The ornamental design for a side element of a shoe upper, as shown and described.

**DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a side element of a shoe upper showing the new design;

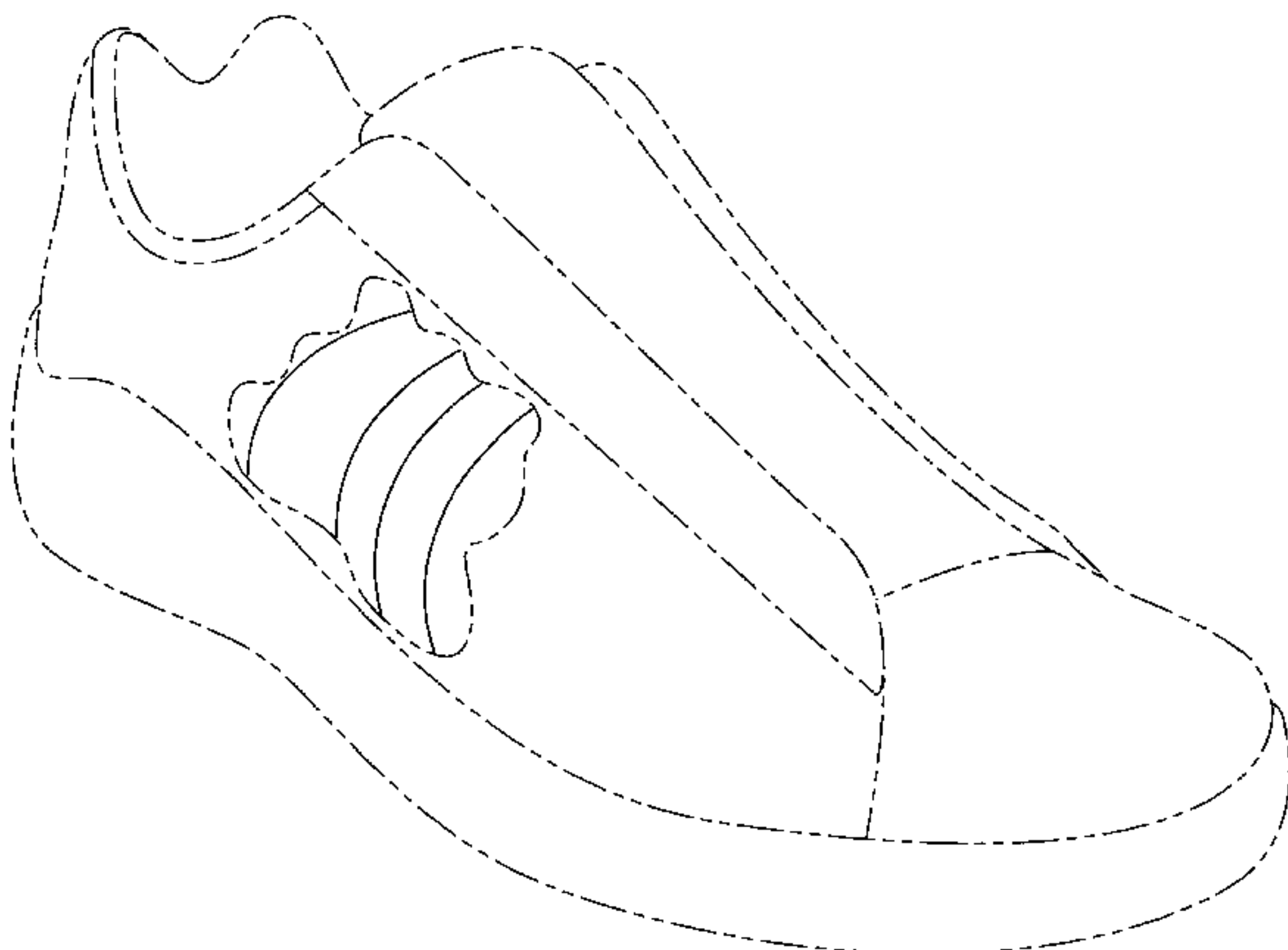
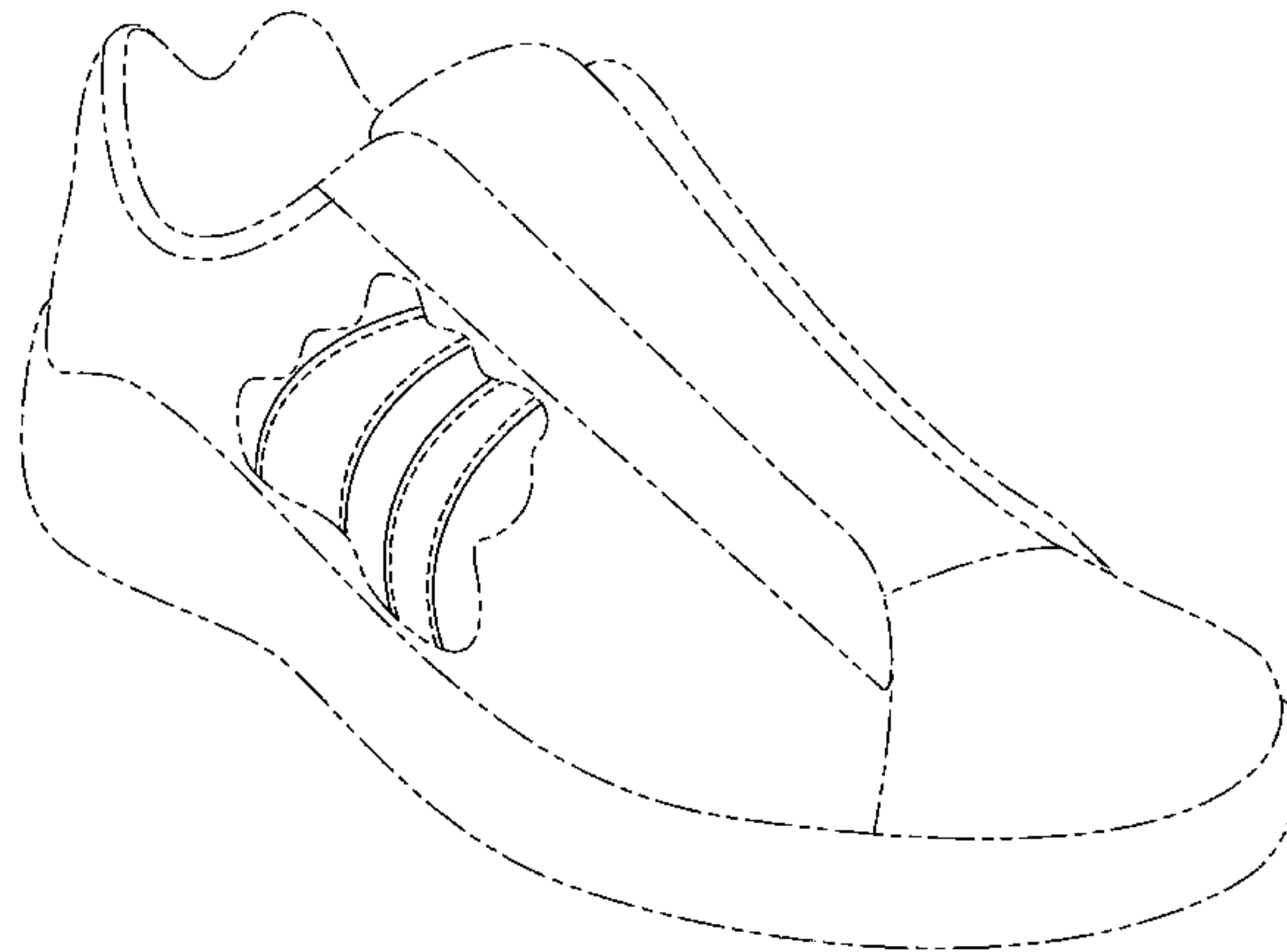
FIG. 2 is a side elevational view thereof;

FIG. 3 is a perspective view of an alternative embodiment of the shoe upper of the new design; and,

FIG. 4 is a side elevational view of the alternative embodiment.

The uneven broken lines in all figures showing the remainder of the shoe are for illustrative purposes only and form no part of the claimed design.

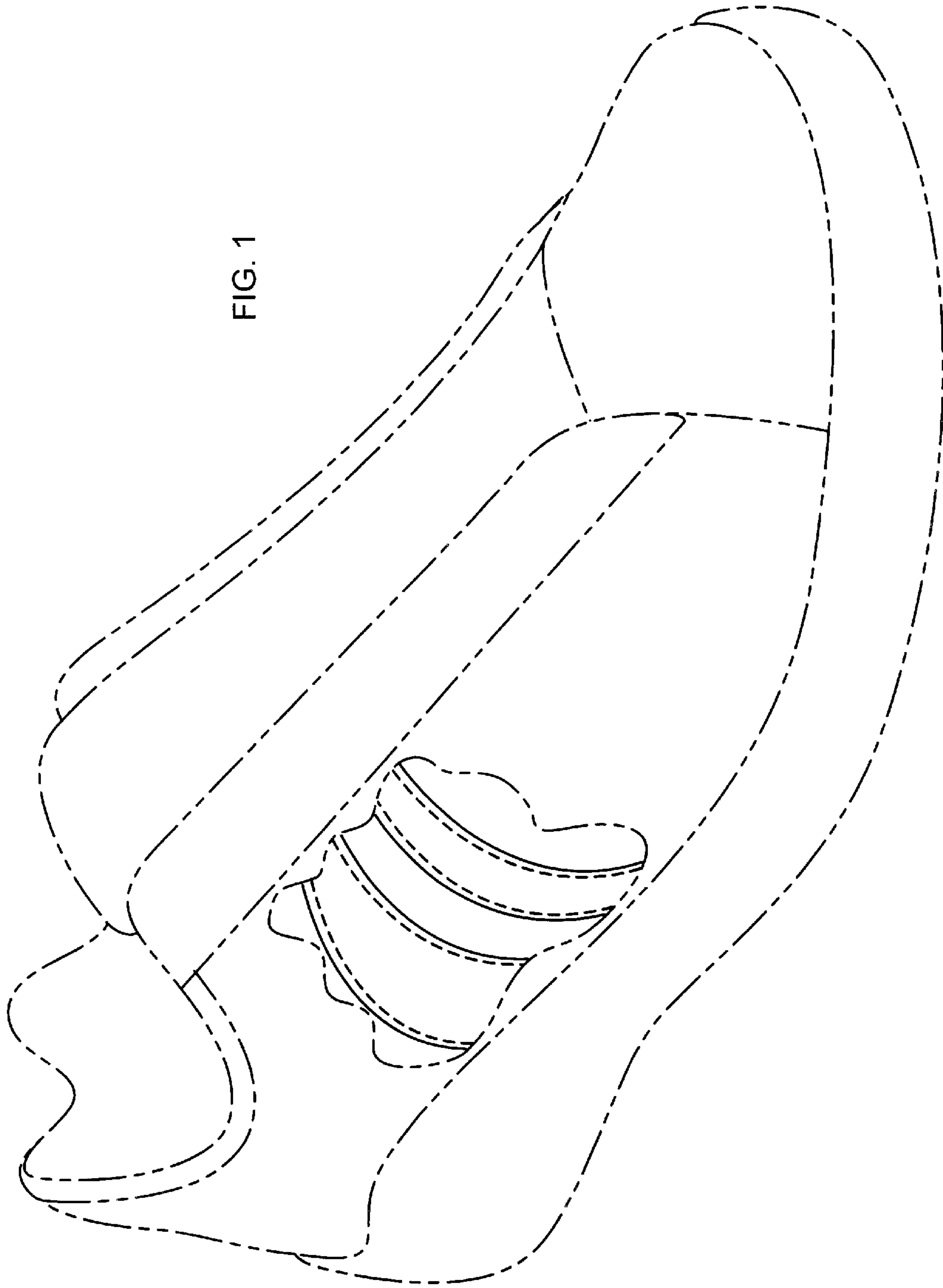

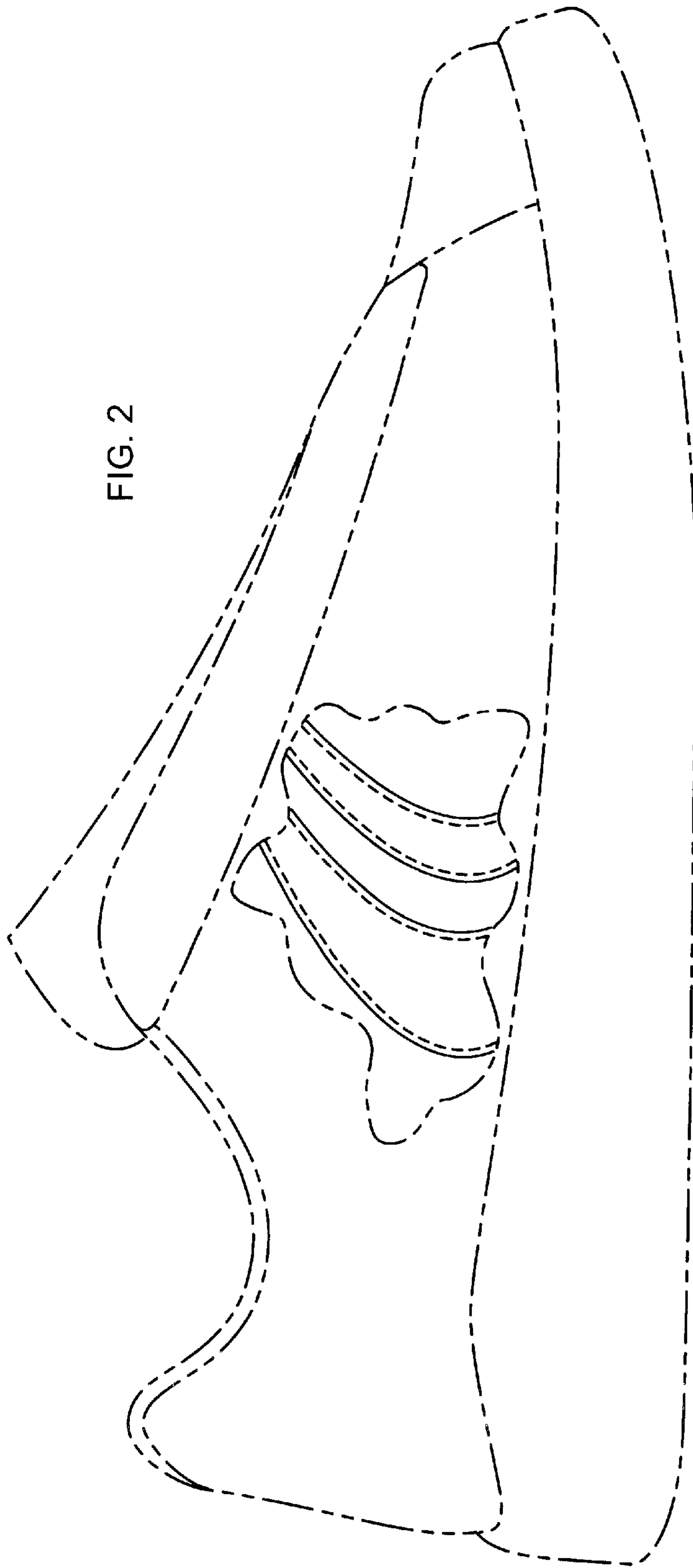
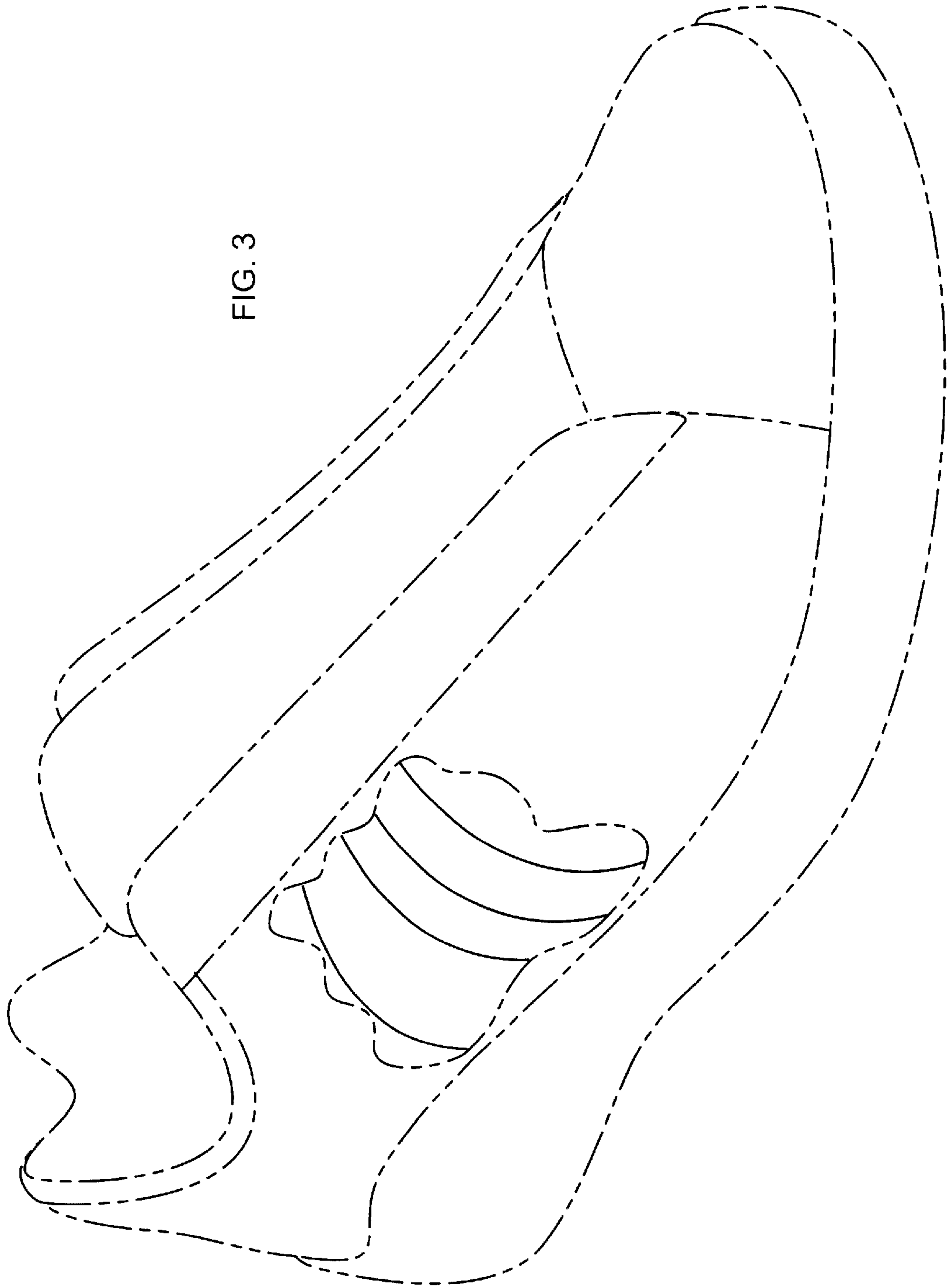

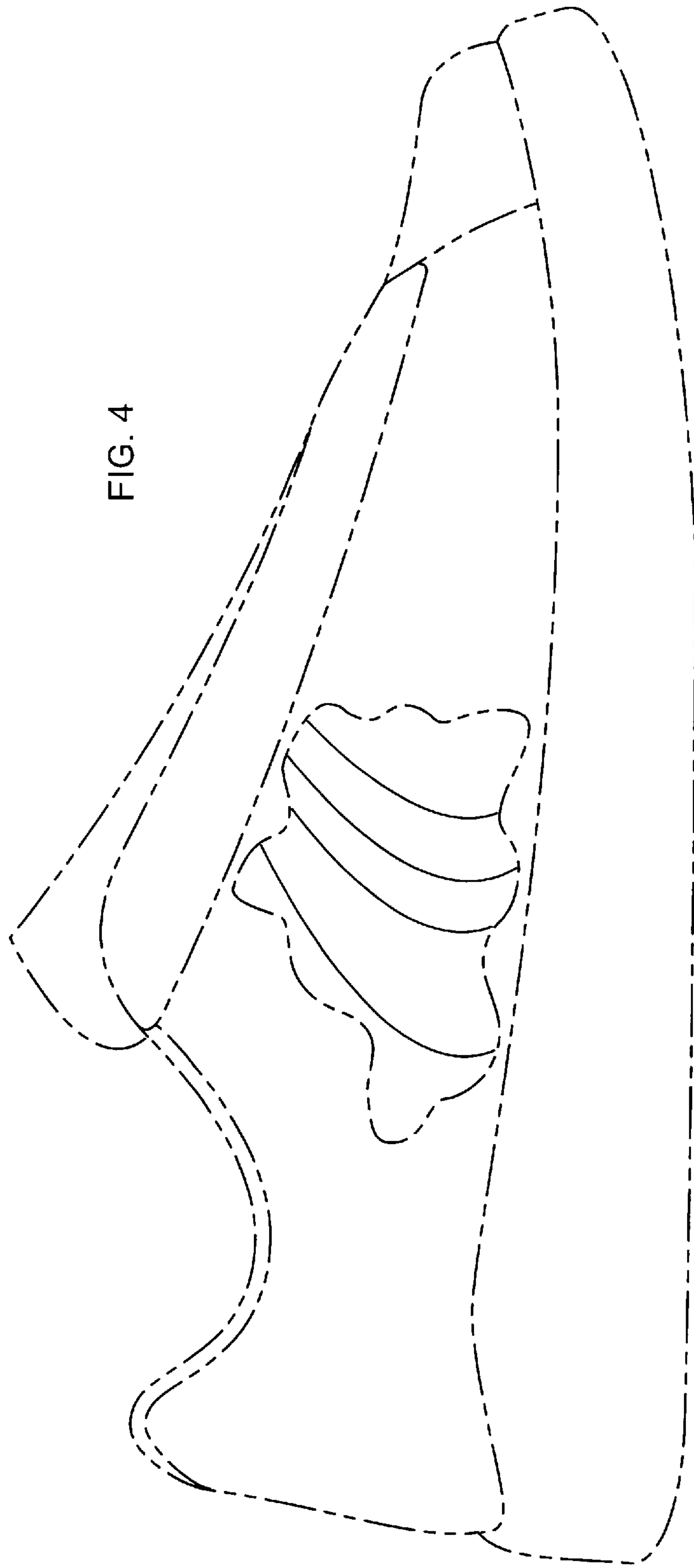
