(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for portion of an engine cover for a boat and openings associated therewith, as shown and described.

**DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 1 is a perspective illustration, from the rear and left side, of openings beneath the engine cover for a boat according to our design;

FIG. 3 is a perspective illustration, from the rear and left side, of a portion of an engine cover for a boat and openings associated therewith according to our design;

FIG. 5 is a top view thereof; and,

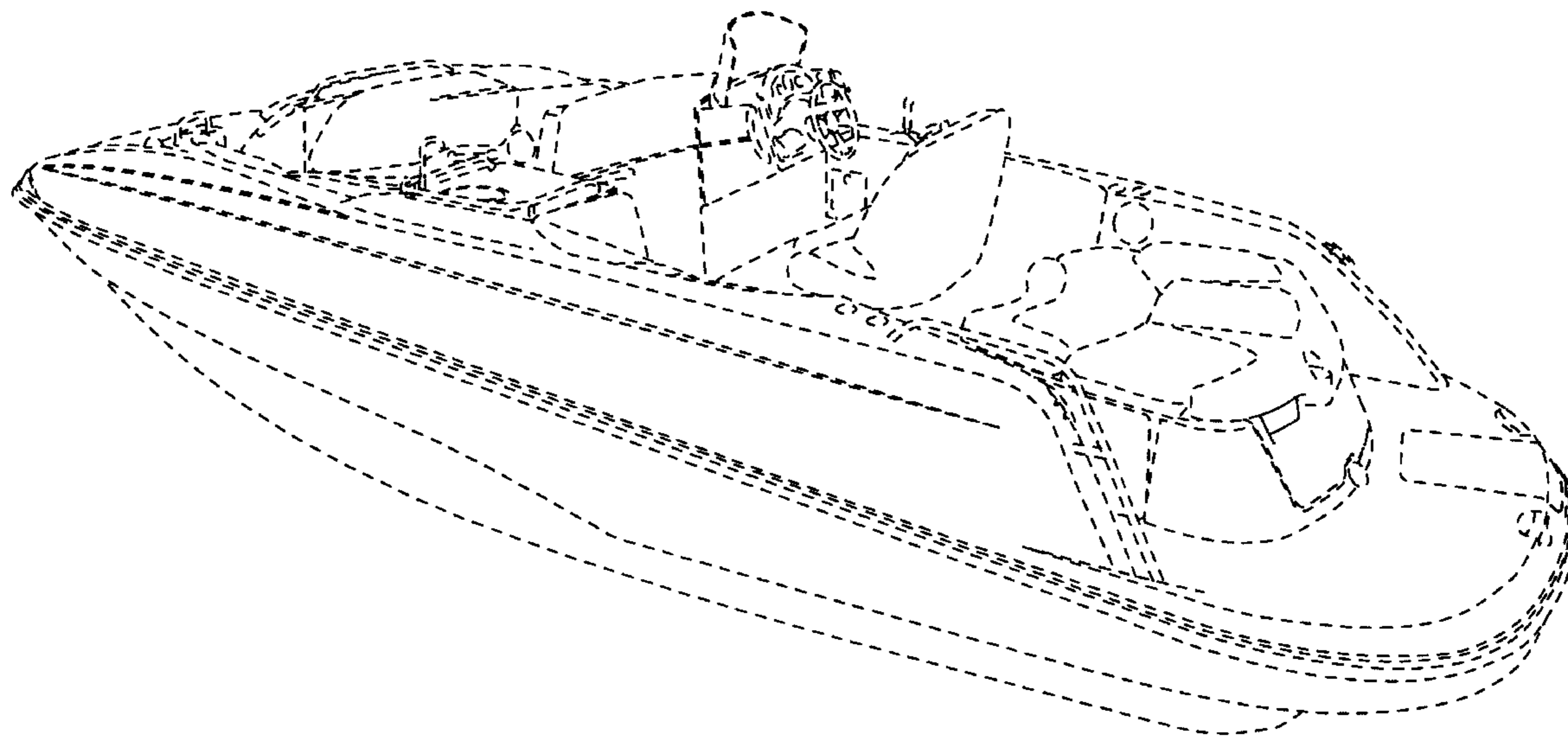
FIG. 6 is a left side view thereof.

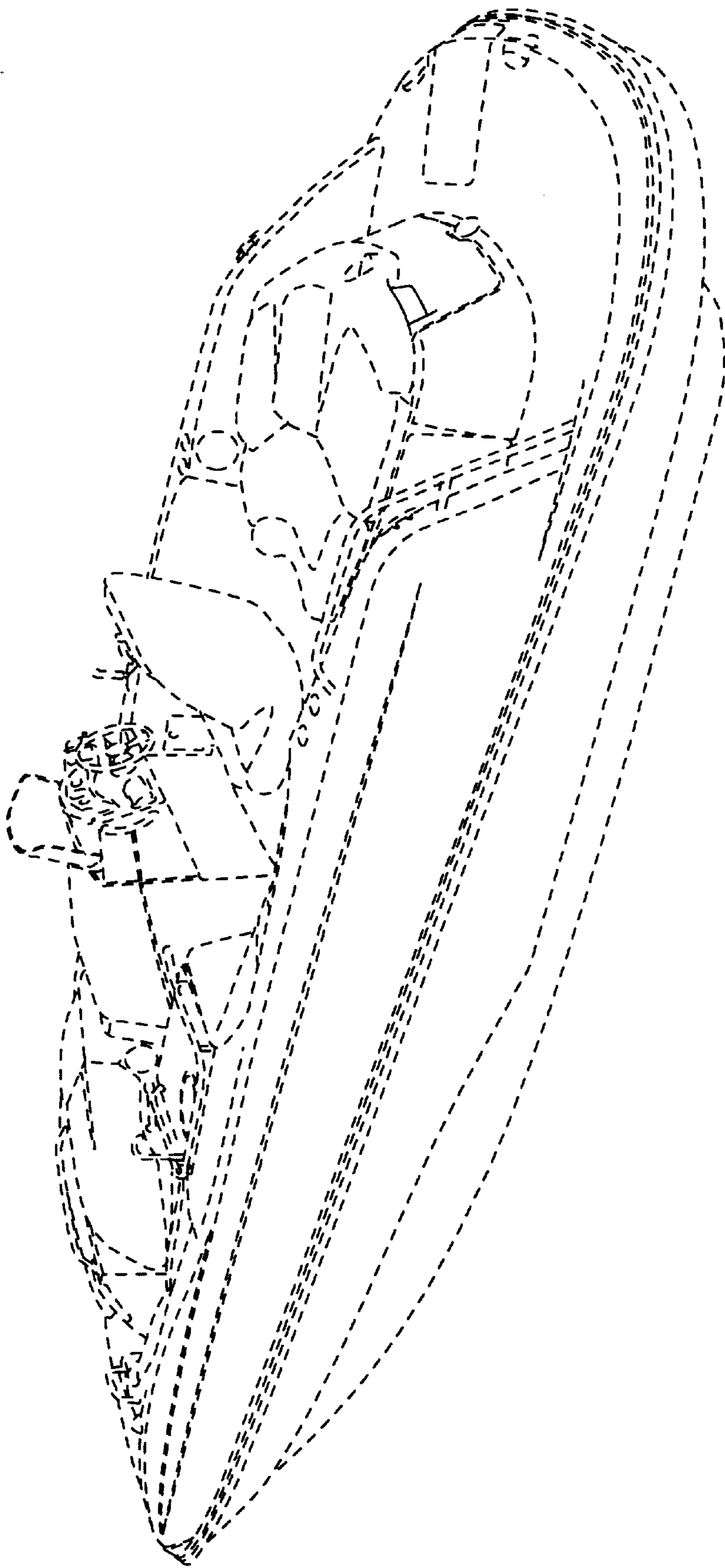
While not illustrated, the mirror-image orientation of aspects of the design is intended to be encompassed hereby.

Where included, broken lines showing environment or structure are for illustrative purposes only and form no part of the claimed design.

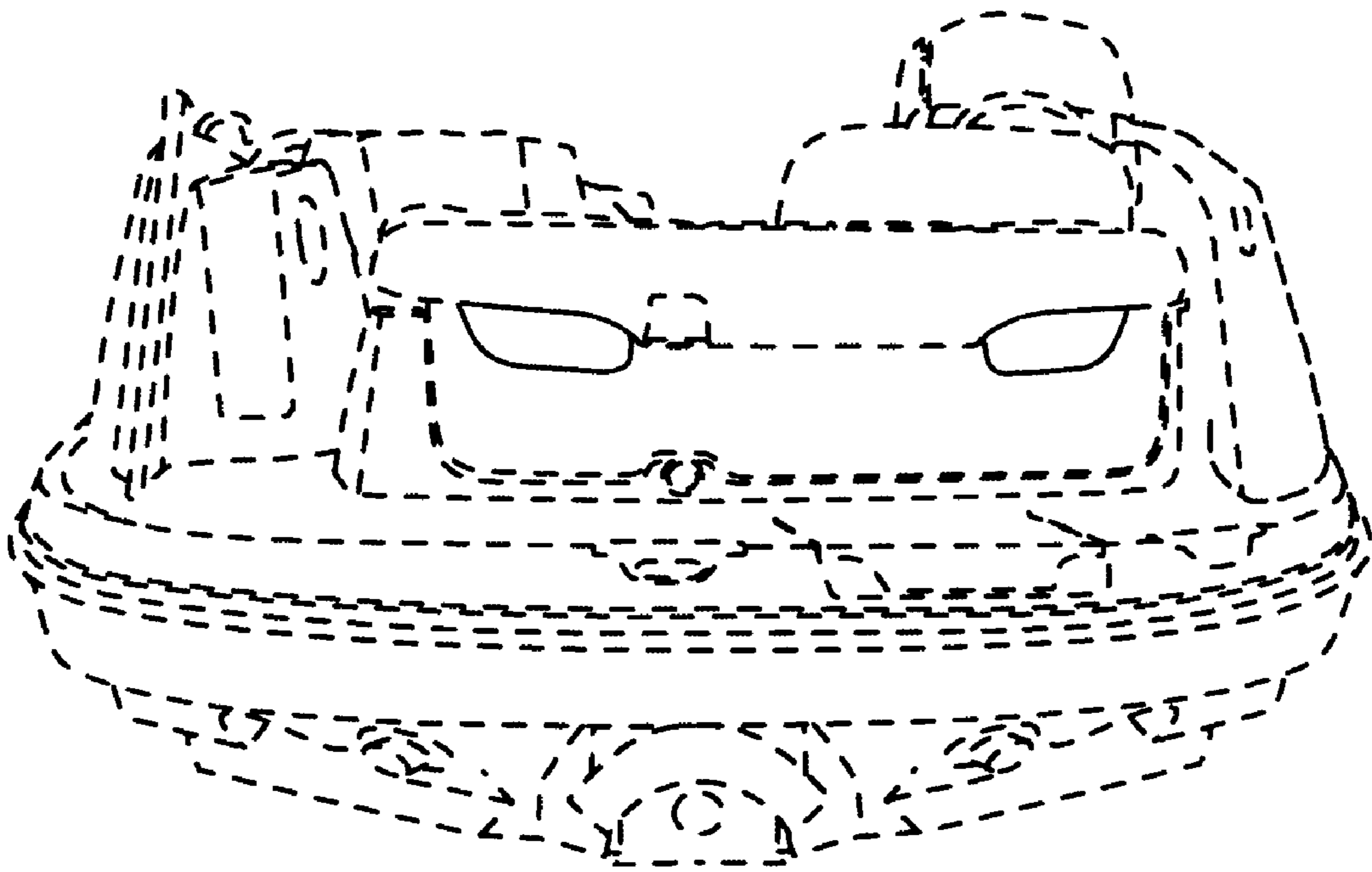
The omission of a view indicates that the omitted view is plain and unornamented.

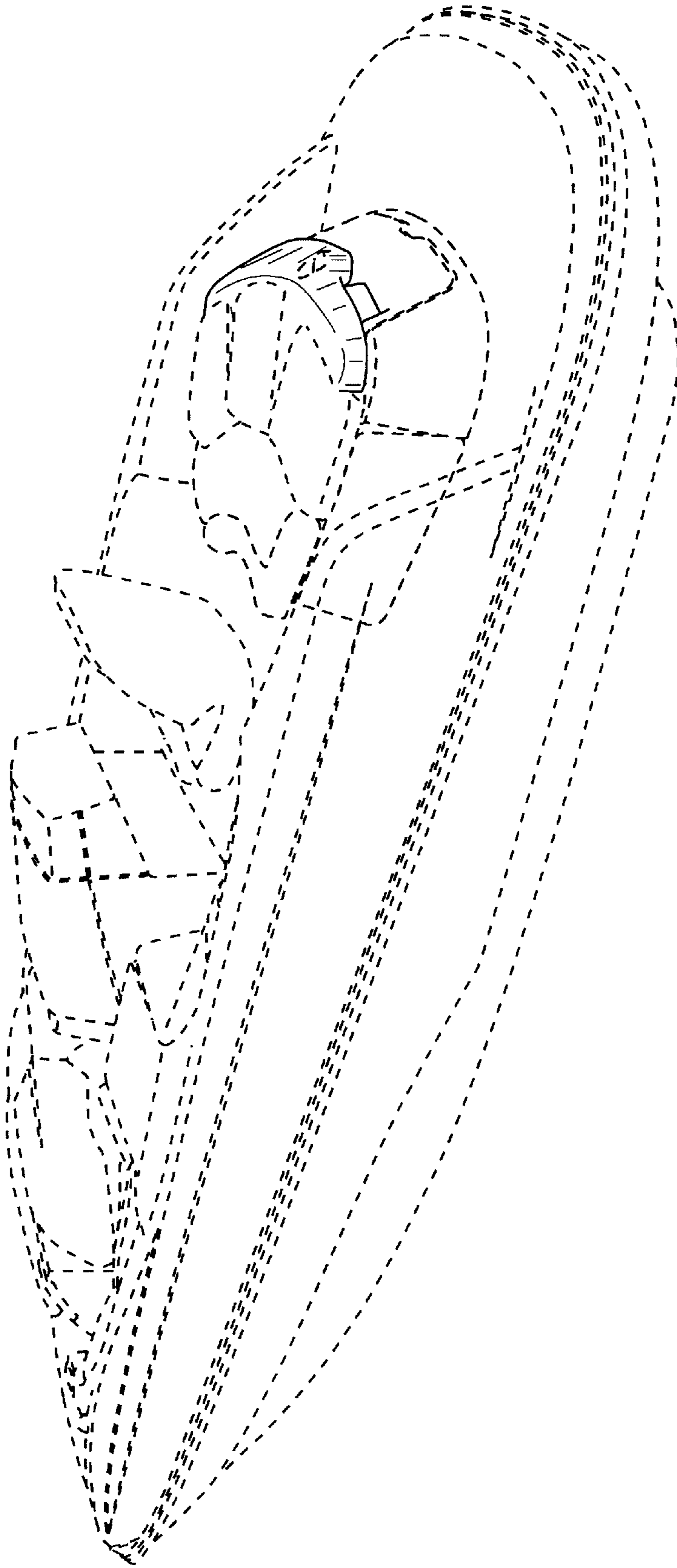




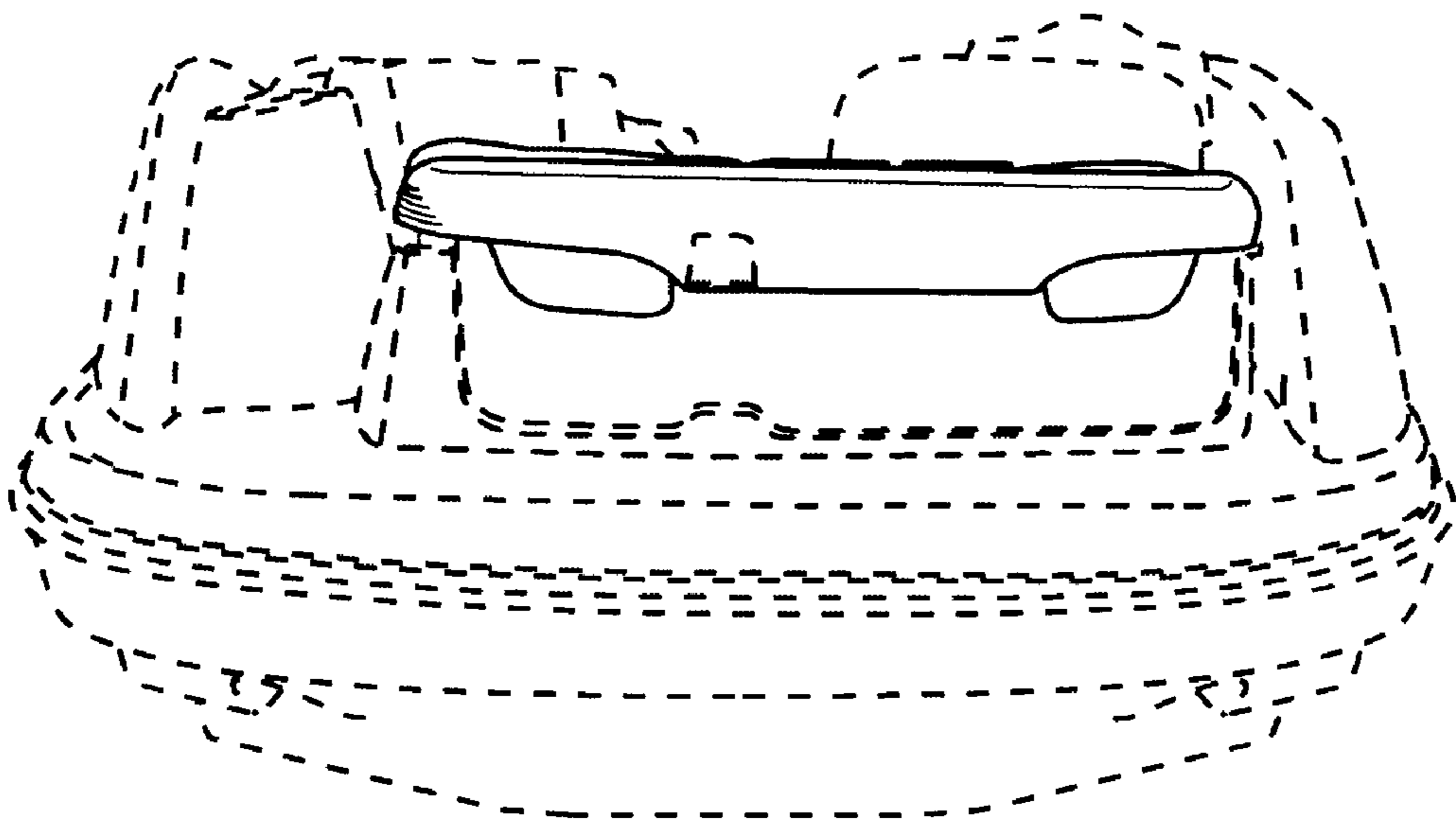

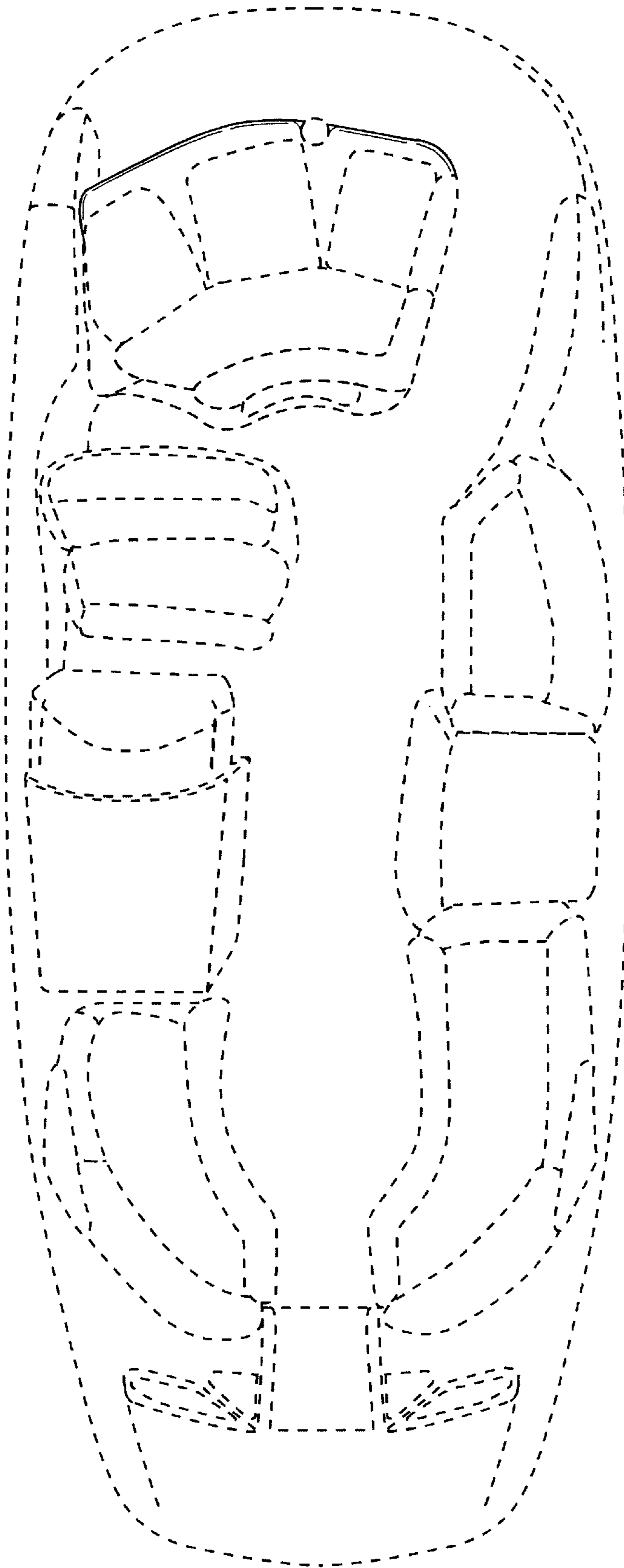

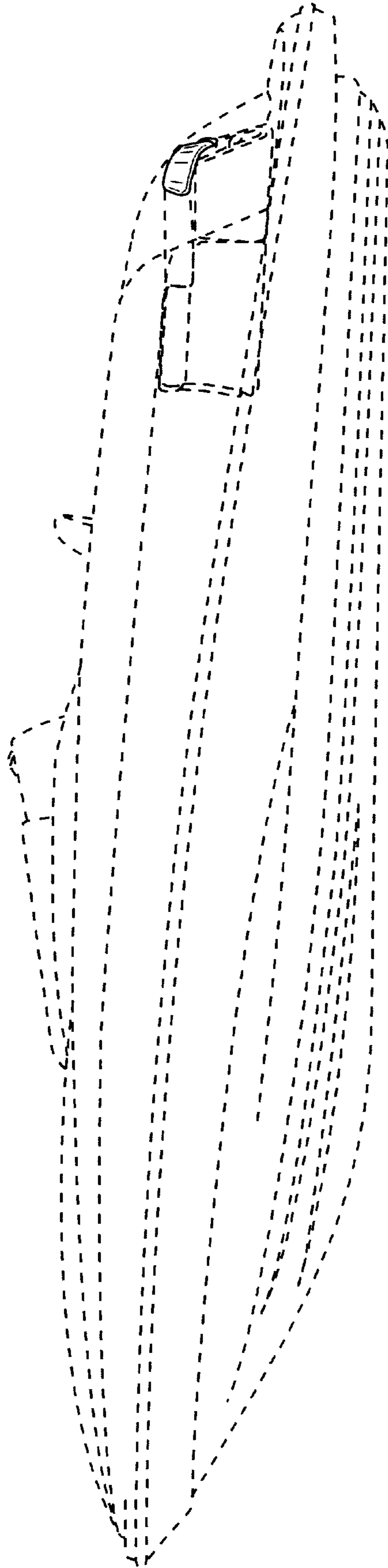
