FIG. 1 is an upper right hand perspective view of the watch case with bracelet showing my new design;

FIG. 2 is an upper left hand perspective view thereof;

FIG. 3 is a top plan view thereof;

FIG. 4 is a bottom plan view thereof with a portion of the band cut away to show the bottom of the watch case;

FIG. 5 is a right side elevational view thereof;

FIG. 6 is a front elevational view, the rear elevational view being a mirror image thereof; and,

FIG. 7 is a left side elevational view thereof.
