FIG. 4 is a rear elevational view thereof.

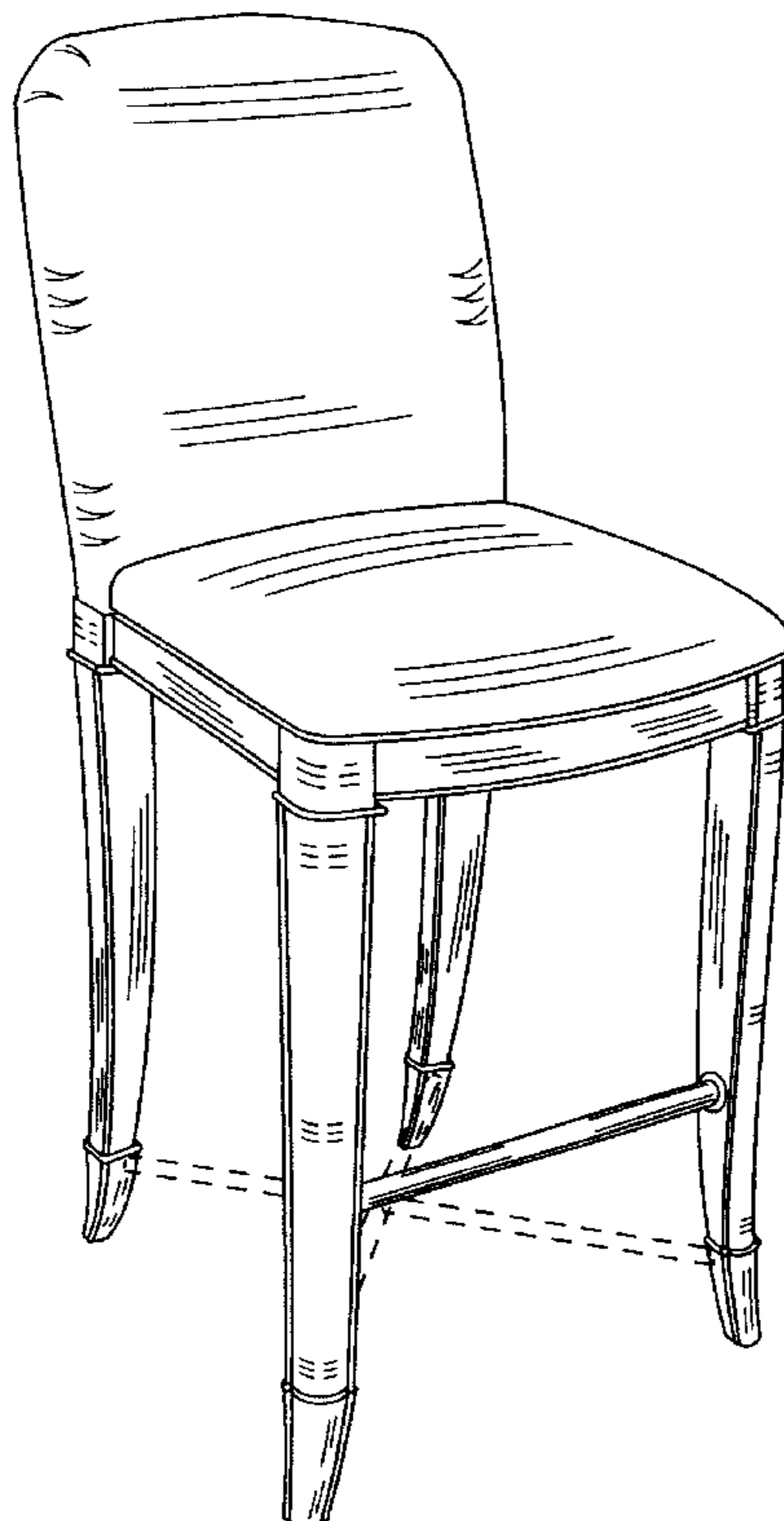
The views of the seat not shown form no part of the claimed design. The broken lines depicting hardware and cross members represent environmental elements only and form no part of the claimed design.

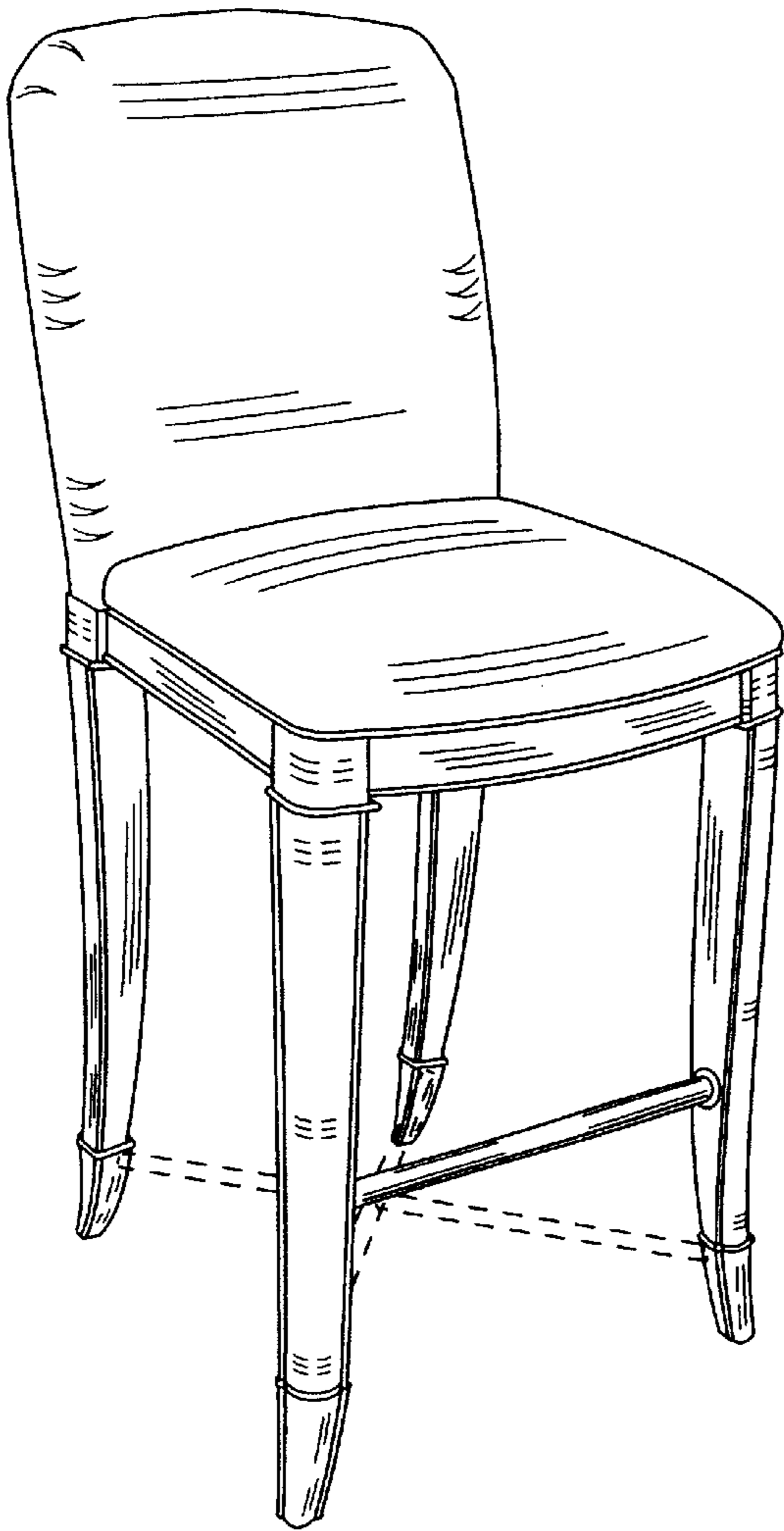

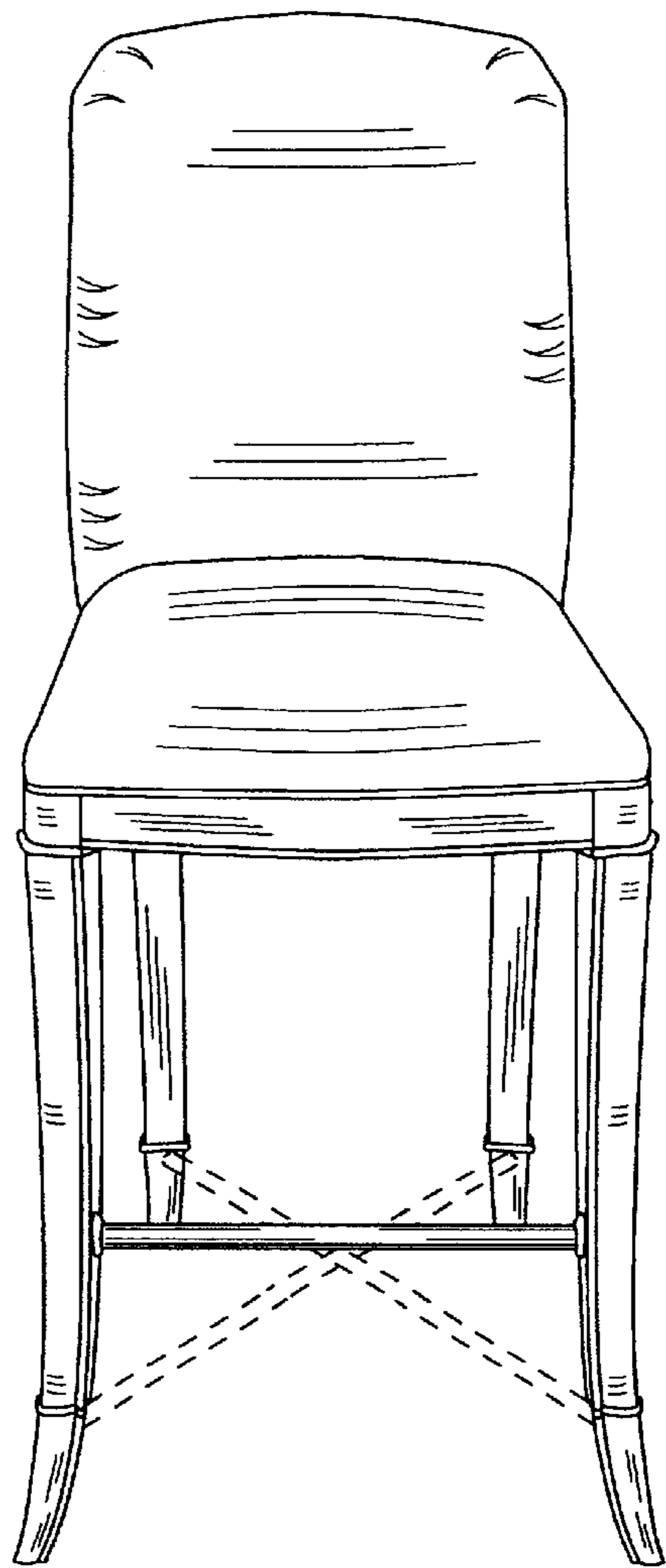

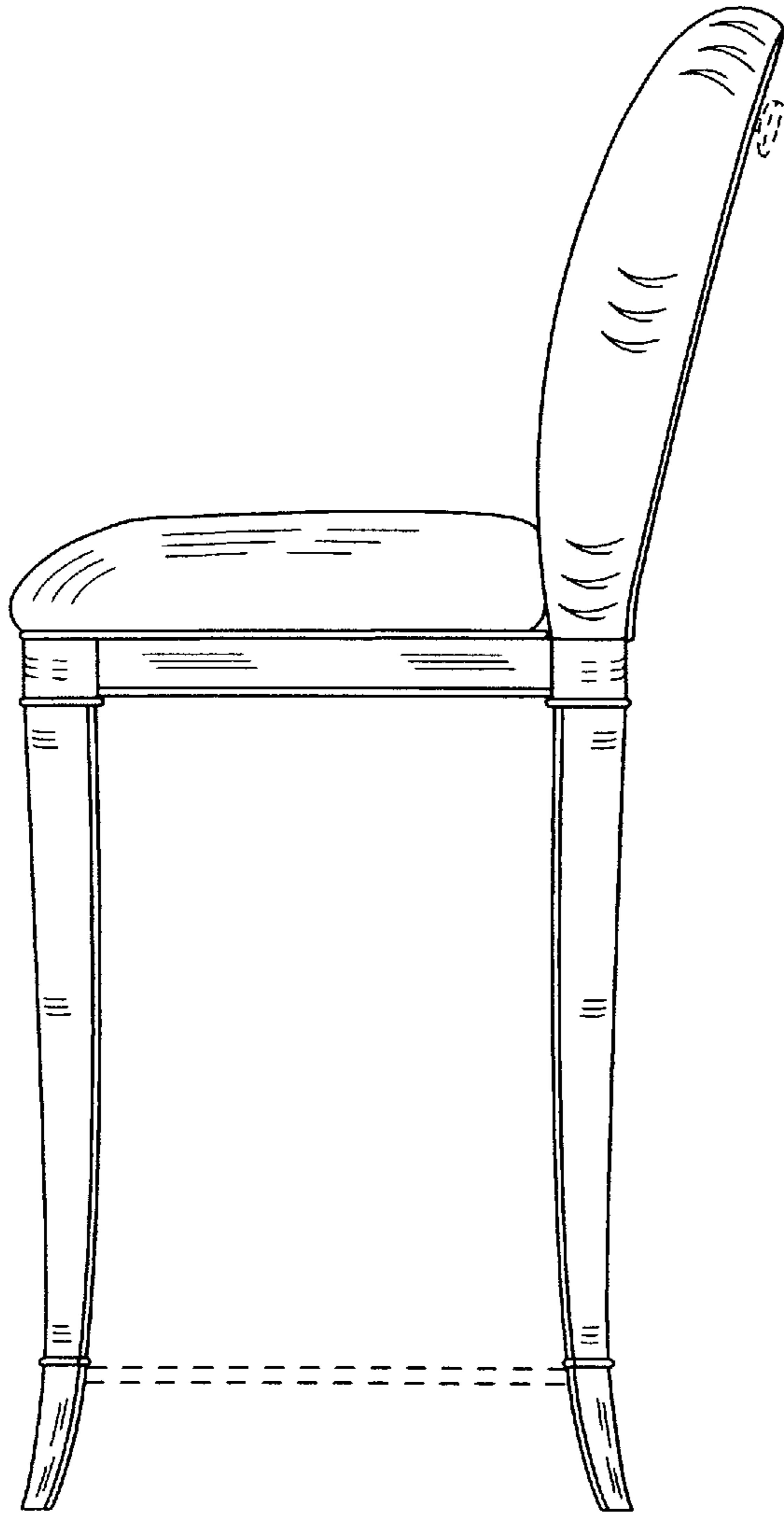

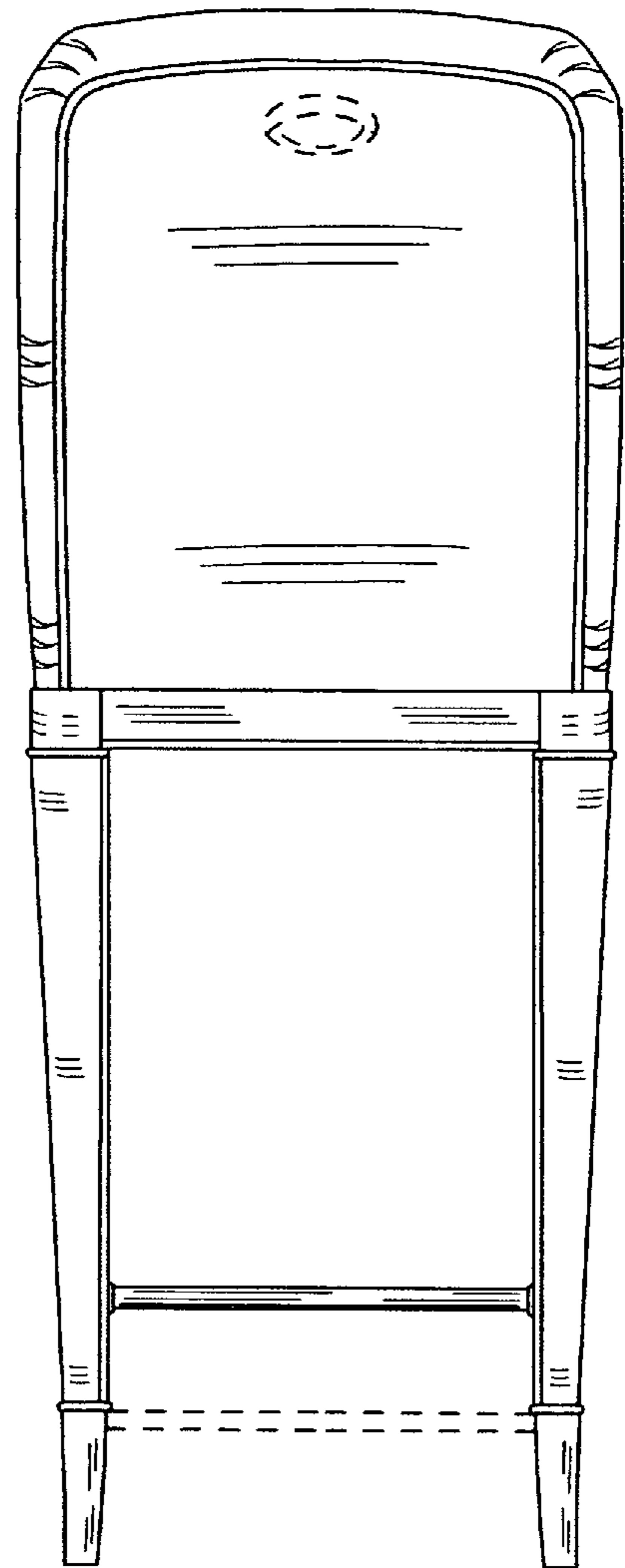
