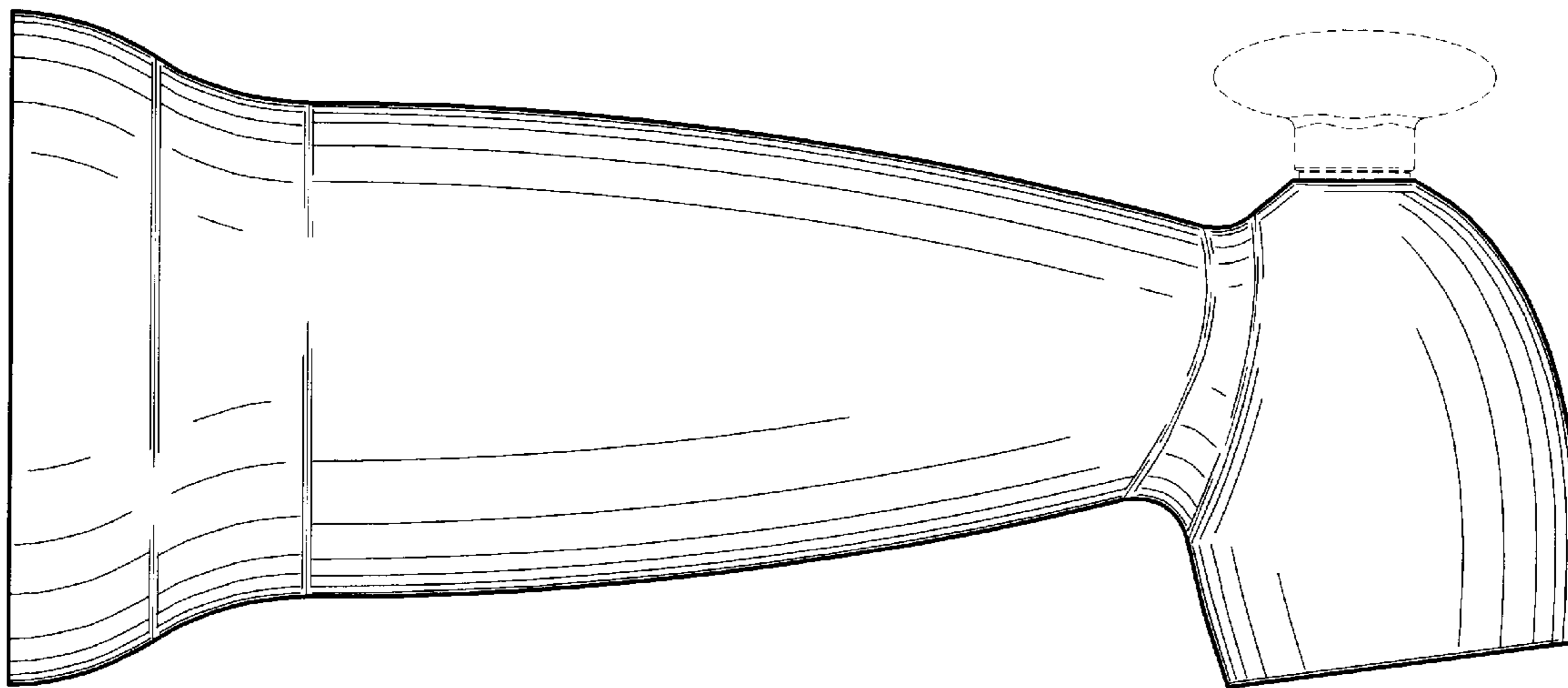
FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of a tub spout showing our new design;

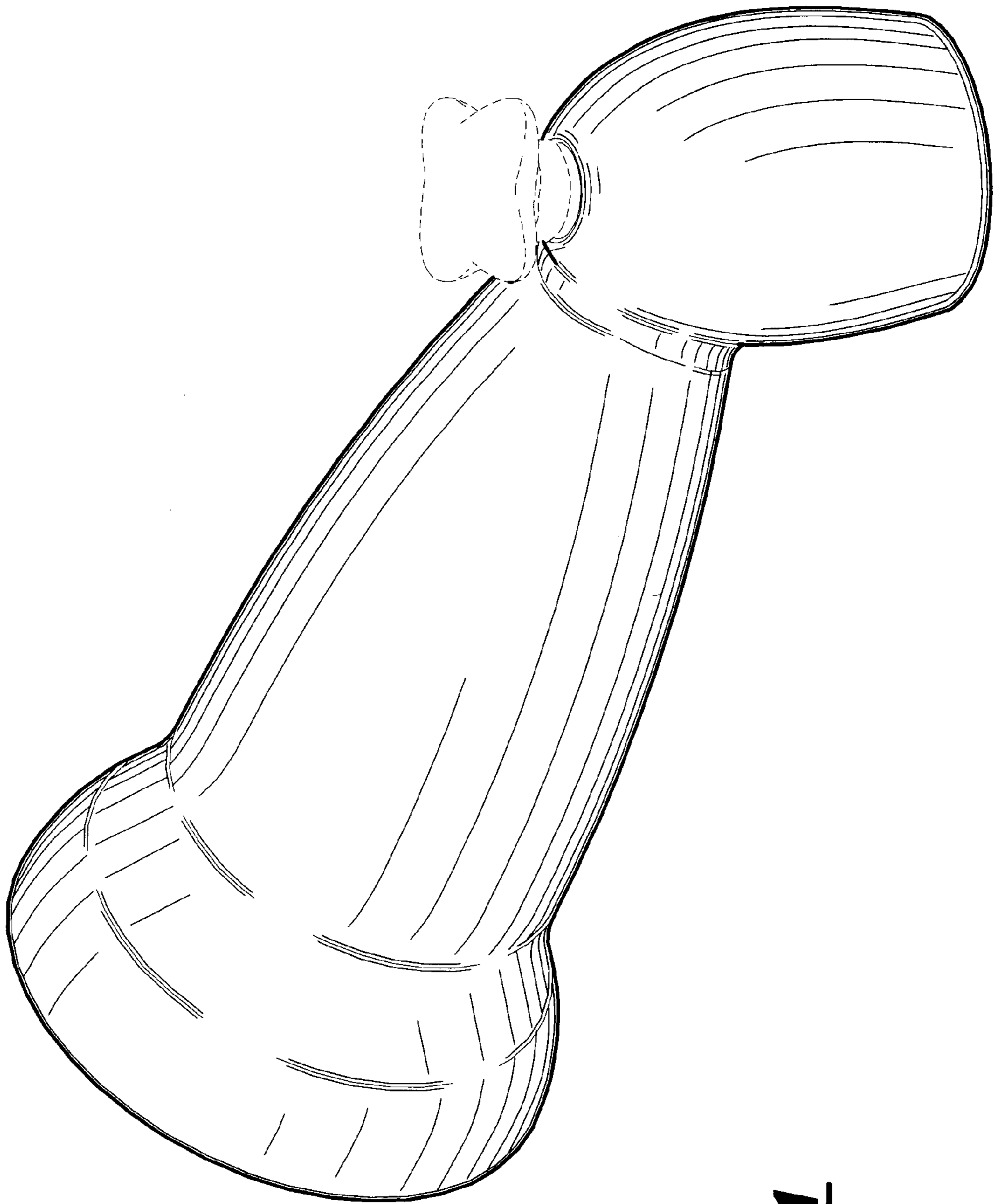

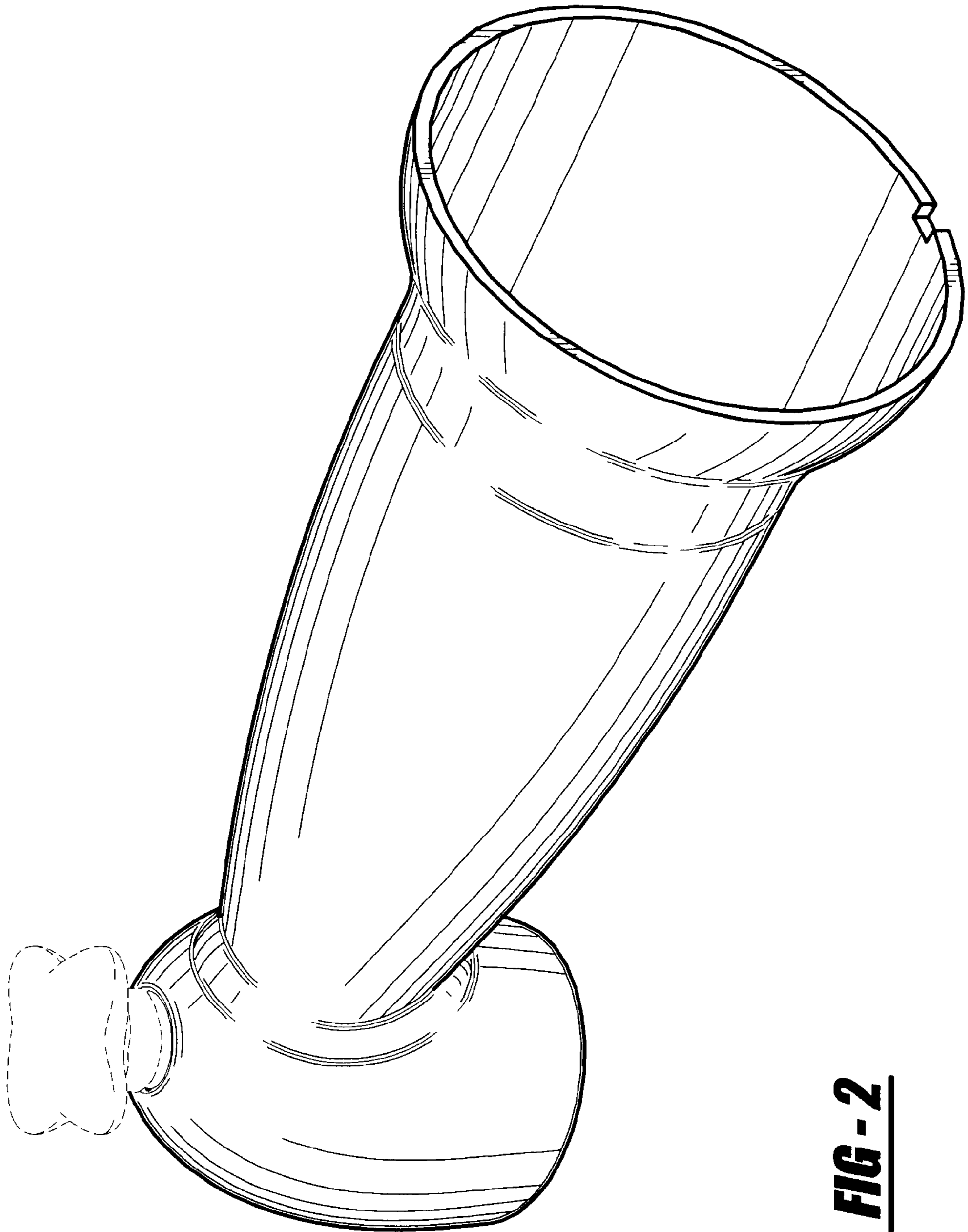

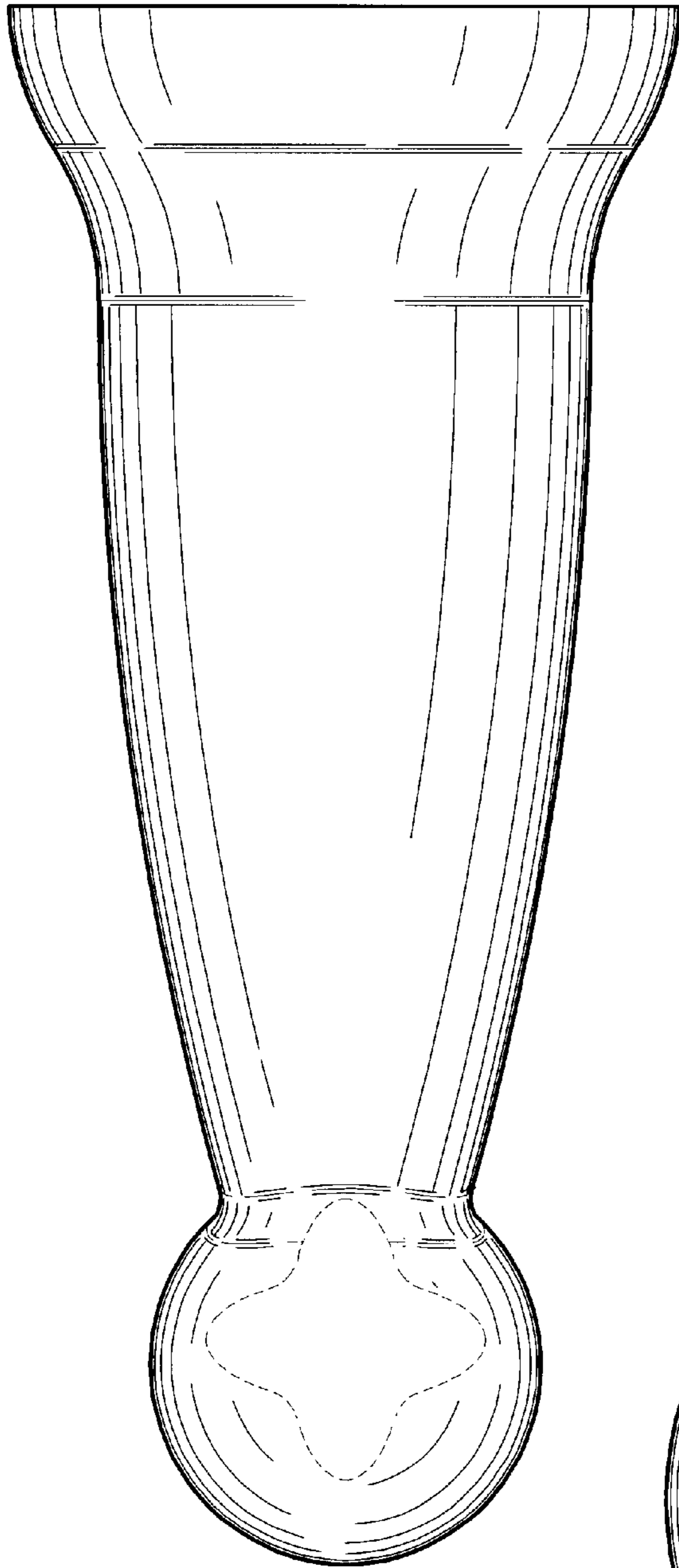

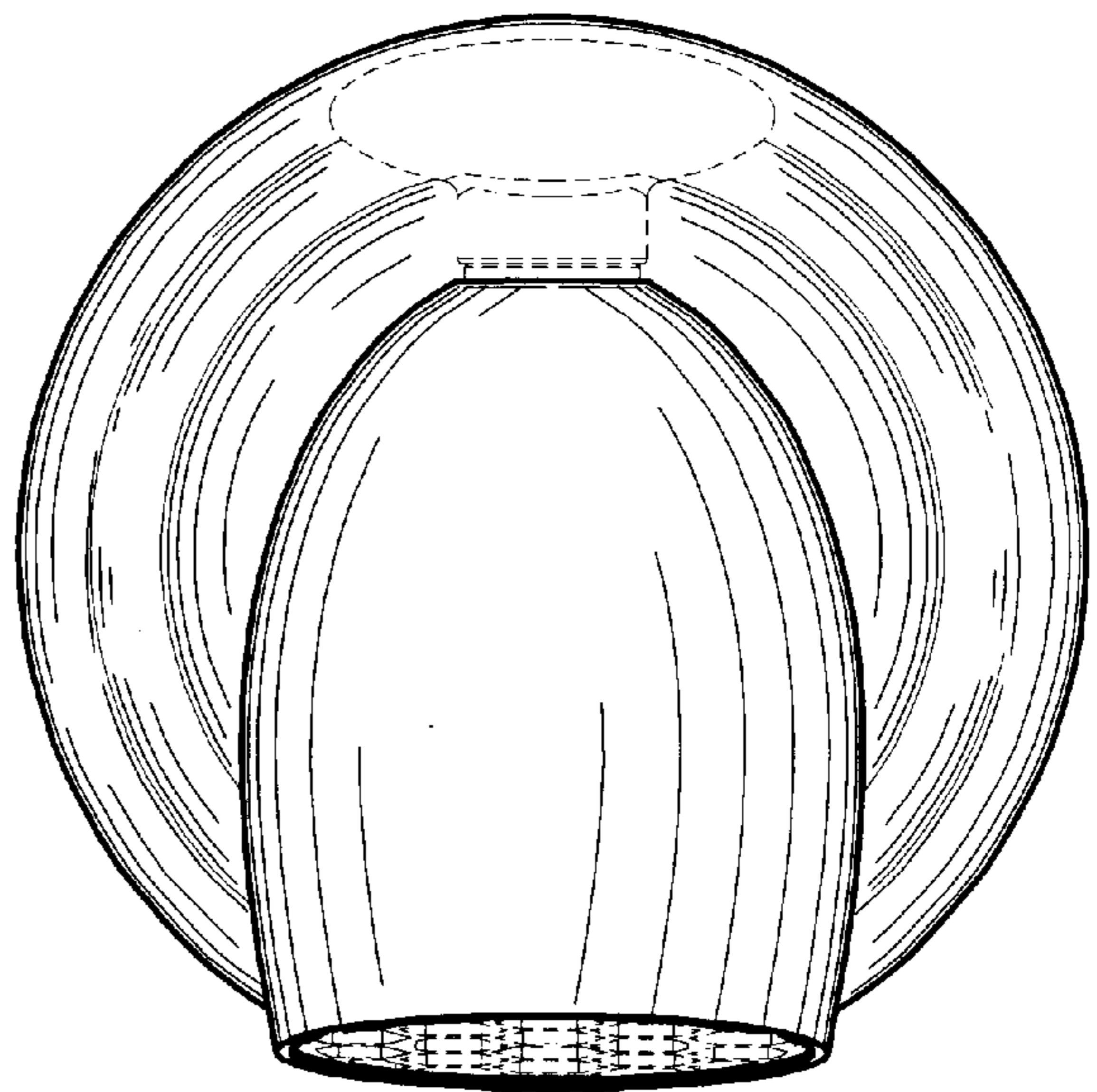

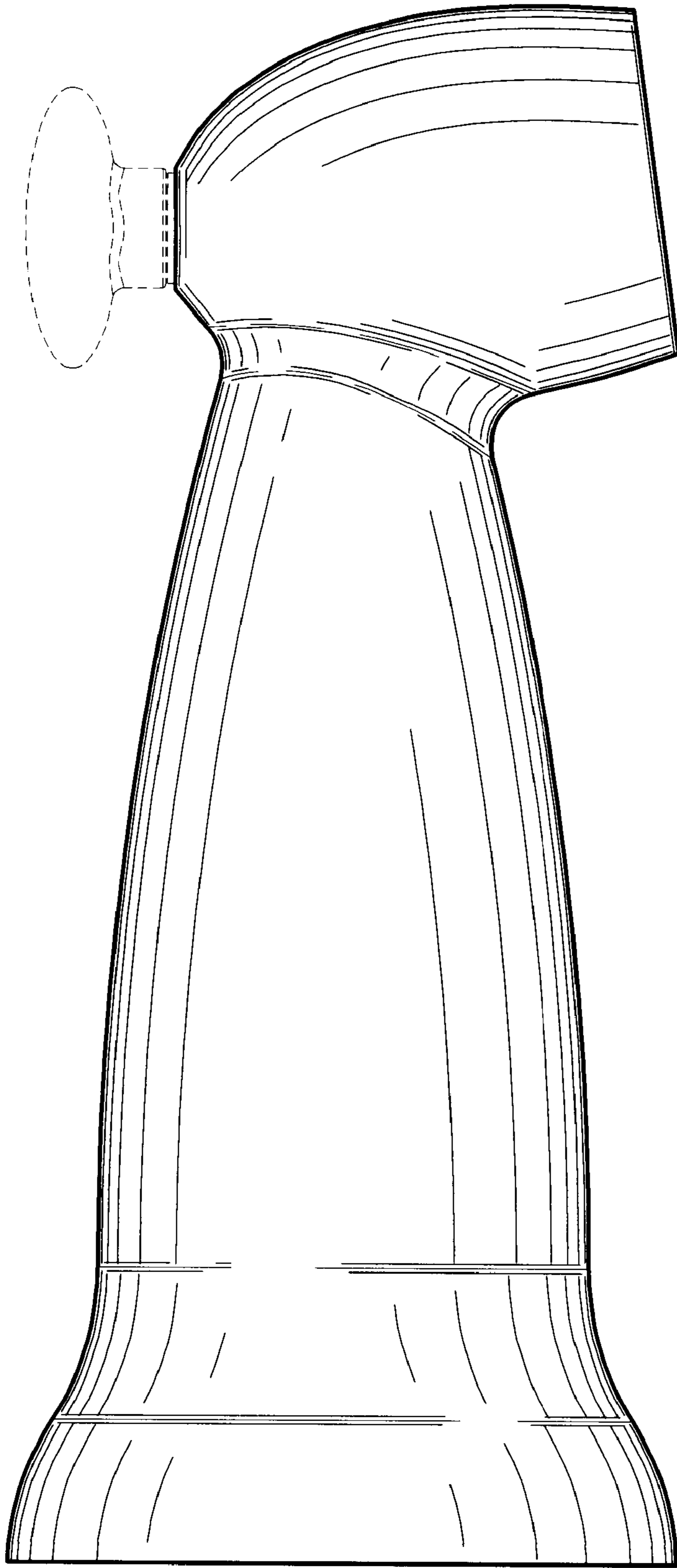

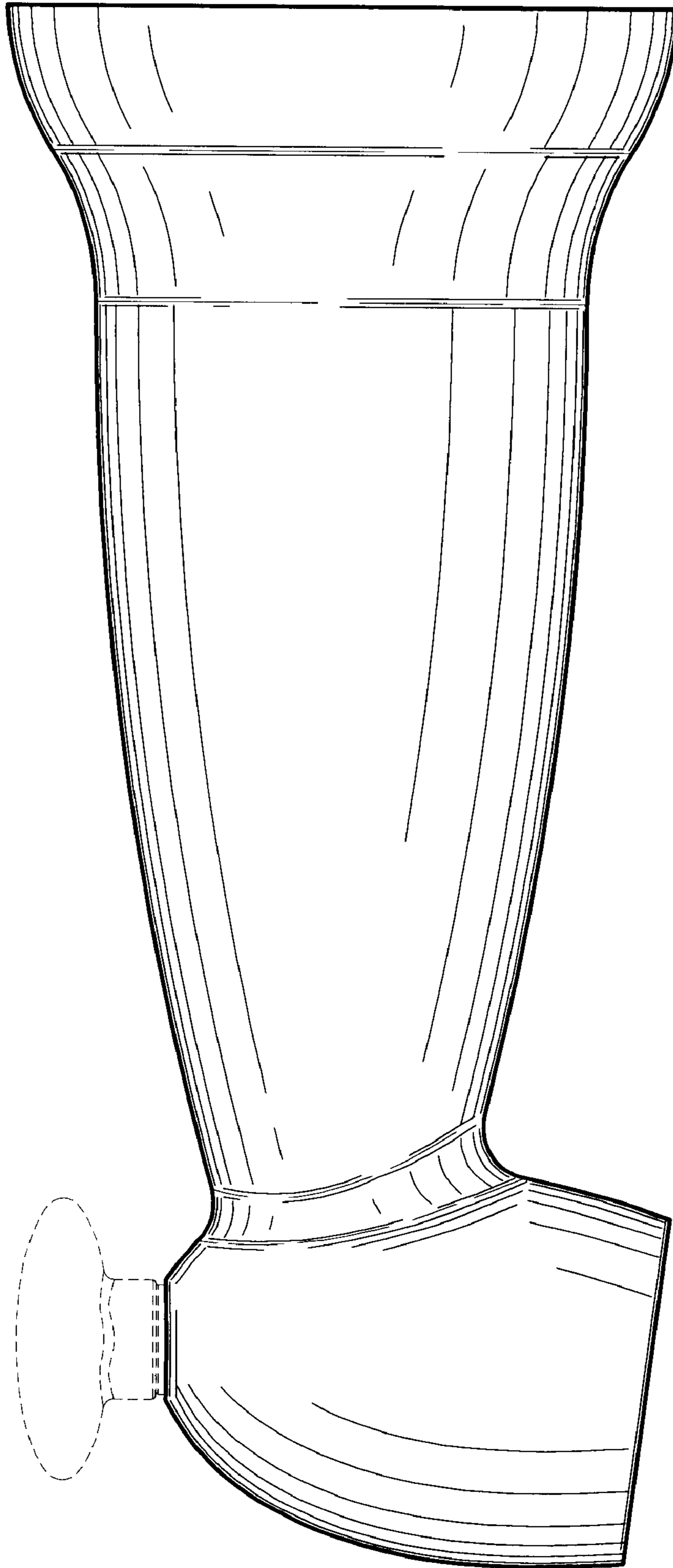

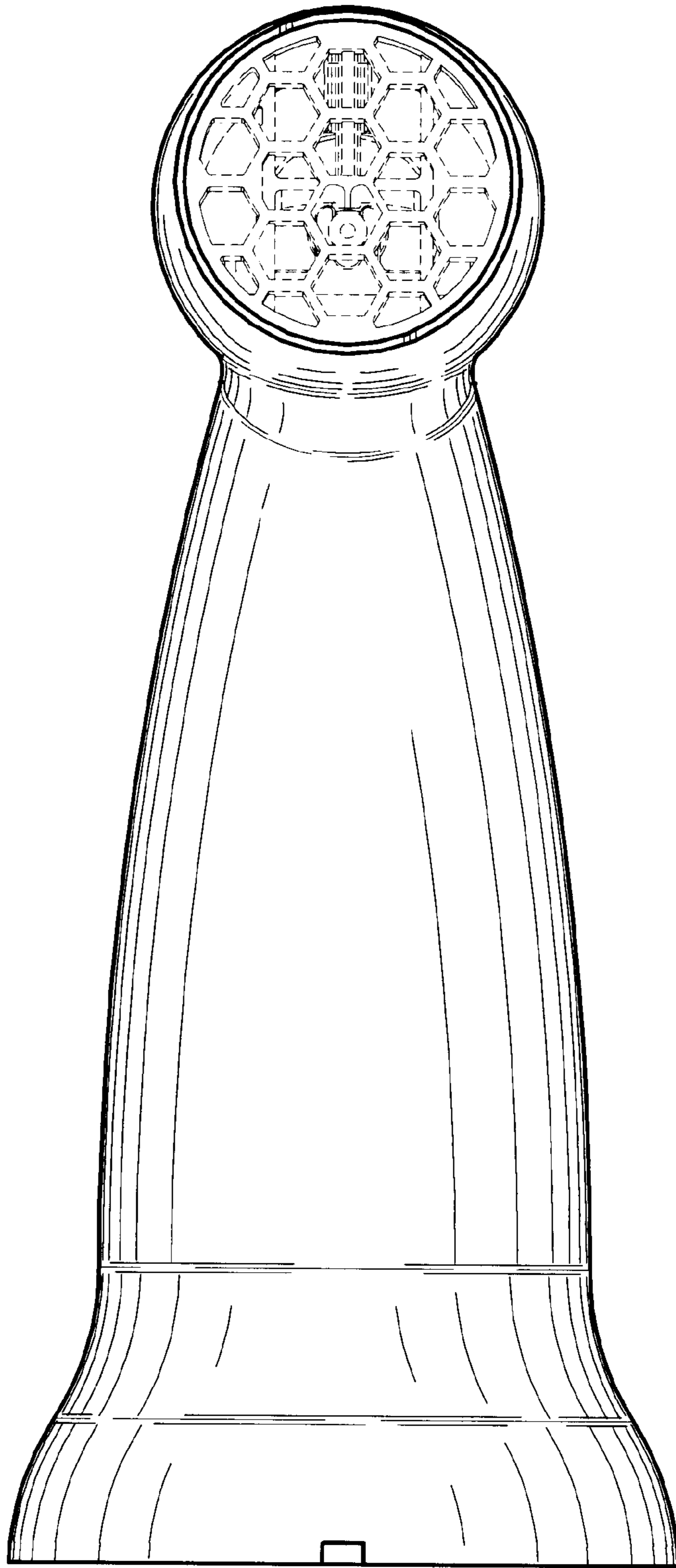
