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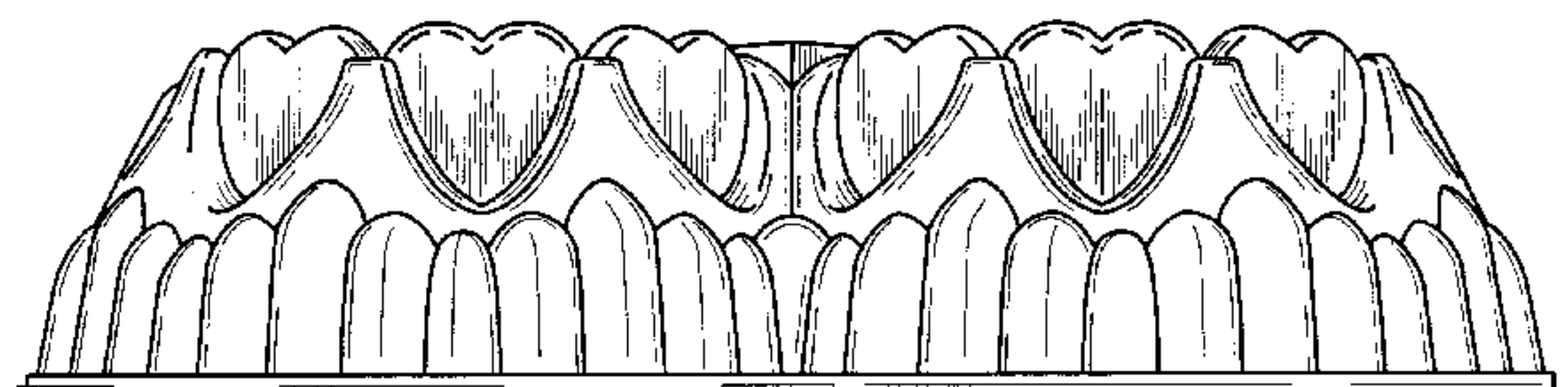
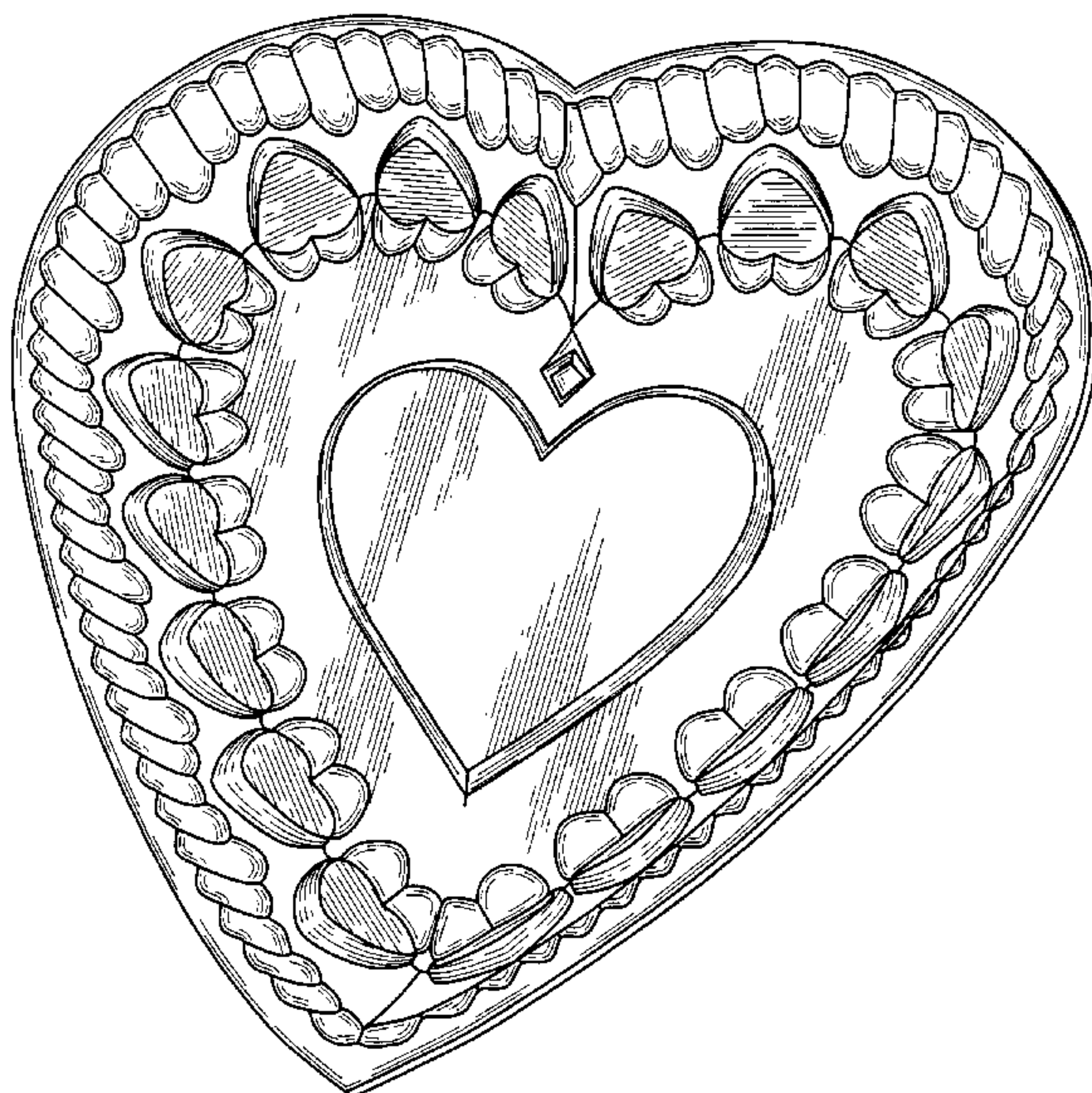
(57) **CLAIM**

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top perspective view of the cake pan;
FIG. 2 is a top plan view of the cake pan;
FIG. 3 is a bottom plan view of the cake pan;
FIG. 4 is a front elevational view of the cake pan;
FIG. 5 is a back elevational view of the cake pan; and,
FIG. 6 is side elevational view of the cake pan, the opposite of which is an identical mirror image.

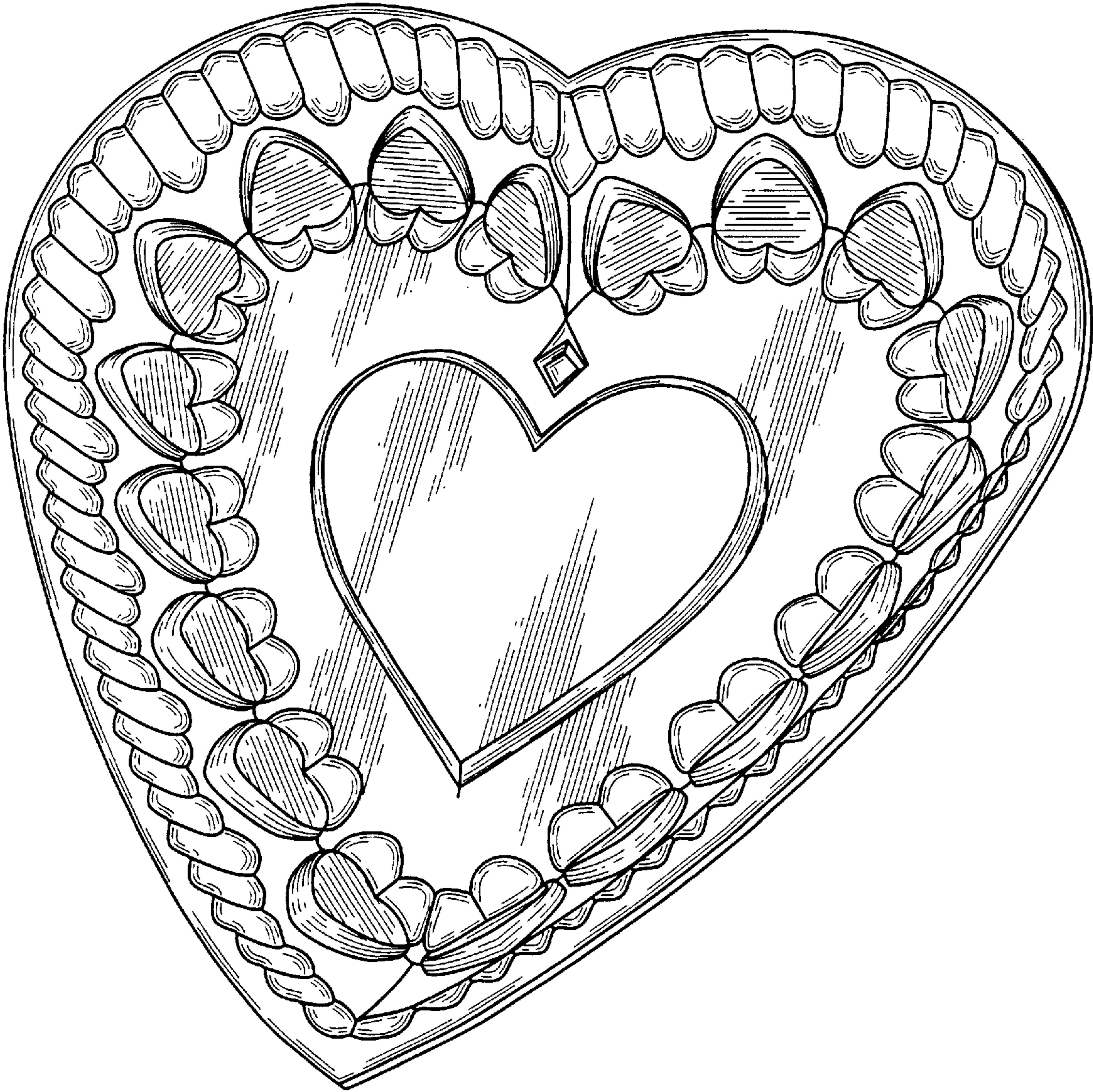

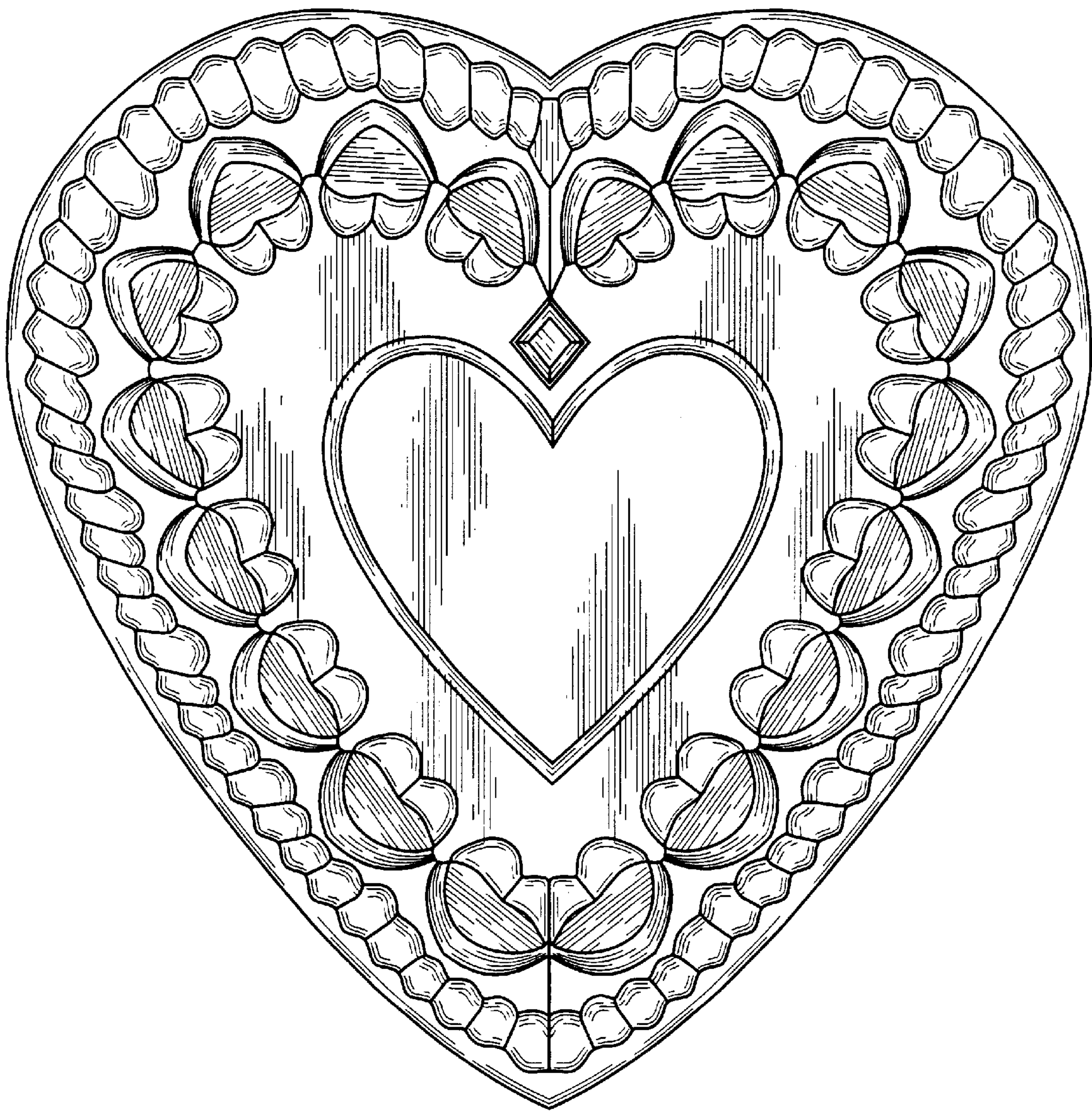

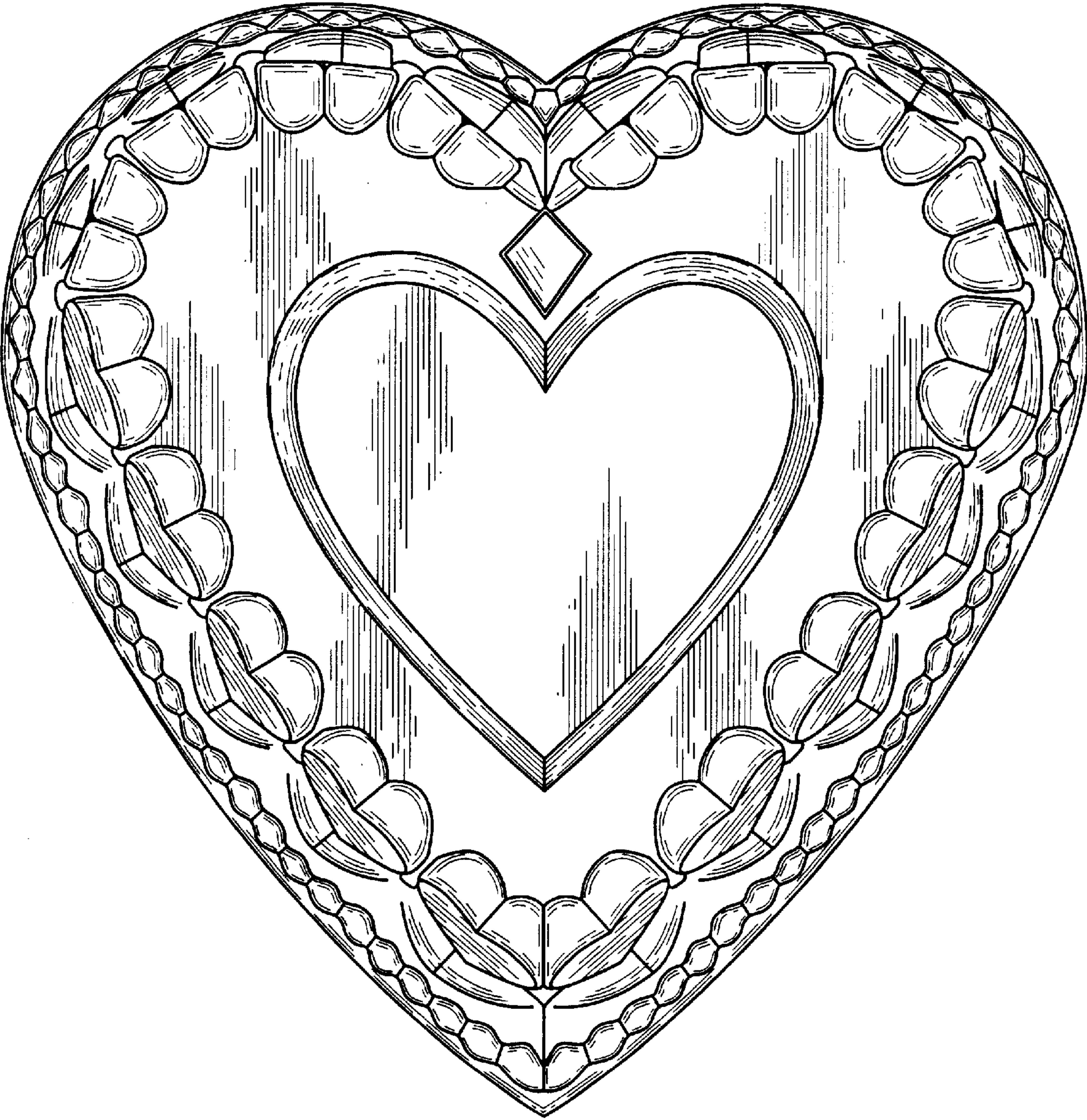

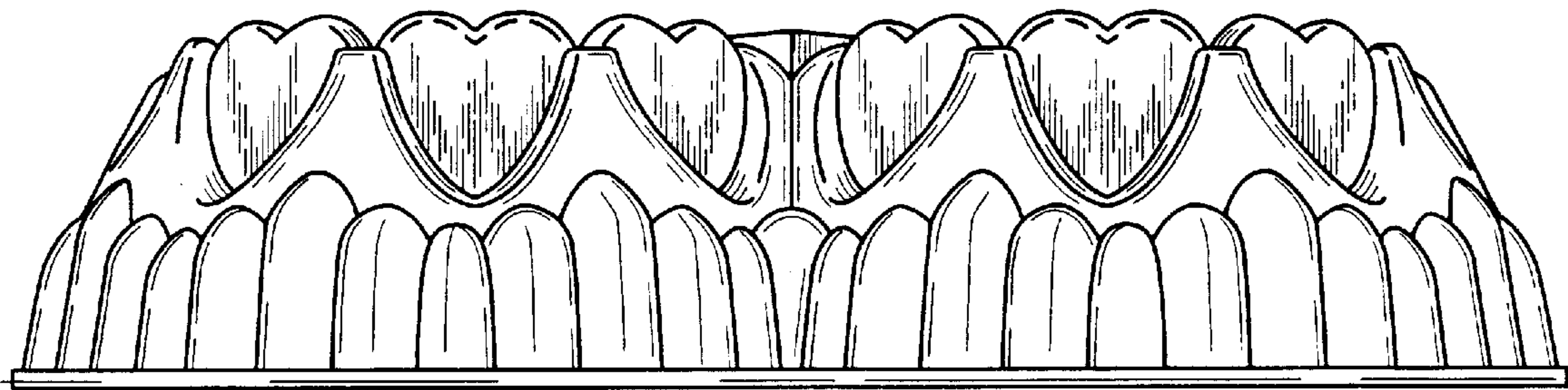

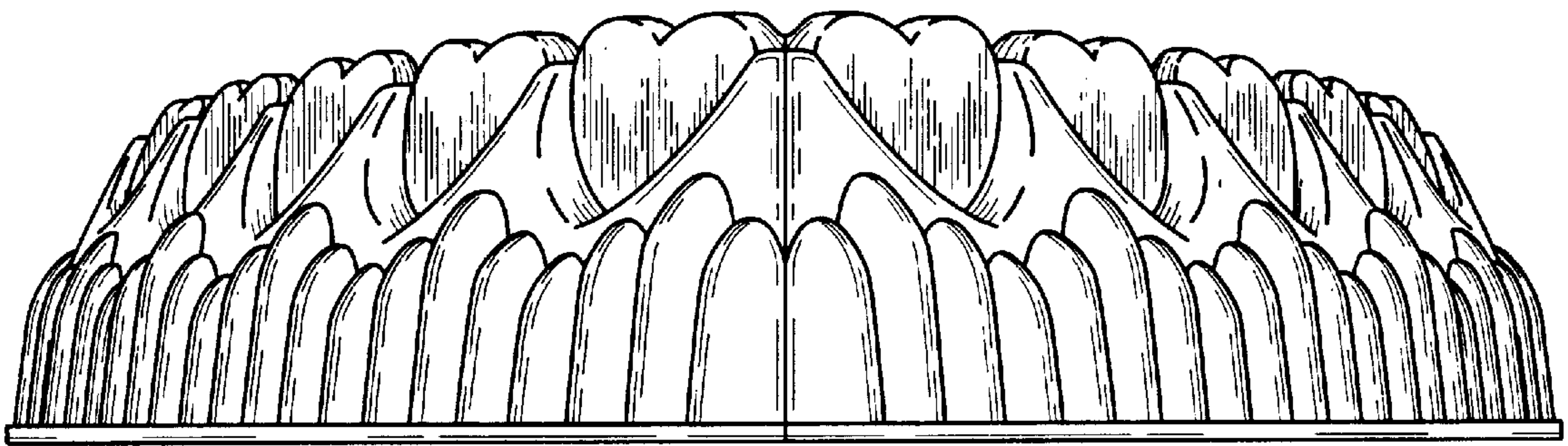

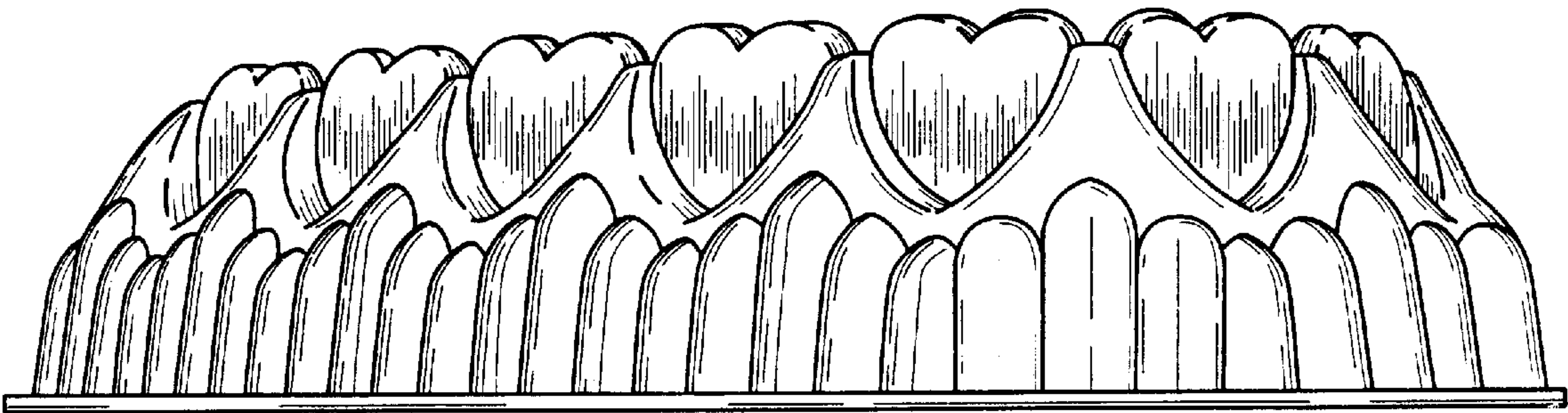
