(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a flashlight, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top plan view of a flashlight according to a first embodiment of the invention, the bottom plan view being essentially identical.

FIG. 2 is a front elevational view of a flashlight according to all three illustrated embodiments of the invention.

FIG. 3 is a rear elevational view of a flashlight according to all three illustrated embodiments of the invention.

FIG. 4 is a right side elevational view of a flashlight according to the first embodiment of the invention, the left side elevational view being essentially identical.

FIG. 5 is a top plan view of a flashlight according to a second embodiment of the invention, the bottom plan view being essentially identical.

FIG. 6 is a right side elevational view of the flashlight according to the second embodiment of the invention, the left side elevational view being essentially identical.

FIG. 7 is a top plan view of a flashlight according to a third embodiment of the invention, the bottom plan view being essentially identical; and,

FIG. 8 is a right side elevational view of the flashlight according to the third embodiment of the invention, the left side elevational view being essentially identical.

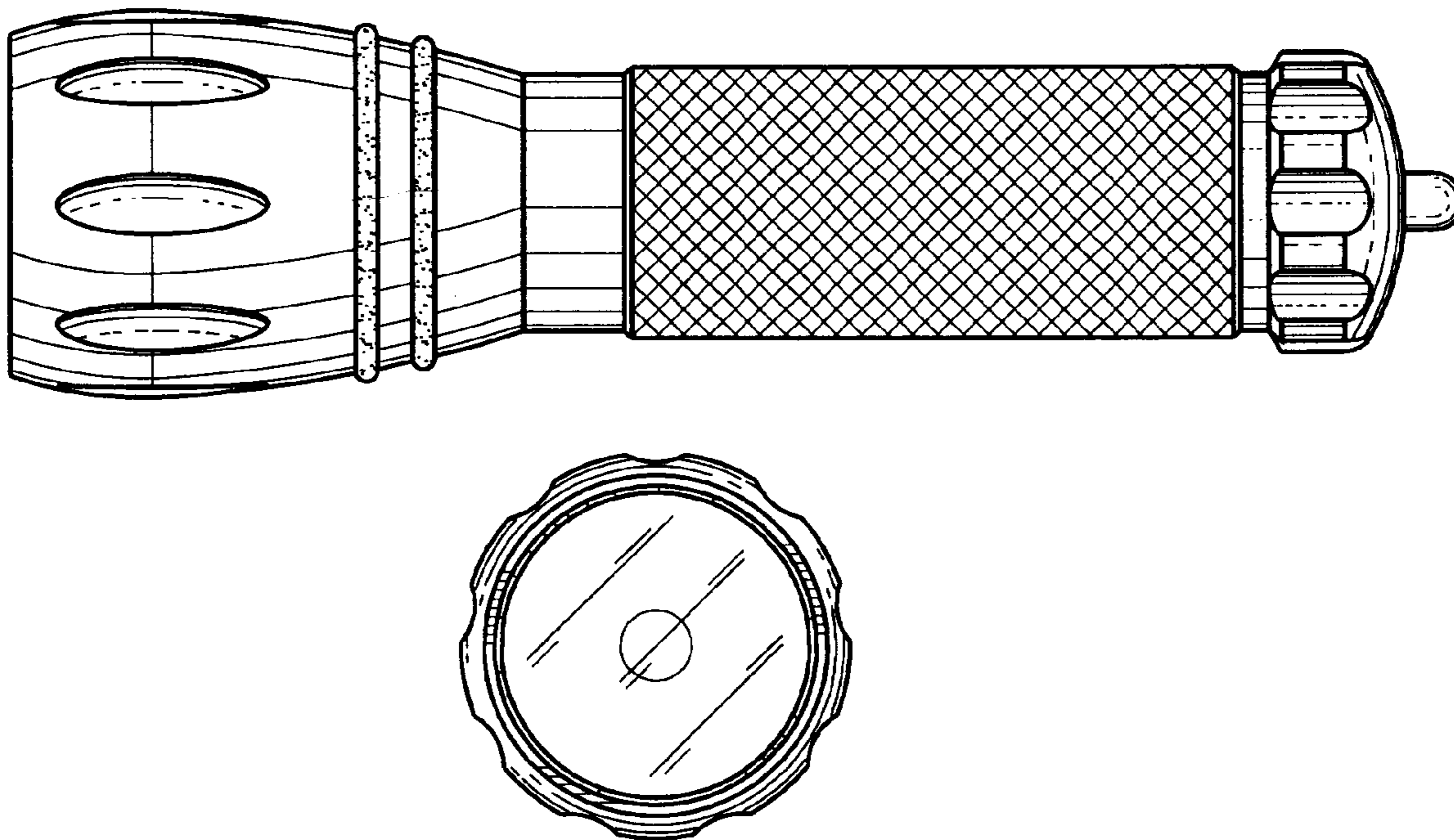

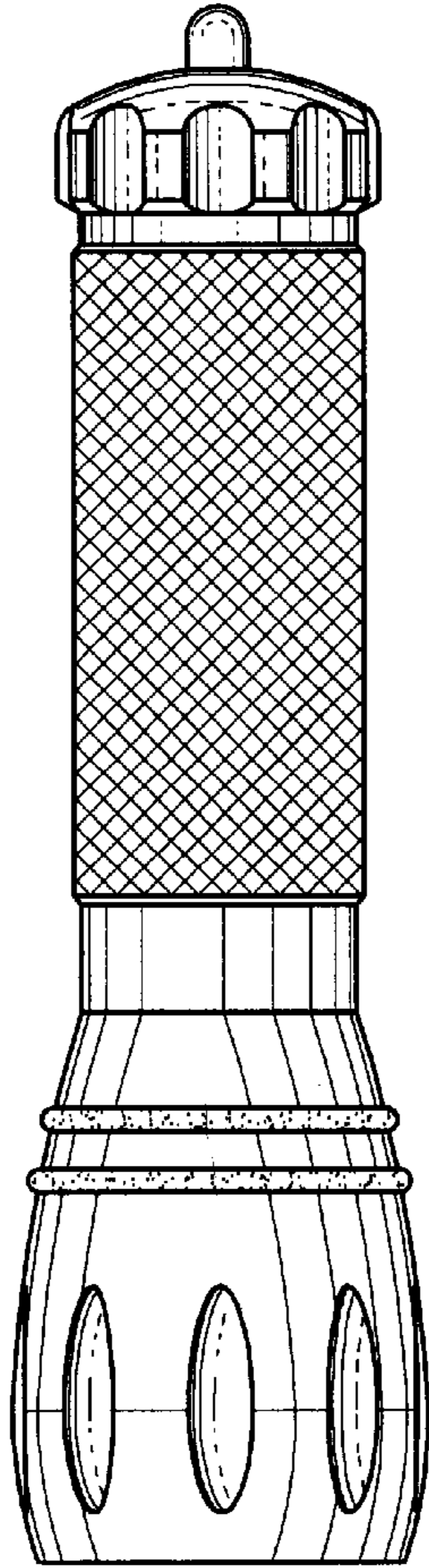

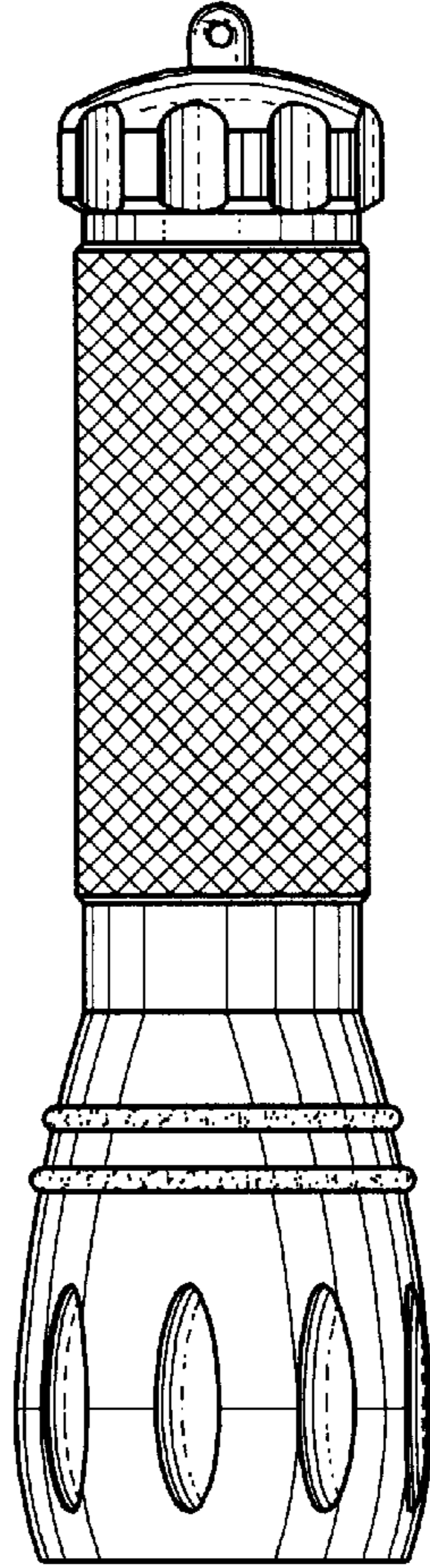

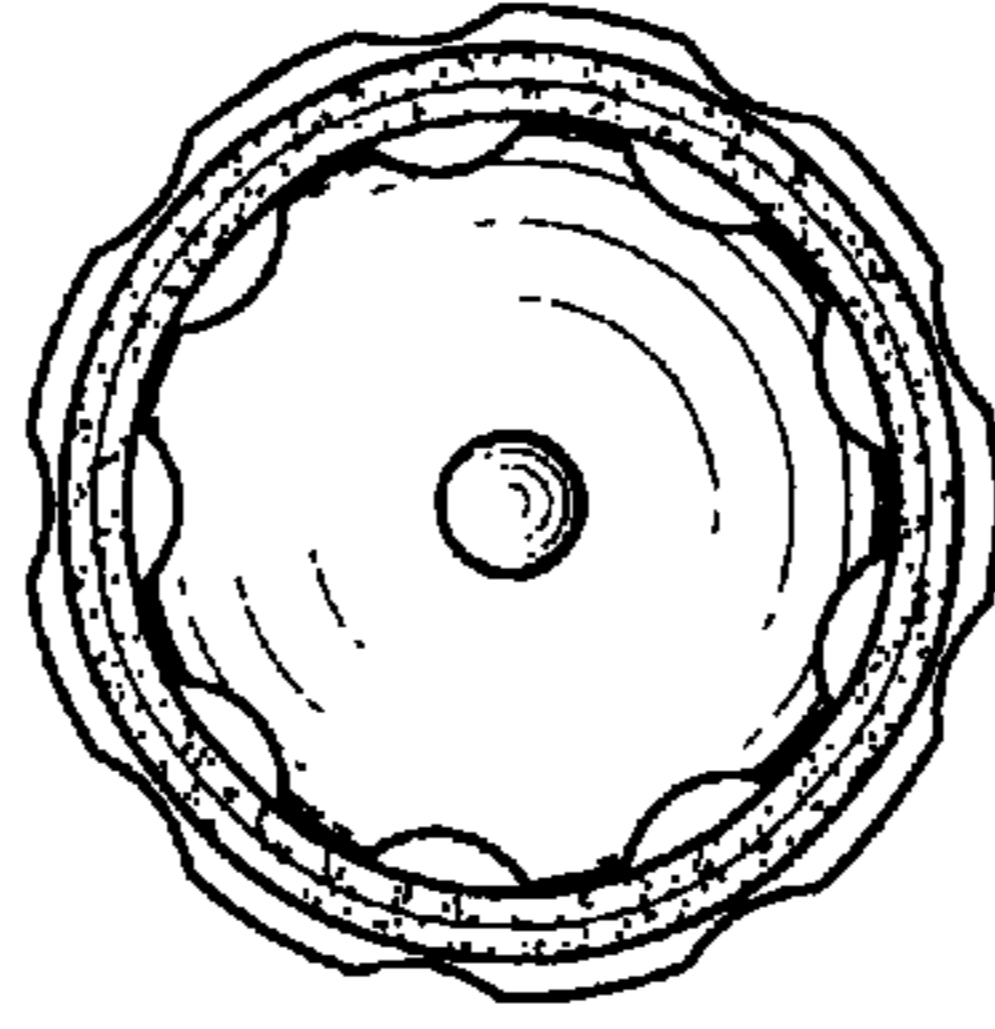

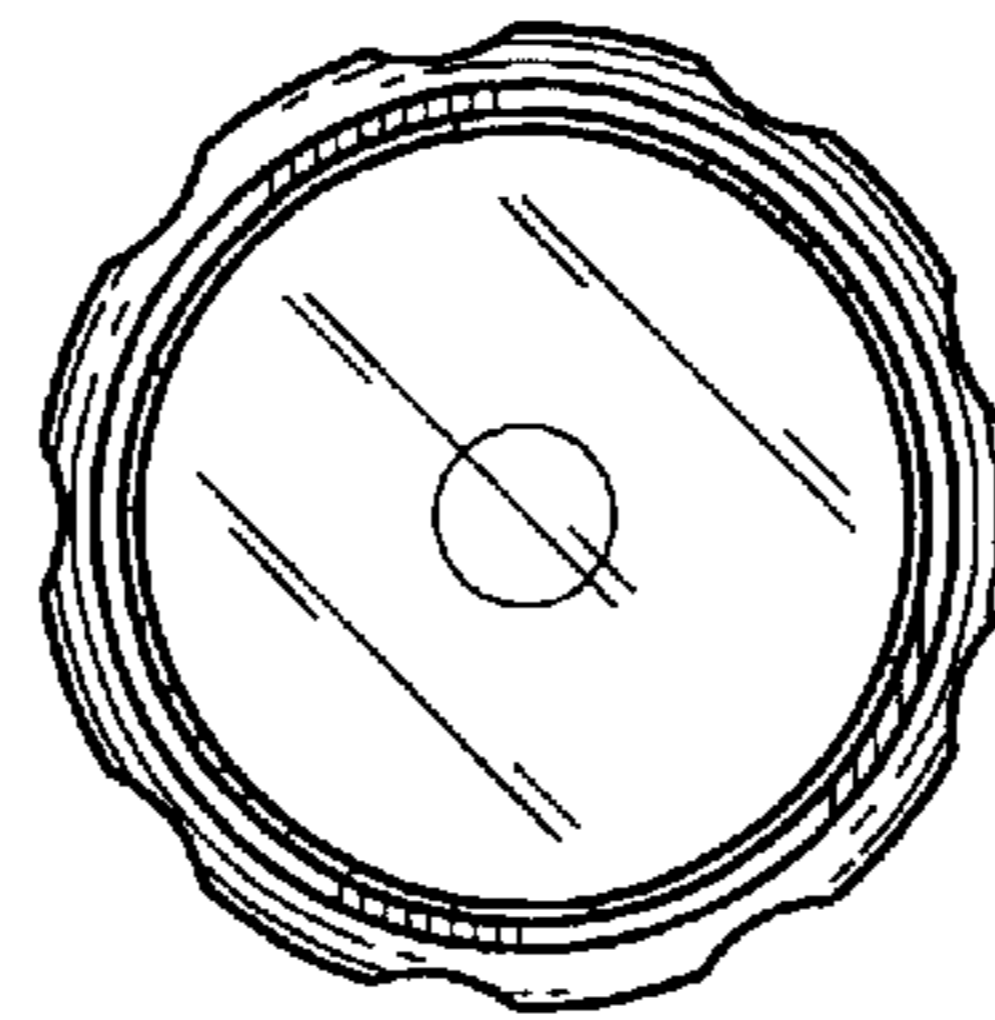

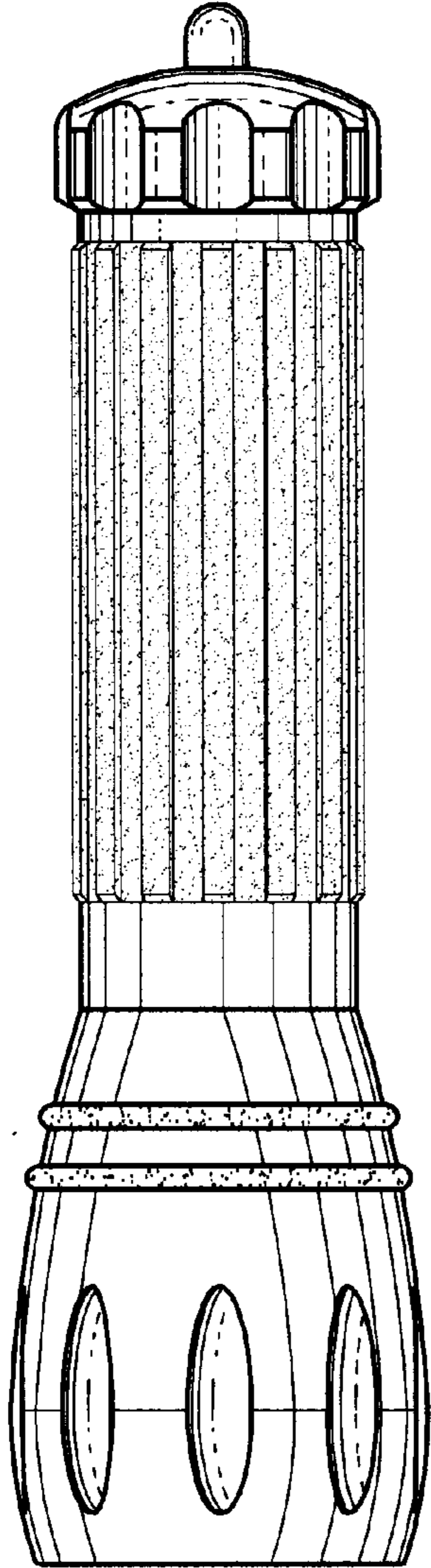
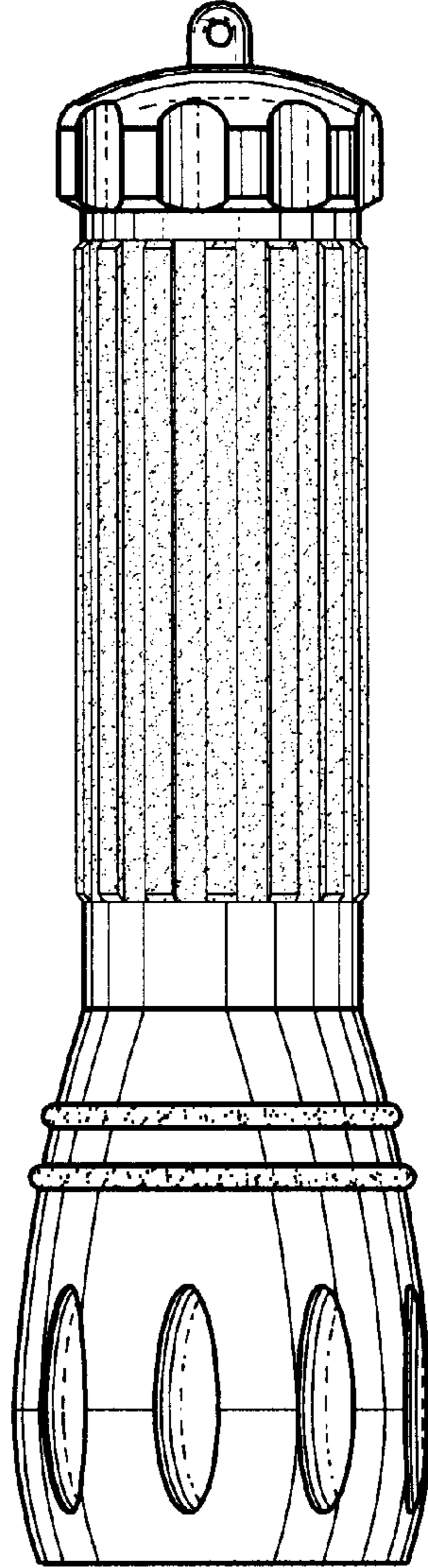

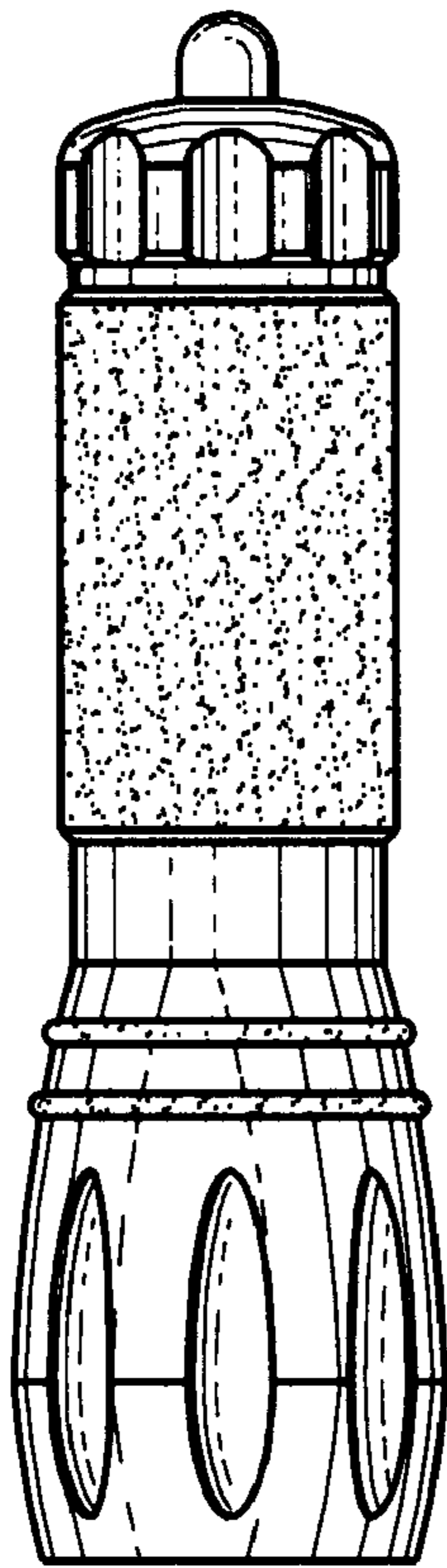

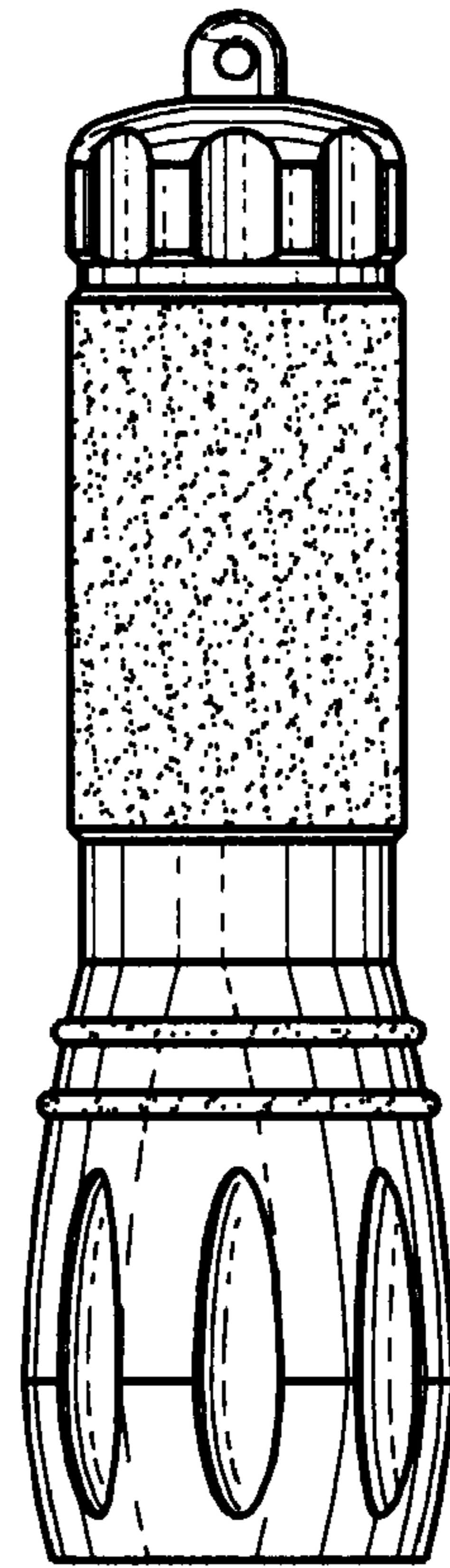
