(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a tear top can opener, as shown and described.

**DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of tear top can opener of my design;

FIG. 2 is a side elevational view of the tear top can opener of FIG. 1, with the opposite side being of identical configuration;

FIG. 3 is a top plan view of the tear top can opener of FIG. 1;

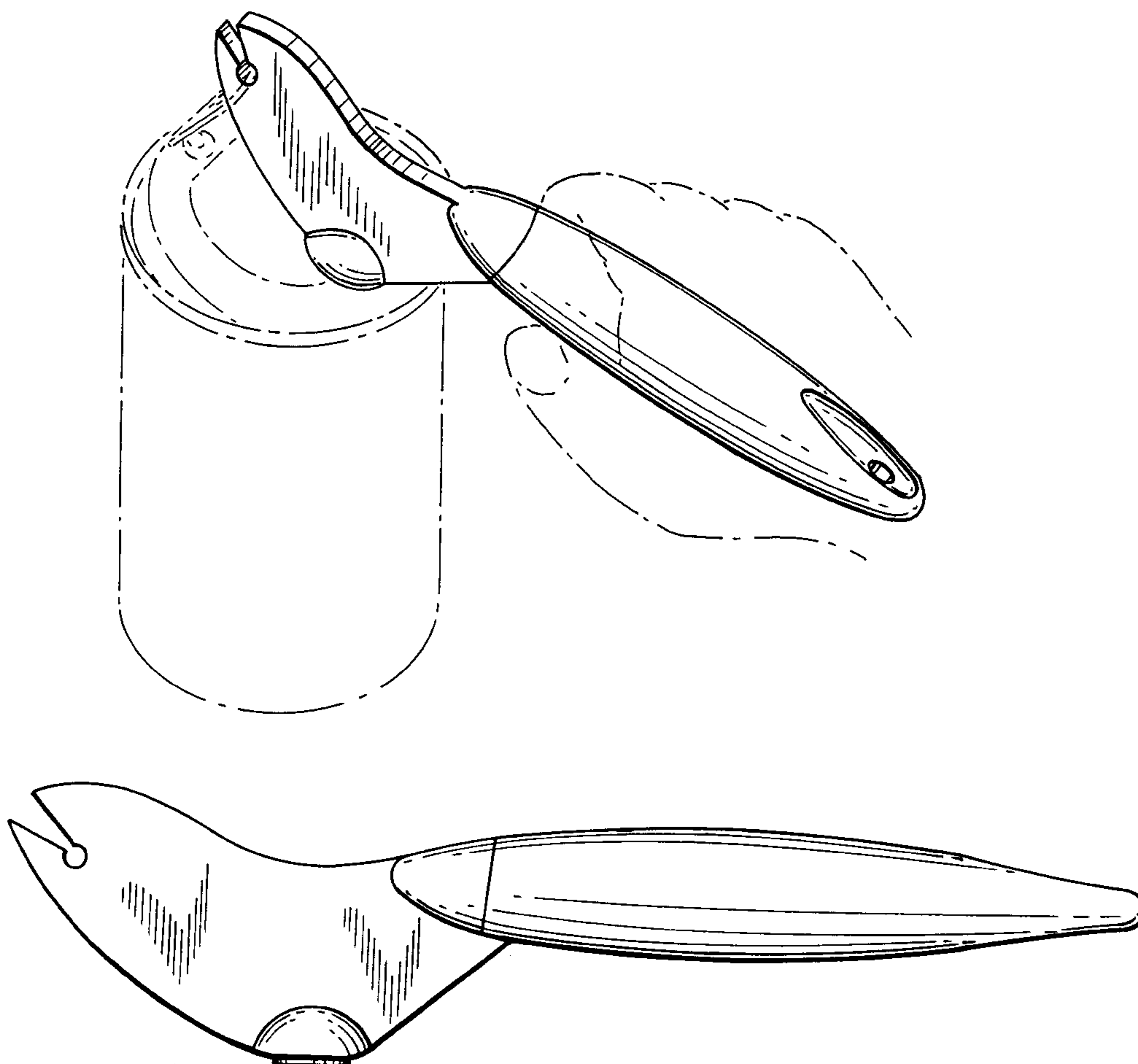
FIG. 4 is a left side elevational view of the tear top can opener of FIG. 2;

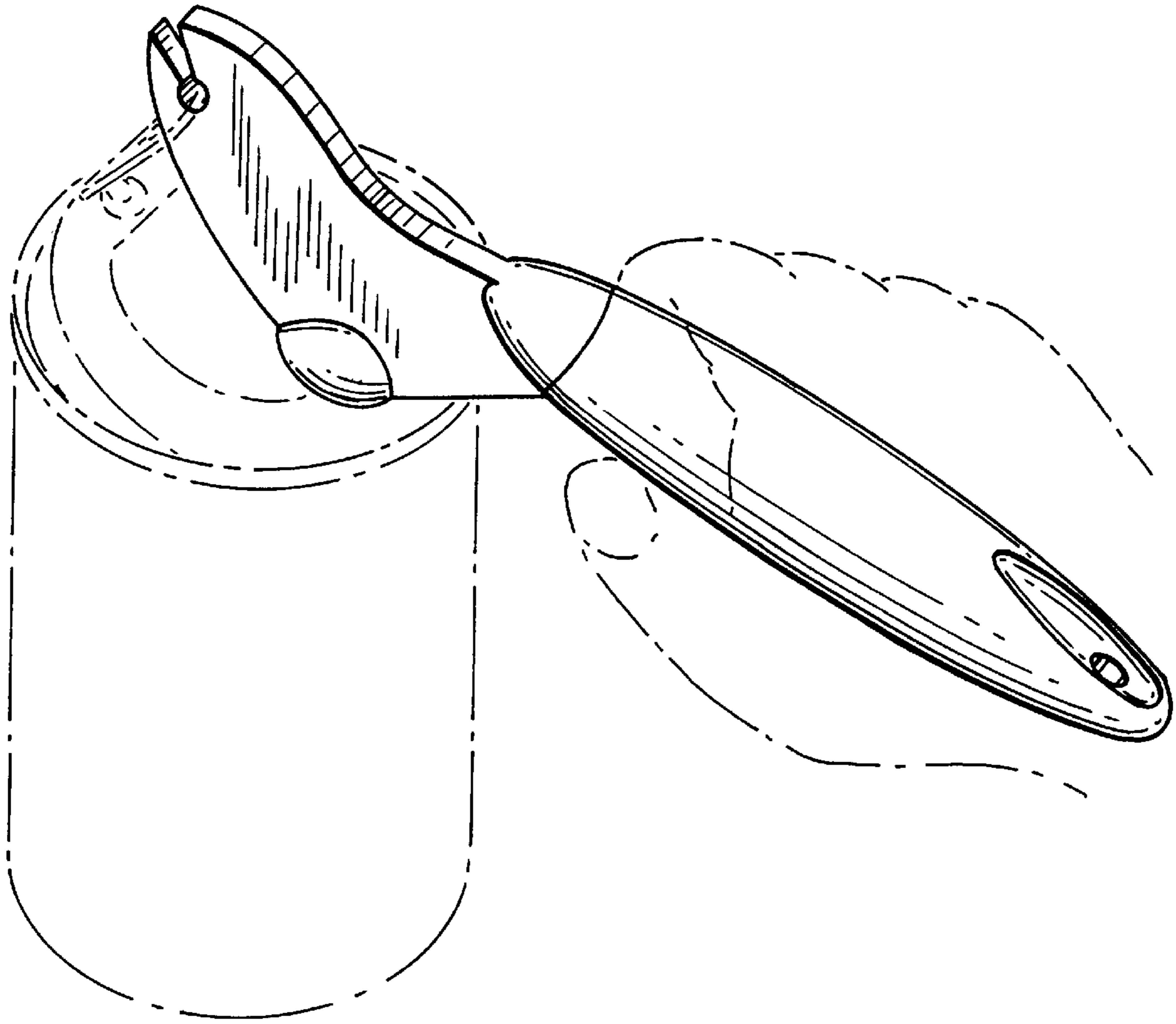

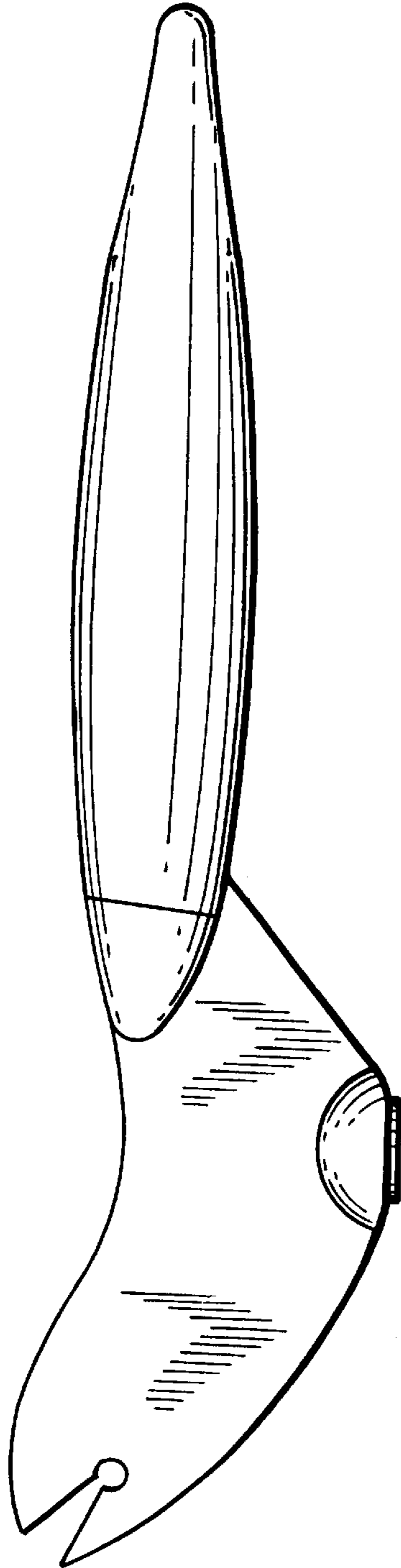

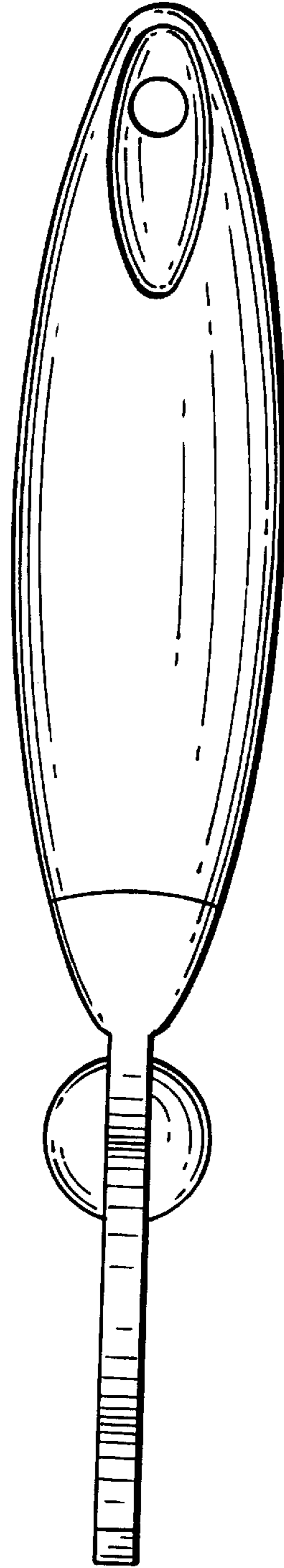

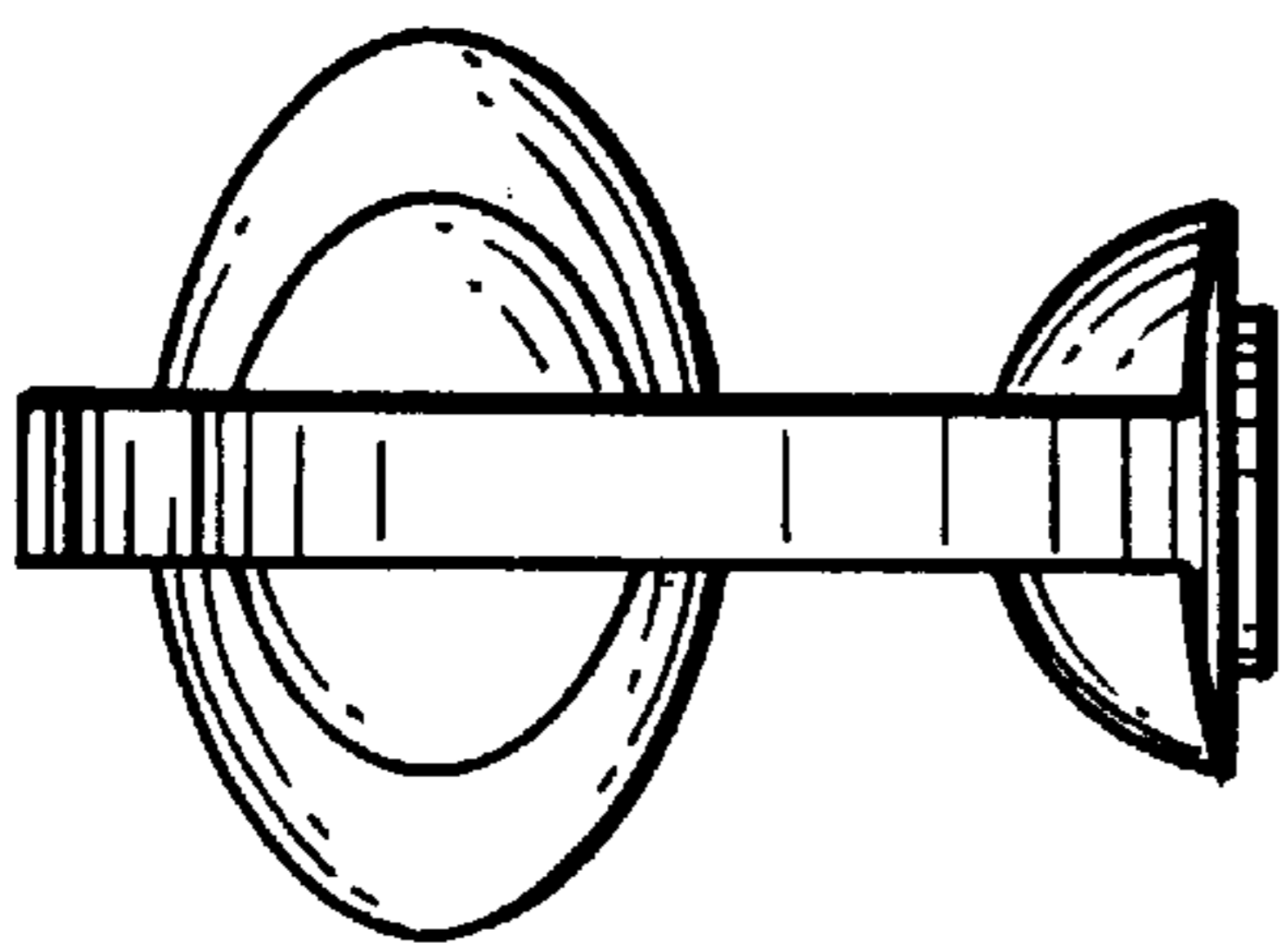

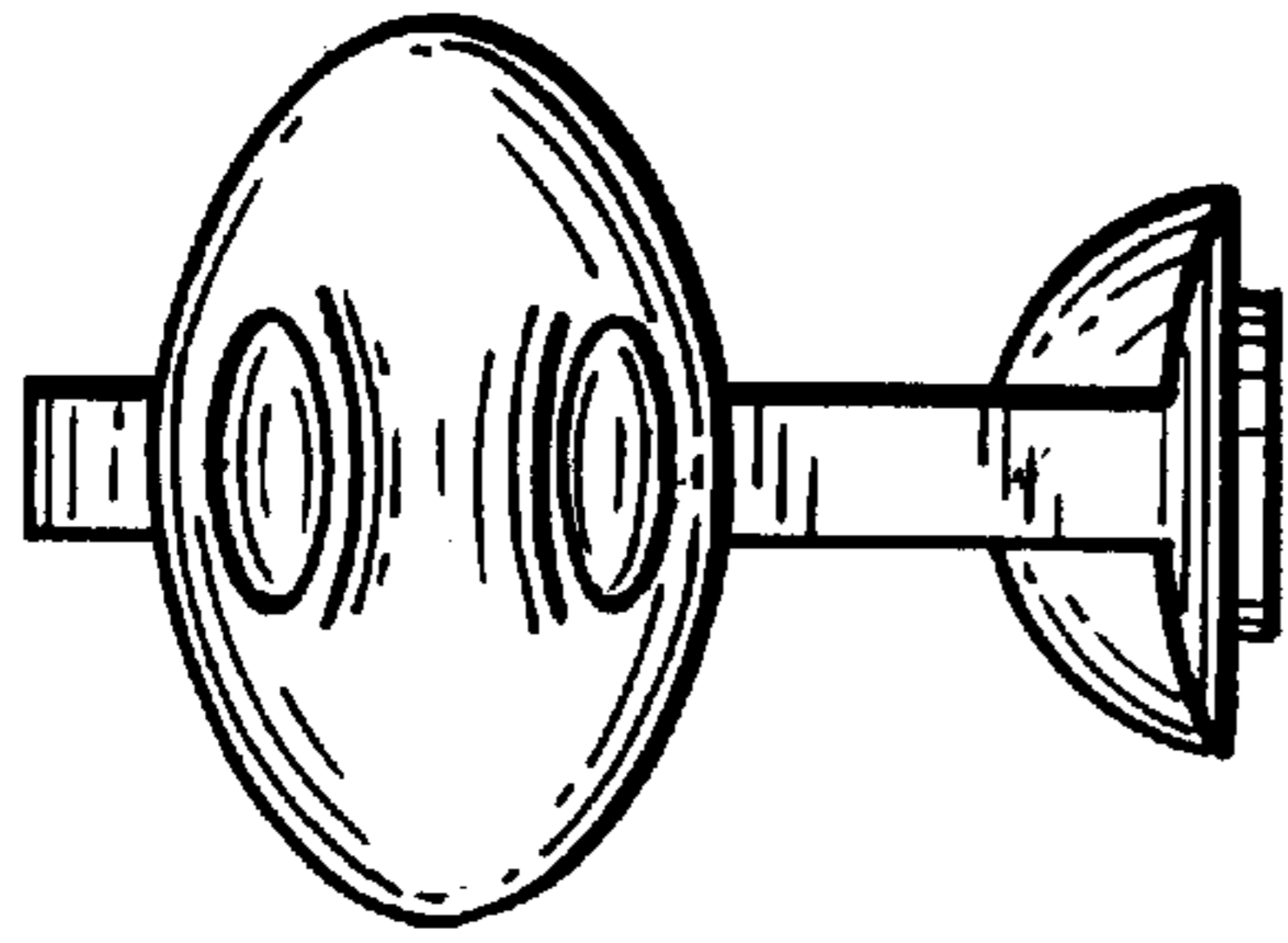

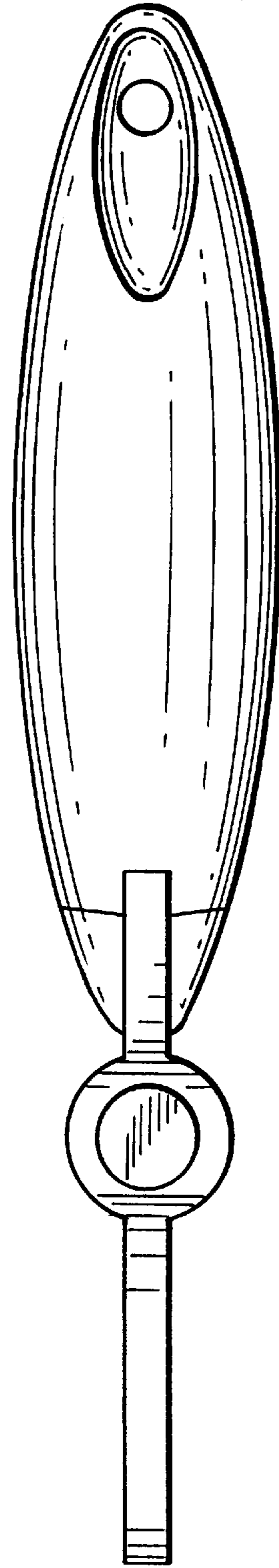
