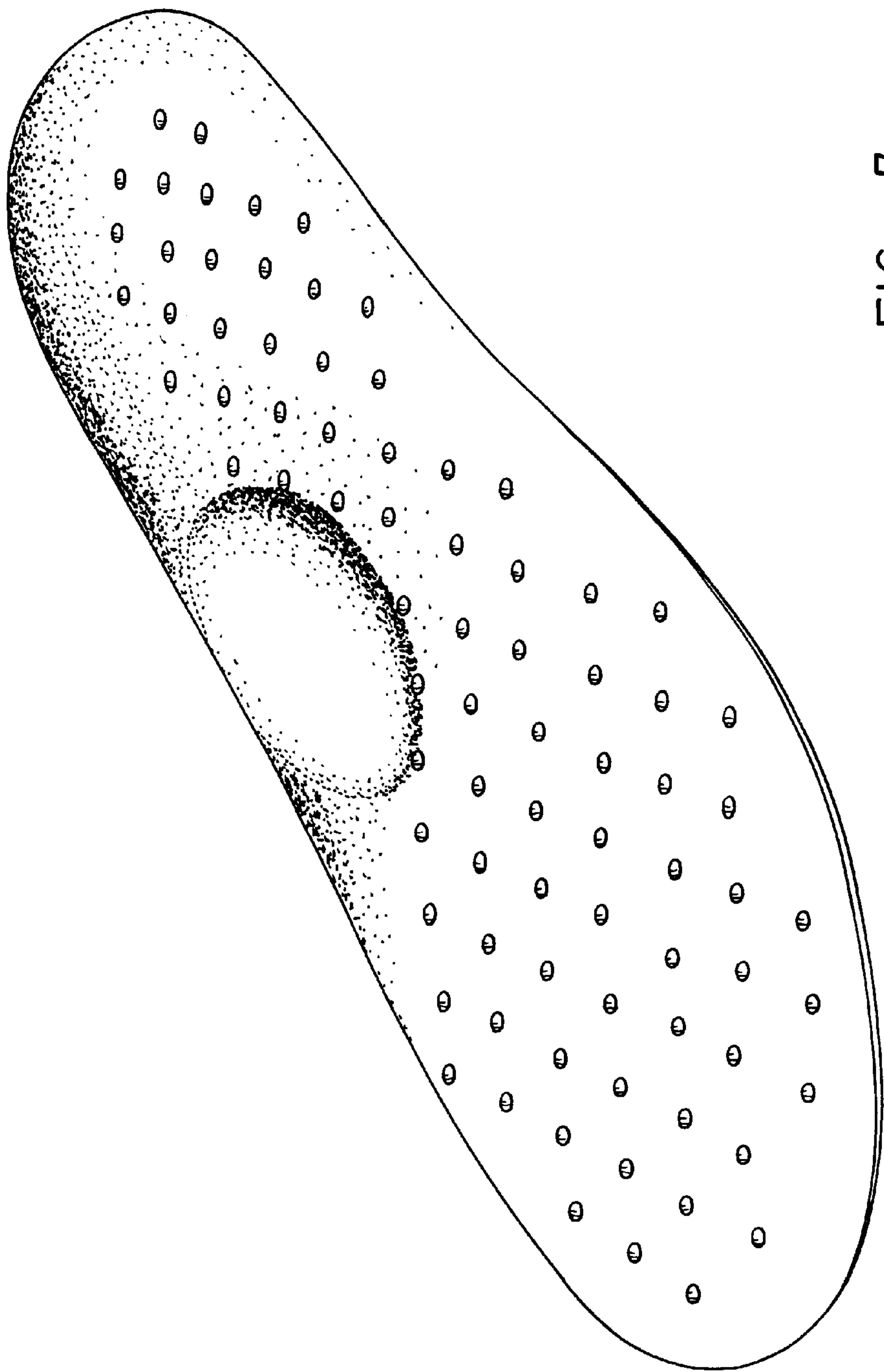

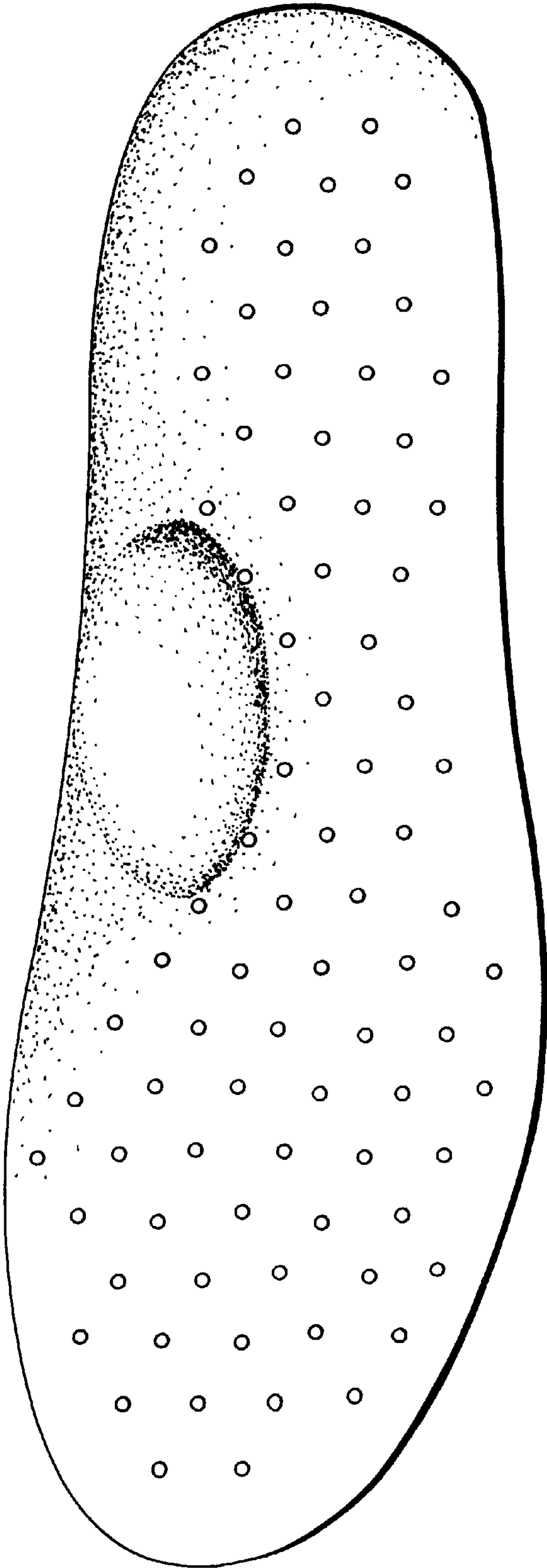
