FIG. 4 is a right side elevational view thereof.

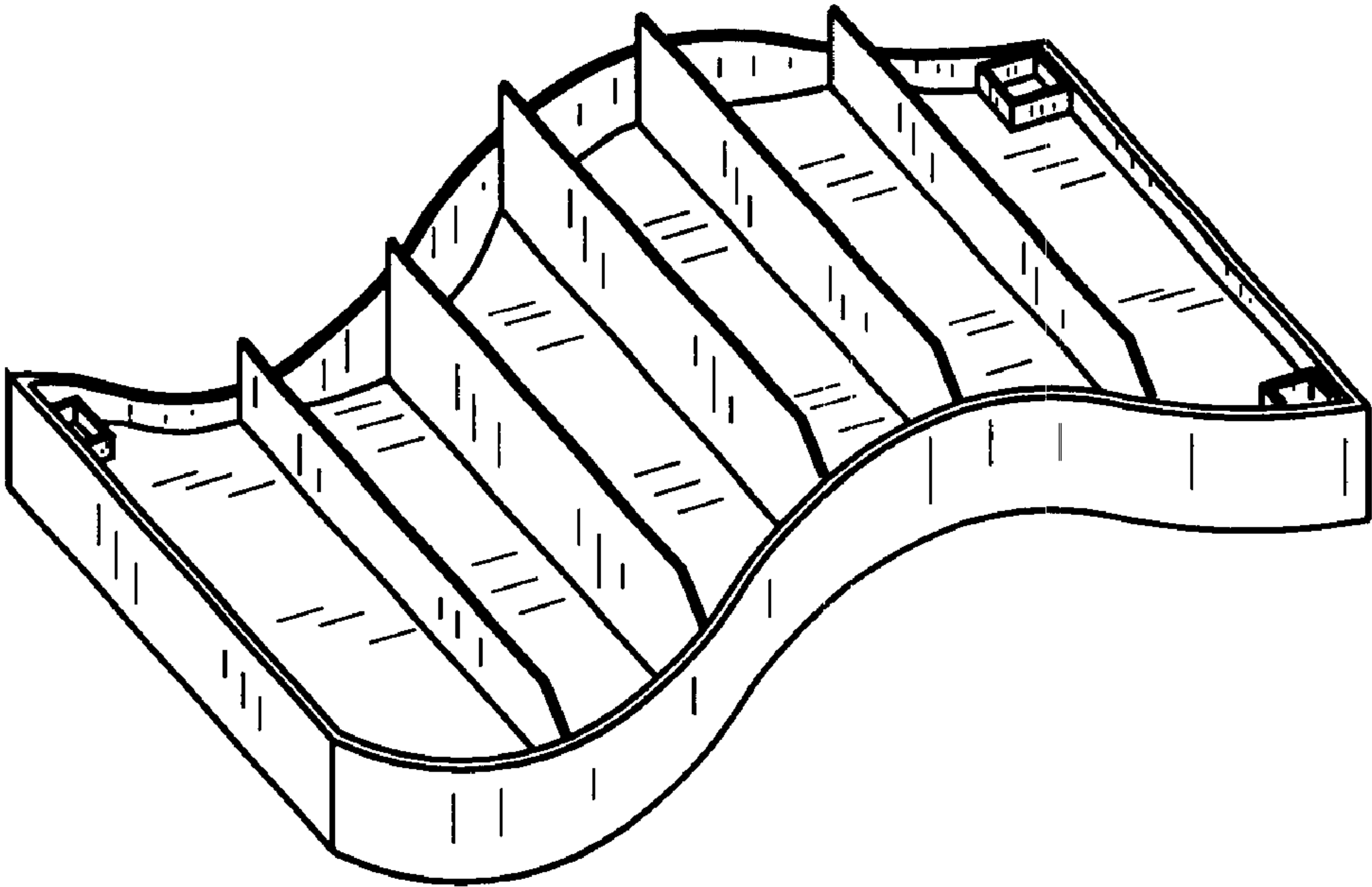
FIG. 5 is a top plan view thereof.

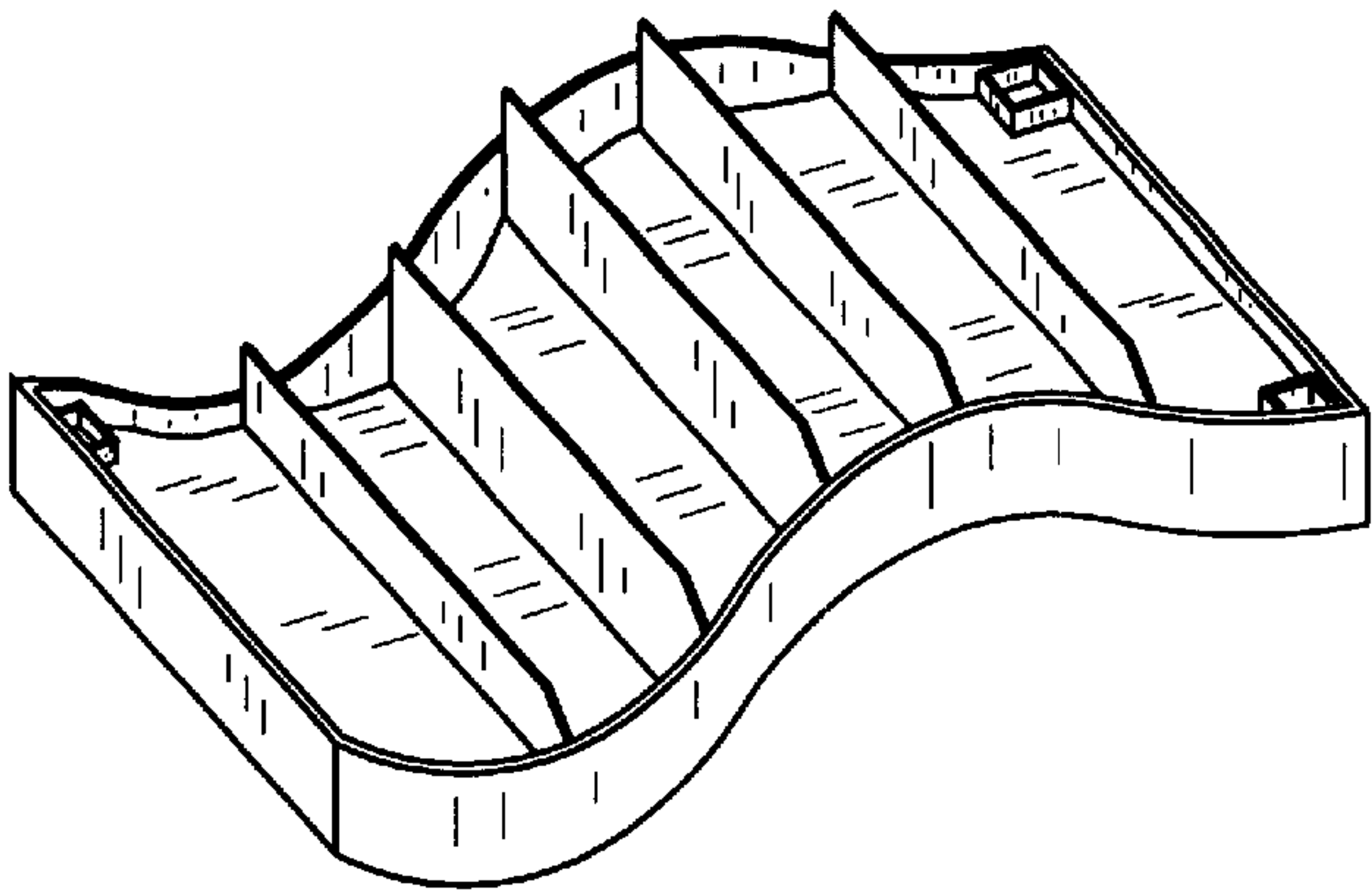

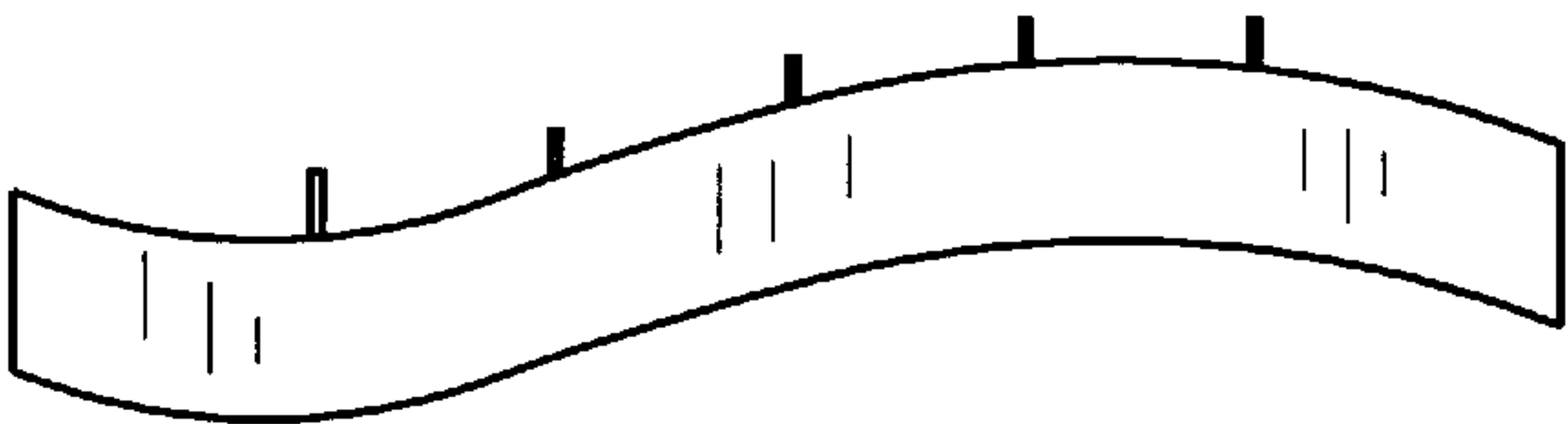

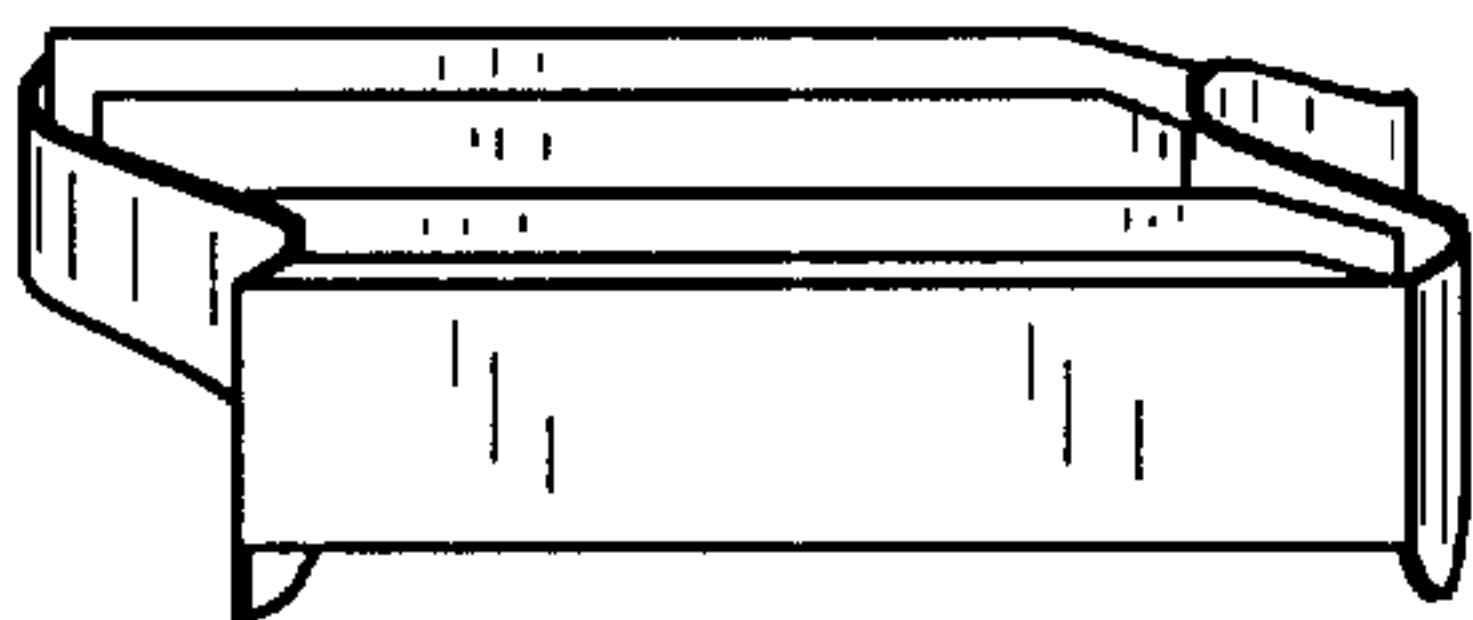

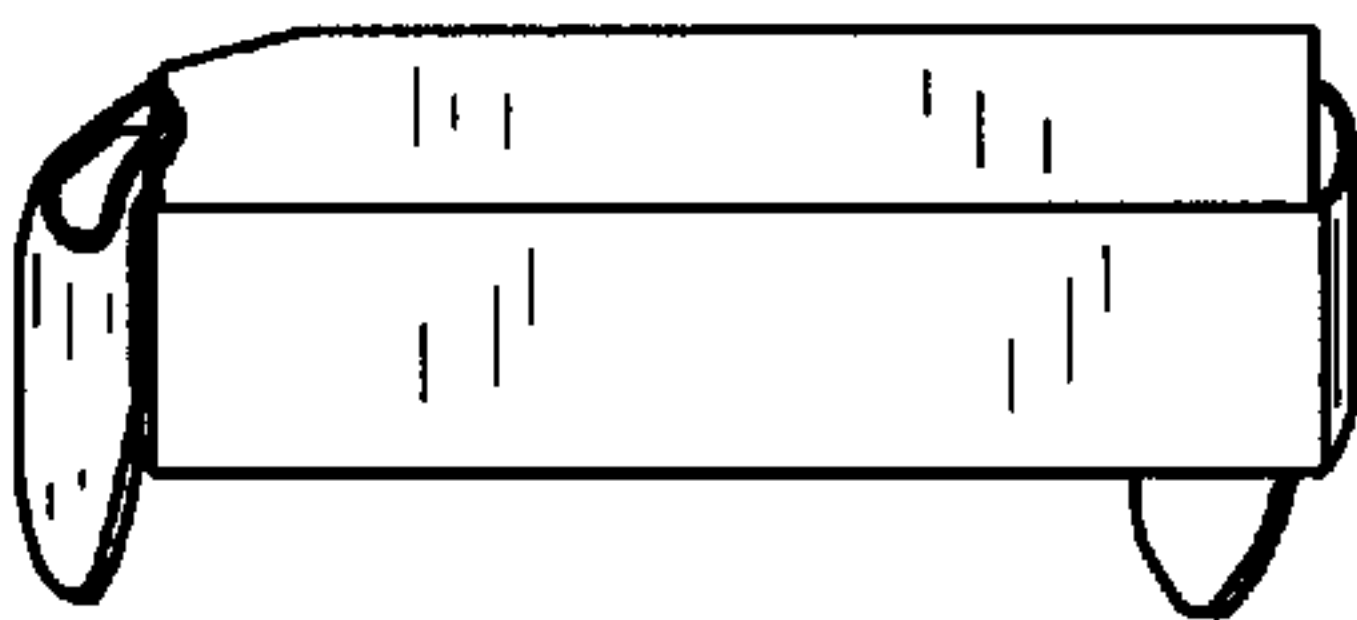

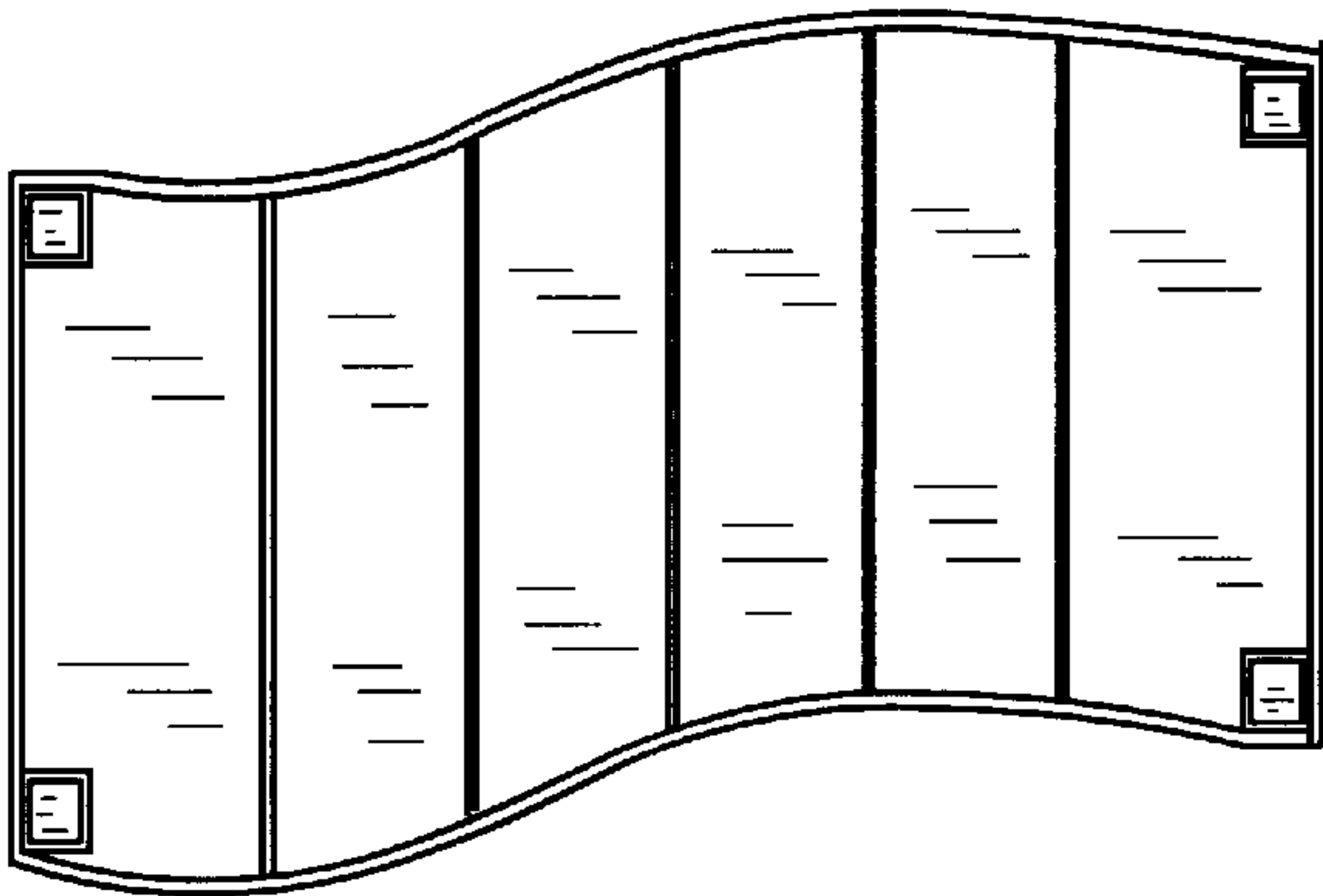

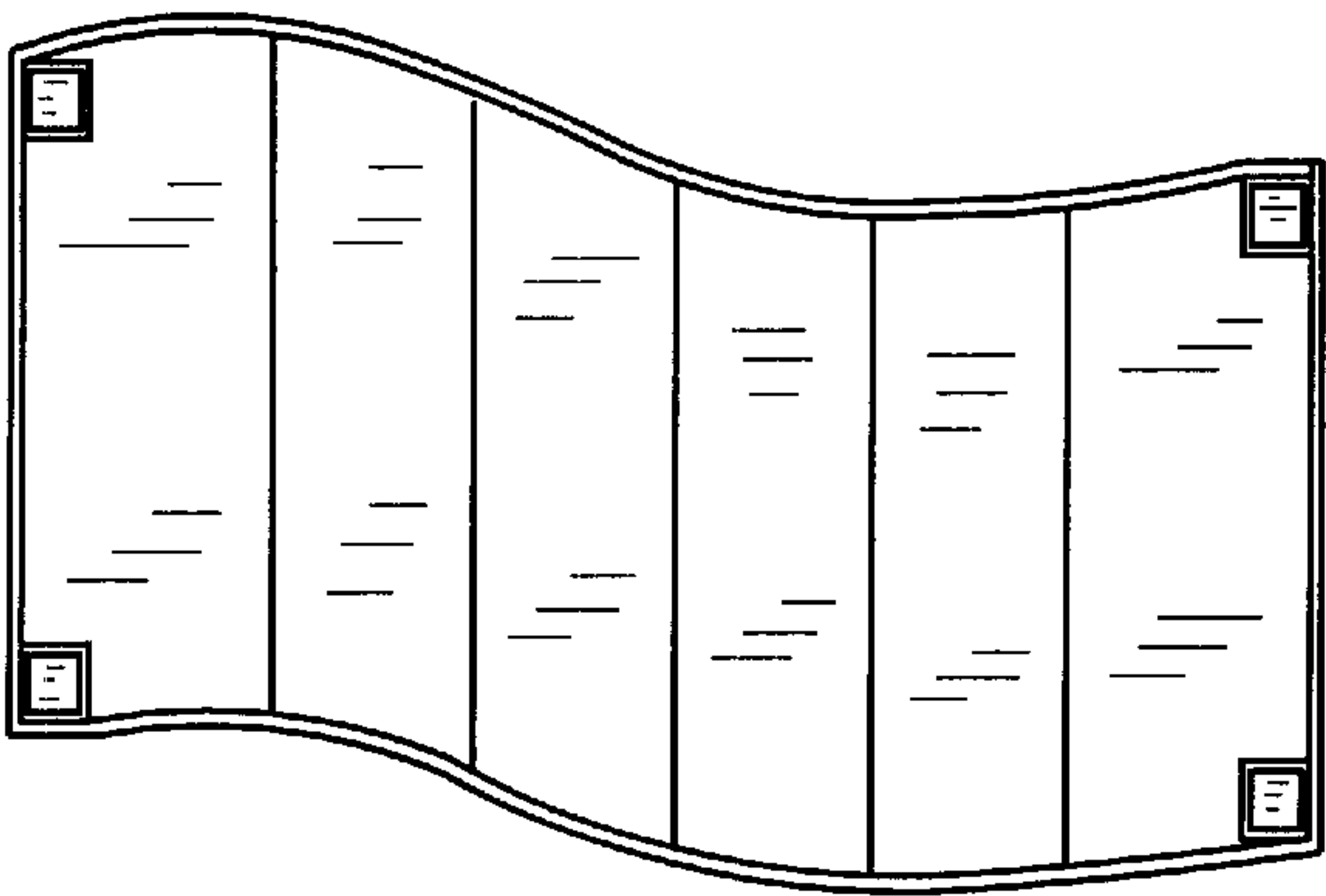

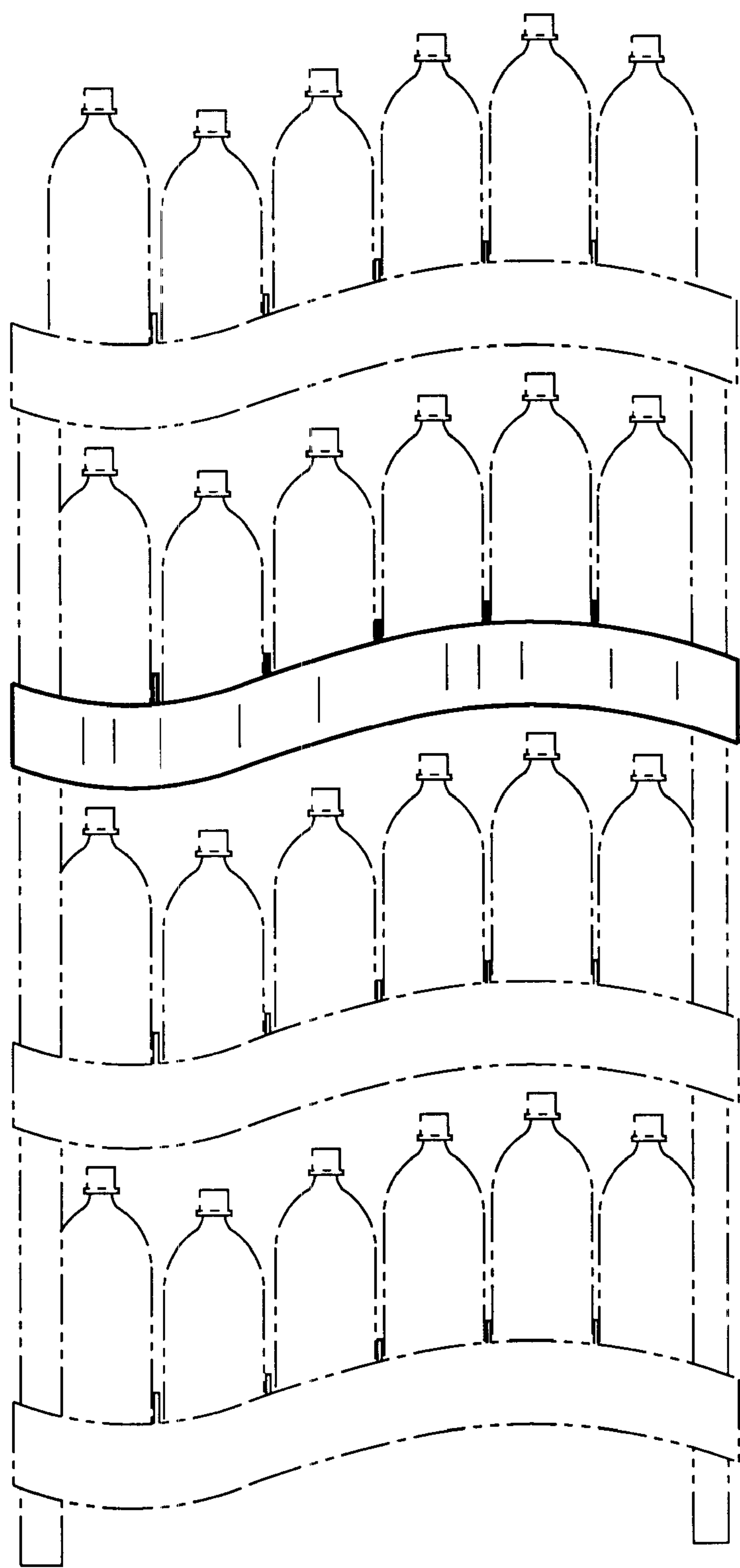
