(57) CLAIM

The ornamental design for a lounge chair, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a lounge chair in accordance with the new design;
FIG. 2 is a top view thereof;
FIG. 3 is a front elevational view thereof;
FIG. 4 is a left side elevational view thereof, a right side elevational view being a mirror image thereof;
FIG. 5 is a rear elevational view thereof; and,
FIG. 6 is a perspective view of an alternative embodiment of a lounge chair in accordance with the new design, a portion of which is cut away to illustrate indeterminate length.
The broken lines in FIGS. 1 and 6 are for illustrative purposes only and form no part of the claimed design.
