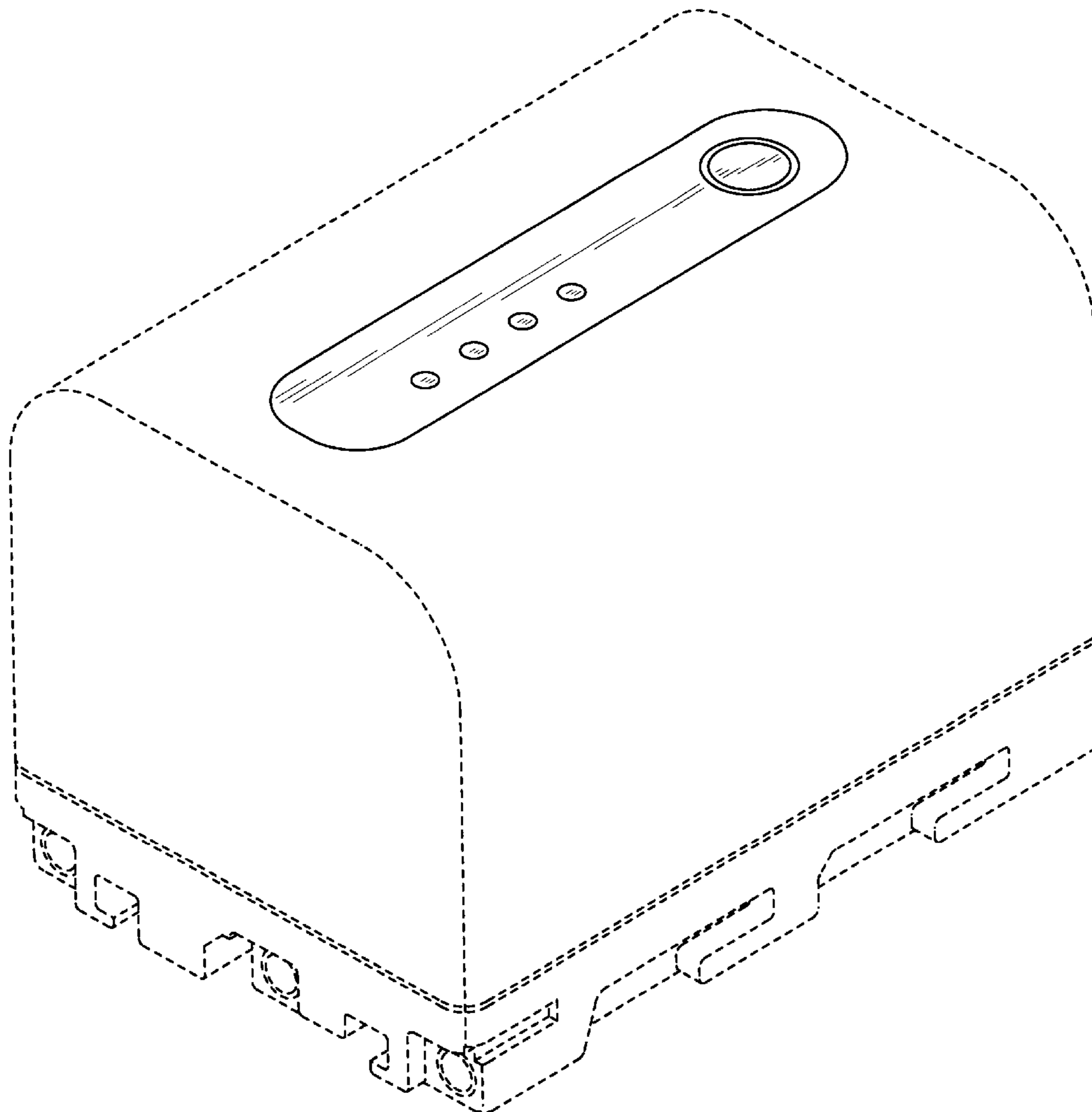
FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a rechargeable battery

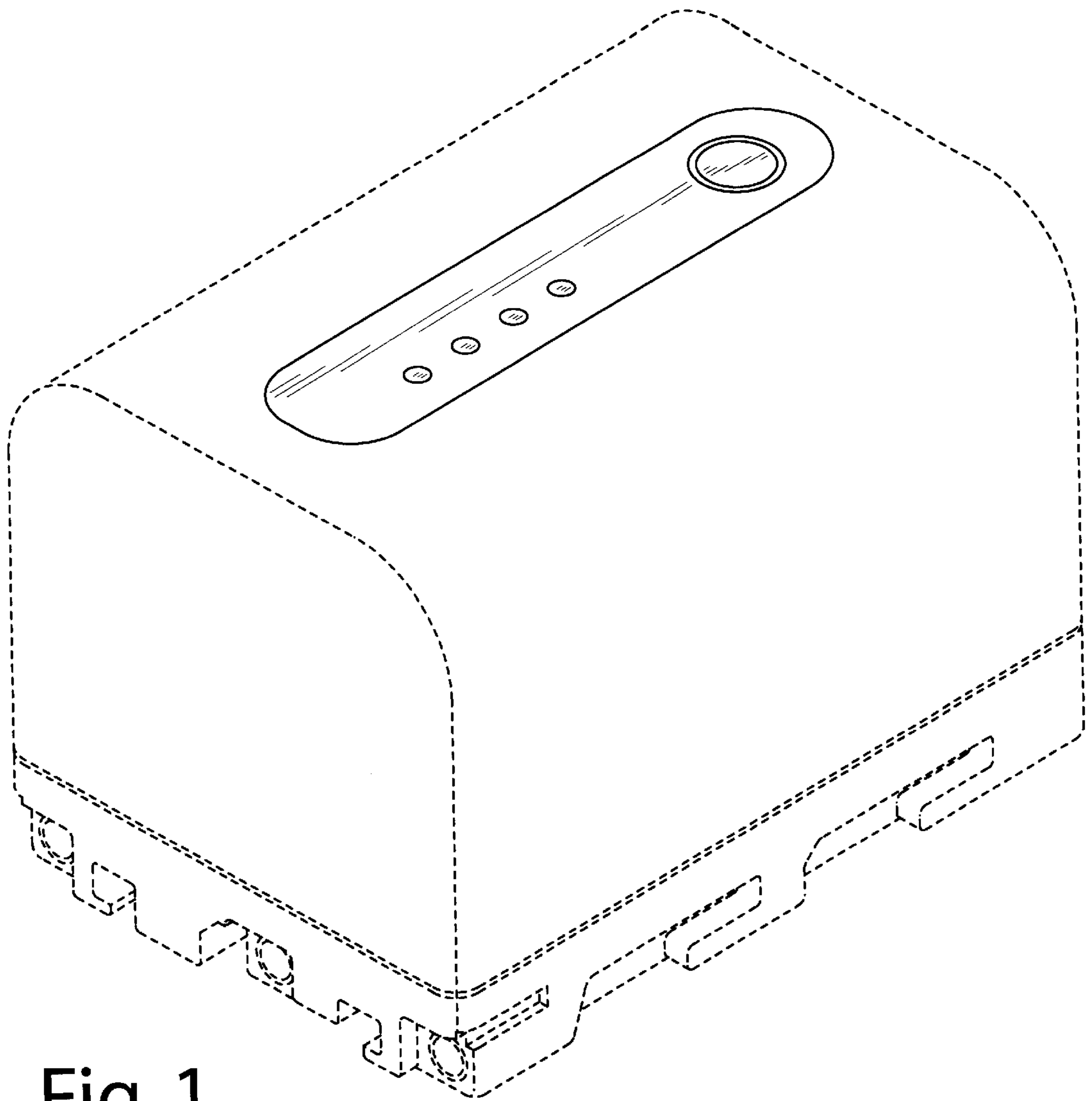
