DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of the kitchen hood of the present invention.

FIG. 2 is a front elevational view of the kitchen hood. FIG. 3 is a side elevational view of the kitchen hood with the opposite side being a mirror image of the same; and, FIG. 4 is a front elevational view of an alternative design for the kitchen hood with the opposite sides conforming to the design shown in FIG. 3.

The top, back and bottom of the design of the kitchen hood shown in FIGS. 1–4 form no part of the claimed design. Further, the broken lines form no part of the claimed design.
