The design for a rear bumper, as shown and described.

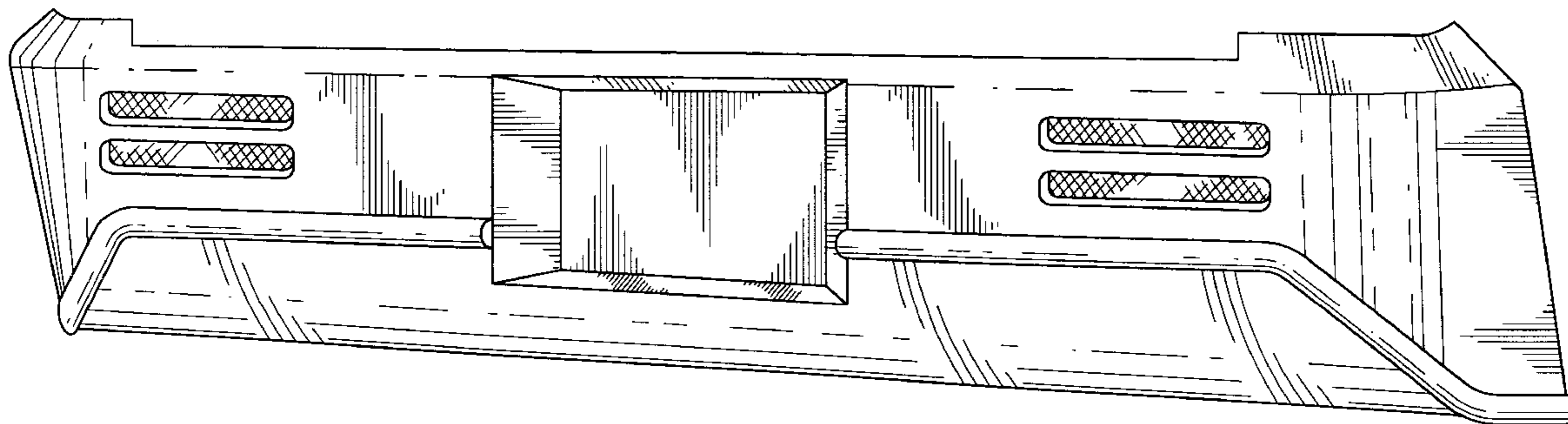
DESCRIPTION

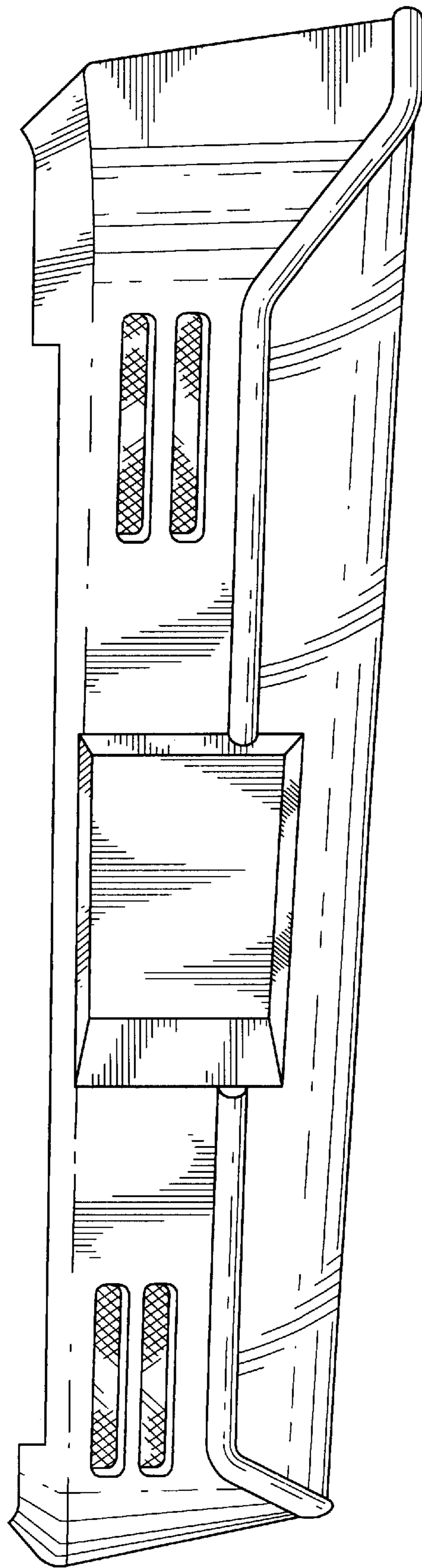

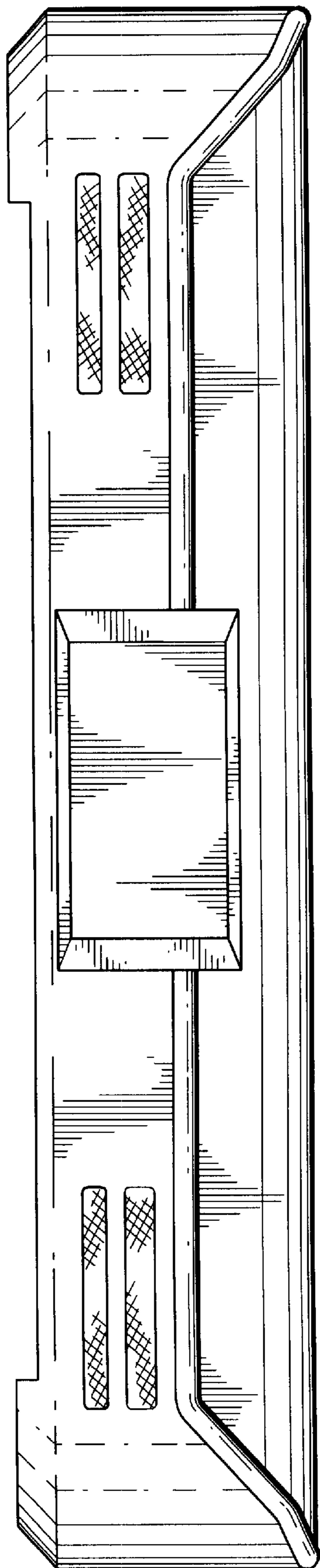
