I claim the ornamental design for an interior and exterior surface of a fence panel, as shown and described.

#### **DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 4 is a right side view thereof;


FIG. 5 is a left side view thereof;








Fig. 3 Fig. 4 Fig. 5




