The ornamental design for a gripper, as shown and described.

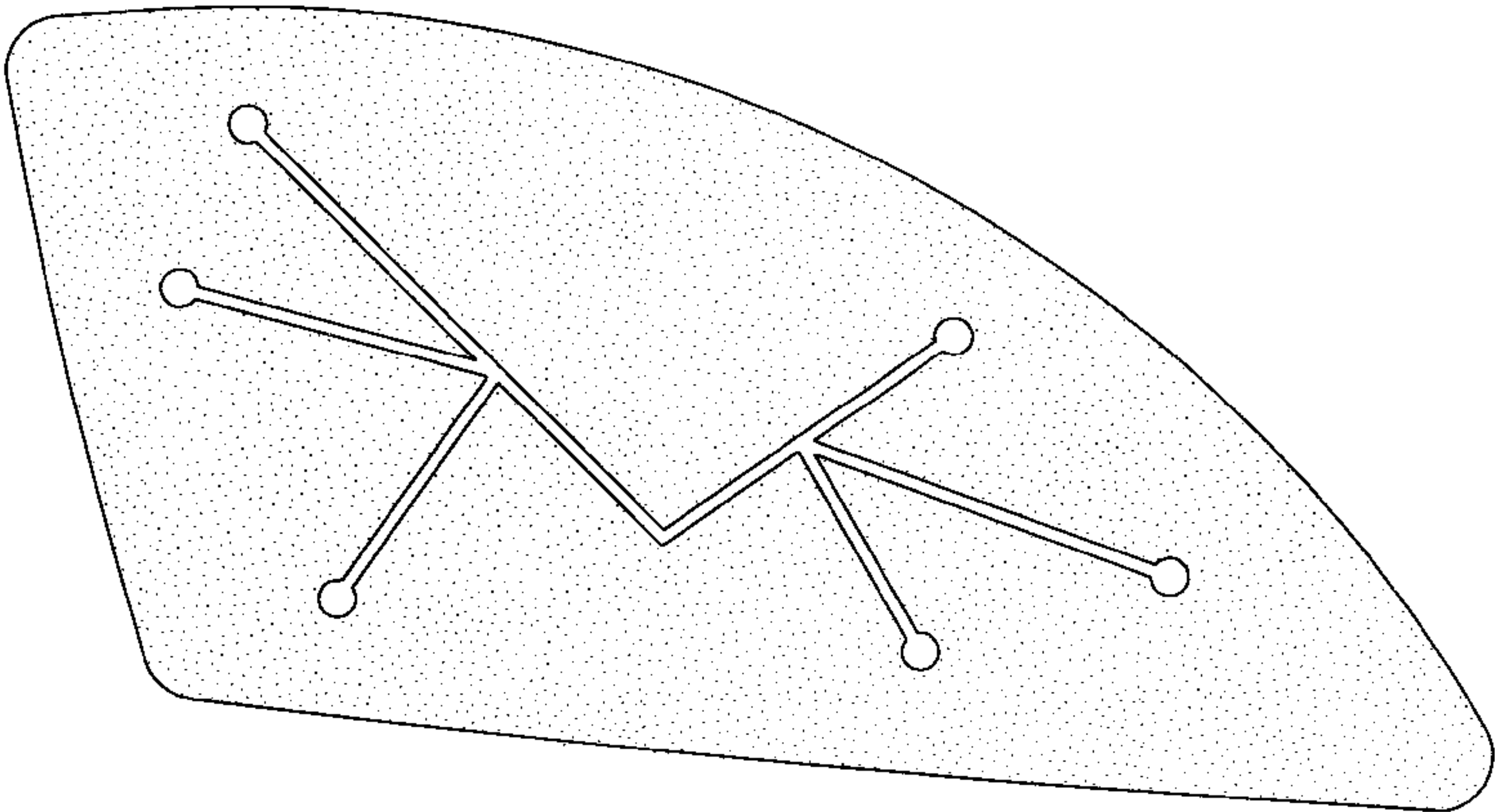
DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top plan view of a gripper embodying our new design;

FIG. 2 is a top plan view of a second embodiment of the design of FIG. 1 with the outer edges shown in broken lines; and,

FIG. 3 is a top plan view of third embodiment of the design of FIG. 1 with the circular openings shown in broken lines. The broken lines shown in FIGS. 2 and 3 define the bounds of the claimed design and form no part of the second and third embodiments.

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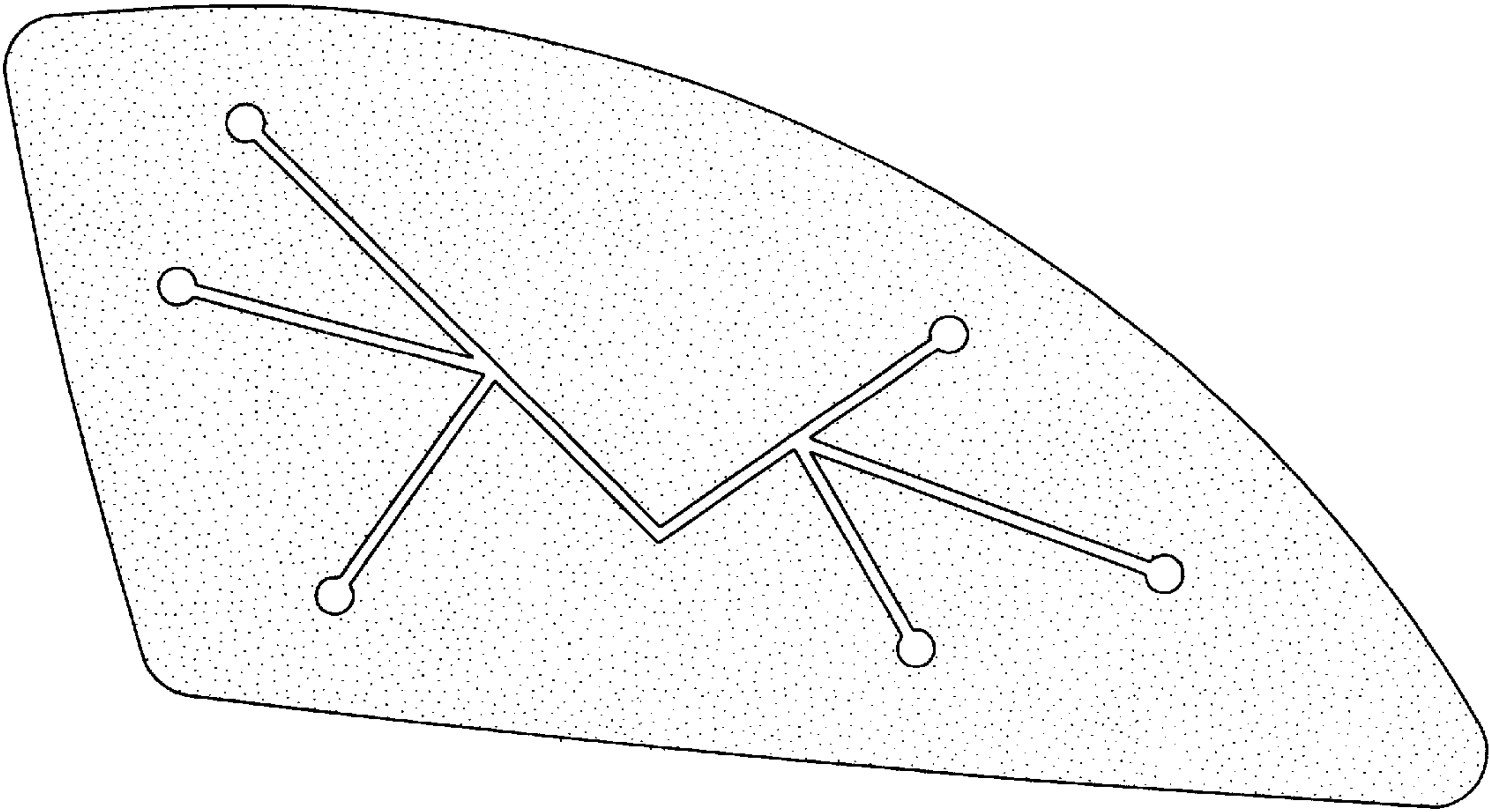

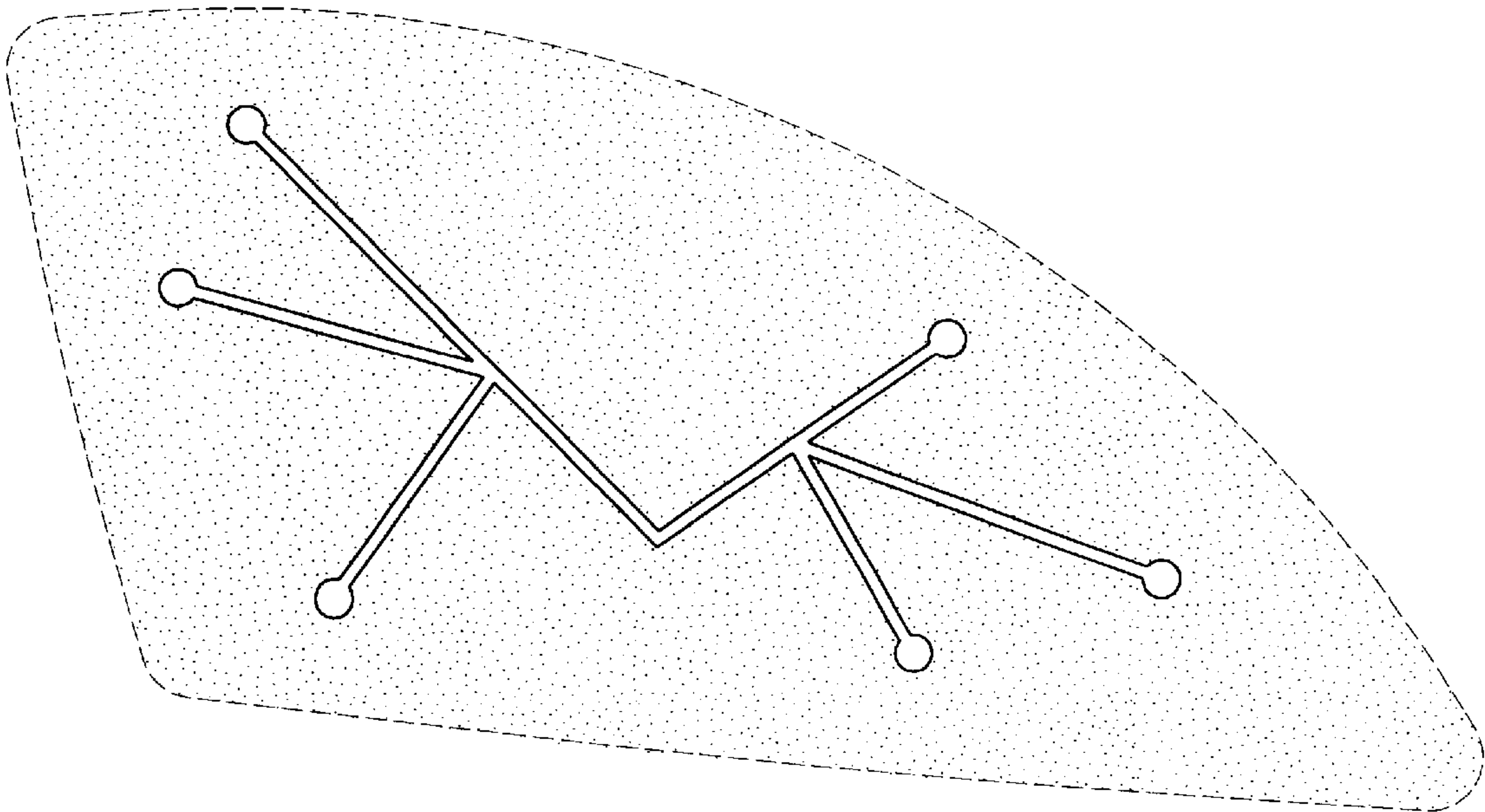

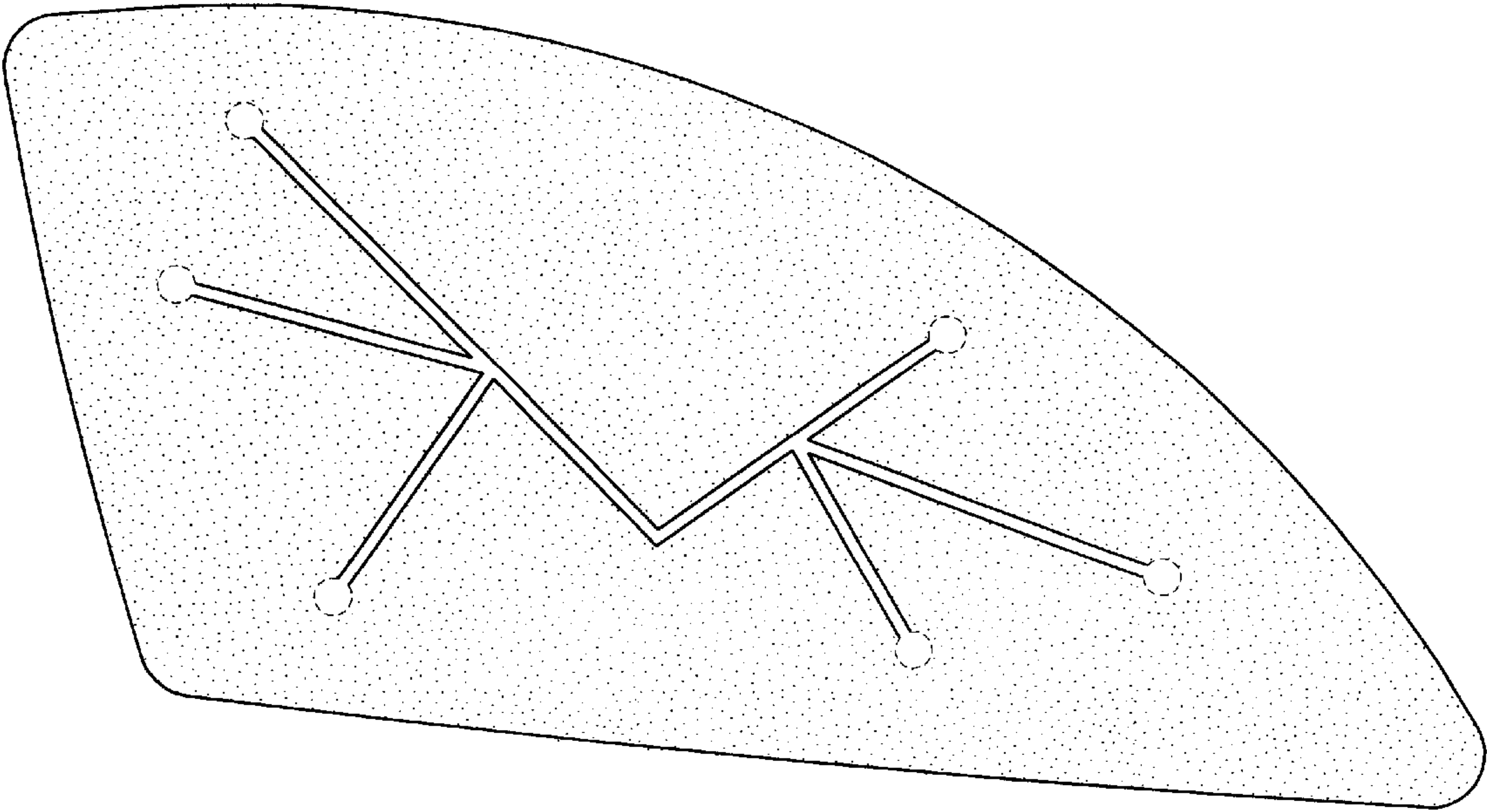
