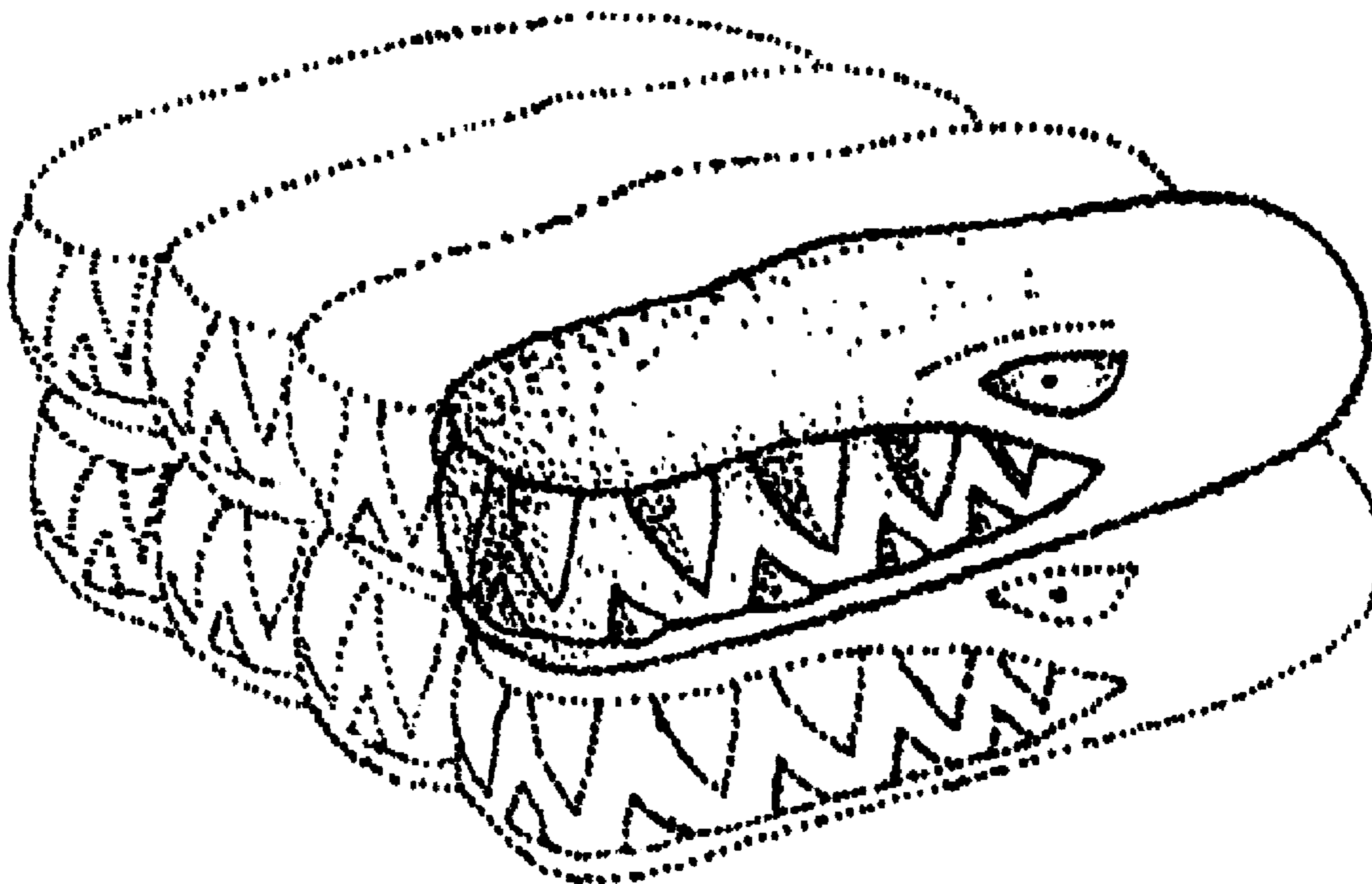

FIG. 5 is a front perspective view thereof, the broken lines
showing an arrangement of additional buns are for illustra-
tive purposes only and form no part of the claimed design.
The bottom view is understood to be essentially flat. As the
article has a cylindrical configuration, a back view adds
nothing to the disclosure not found in the side and top views.

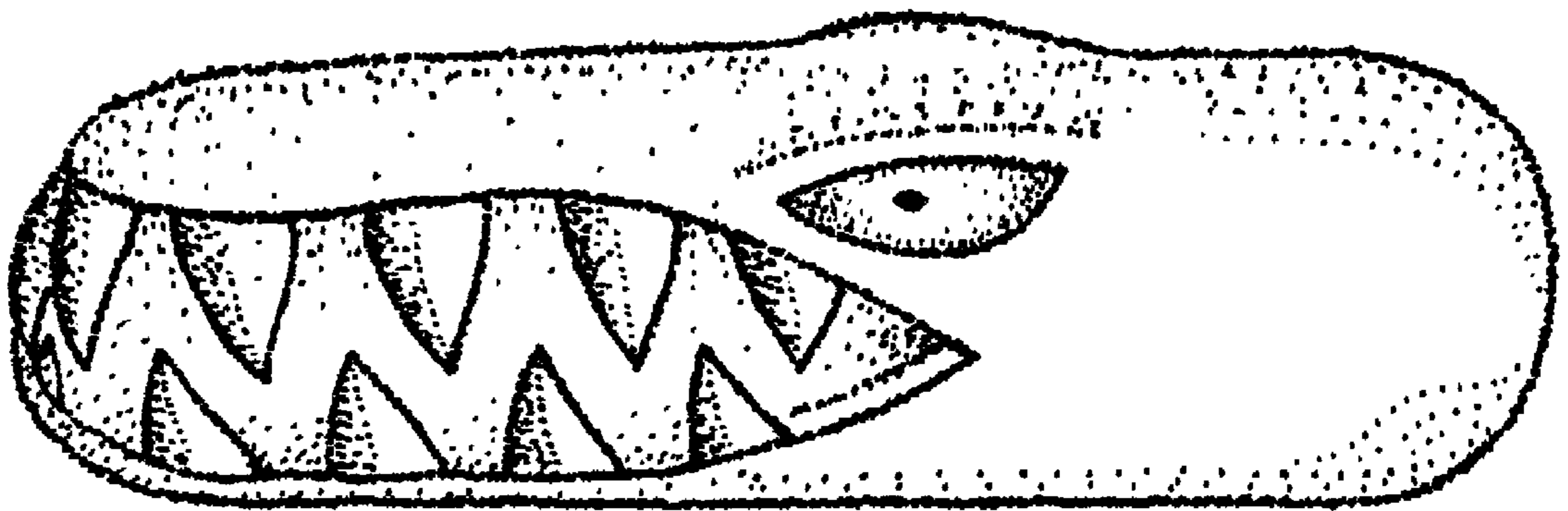

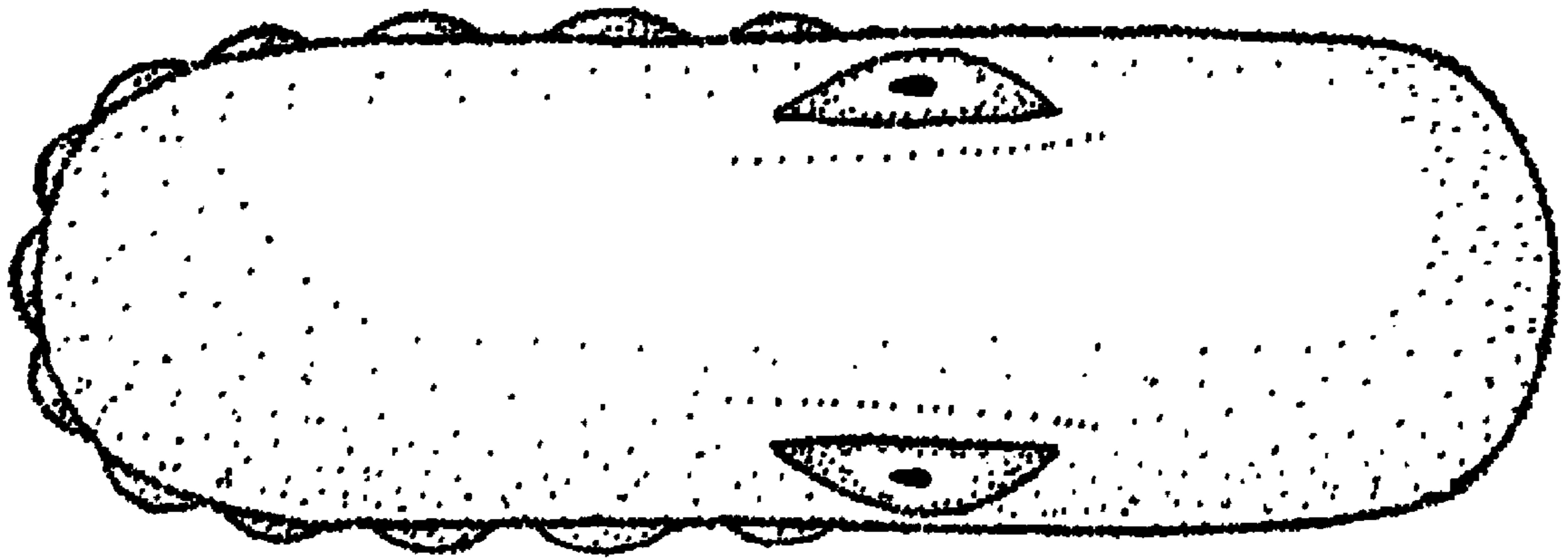

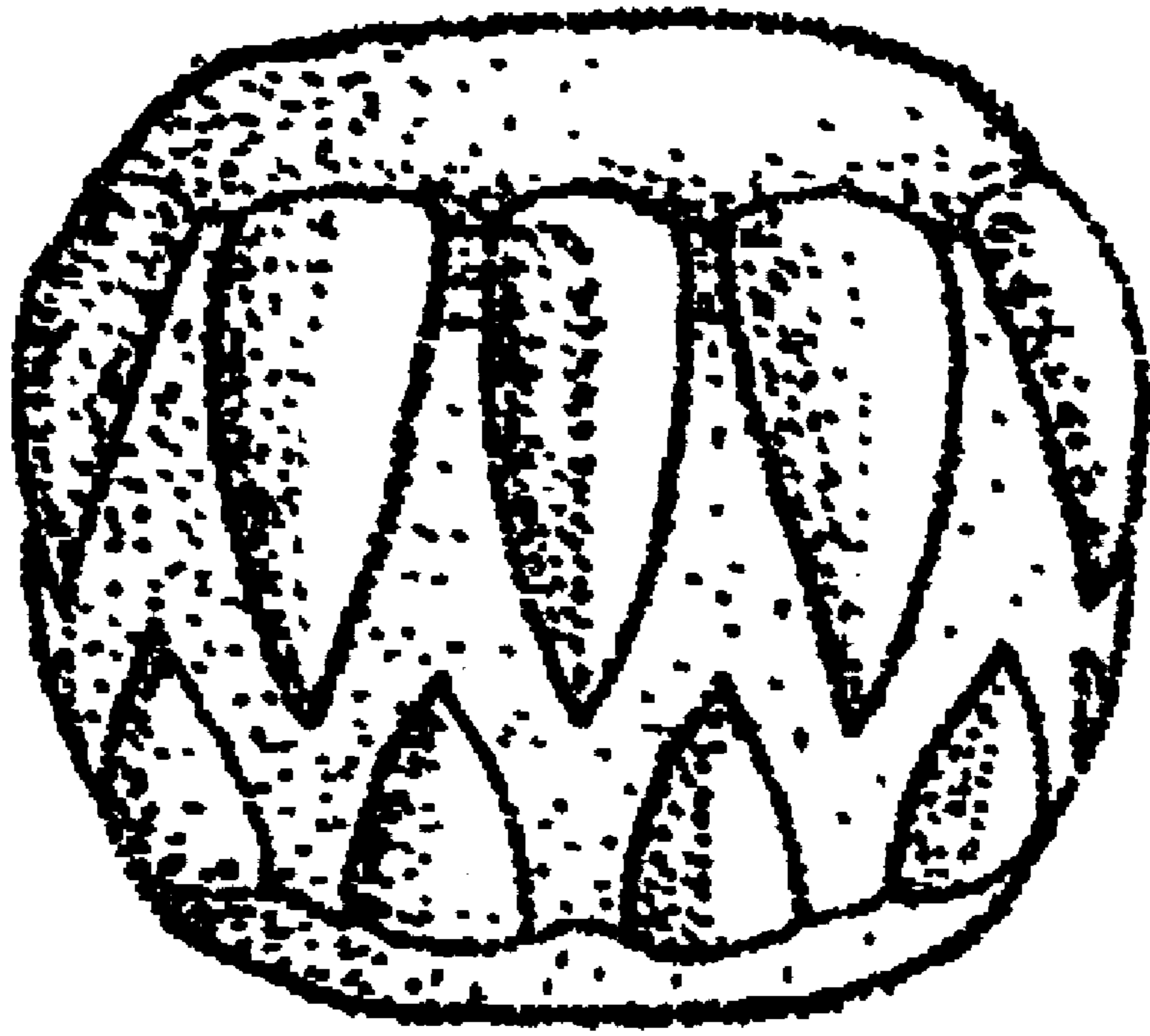

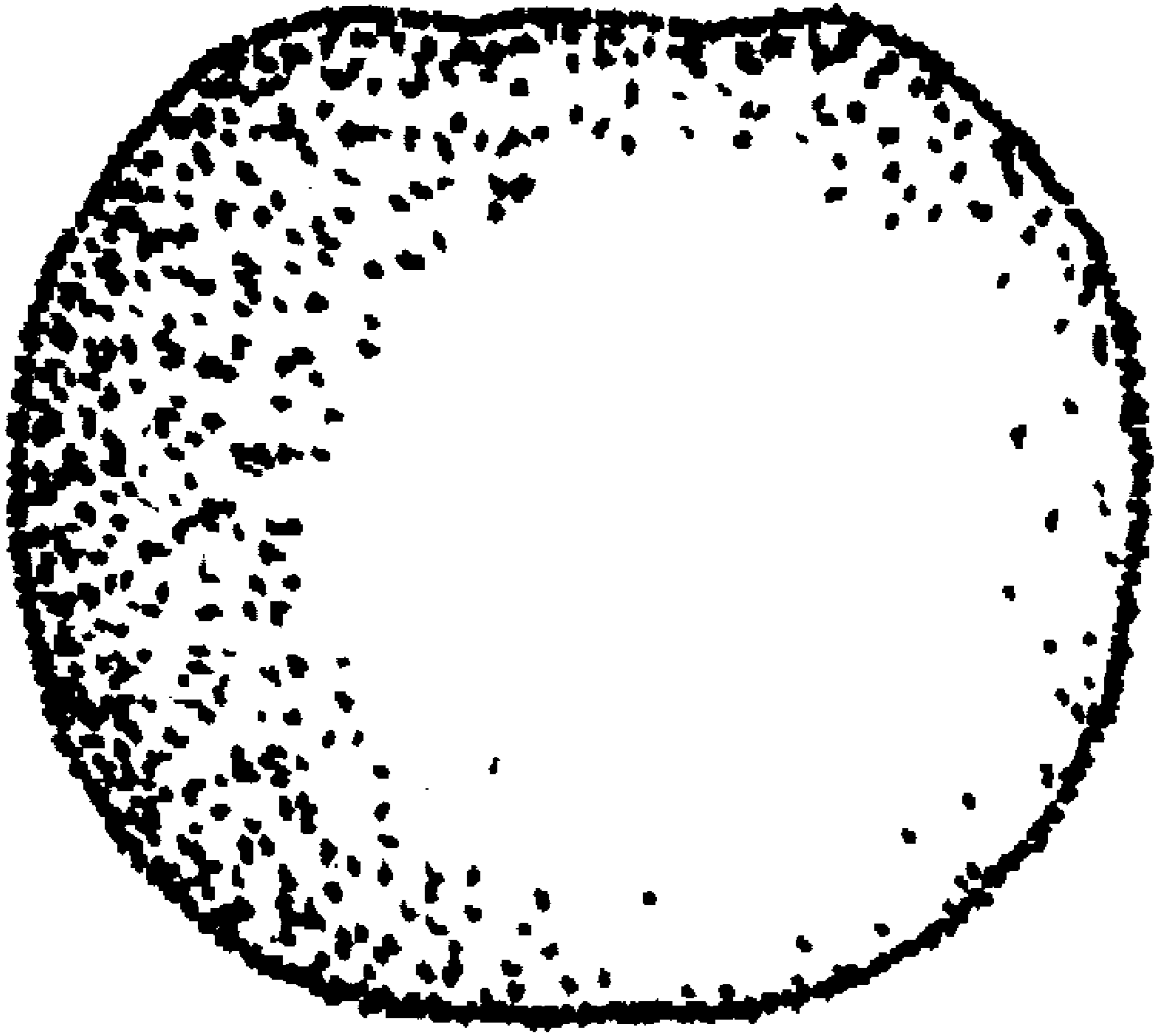

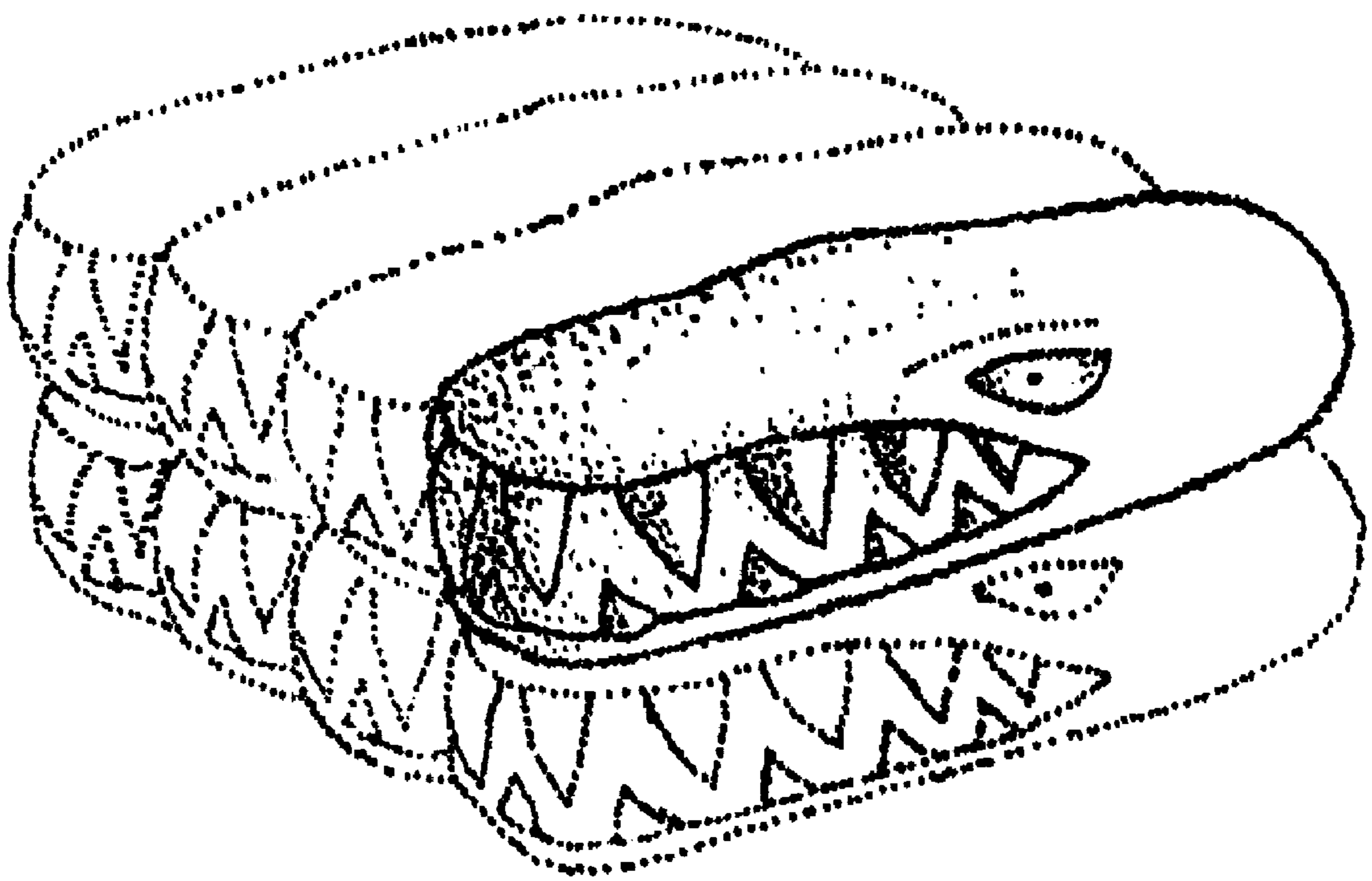
